DESCRIPTION

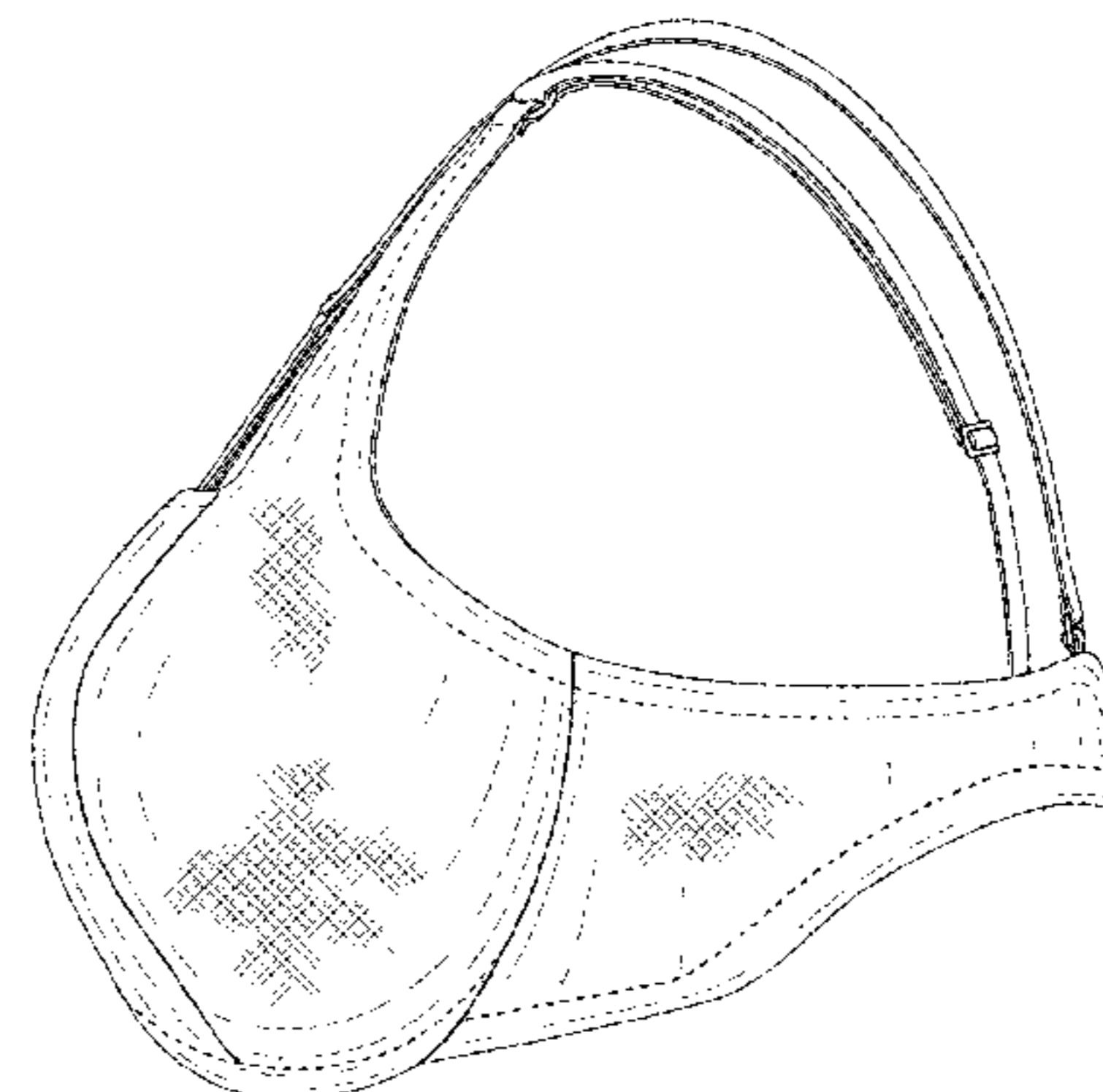
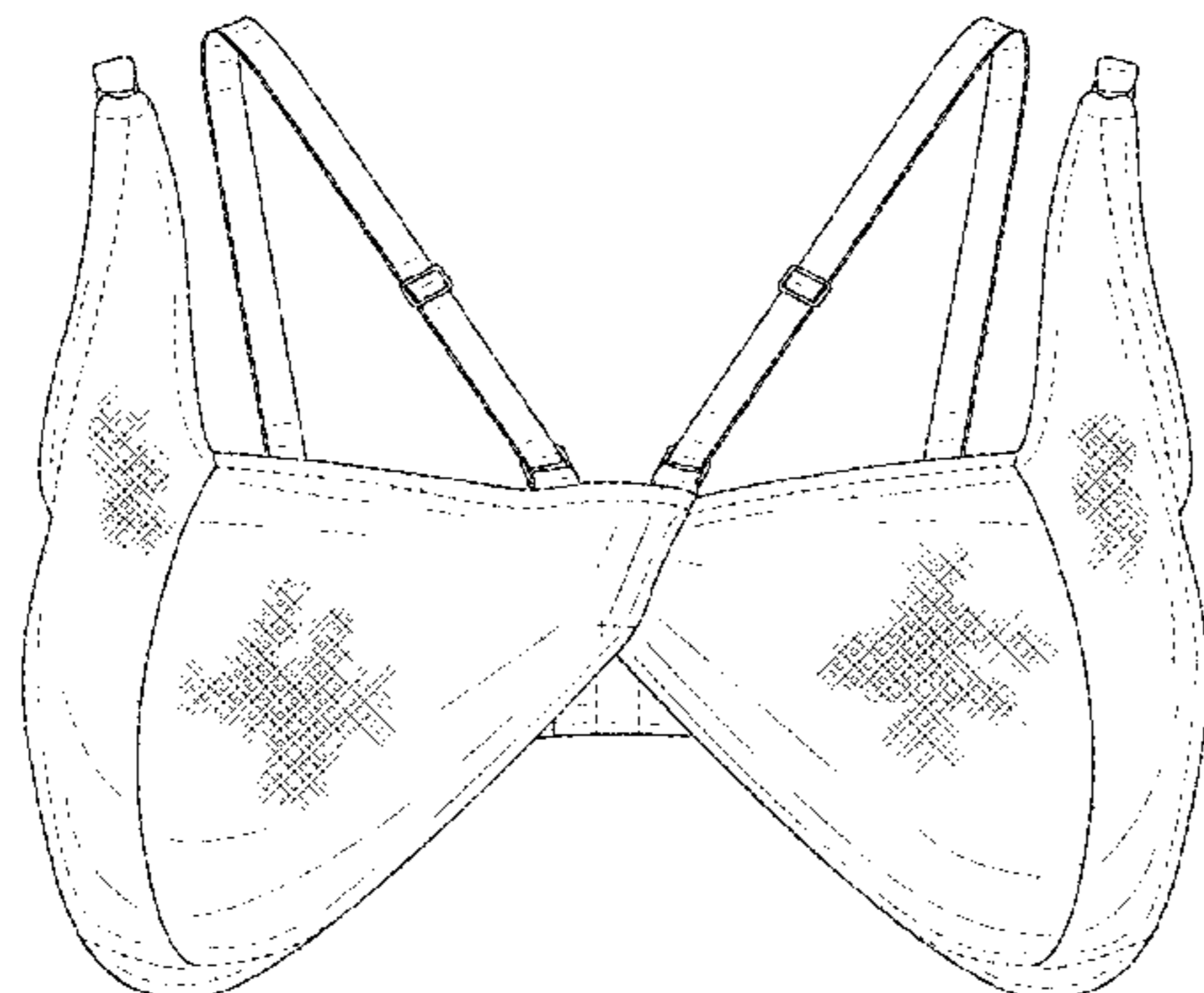
