DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the present invention; FIG. 2 is a front elevational view of the present invention shown in FIG. 1, the rear elevational view being a mirror image thereof;

FIG. 3 is a right side elevational view of the present invention shown in FIG. 1, the left side elevational view being a mirror image thereof;

FIG. 4 is a top plan view of the present invention shown in FIG. 1;

FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view of the present invention shown in FIG. 1;

FIG. 6 is a perspective view of the present invention;

FIG. 7 is a front elevational view of the present invention shown in FIG. 6, the rear elevational view being a mirror image thereof;

FIG. 8 is a right side elevational view of the present invention shown in FIG. 6, the left side elevational view being a mirror image thereof;

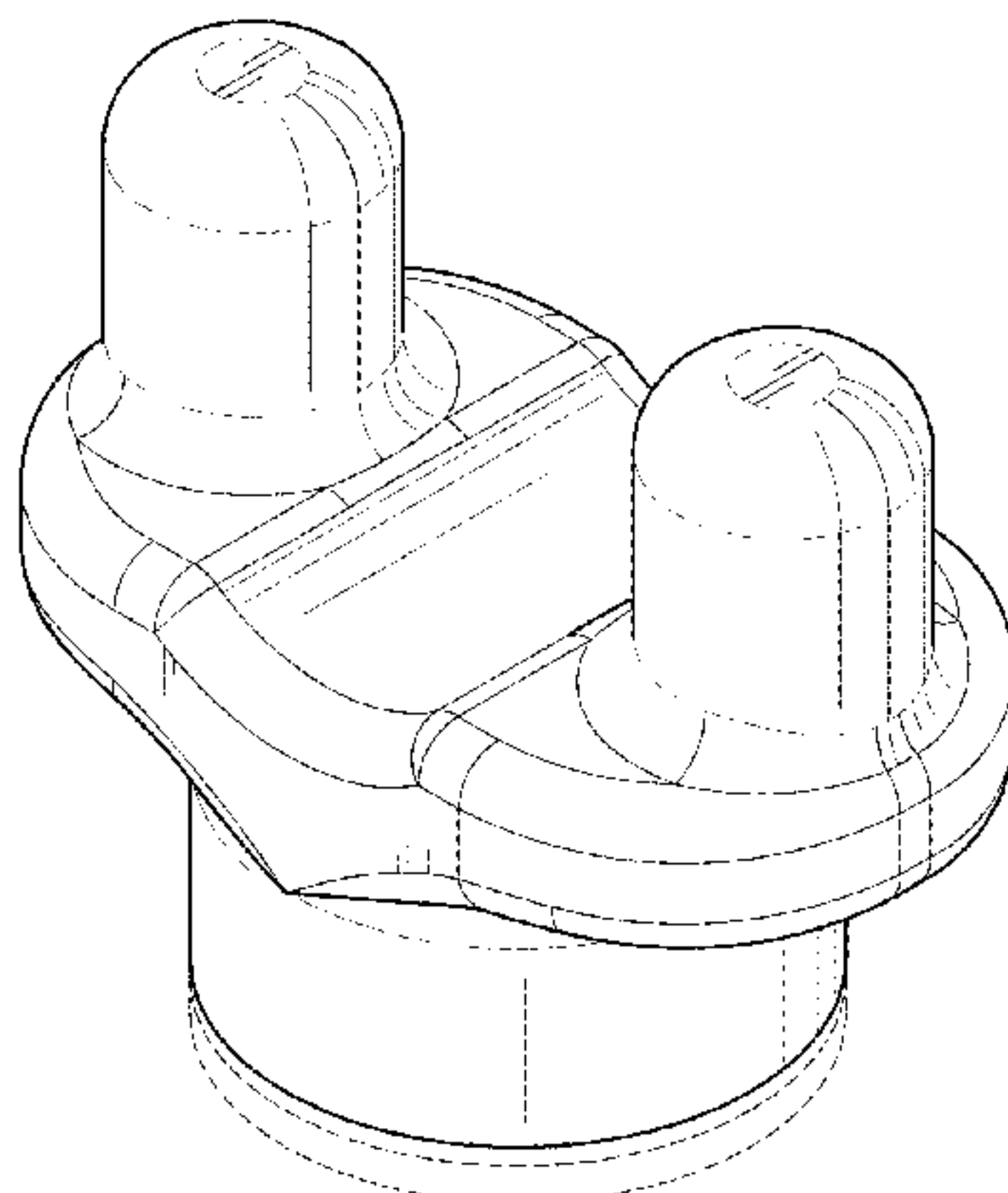
FIG. 9 is a top plan view of the present invention shown in FIG. 6;

