FIG. 5 is a left side view thereof.

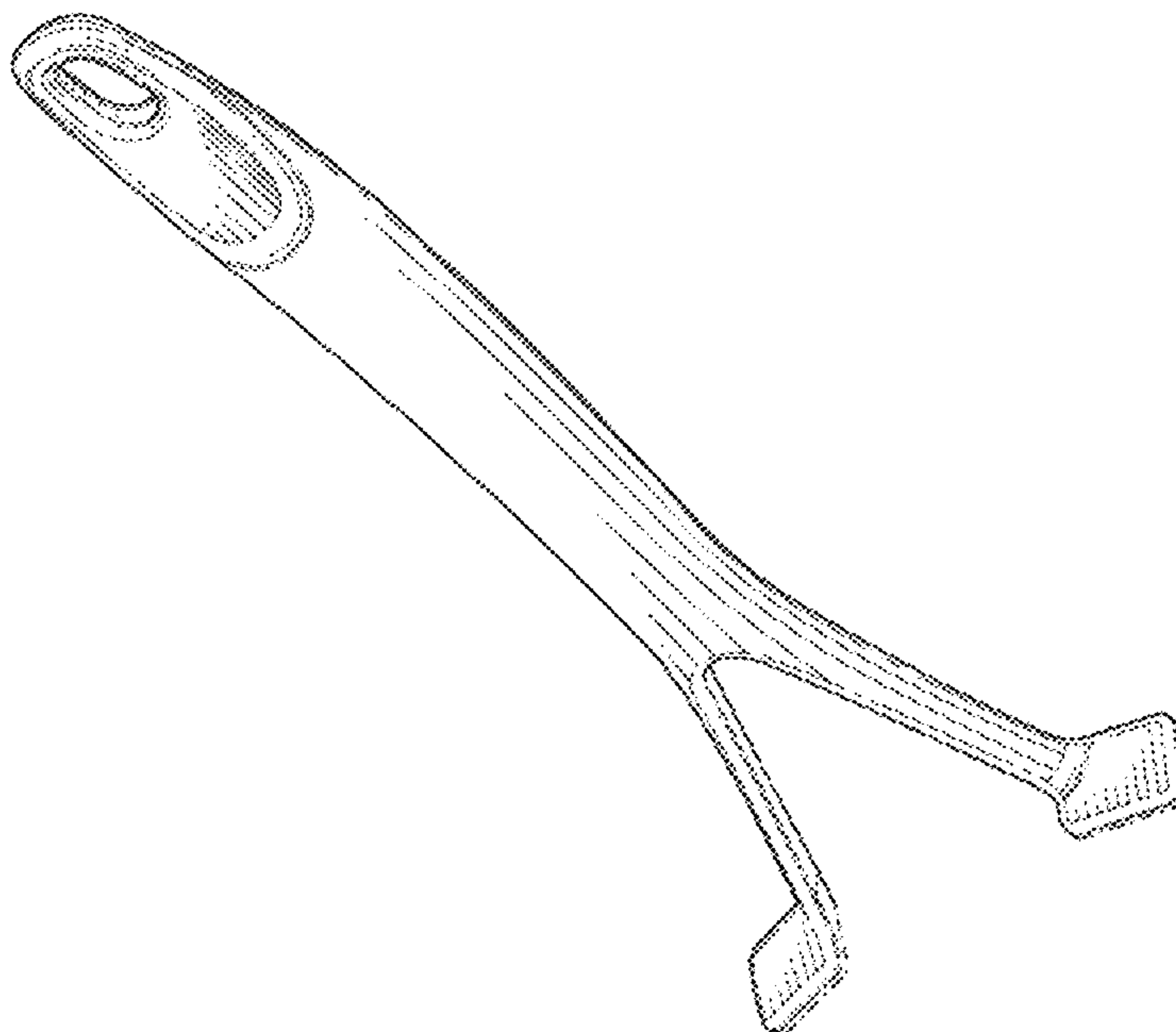
FIG. 6 is a top plan view thereof, partially obscured by a portion of the cooking pot.

