**DESCRIPTION**

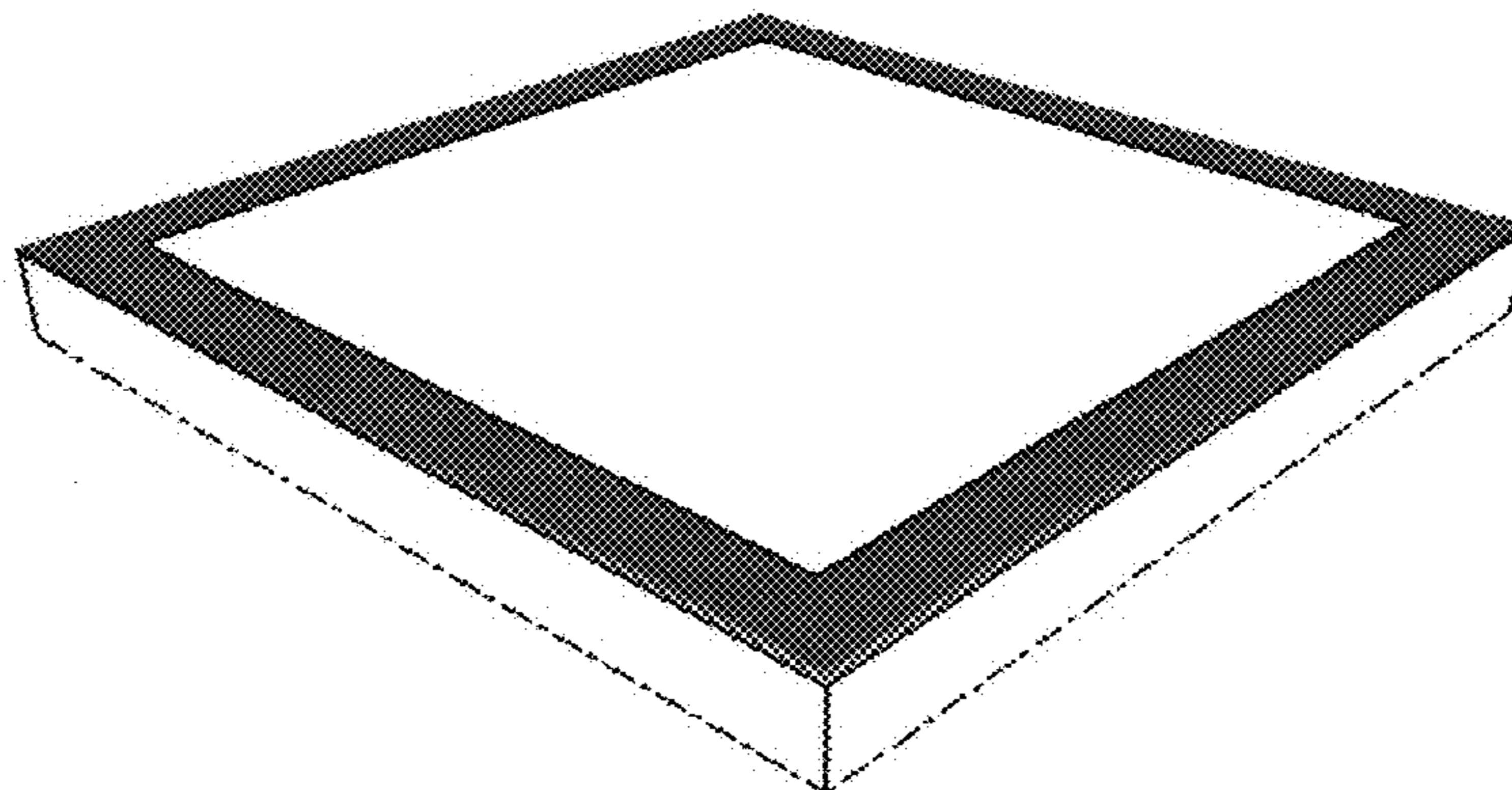

