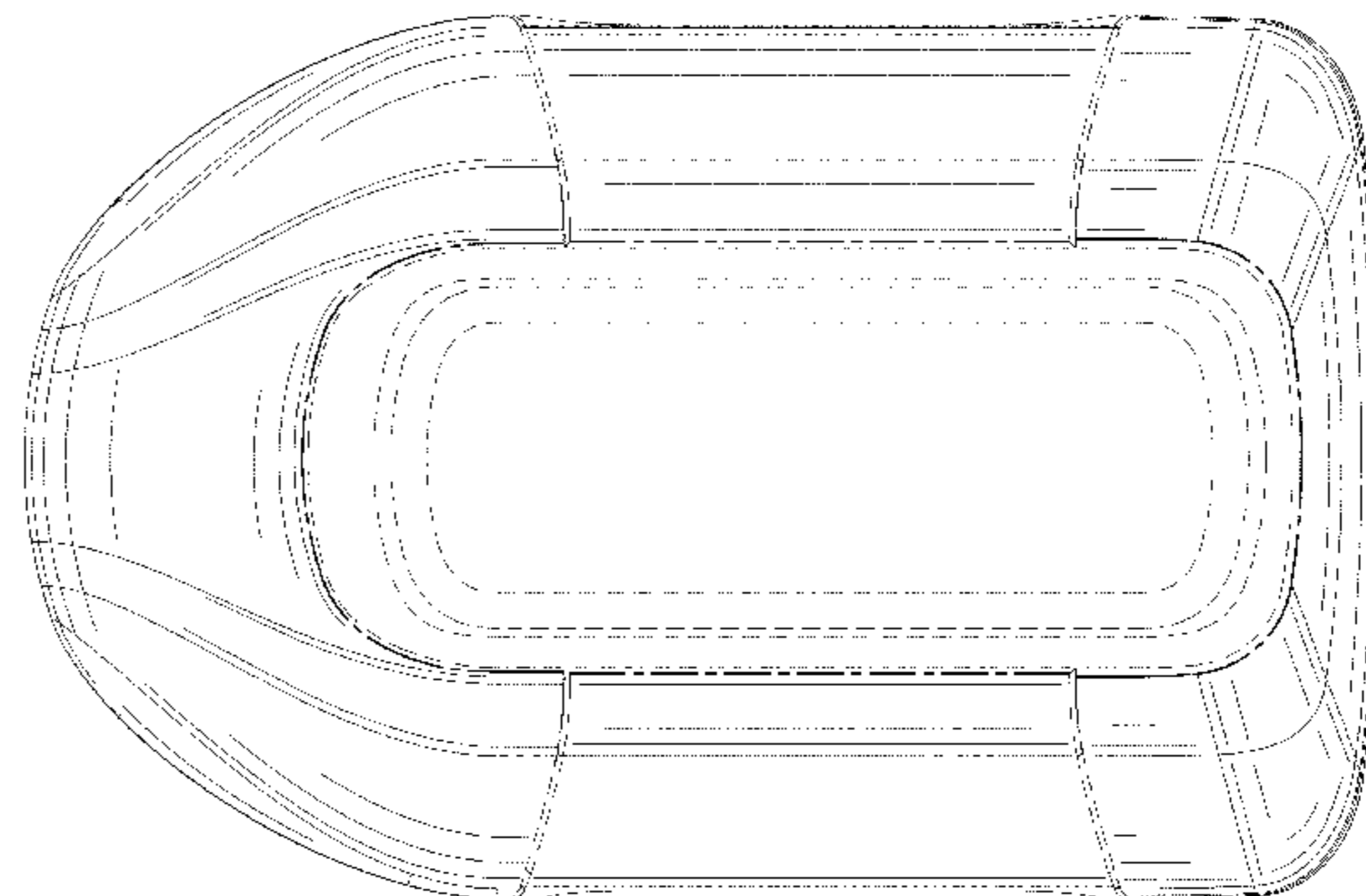
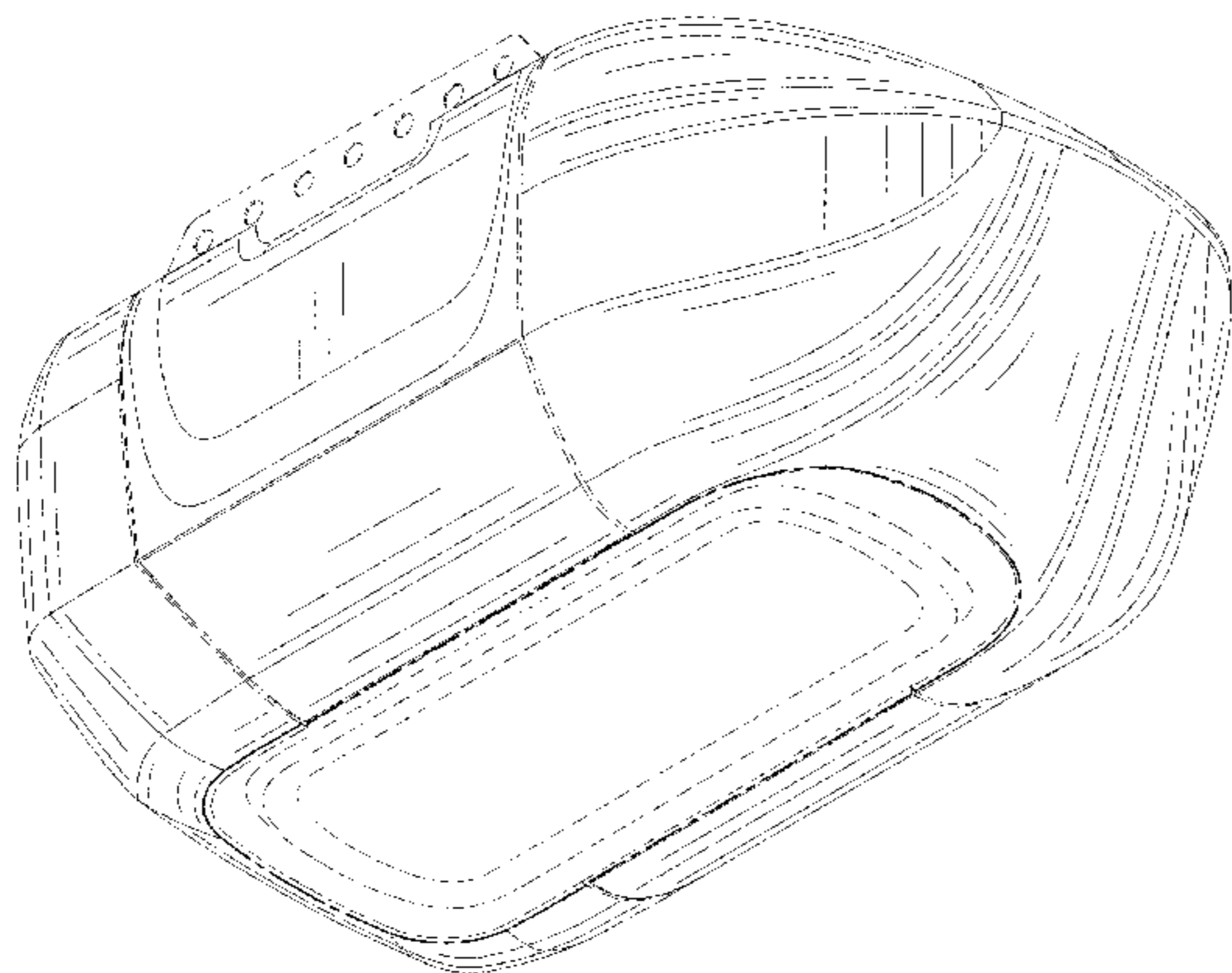
