(57) **CLAIM**

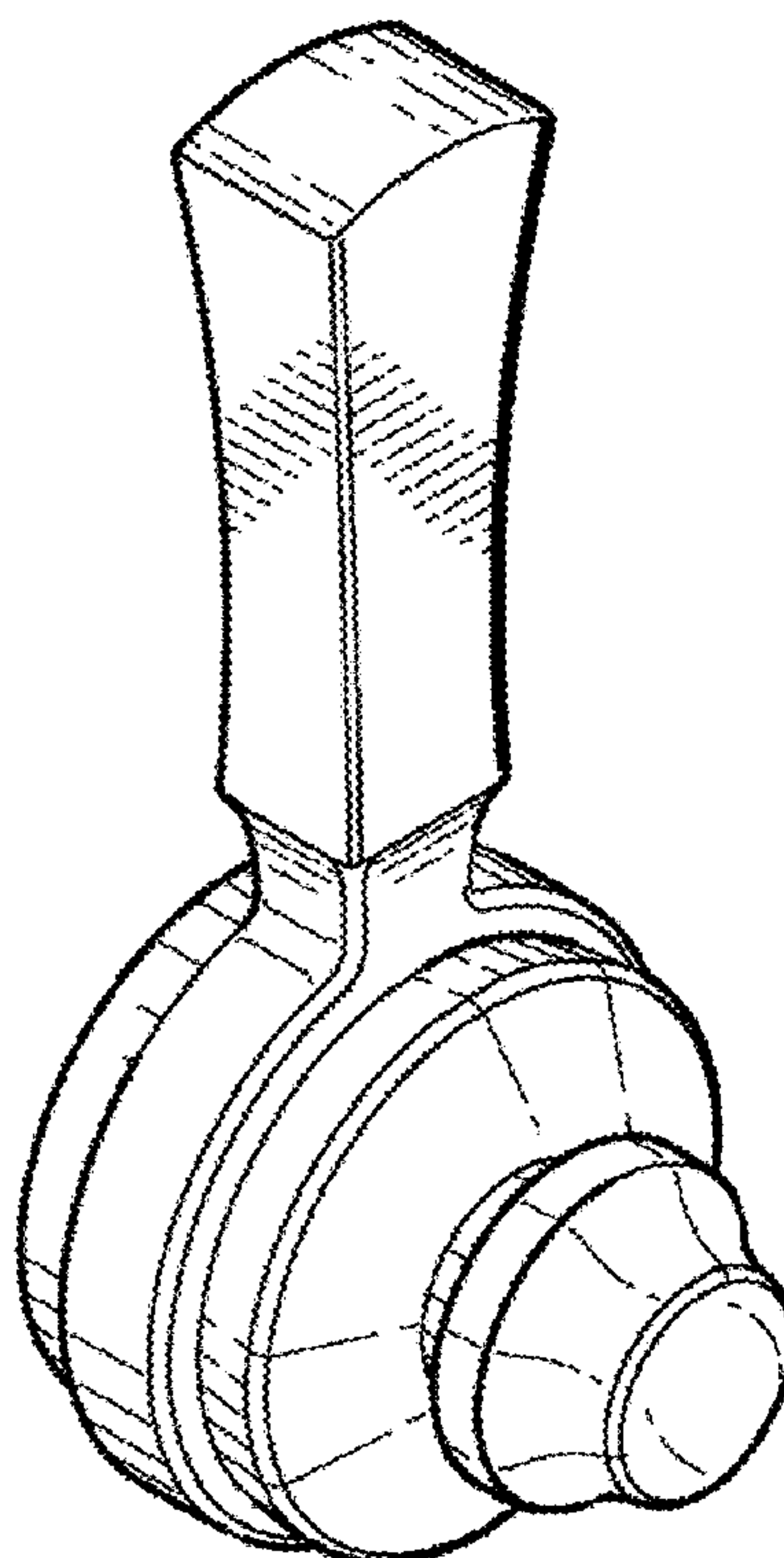
The ornamental design for a faucet handle, as shown and

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a faucet handle showing my
new design;
FIG. 2 is a first end view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a second end view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a first side view thereof, the opposite side being a
mirror image of the side shown; and,
FIG. 6 is a bottom view thereof.

