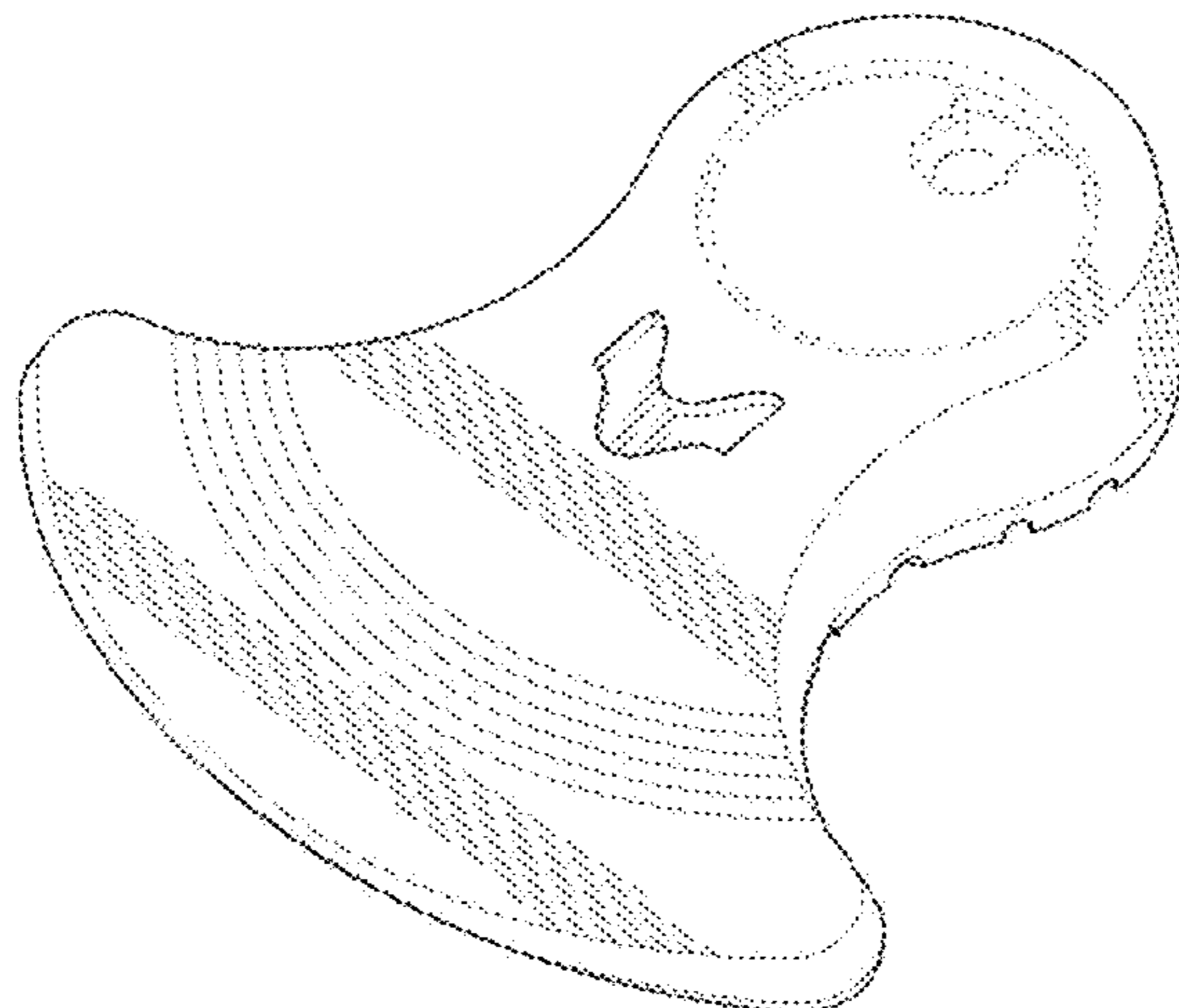
(57) **CLAIM**

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a top, front, and left-side