FIG. 9 is an upper, left, front perspective environmental use view.

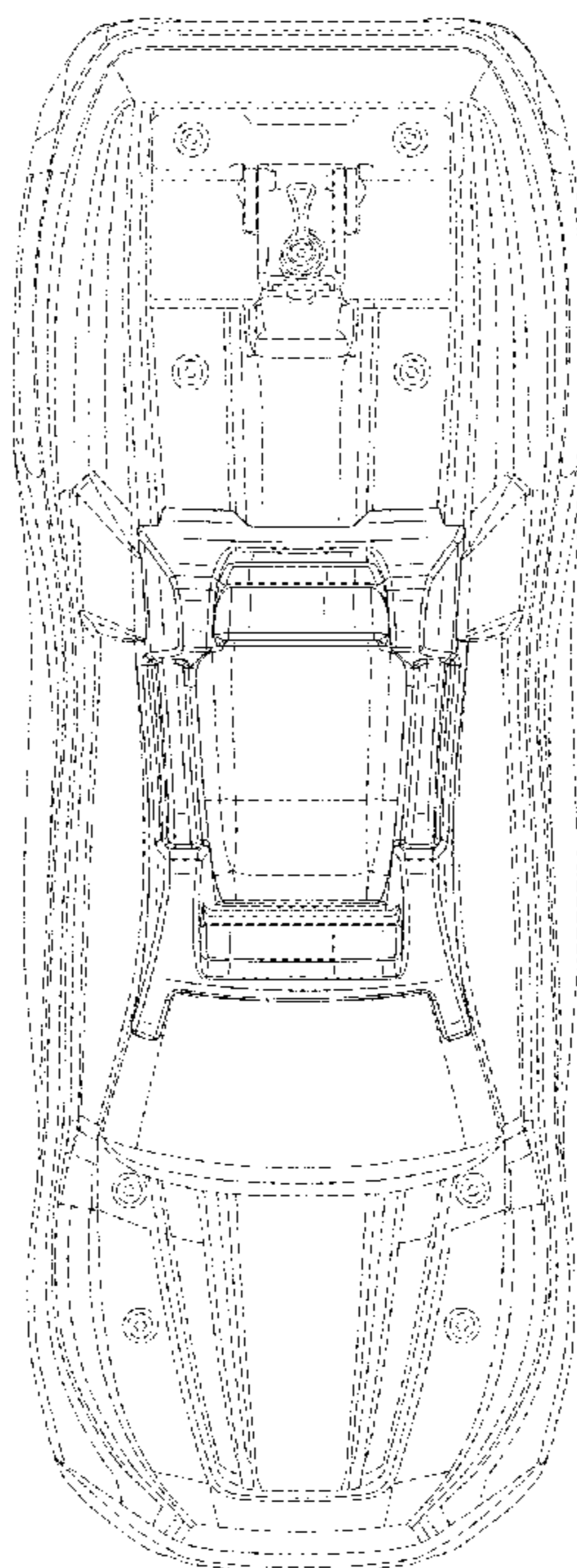