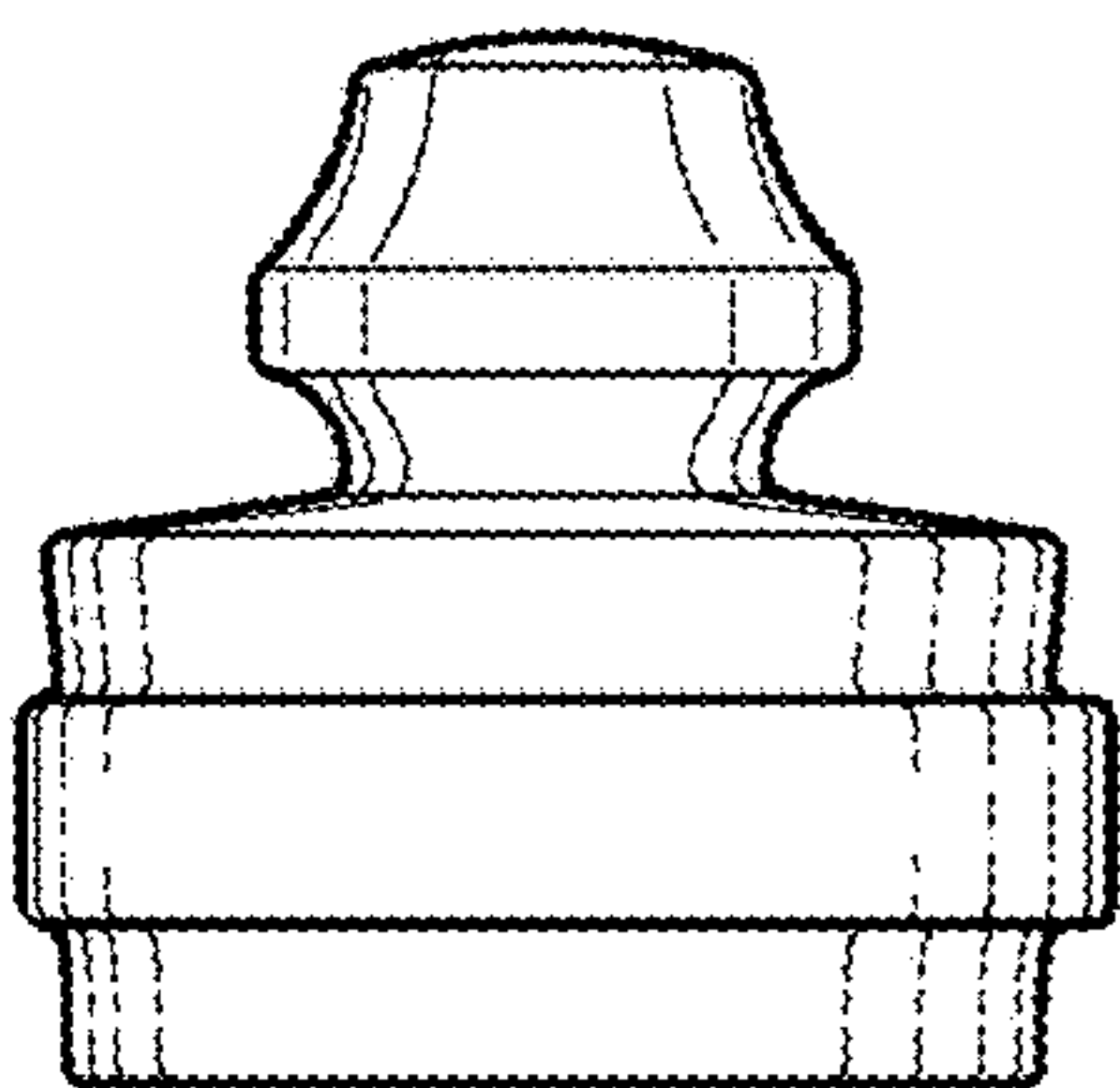
