handbag;

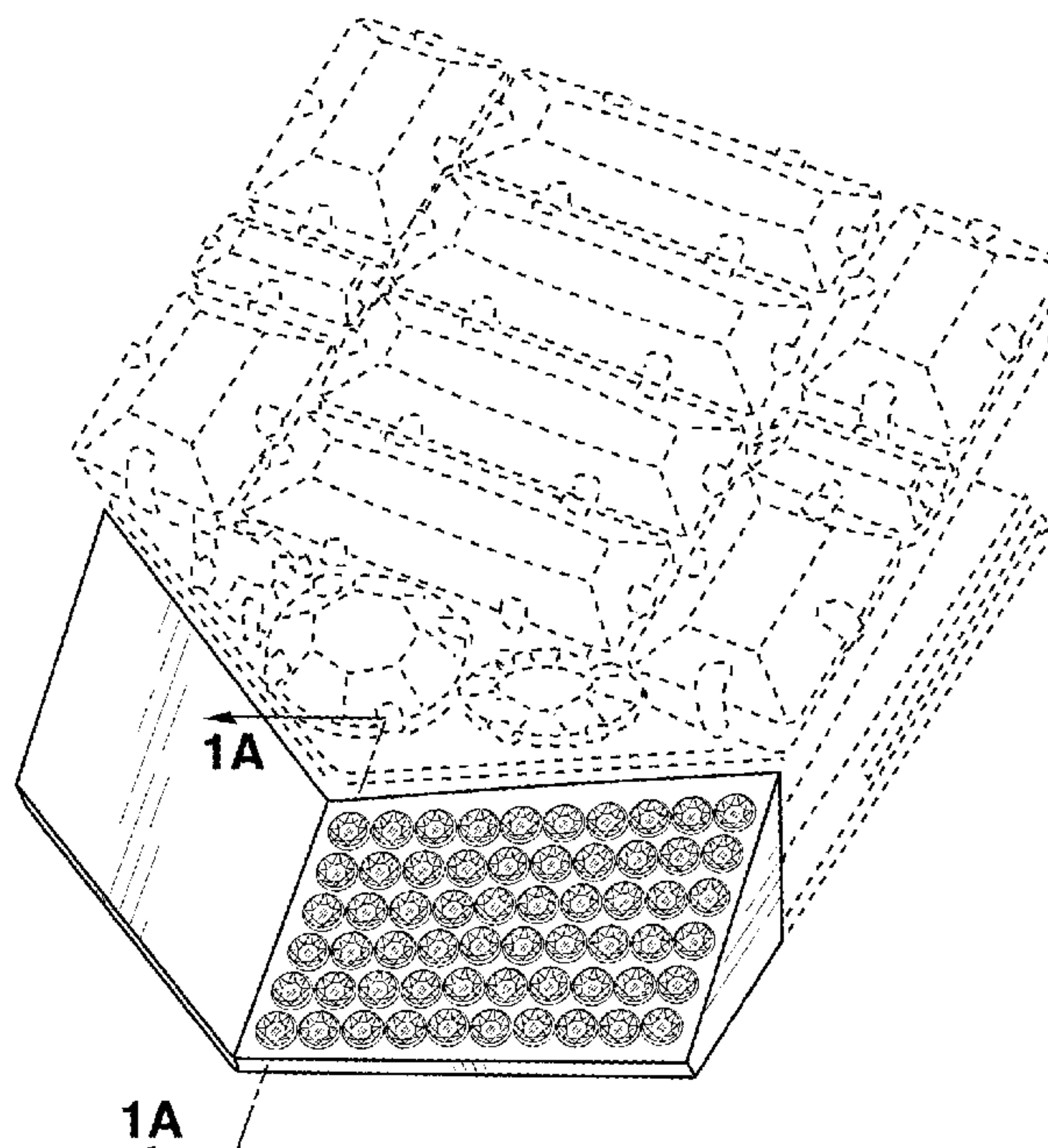
FIG. 9 is a front