as shown and described.

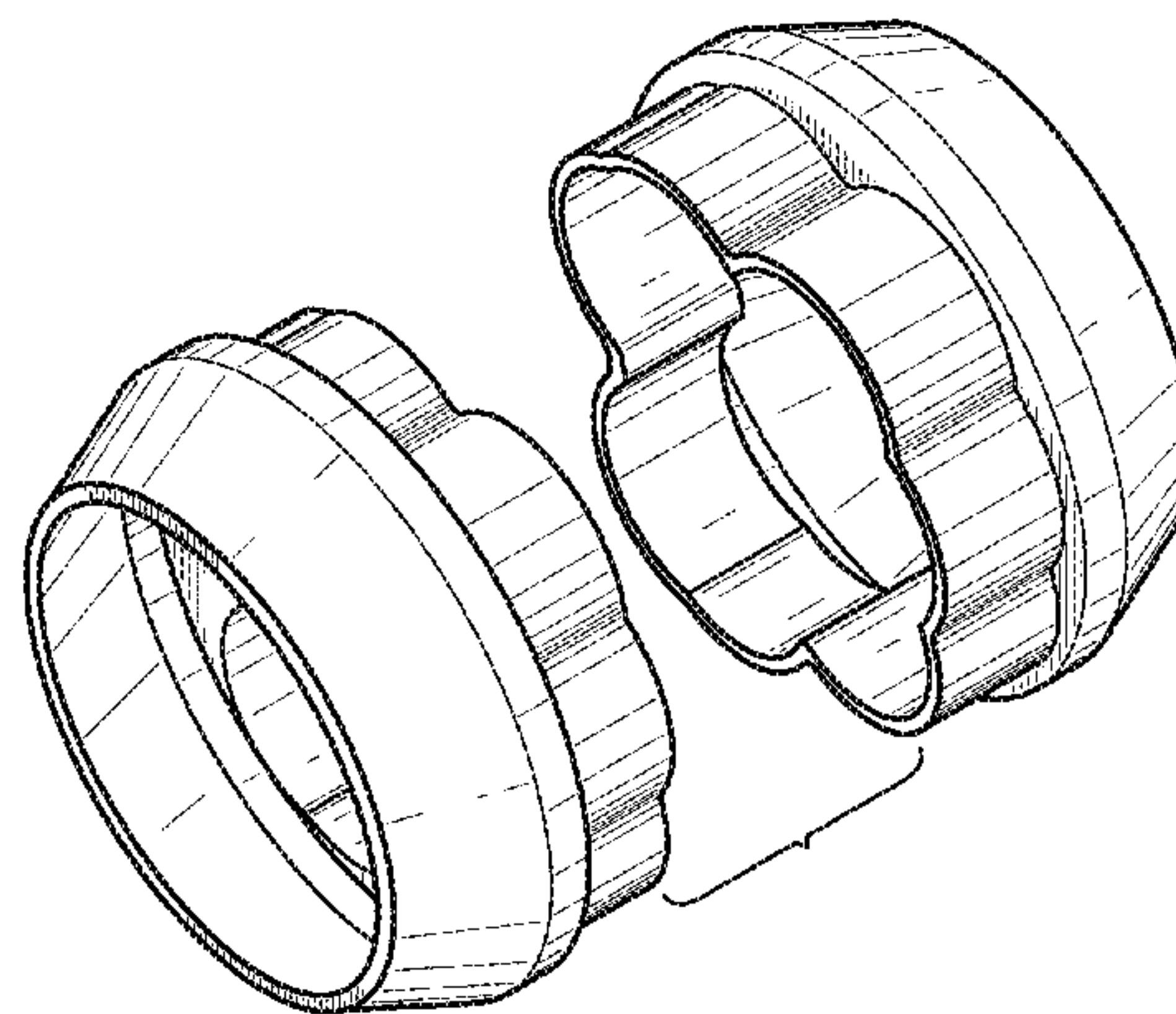