FIG. 1 is a top, front, and right side perspective view of a bra showing my new design with environment;

The short evenly spaced broken lines represent stitching and form part of the claimed design.

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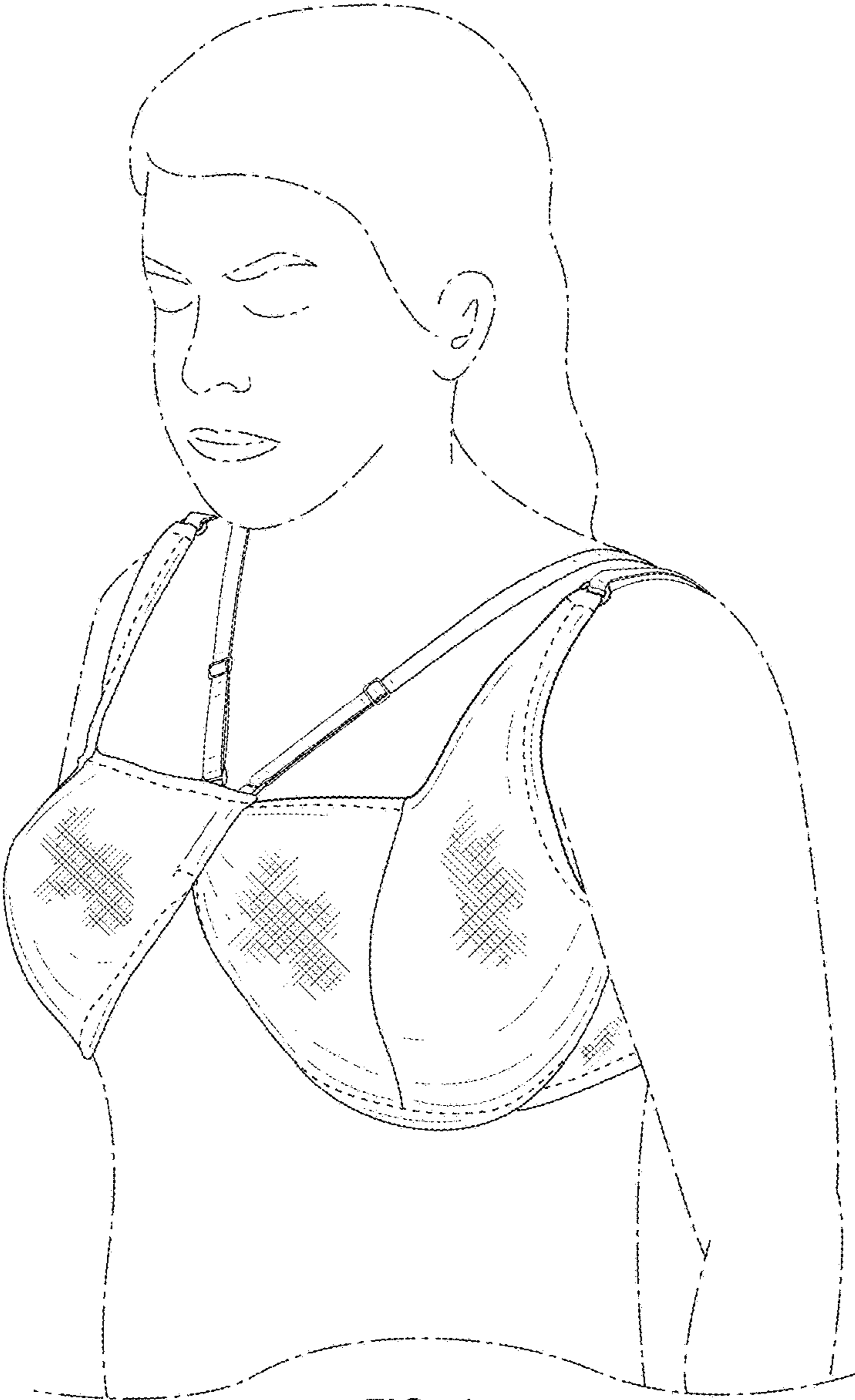

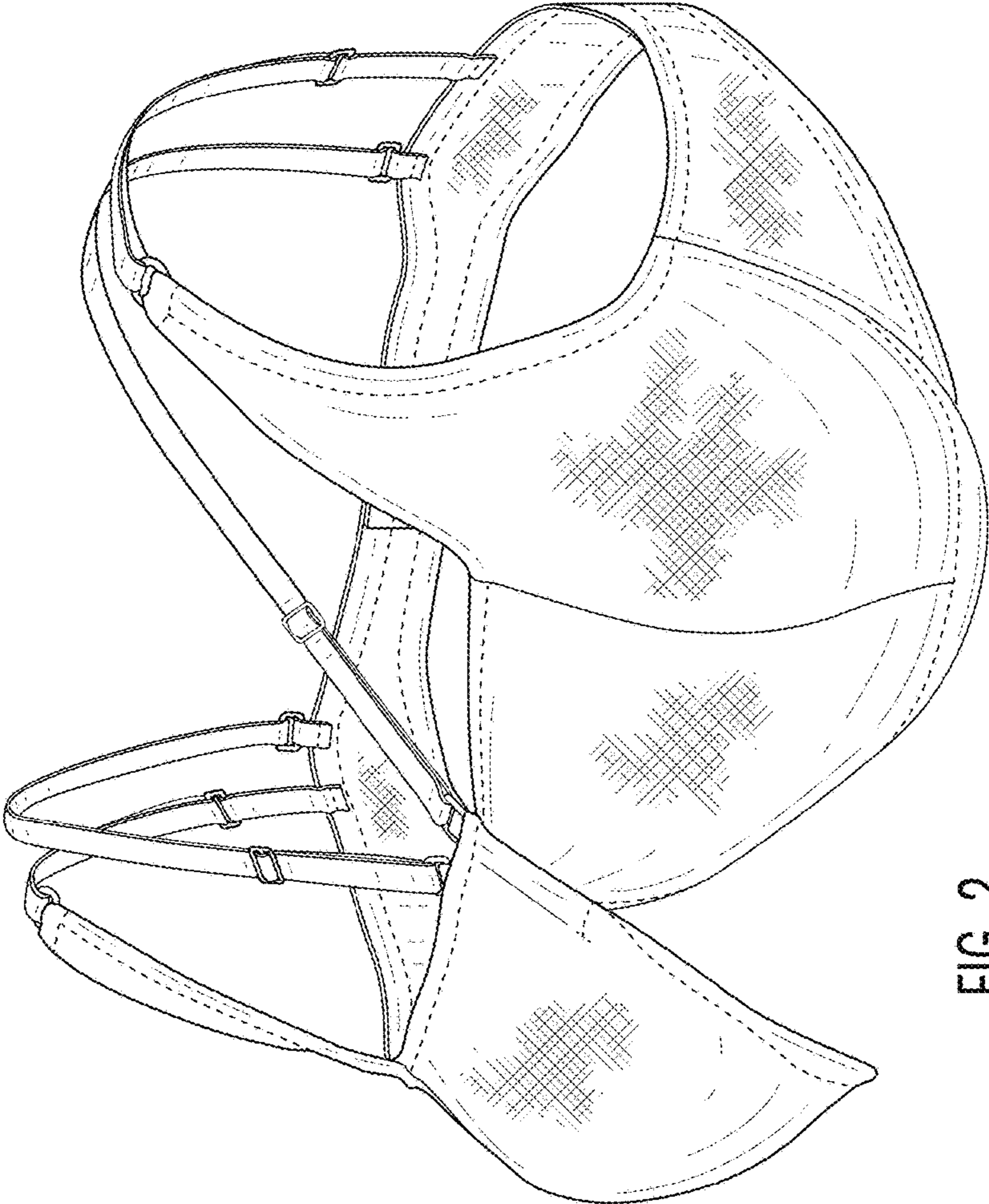

