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(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for an undergarment with built-in sacroiliac belt, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of an undergarment with built-in sacroiliac belt, showing the new design, with the undergarment with built-in sacroiliac belt shown being worn.

FIG. 2 is a front perspective view of the undergarment with built-in sacroiliac belt seen in FIG. 1, shown alone.

FIG. 3 is a rear perspective view of the undergarment with built-in sacroiliac belt of FIG. 2.

FIG. 4 is a front elevation view of the undergarment with built-in sacroiliac belt of FIG. 2.

FIG. 5 is a rear elevation view of the undergarment with built-in sacroiliac belt of FIG. 2.

FIG. 6 is a first side elevation view of the undergarment with built-in sacroiliac belt of FIG. 2.

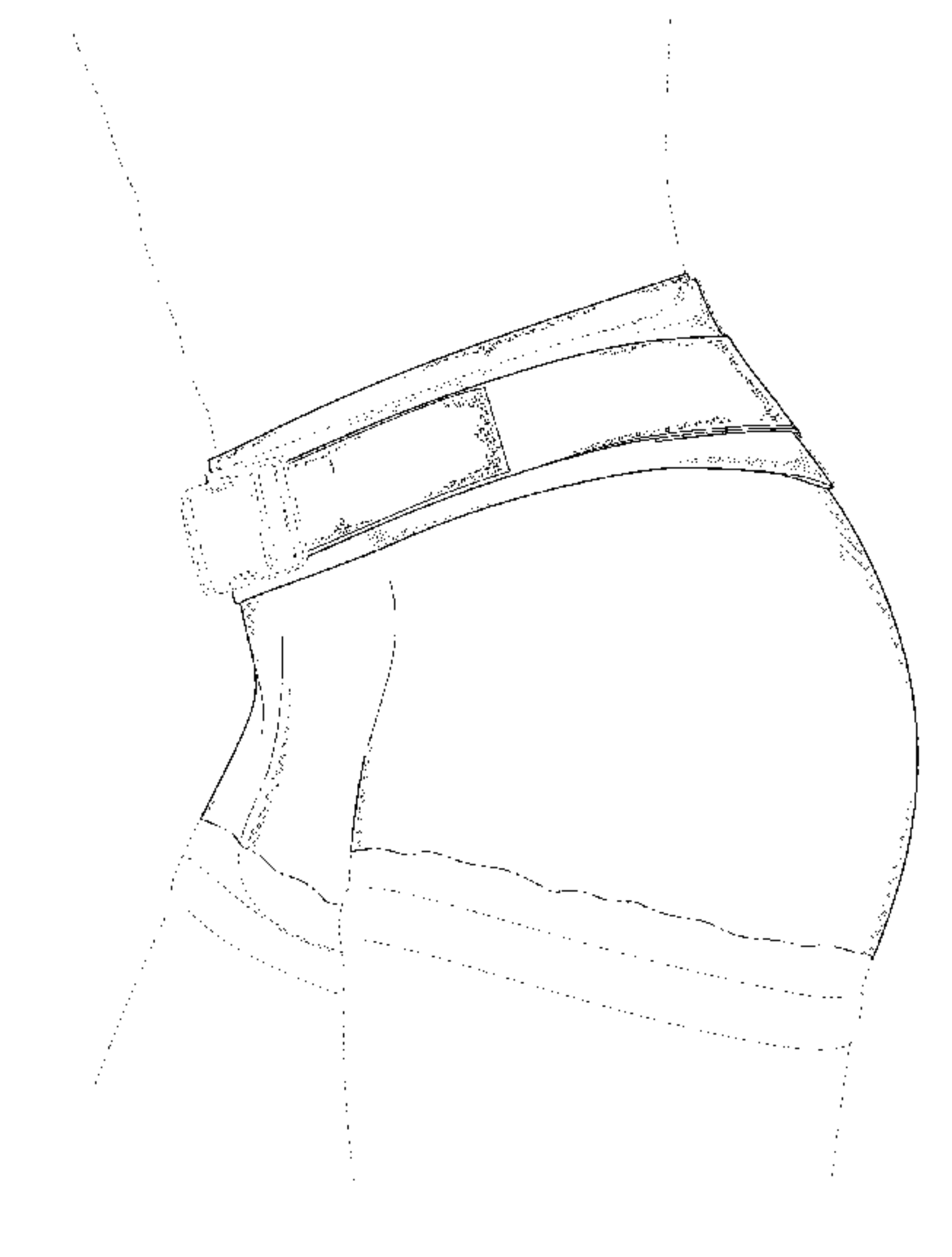
FIG. 7 is a second, opposite side elevation view of the undergarment with built-in sacroiliac belt of FIG. 2.