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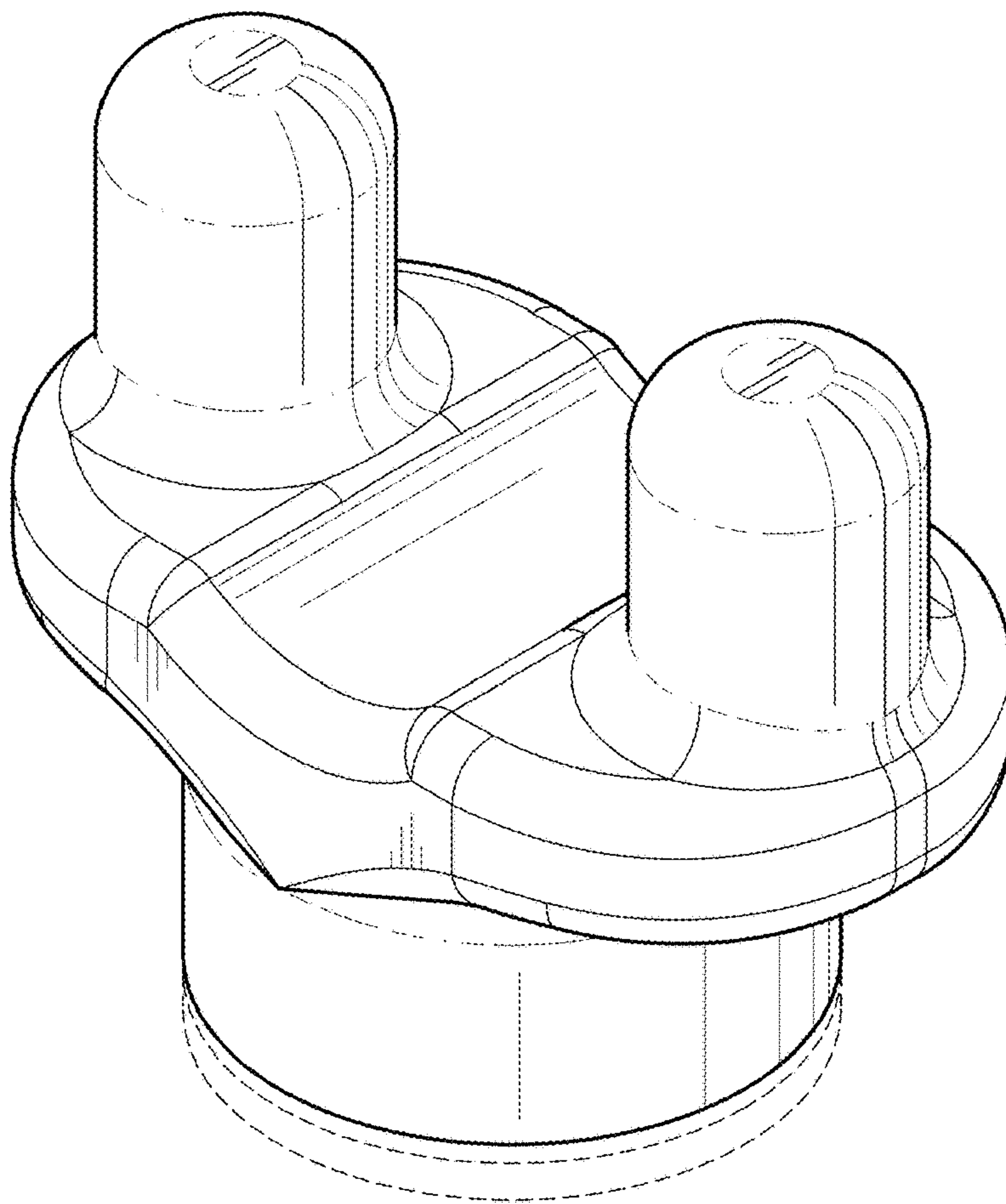

