(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a wearable item, as shown.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a wearable item in the form of a vest that is a first embodiment of the invention, formed at least partially from sheet material having slots in a first configuration;

FIG. 2 is a front elevational view of the vest of FIG. 1;

FIG. 3 is a back elevational view of the vest of FIG. 1;

FIG. 4 is a right side elevational view of the vest of FIG. 1;

FIG. 5 is a left side elevational view of the vest of FIG. 1;

FIG. 6 is a top plan view of the vest of FIG. 1;

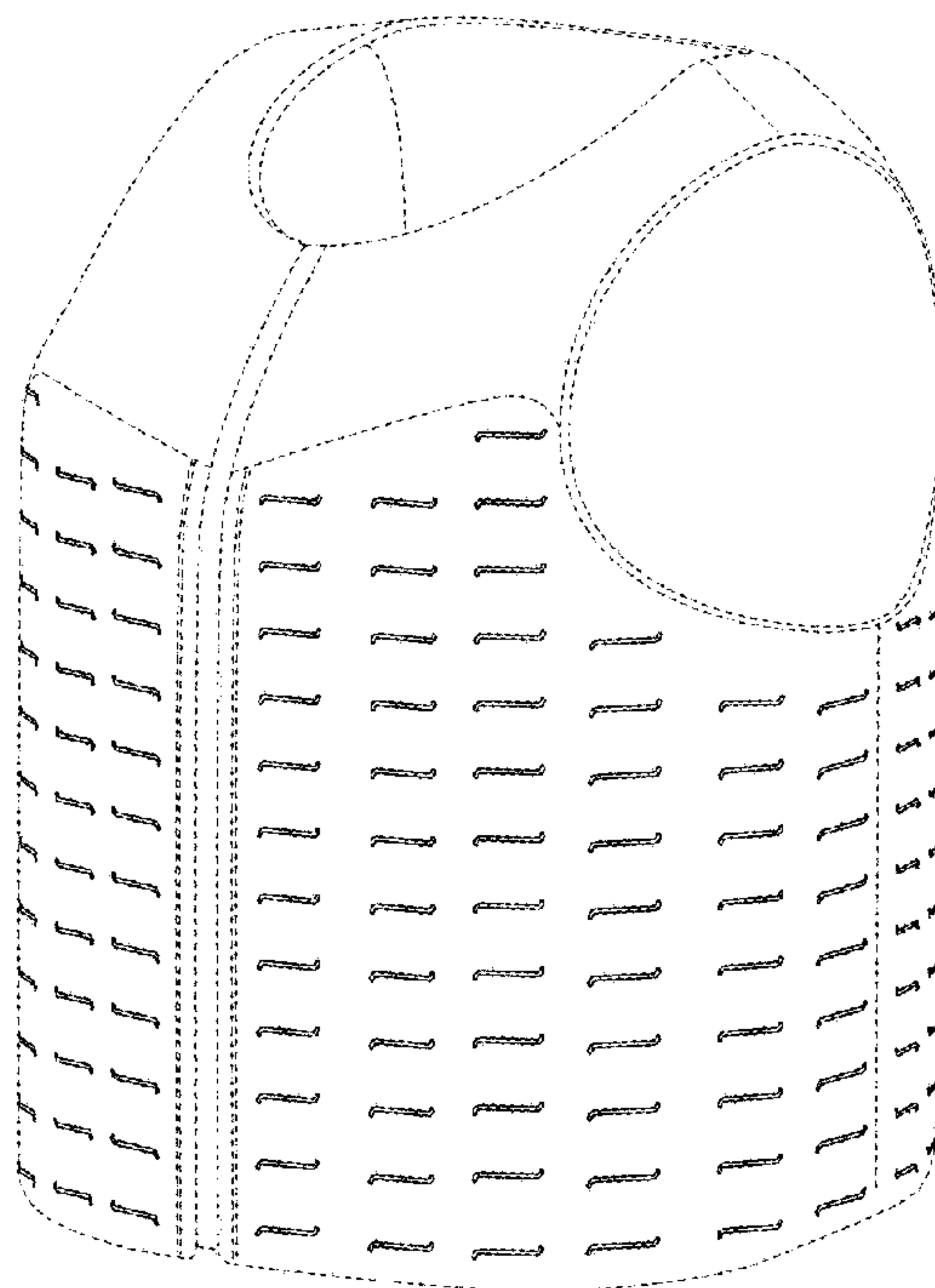
FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view of the vest of FIG. 1;

FIG. 8 is a perspective view of a portion of a wearable item in the form of a sheet material having slots in the first configuration; and,

