FIG. 1 is a front view of a first embodiment thereof for an animated design in a first state; and

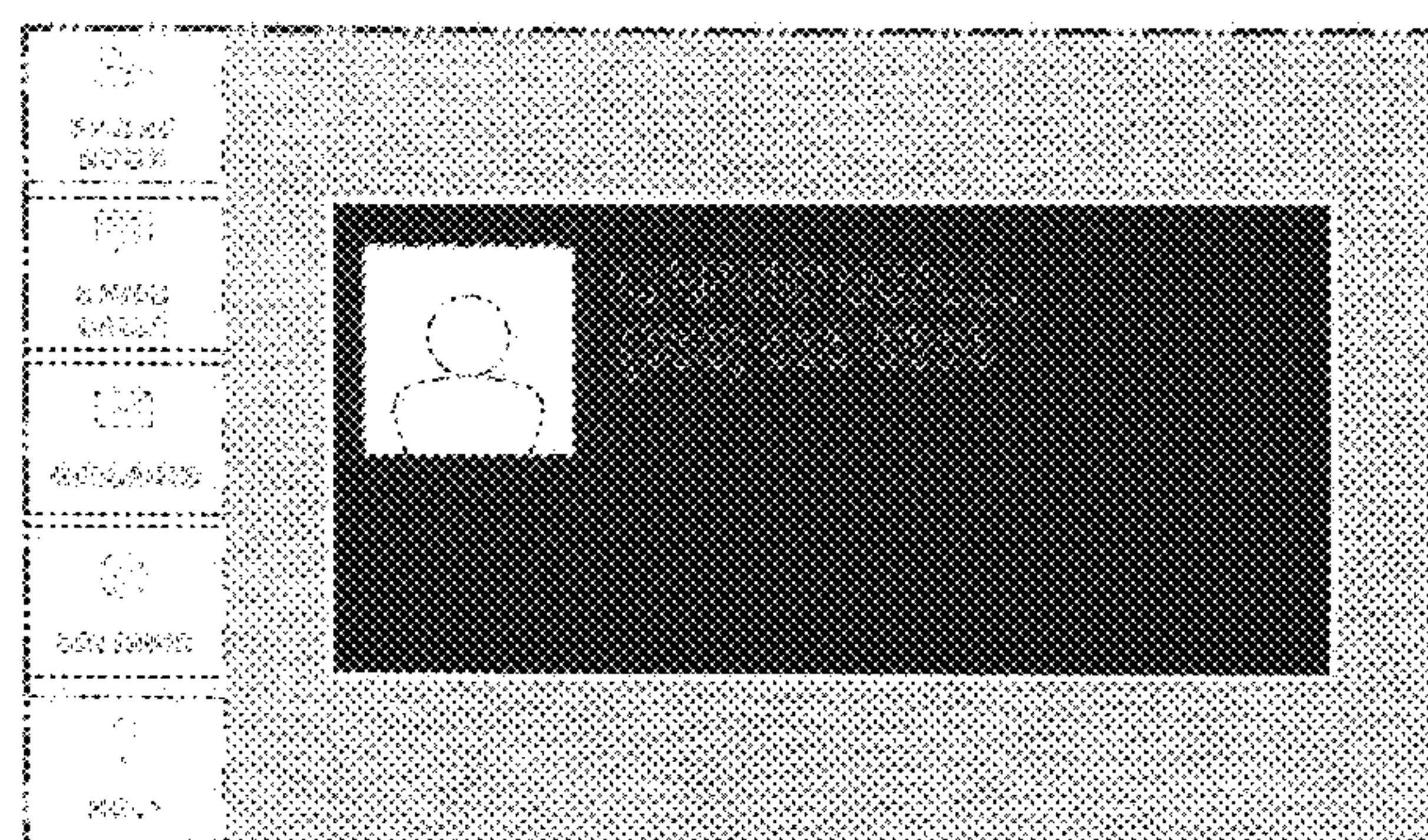
