DESCRIPTION
FIG. 1 is a front and left side perspective view of a first embodiment of a floating platform bed showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a left side elevation view thereof, the right side being a mirror image;
FIG. 4 is a front elevation view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a rear elevation view thereof;
FIG. 6 is a front and left side perspective view of a second embodiment of a floating platform bed showing my new design;
FIG. 7 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 8 is a left side elevation view thereof;
FIG. 9 is a front elevation view thereof;
FIG. 10 is a rear elevation view thereof;
FIG. 11 is a front and left side perspective view of a third embodiment of floating platform bed showing my new design;
FIG. 12 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 13 is a left side elevation view thereof;
FIG. 14 is a front elevation view thereof; and,
FIG. 15 is a rear elevation view thereof.
The broken lines show environmental subject matter and form no part of the claimed design.
The floating platform bed is shown with a symbolic break in its width and in its length. The appearance of any portion of the article between the break lines forms no part of the claimed design.

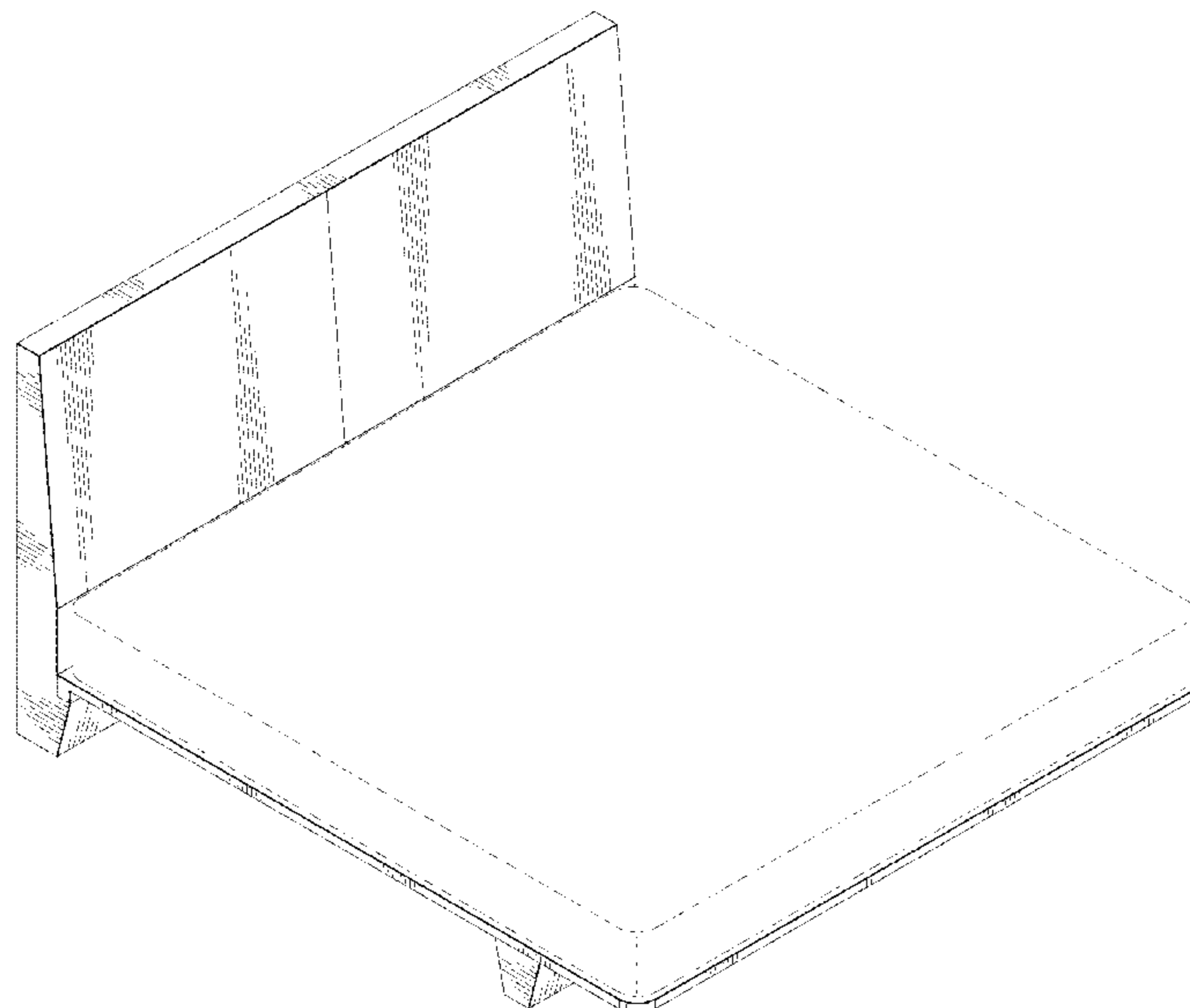
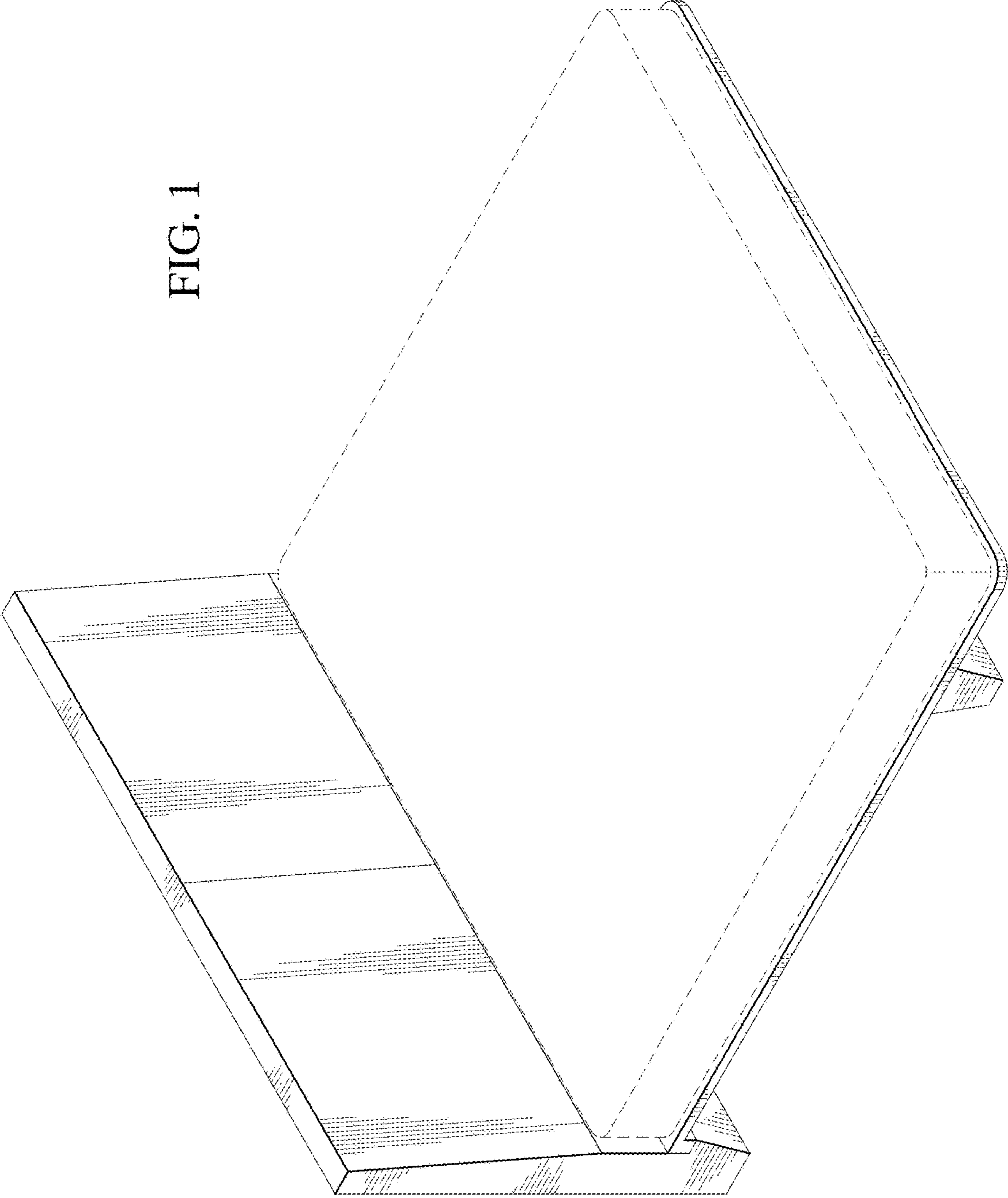

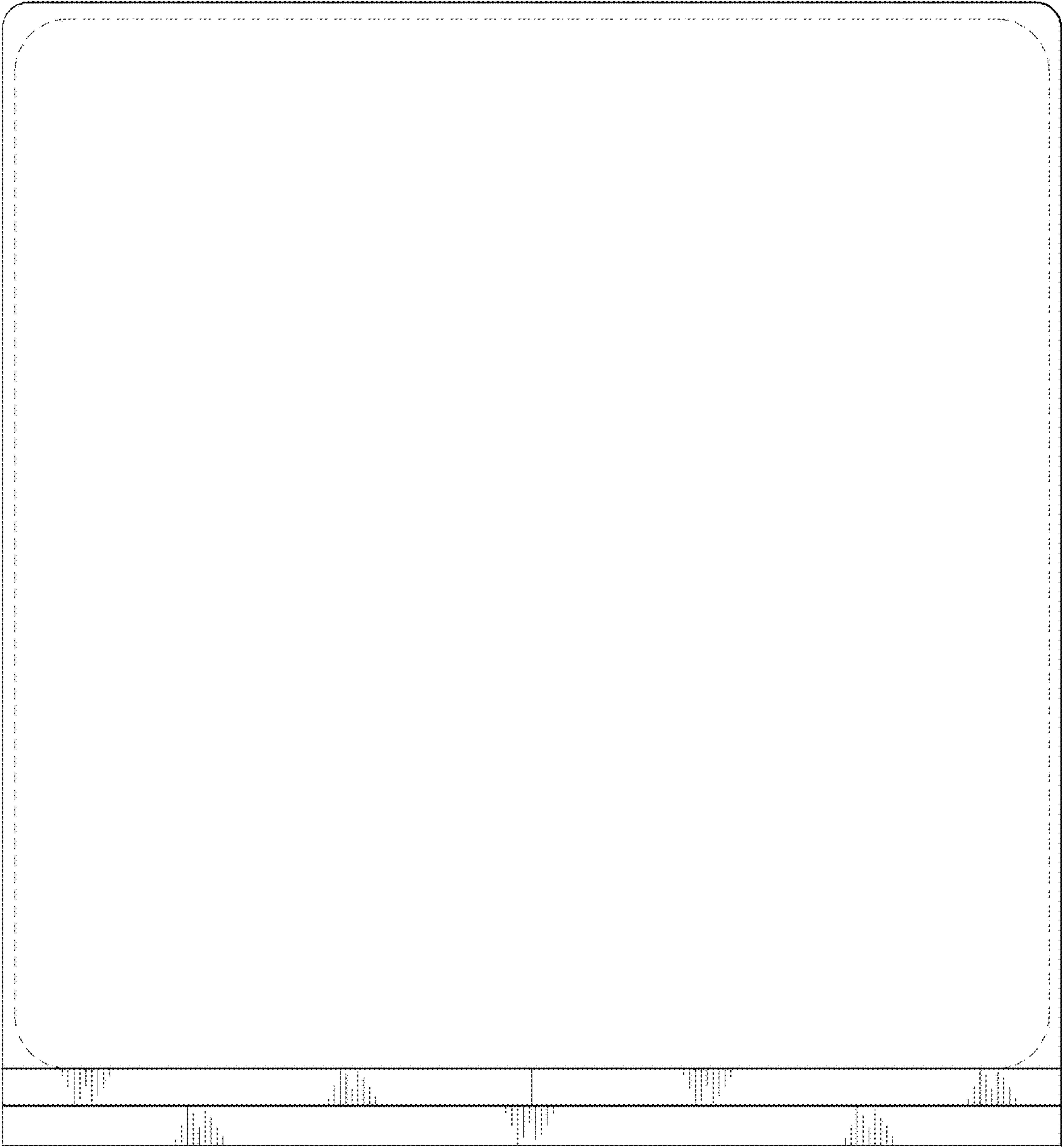

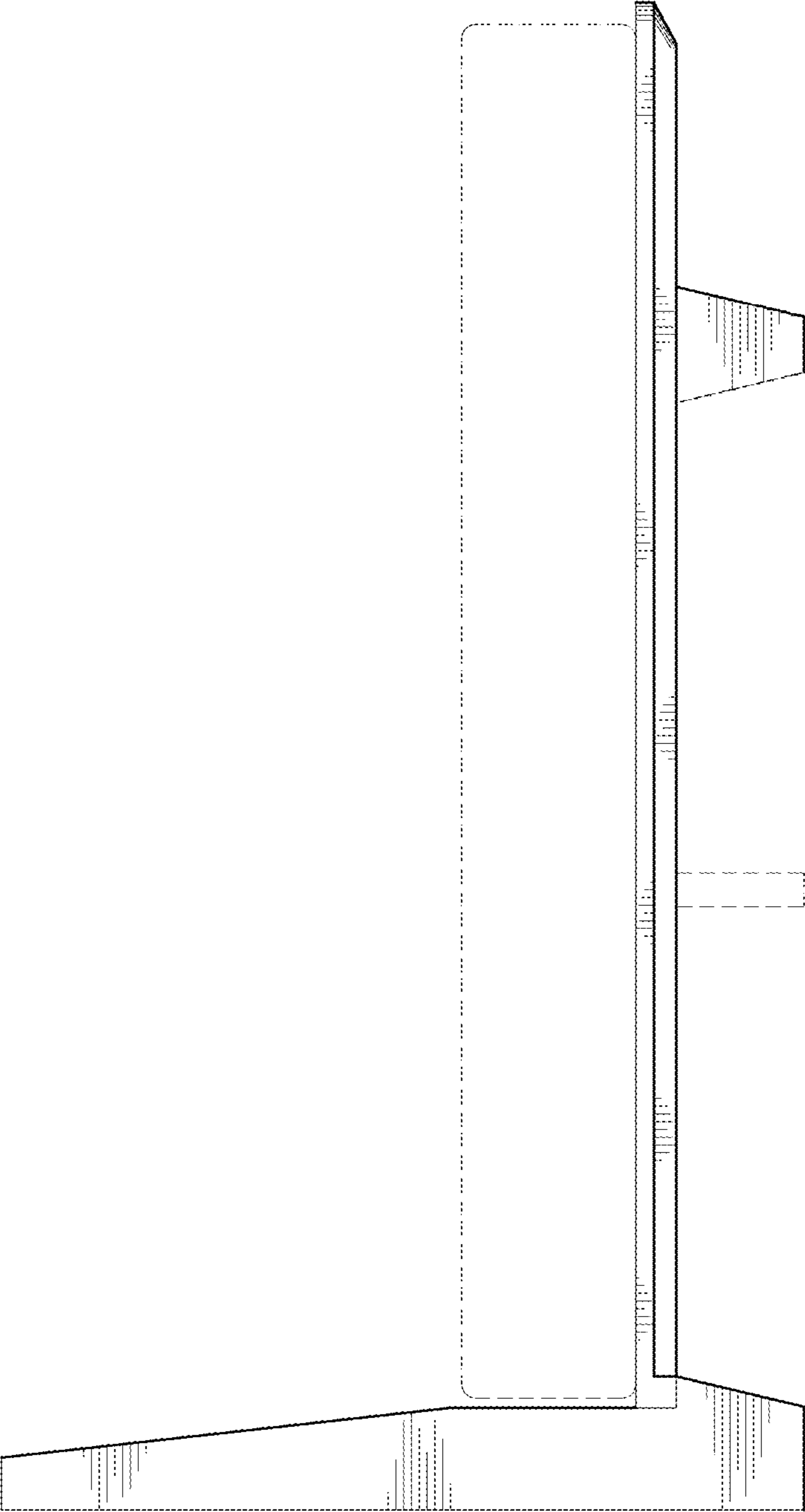