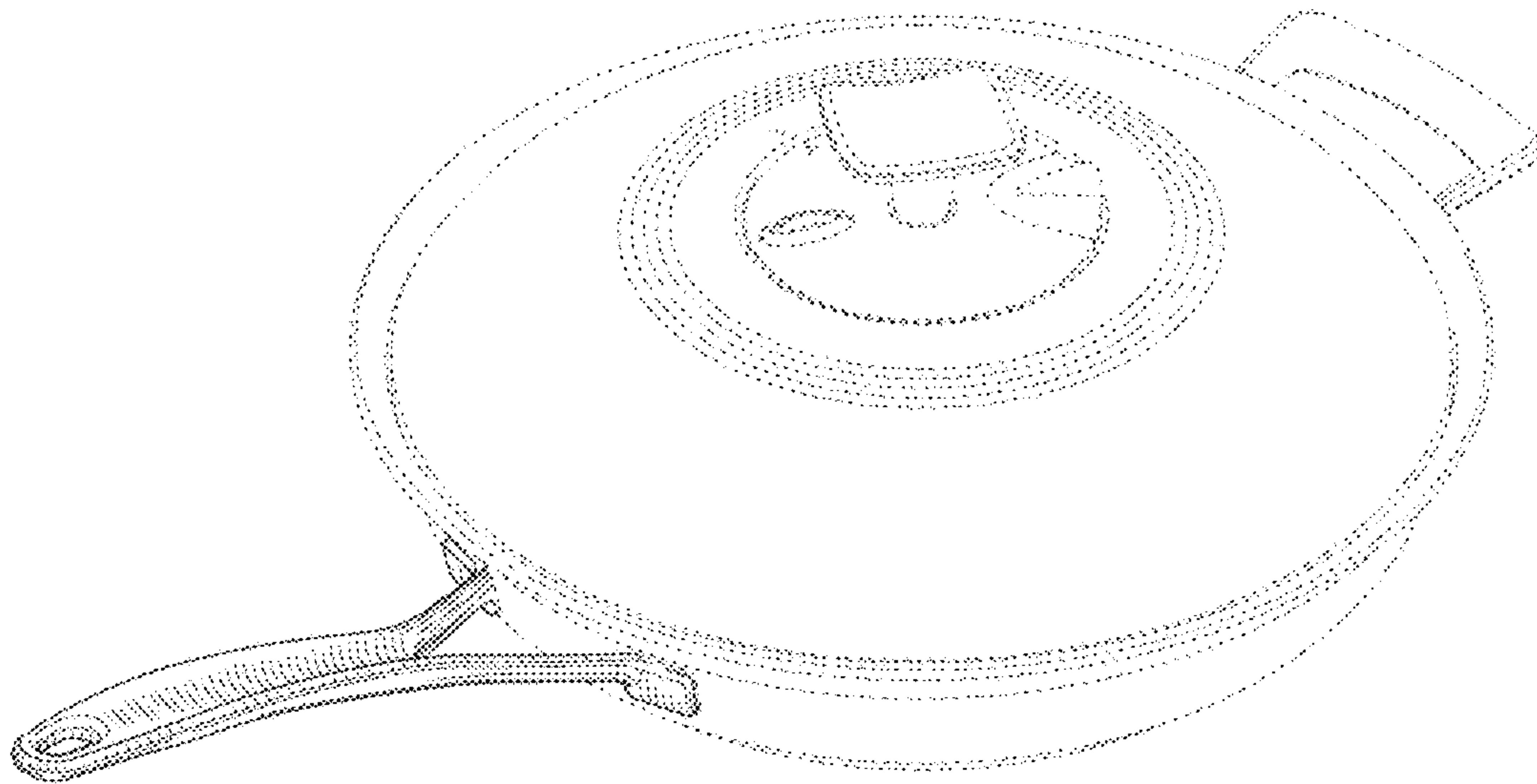