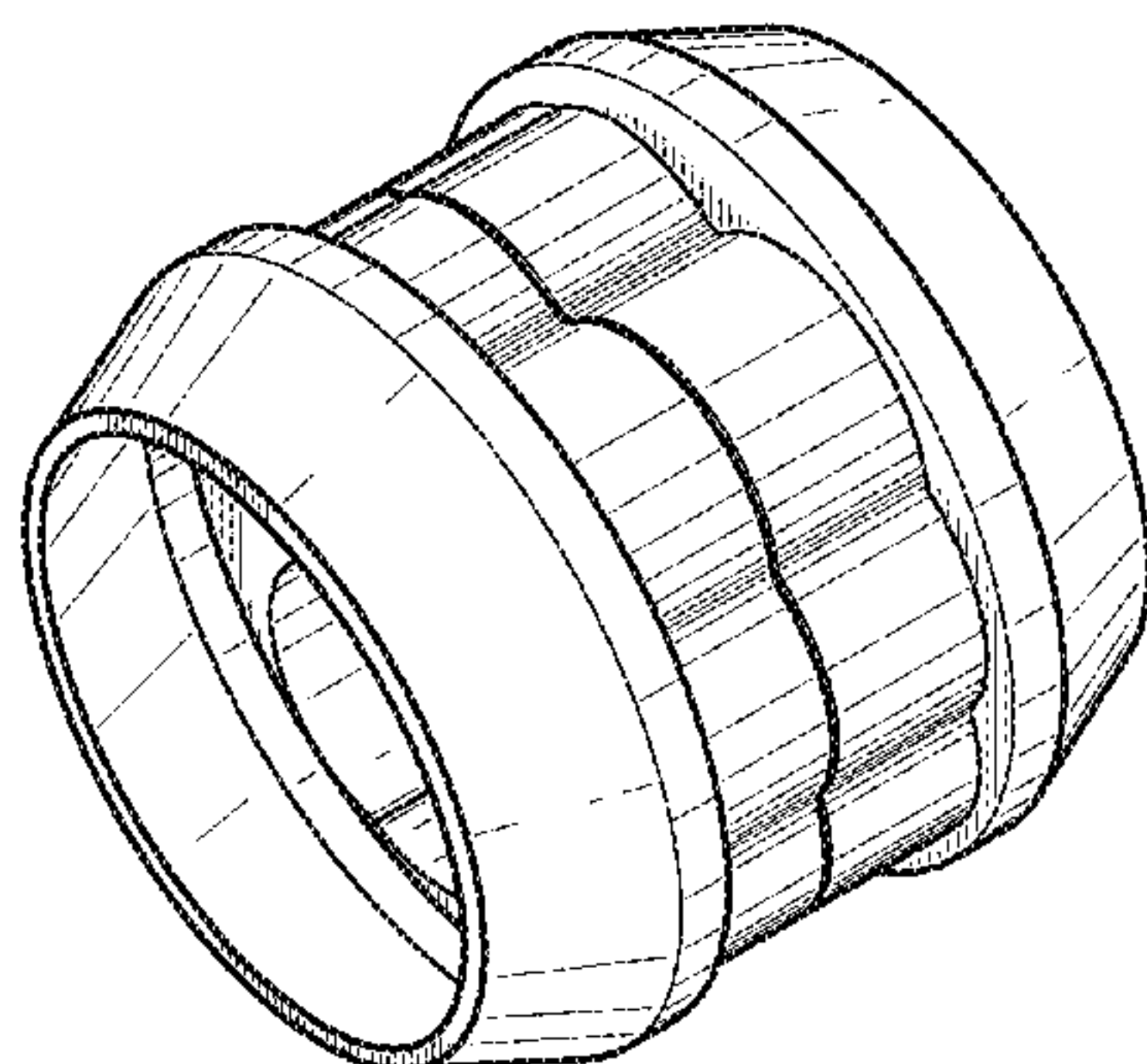
DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