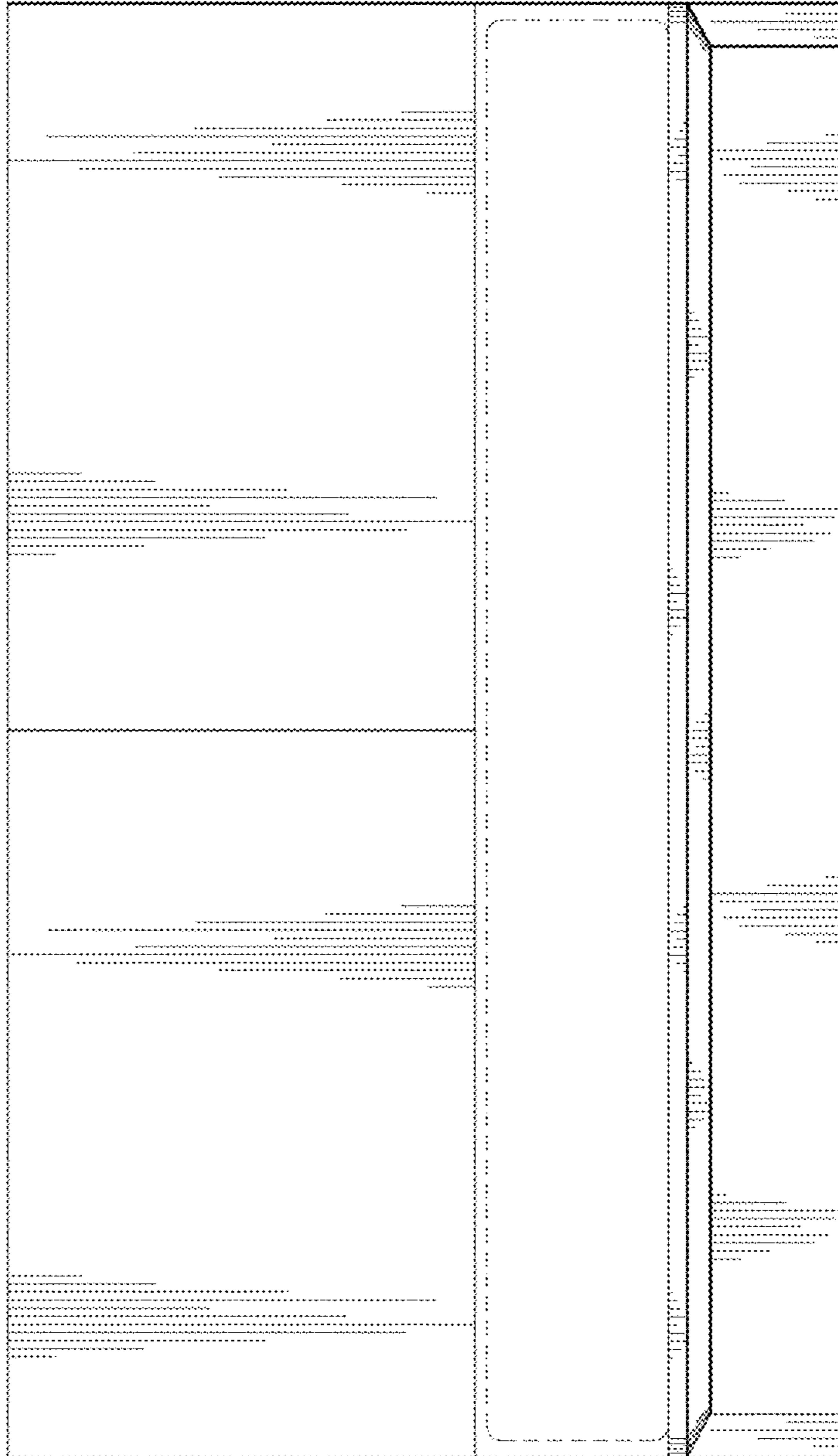

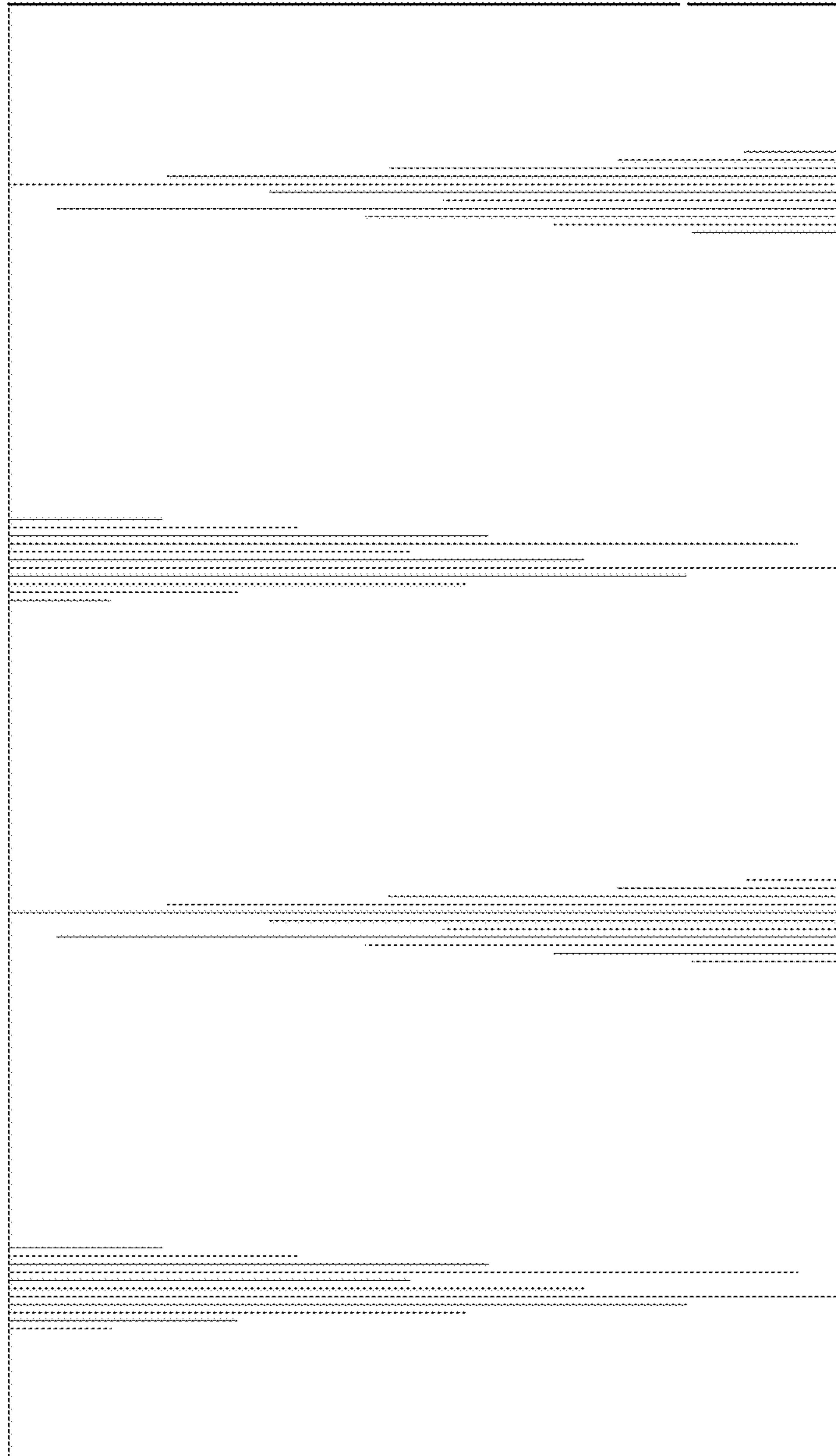
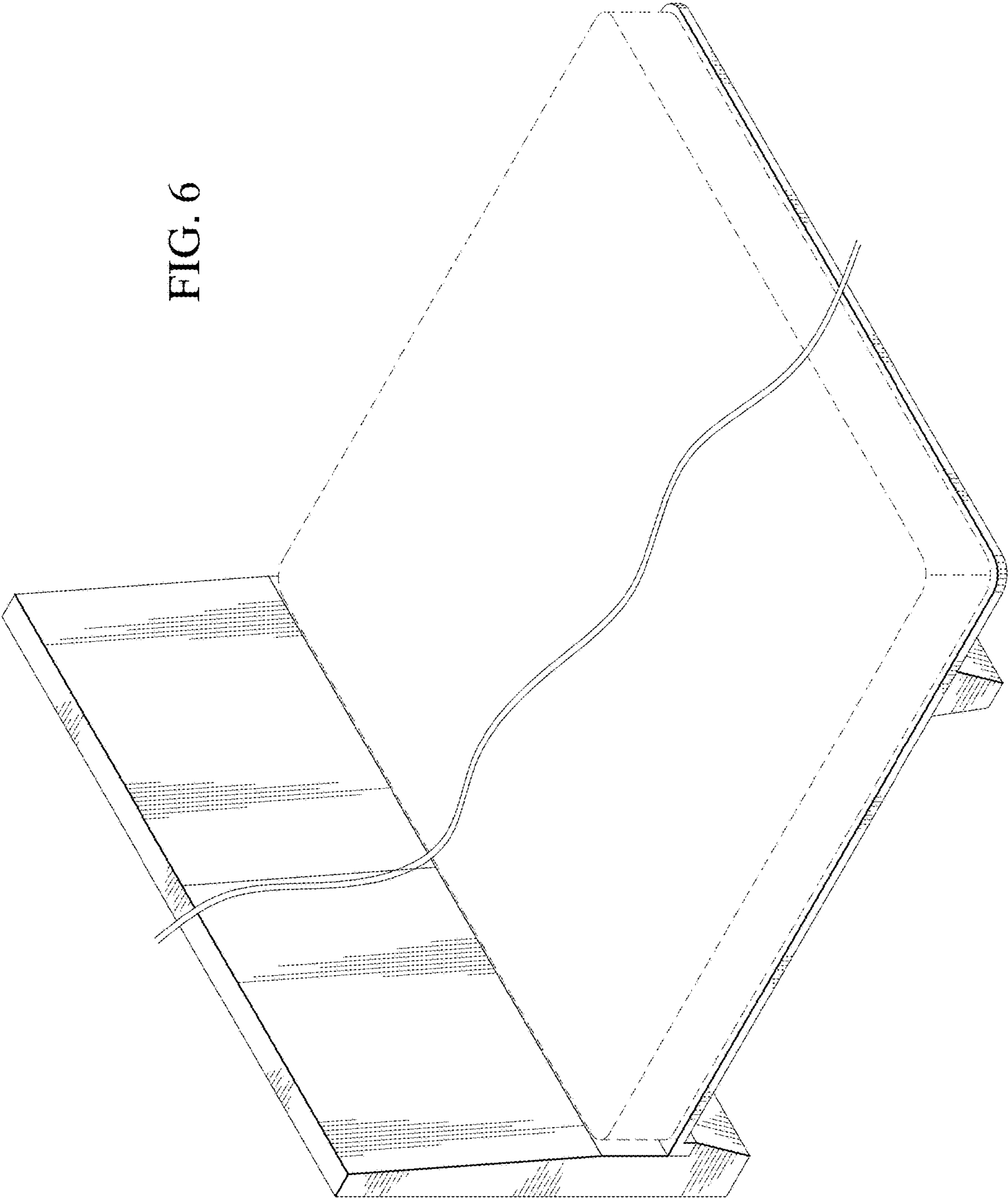

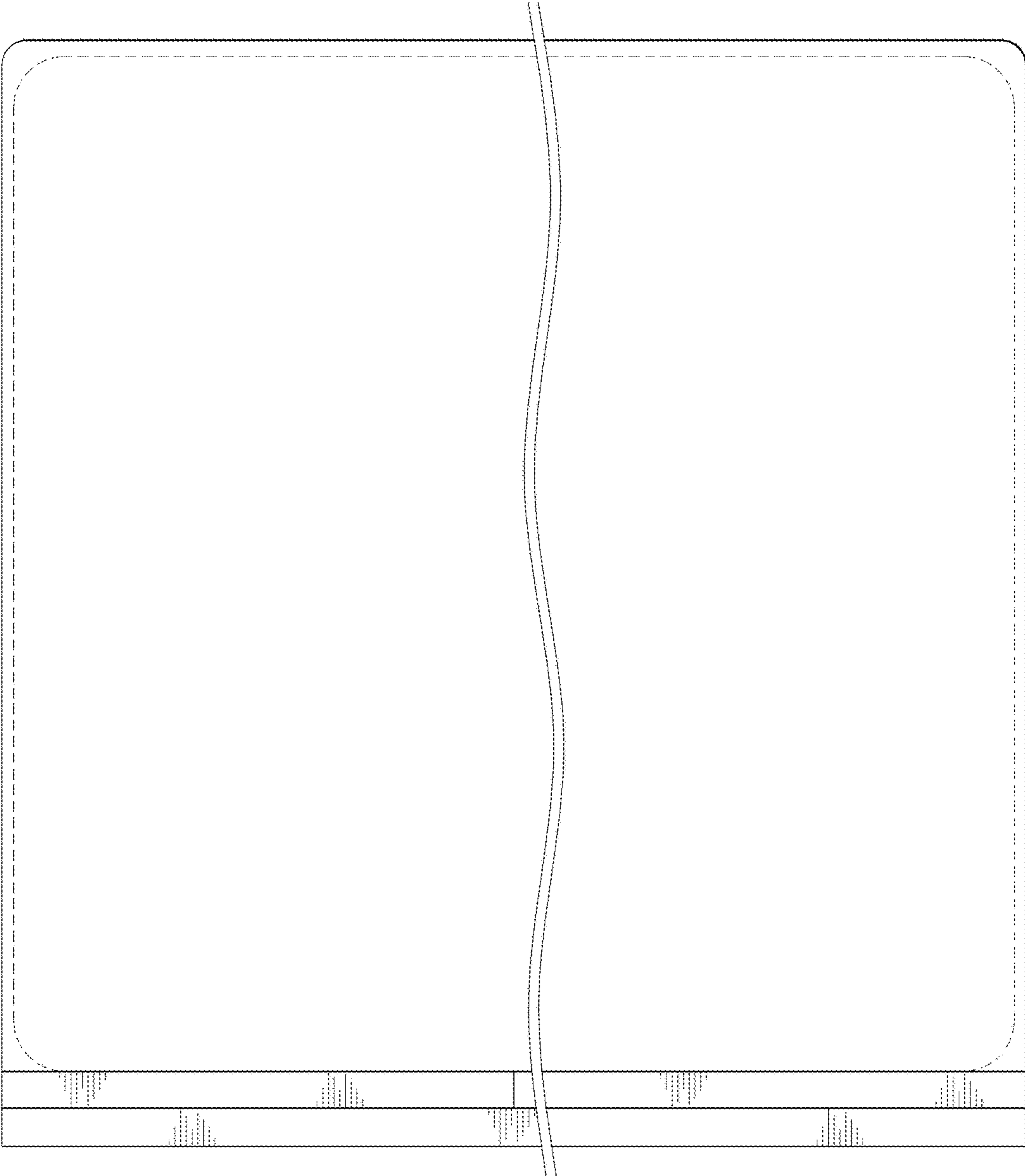

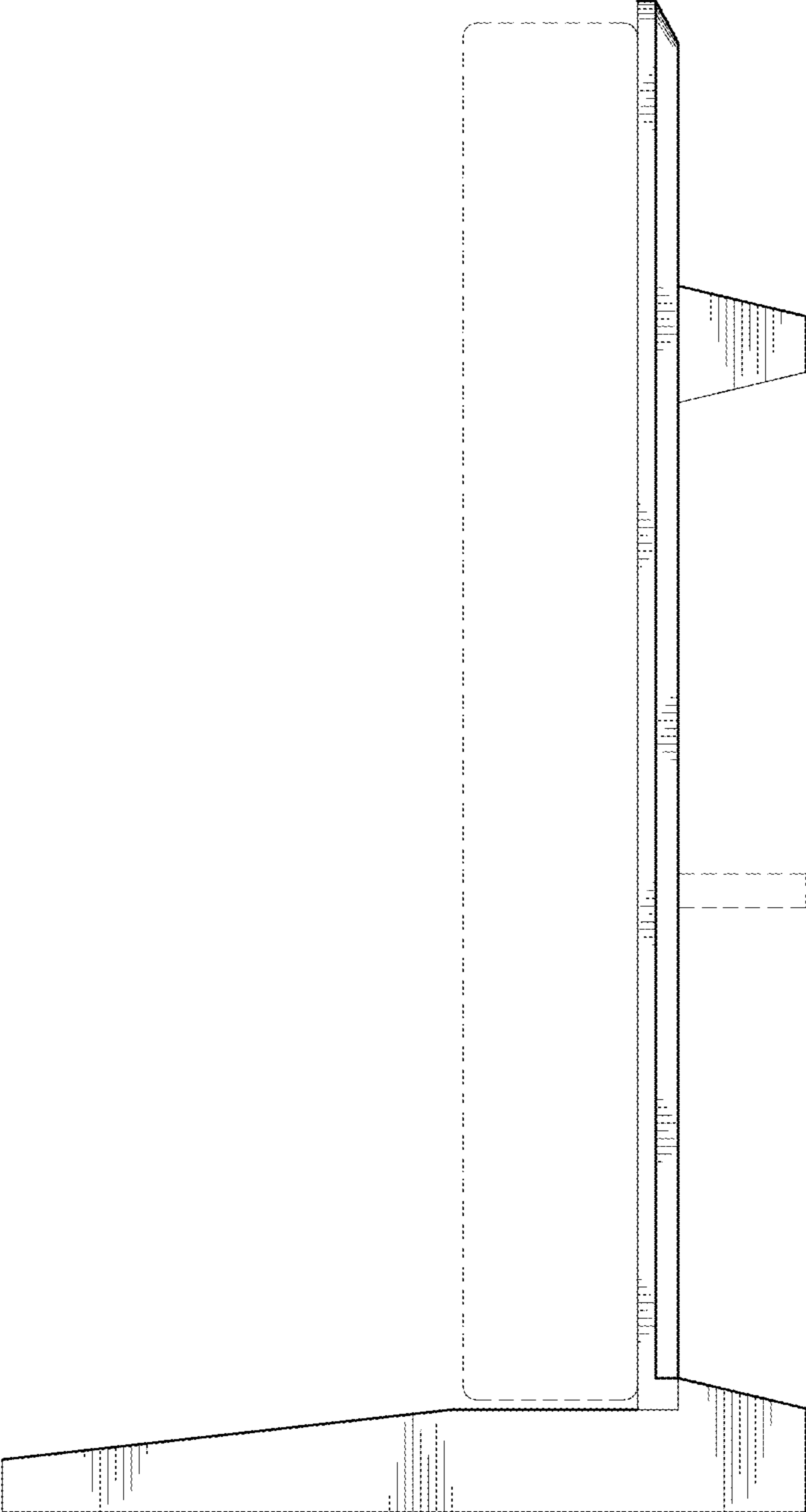

