FIG. 6 is a right side view thereof;

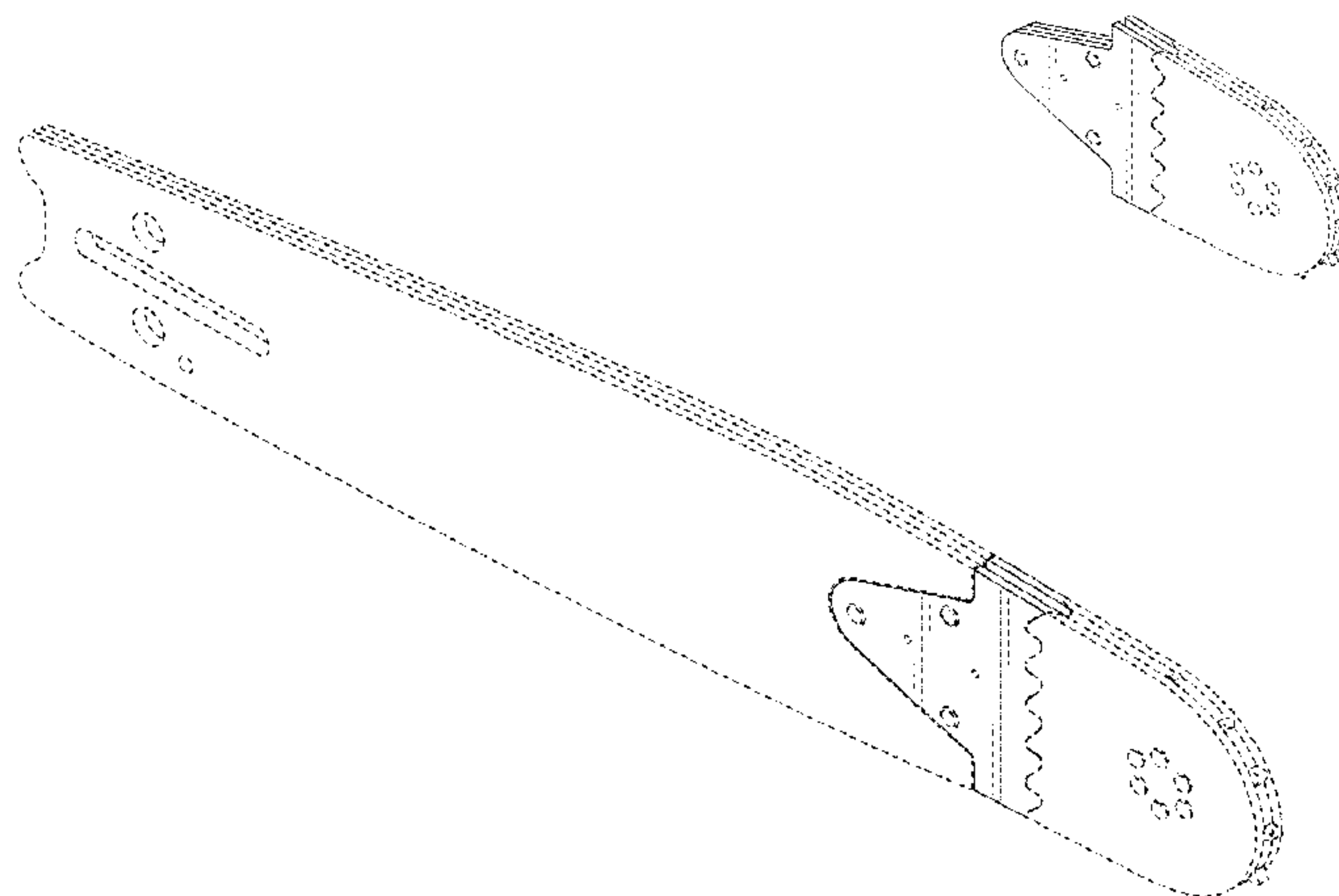