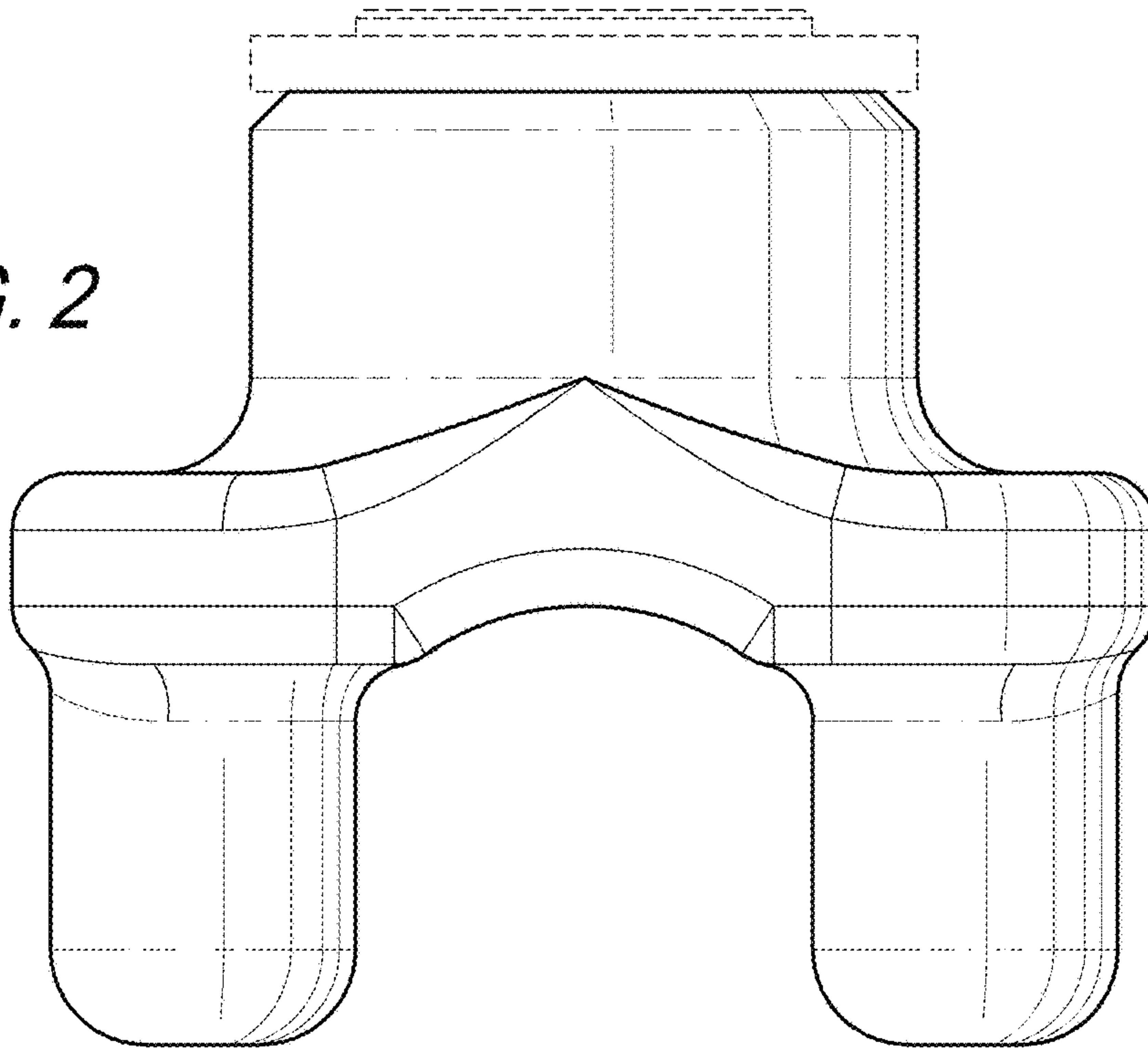
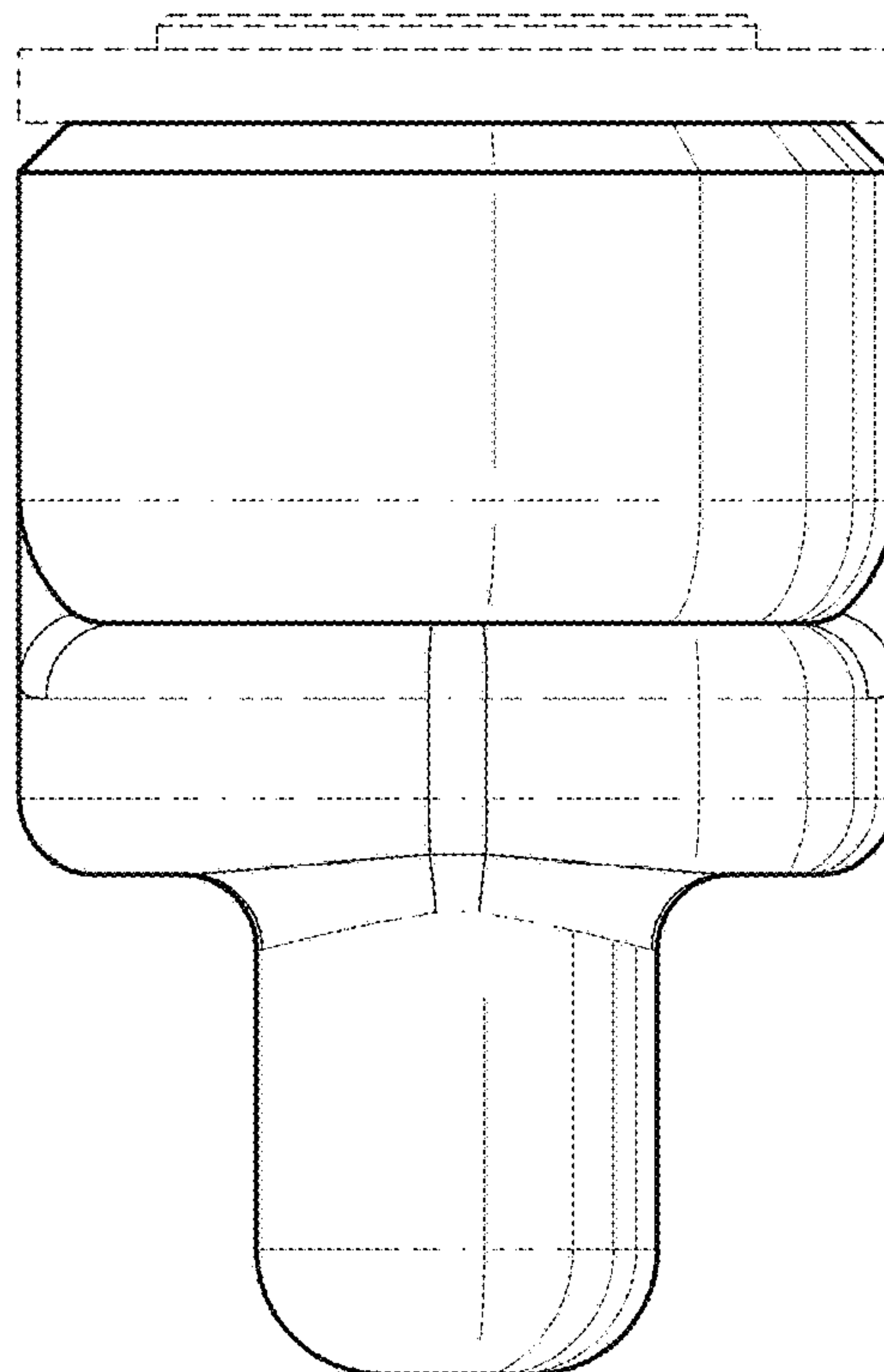

