showing my new design;

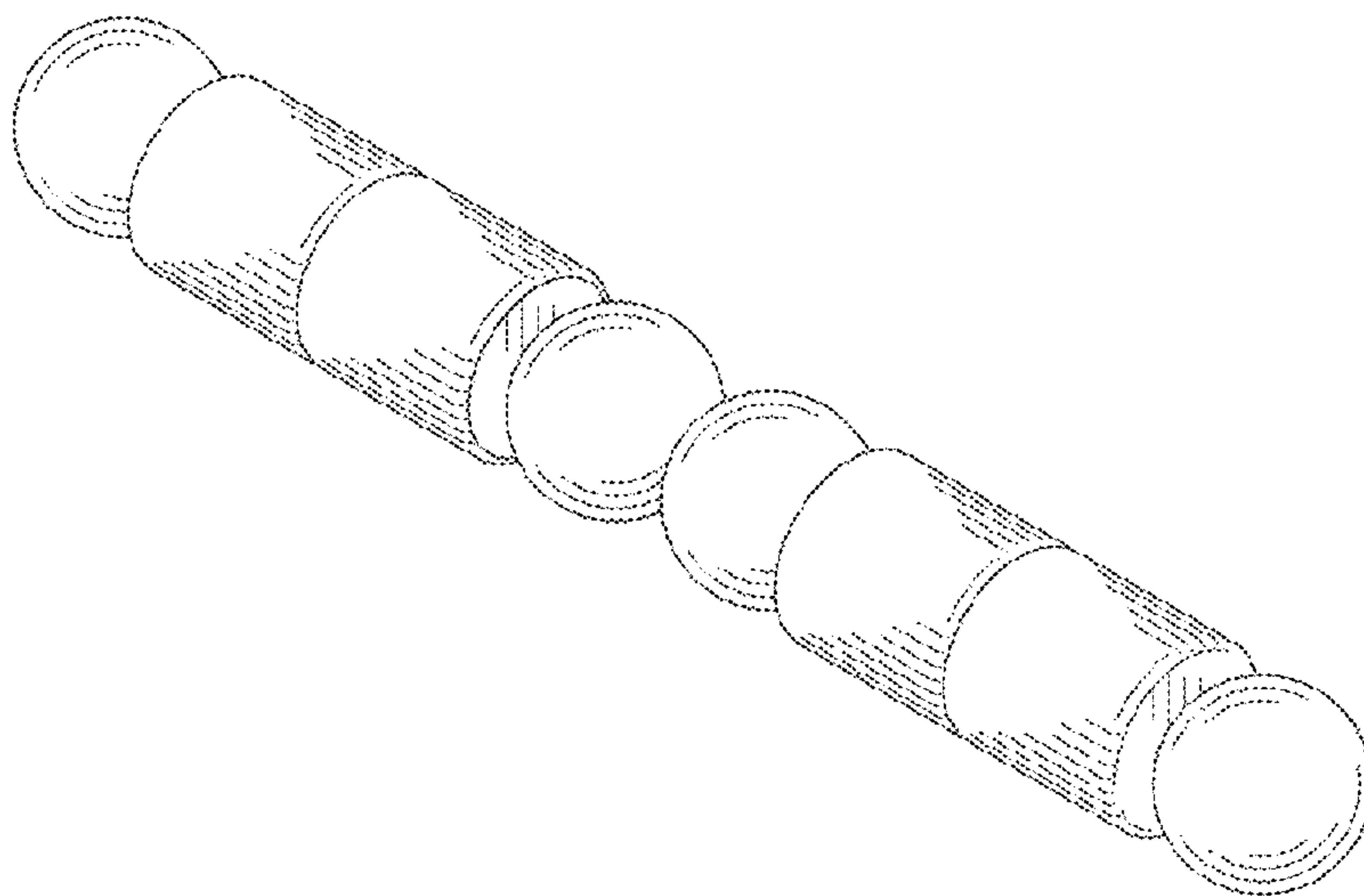
FIG. 2 is a front elevation view thereof, the rear elevation