perspective view of an alternative embodi-

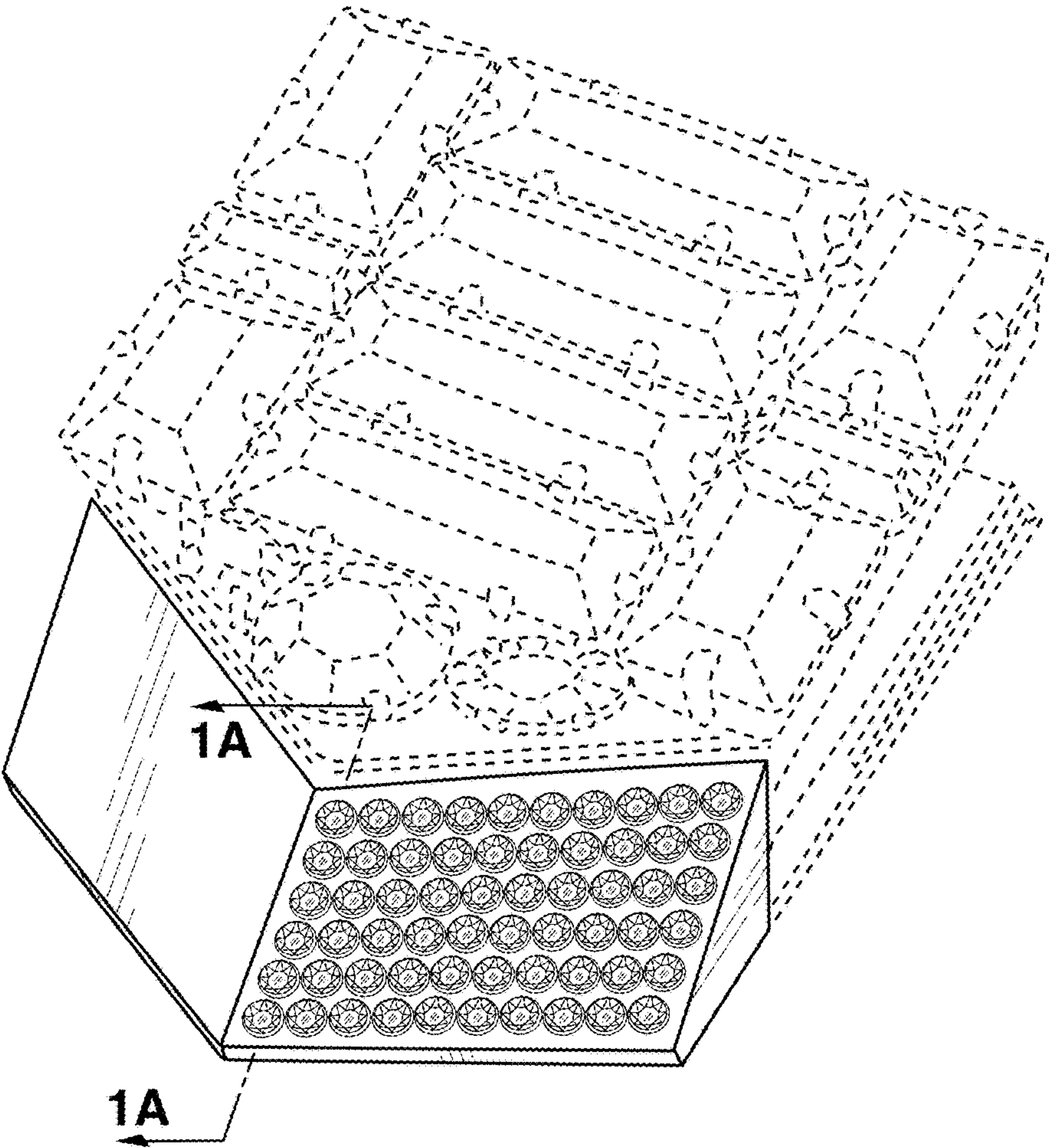

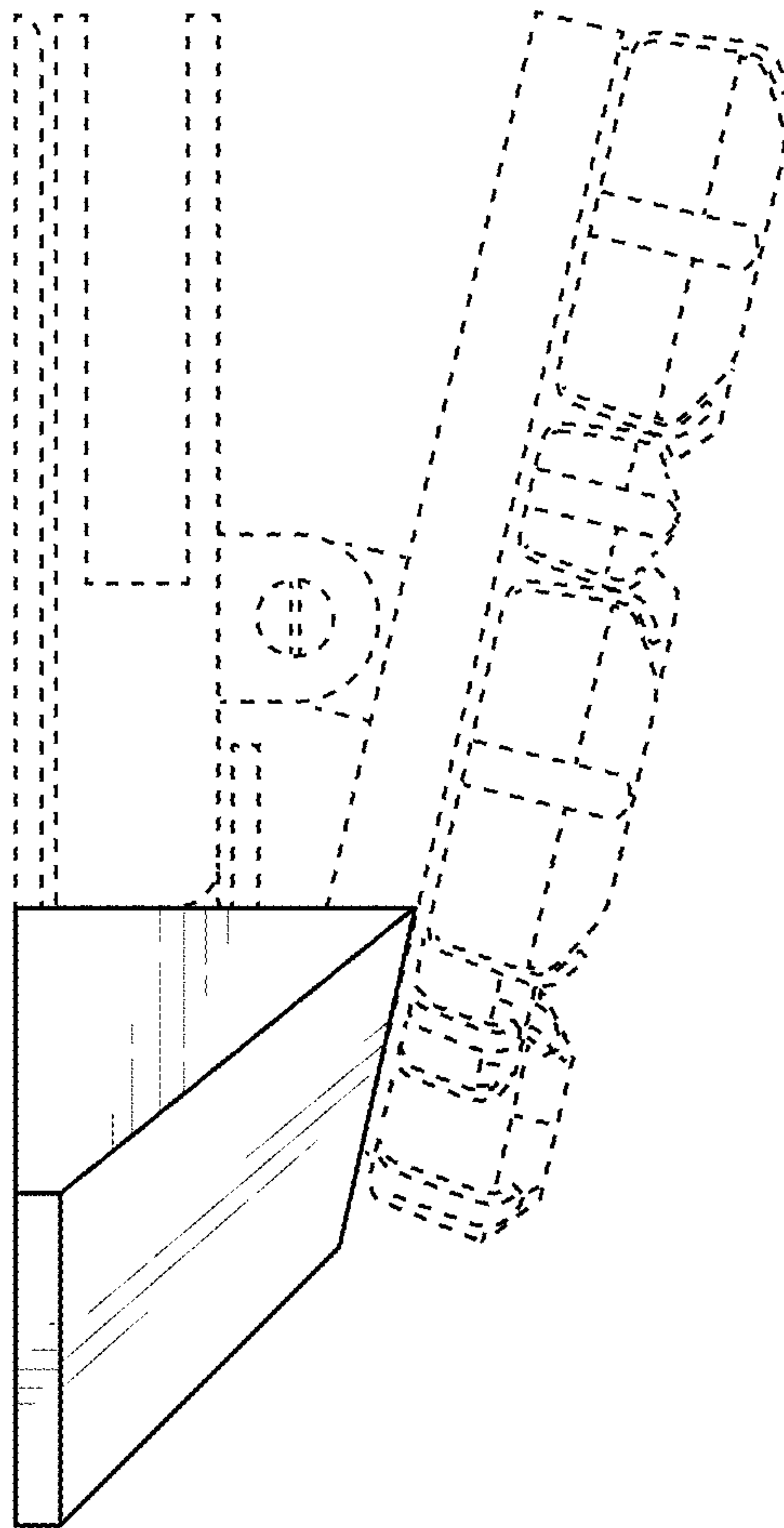