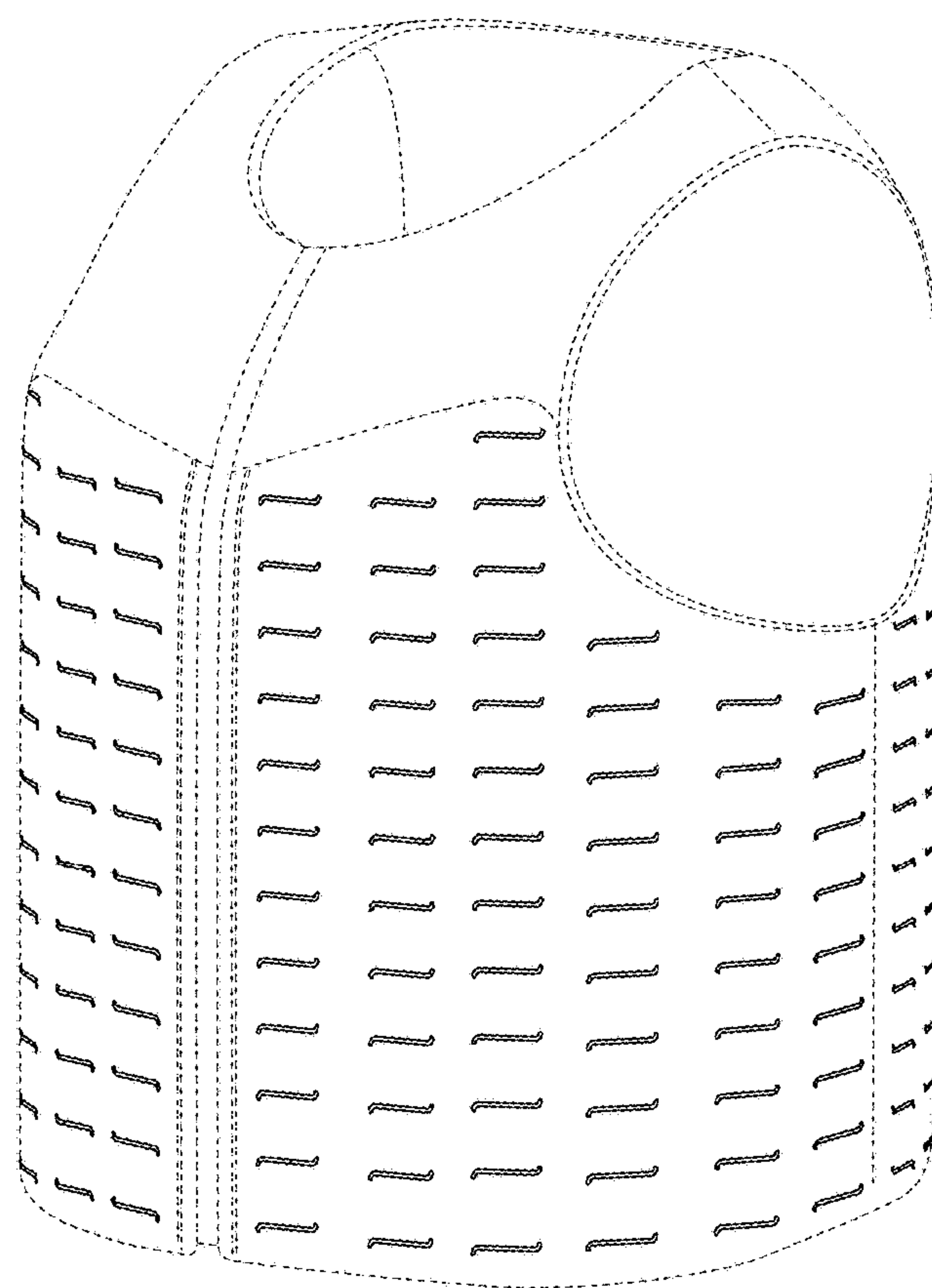

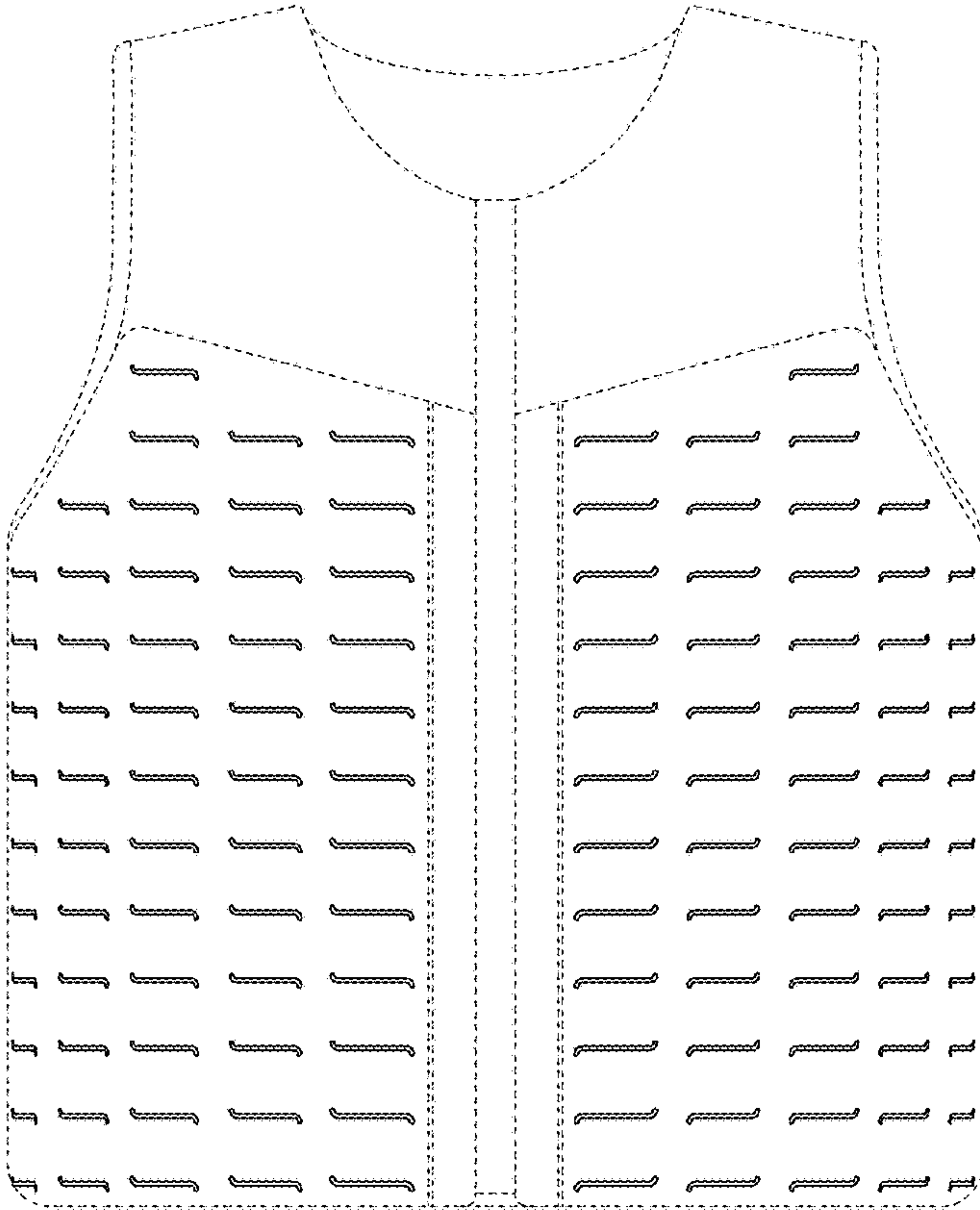

