(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a tessellated massage roller, as shown and described.

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a first embodiment of a tessellated massage roller;

FIG. 2 is a right side elevation view of the tessellated massage roller of FIG. 1, the left side elevation view being a mirror image thereof;

FIG. 3 is top plan view of the tessellated massage roller of FIG. 1, the bottom plan view being a mirror image thereof;

FIG. 4 is a front elevation view of the tessellated massage roller of FIG. 1, the rear elevation view being a mirror image thereof;

FIG. 5 is a perspective view of a second embodiment of a tessellated massage roller having a first length;

FIG. 6 is a right side elevation view of the tessellated massage roller of FIG. 5, the left side elevation view being identical thereto;

FIG. 7 is a top plan view of the tessellated massage roller of FIG. 5, the bottom plan view being identical thereto;

FIG. 8 is a front elevation view of the tessellated massage roller of FIG. 5, the rear elevation view being identical thereto;

FIG. 9 is a perspective view of a third embodiment of a tessellated massage roller having a second length;

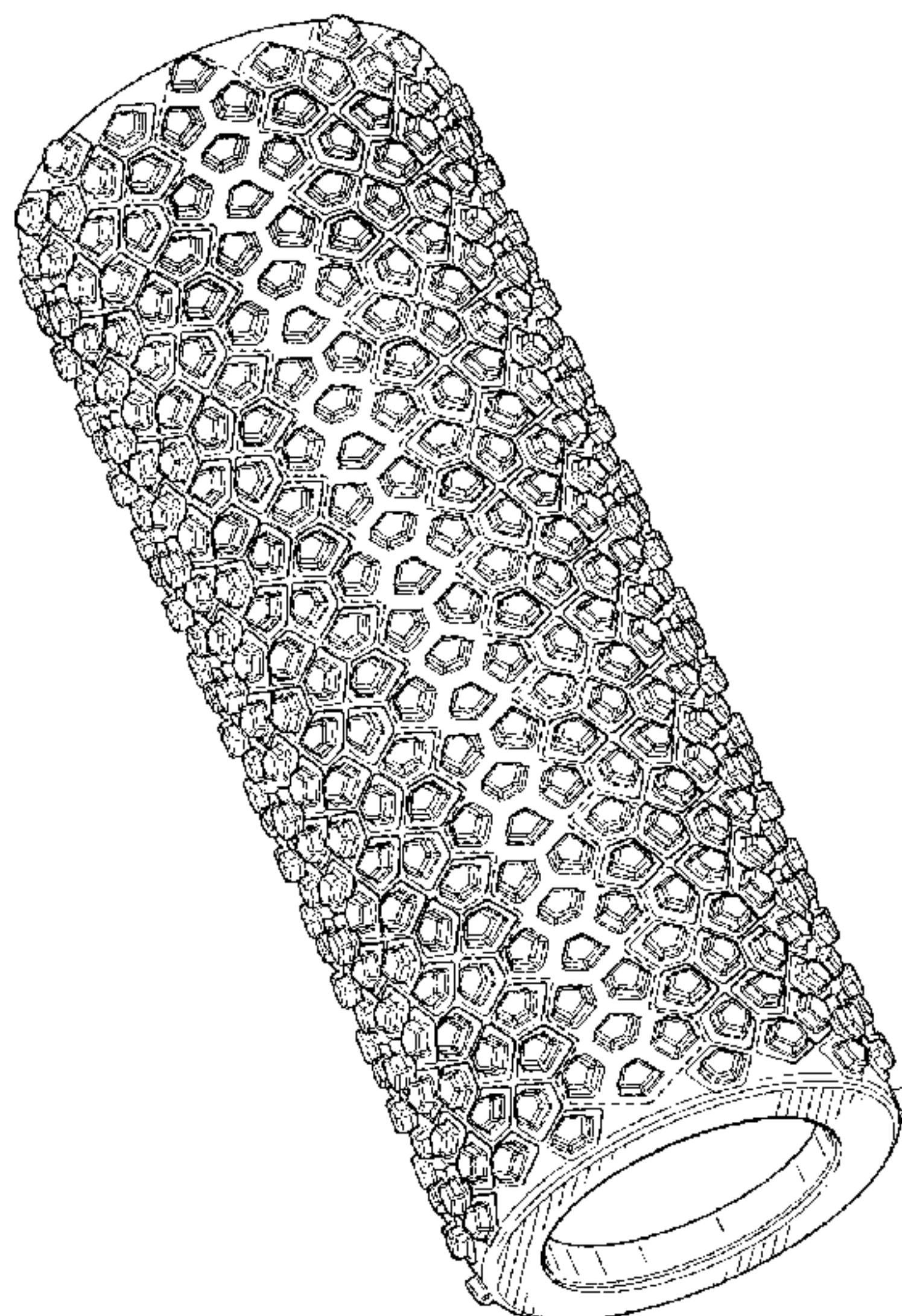
FIG. 10 is a right side elevation view of the tessellated massage roller of FIG. 9, the left side elevation view being identical thereto;

FIG. 11 is a top plan view of the tessellated massage roller of FIG. 9, the bottom plan view being identical thereof; and,

FIG. 12 is a front elevation view of the tessellated massage roller of FIG. 9, the rear elevation view being identical thereto.

The broken lines depict portions of the tessellated massage roller and form no part of the claimed design. The tessellated massage roller in FIGS. 1-3 is shown with a symbolic break in its length. The appearance of any portion of the article between the break lines forms no part of the claimed design.

