FIG. 1 is a bottom plan view of a container cap simulating a barrel;

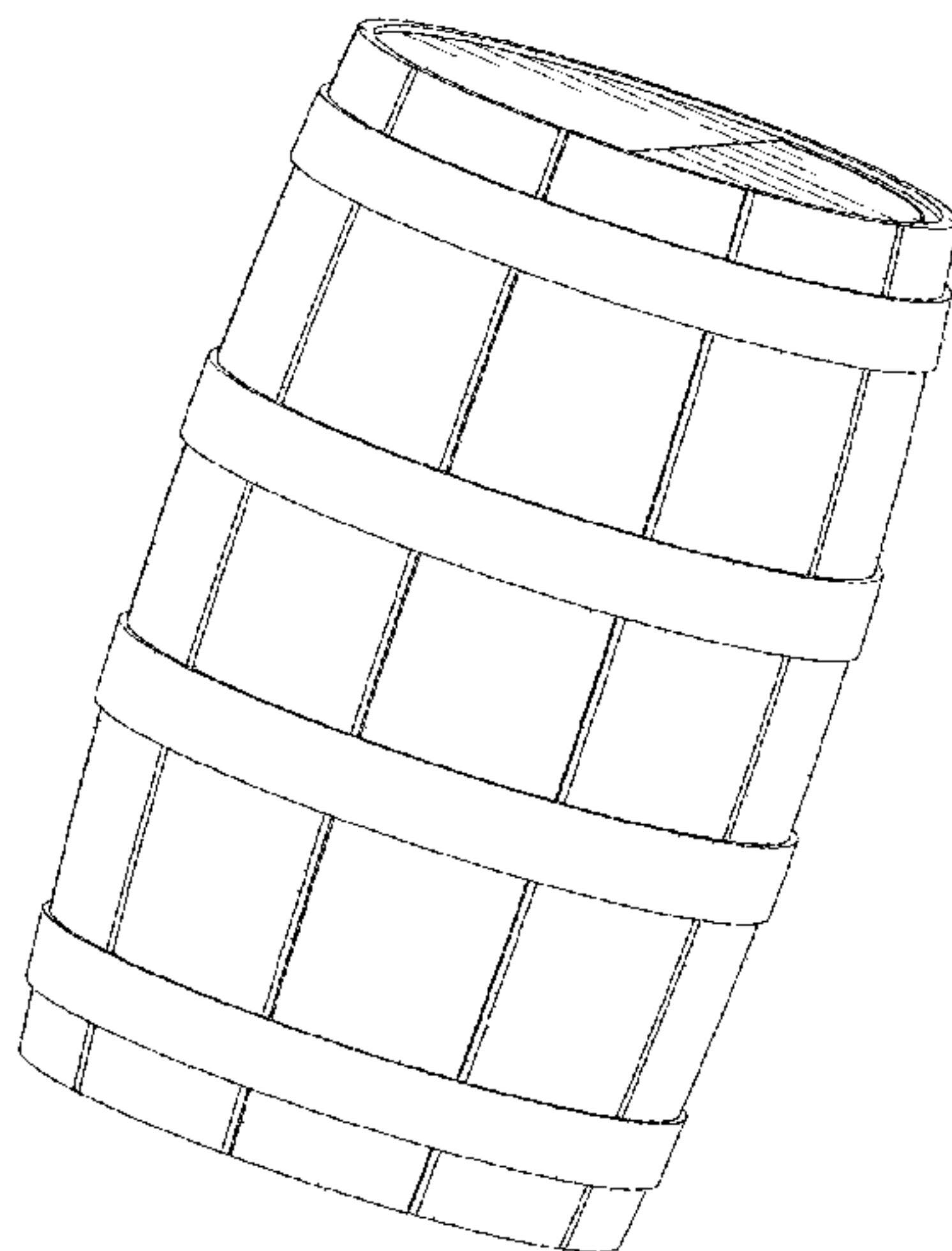
FIG. 2 is a side view of the container