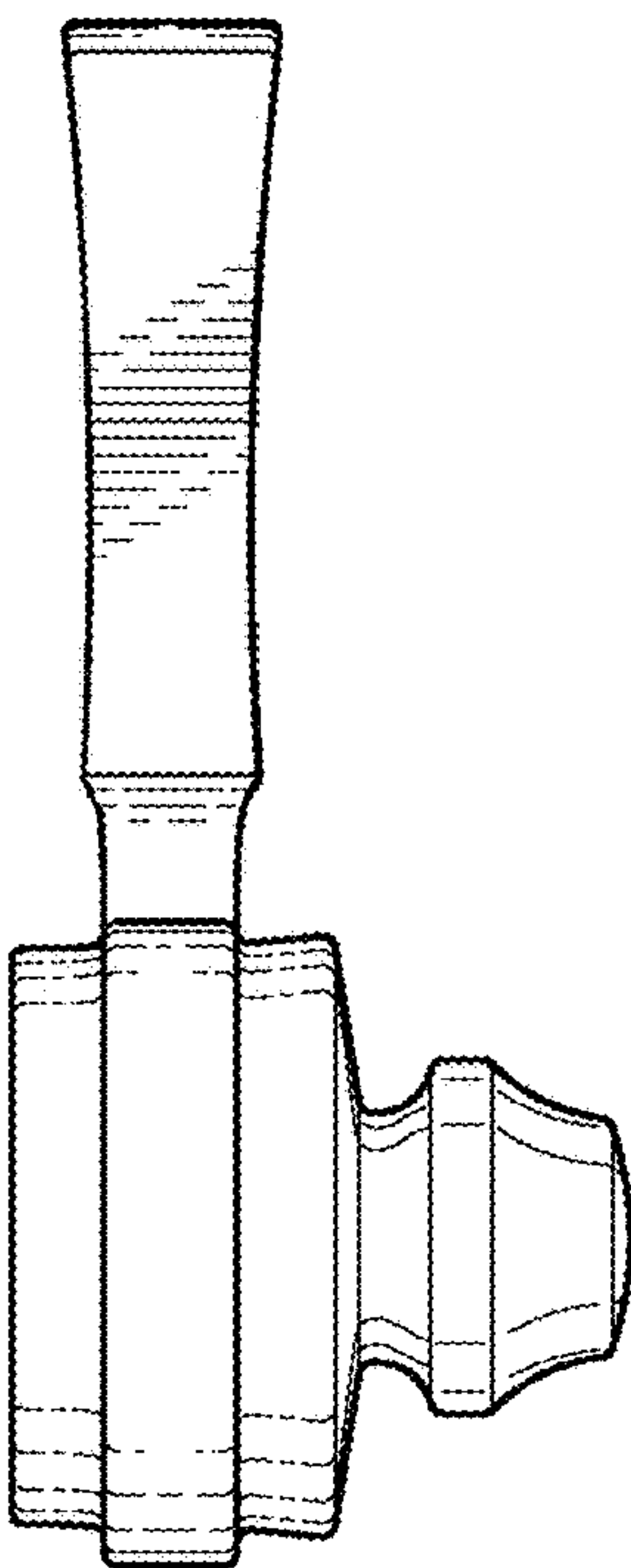