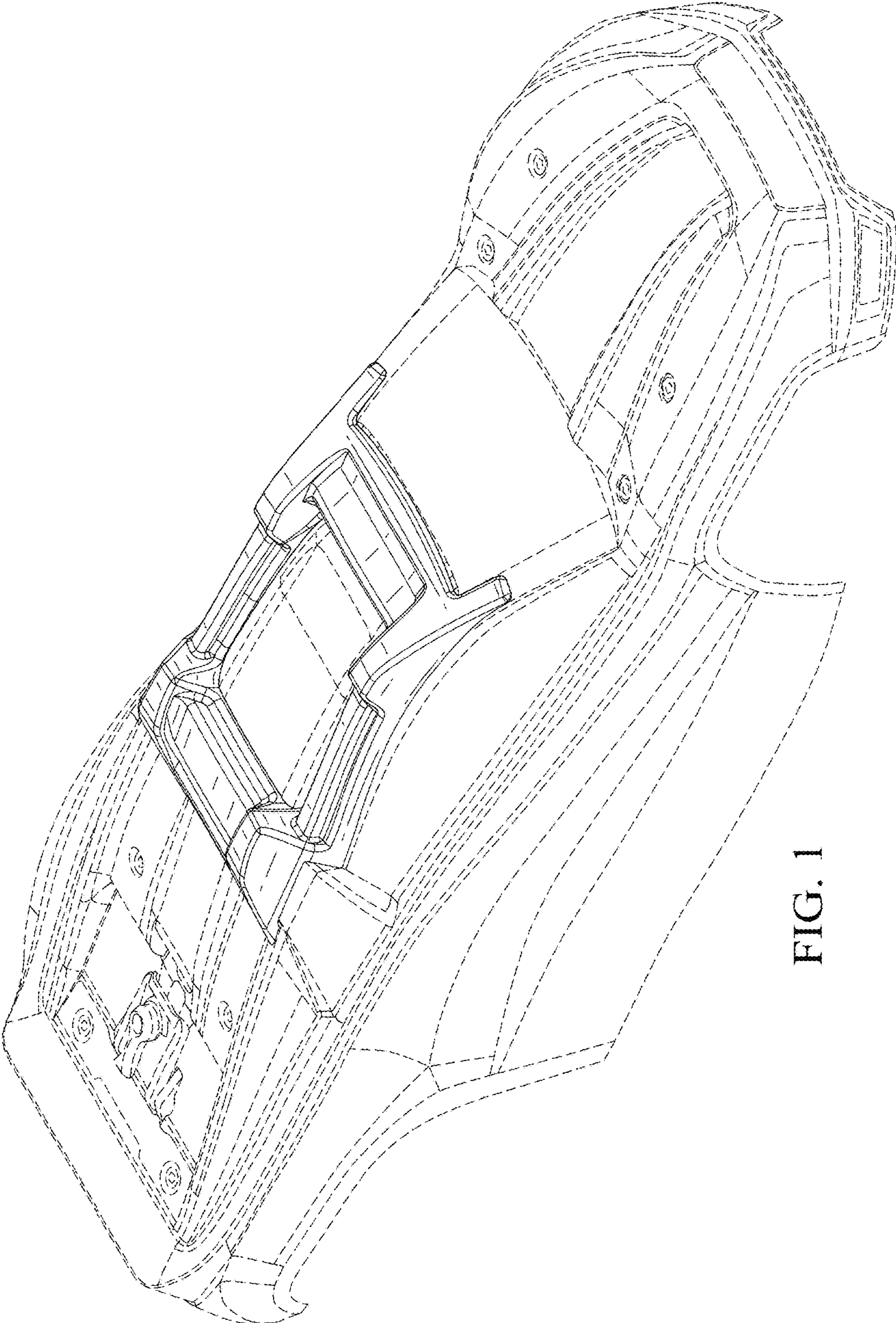

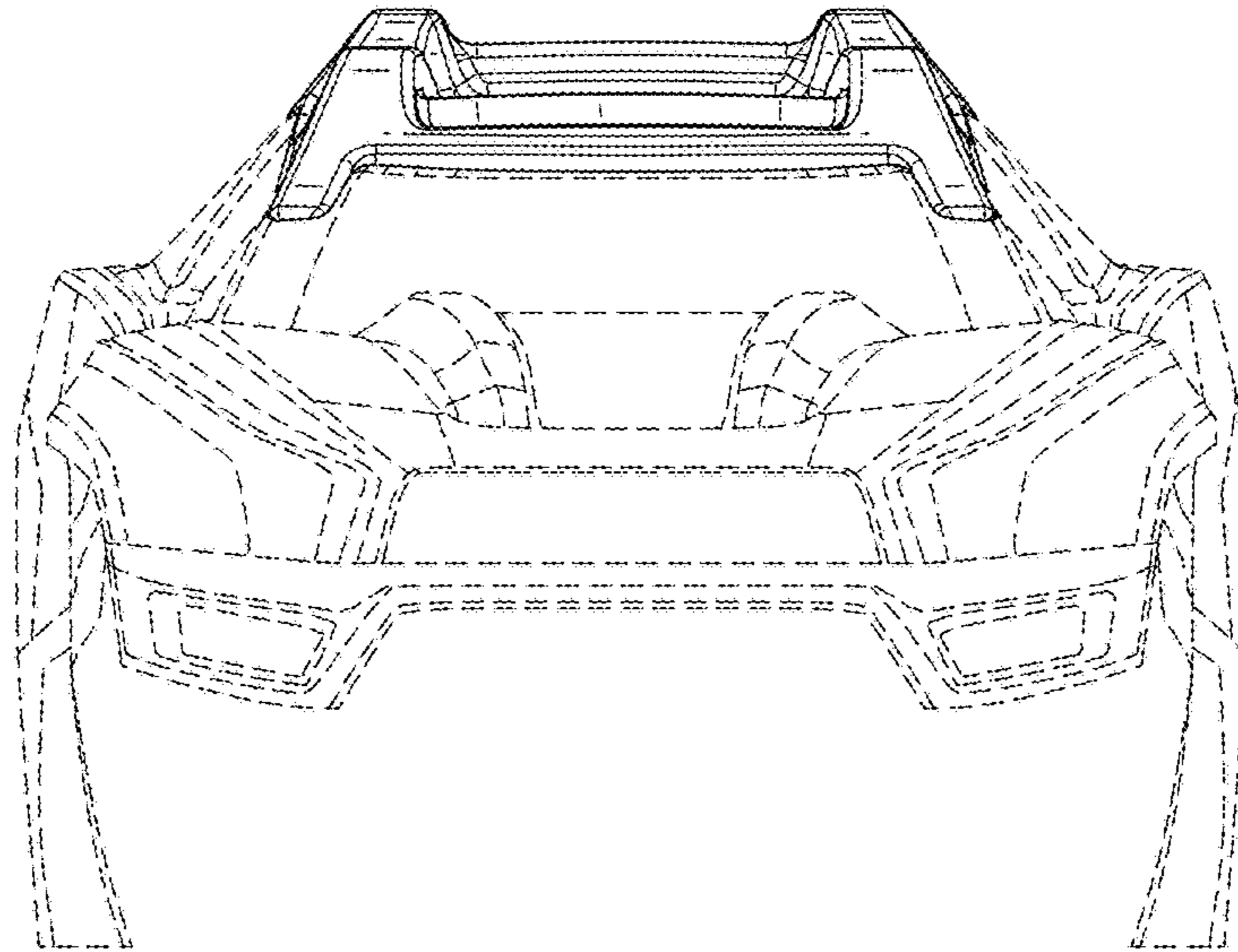

