(57) **CLAIM**

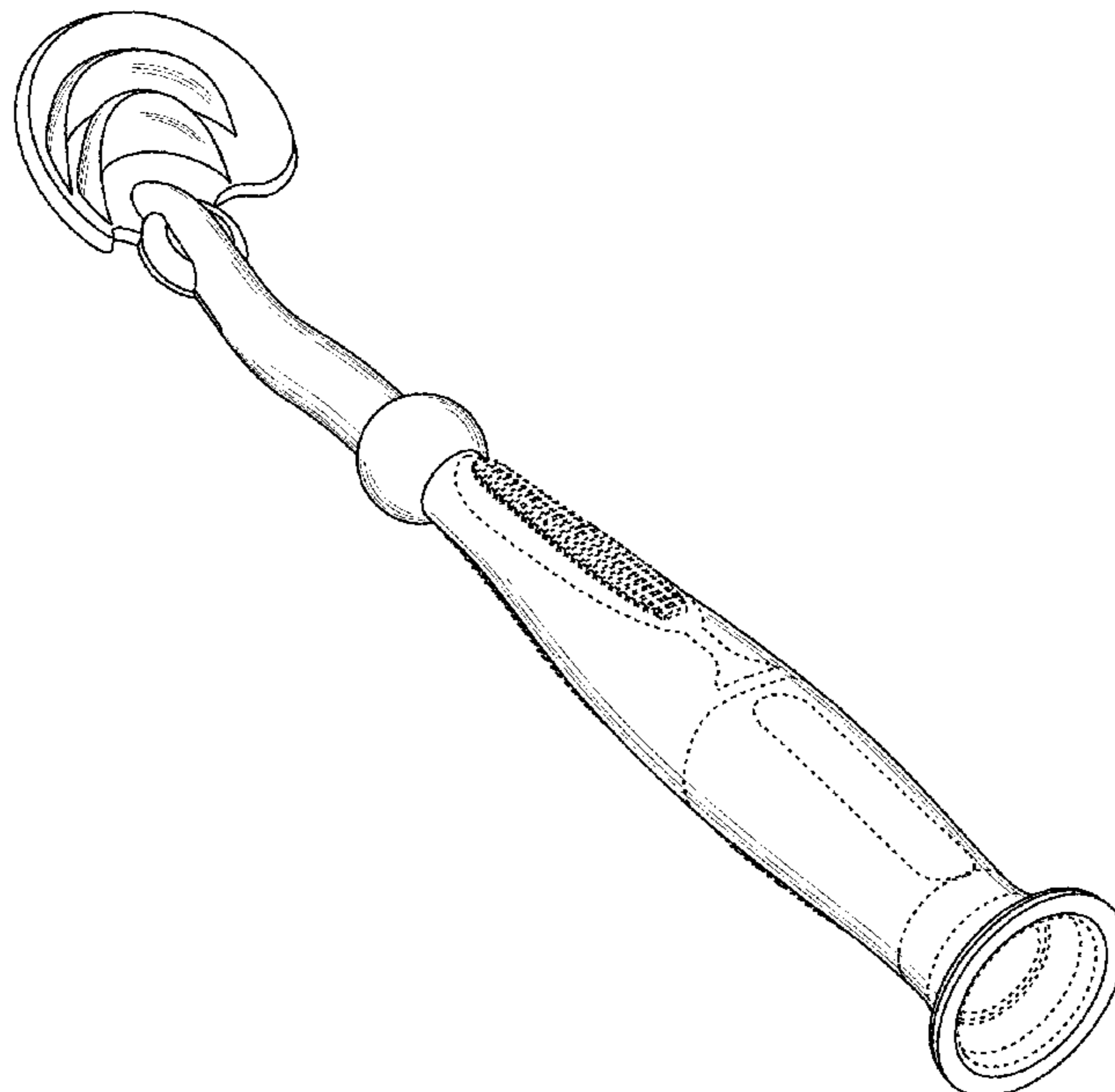
The ornamental design for a standing tongue scraper, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a standing tongue scraper, showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a front view of the tongue scraper shown in FIG. 1;
FIG. 3 is a rear view of the tongue scraper shown in FIG. 1;
FIG. 4 is a left-side view of the tongue scraper shown in FIG. 1;
FIG. 5 is a right-side view of the tongue scraper shown in FIG. 1;
FIG. 6 is a top plan view of the tongue scraper shown in FIG. 1; and,
FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view of the tongue scraper shown in FIG. 1.