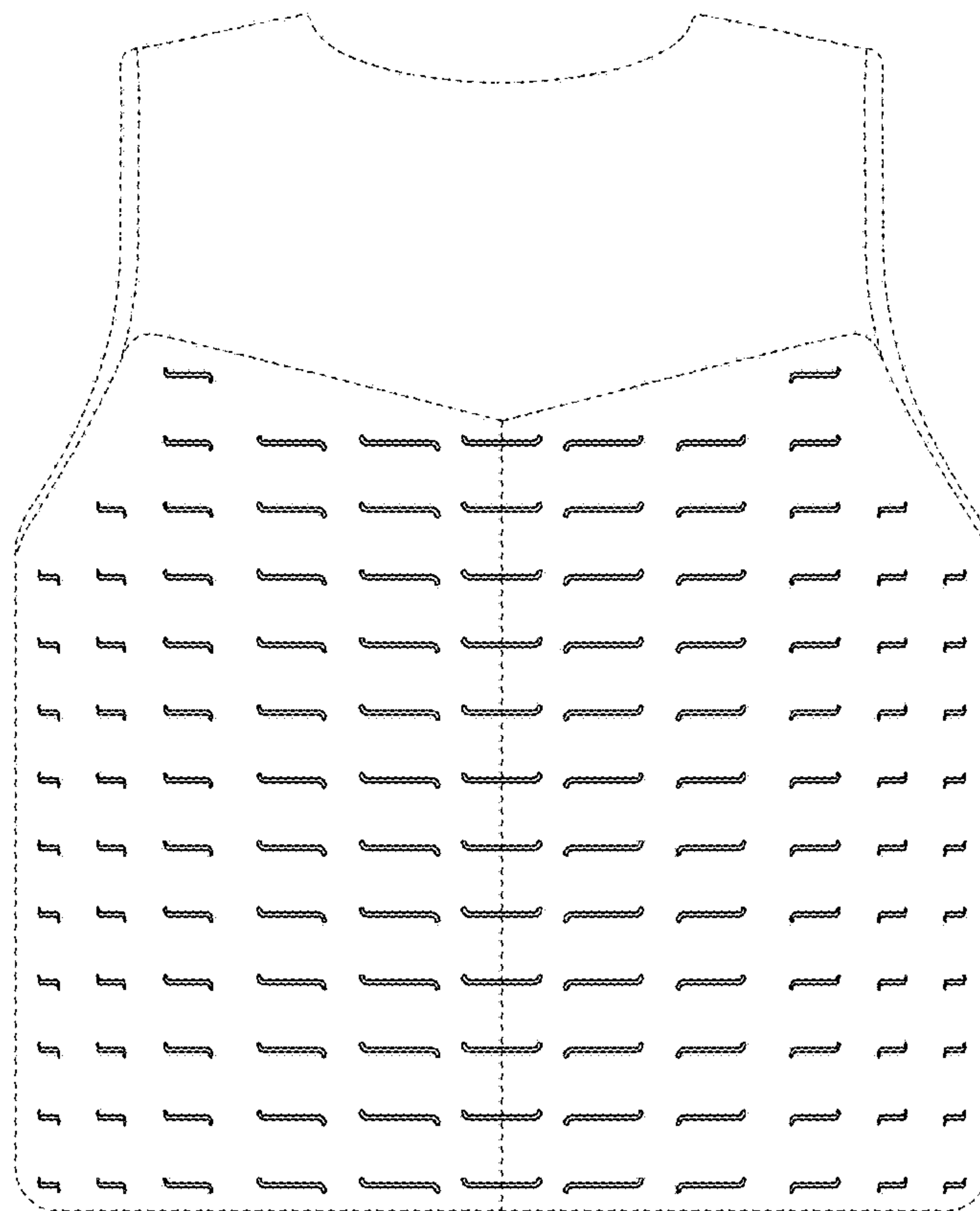

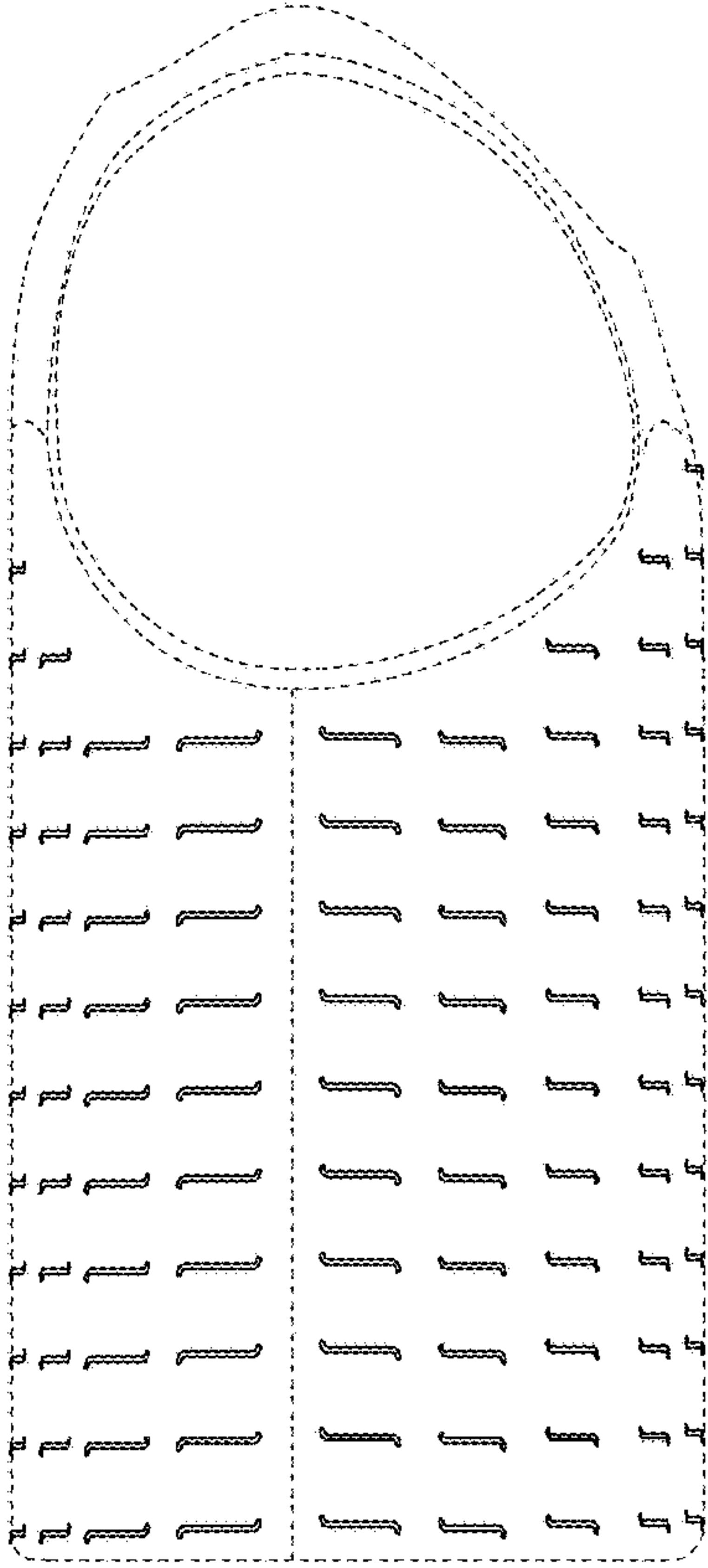