We claim the ornamental design for movable barrier operator device, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

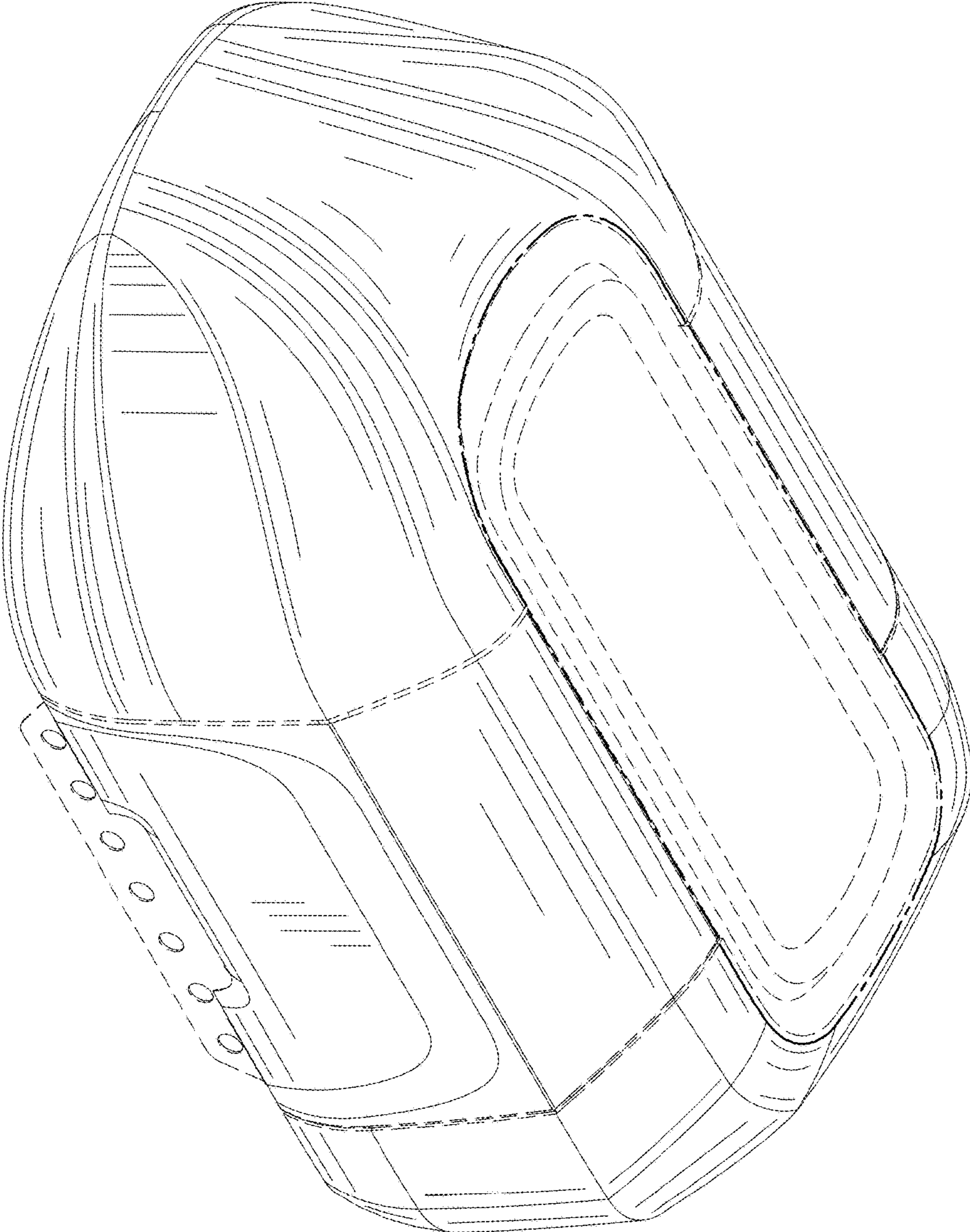

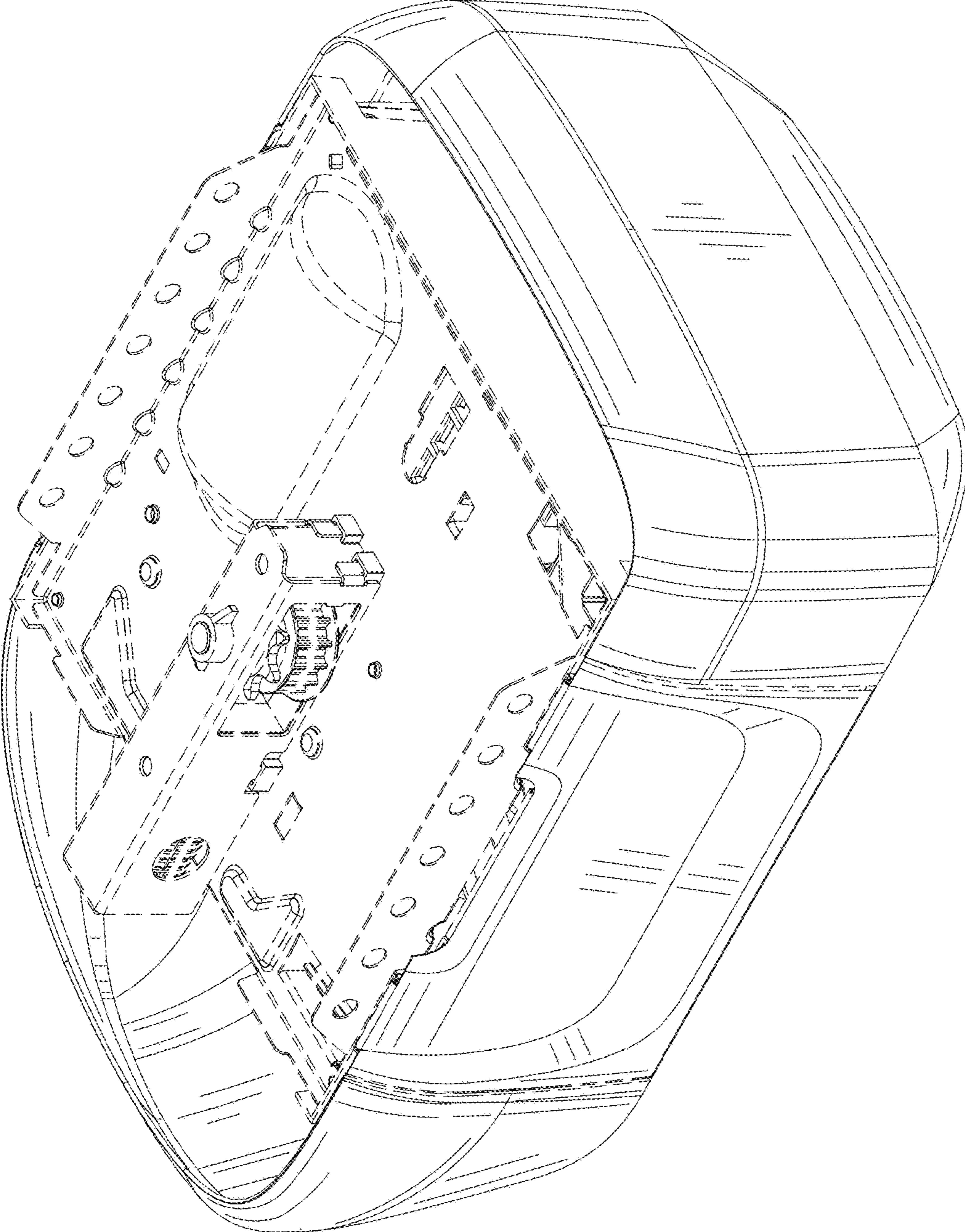

