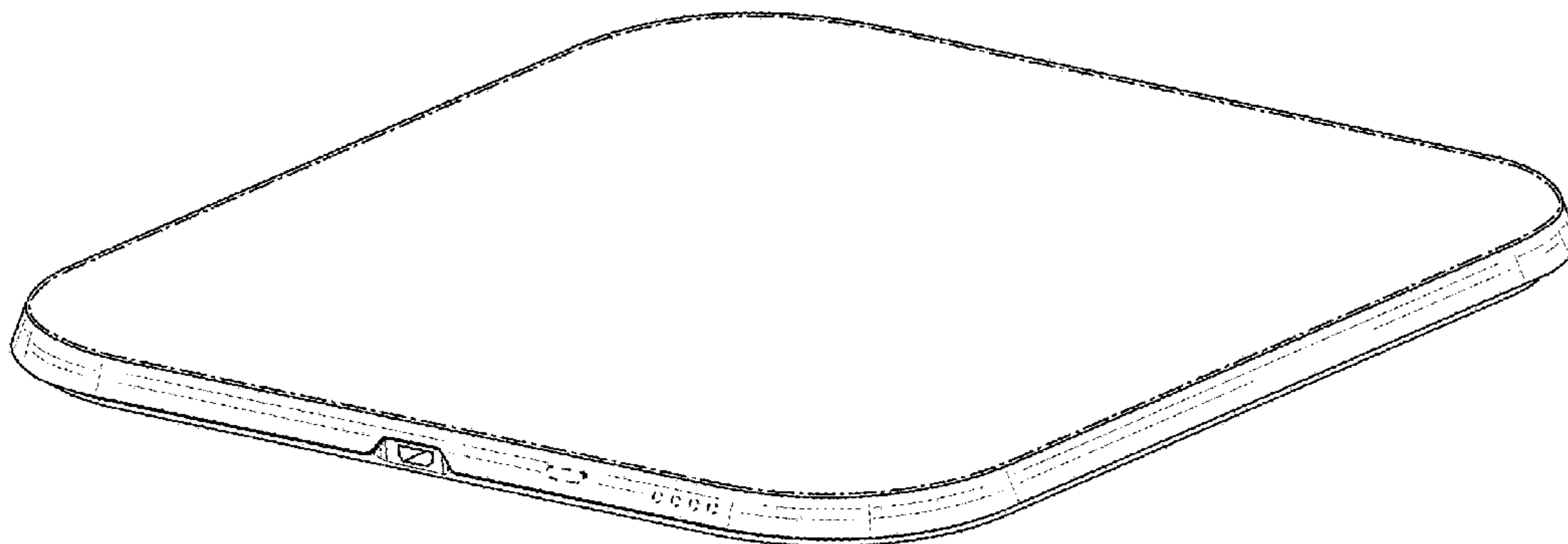
(57) **CLAIM**

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a charger showing our new design;  
FIG. 2 is a front view thereof;  
FIG. 3 is a rear view thereof;  
FIG. 4 is a right side view thereof;  
FIG. 5 is a left side view thereof; and,  
FIG. 6 is a top view thereof.  
The uneven-length broken lines depict a boundary to the claim and form no part thereof. The even-length broken lines within the shaded area depict features of the article that form no part of the claimed design.