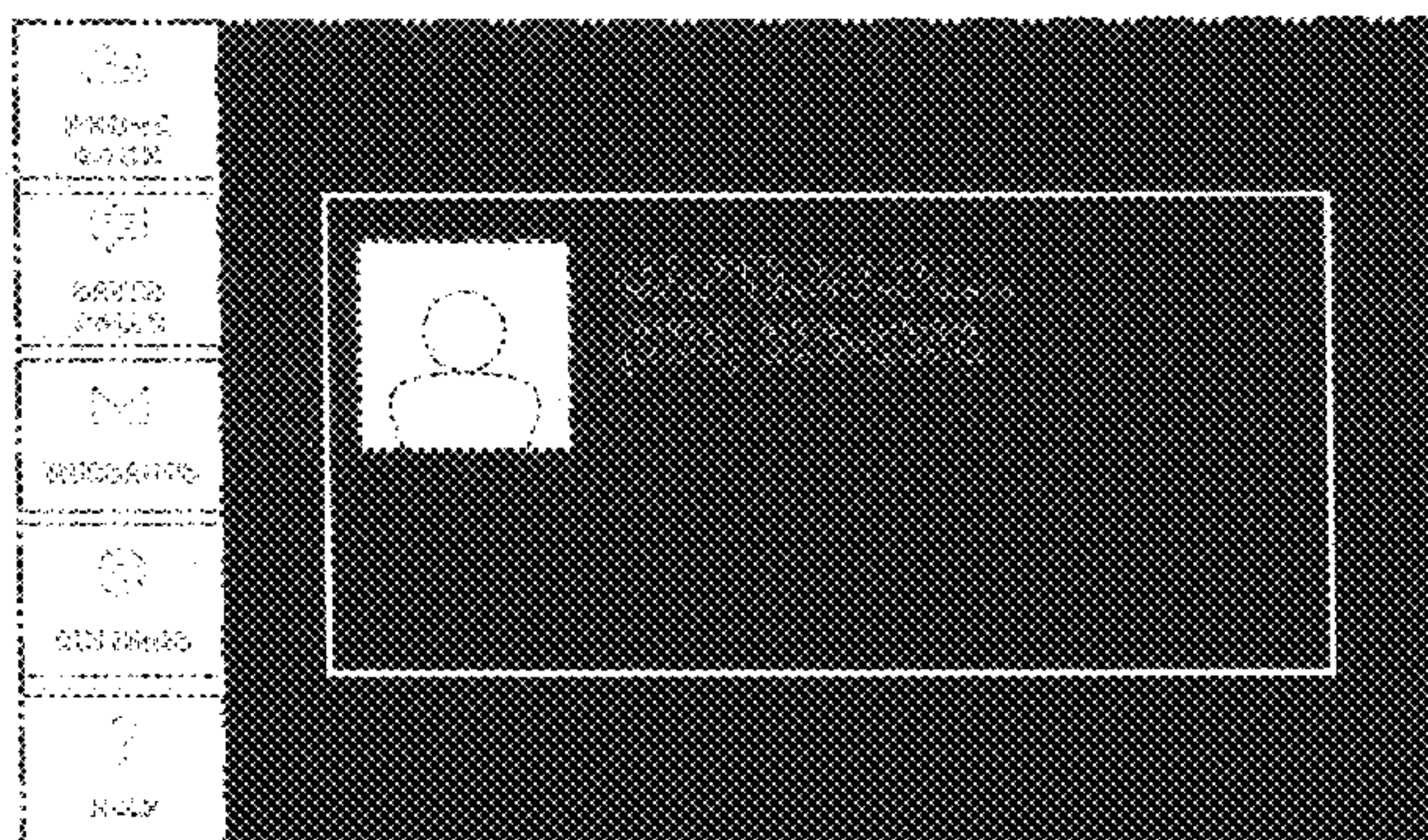