FIG. 7 is a left side view thereof;

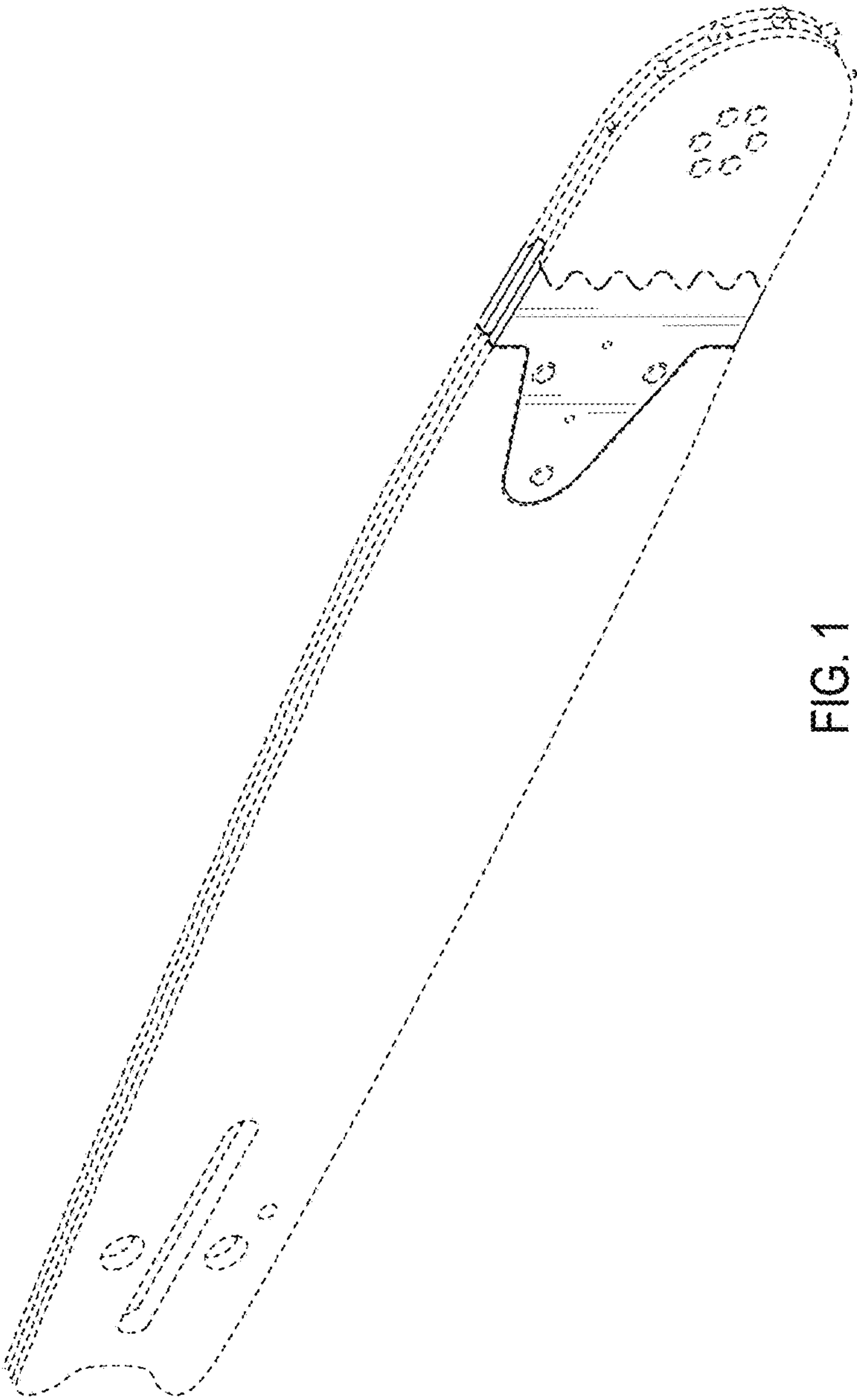