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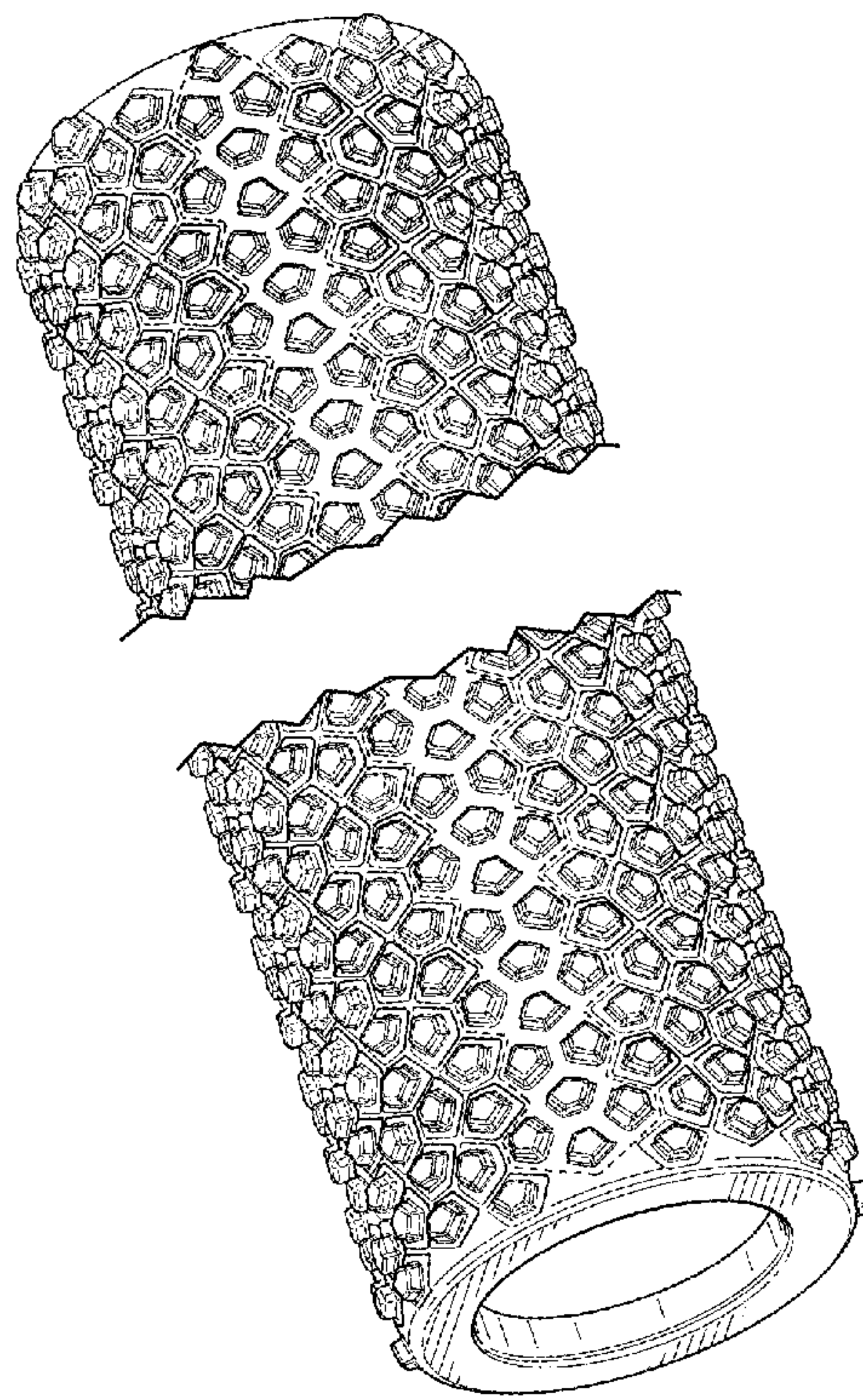