front, right perspective view of the automobile
exhaust collector showing the new design;

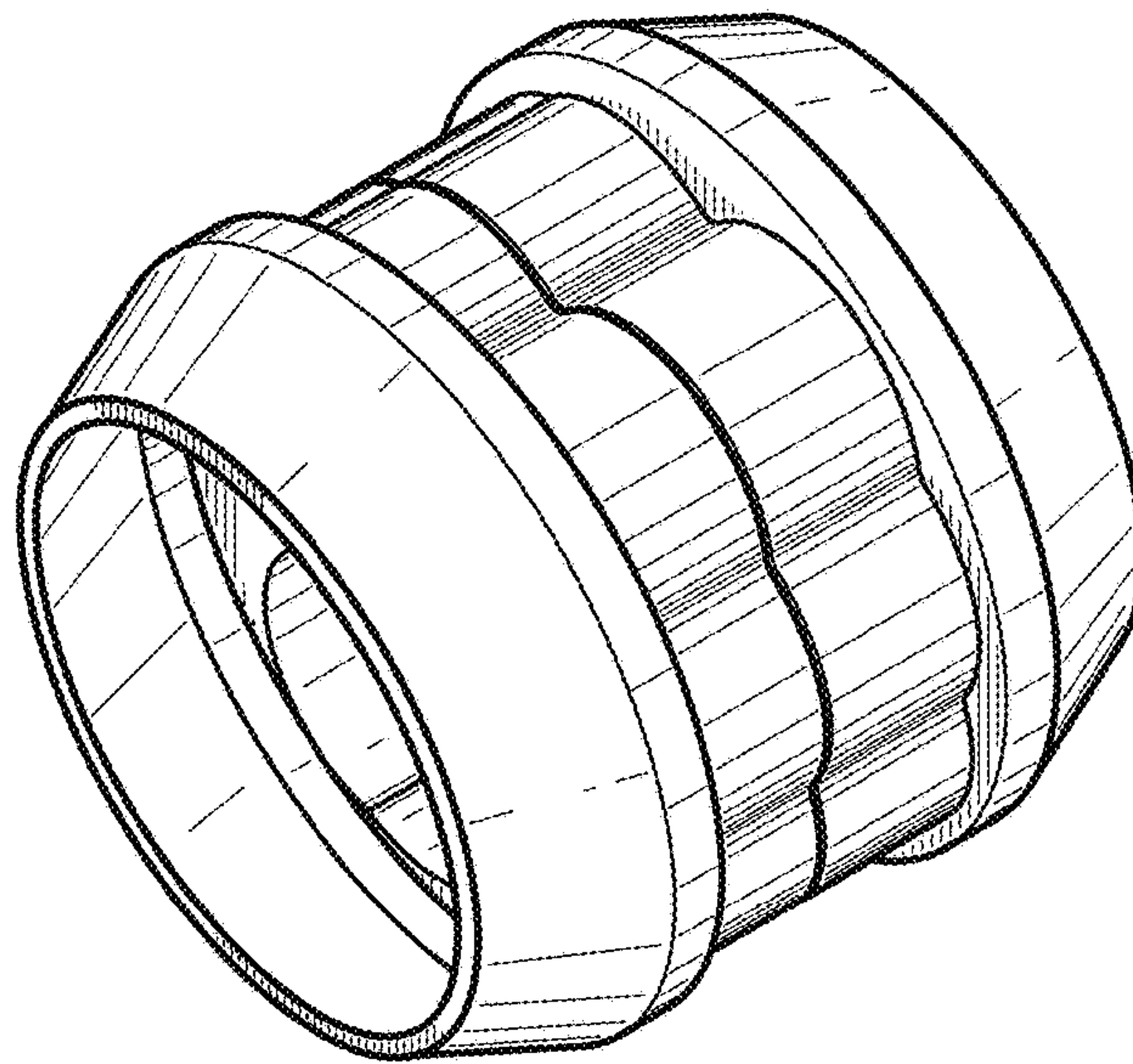