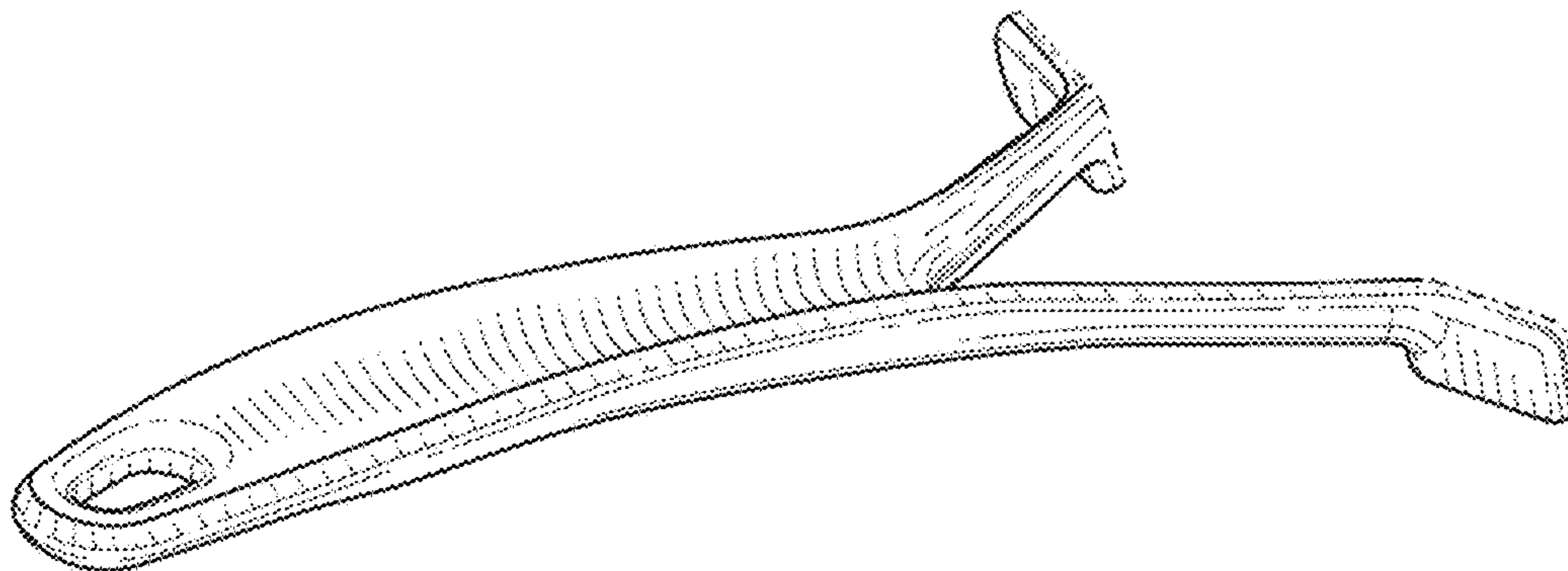