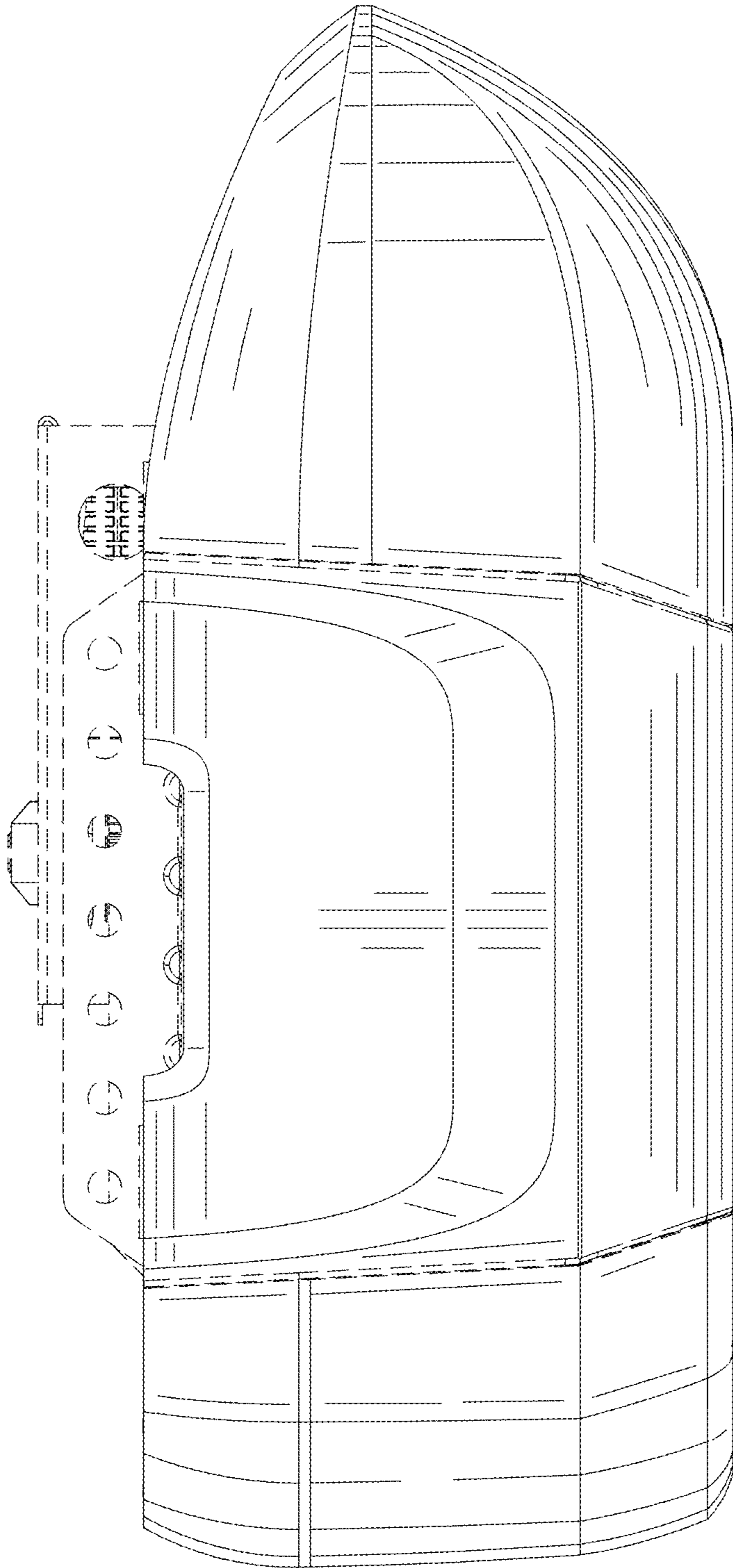