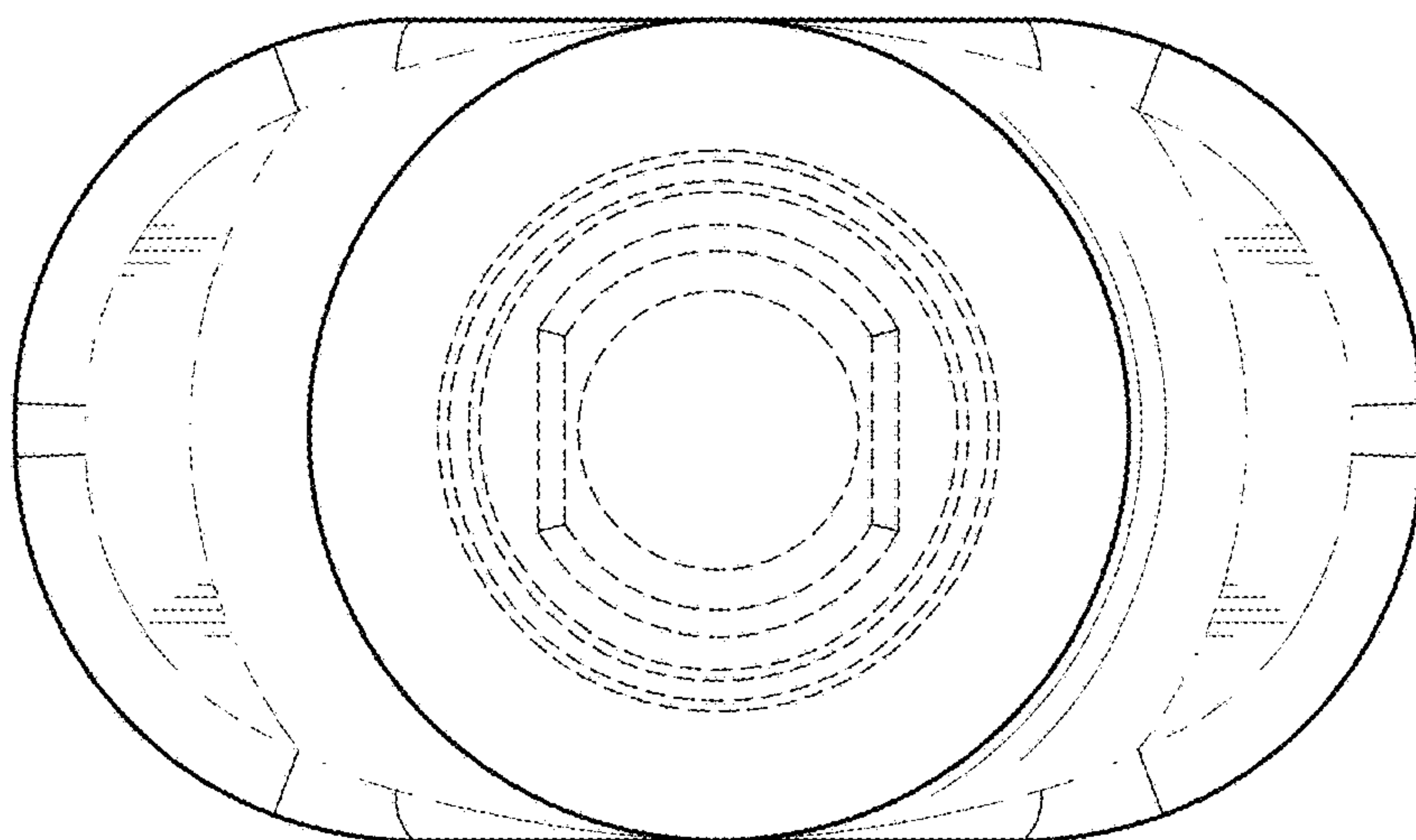

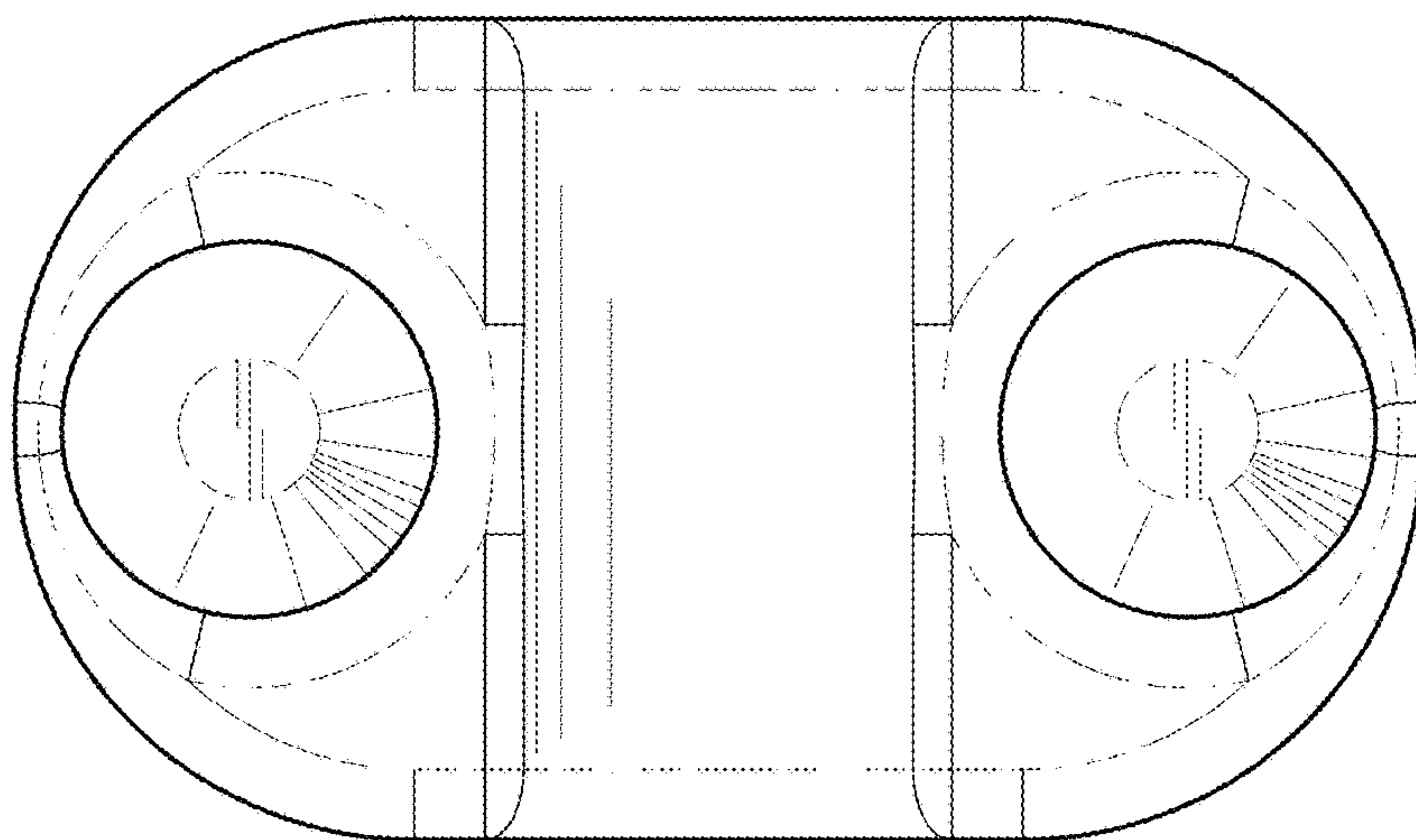