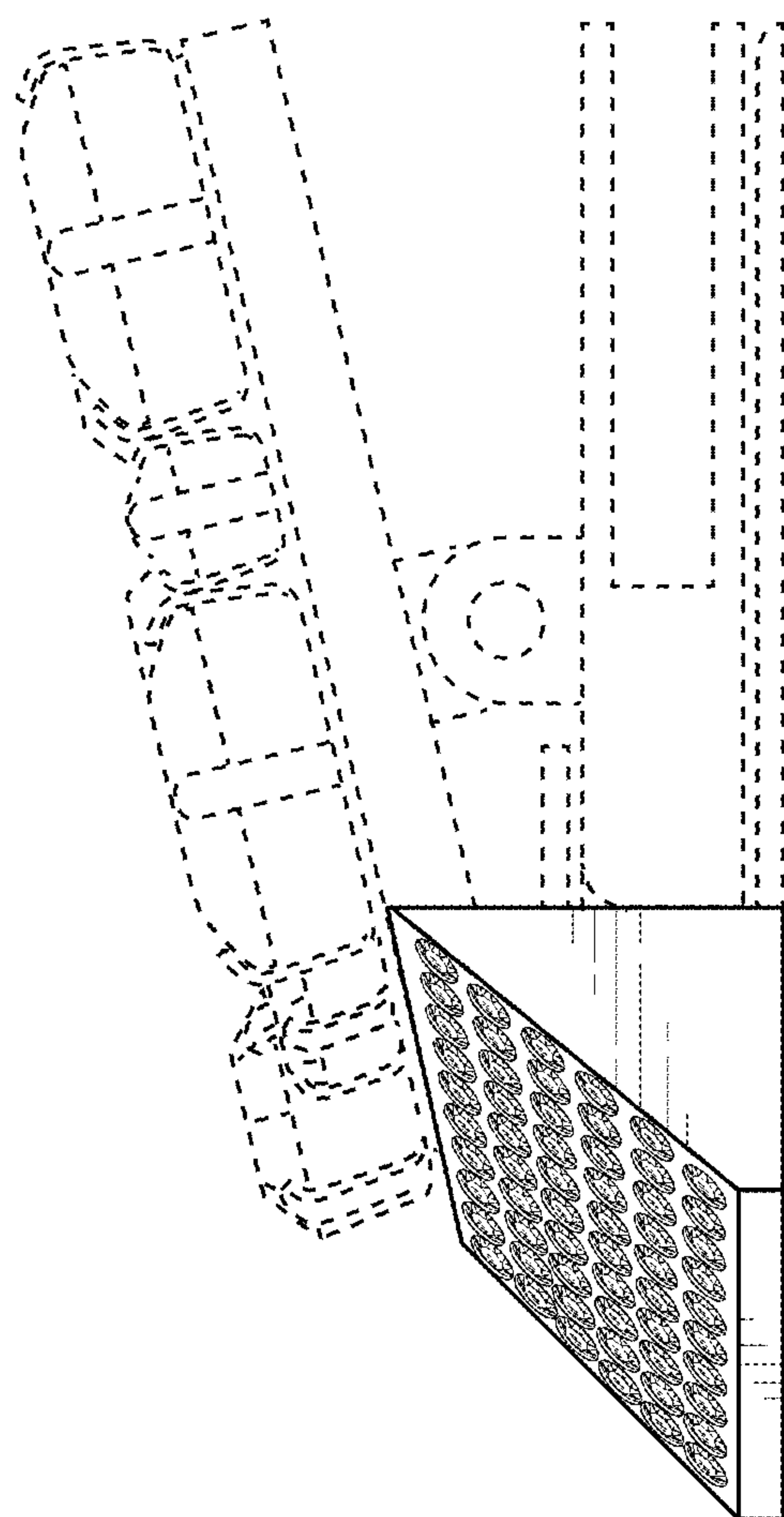

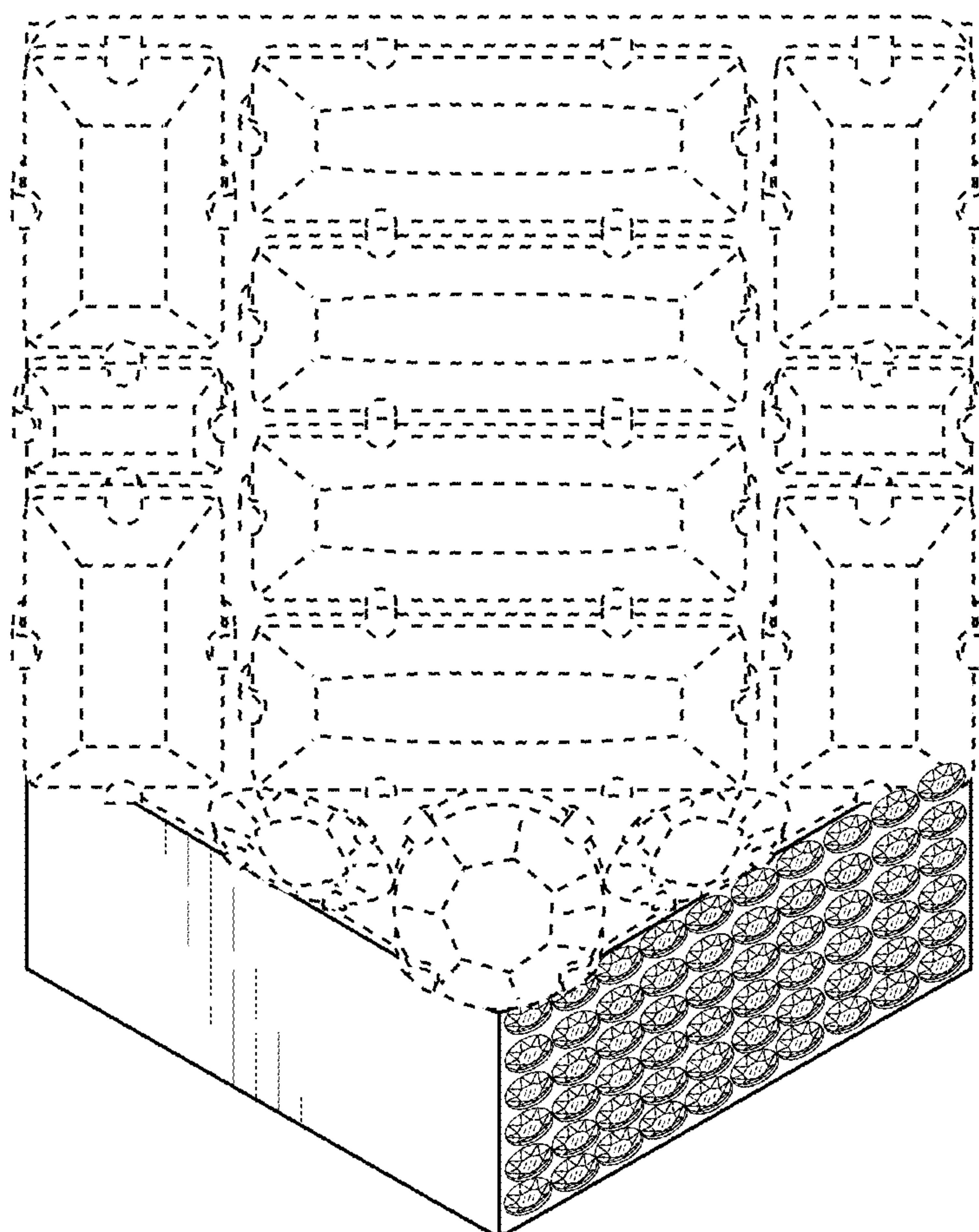