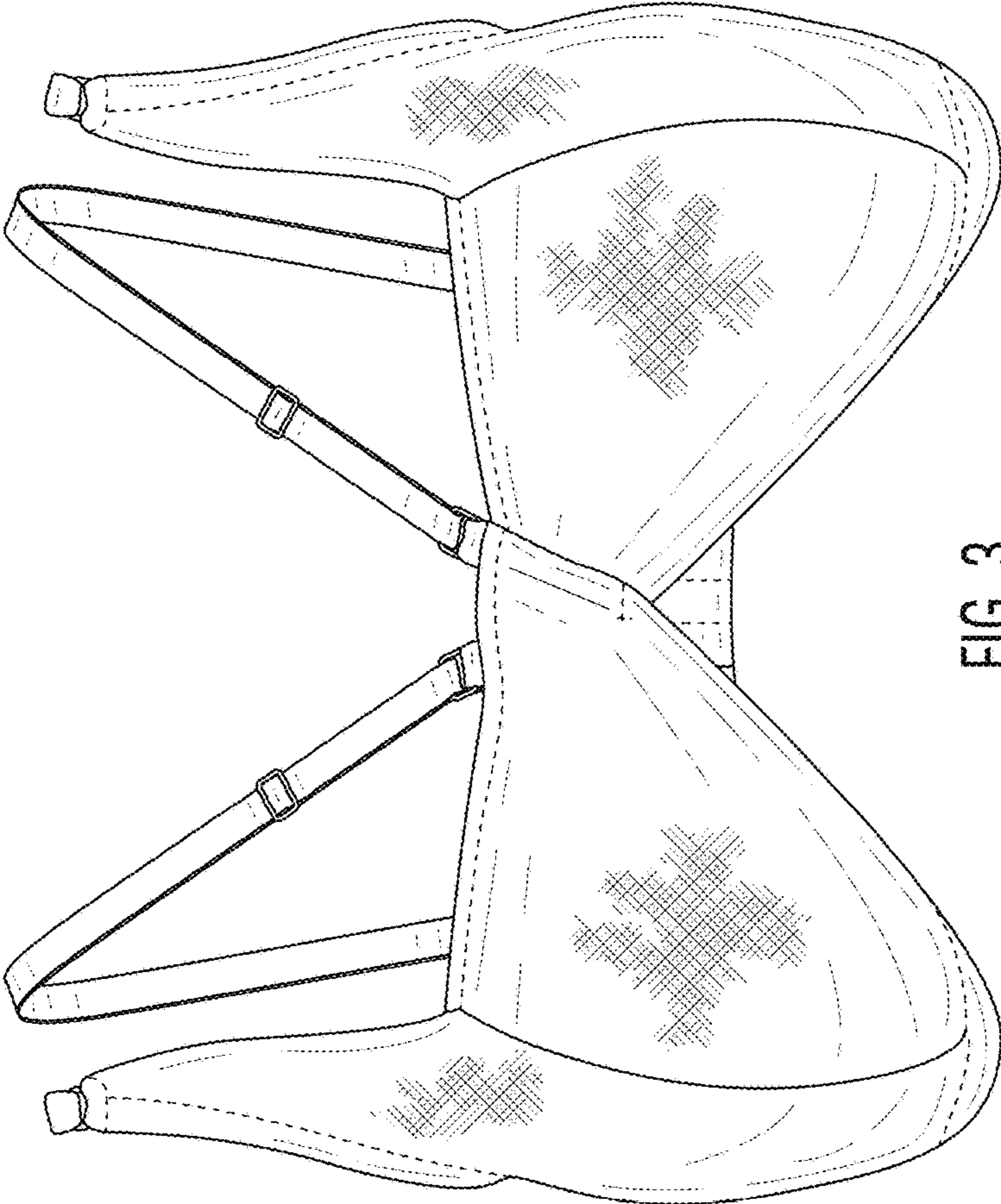

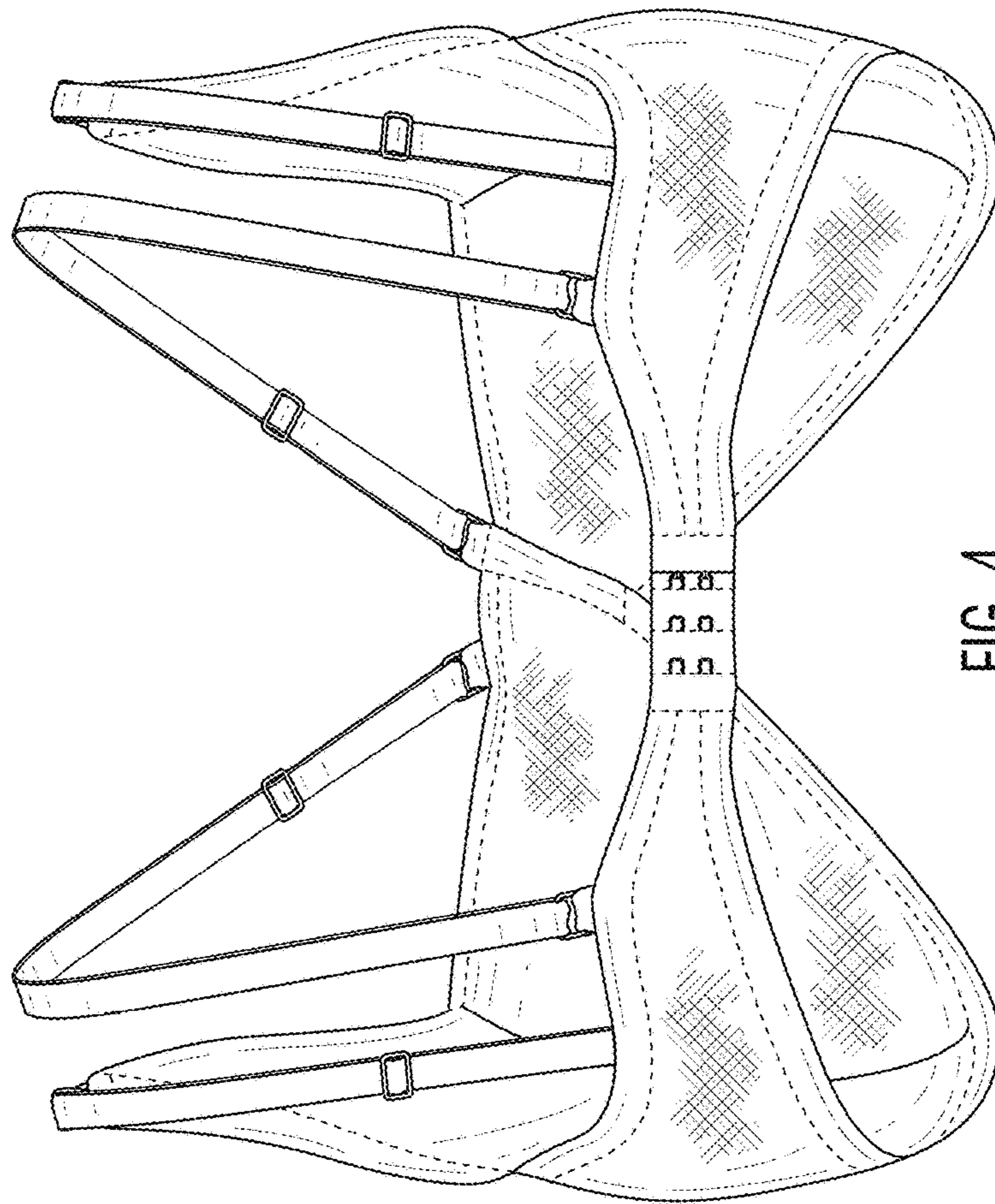