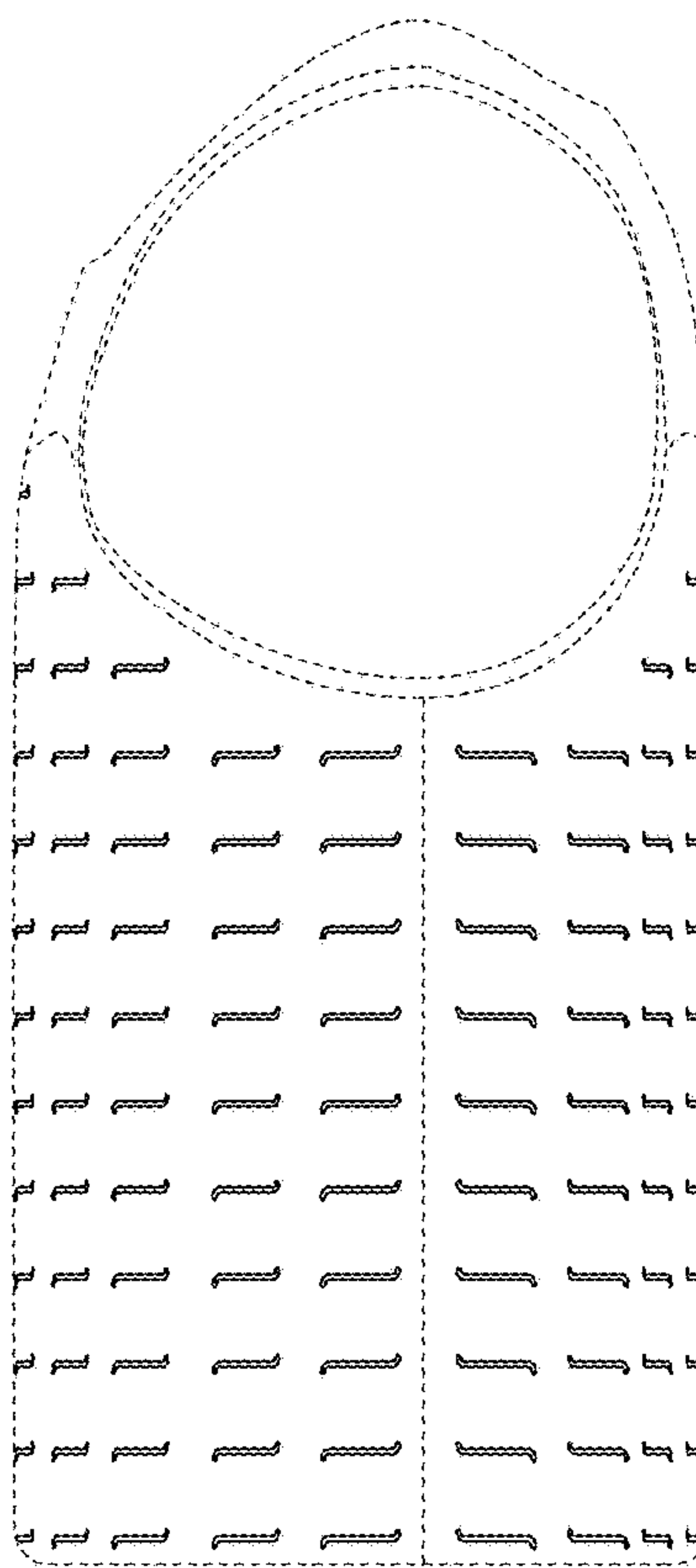

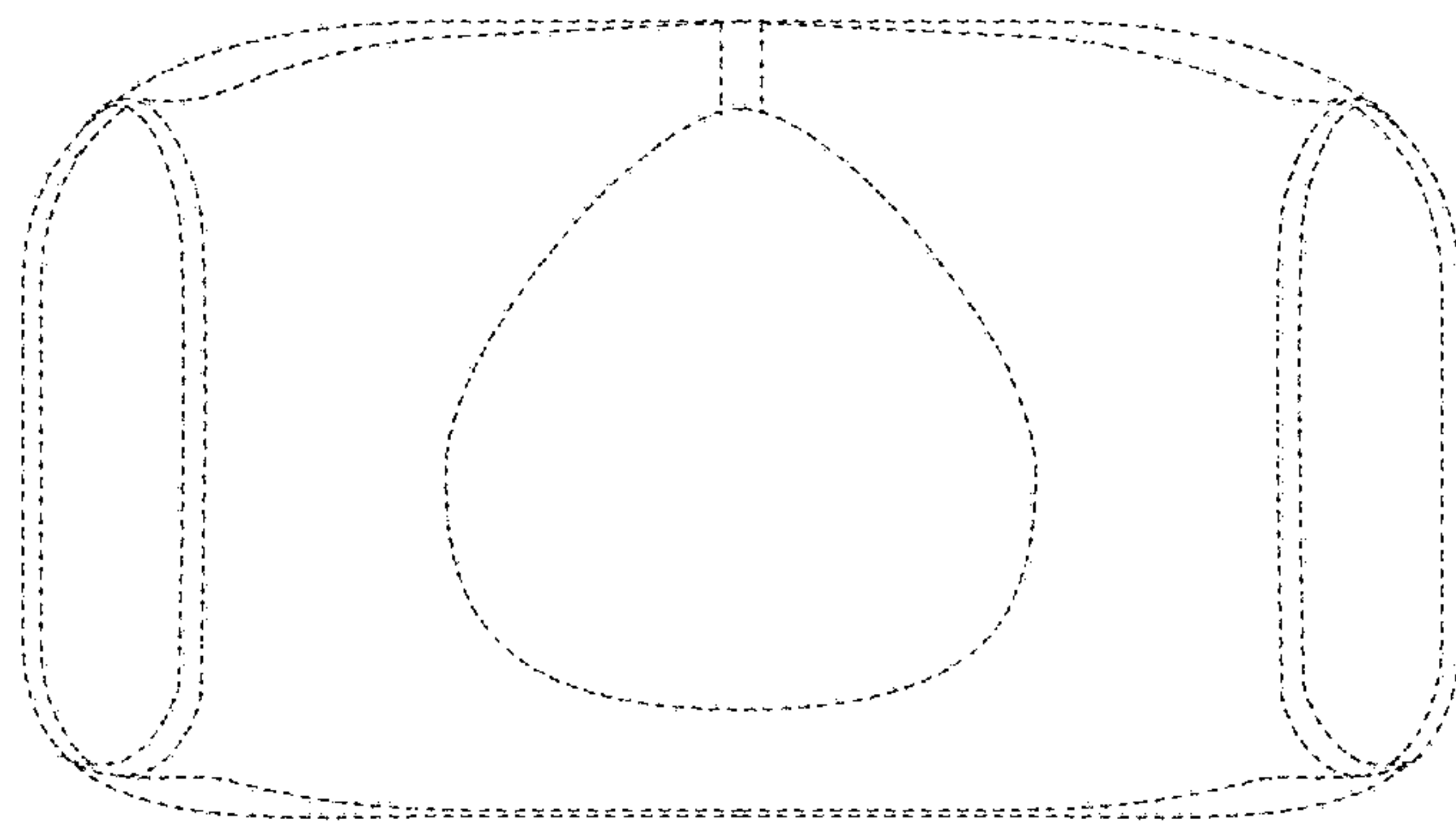