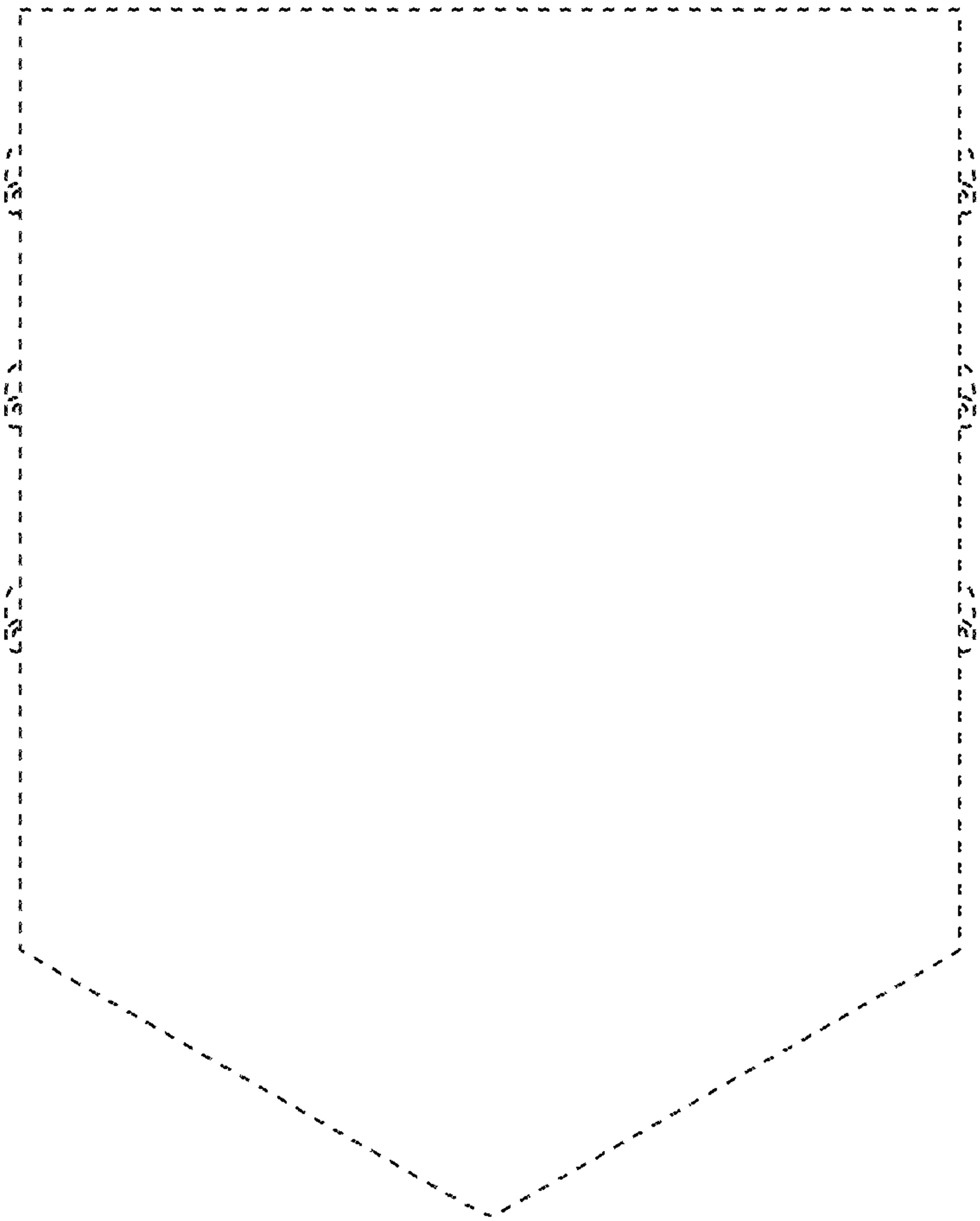