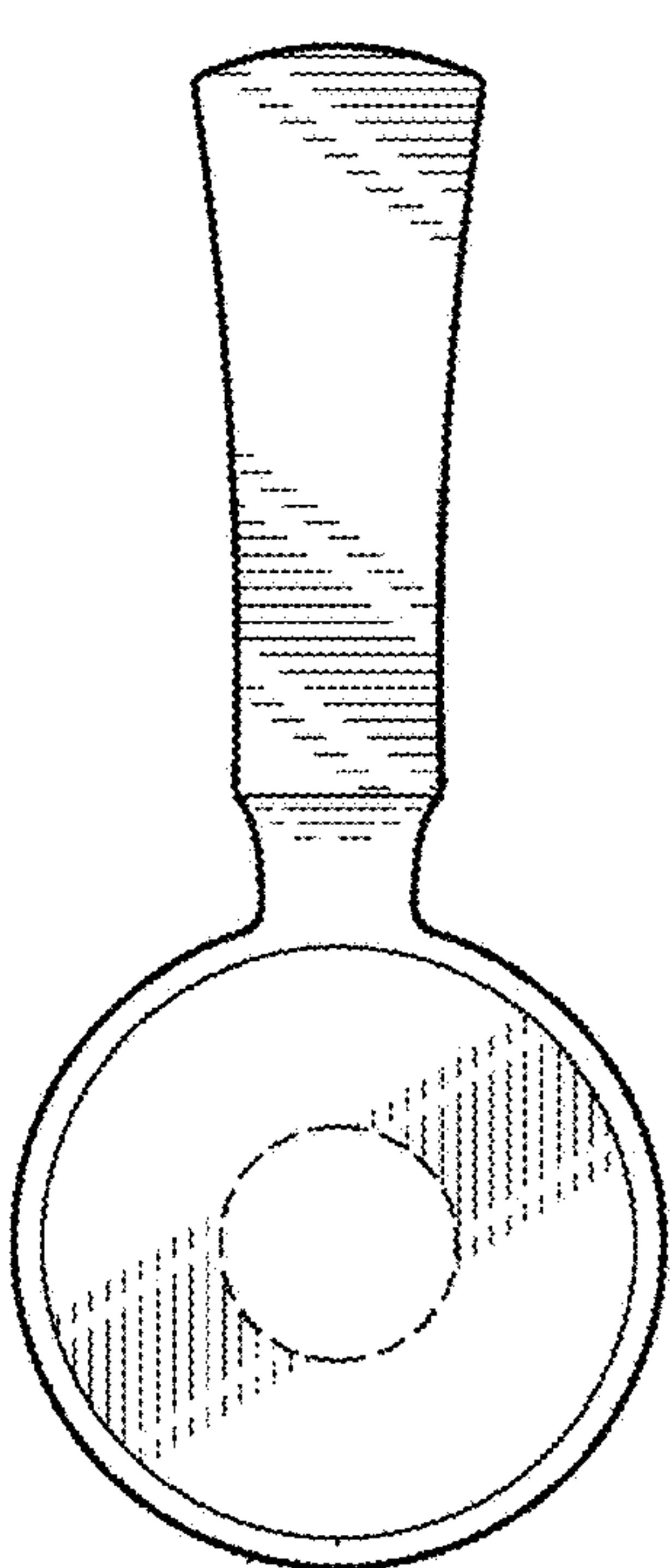
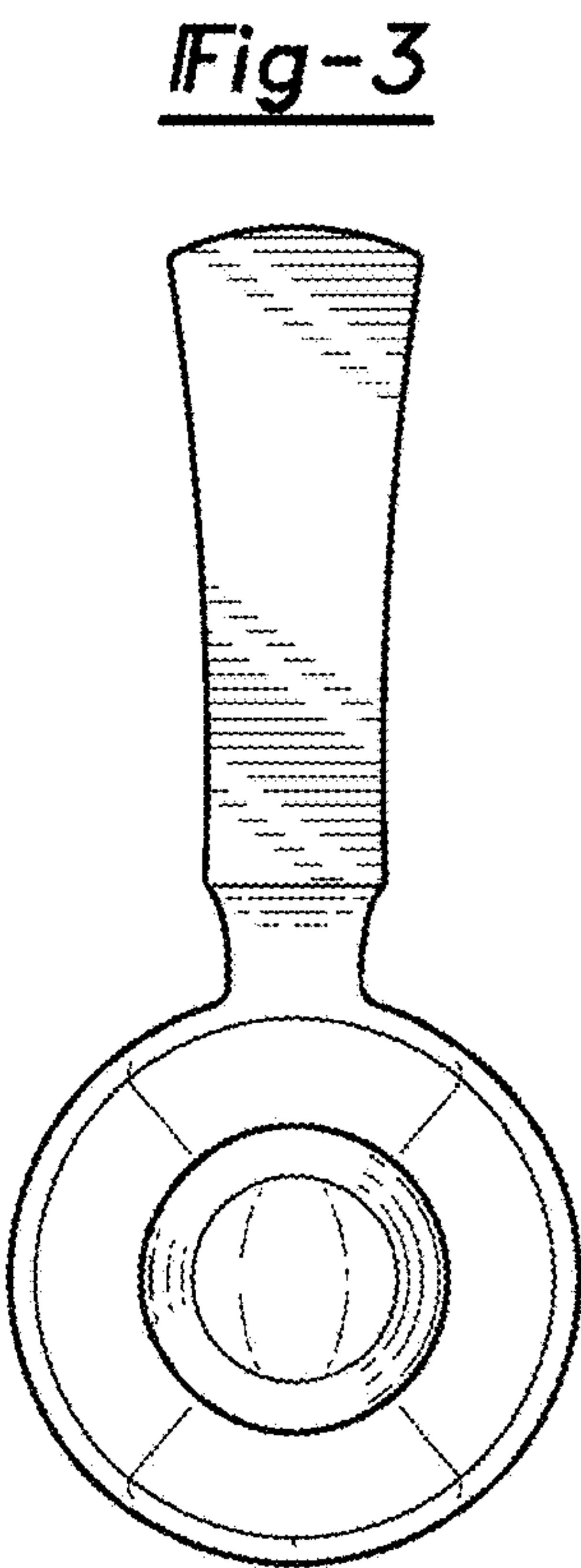
