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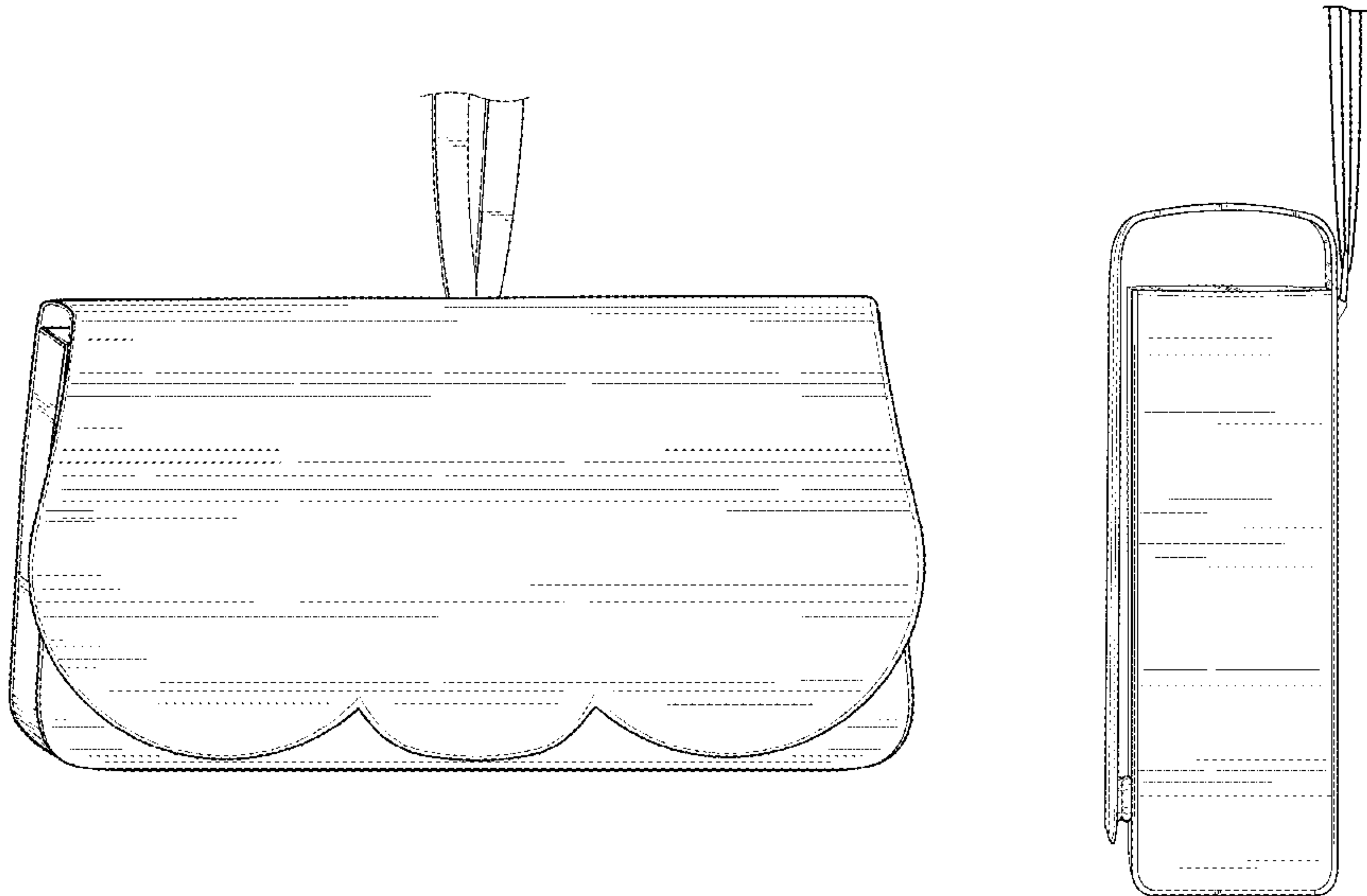

DESCRIPTION
FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of the present spectacle case;
FIG. 2 is a right side view of same;
FIG. 3 is a left side view of the spectacle case of FIG. 1;
FIG. 4 is a front view of same;
FIG. 5 is a rear view of the spectacle case of FIG. 1;
FIG. 6 is a top view of same;
FIG. 7 is a bottom view of the spectacle case of FIG. 1; and,
FIG. 8 is a top perspective view of the spectacle case of FIG. 1 in an open position.