FIG. 8 is a top plan view of the undergarment with built-in sacroiliac belt of FIG. 2; and,

The wavy dash-dot line itself represents a boundary line, which boundary line itself forms no part of the claimed design.

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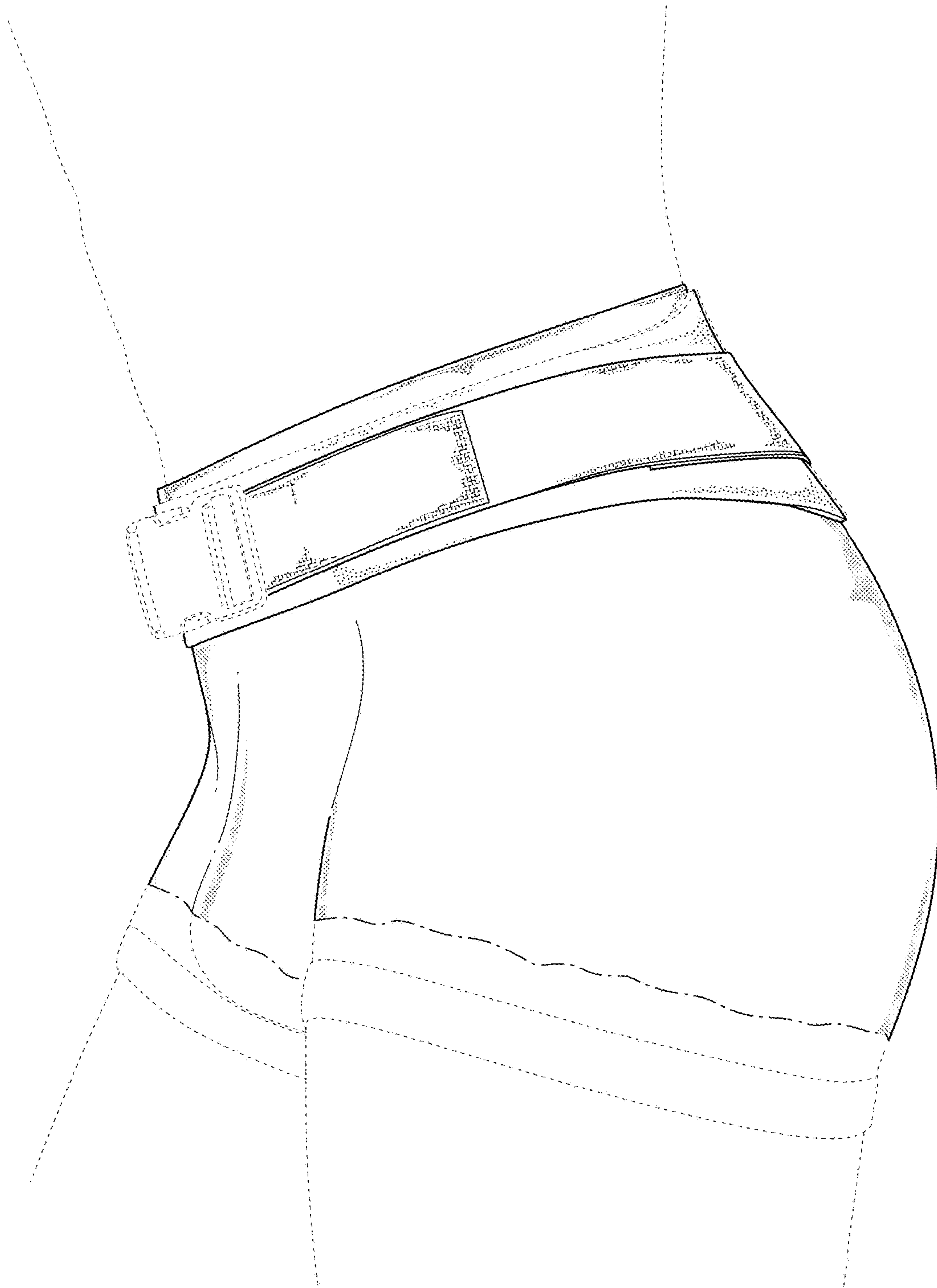