The broken lines shown in FIGS. 1-7 illustrate portions of the standing tongue scraper that form no part of the claimed design.

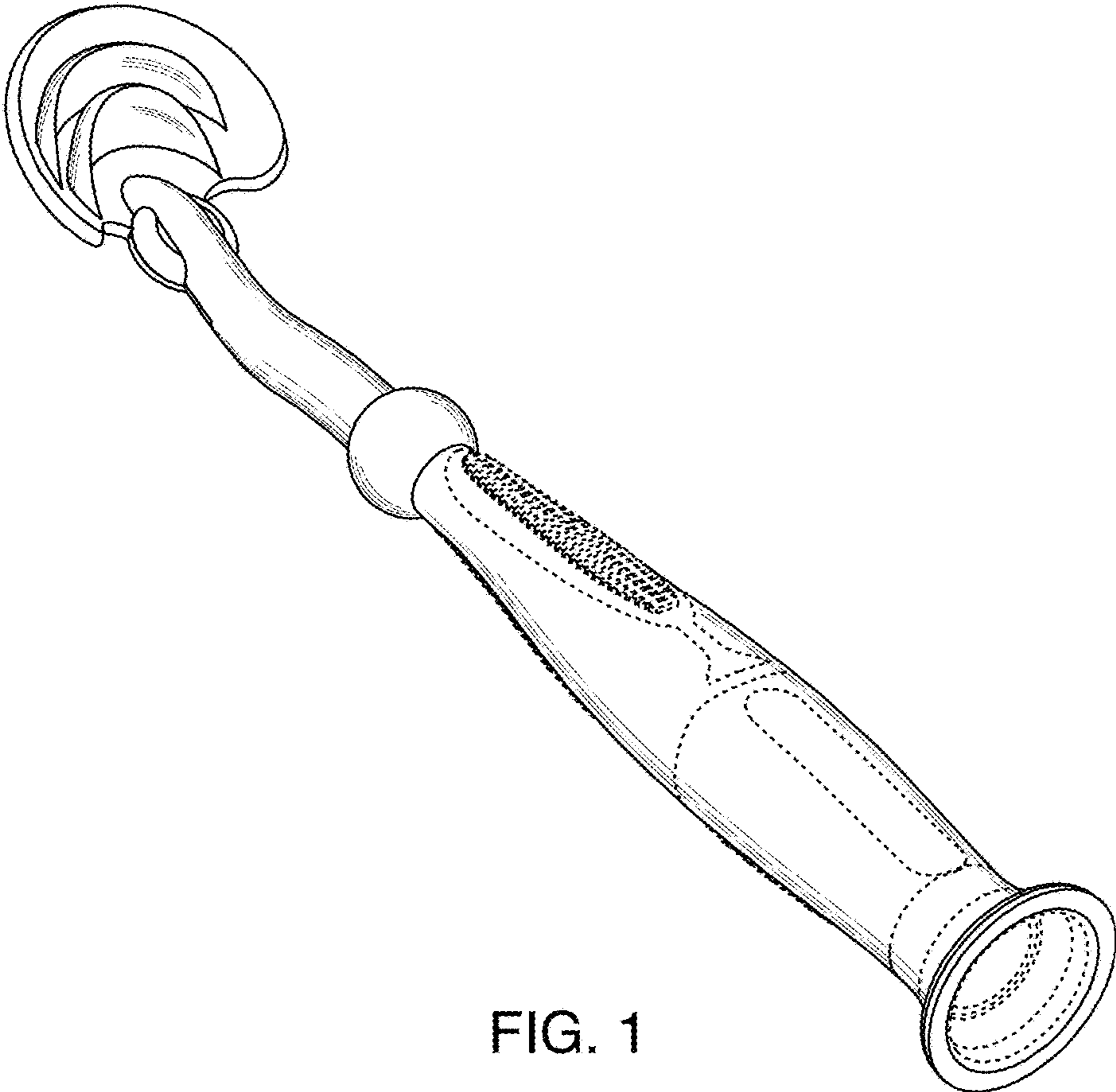

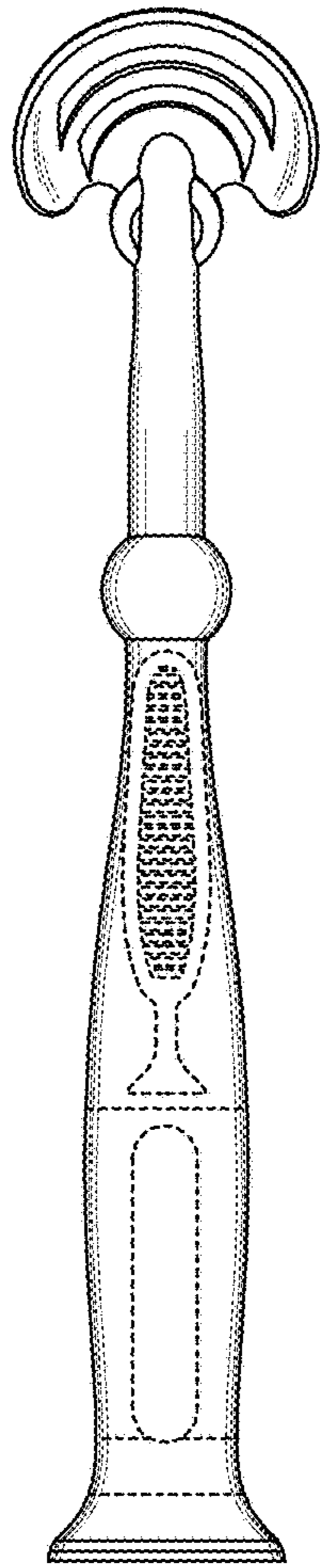