The straps at the top of the spectacle case are shown broken away. The appearance of any portion of the straps beyond the breakaway line forms no part of the claimed design.

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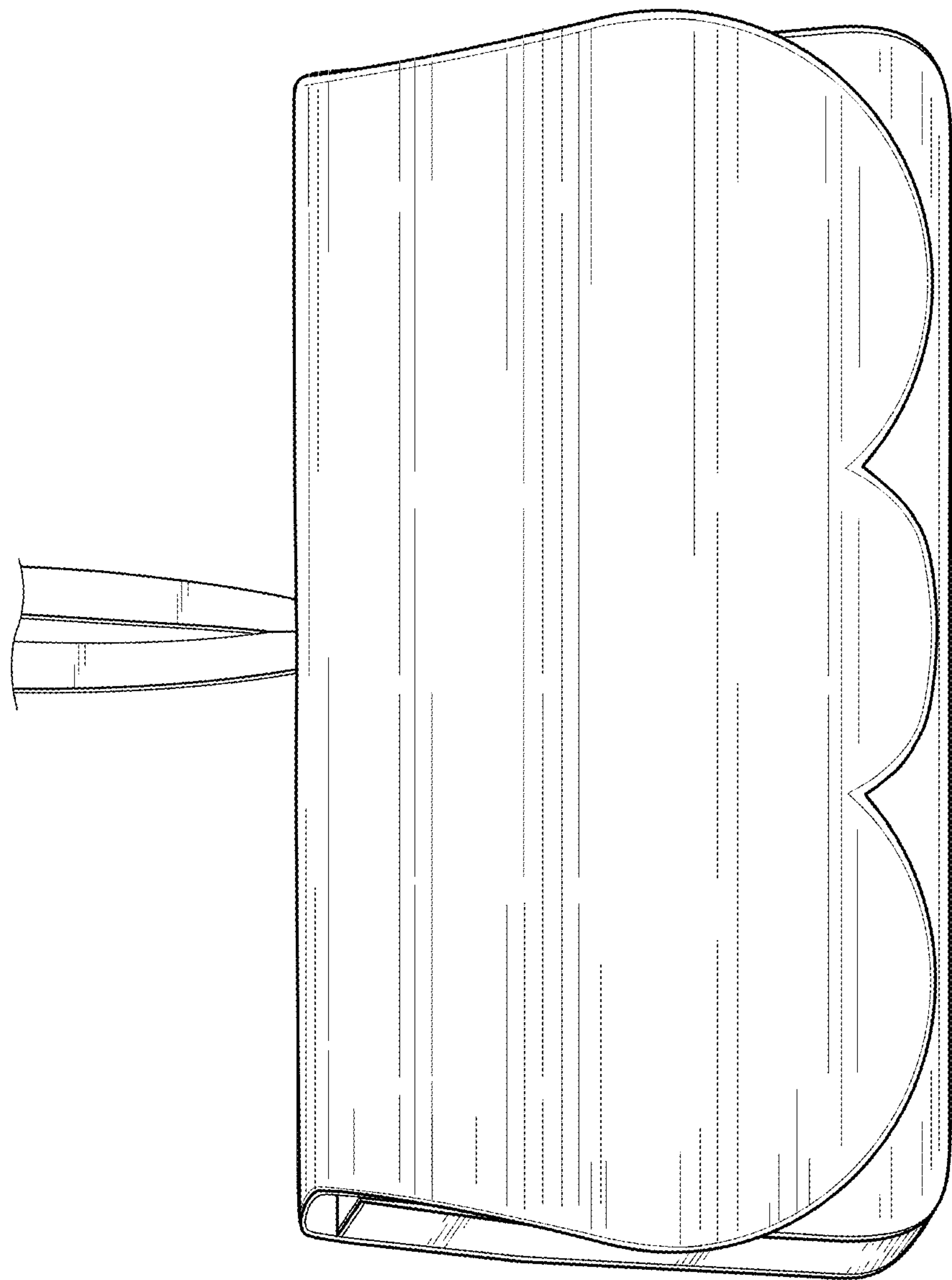