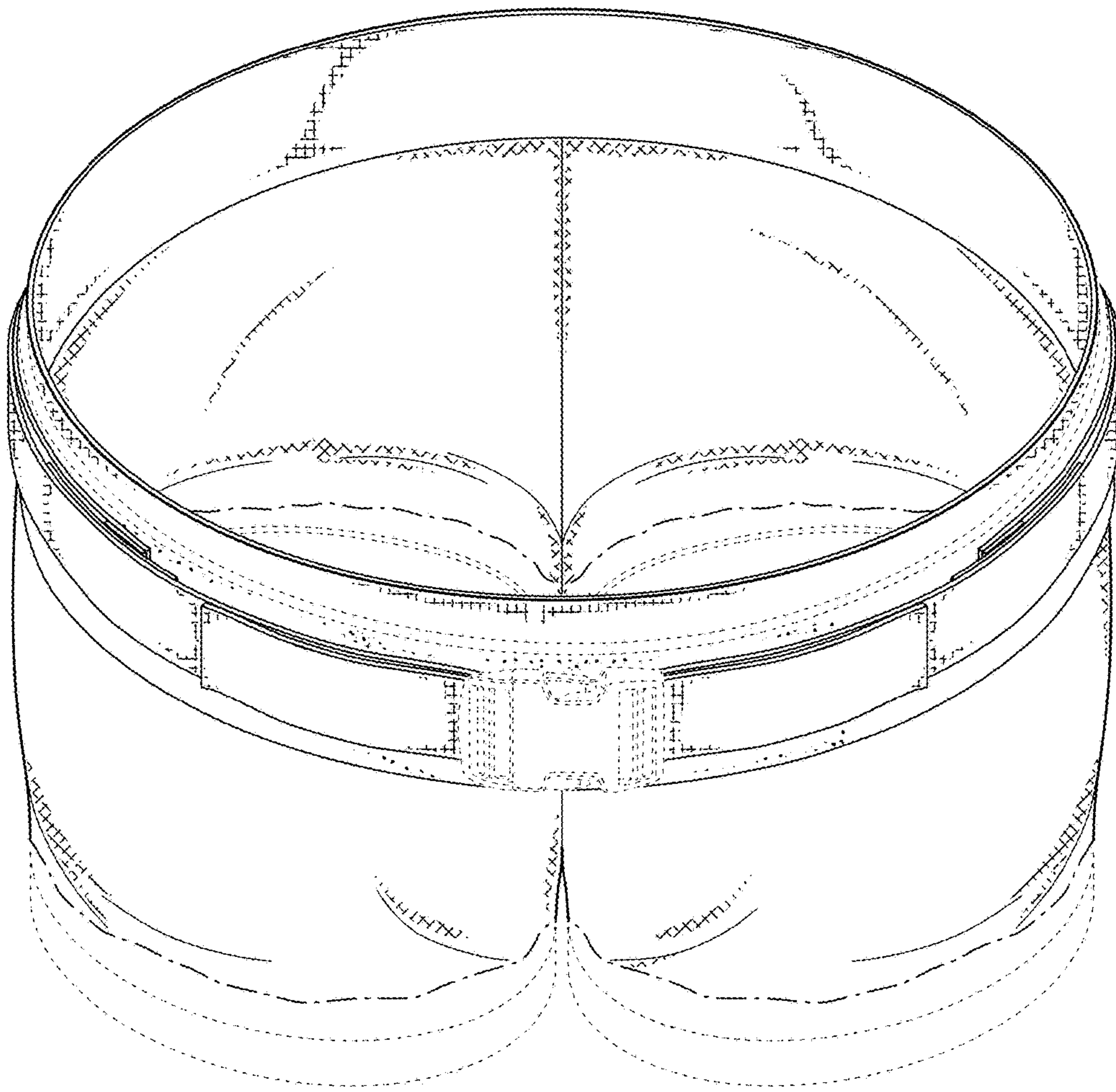