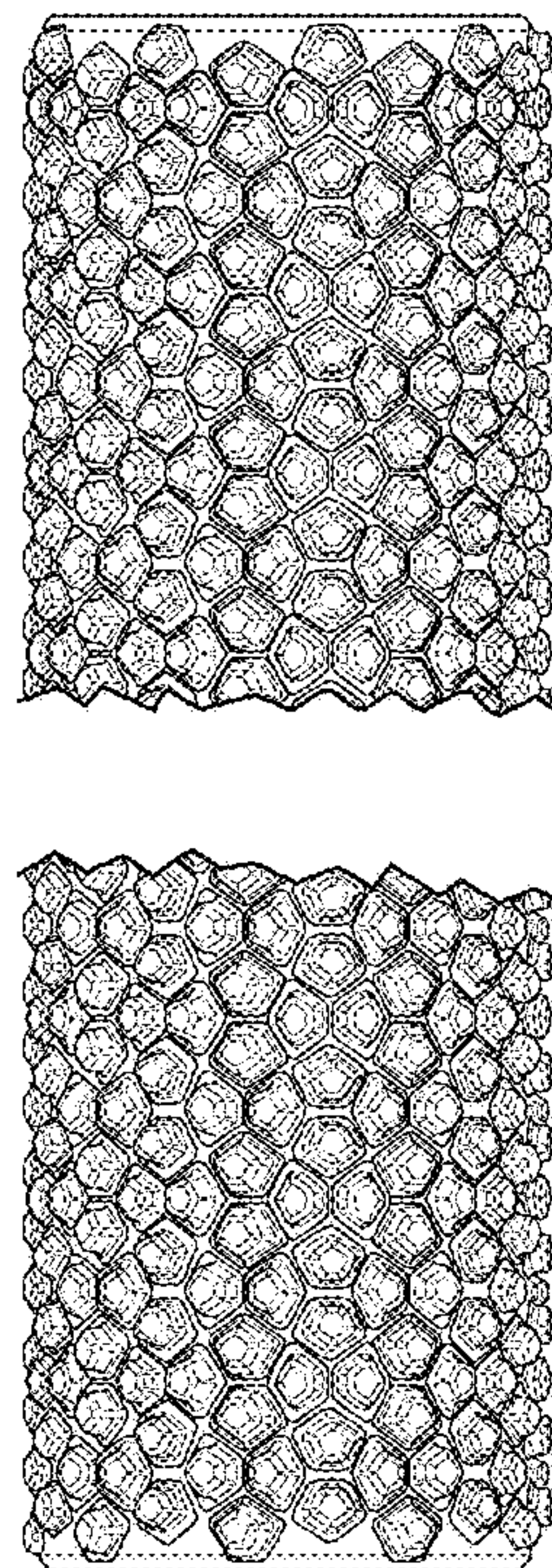

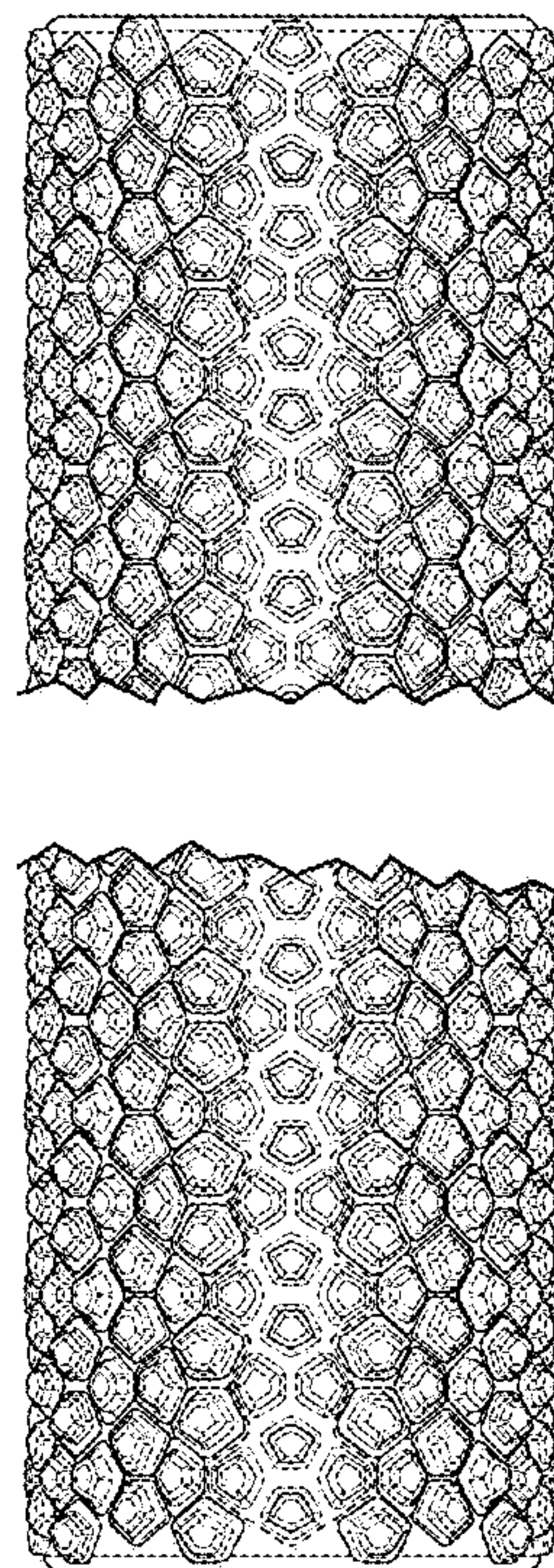