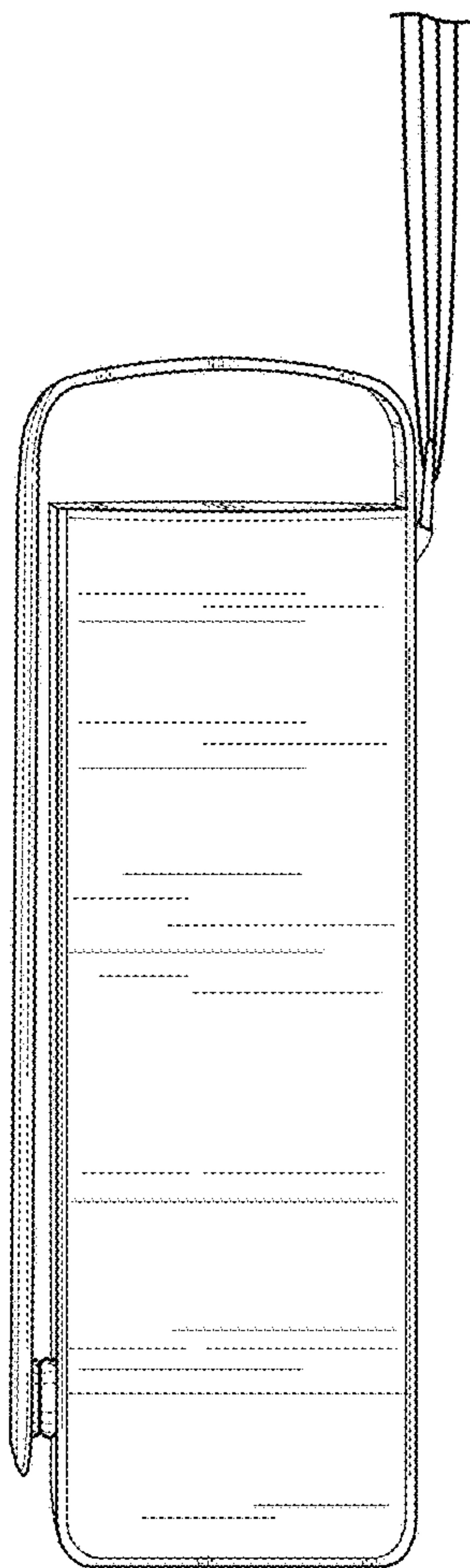

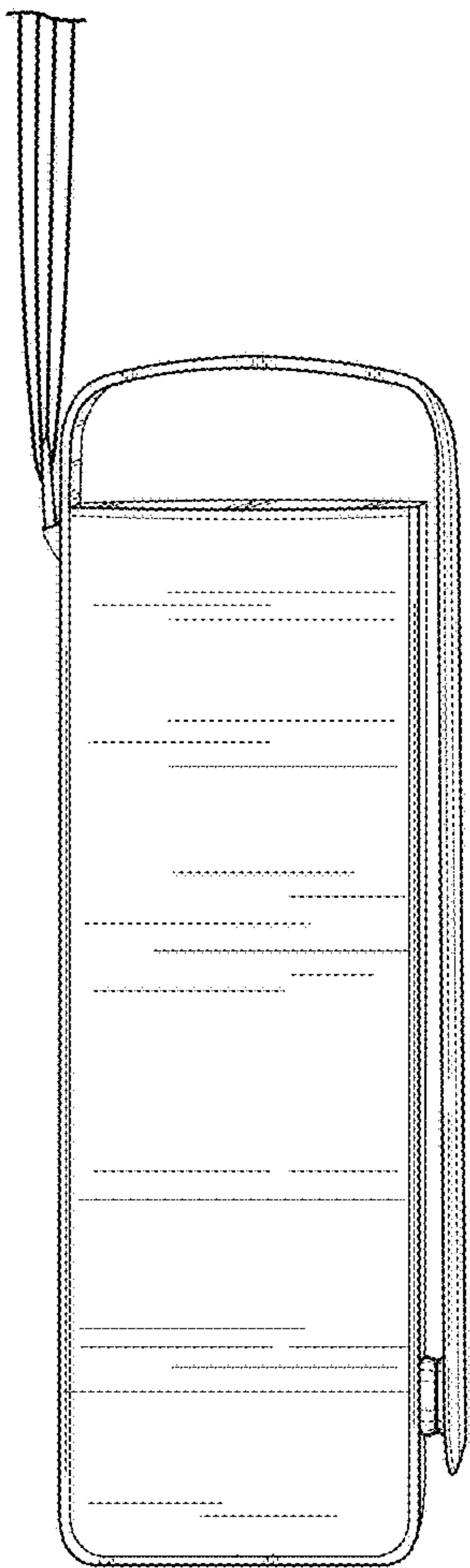

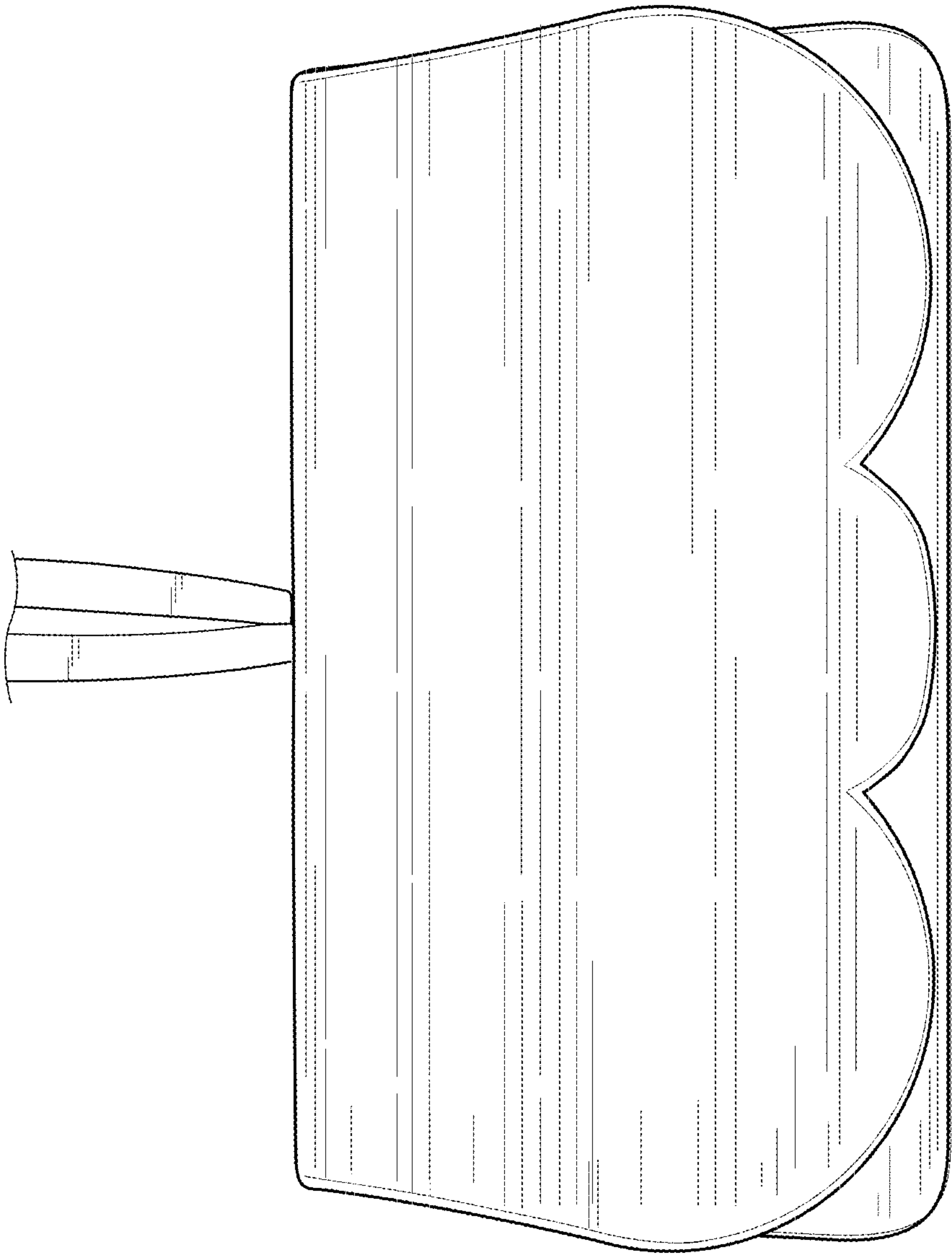