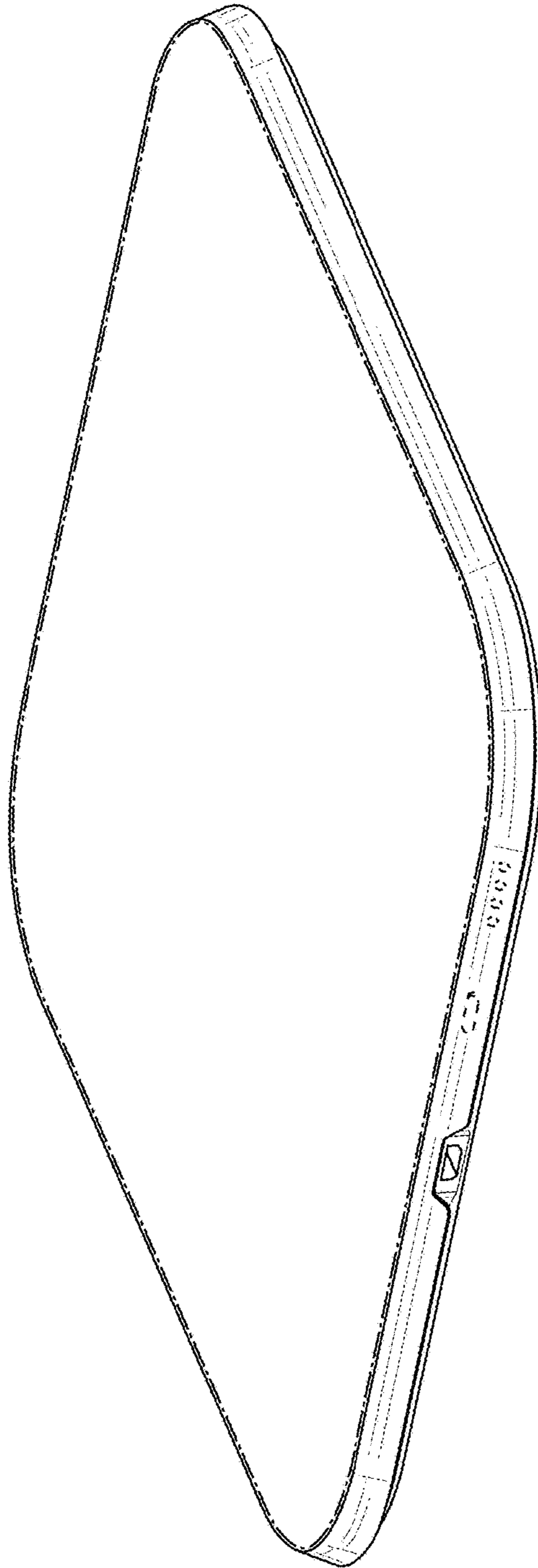

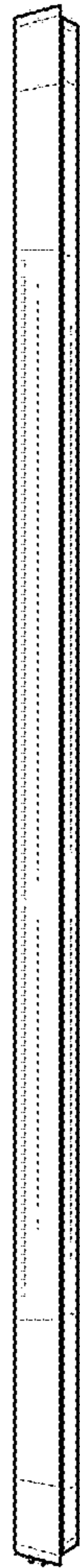

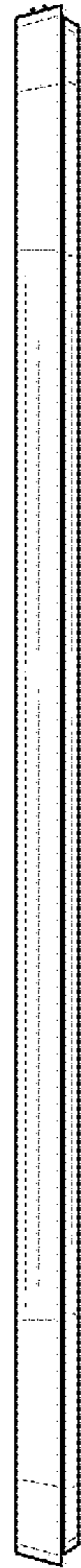

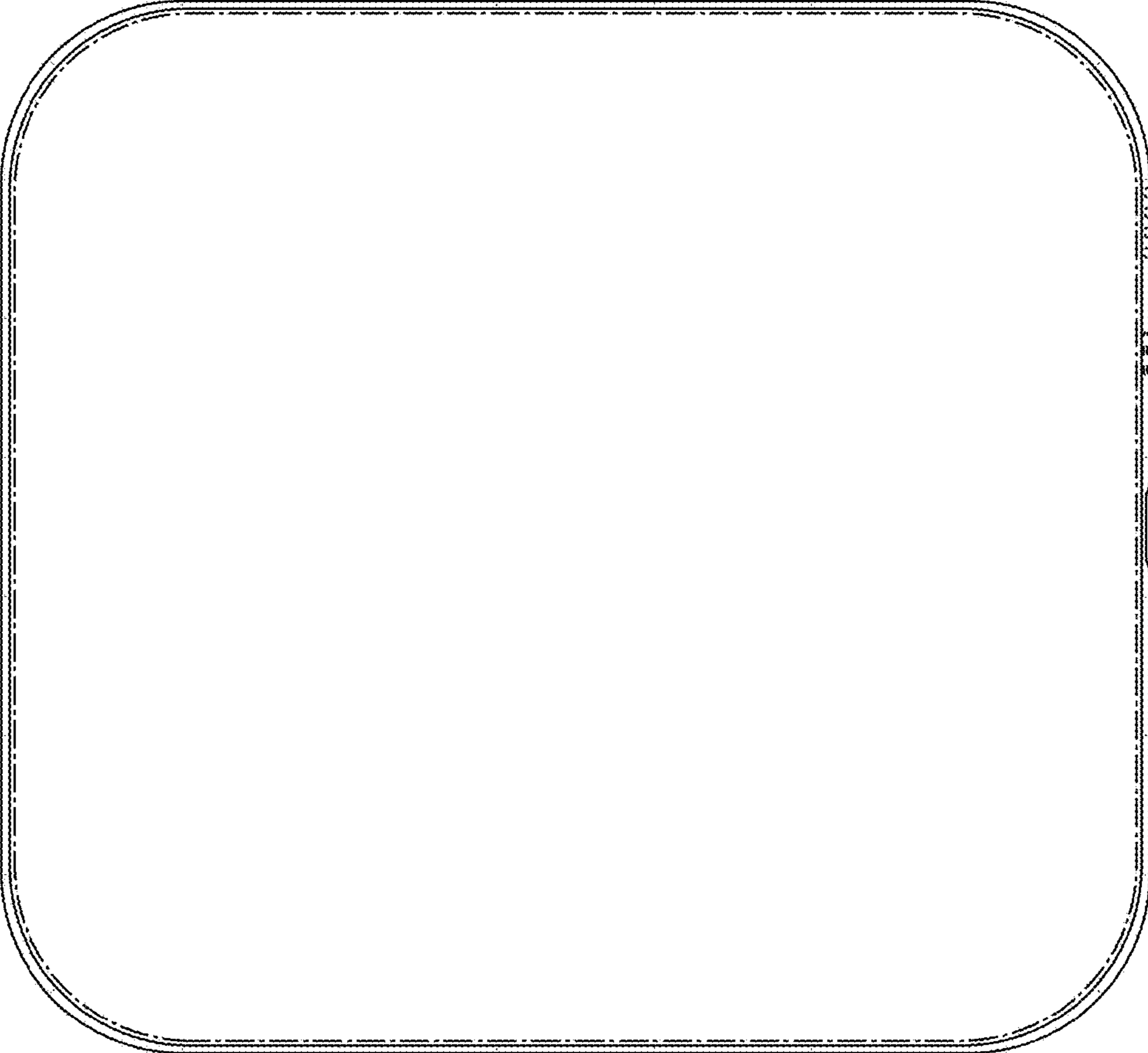