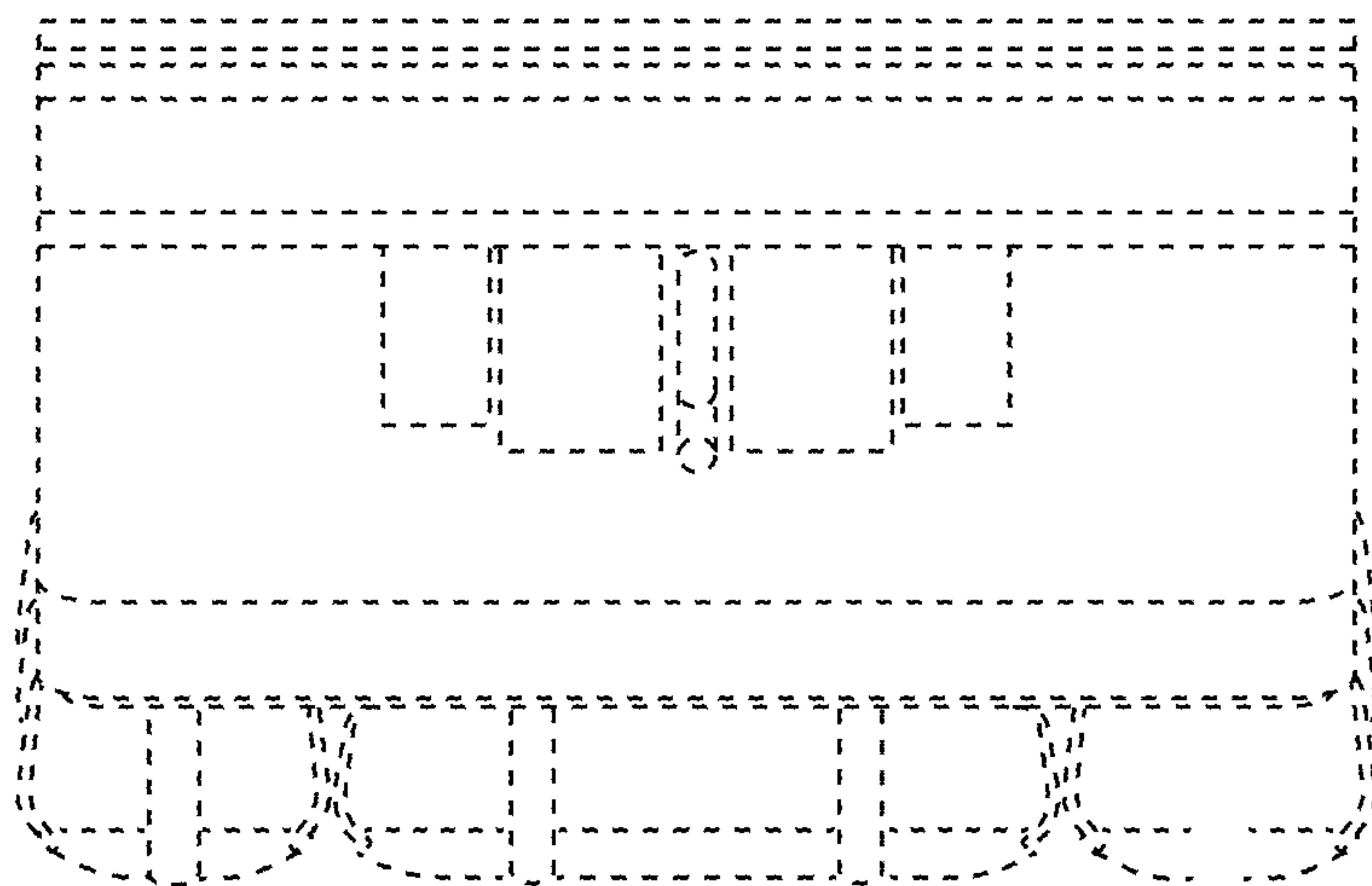

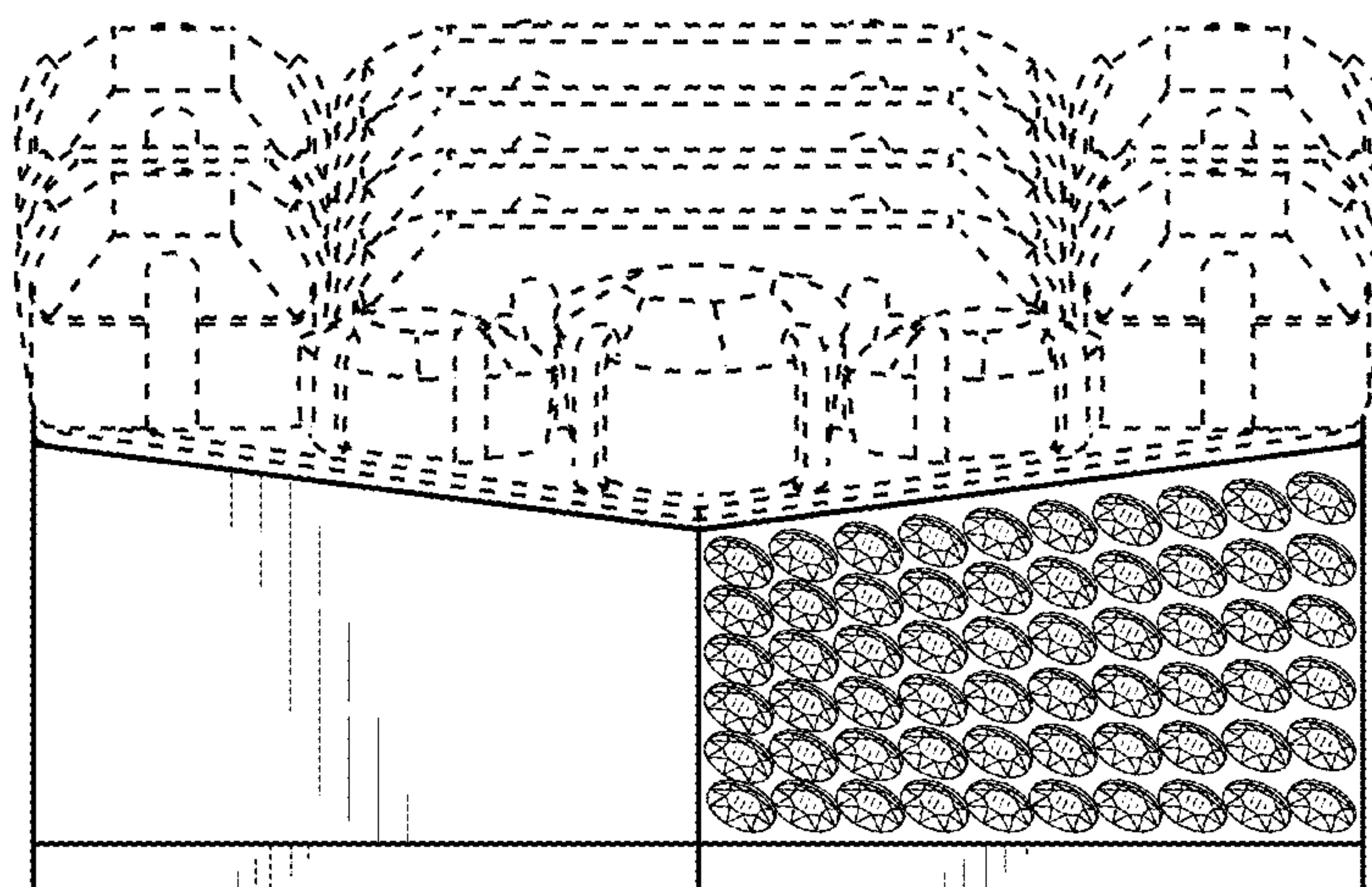