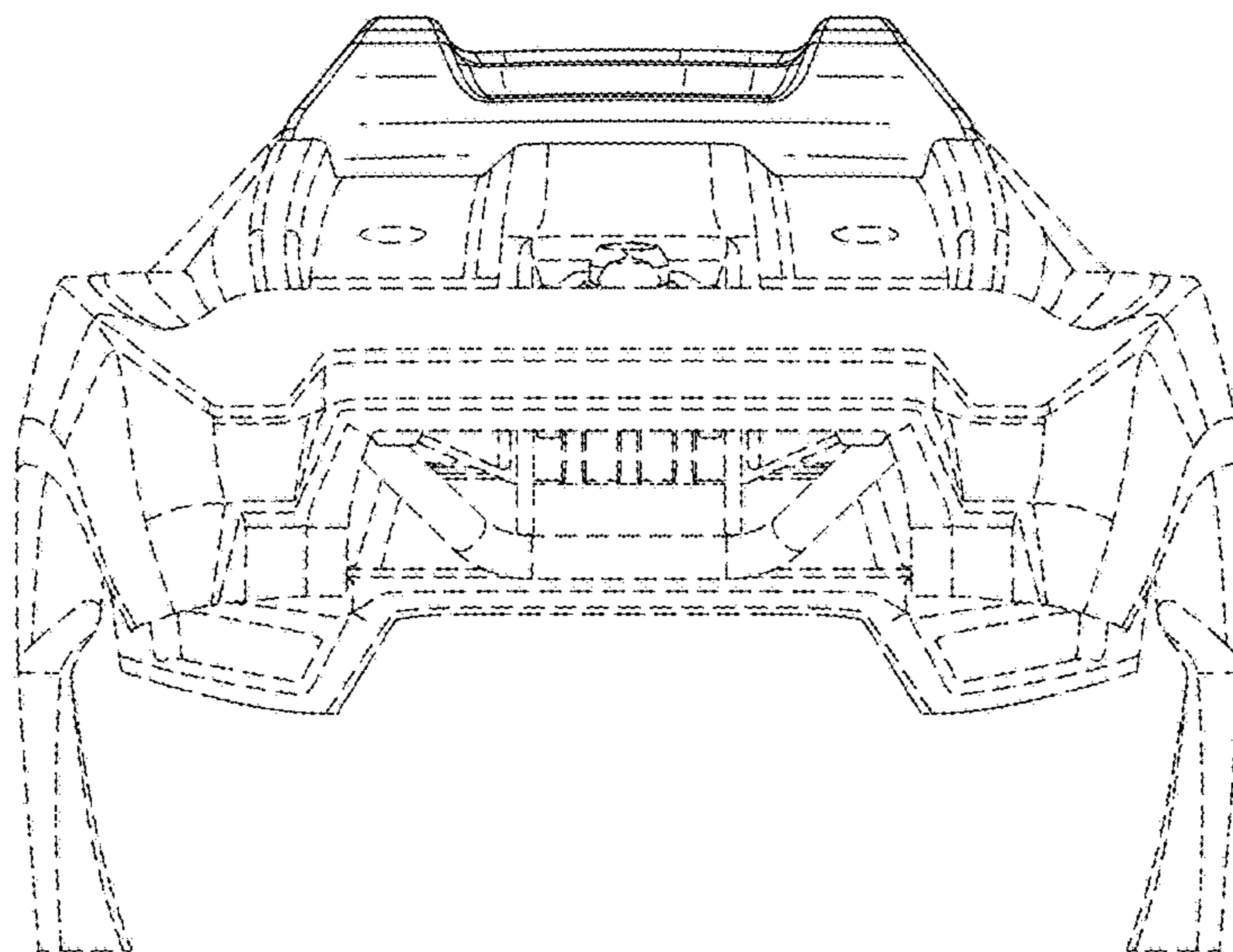

