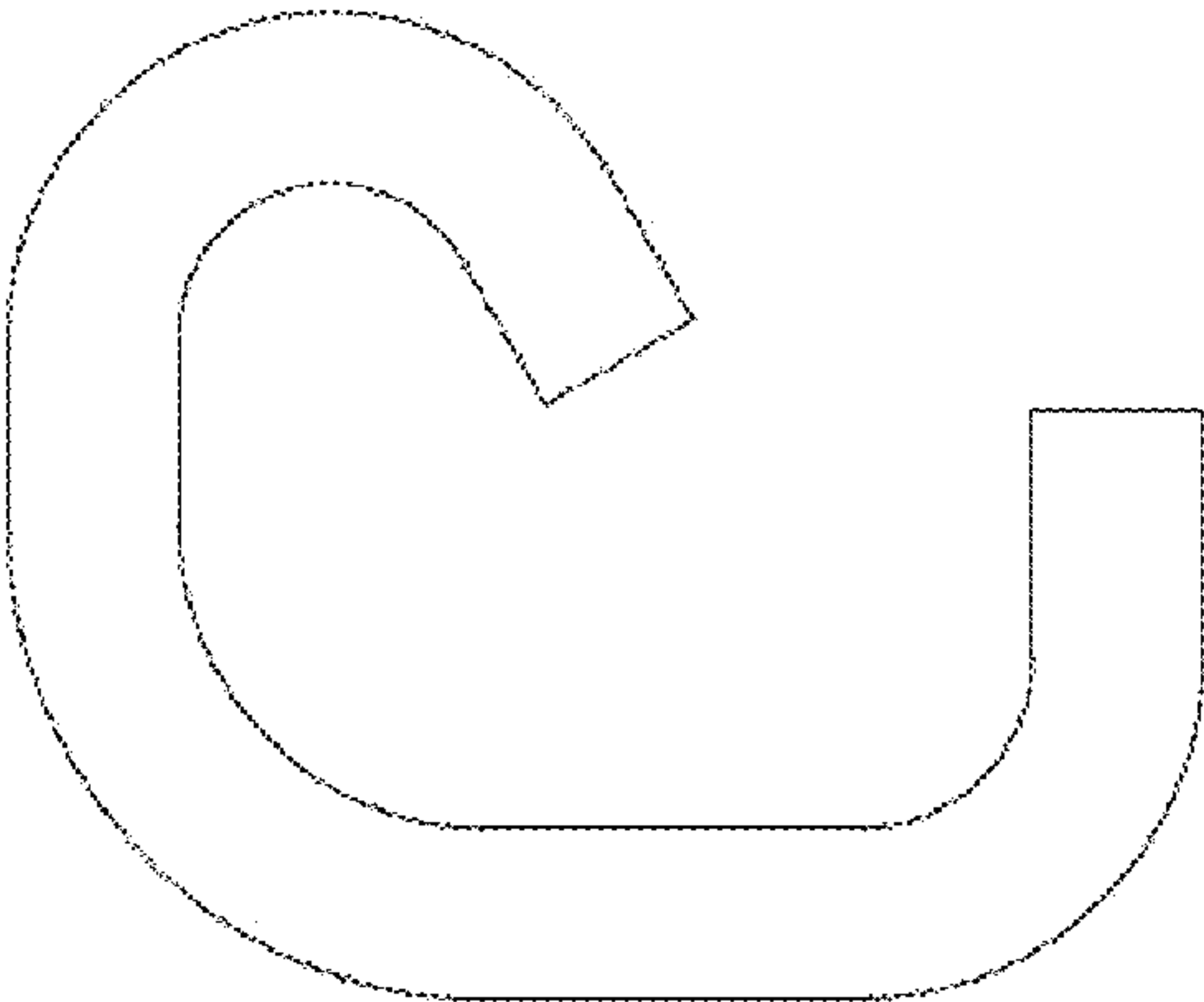
CLAIM

The ornamental design for a connector for sheet pile, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1.1 is a front elevation view of a connector for sheet pile according to my new design; and
FIG. 1.2 is a top, front, right side perspective view thereof.