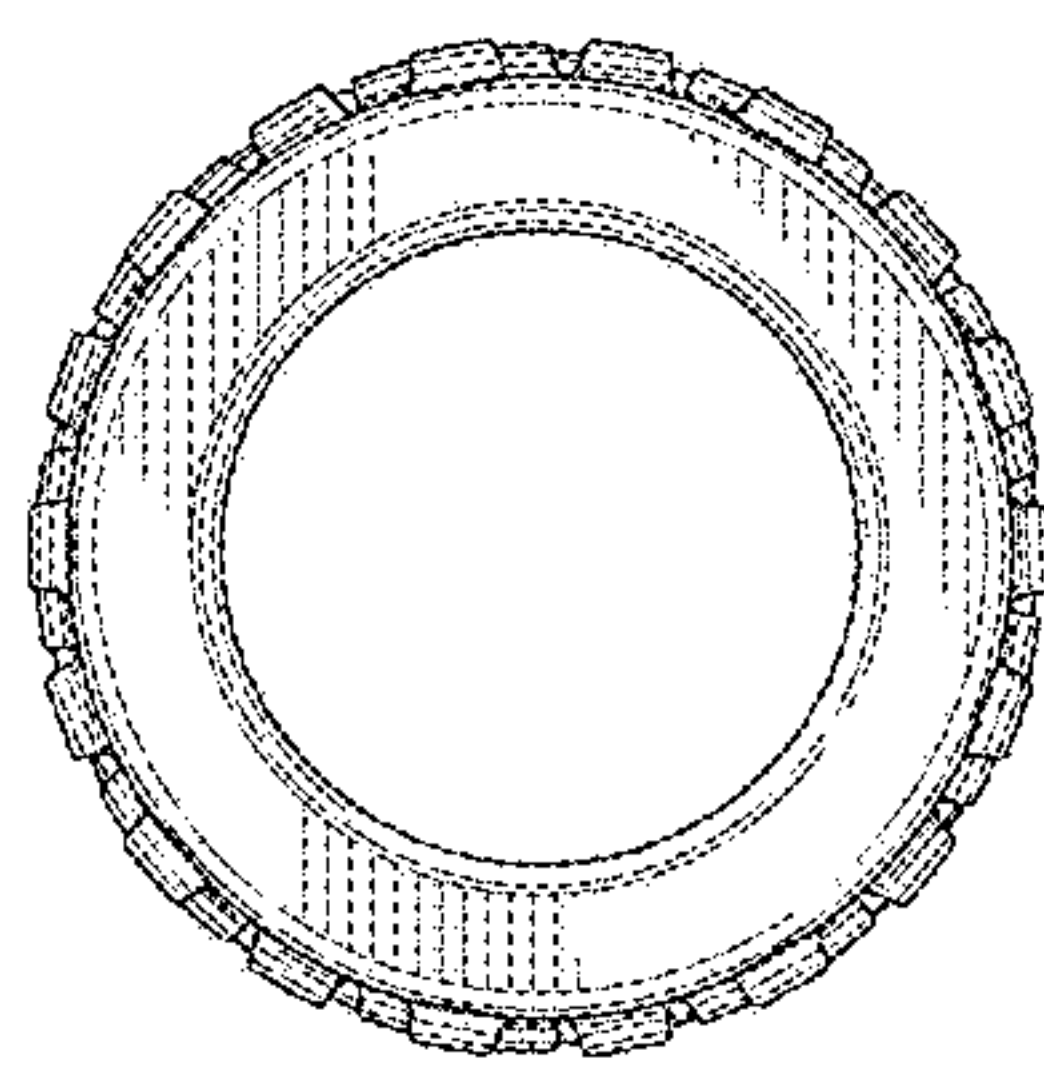

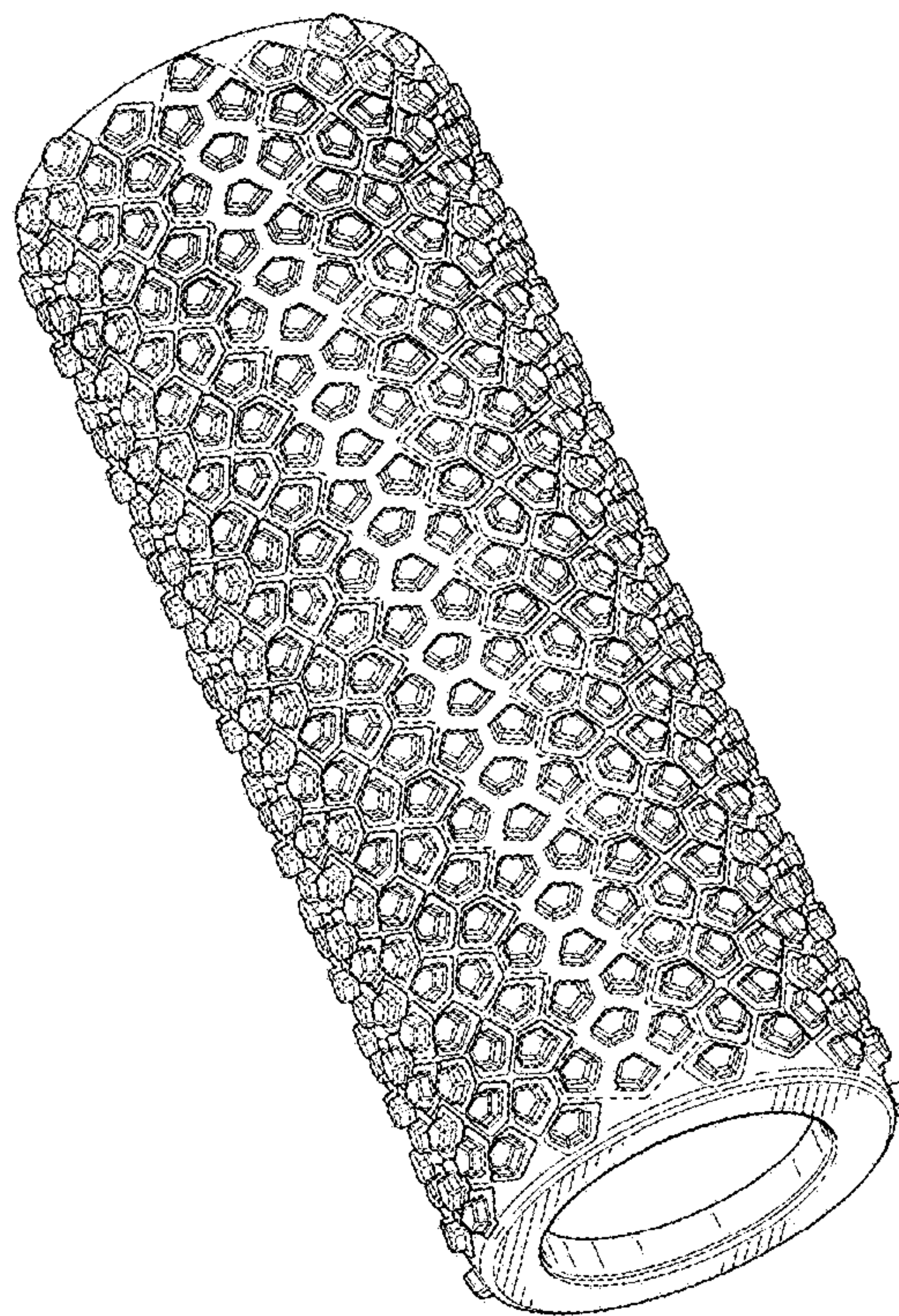