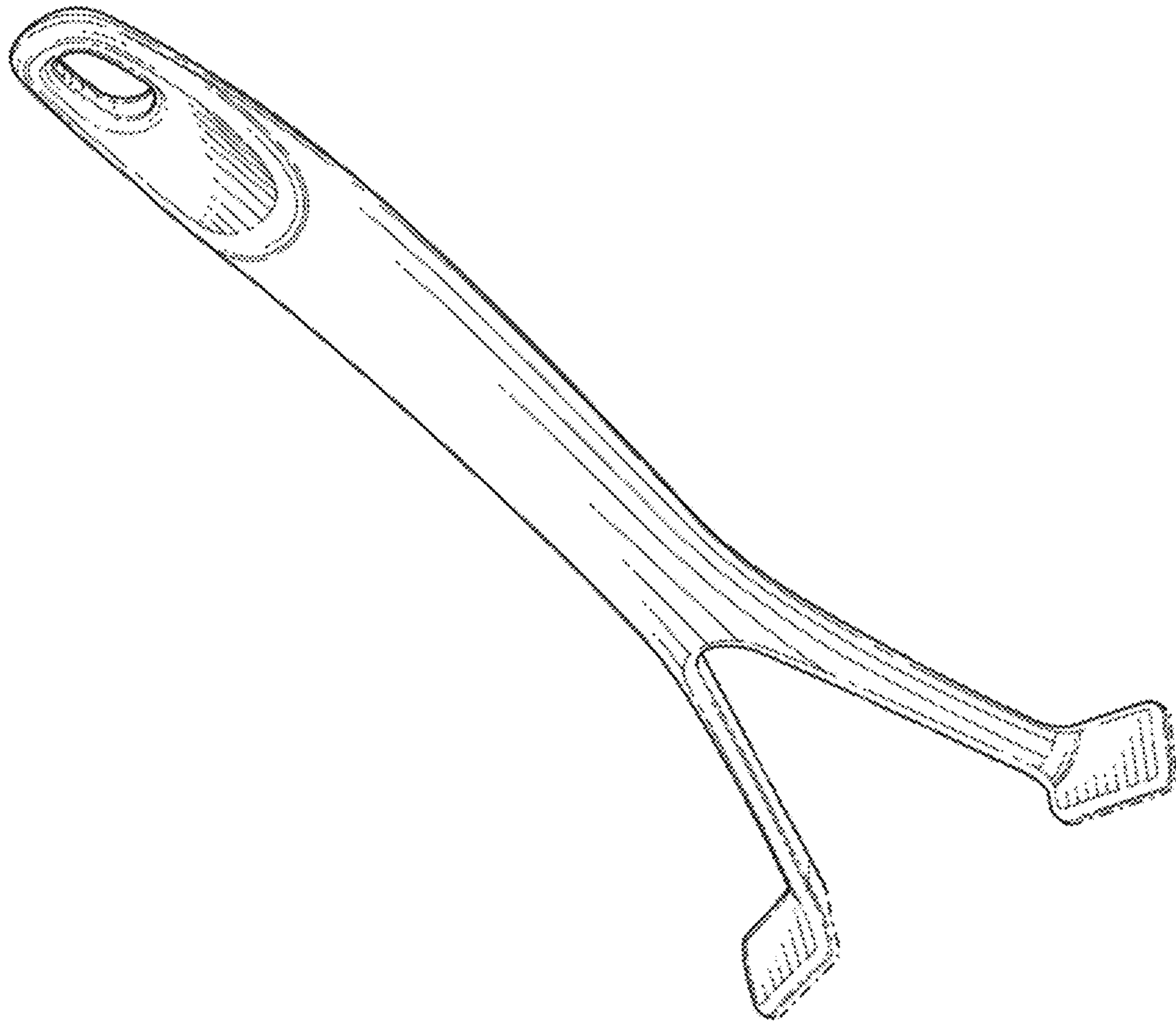