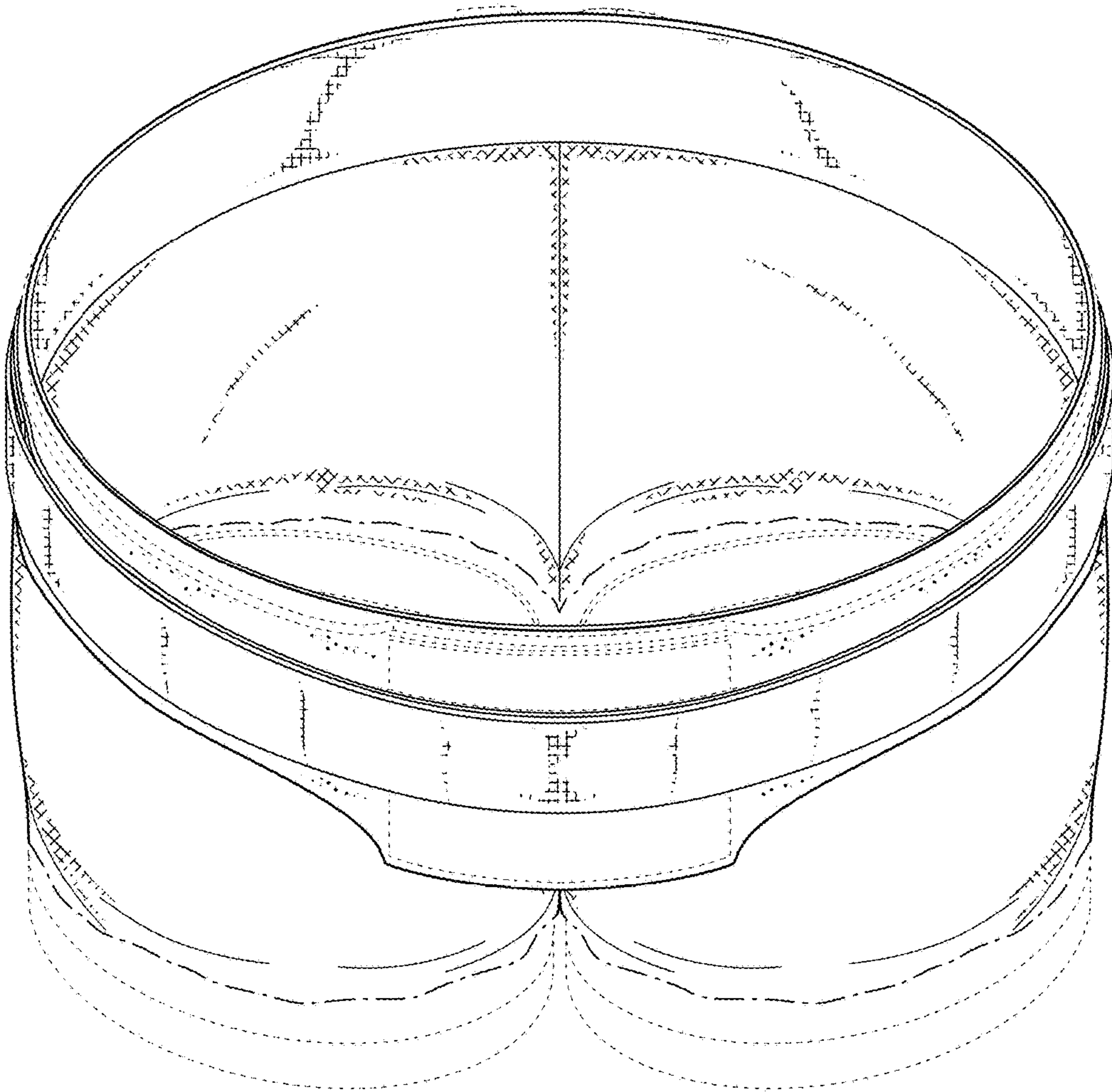