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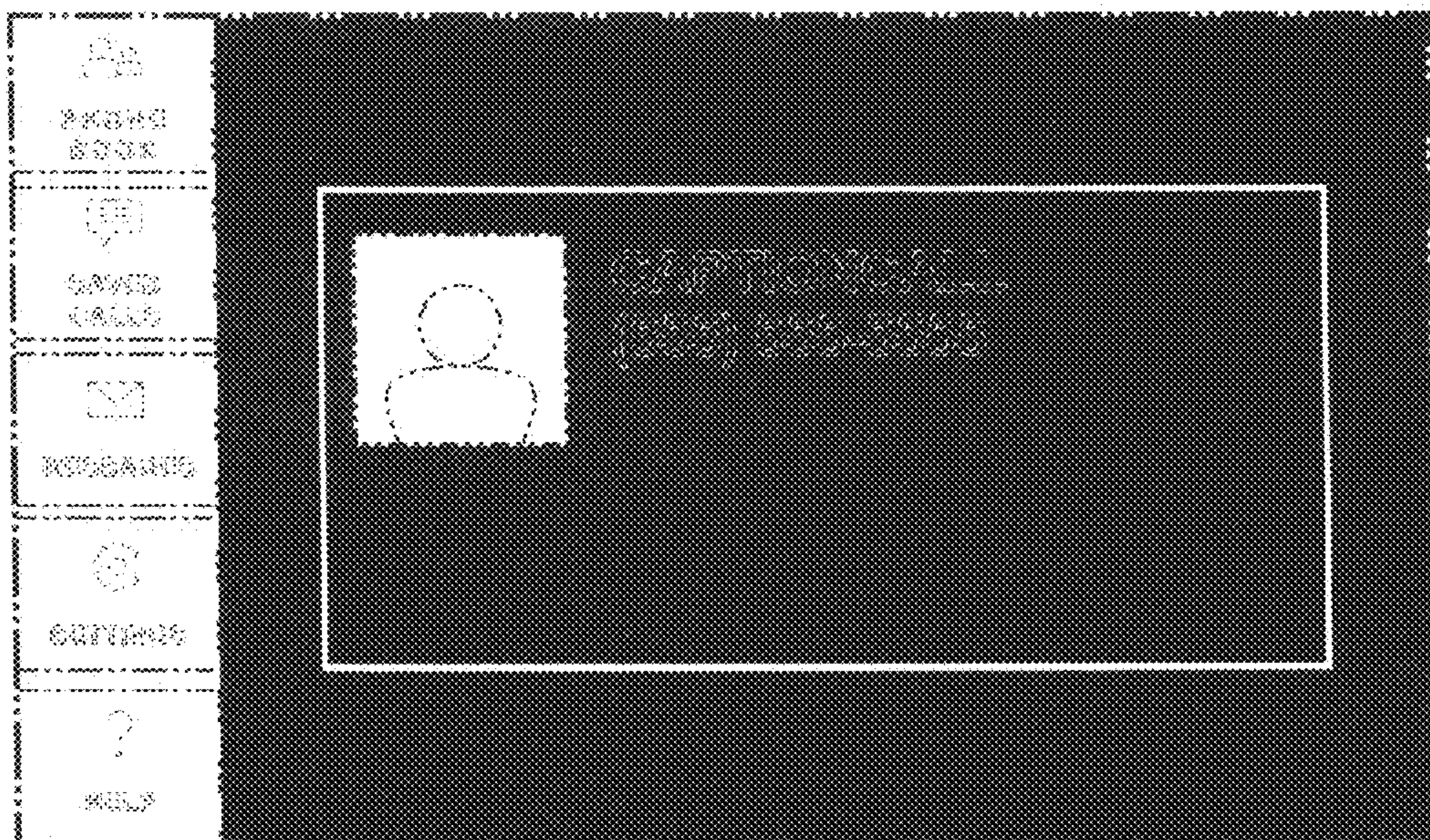