perspective view of a leveling device showing my new design;  
 FIG. 2 is a bottom, rear, and left-side perspective view thereof;  
 FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof;  
 FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof;  
 FIG. 5 is a front end elevation view thereof;  
 FIG. 6 is a rear end elevation view thereof;  
 FIG. 7 is a left-side elevation view thereof;  
 FIG. 8 is a right-side elevation view thereof;  
 FIG. 9 is a top plan view of the leveling device with an unclaimed replicable insert;

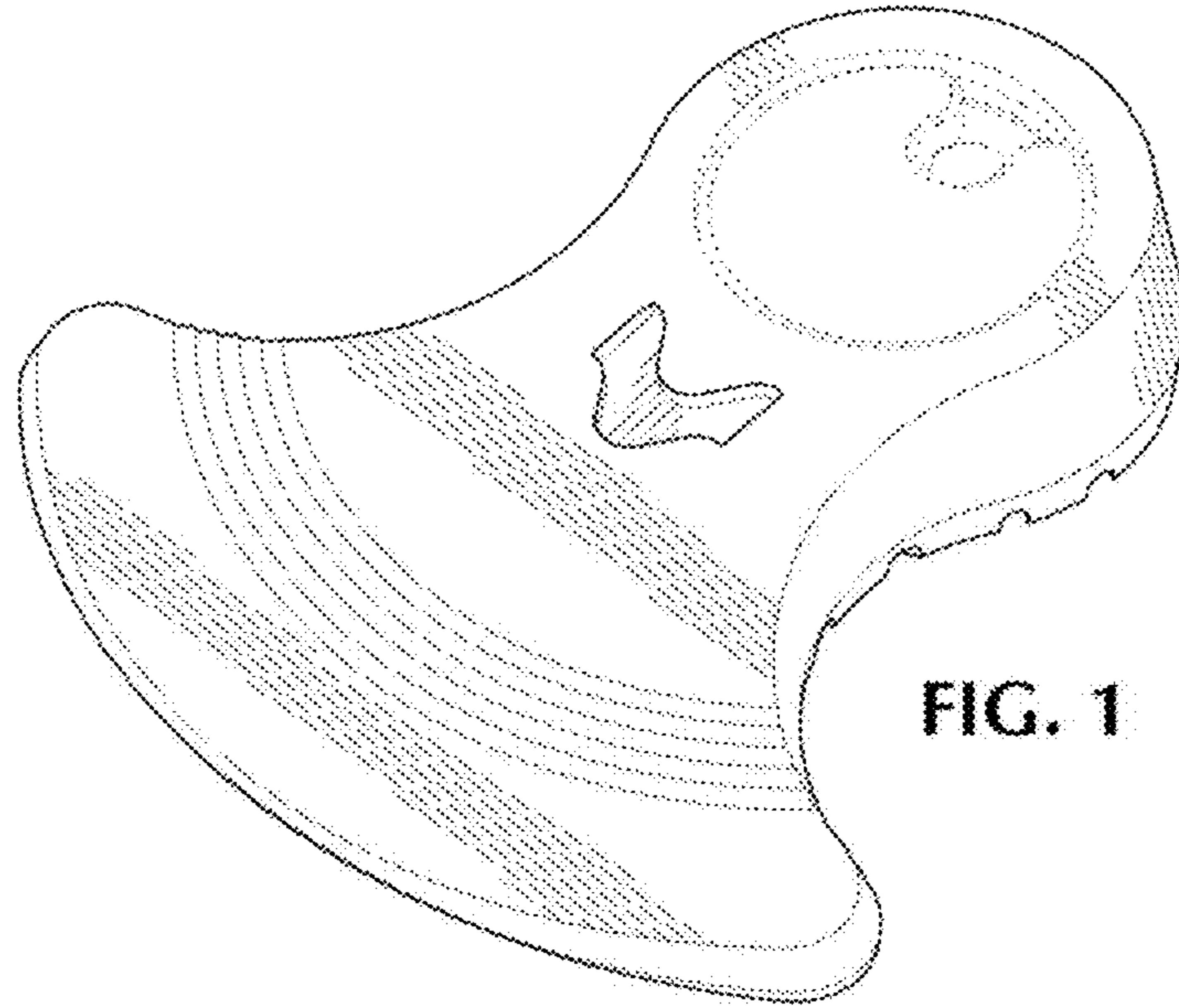