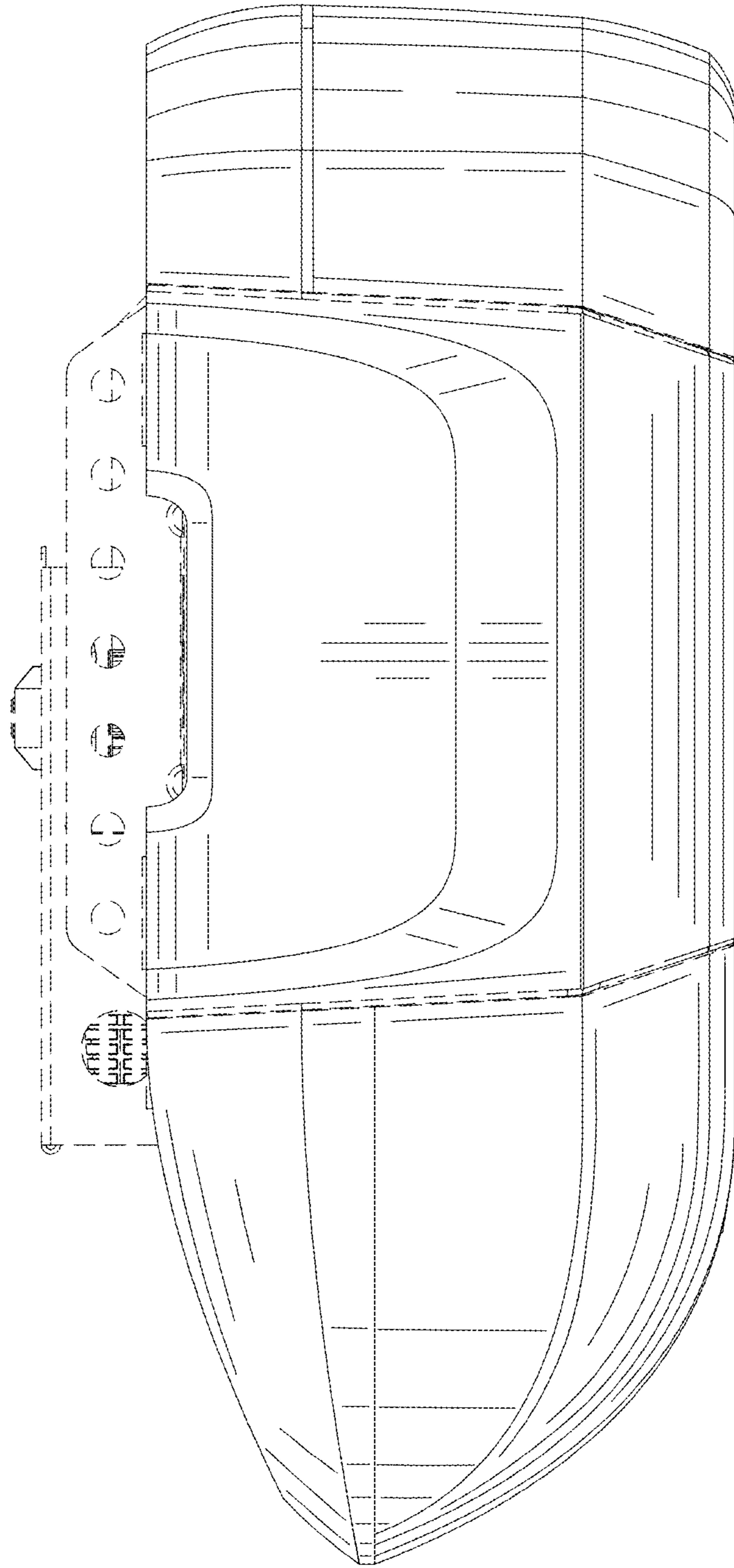

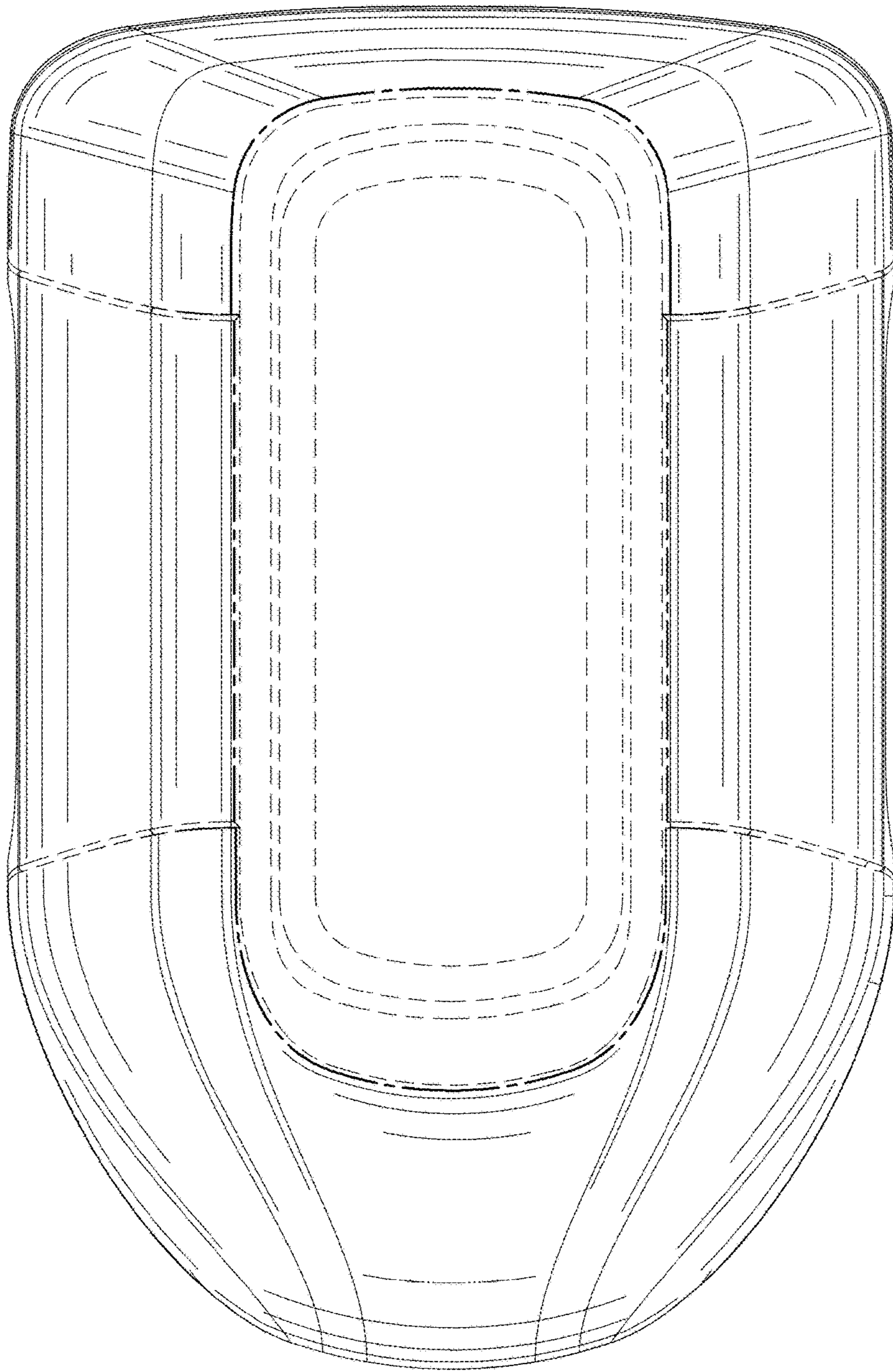