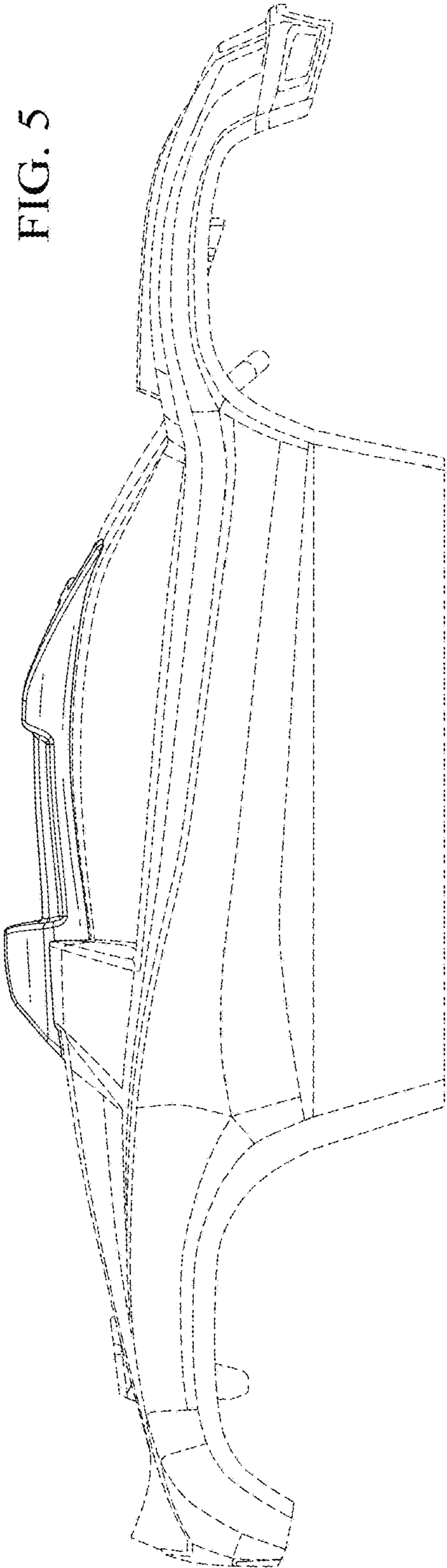
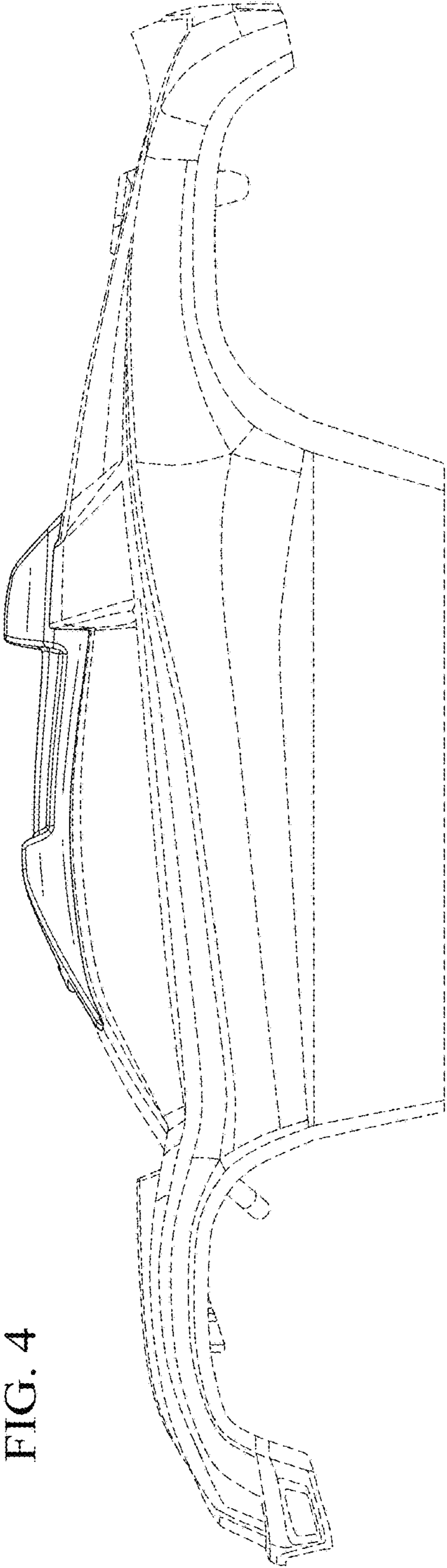