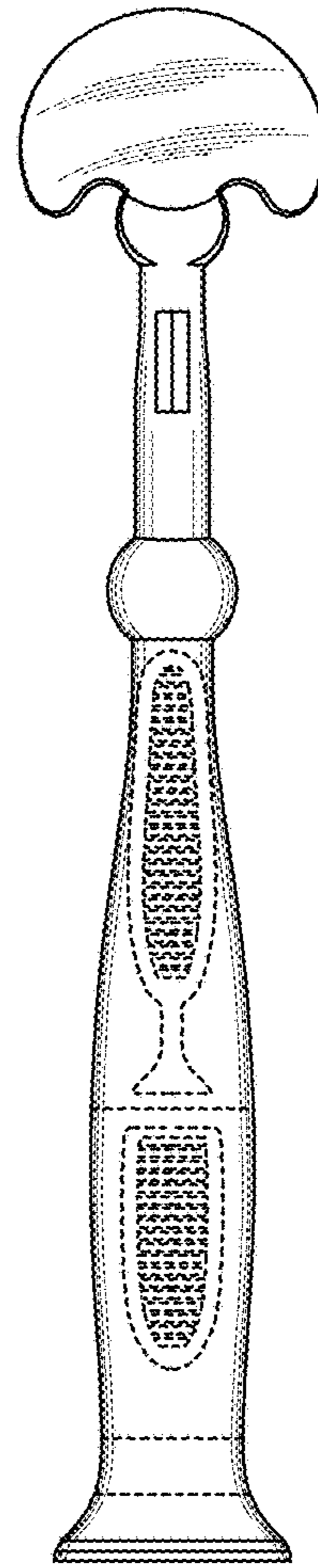

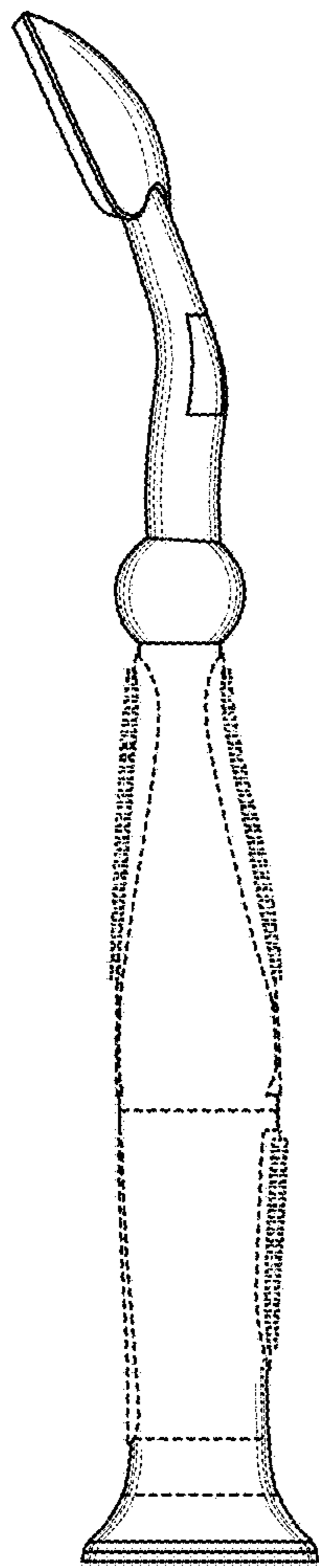