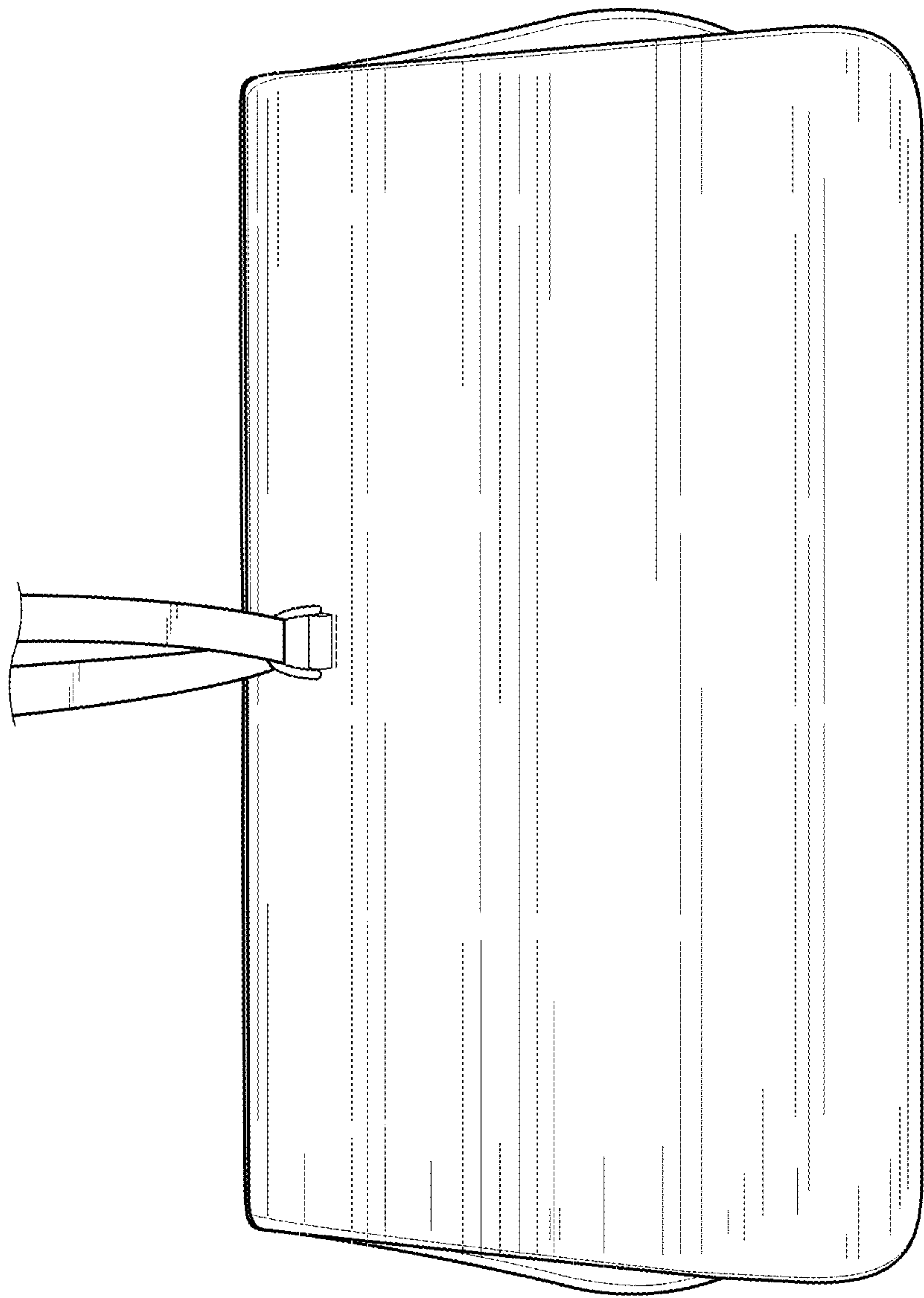

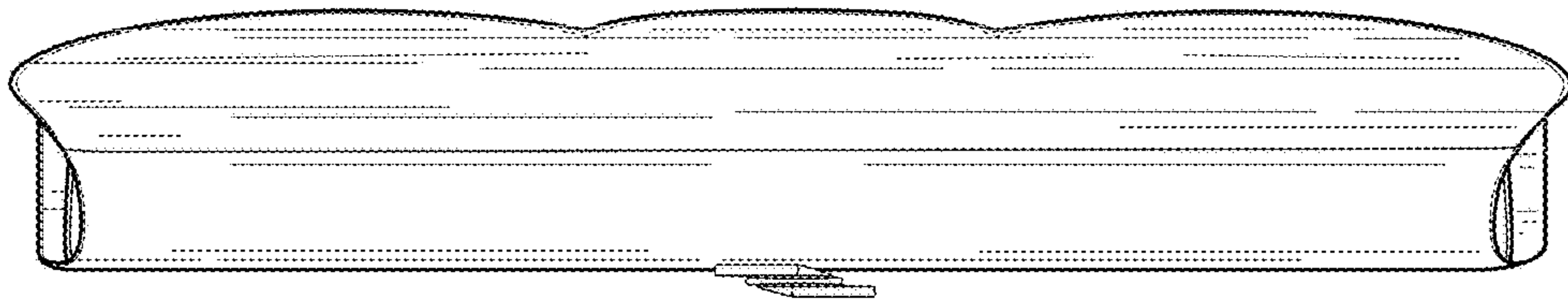