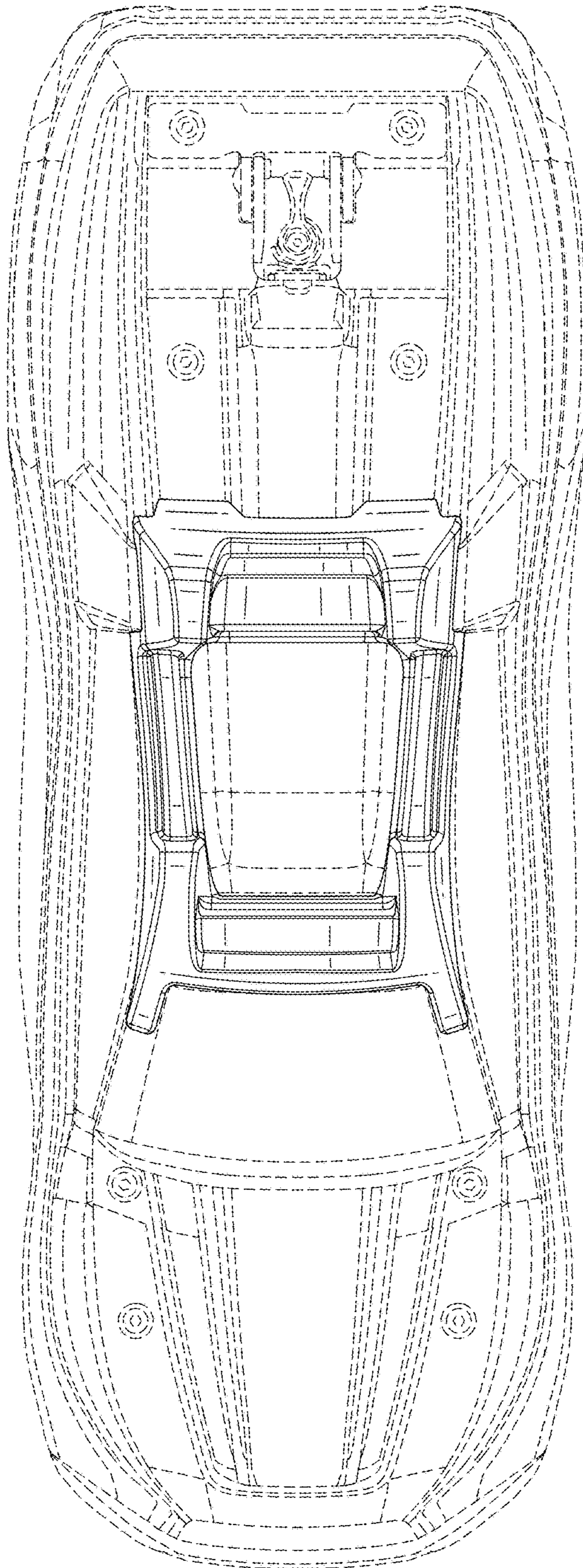