The pair of adjacent broken lines form no part of the claimed design and indicate that the appearance of any portion of the article between the break lines forms no part of the claimed design.

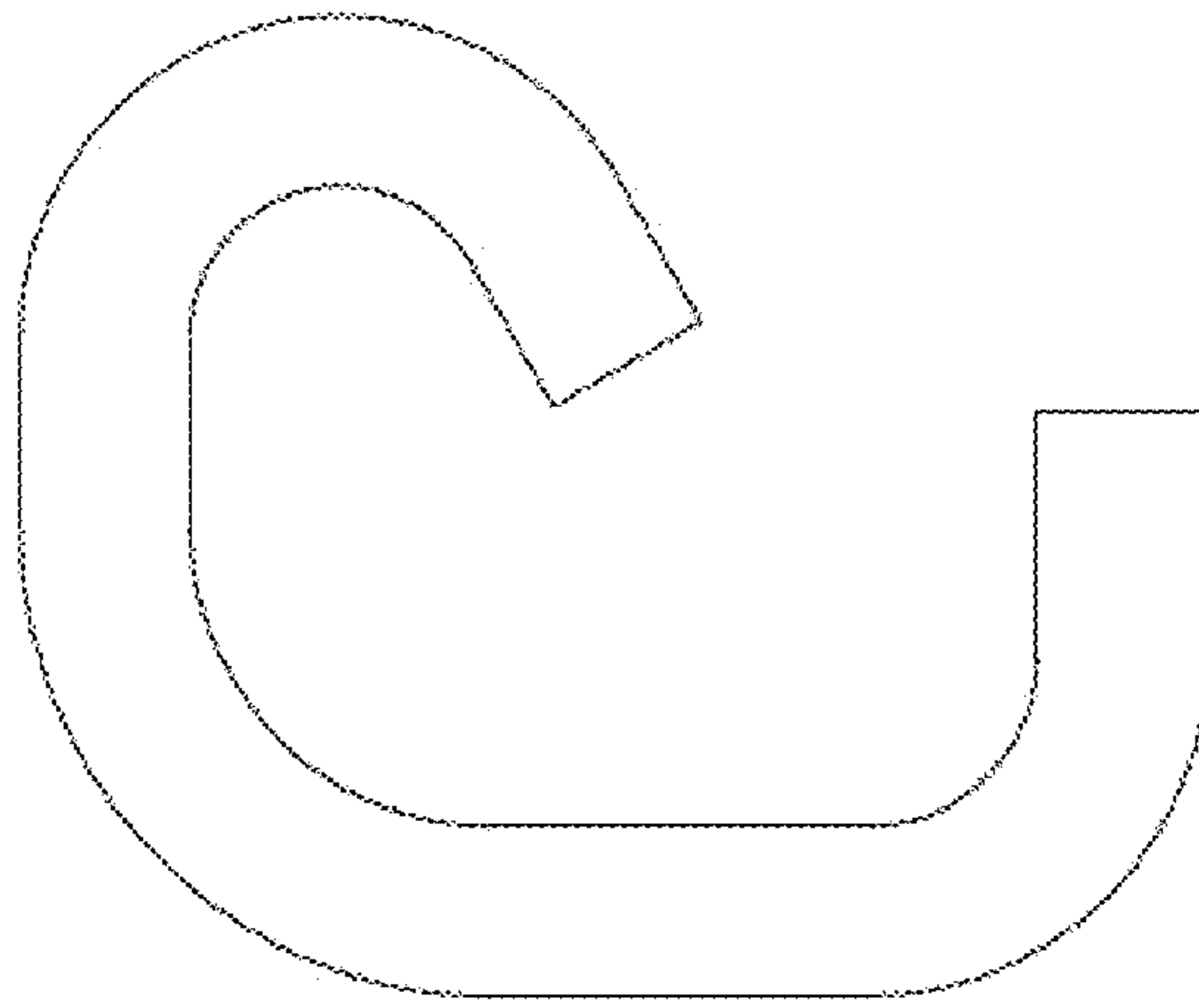

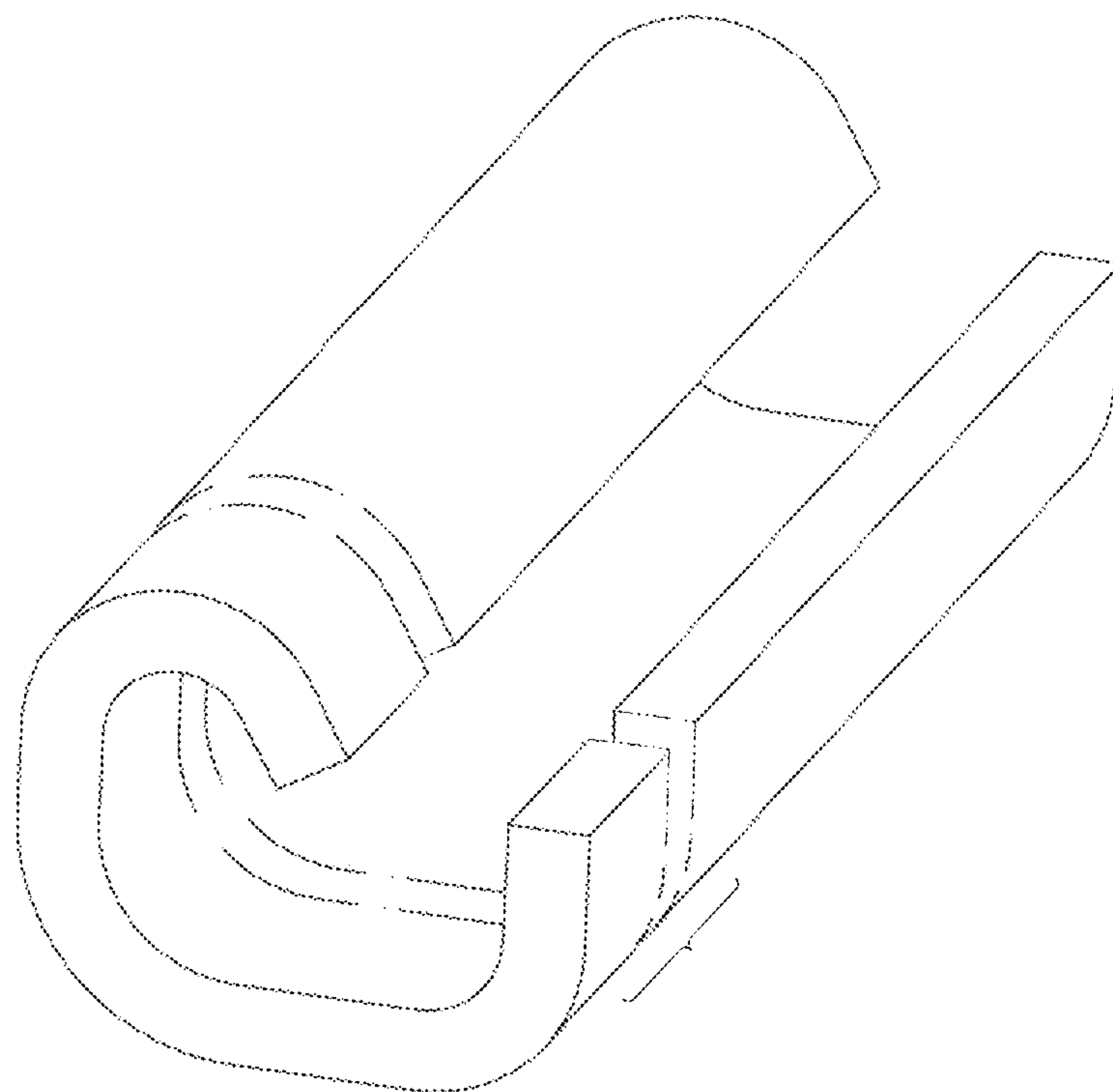