cap simulating a barrel;

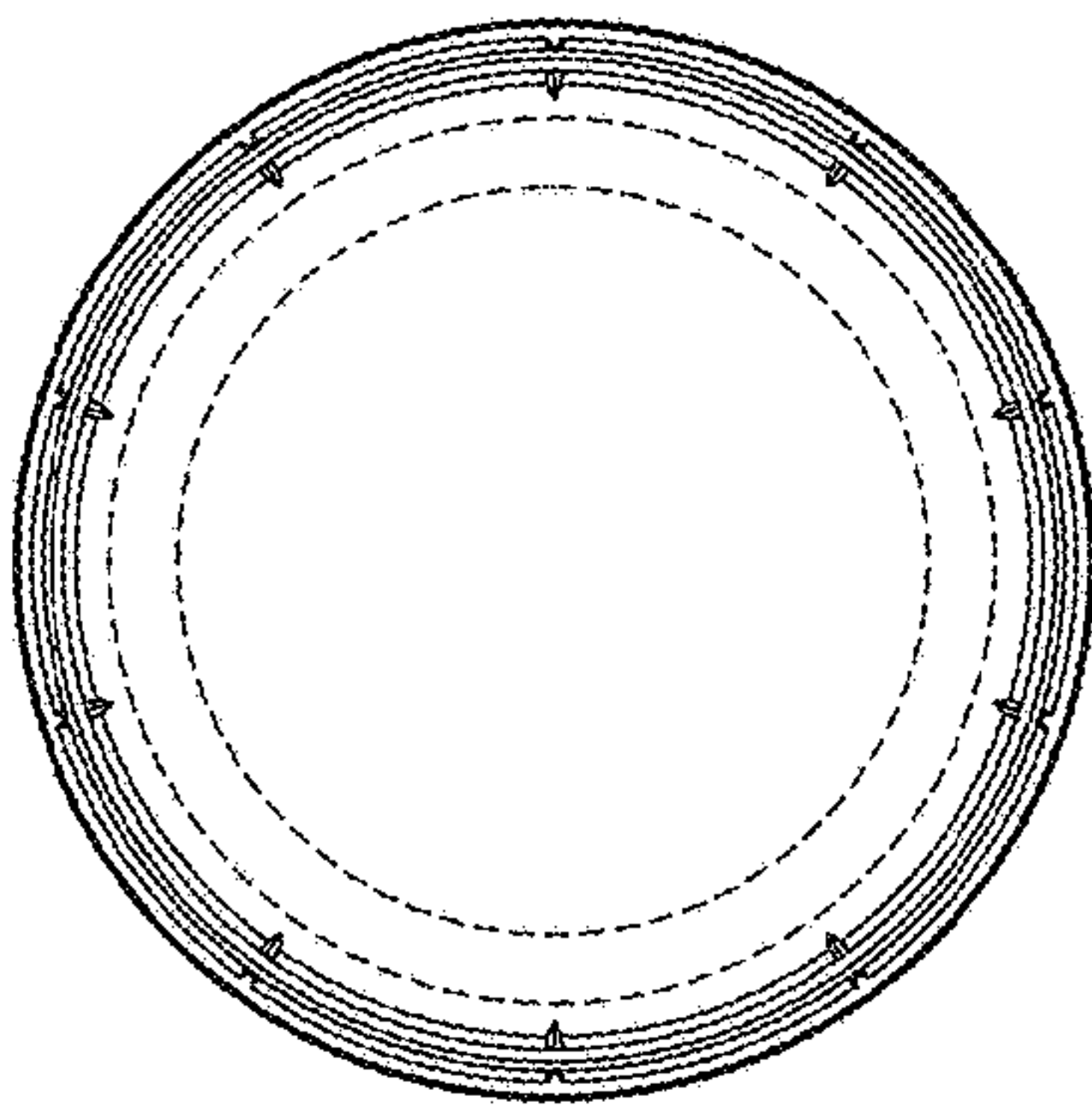