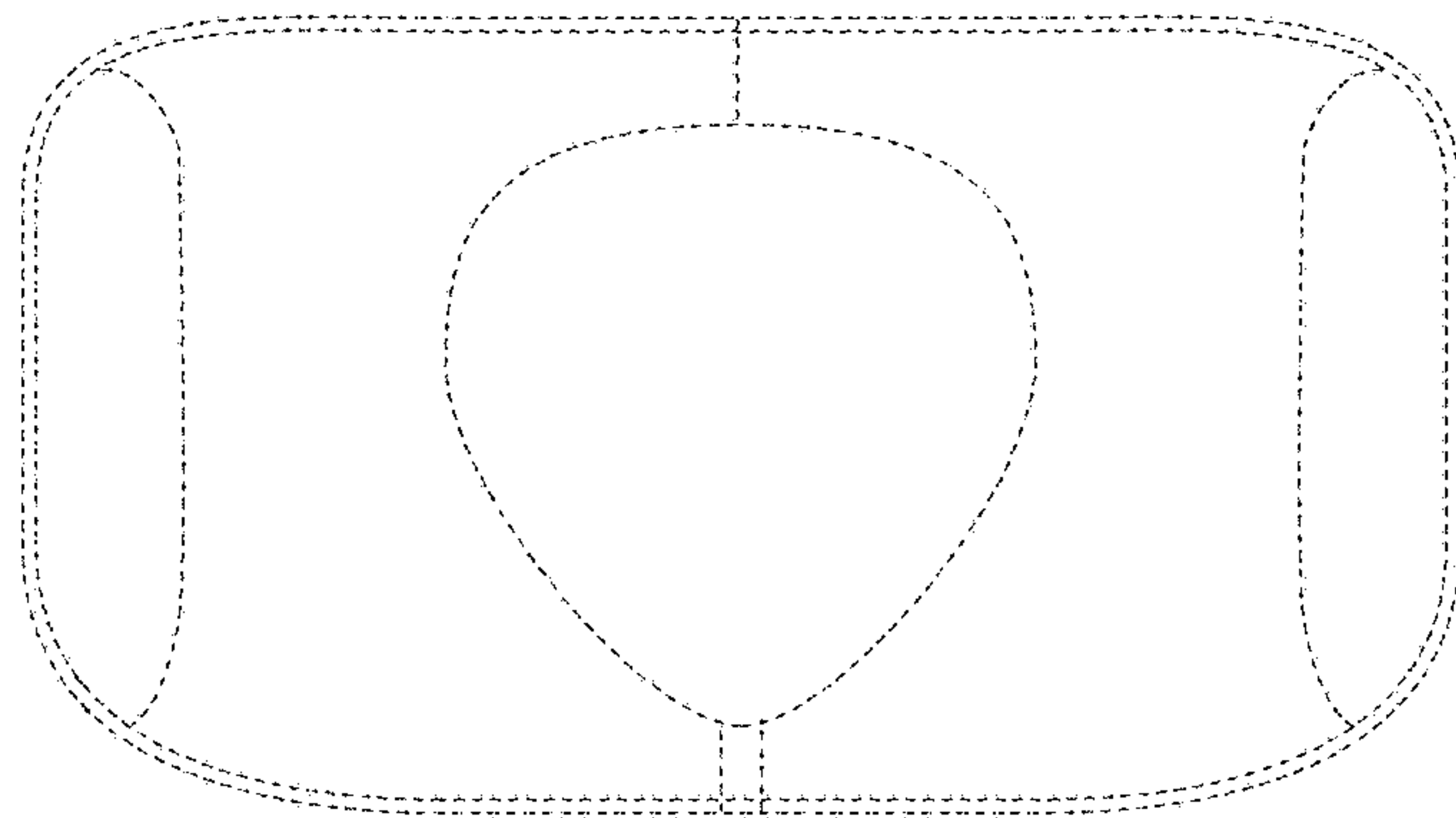

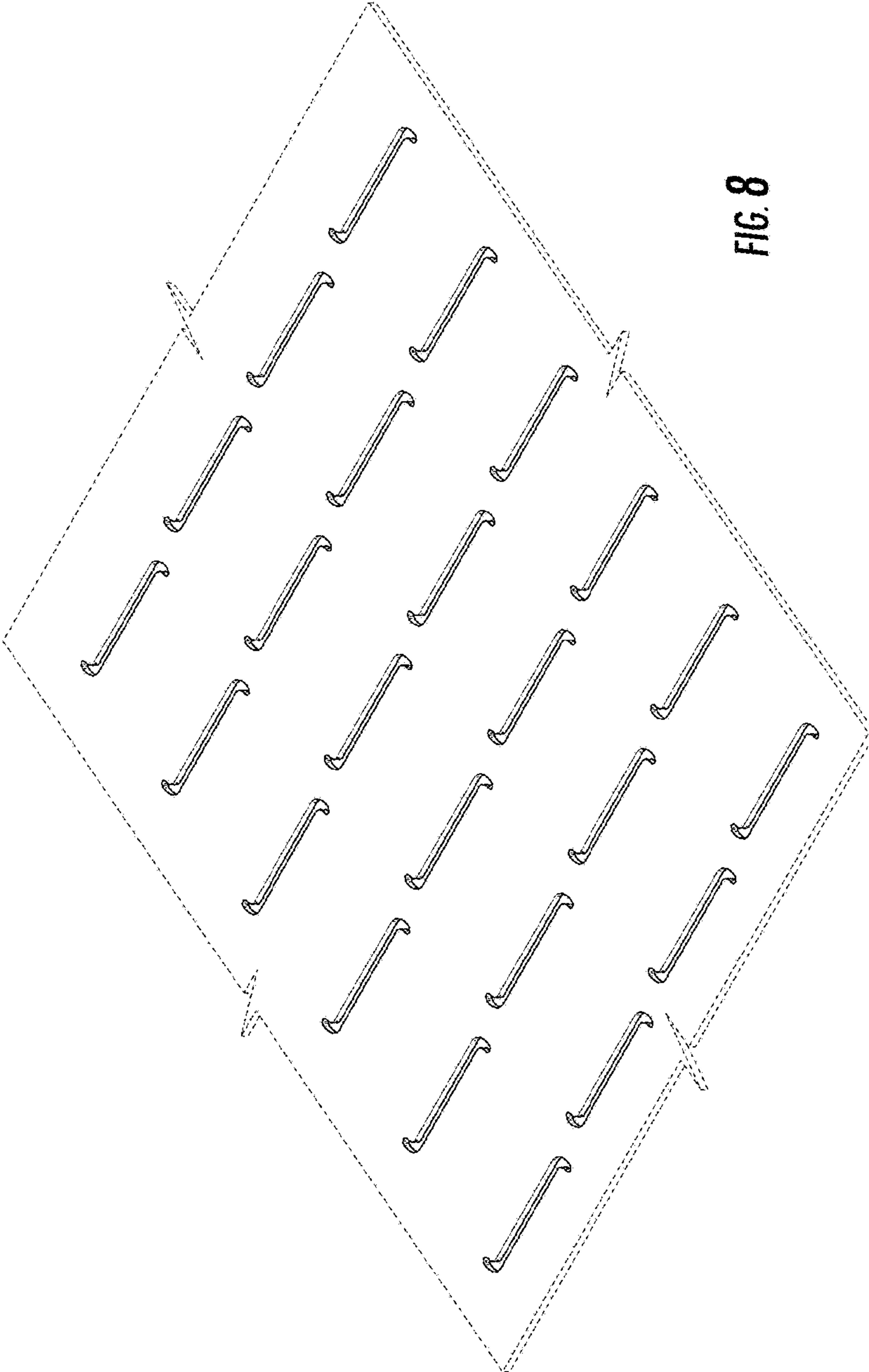