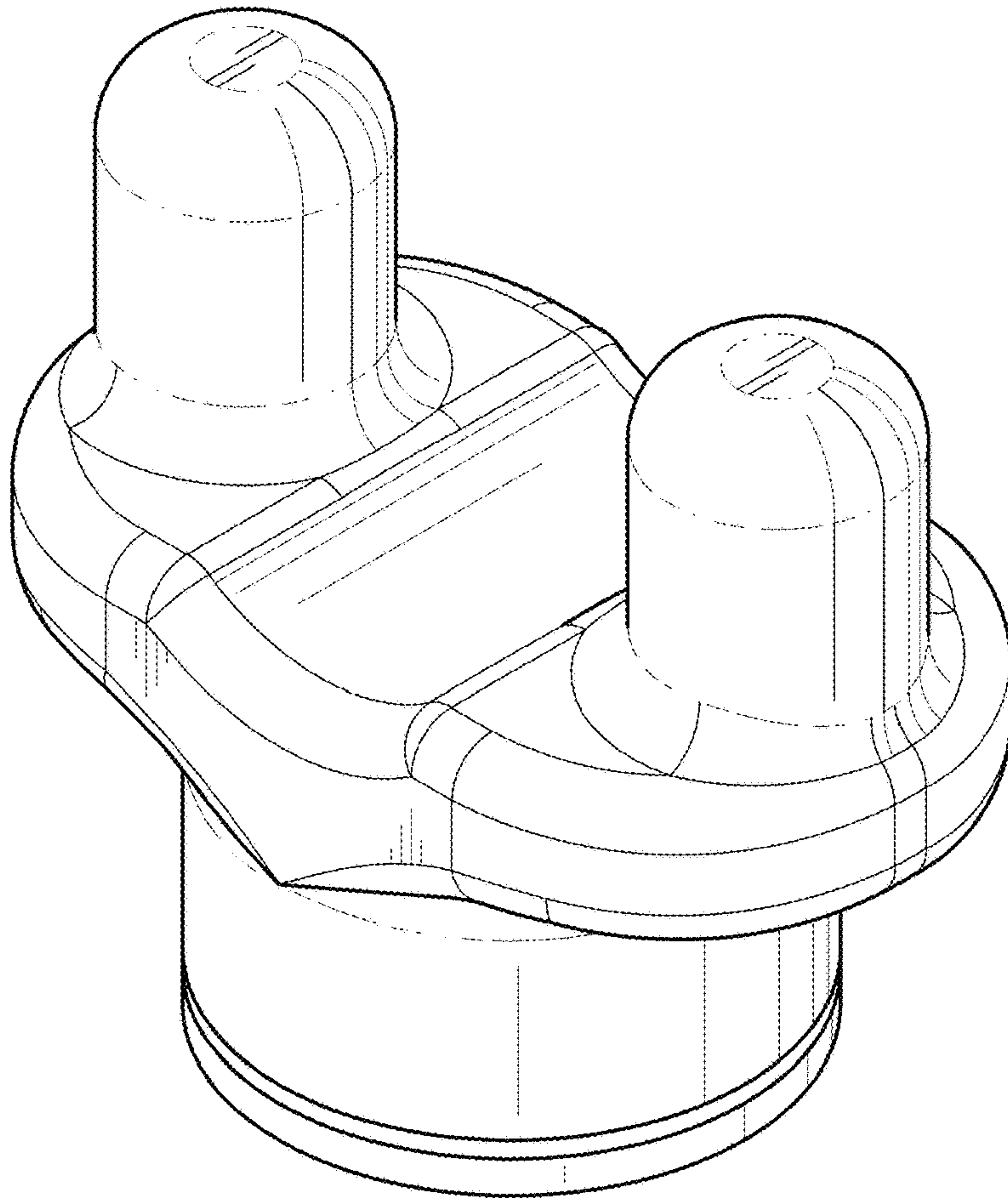