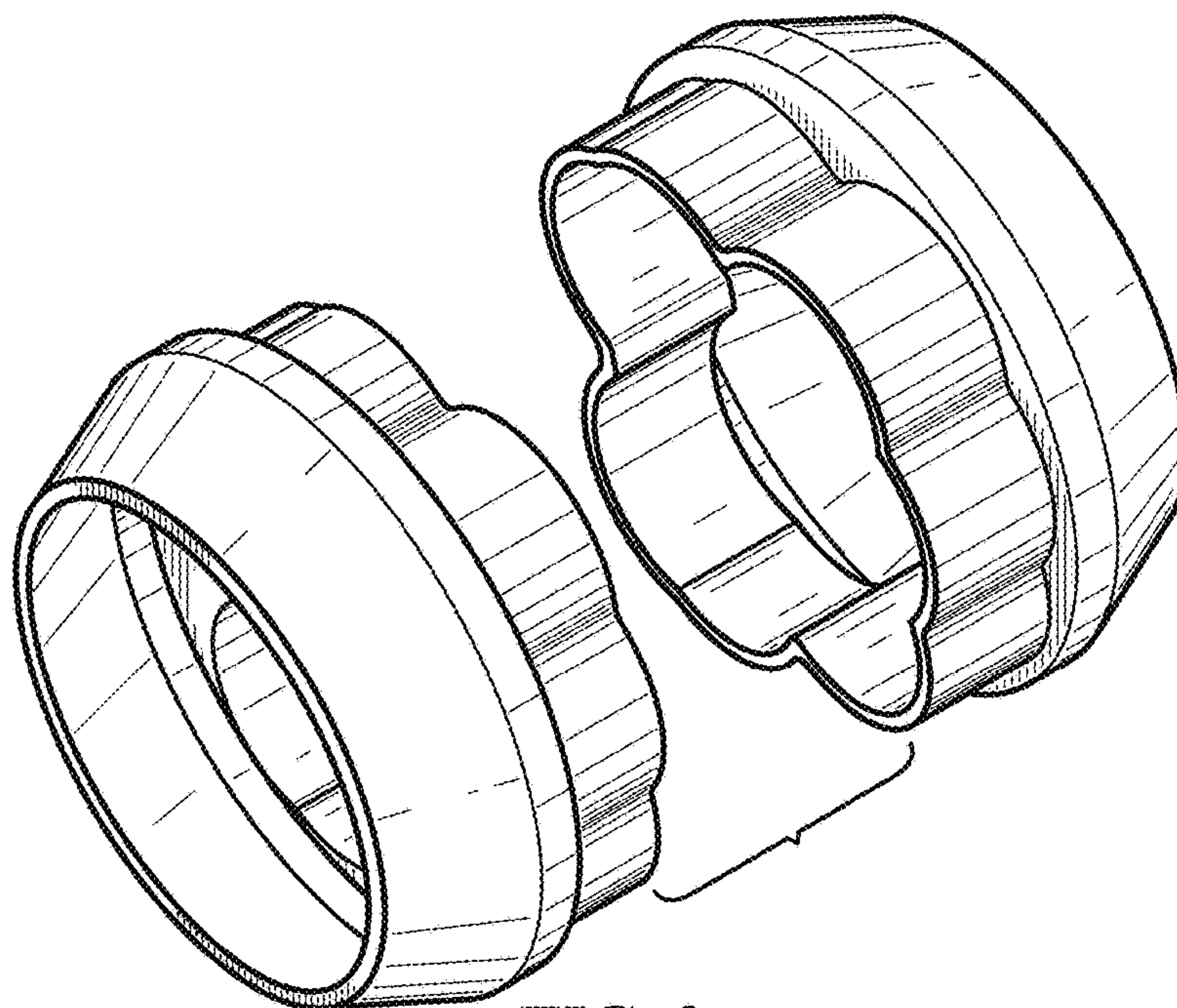

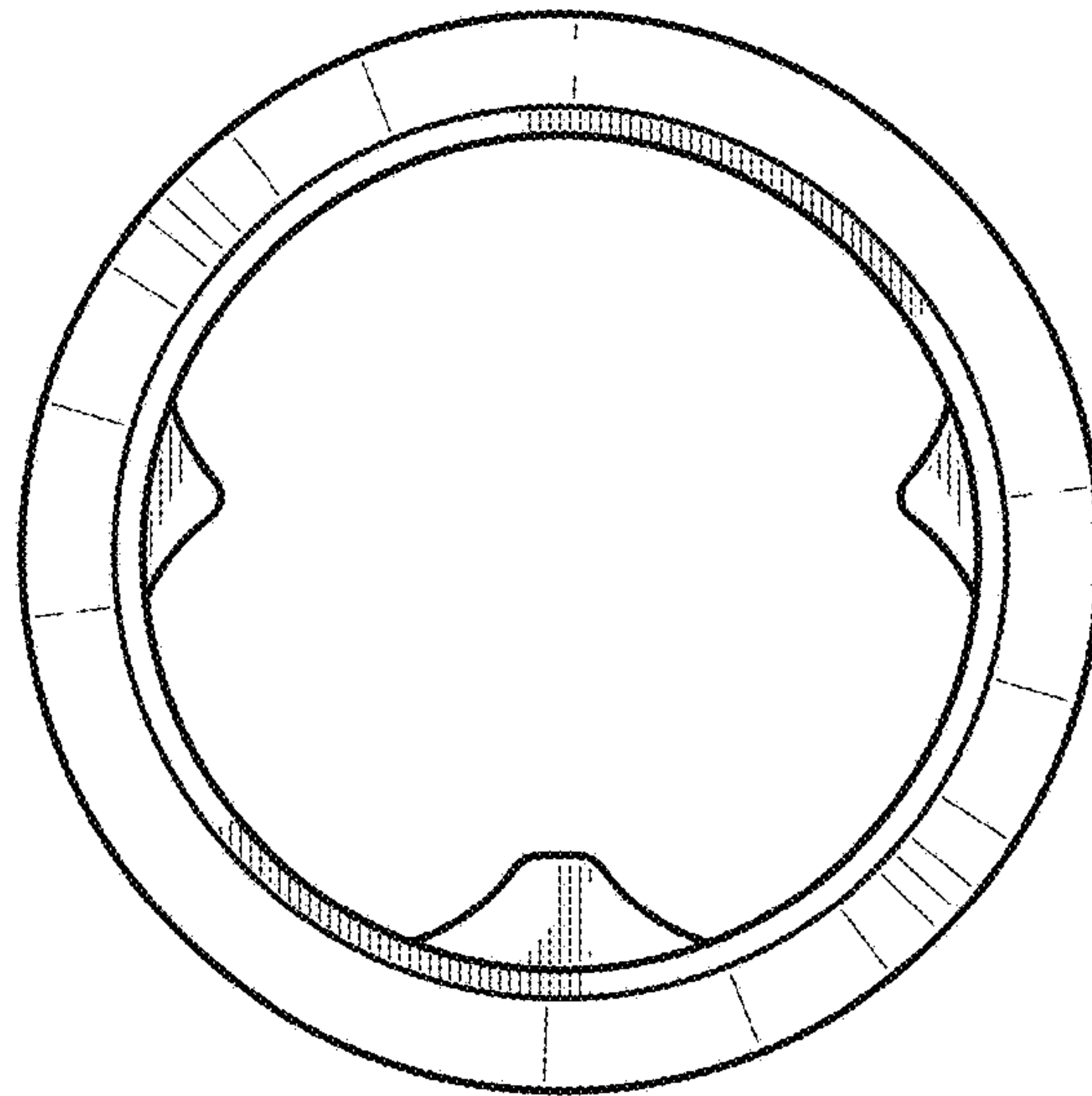