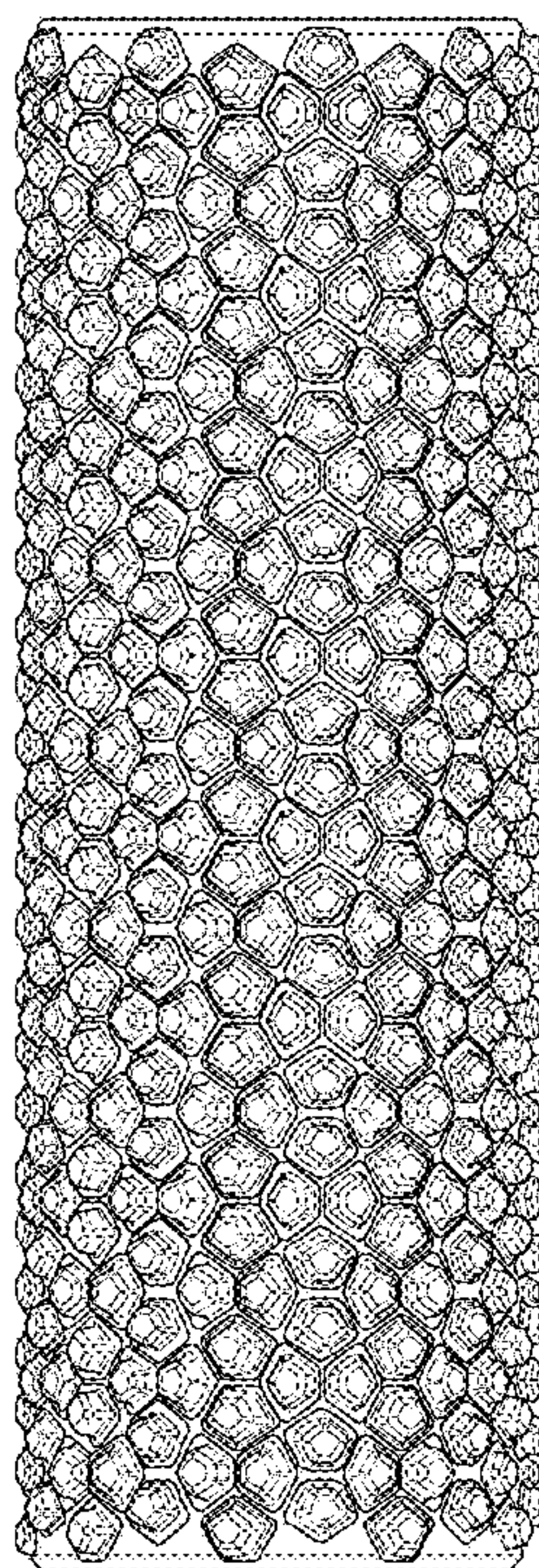