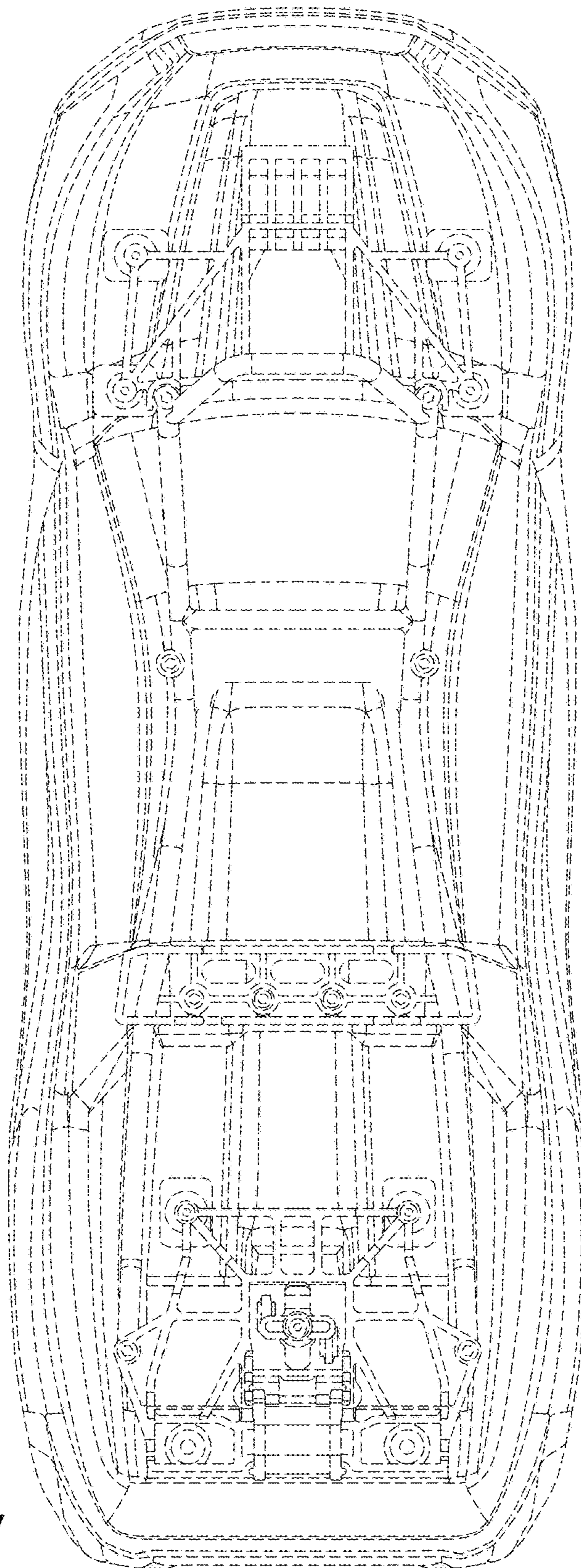

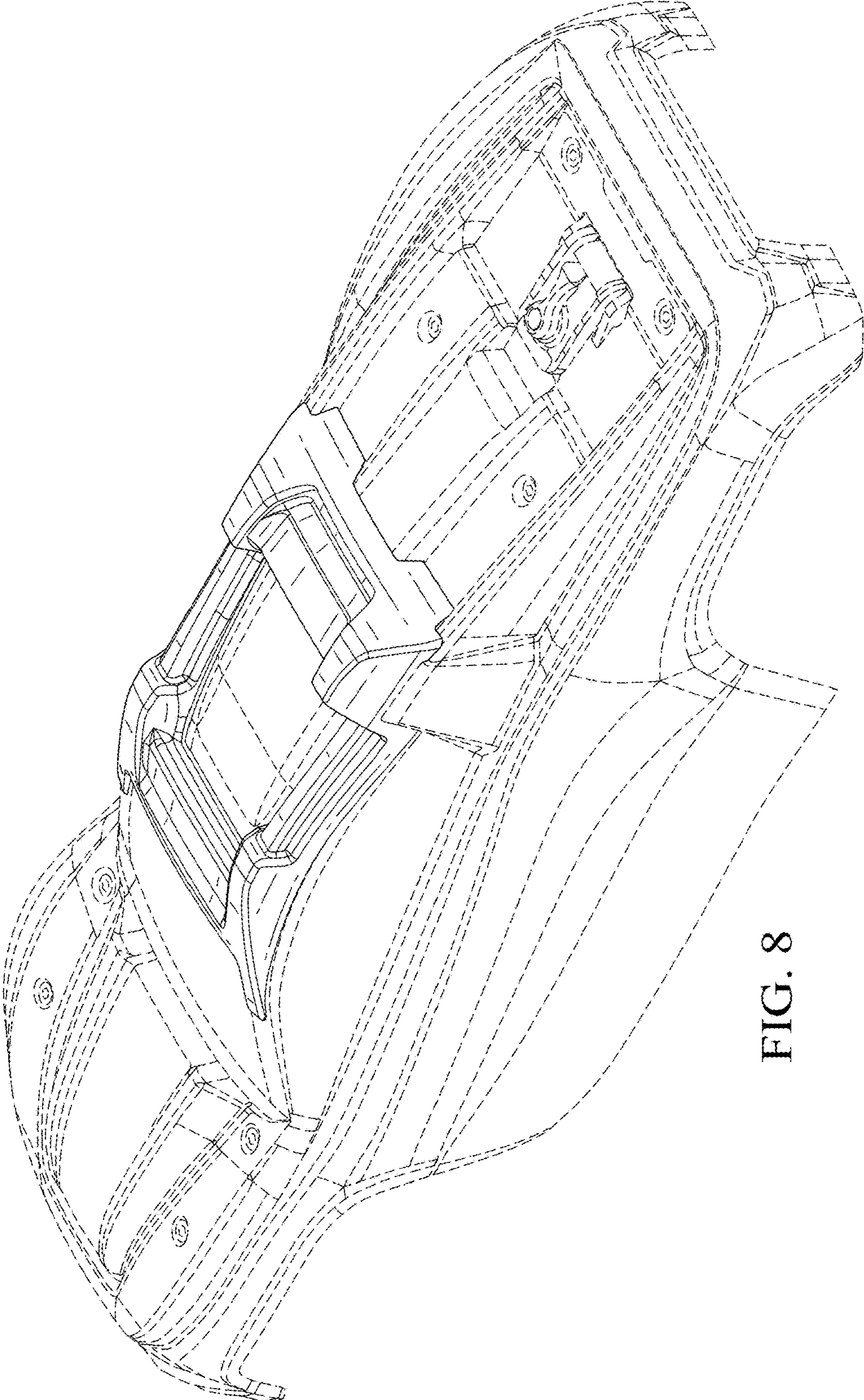