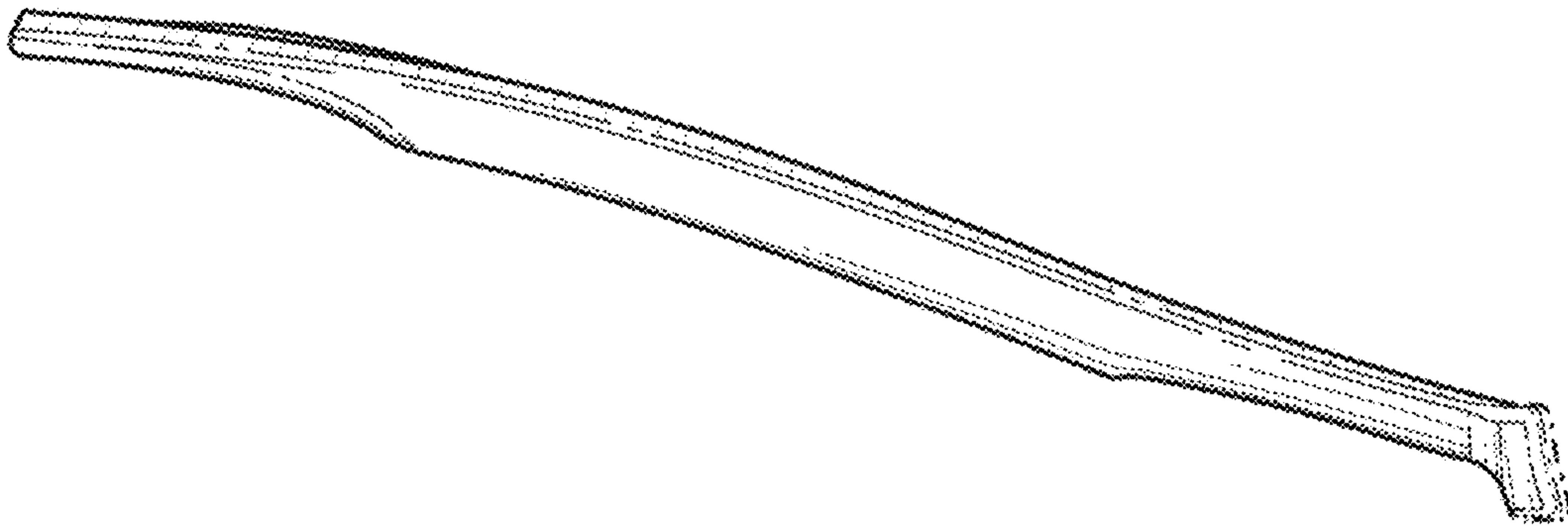

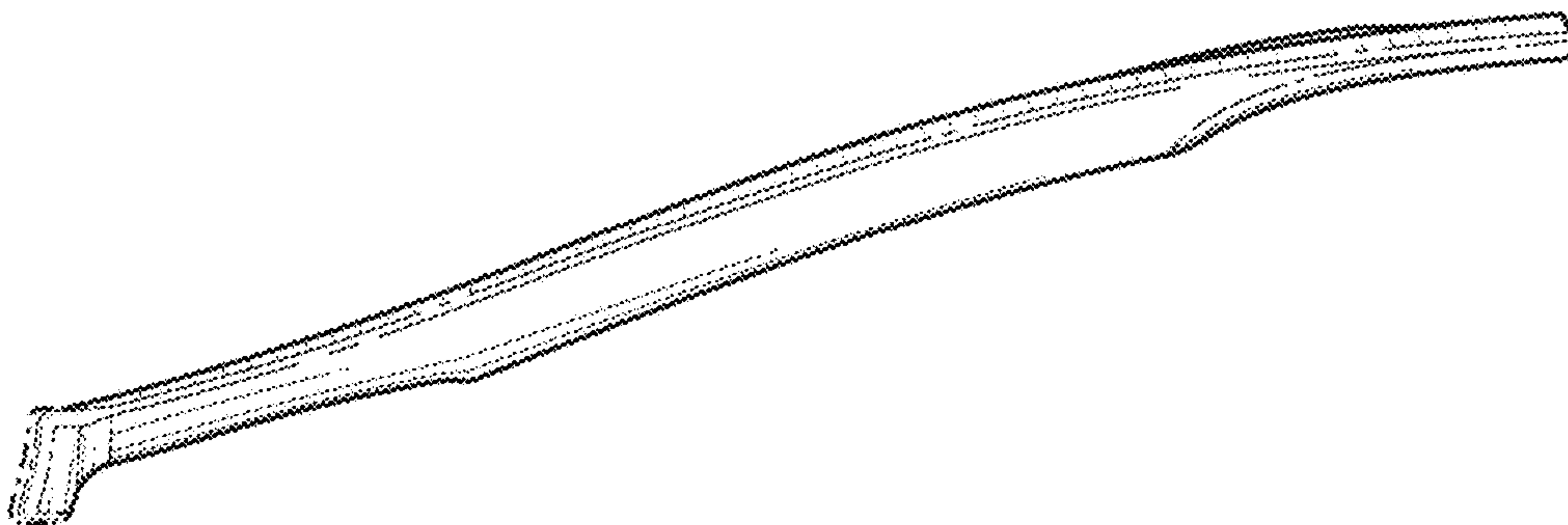