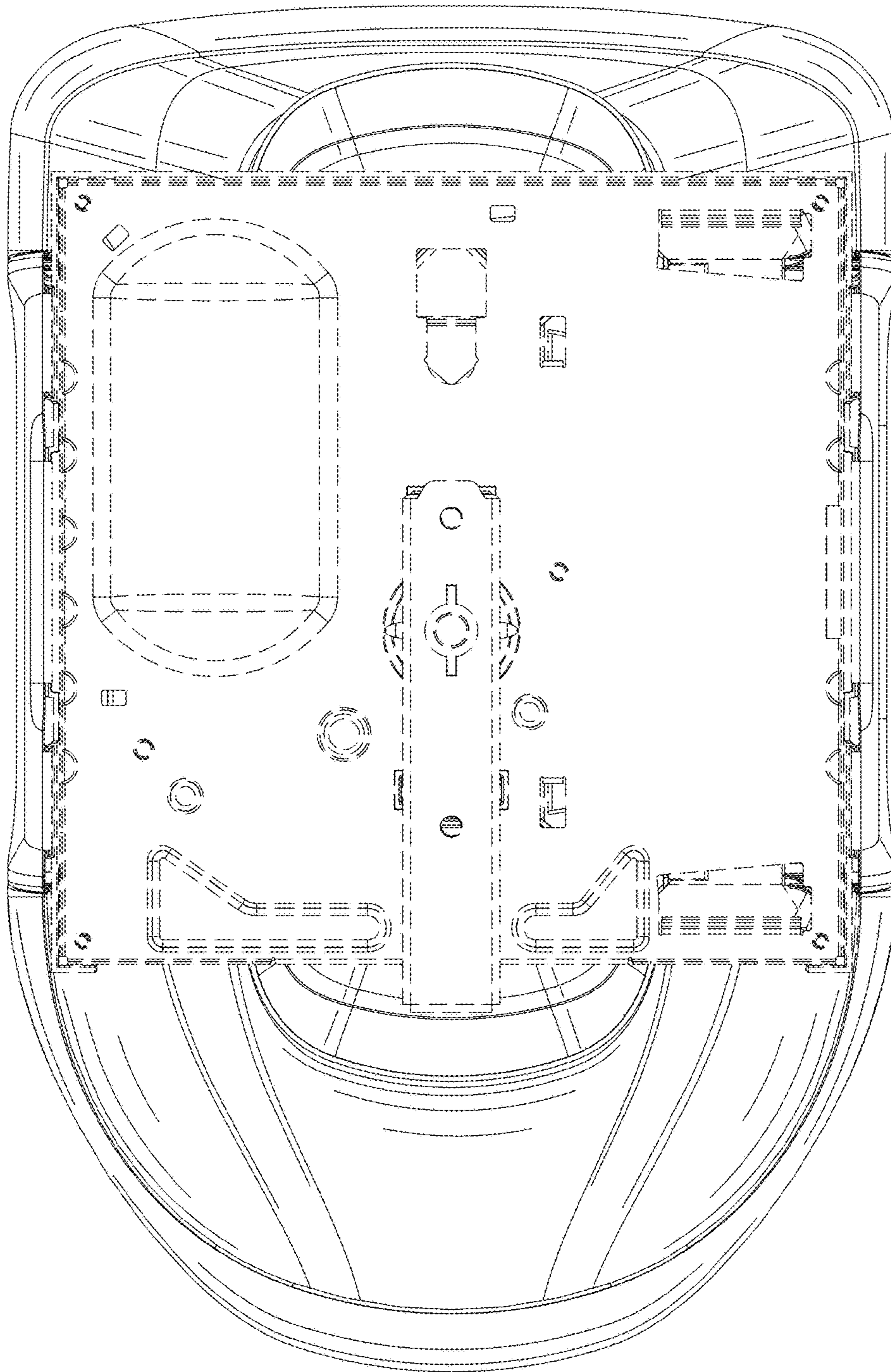