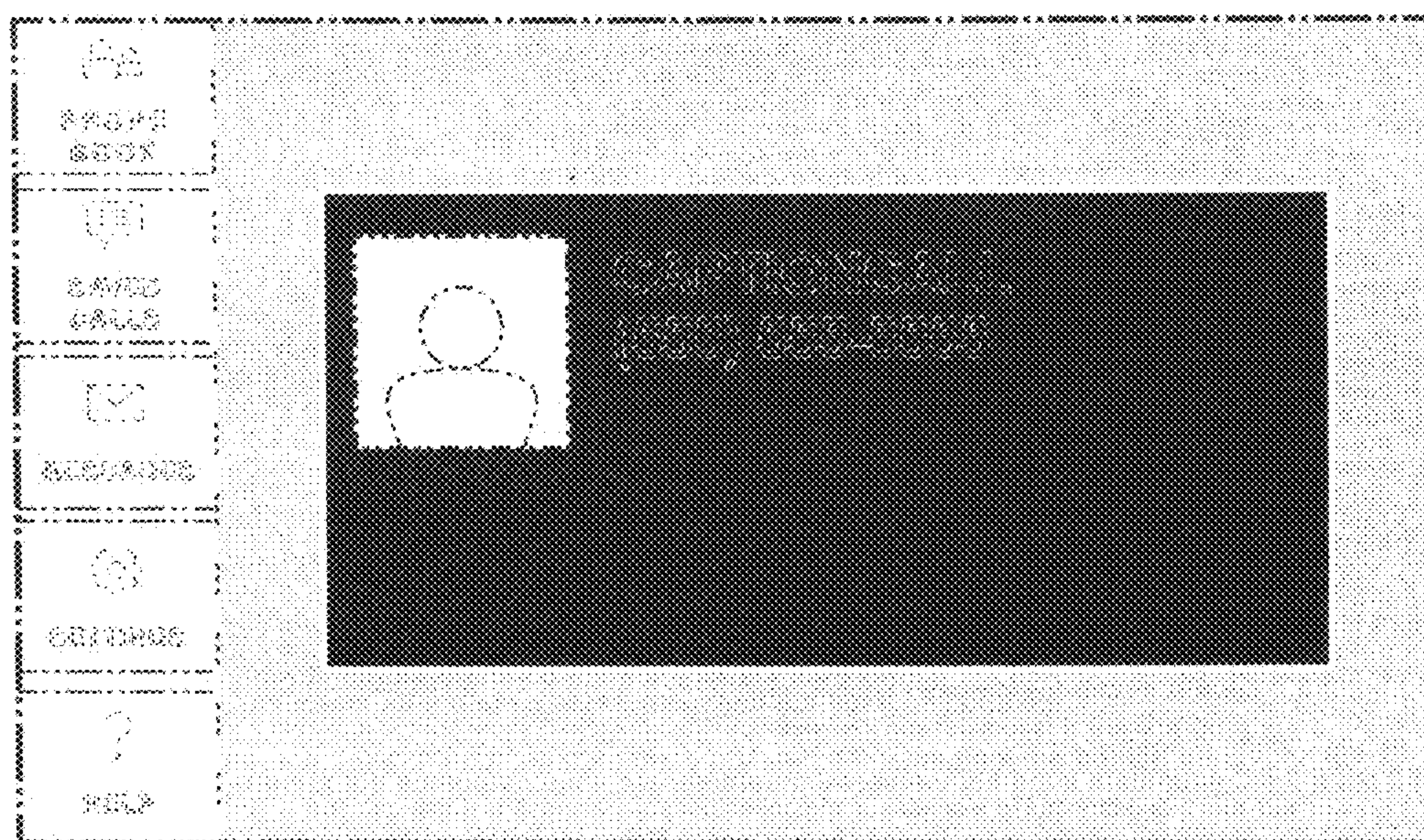