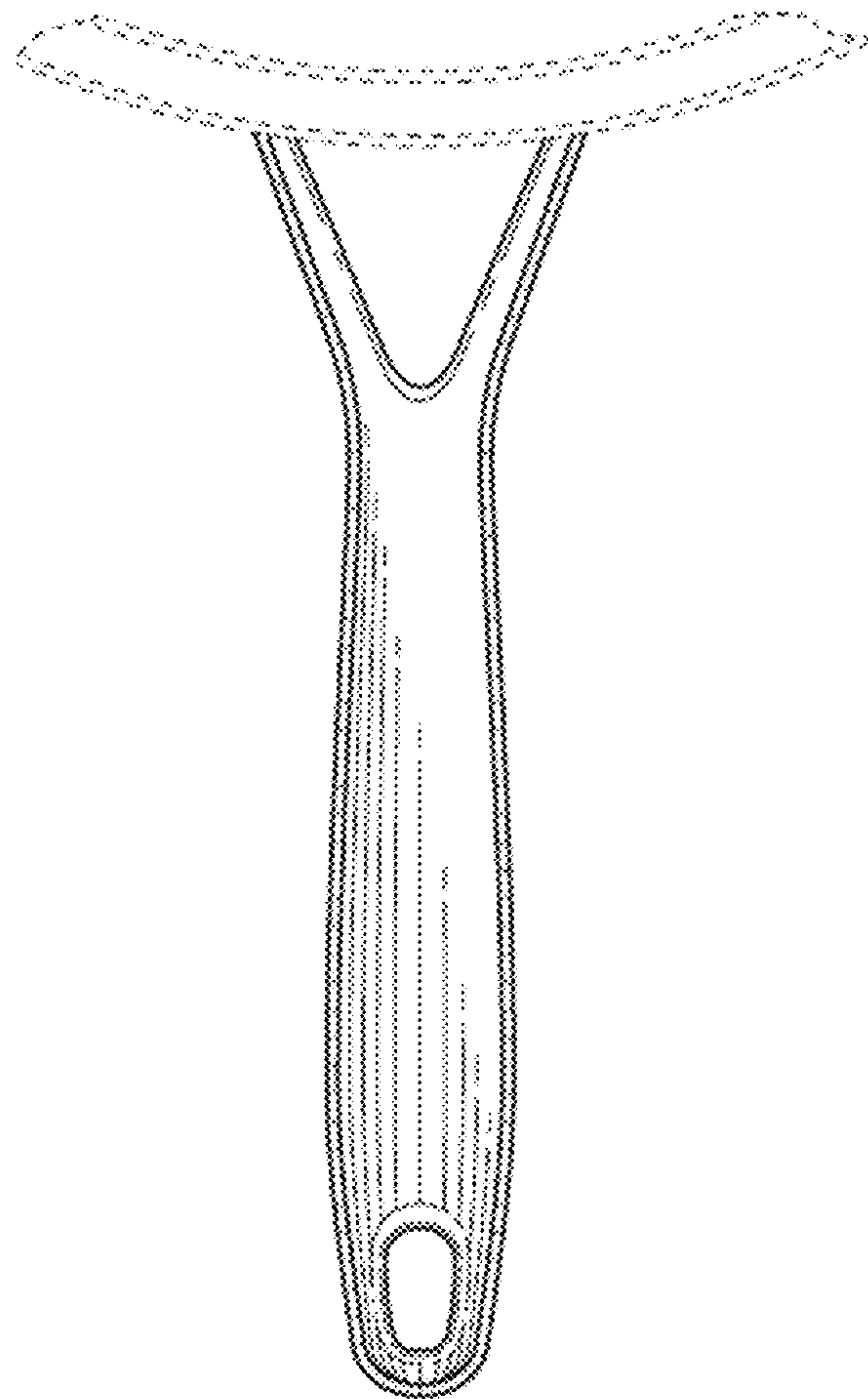