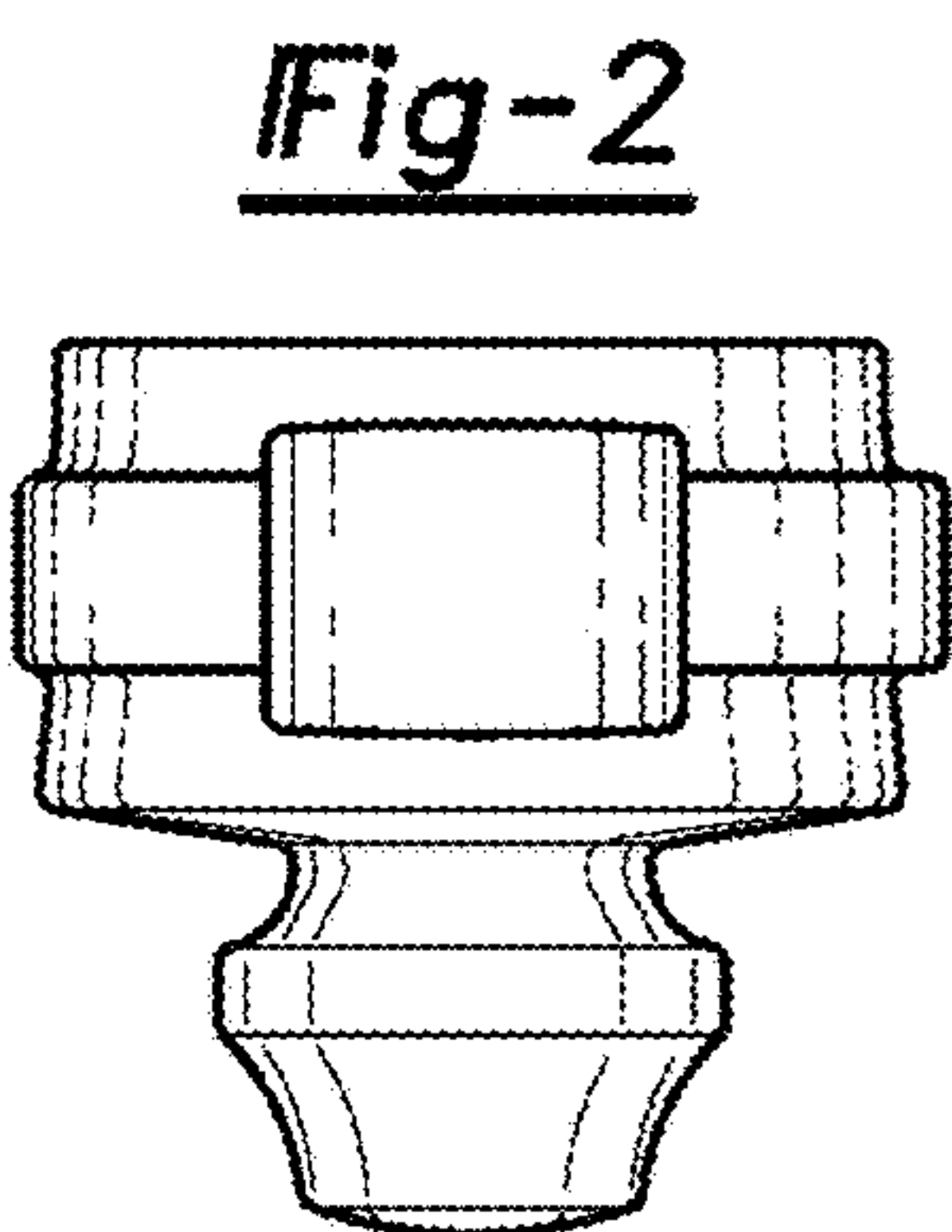