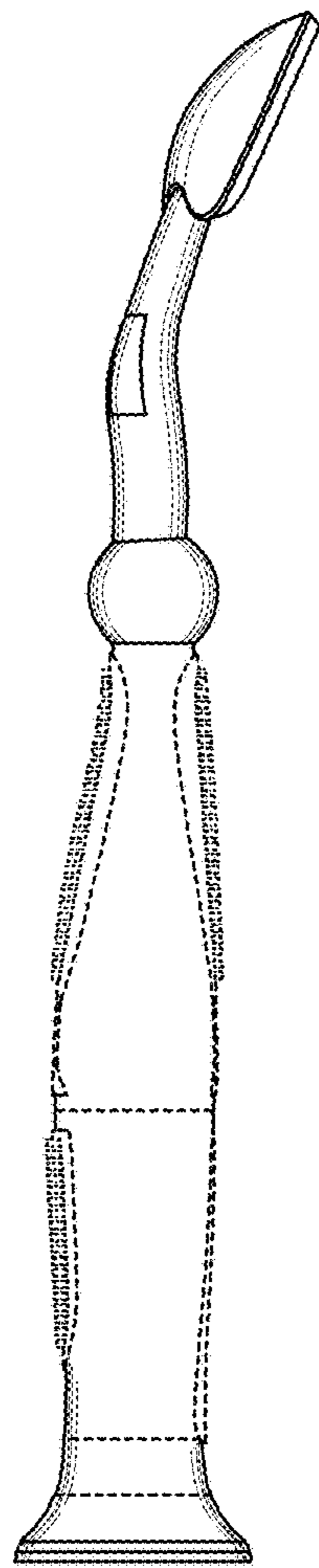

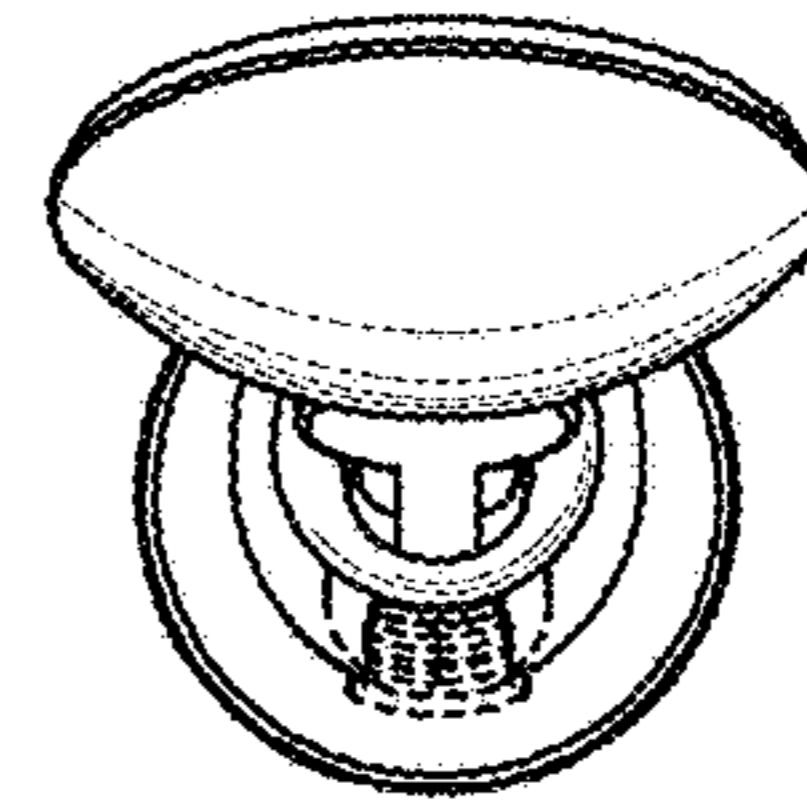

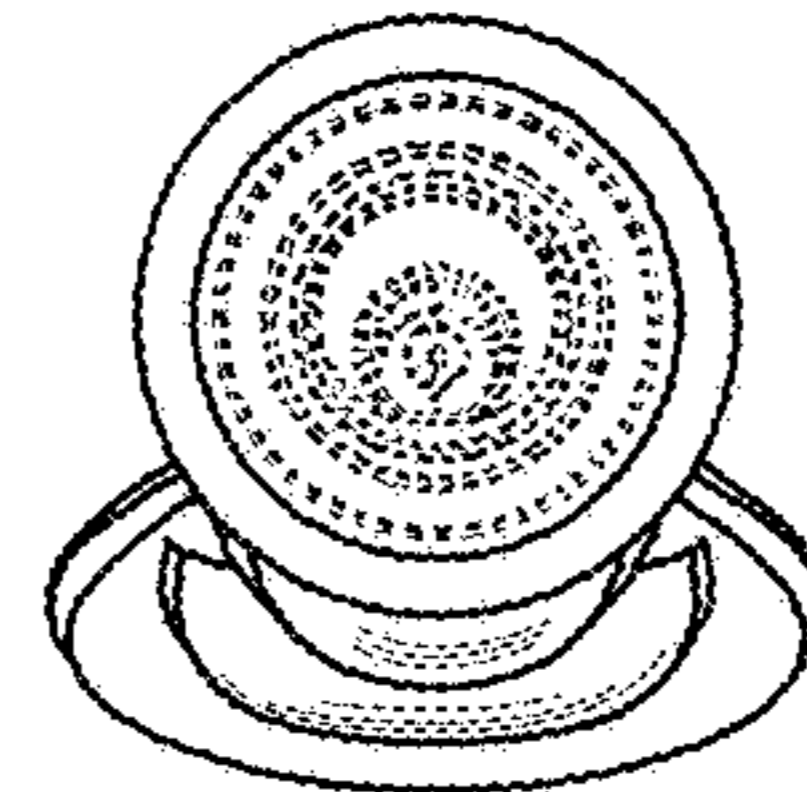