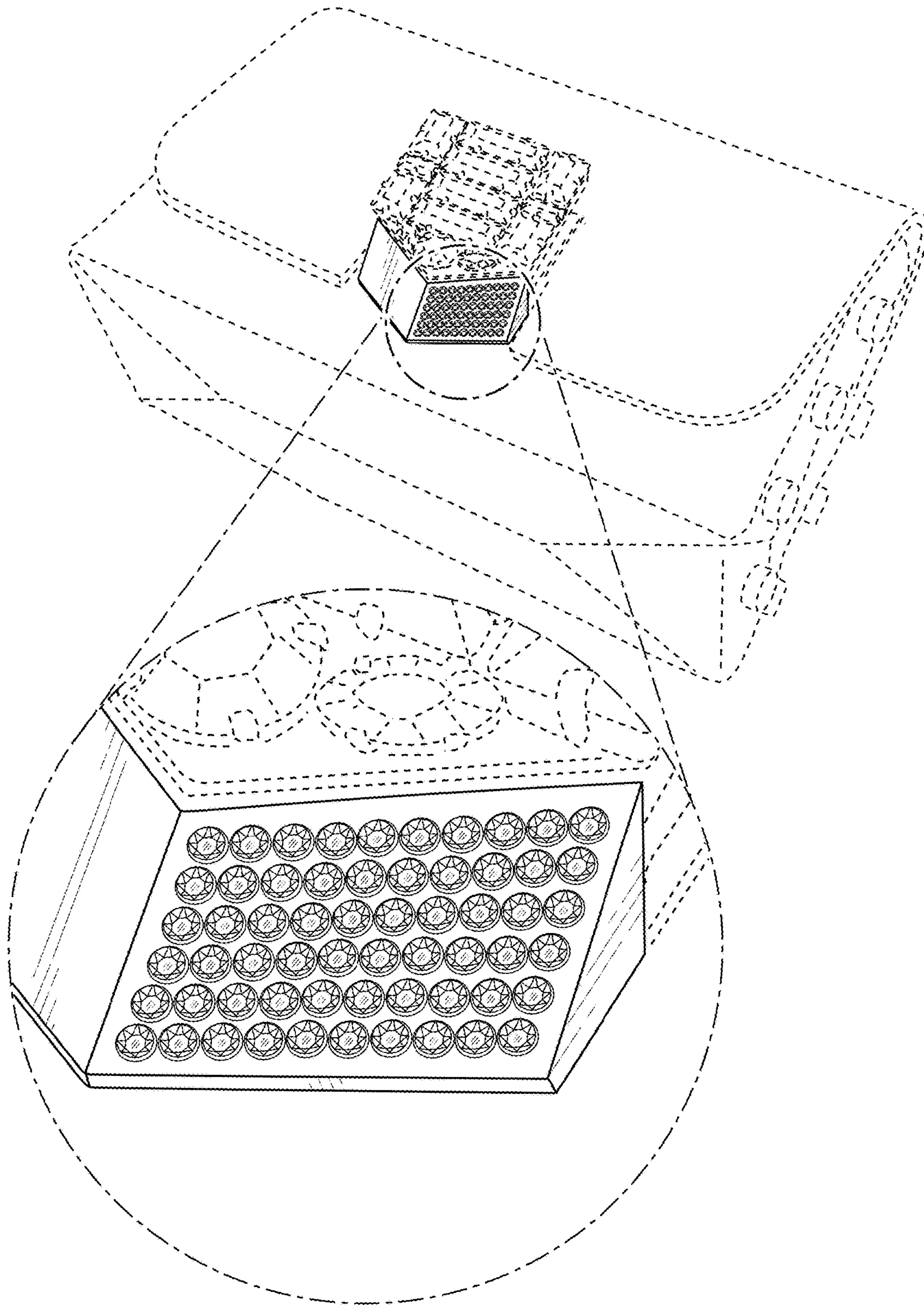