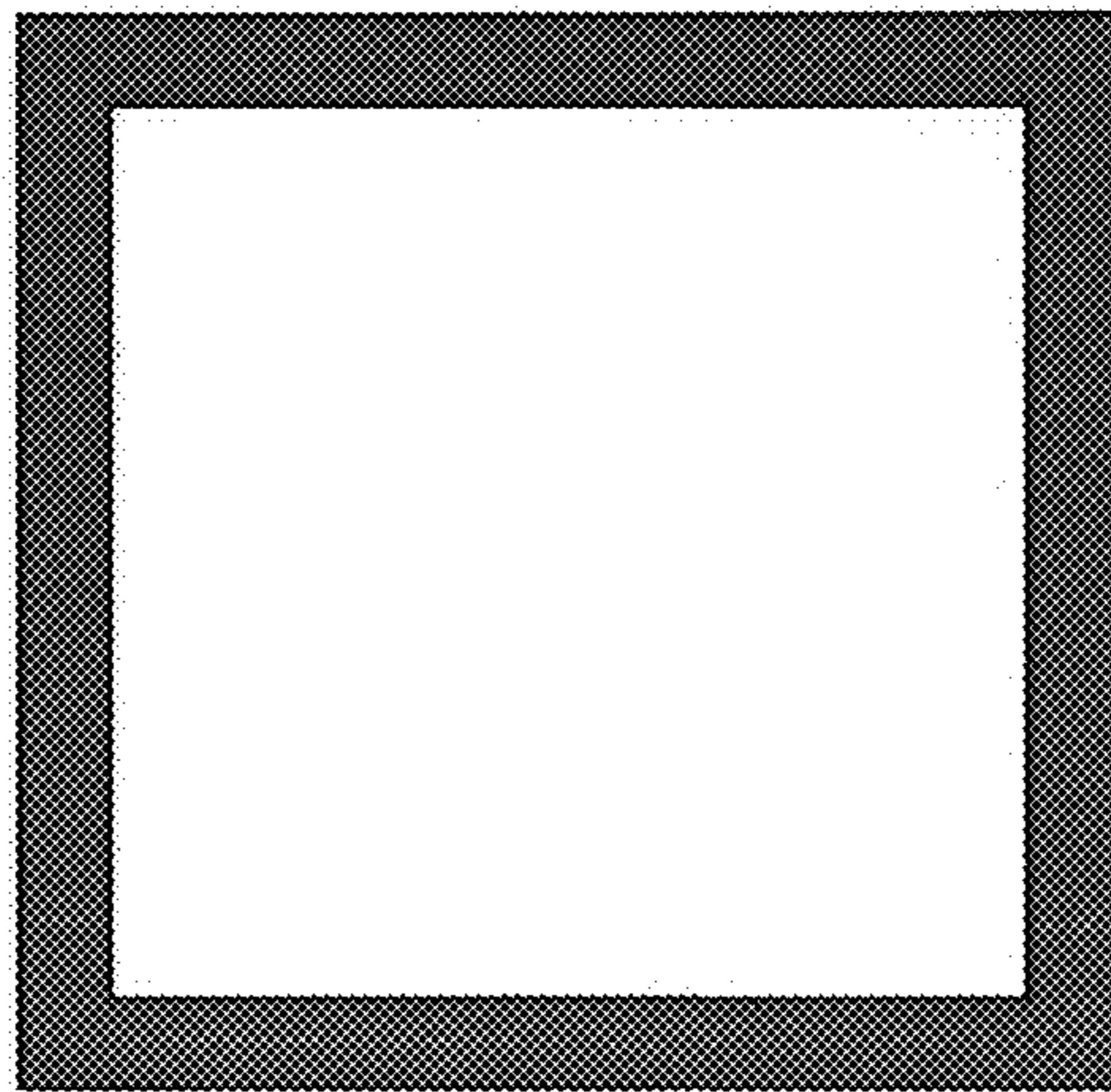

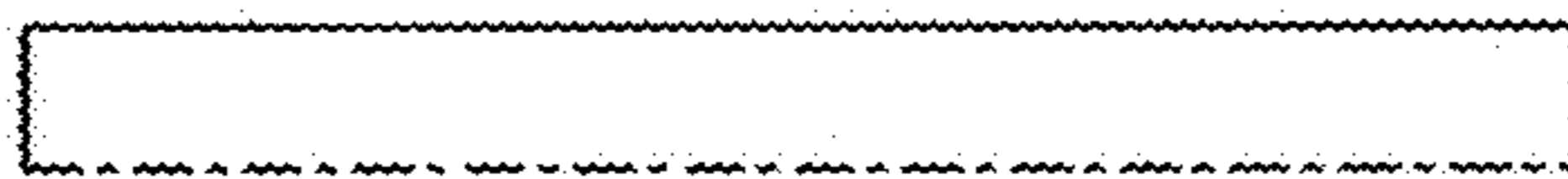