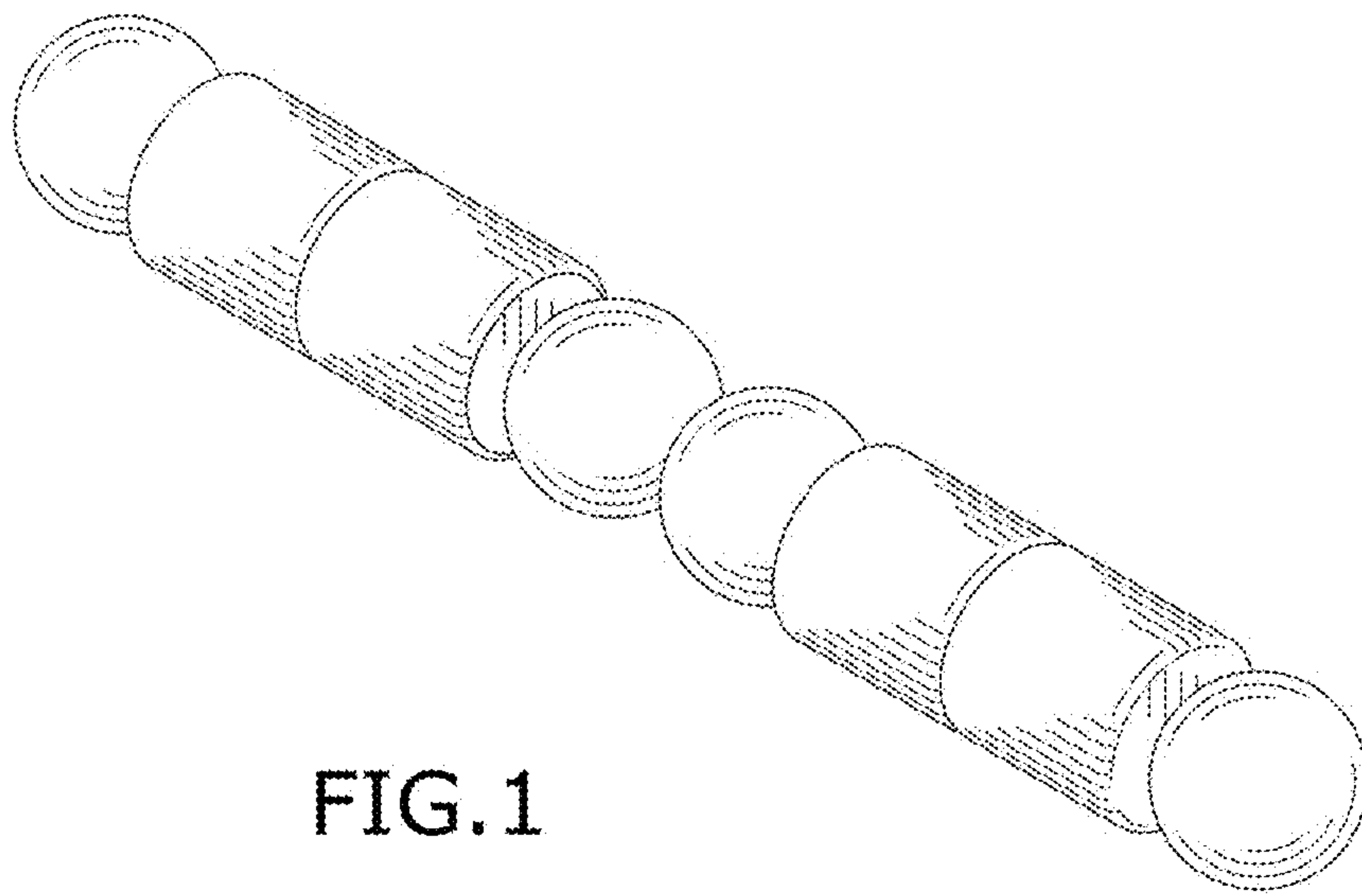

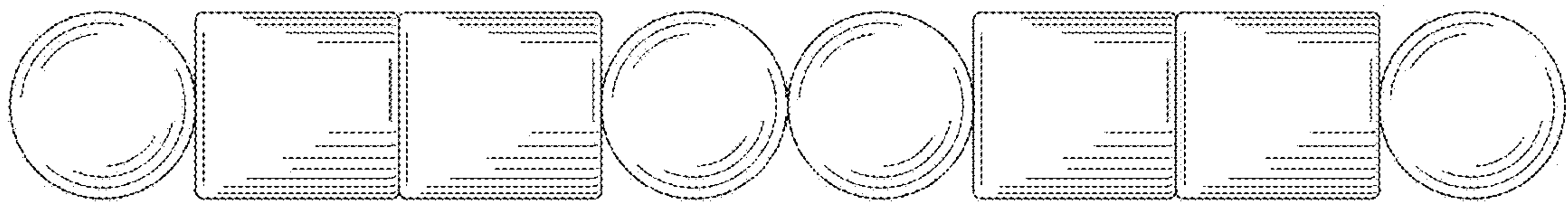