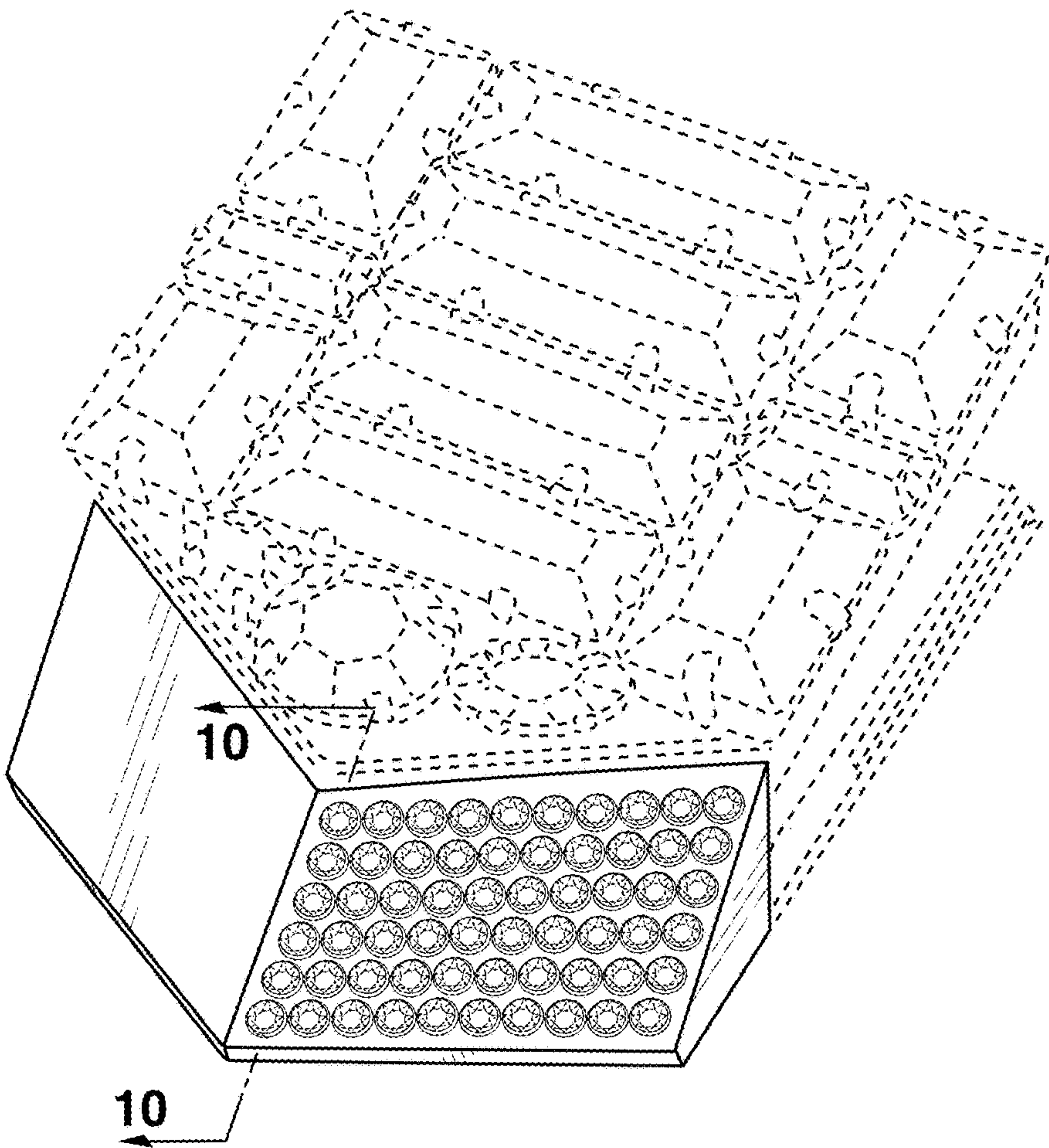

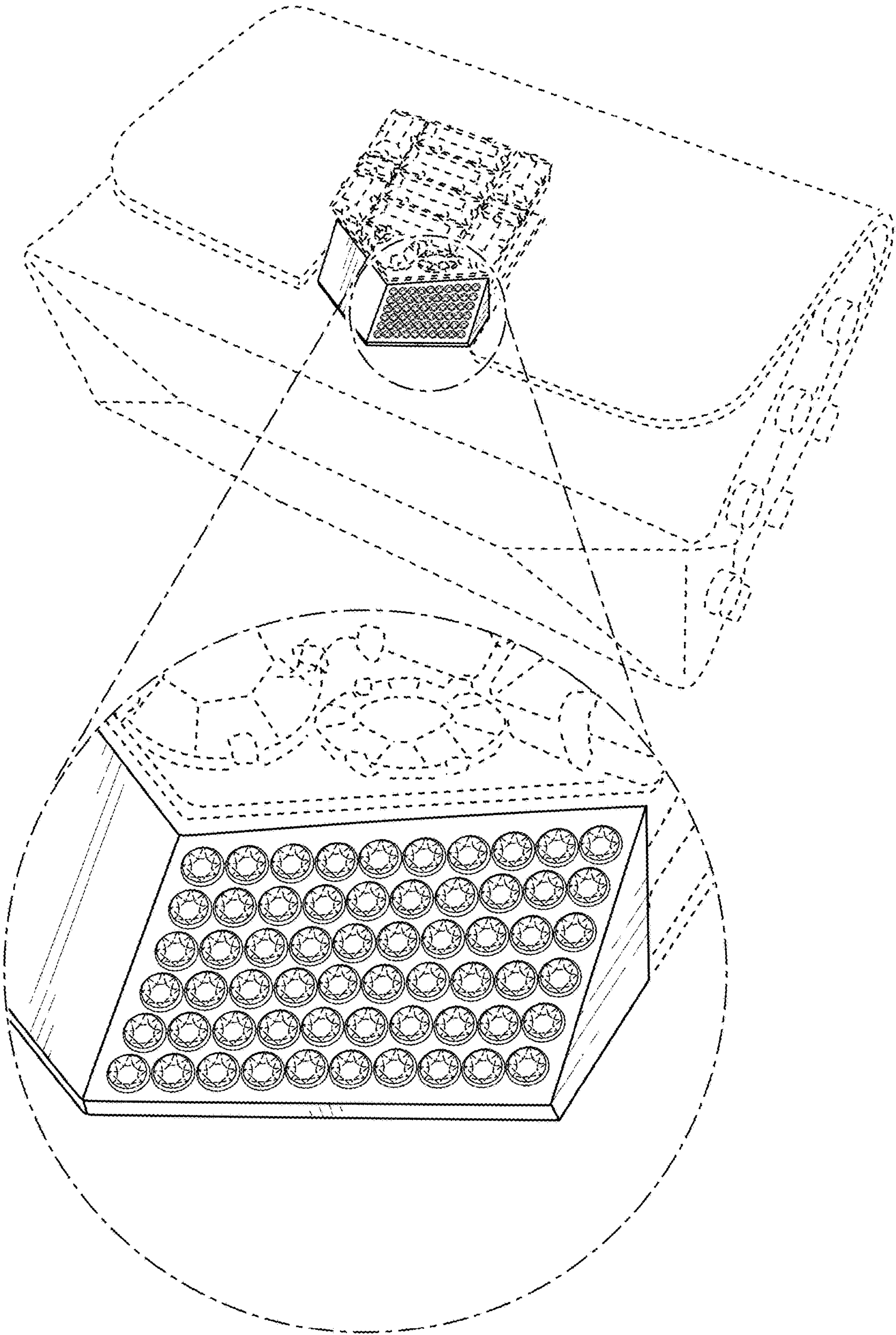