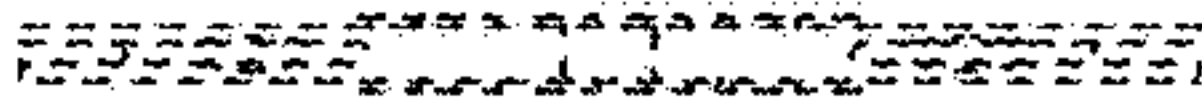

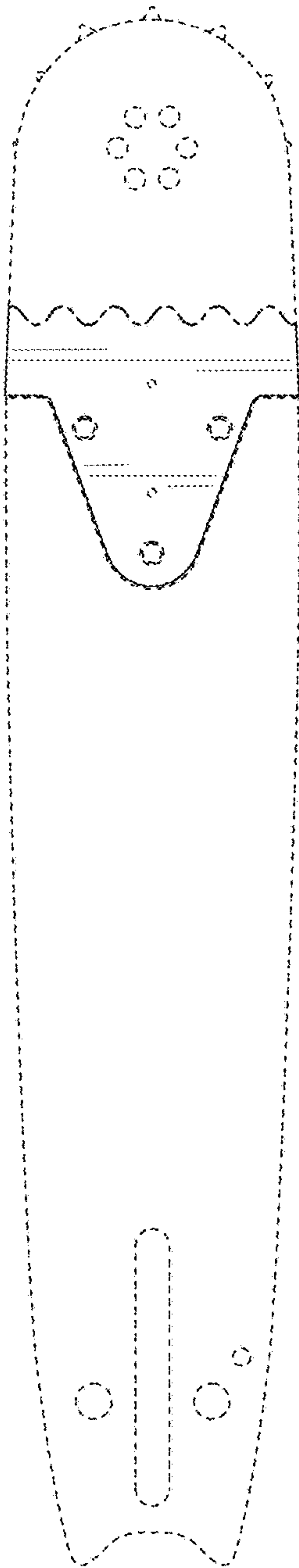