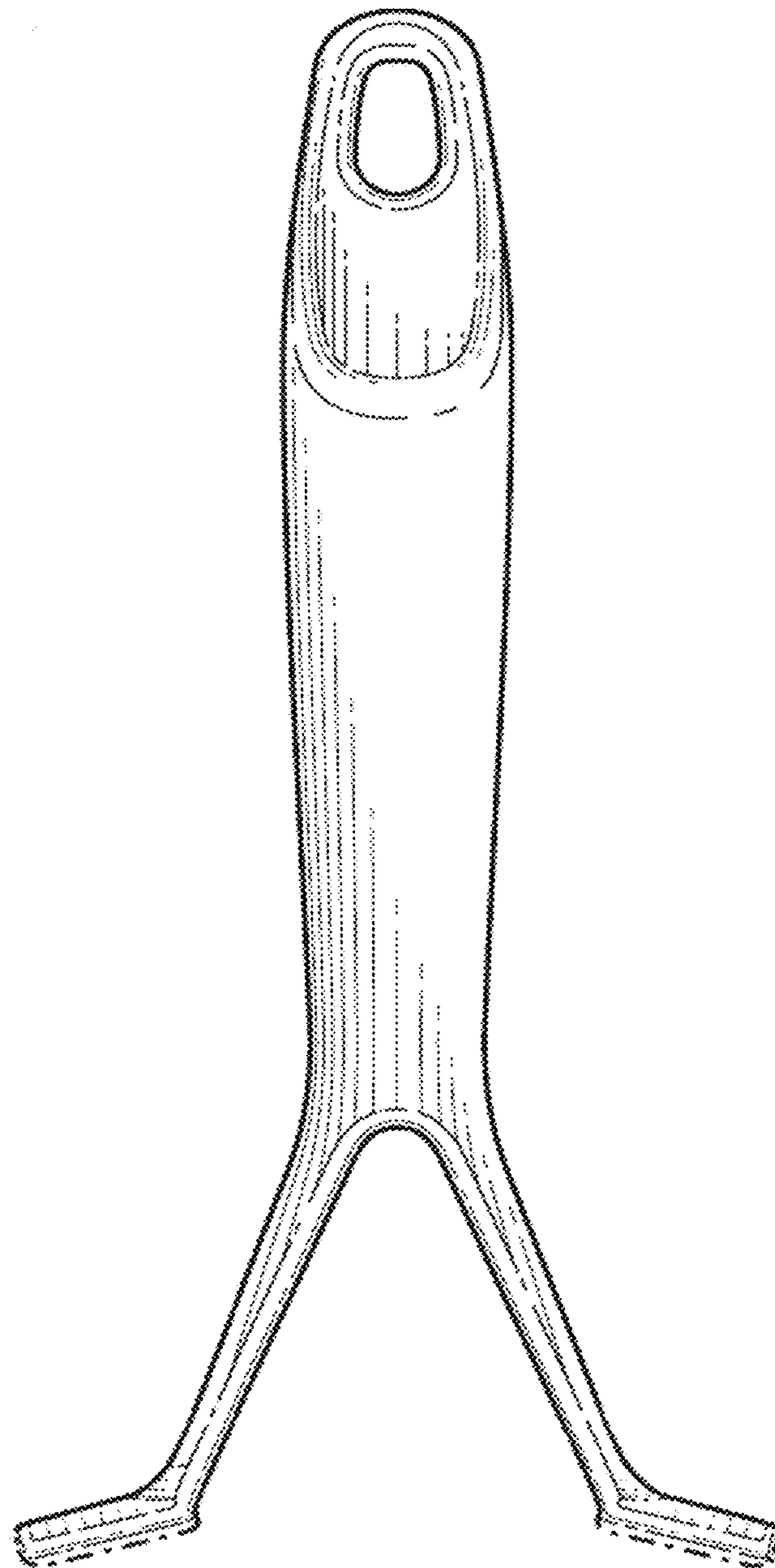