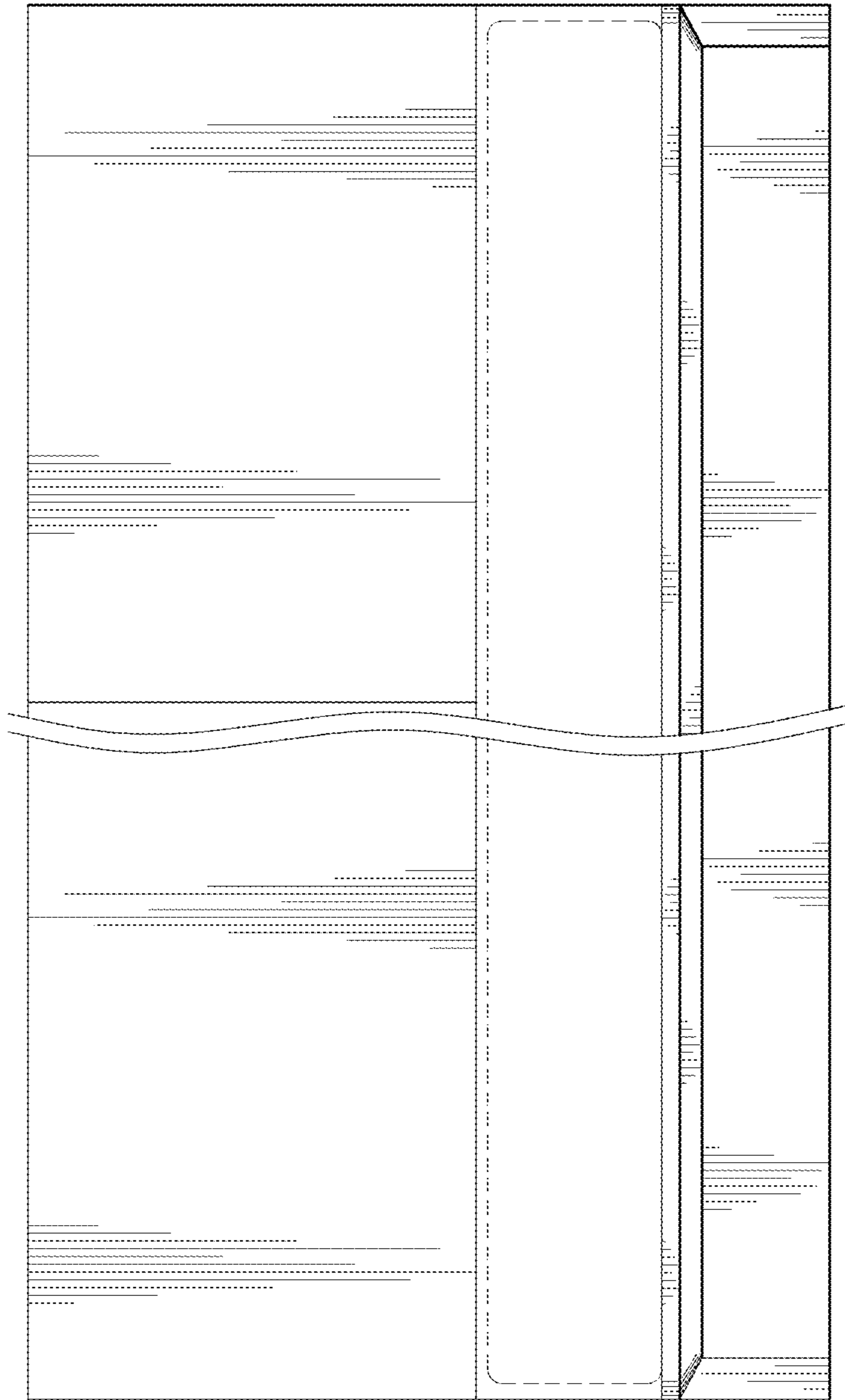

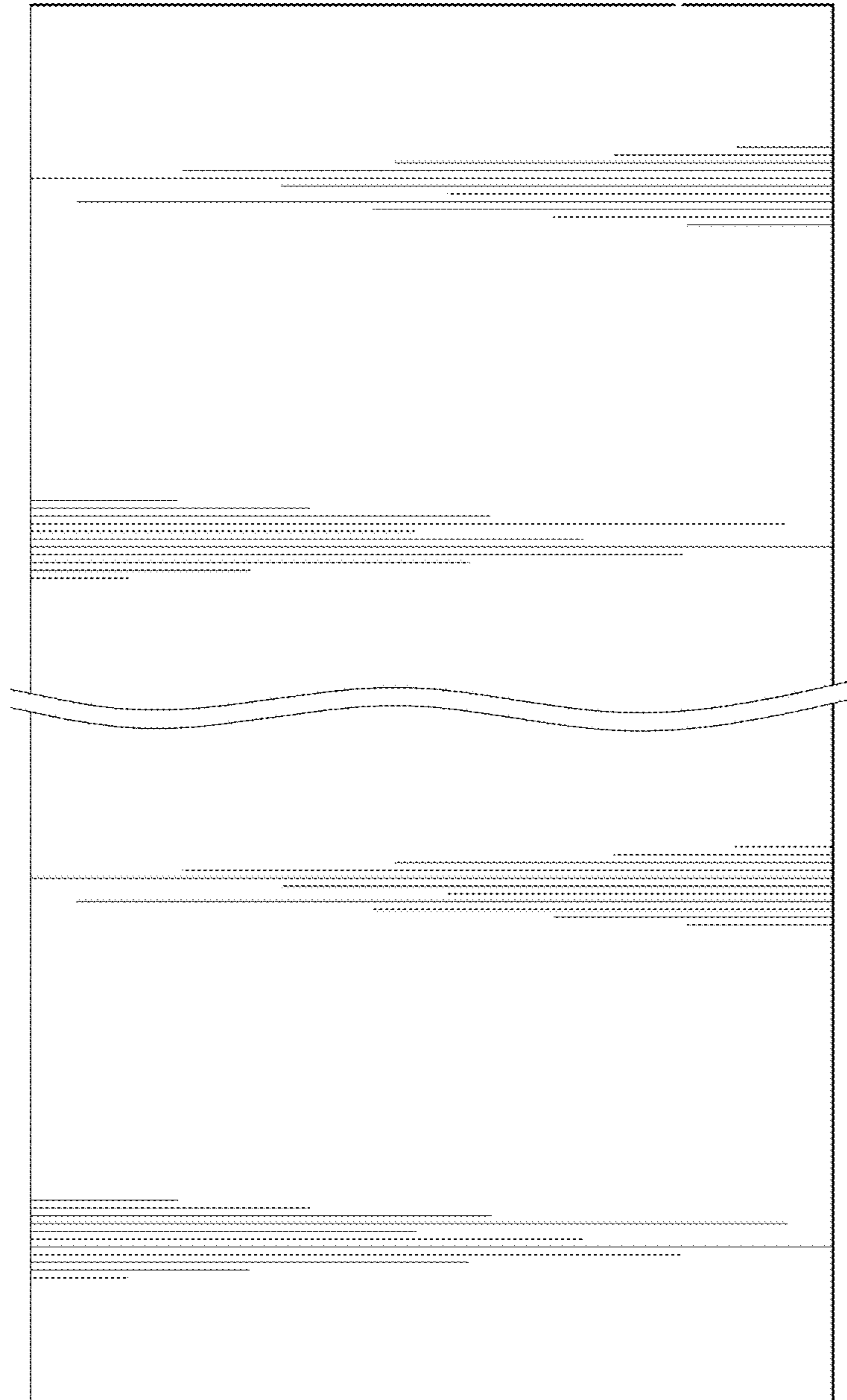
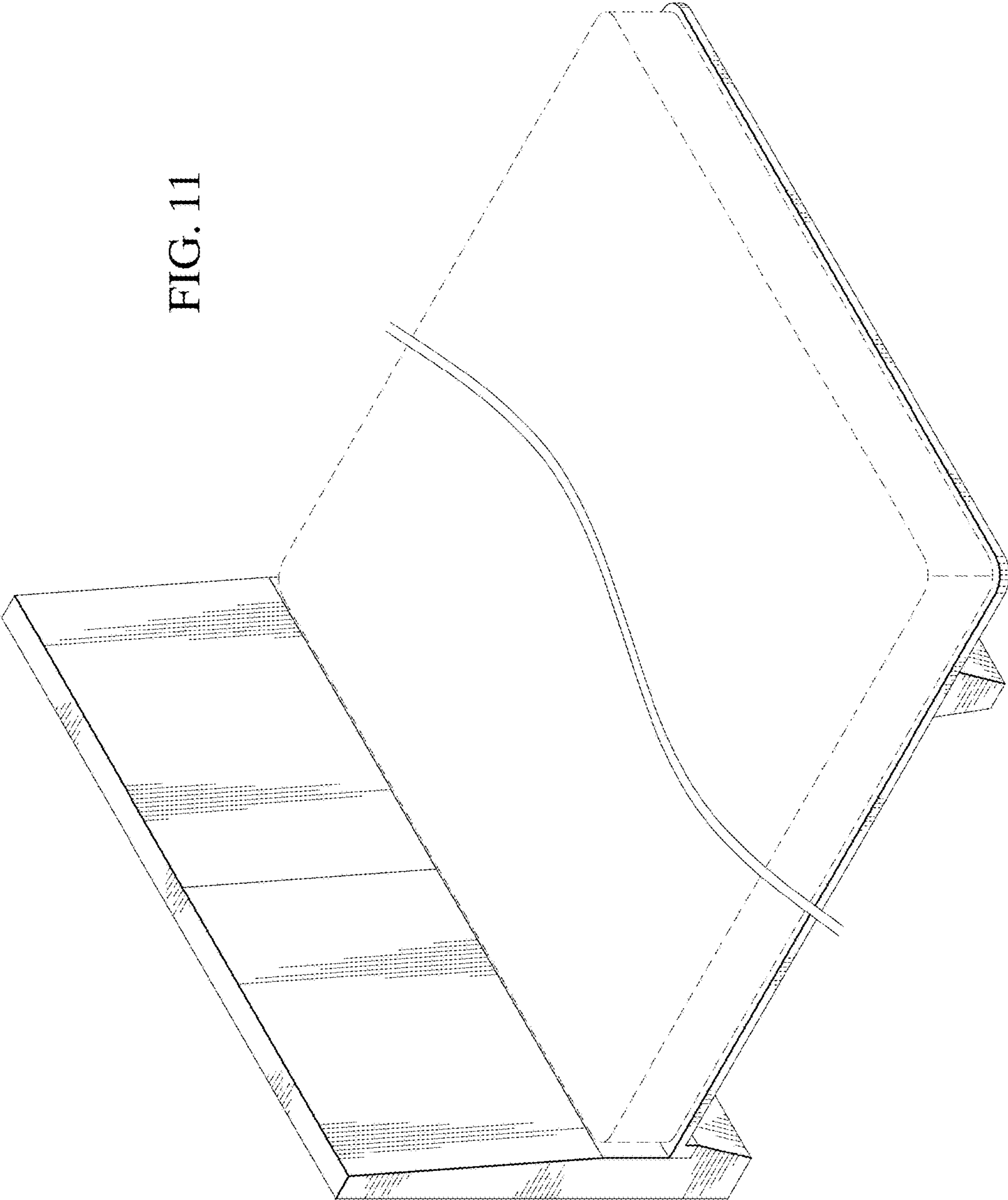

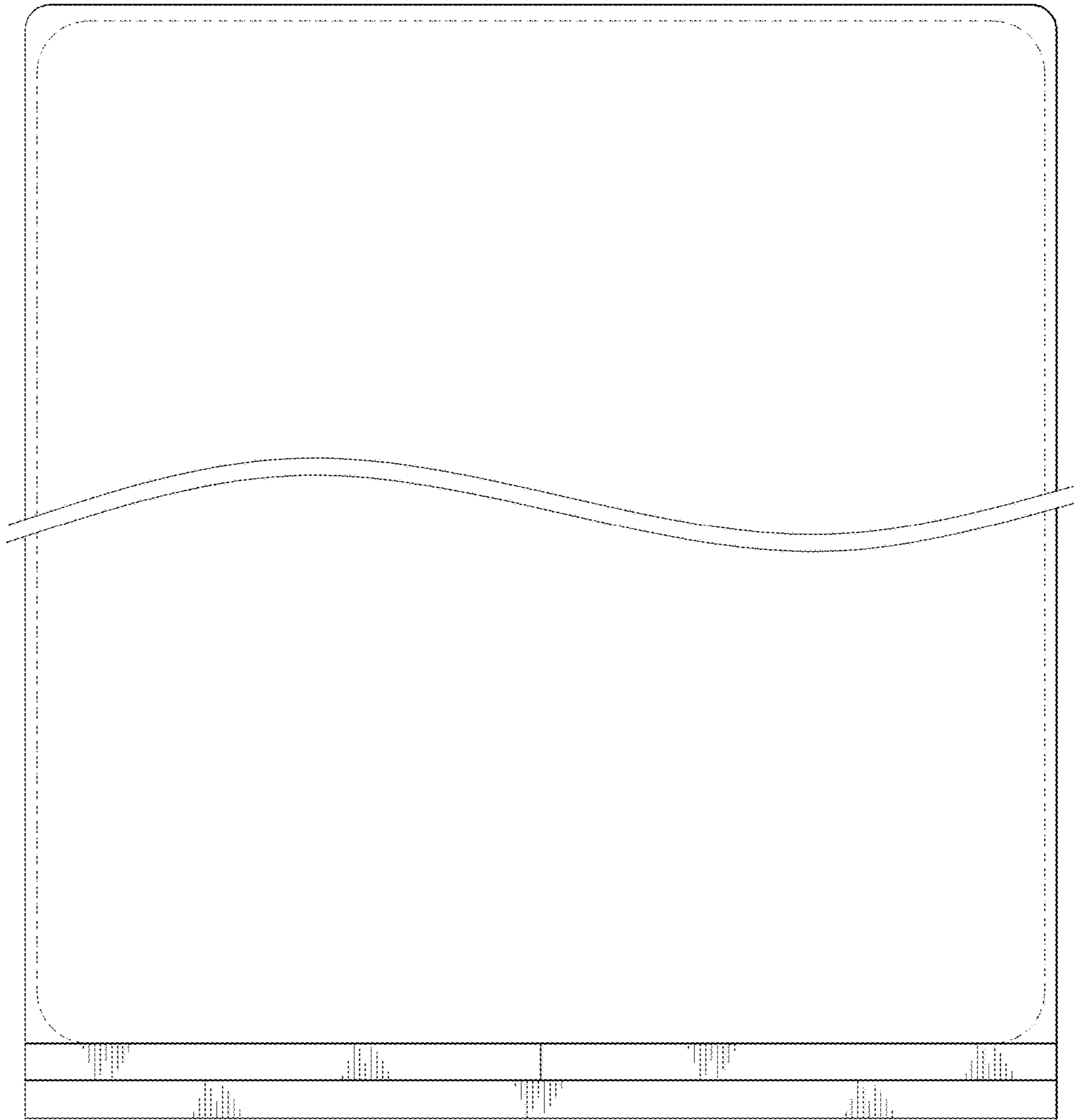

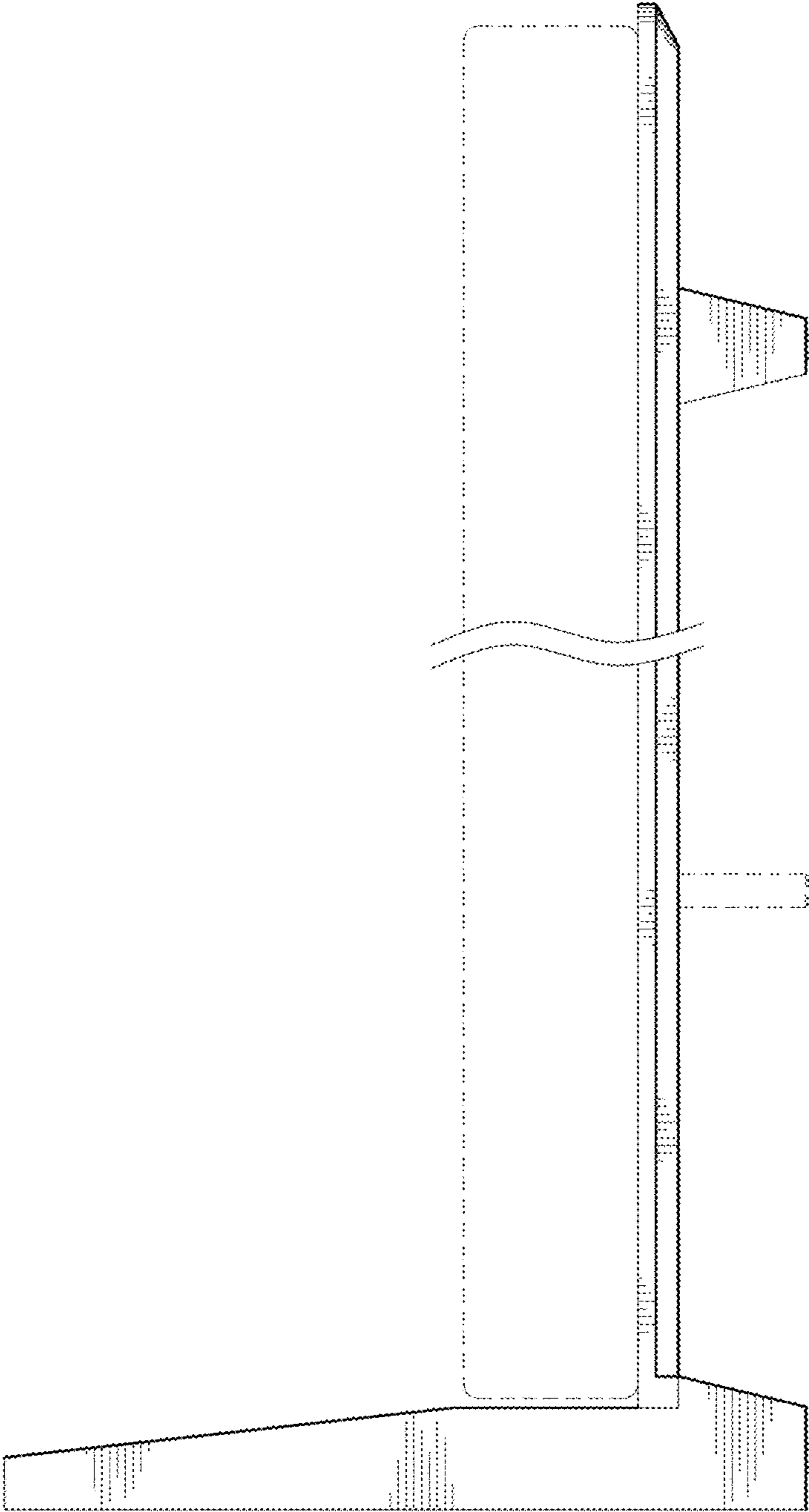

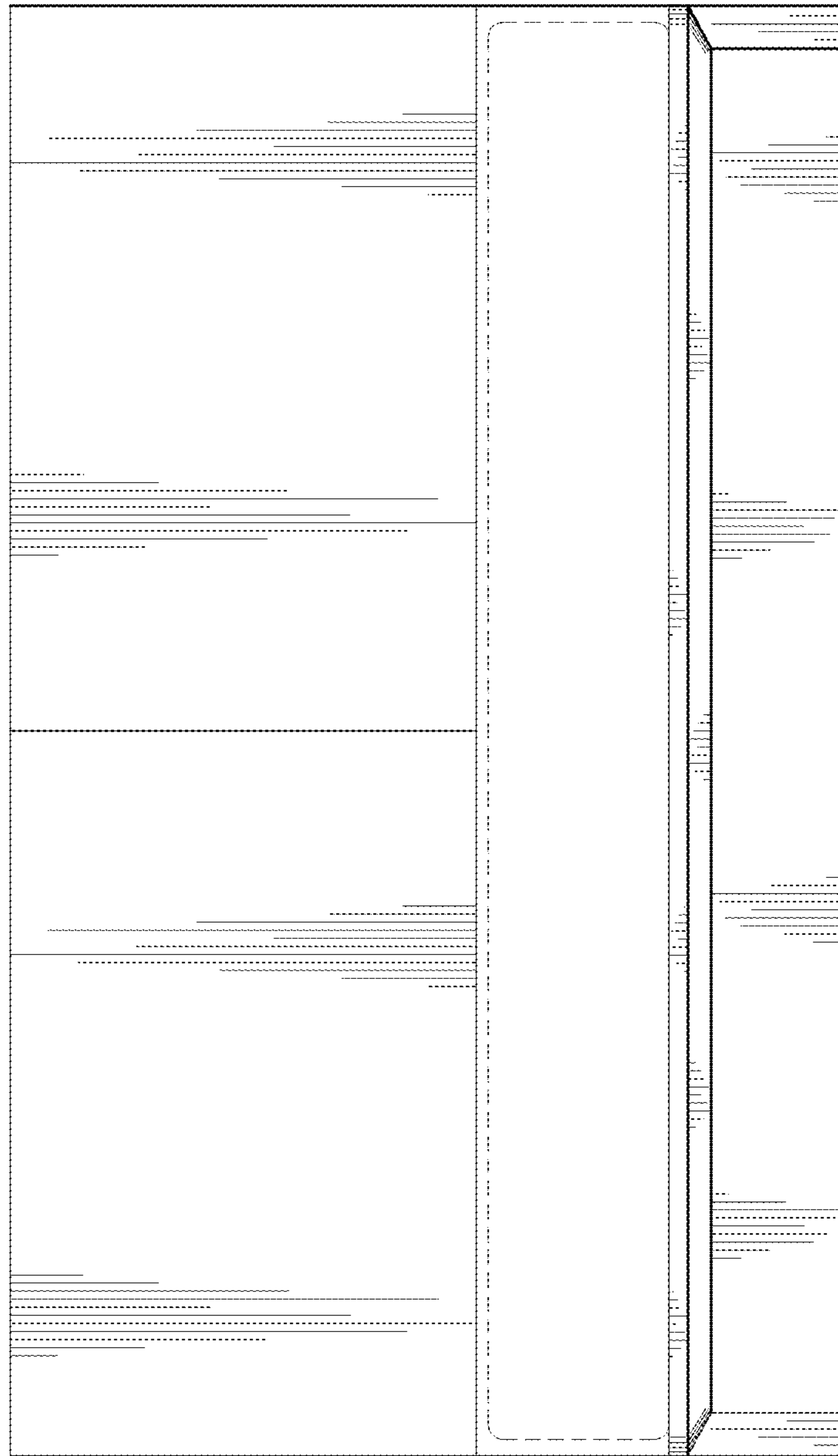