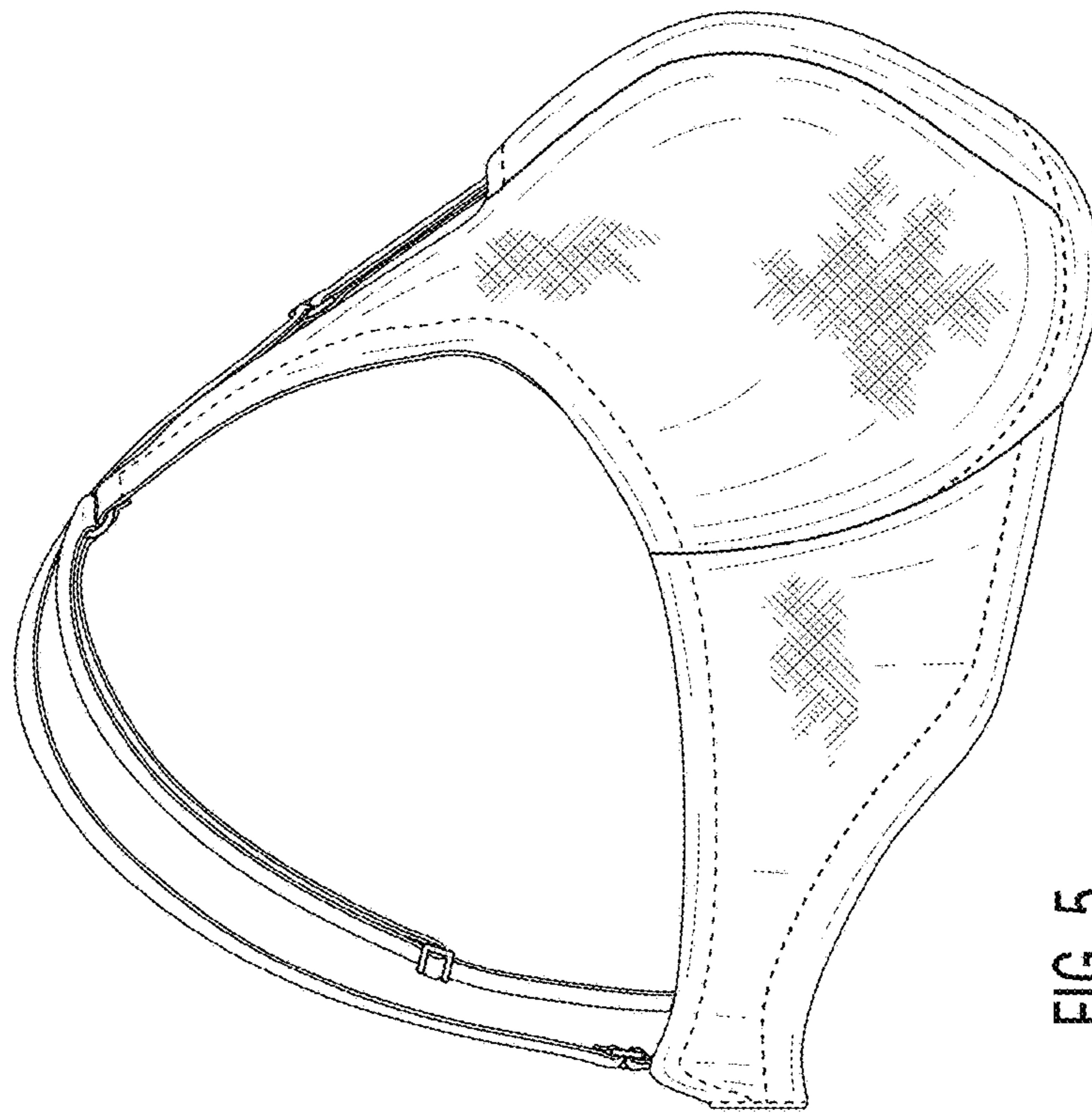

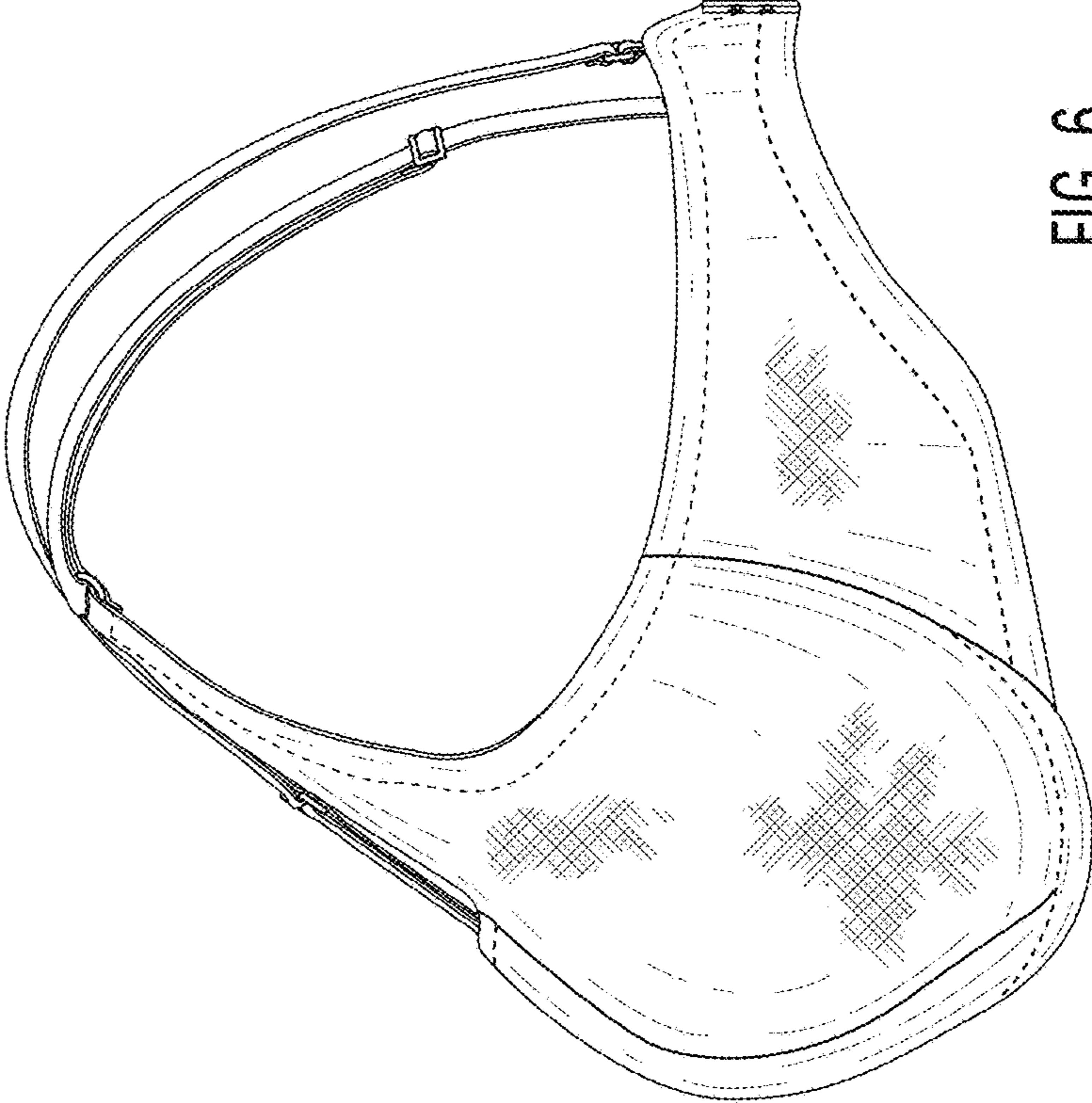