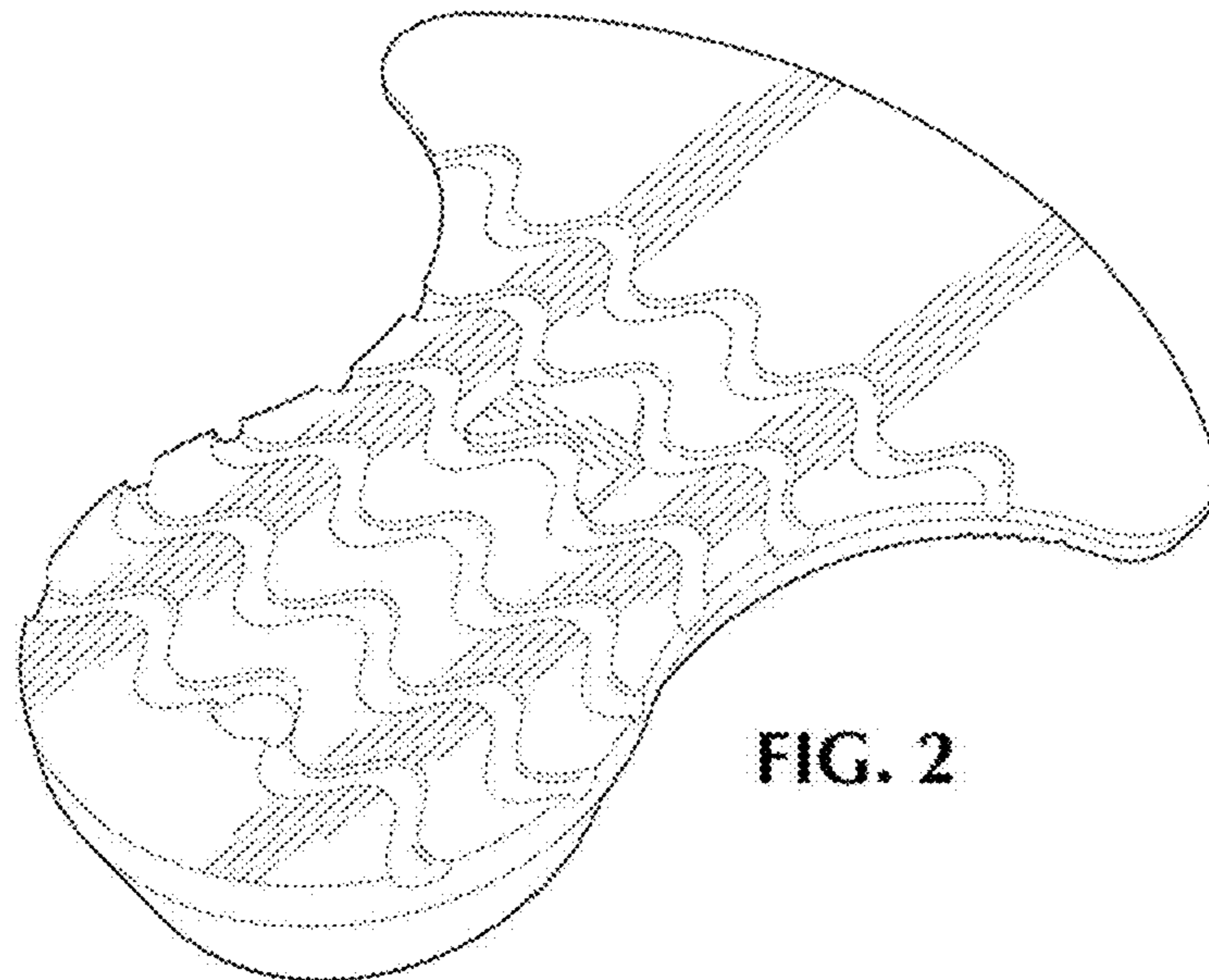

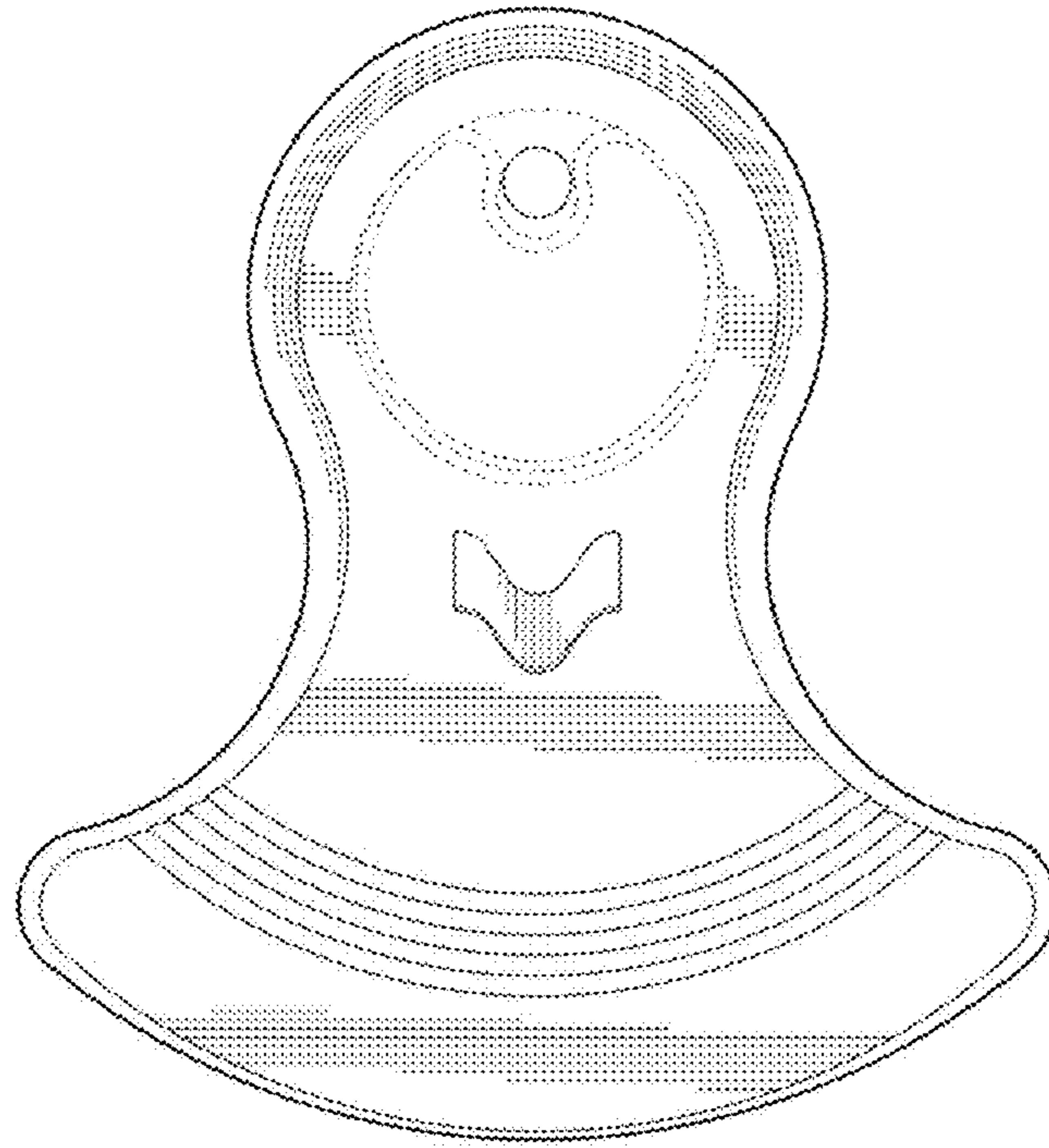

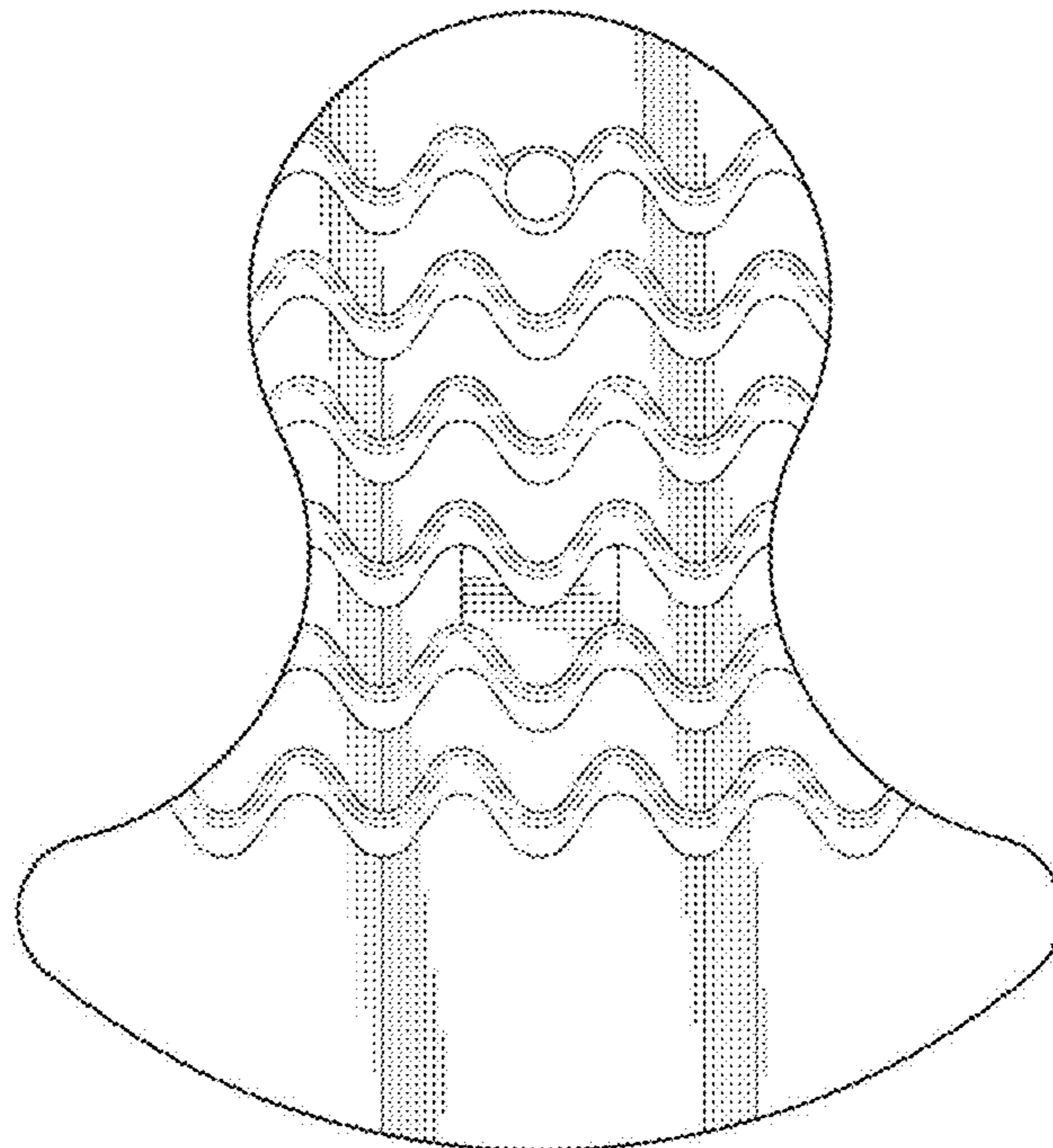