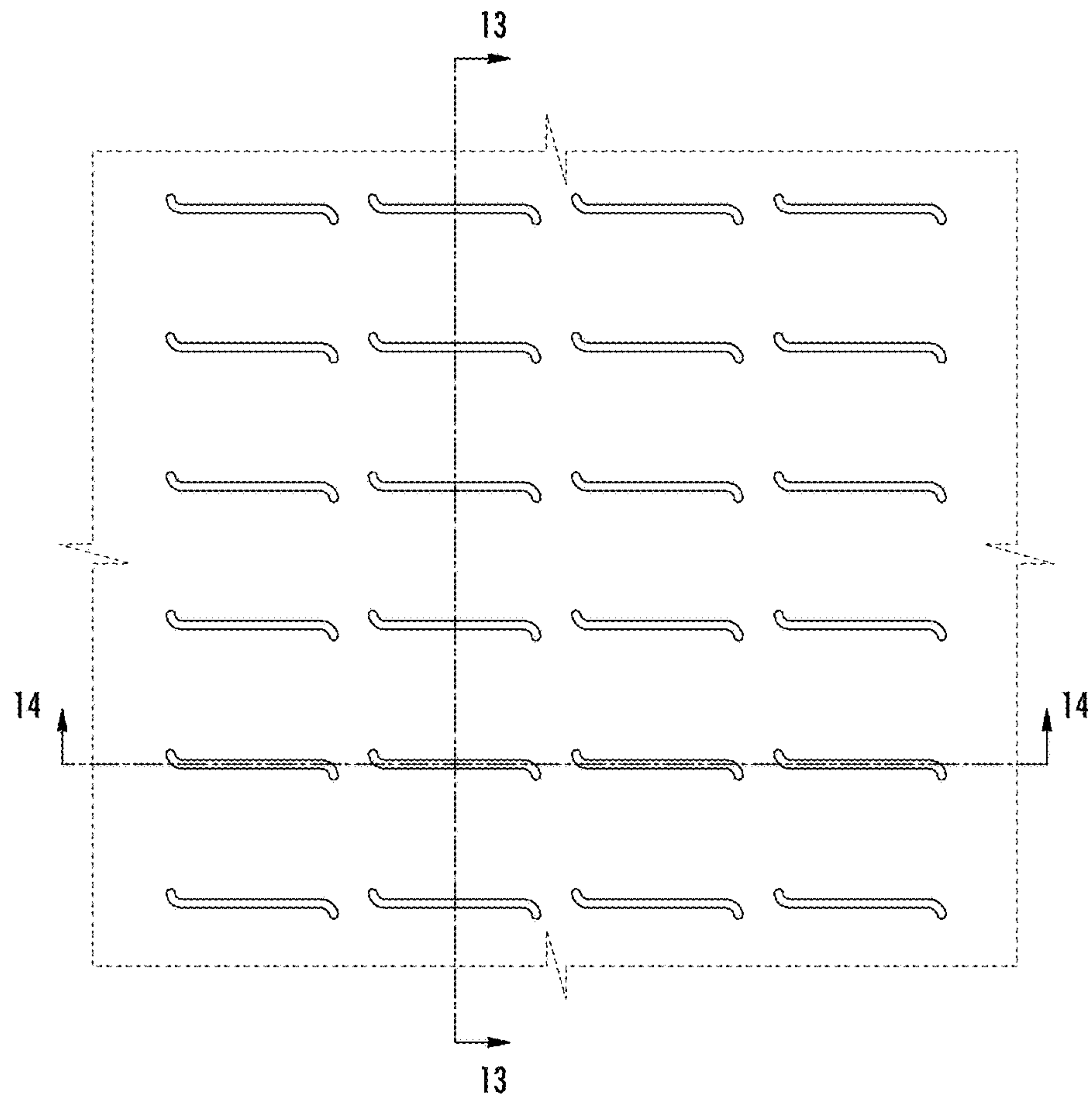

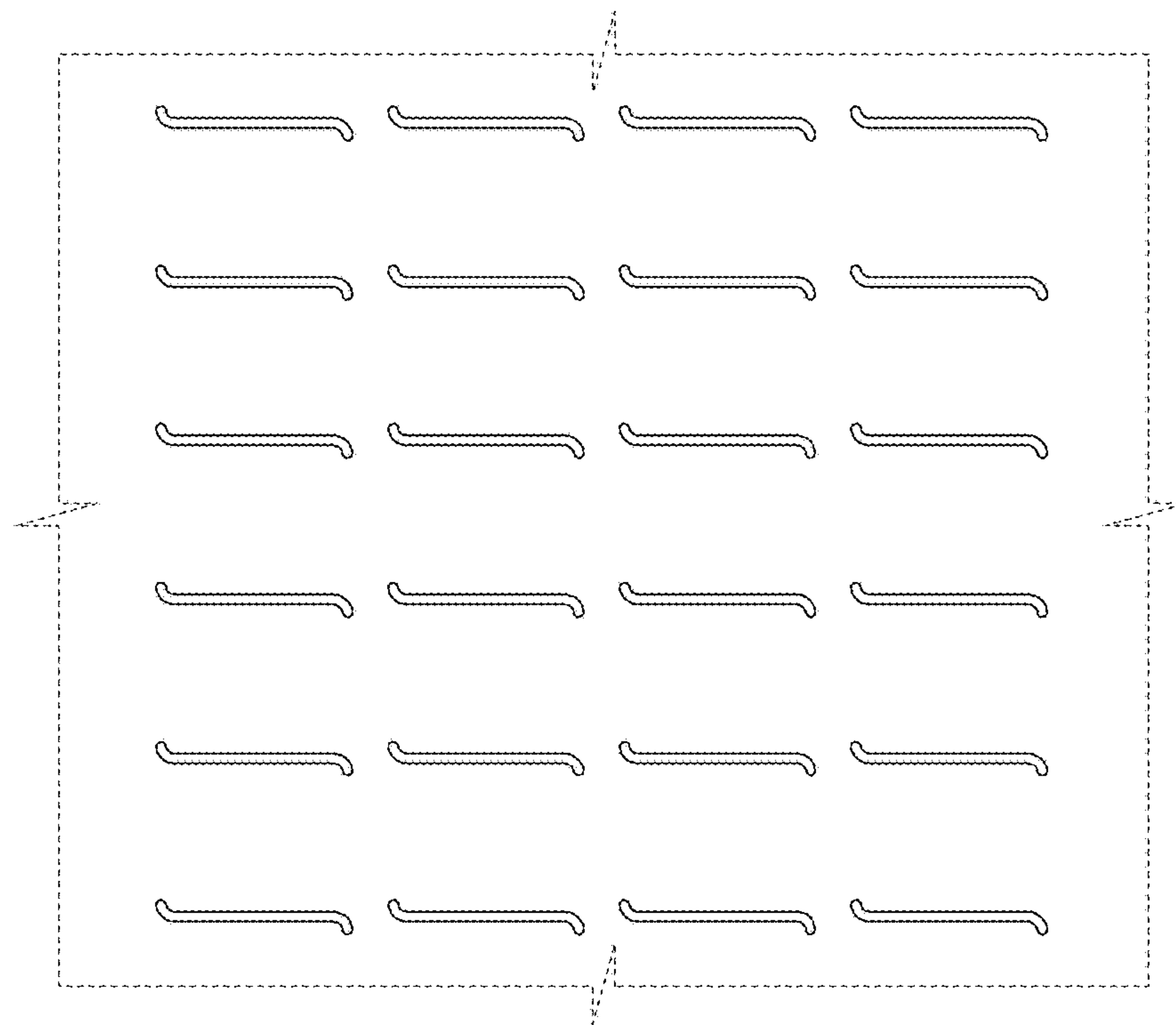