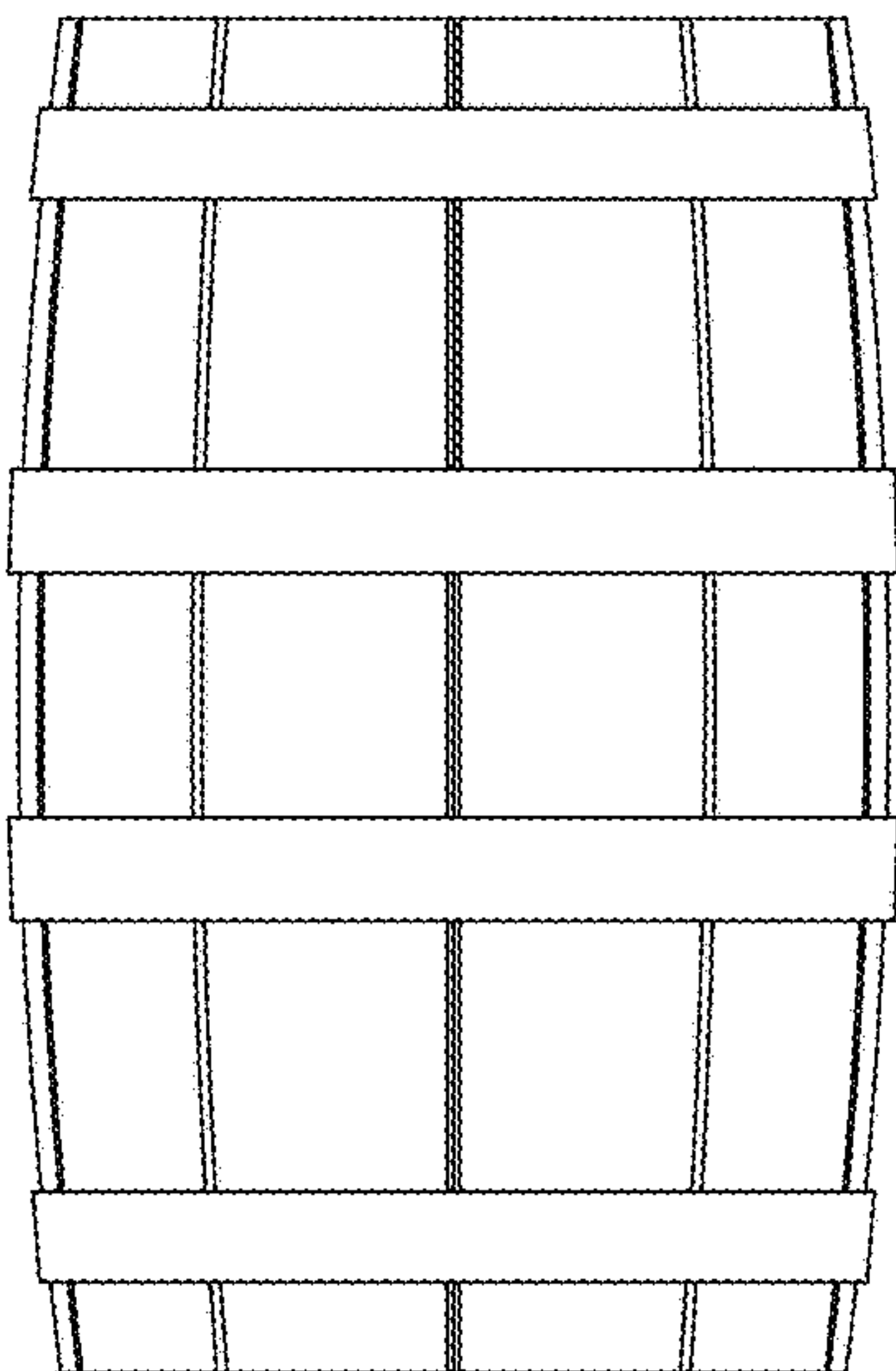

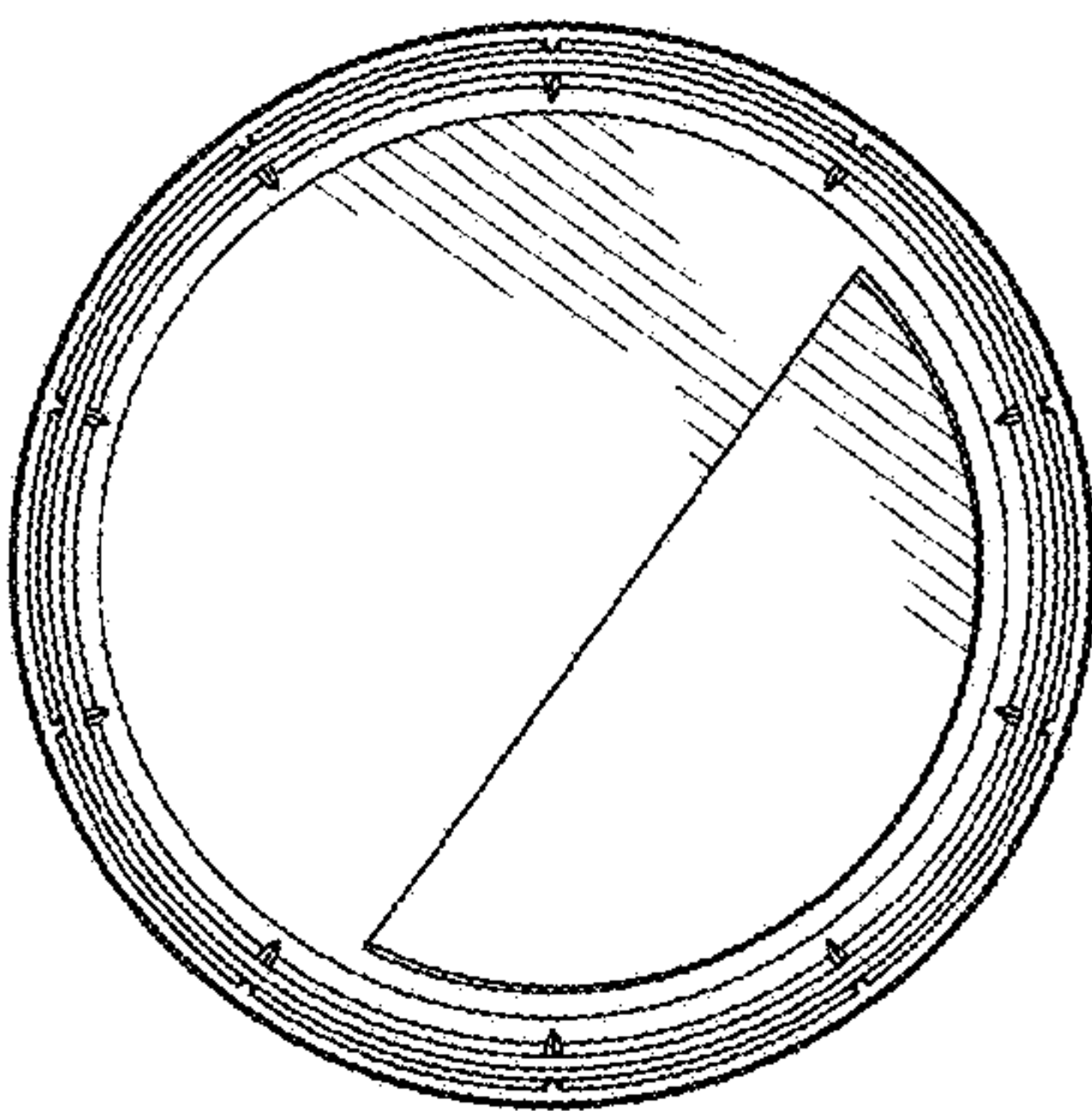