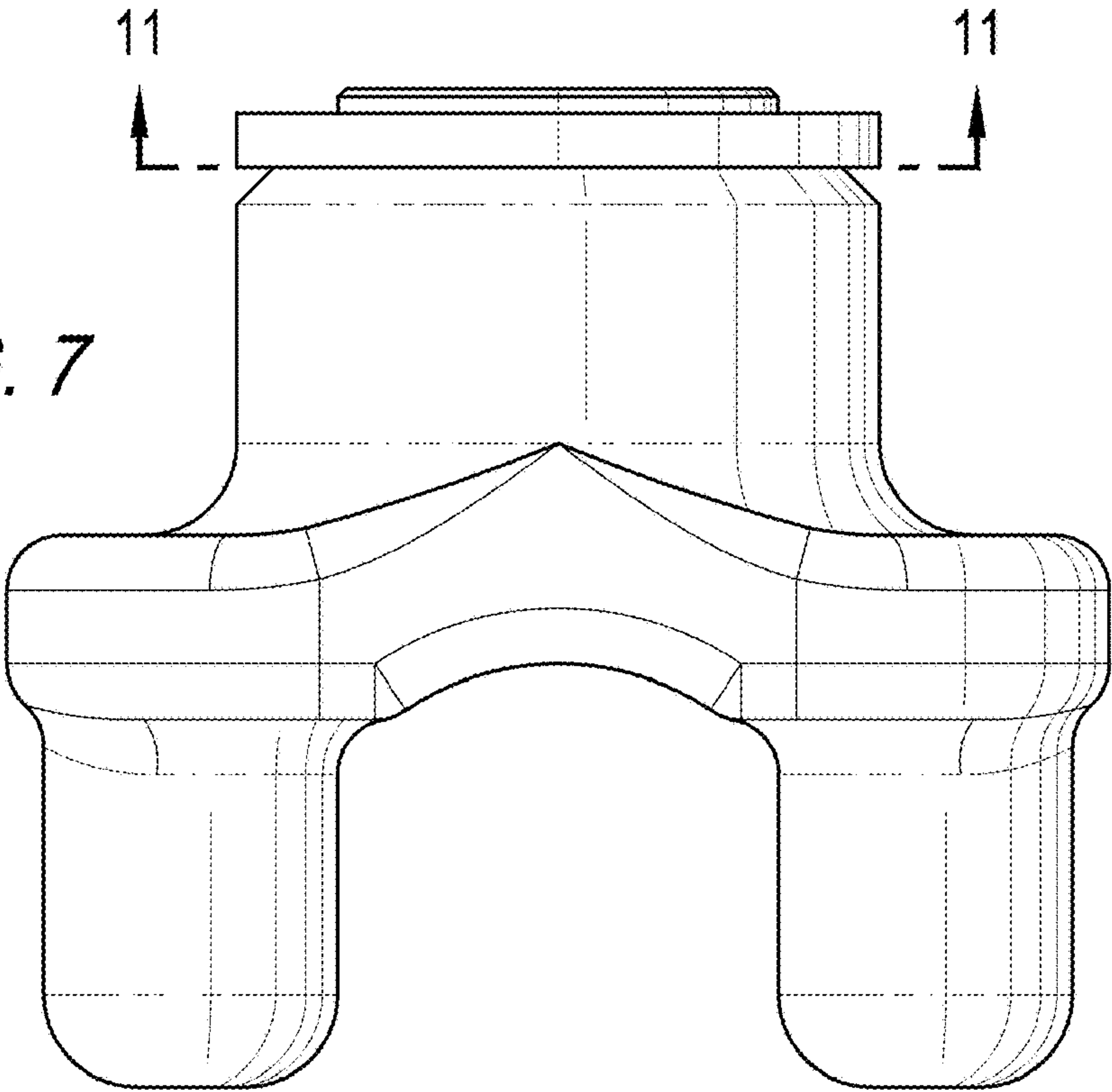
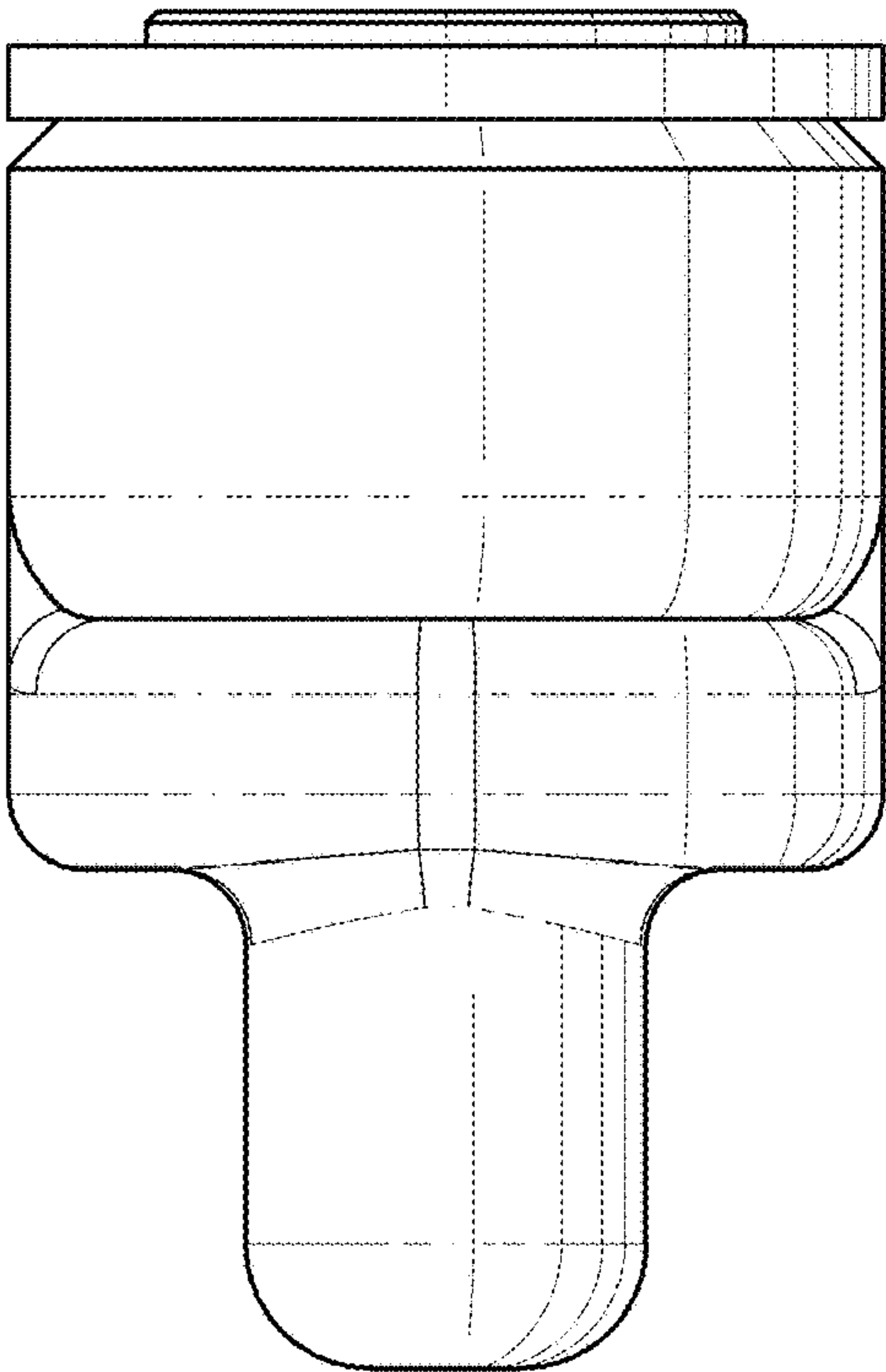