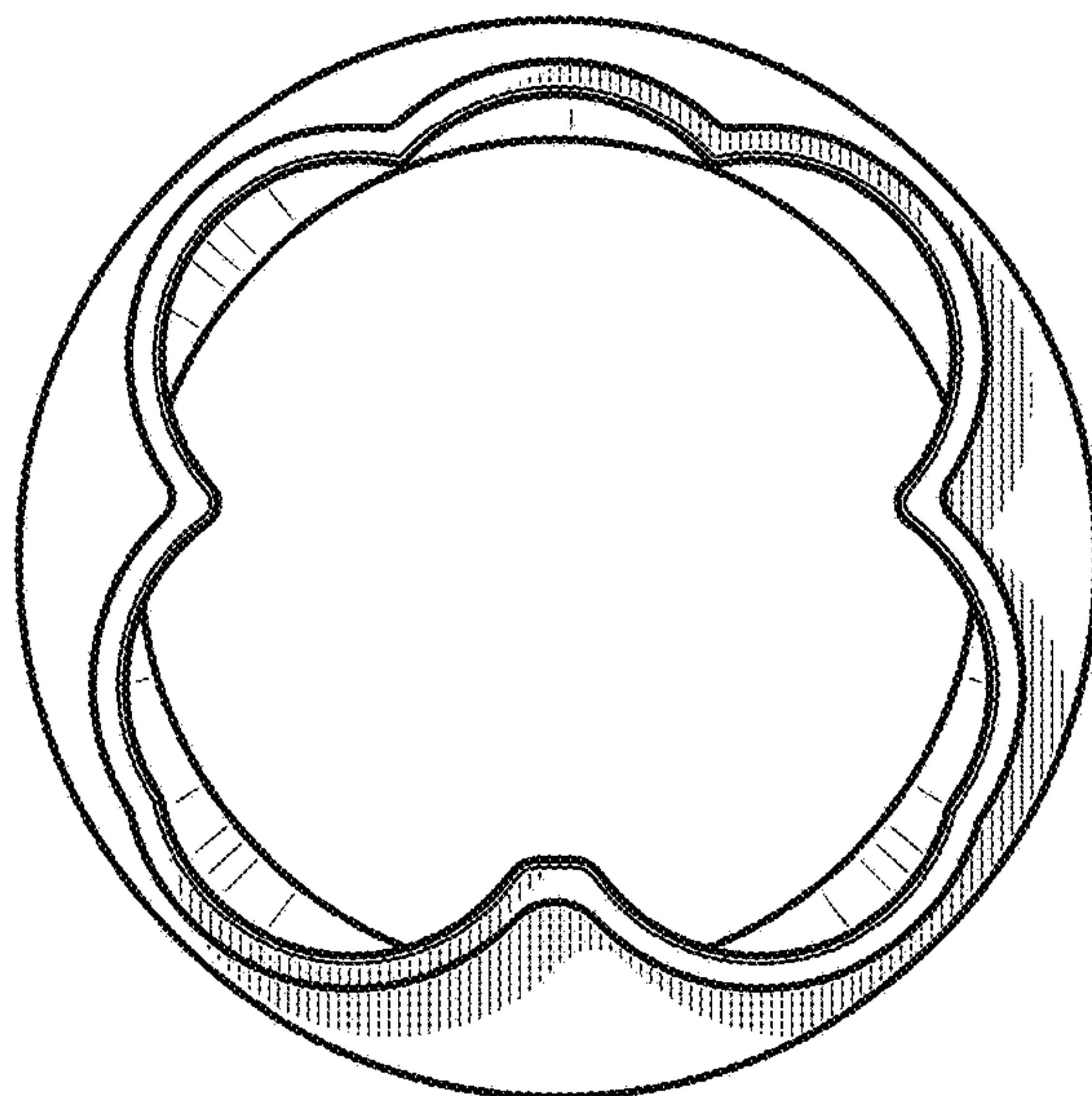