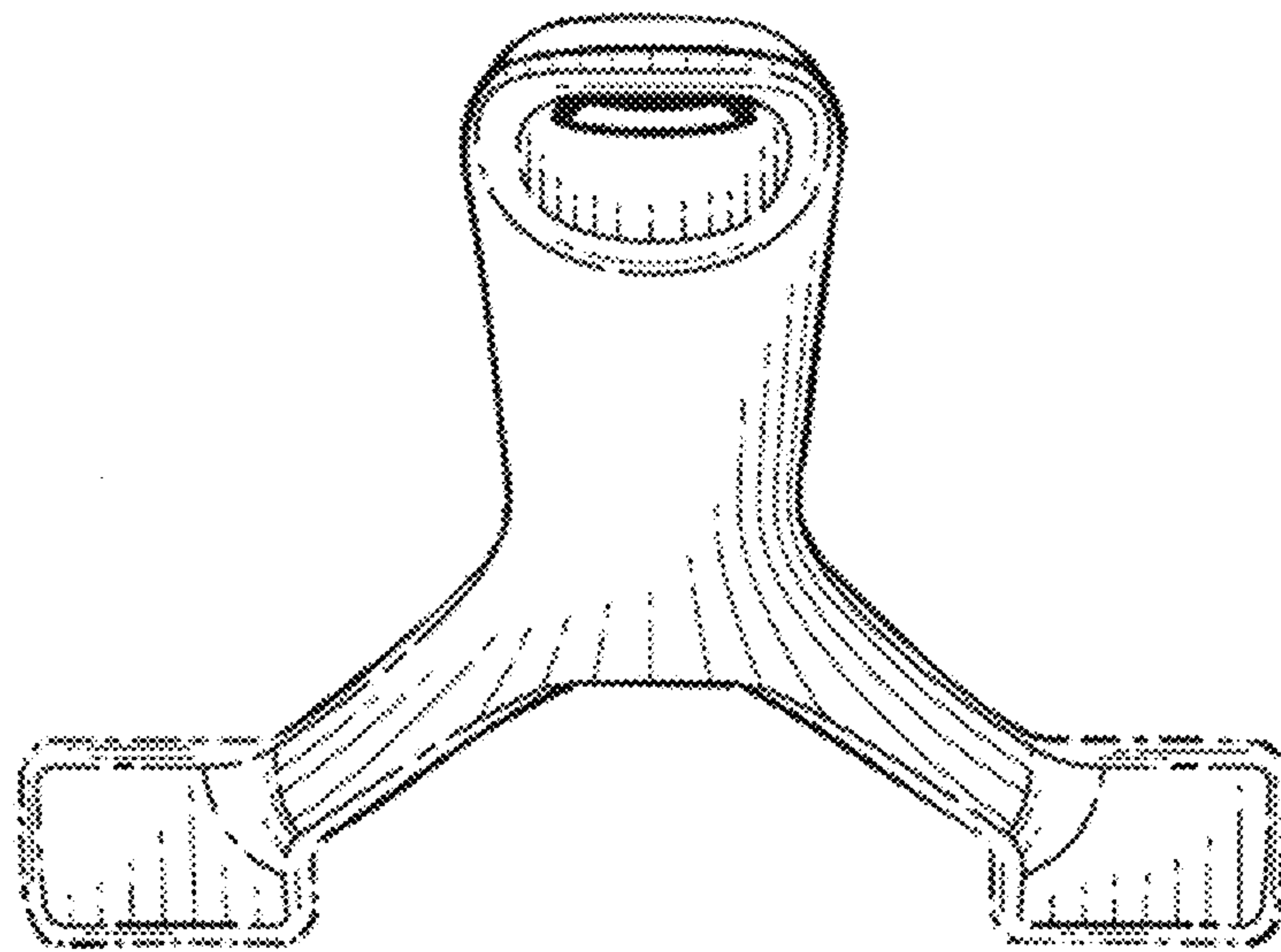