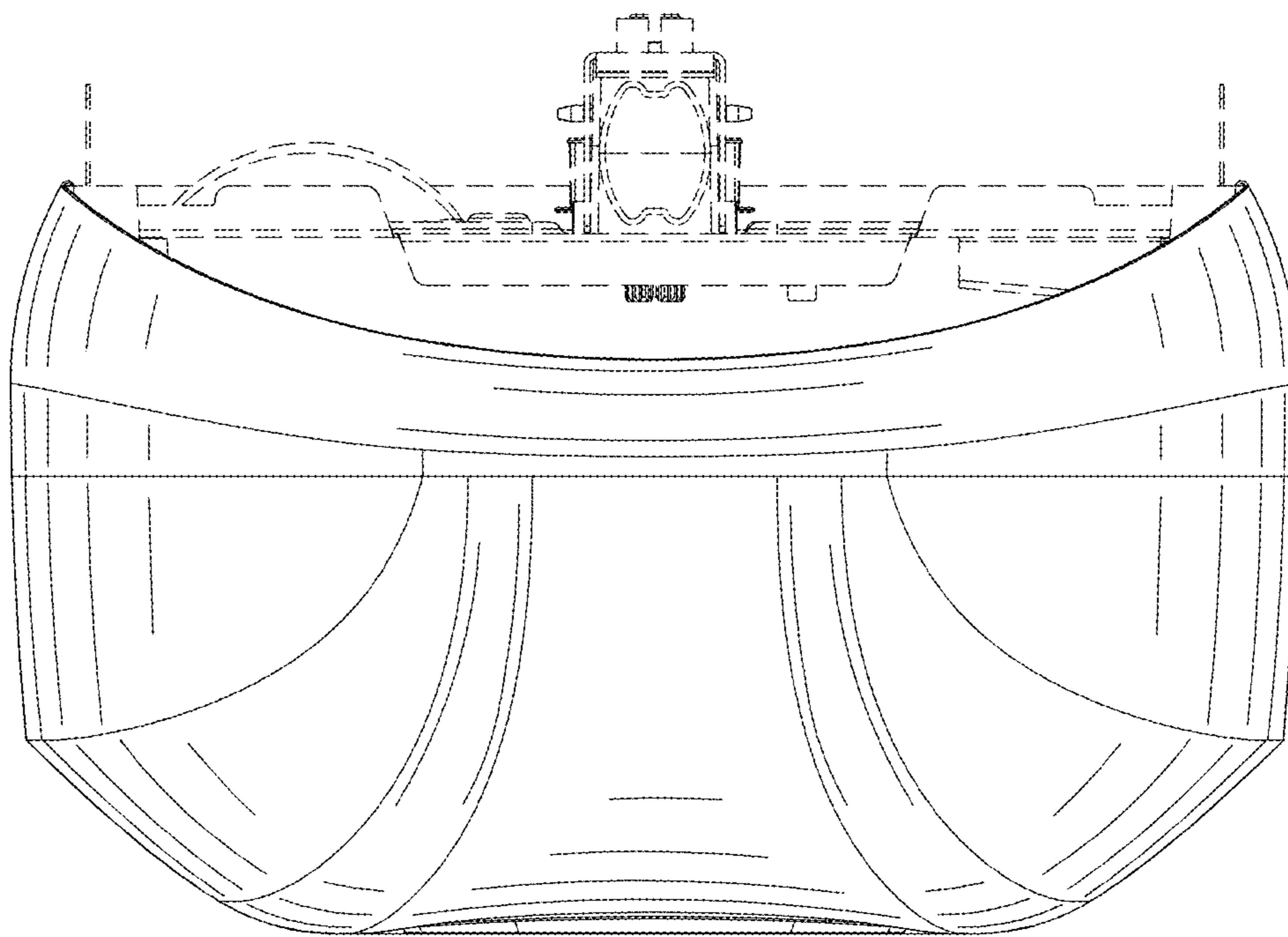

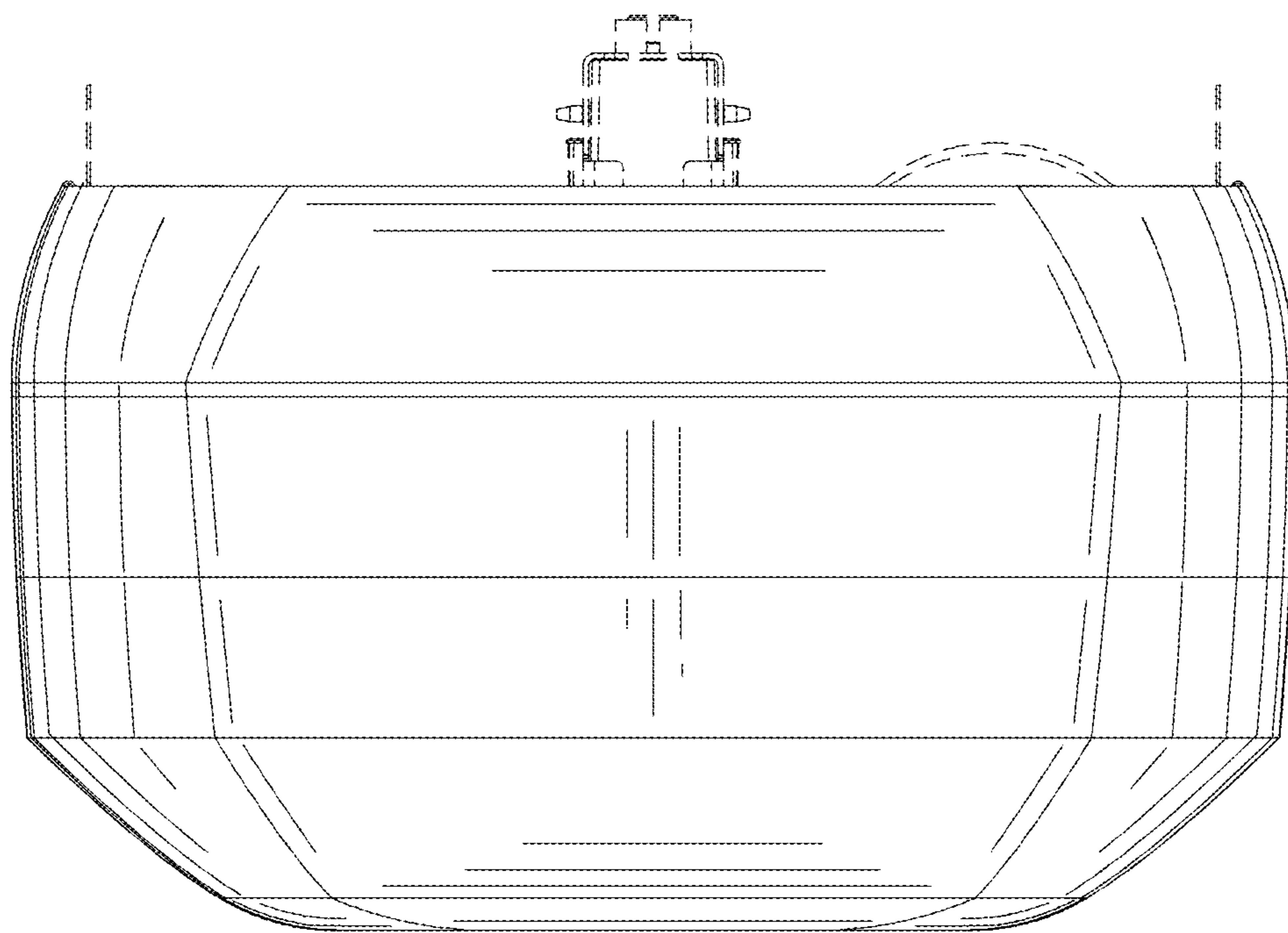