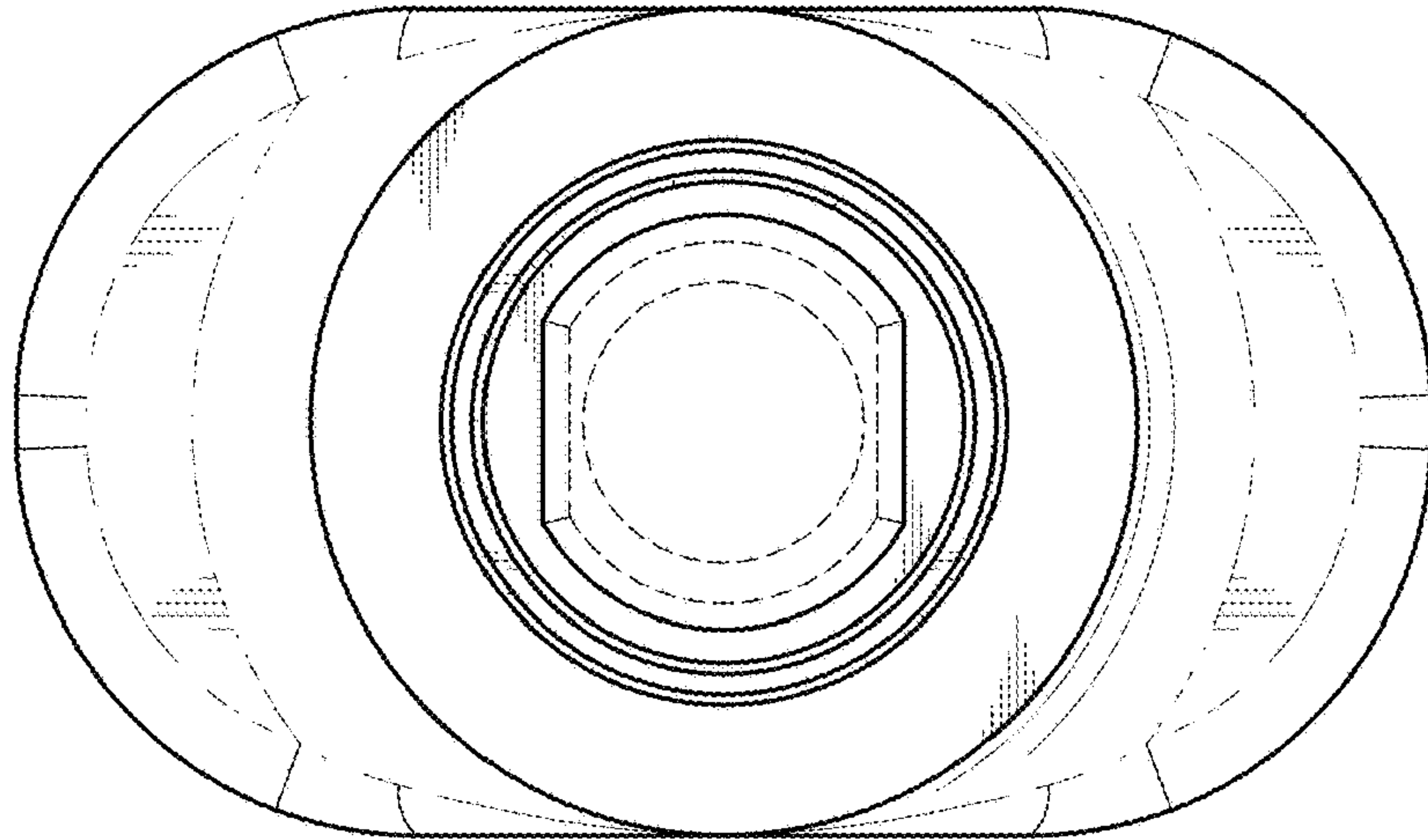