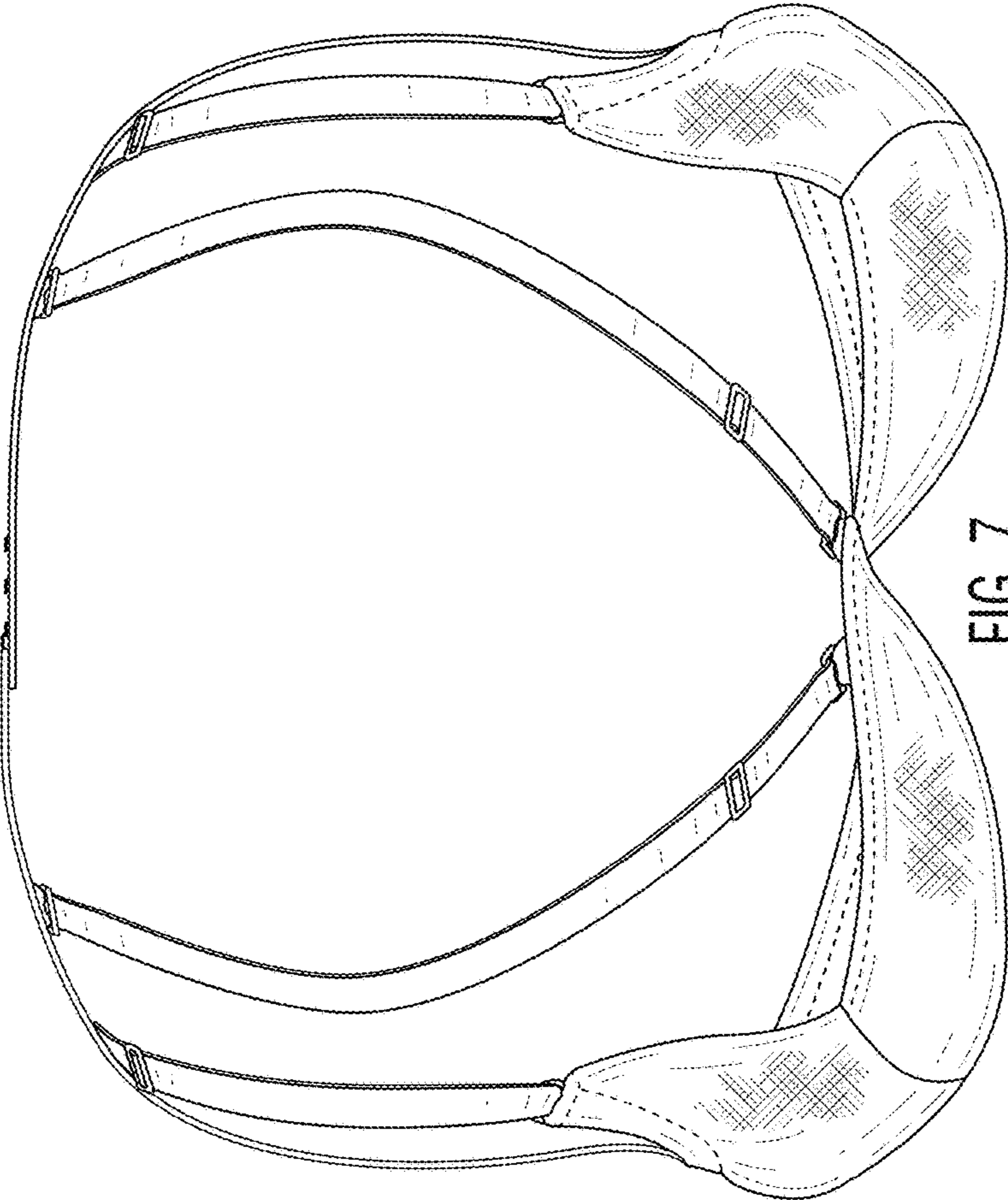

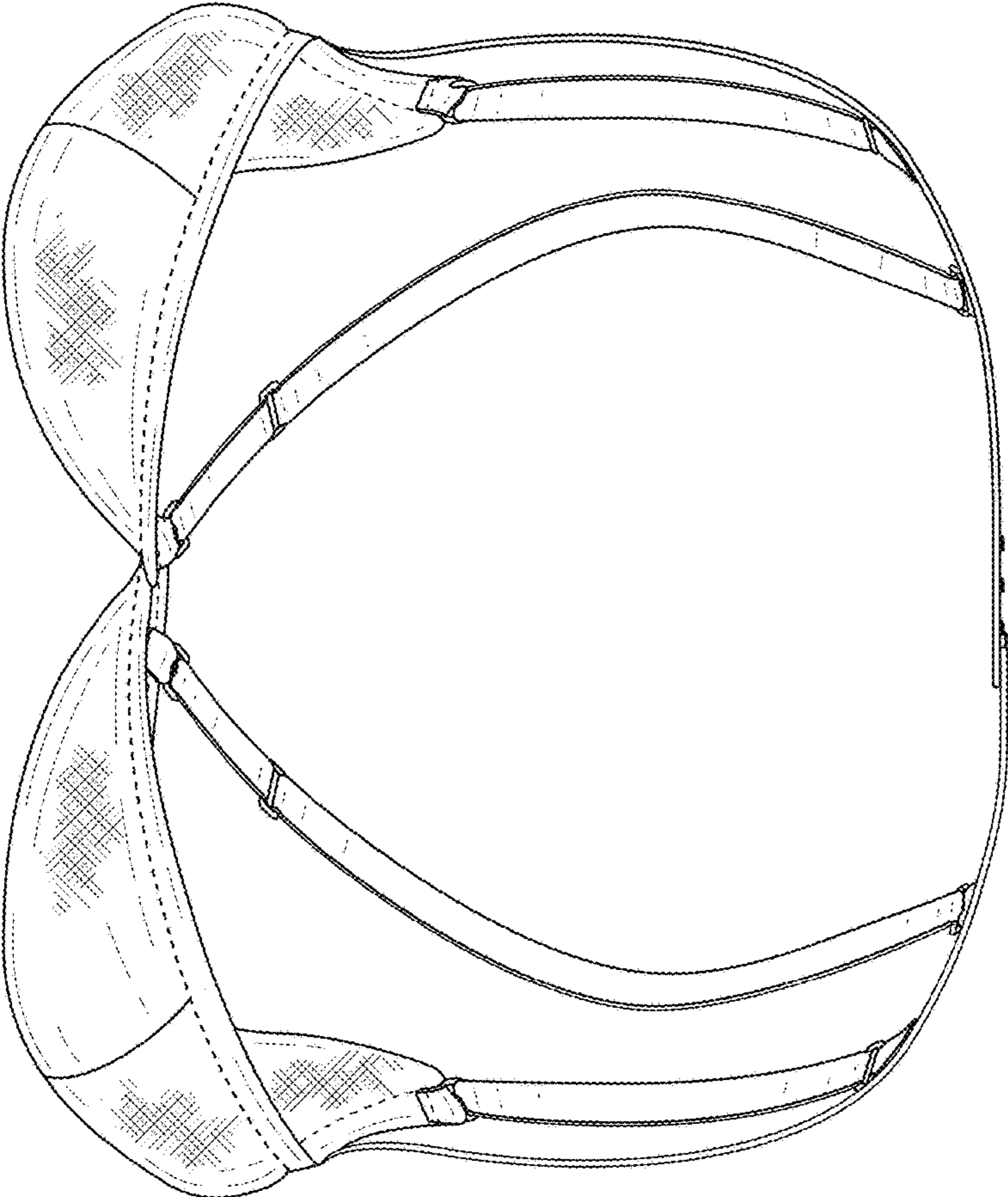