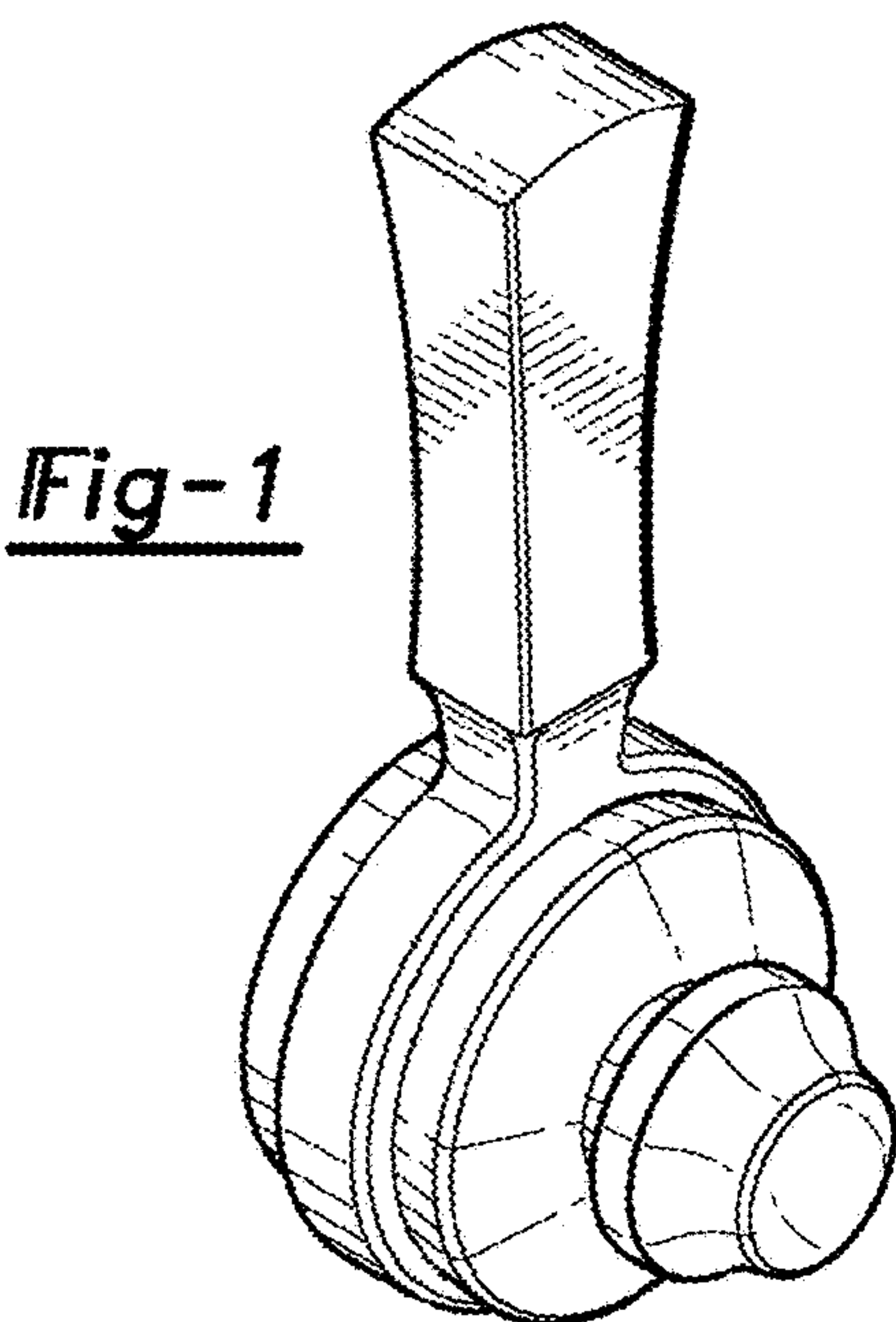