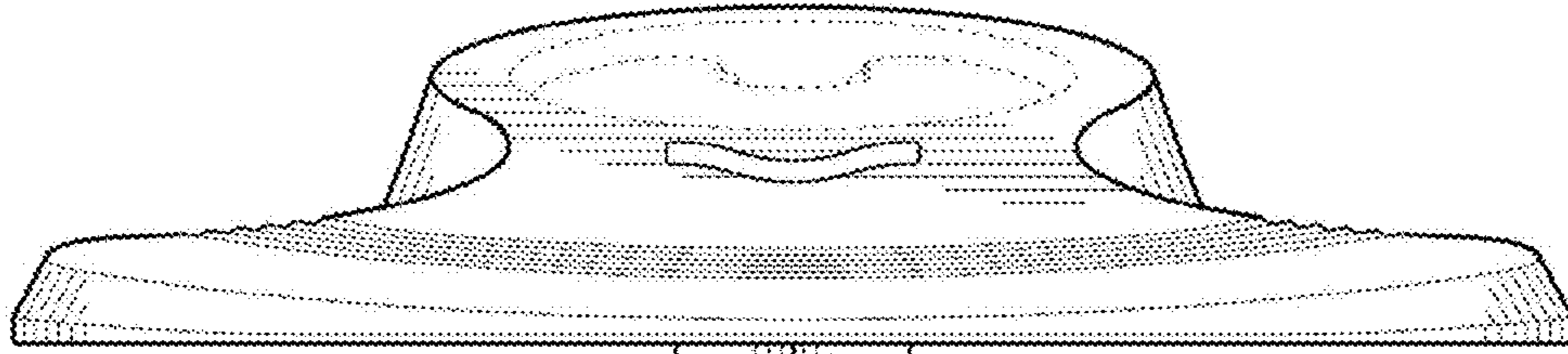

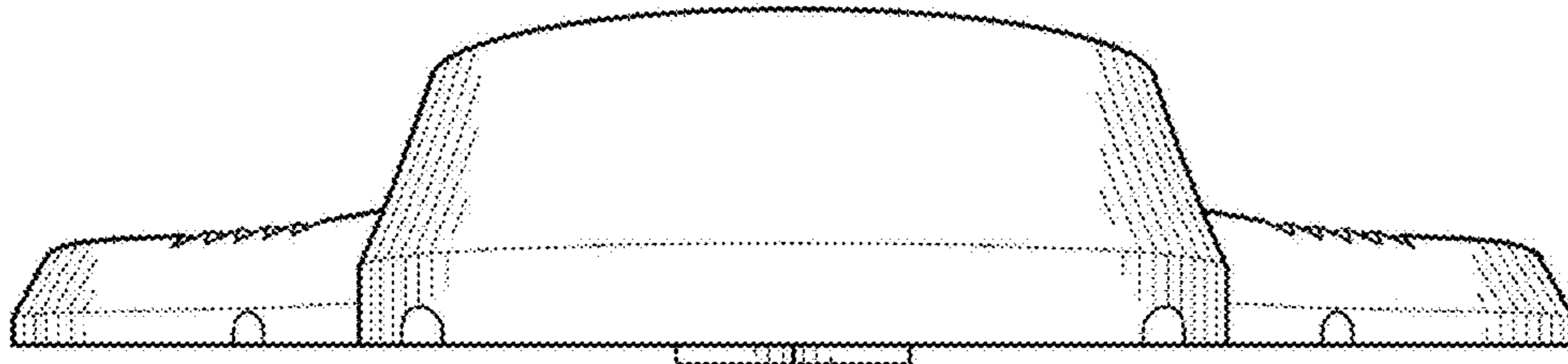

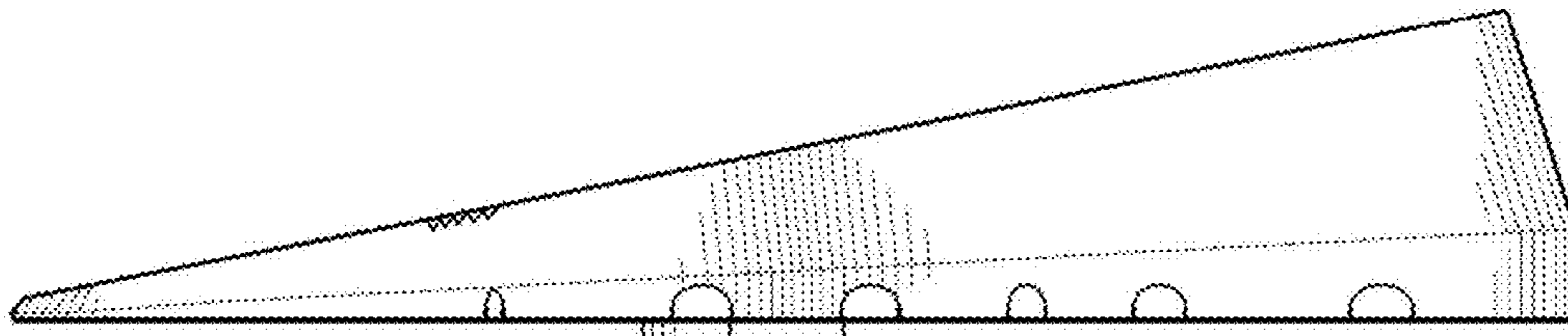

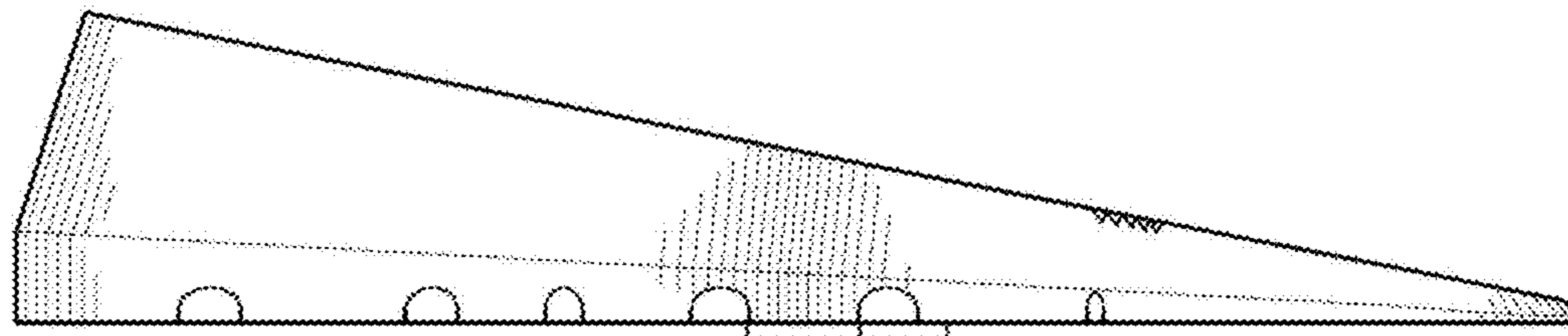