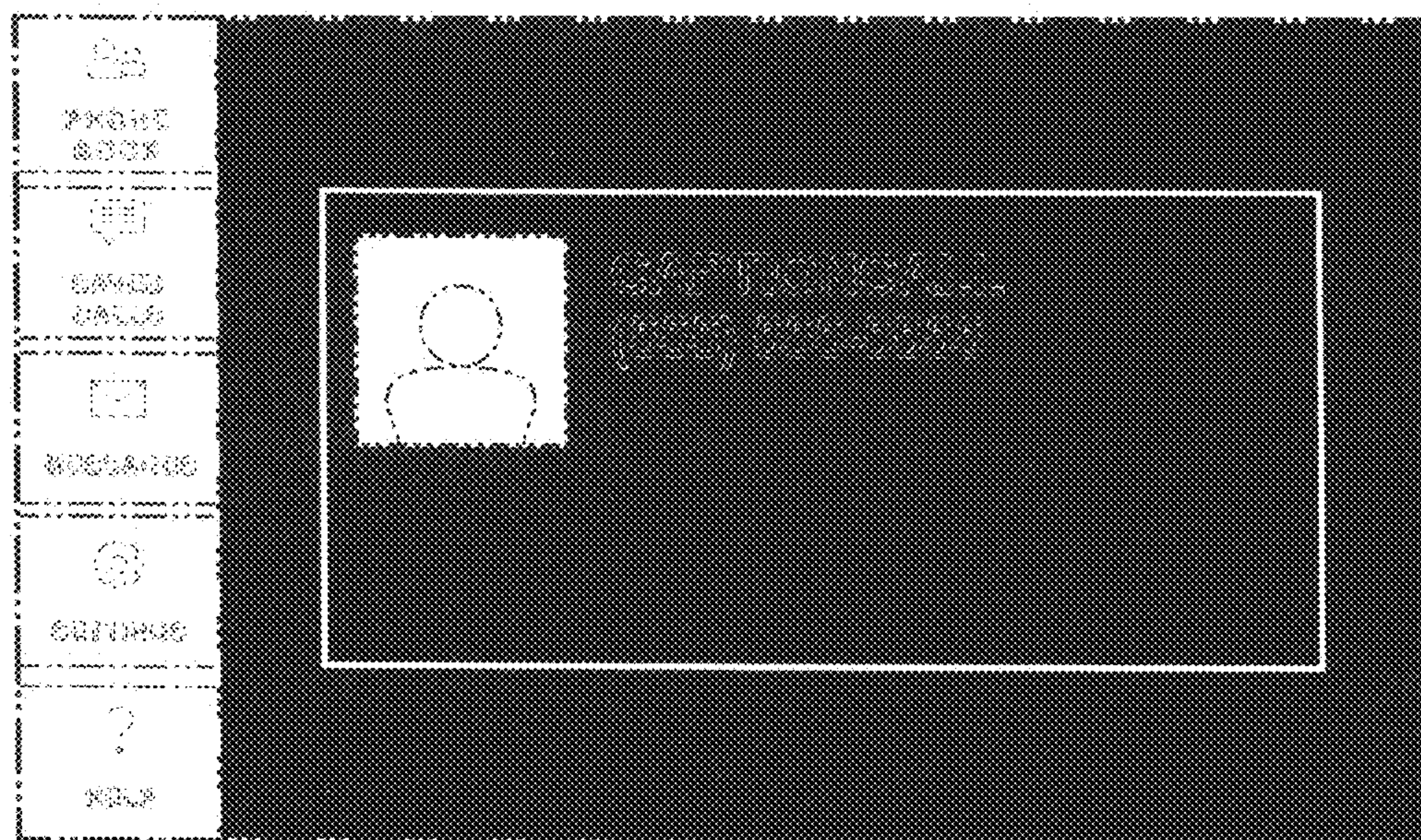

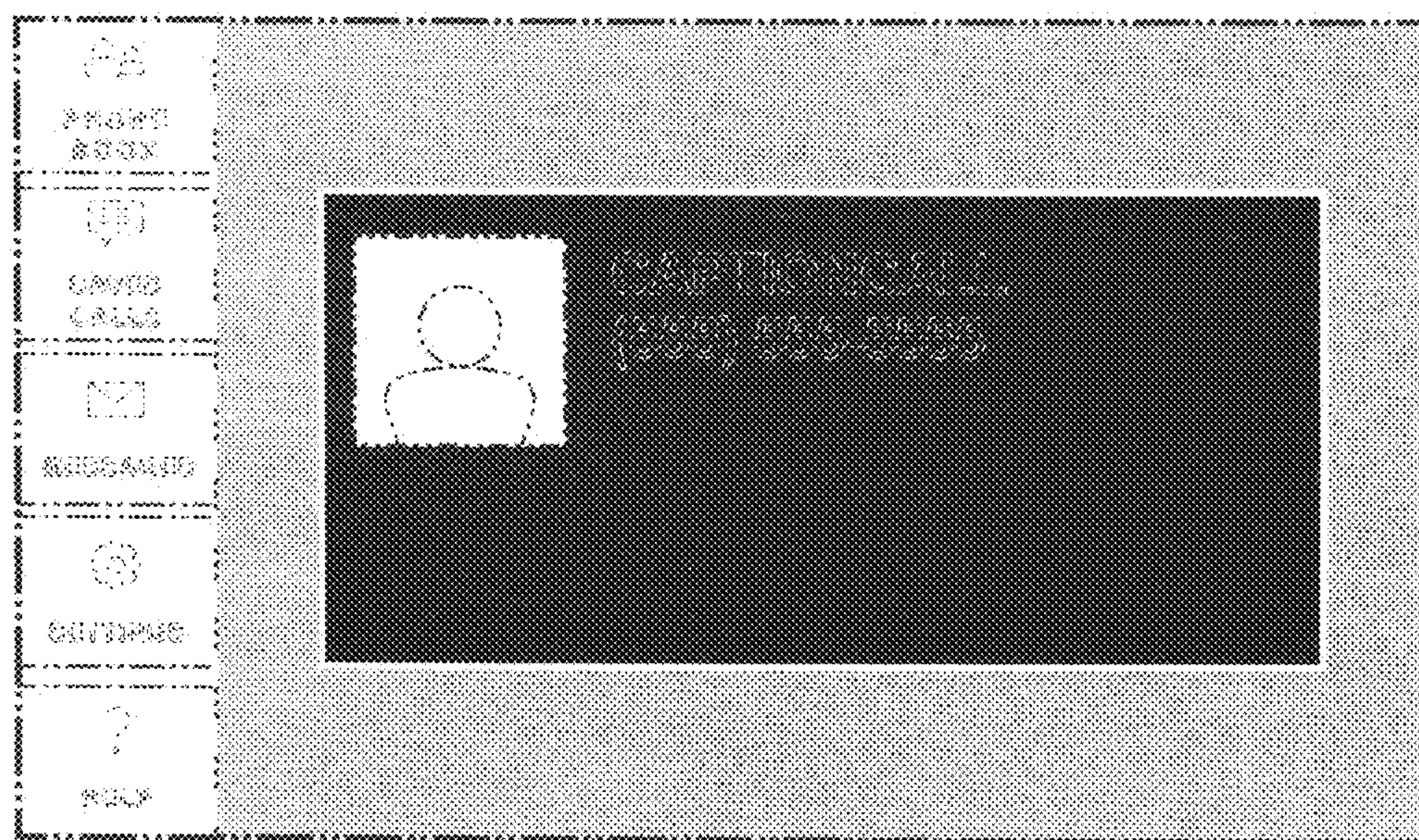