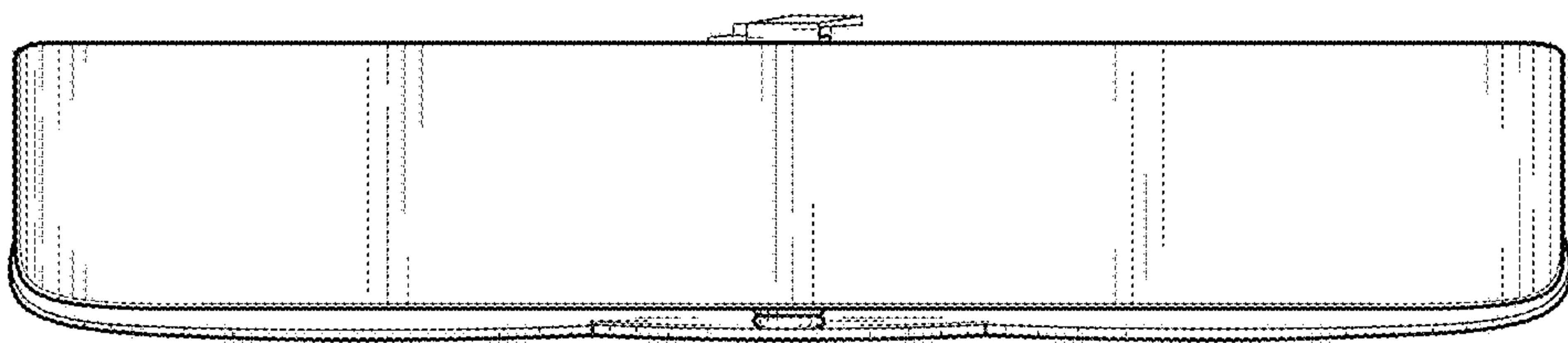

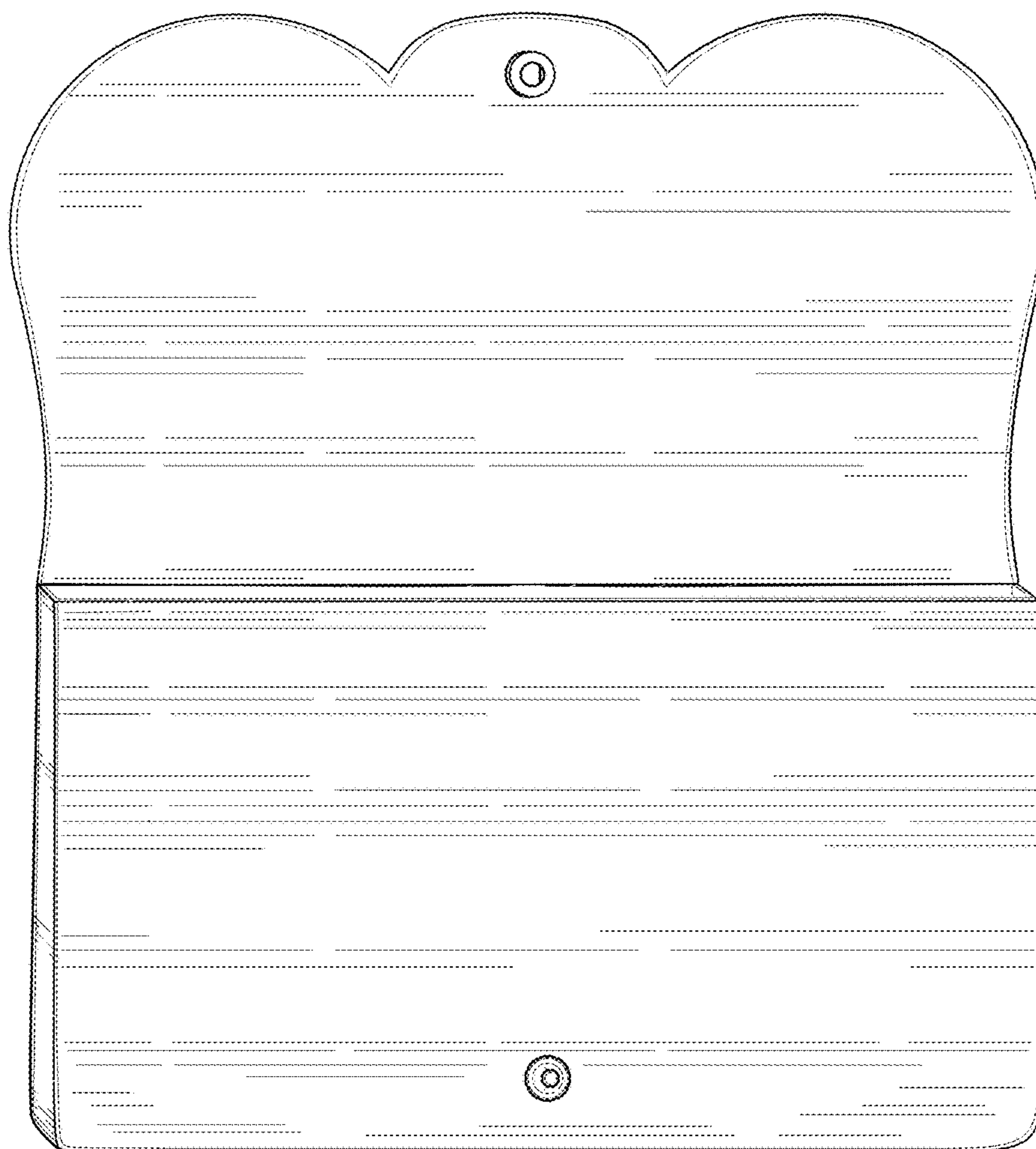