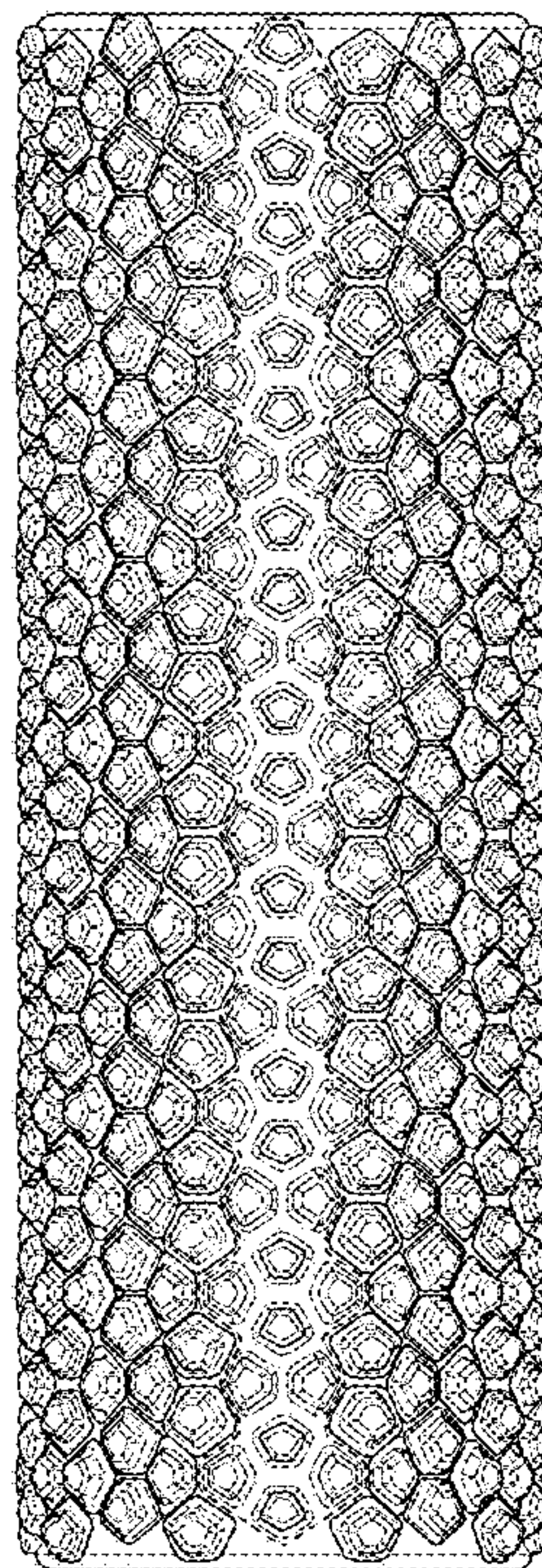

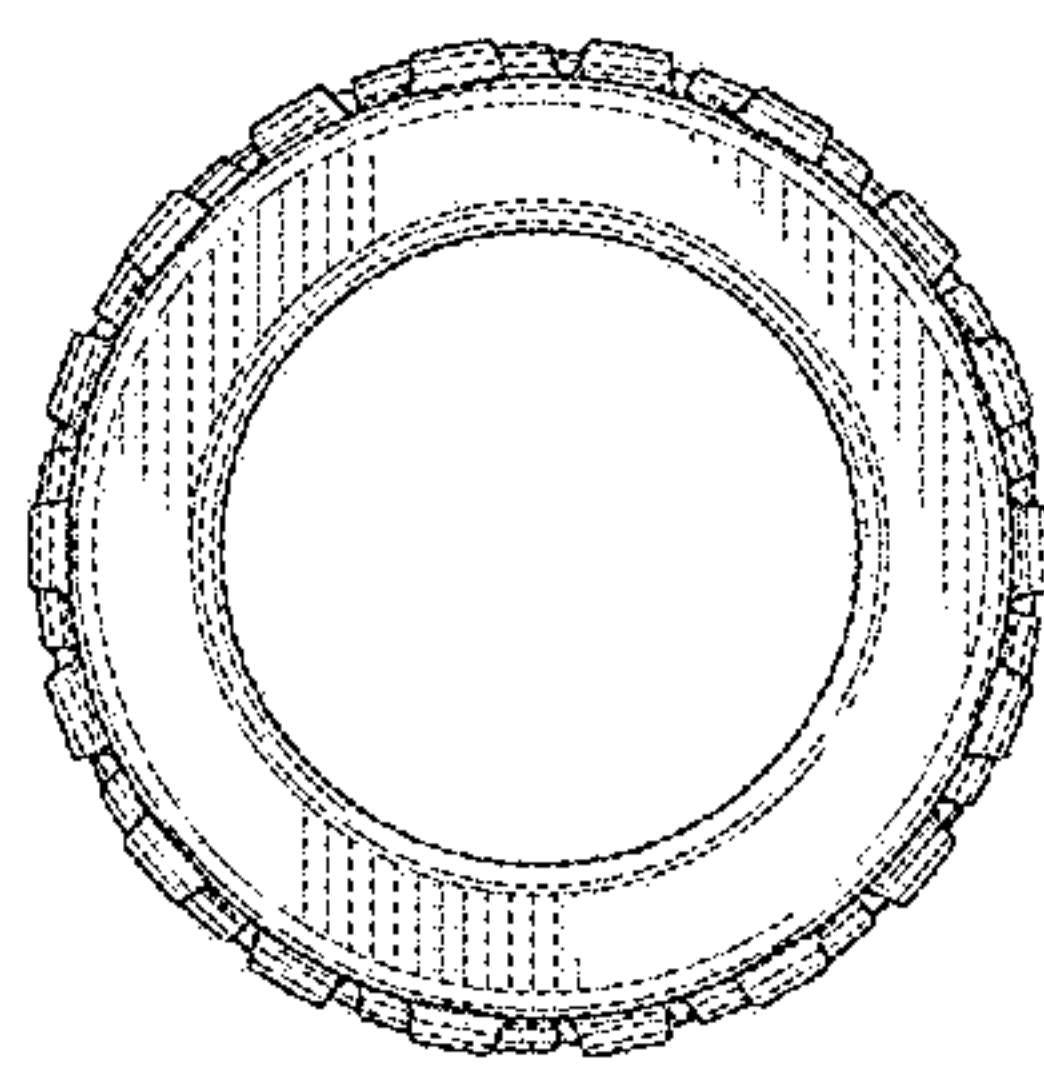