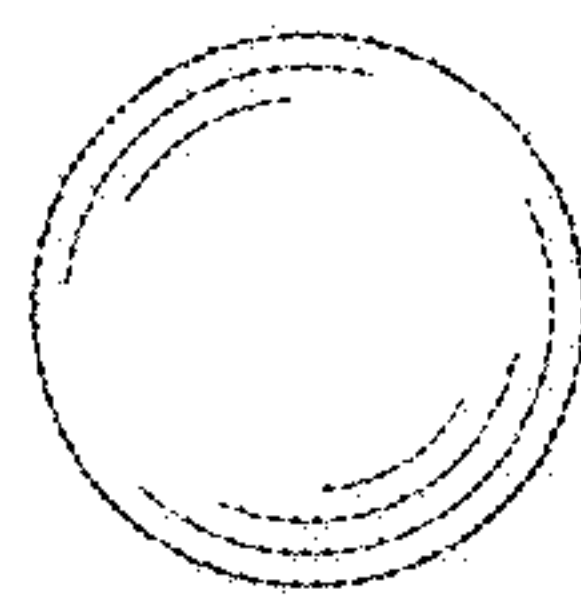

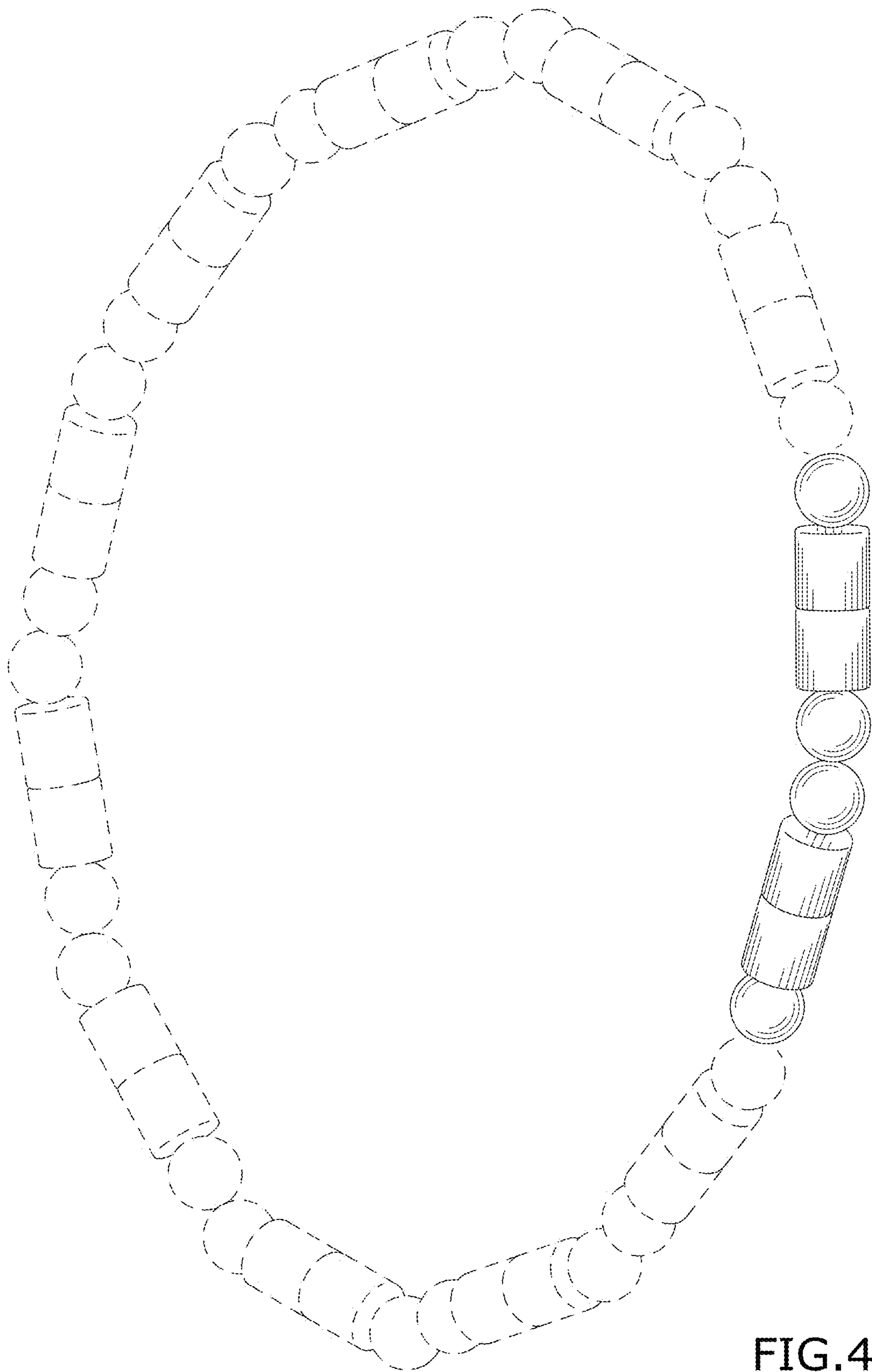