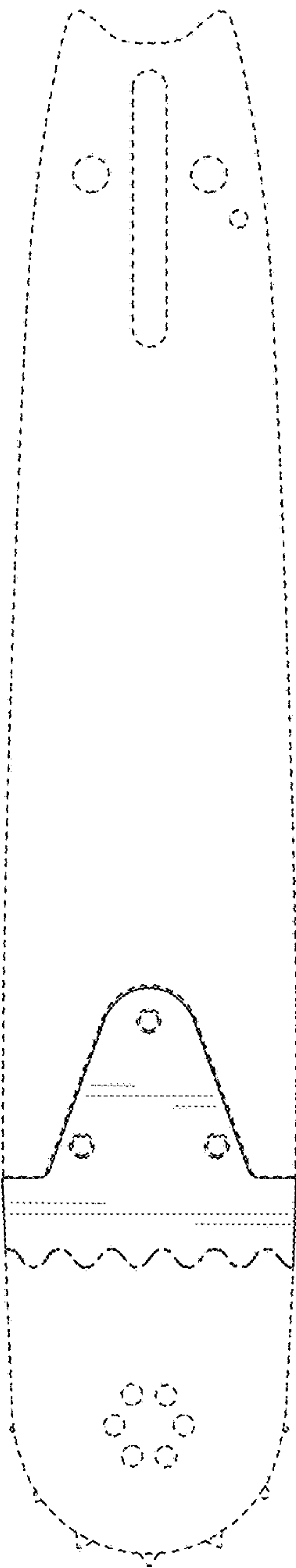

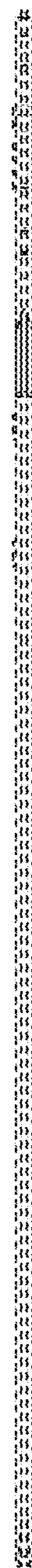