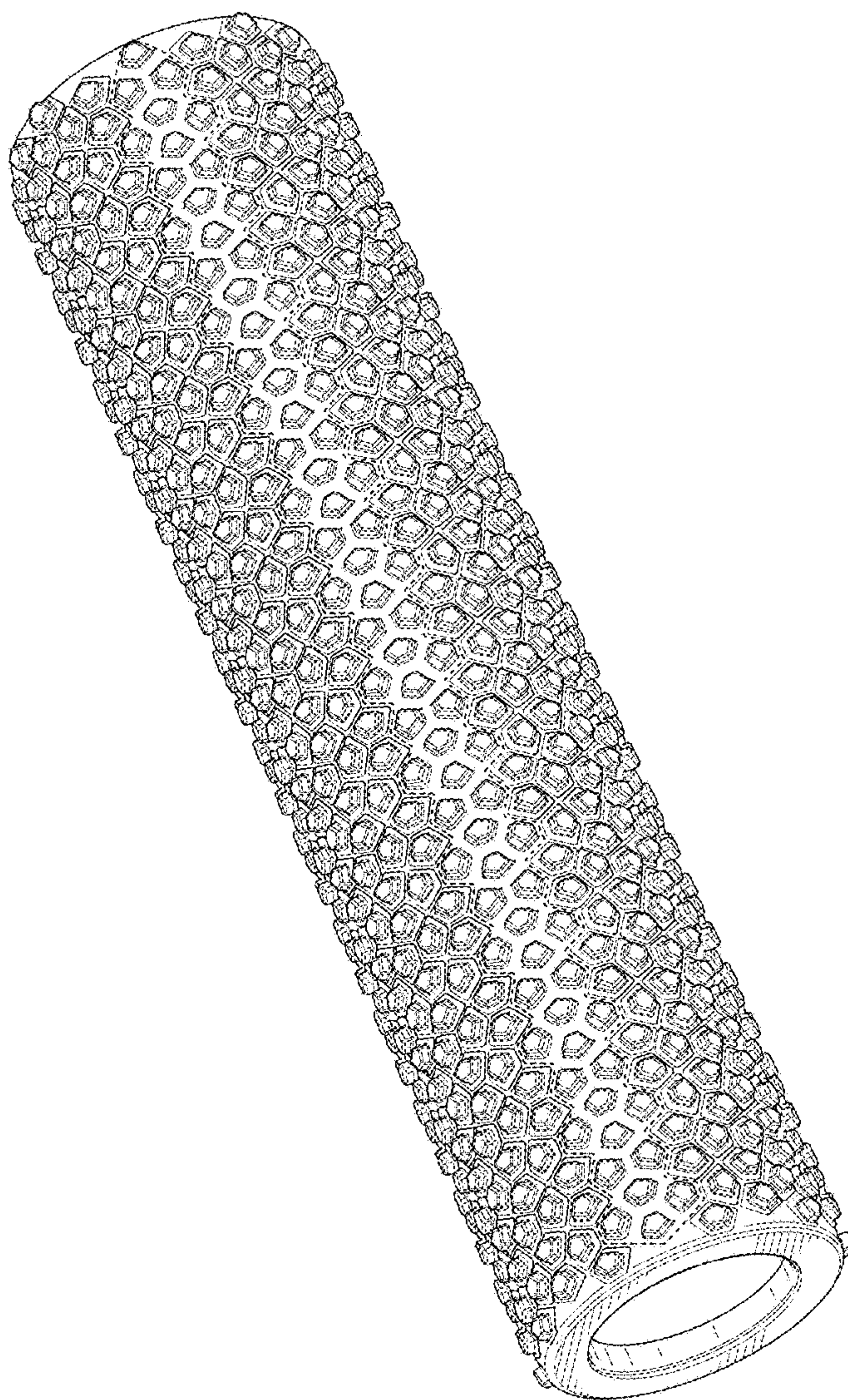

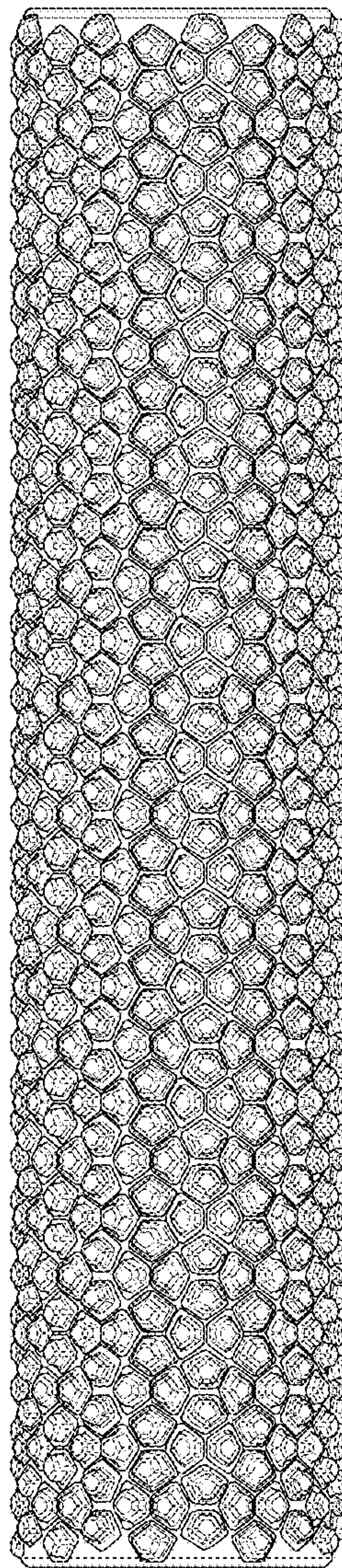