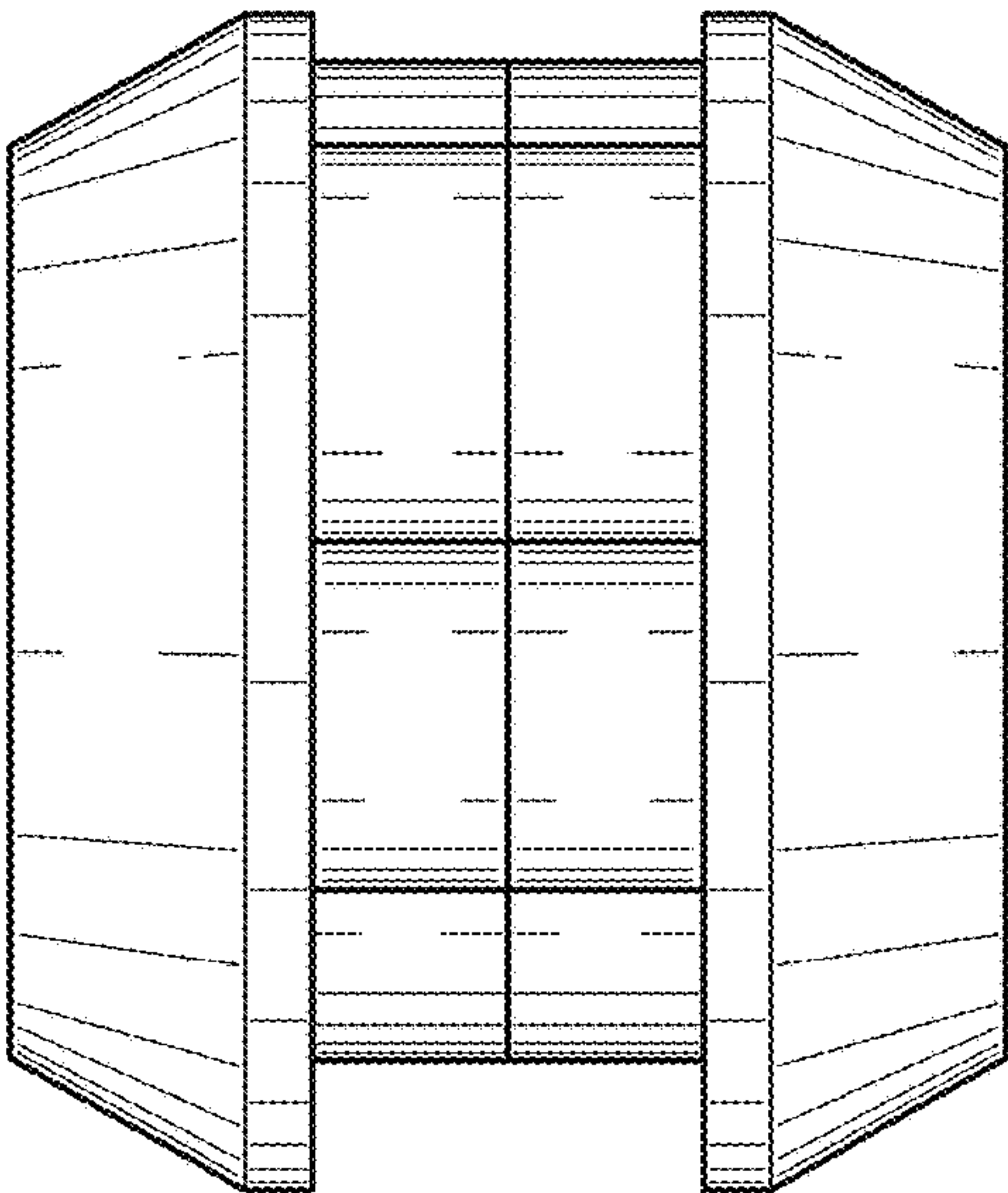

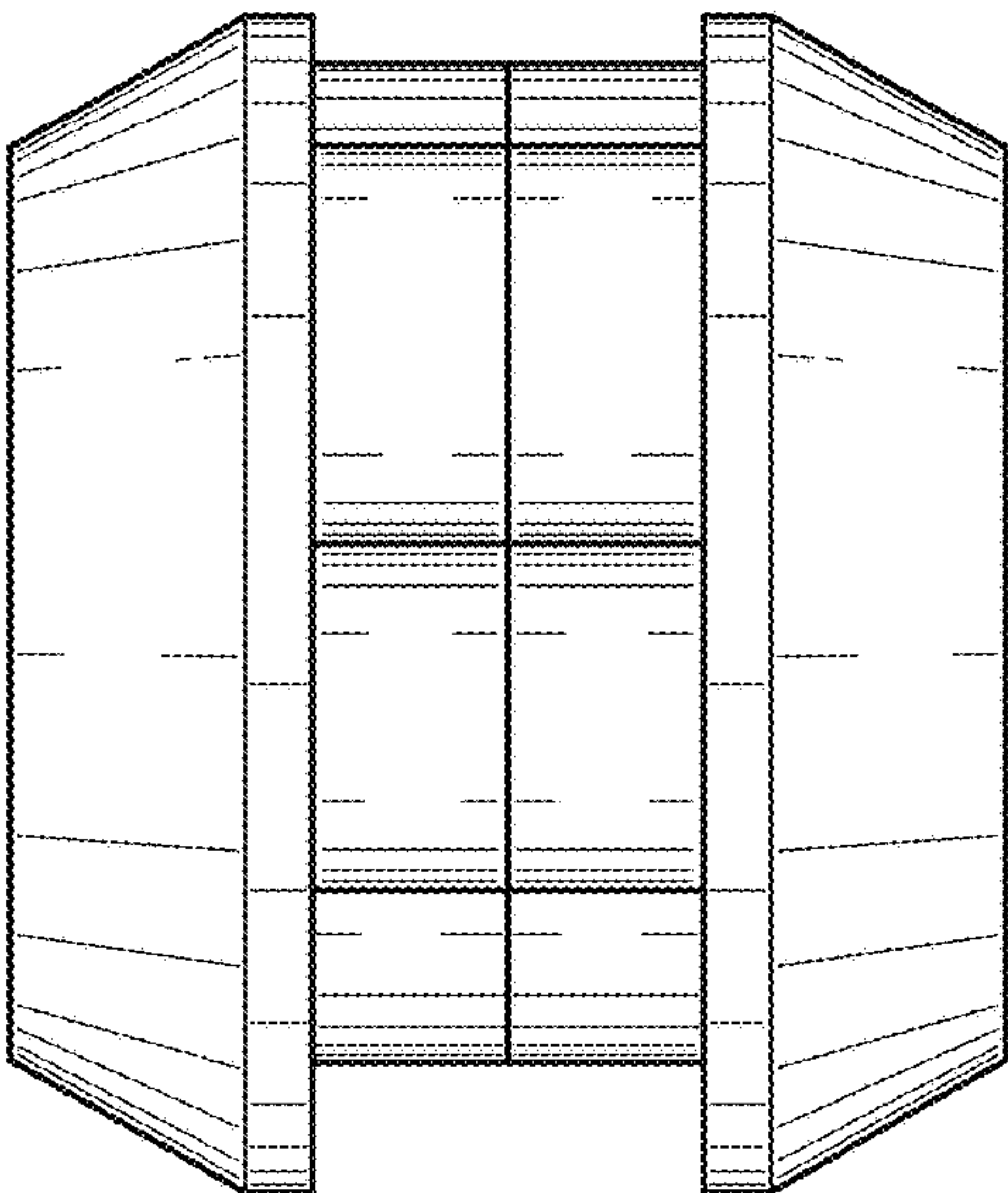