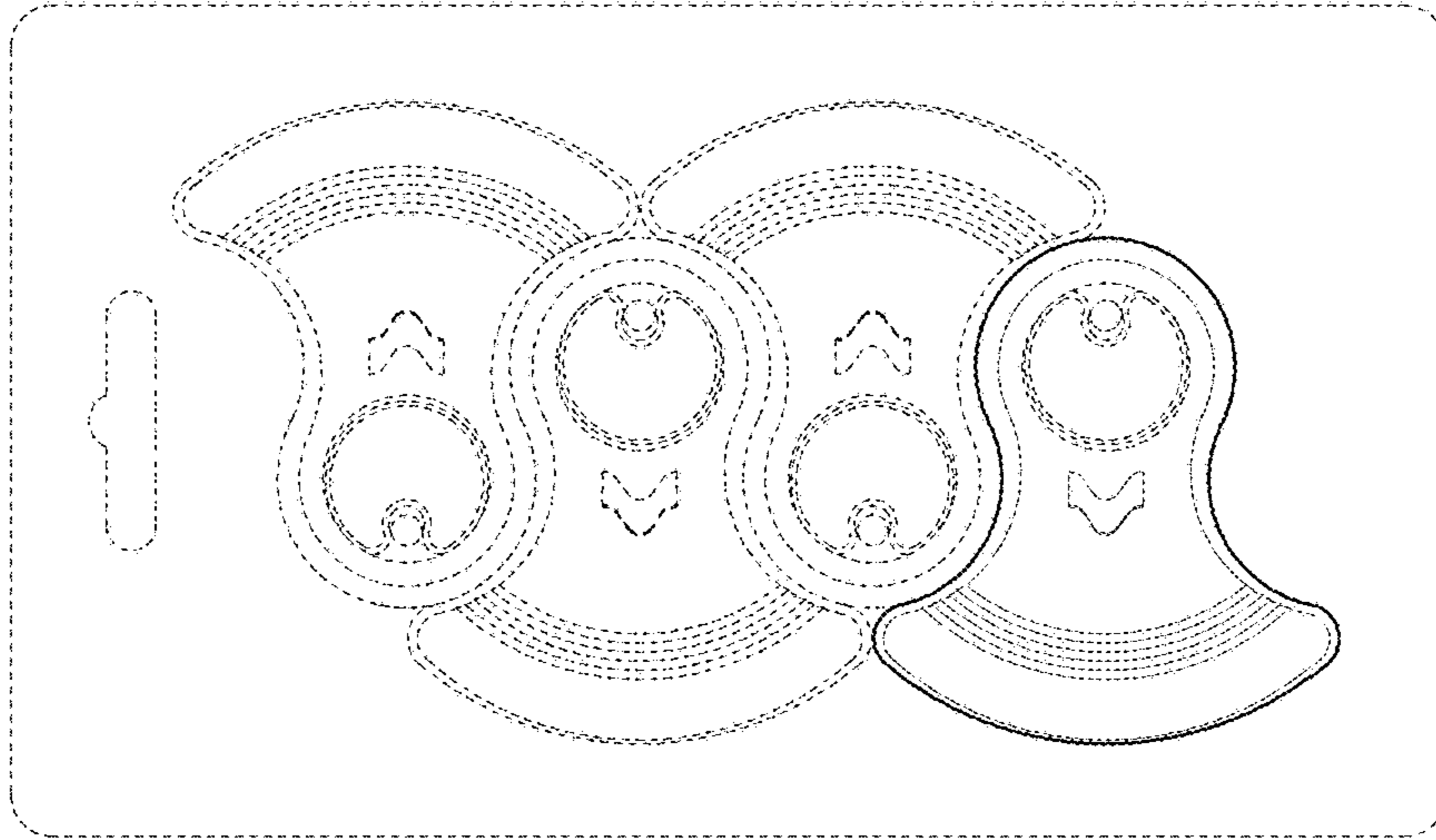

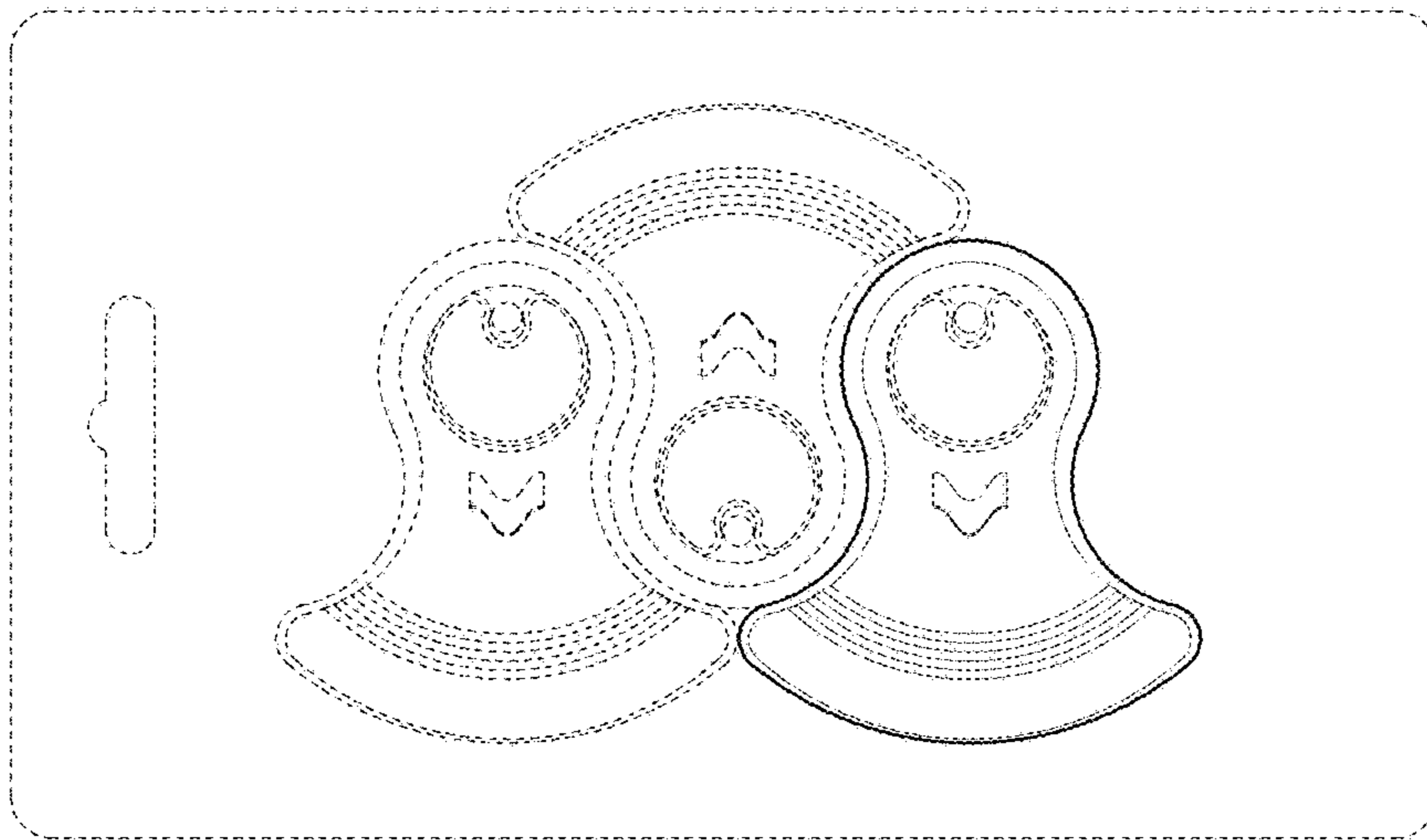

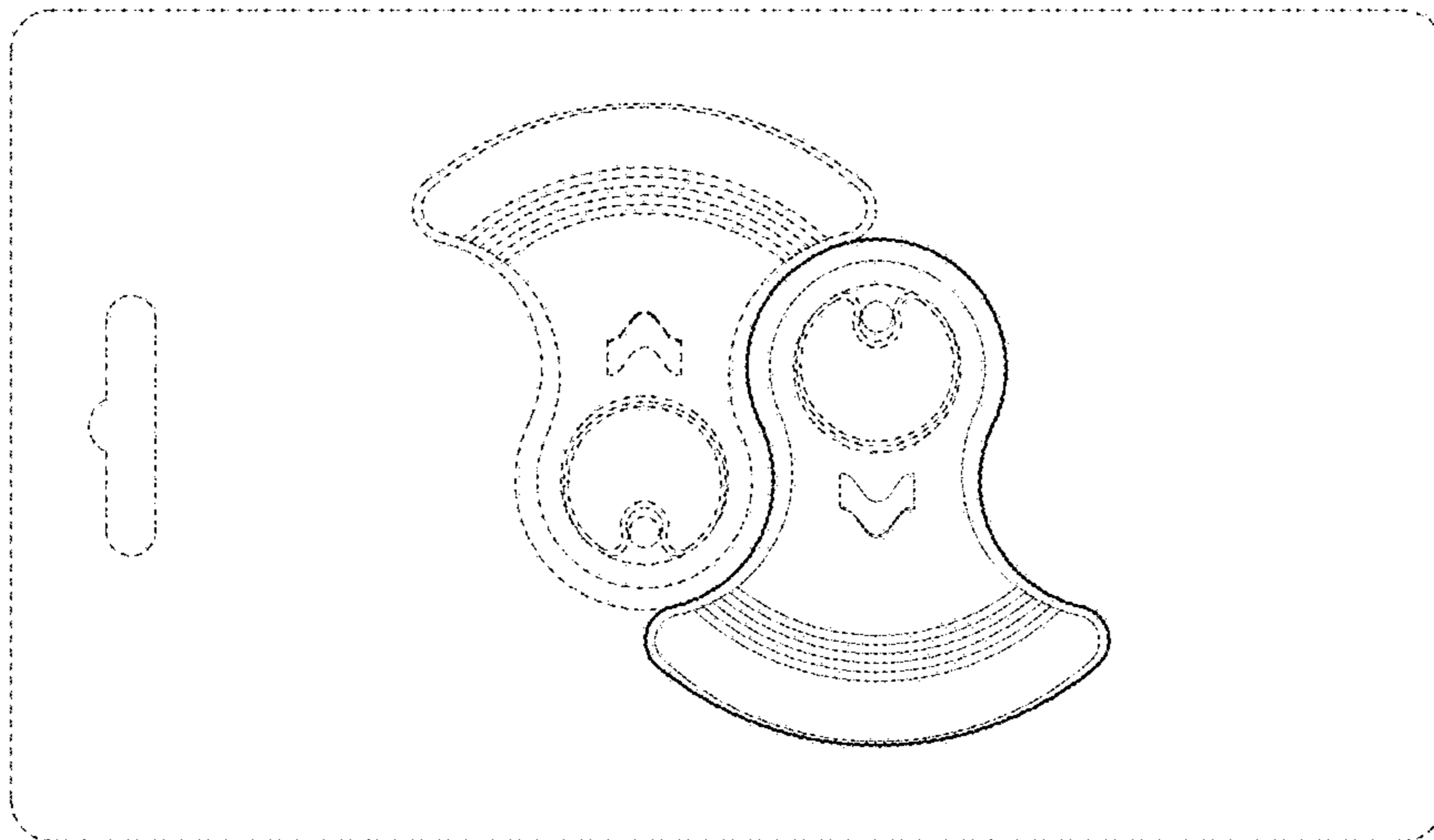