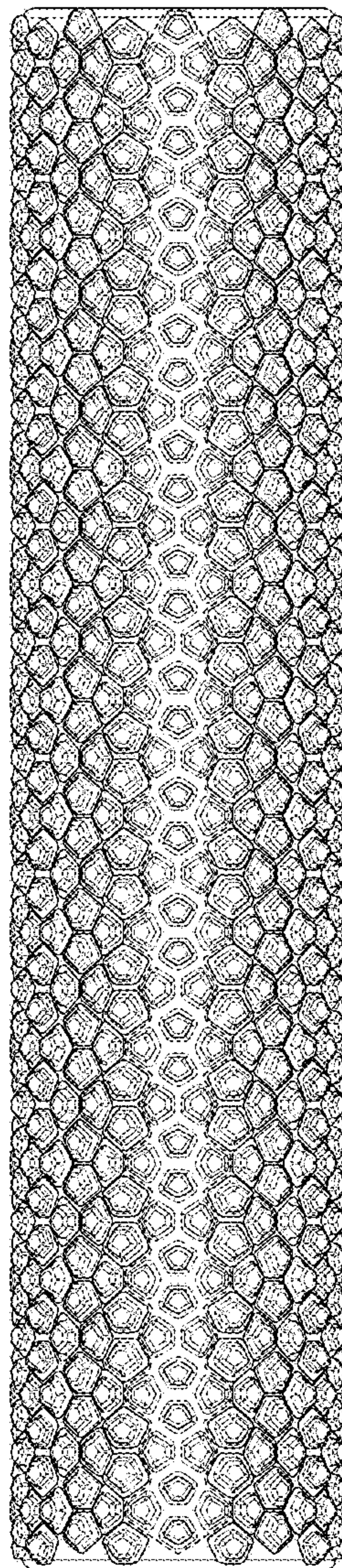

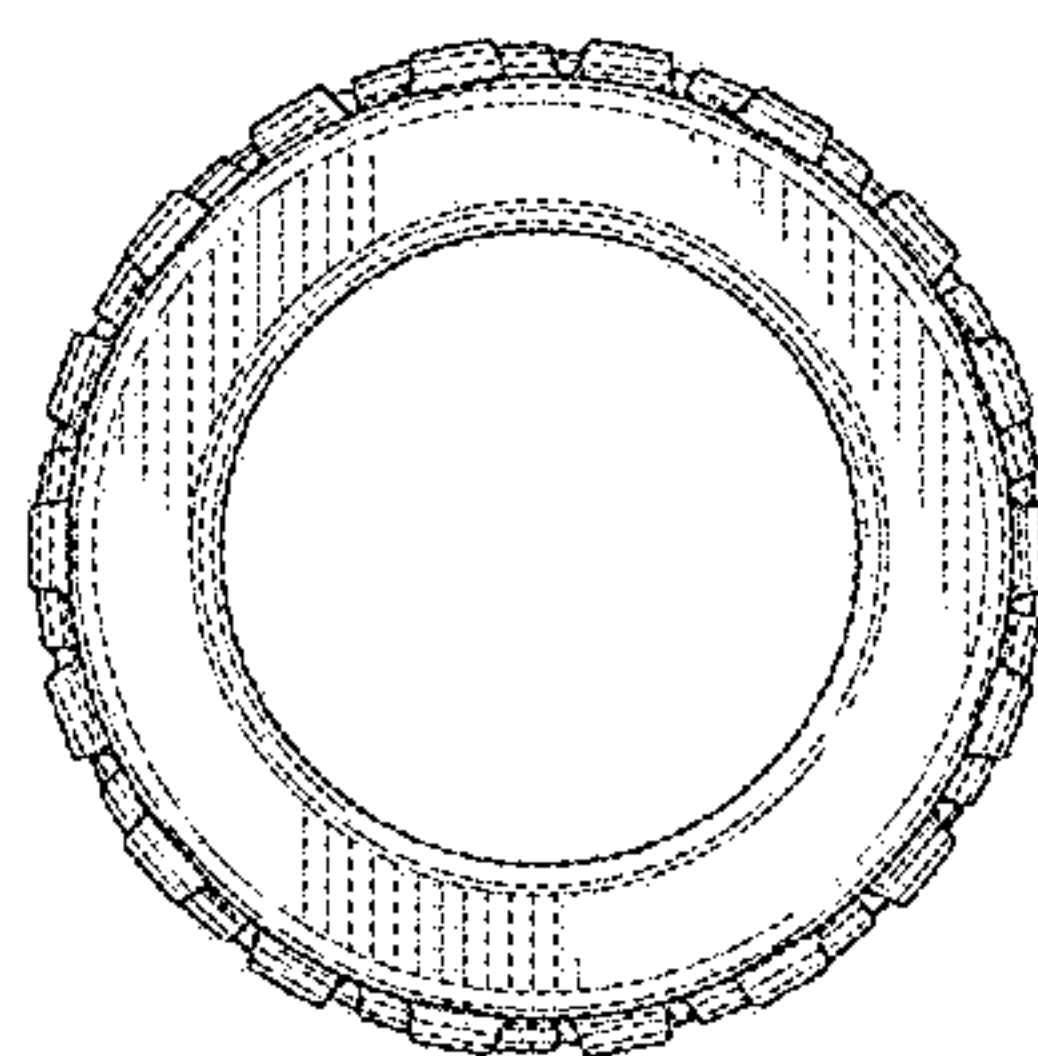