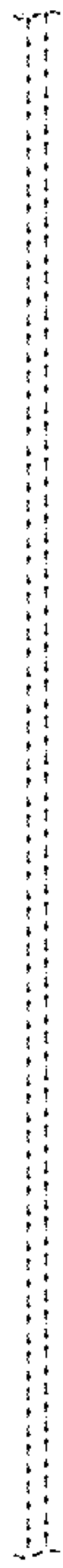

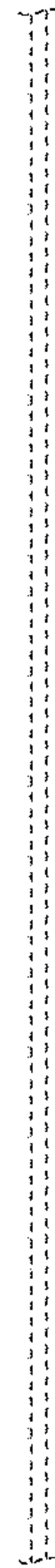

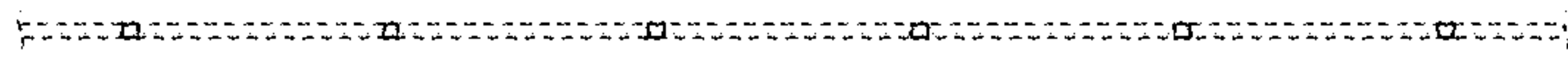

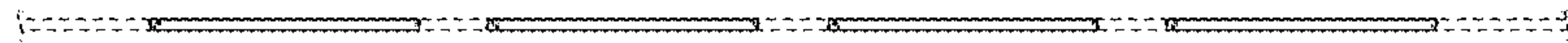