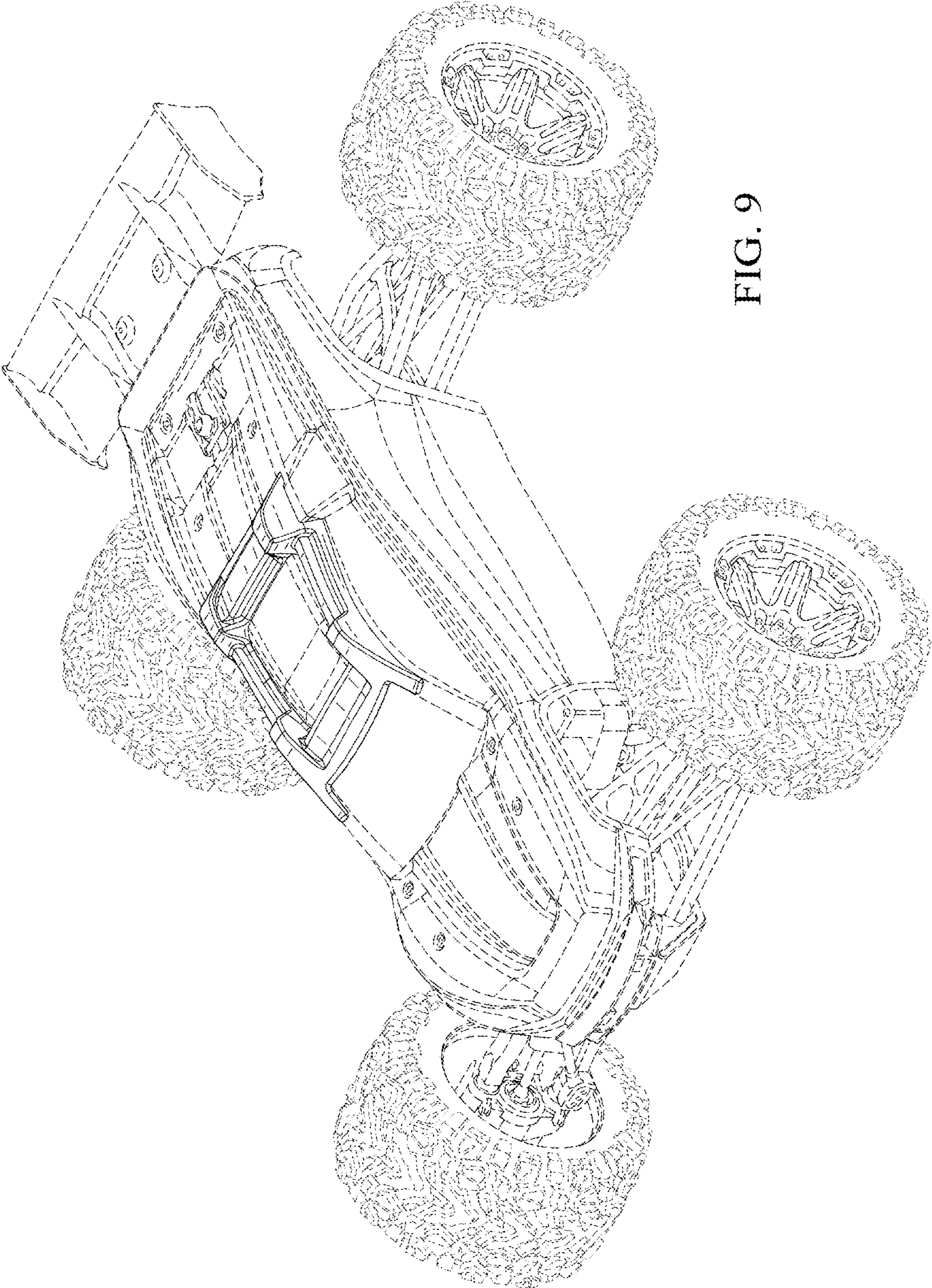