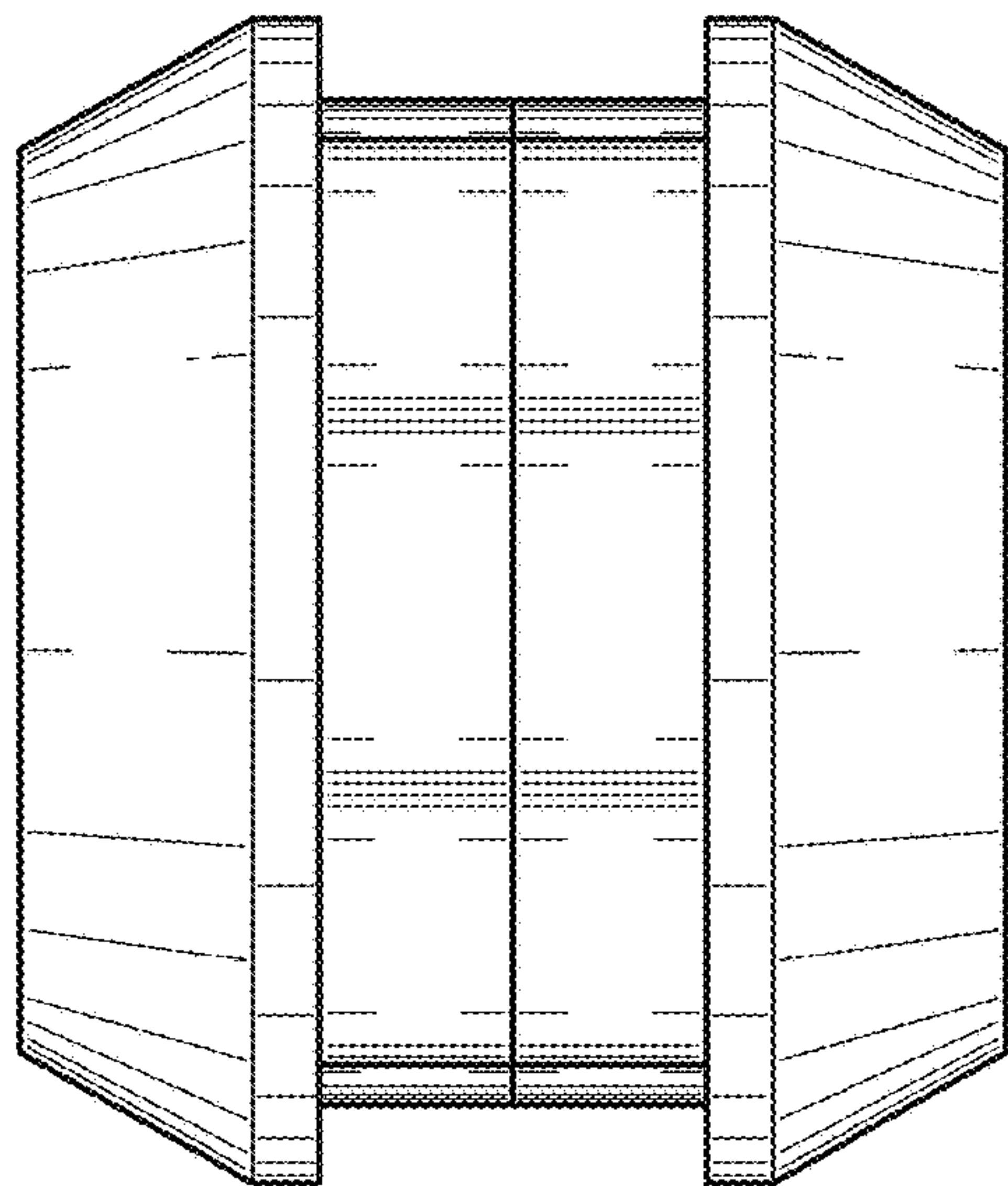

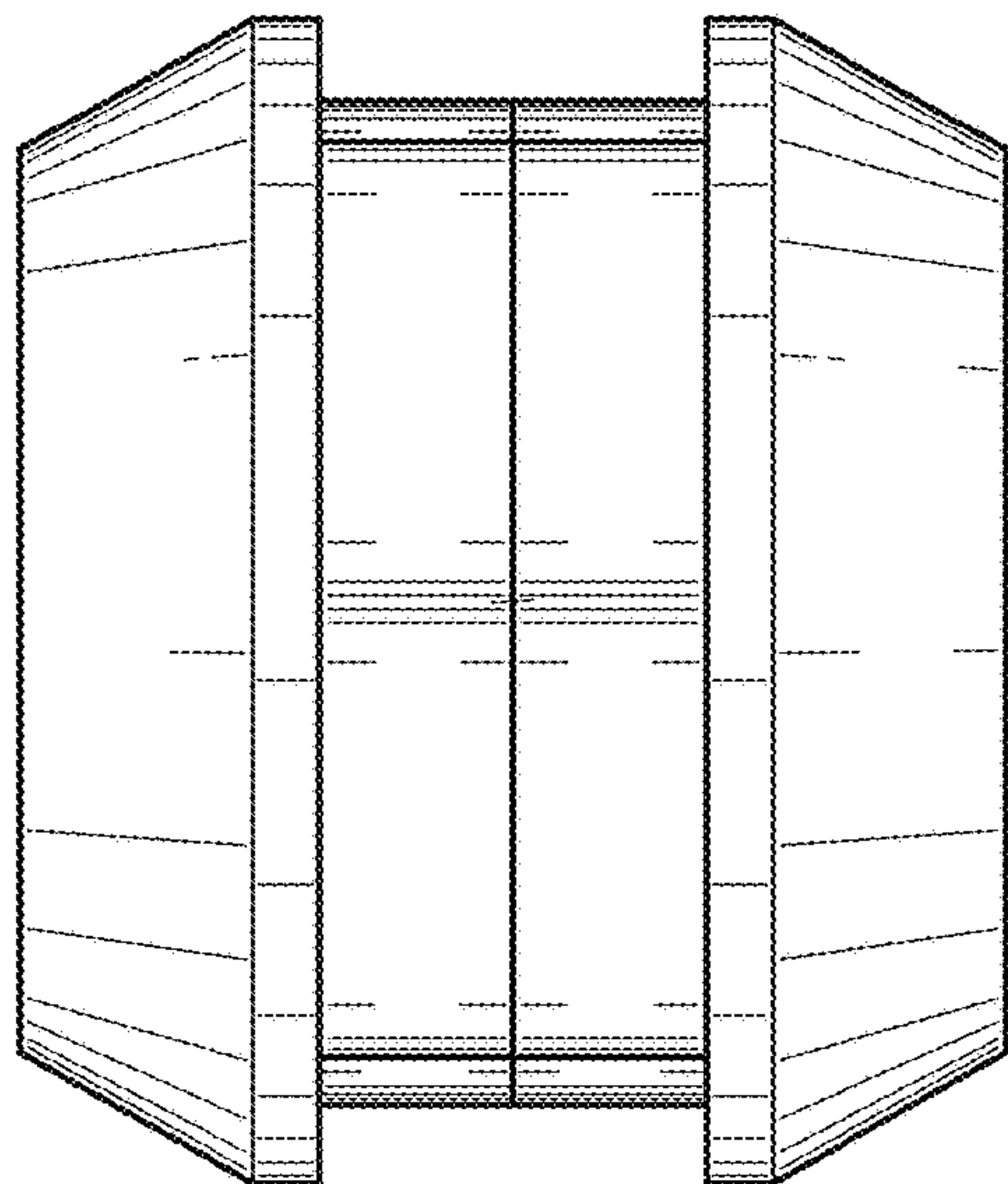