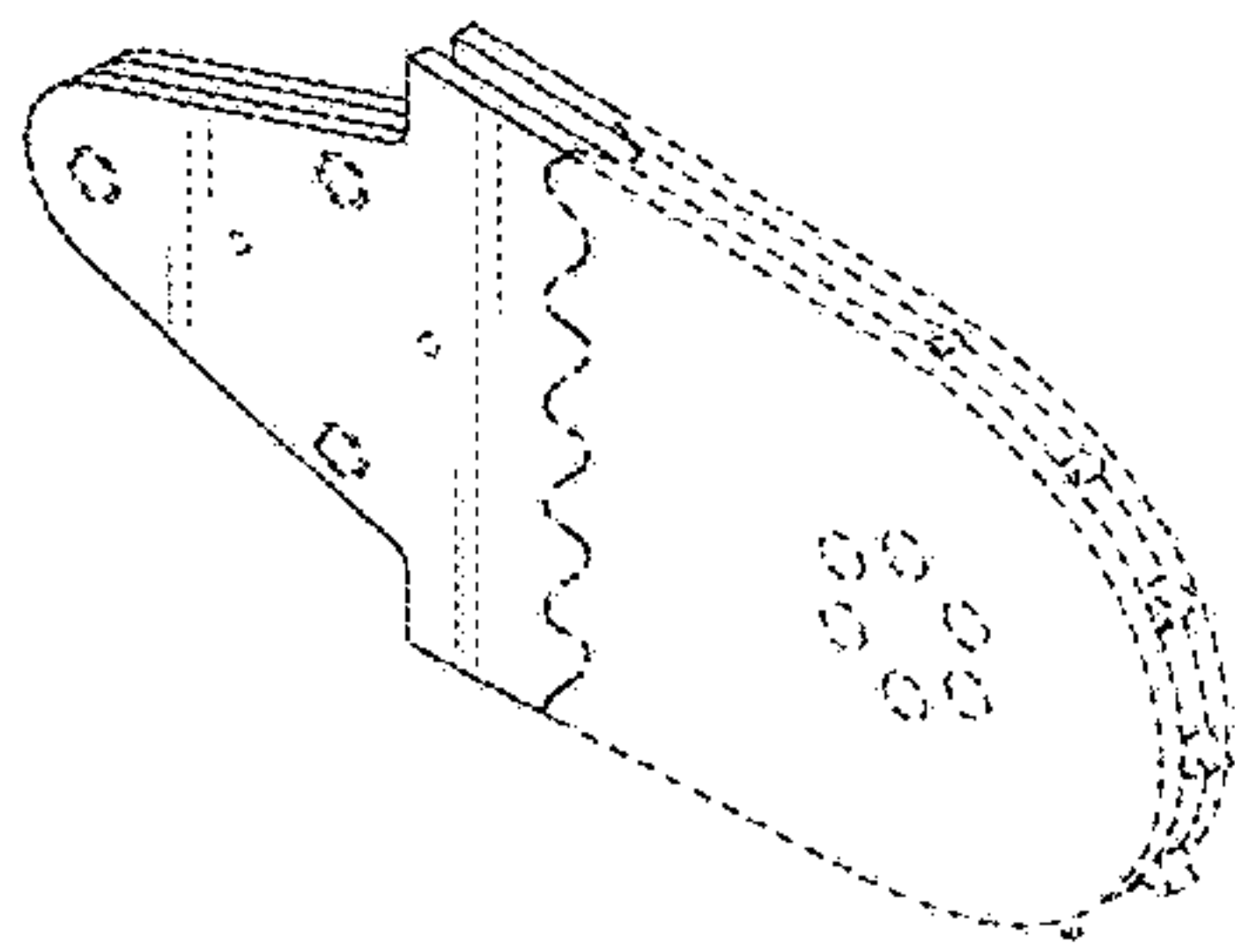

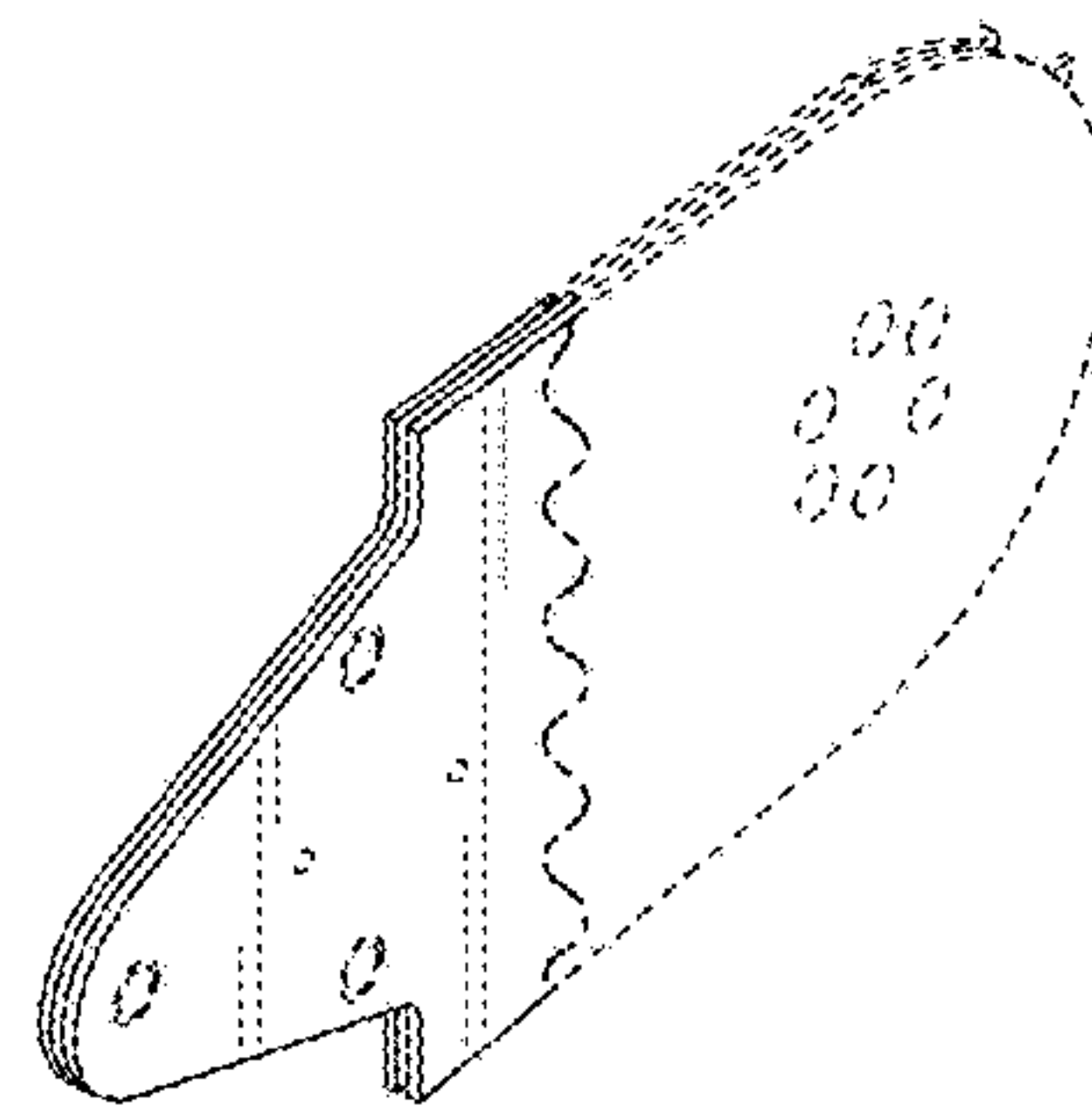