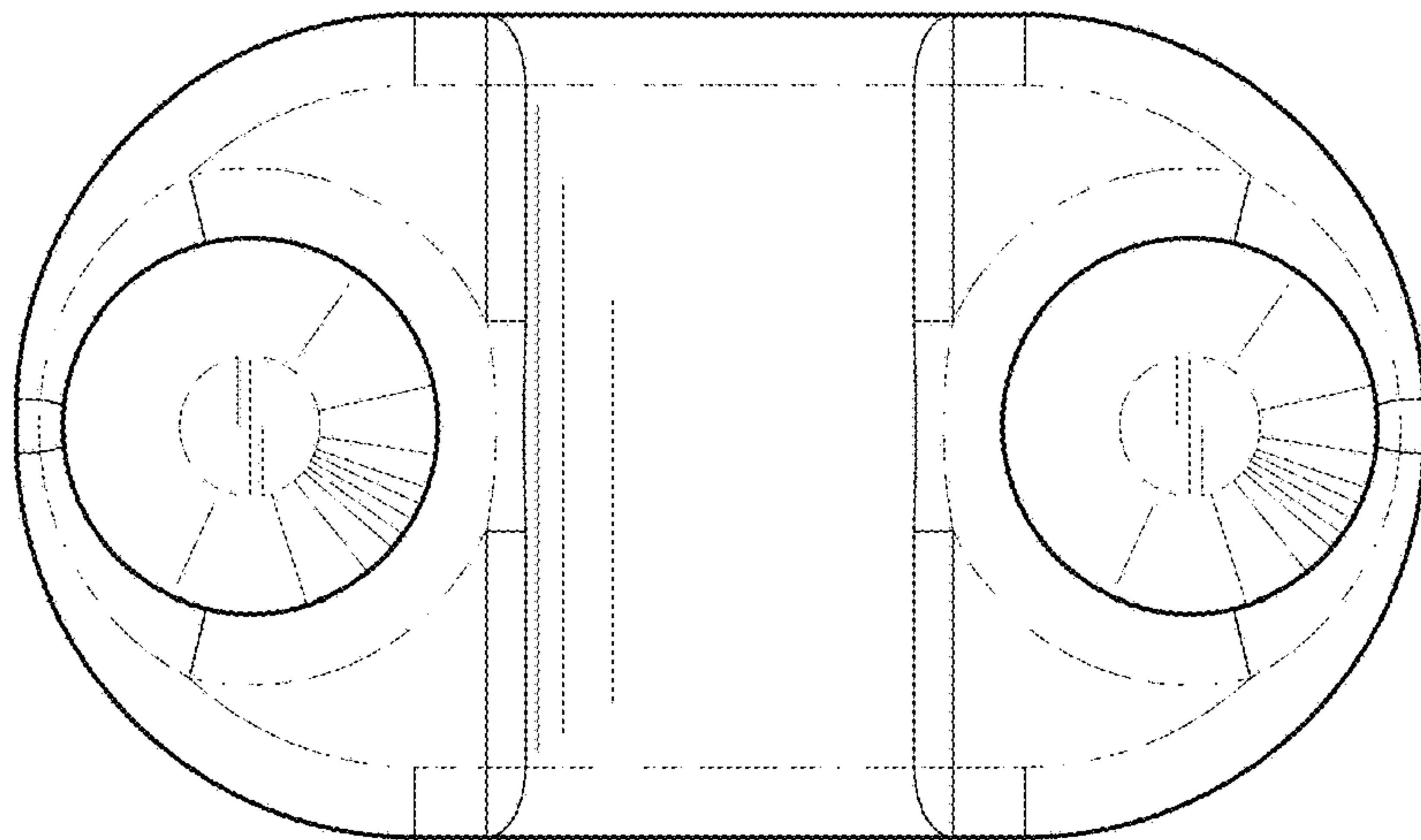

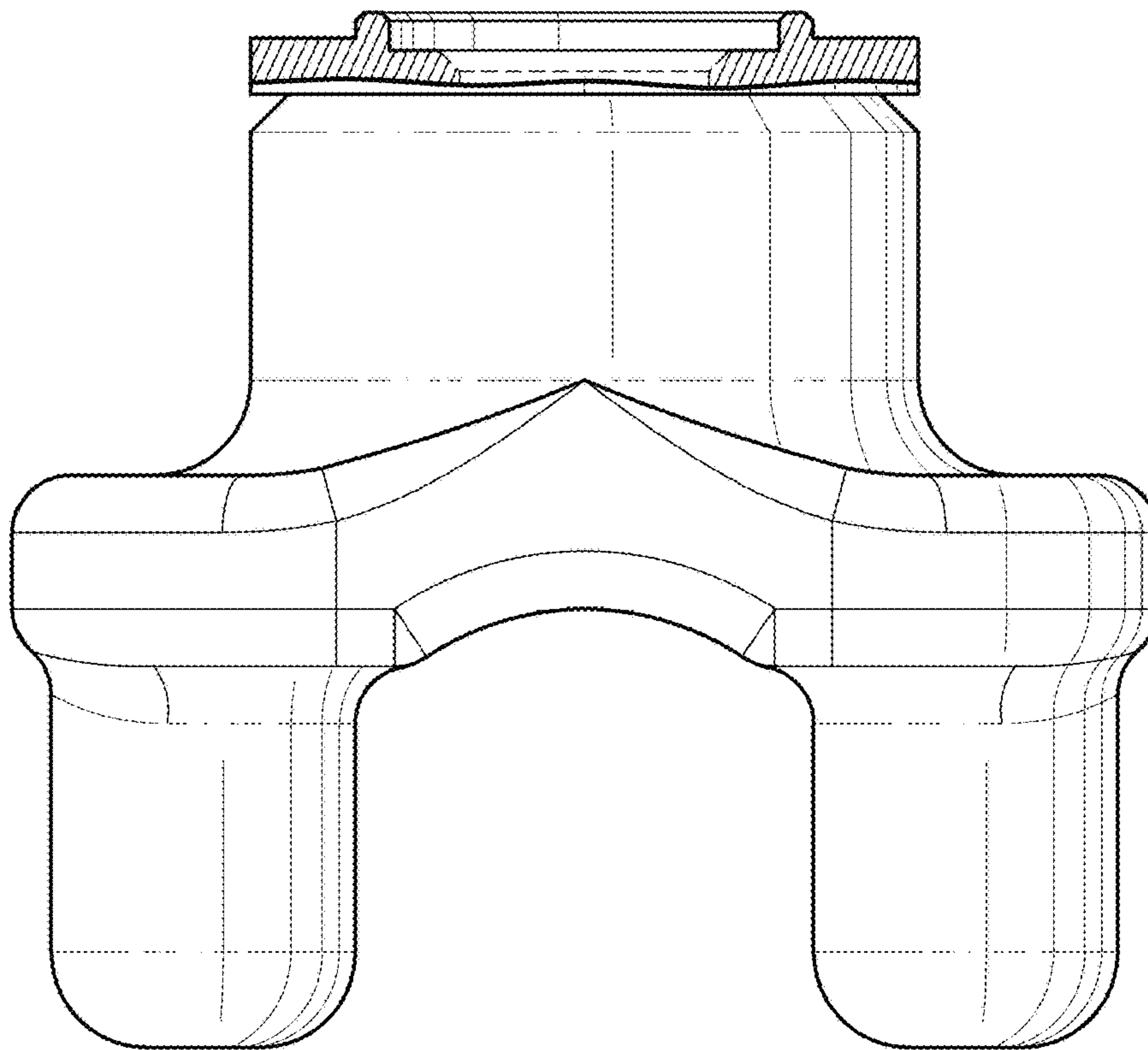