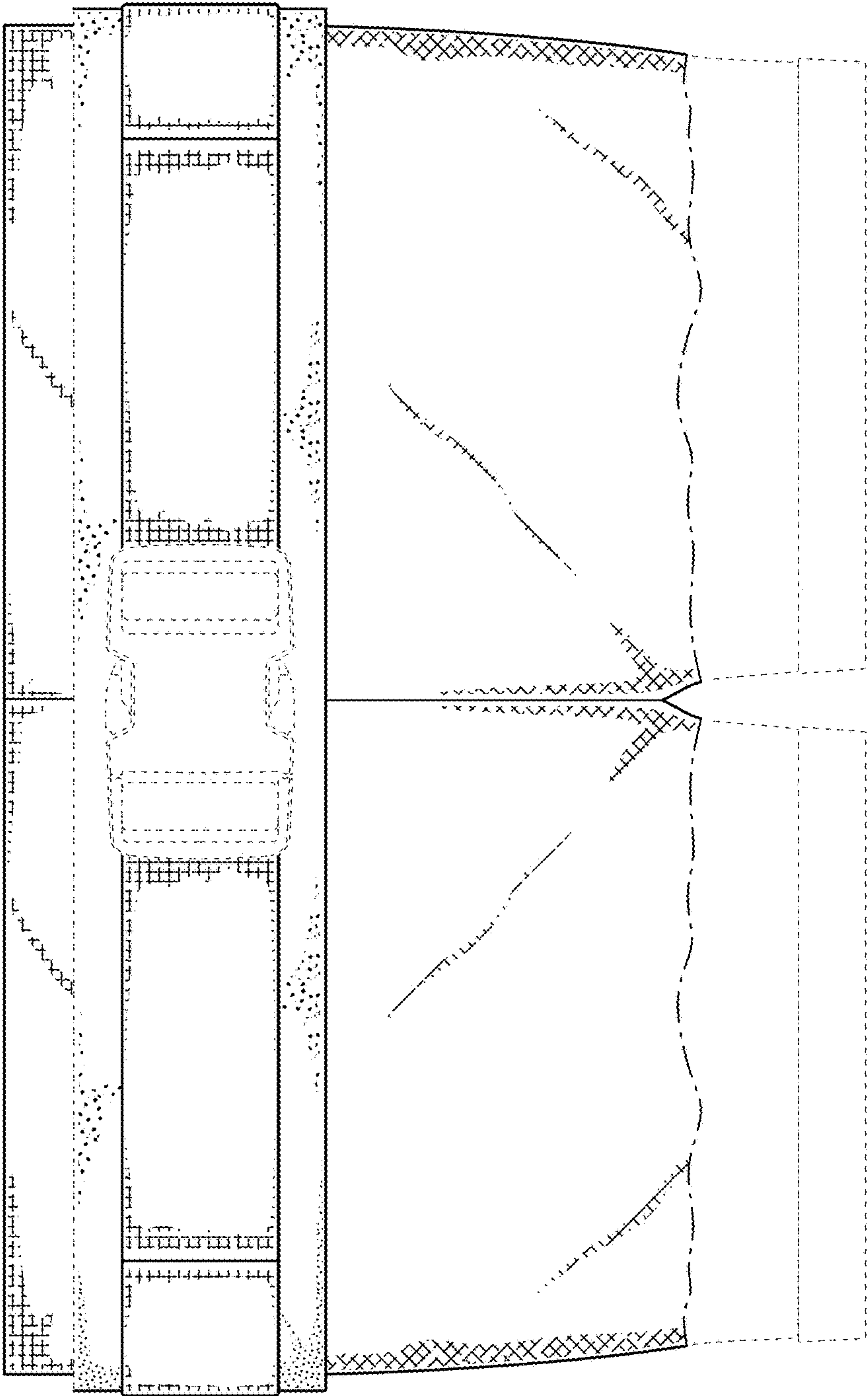

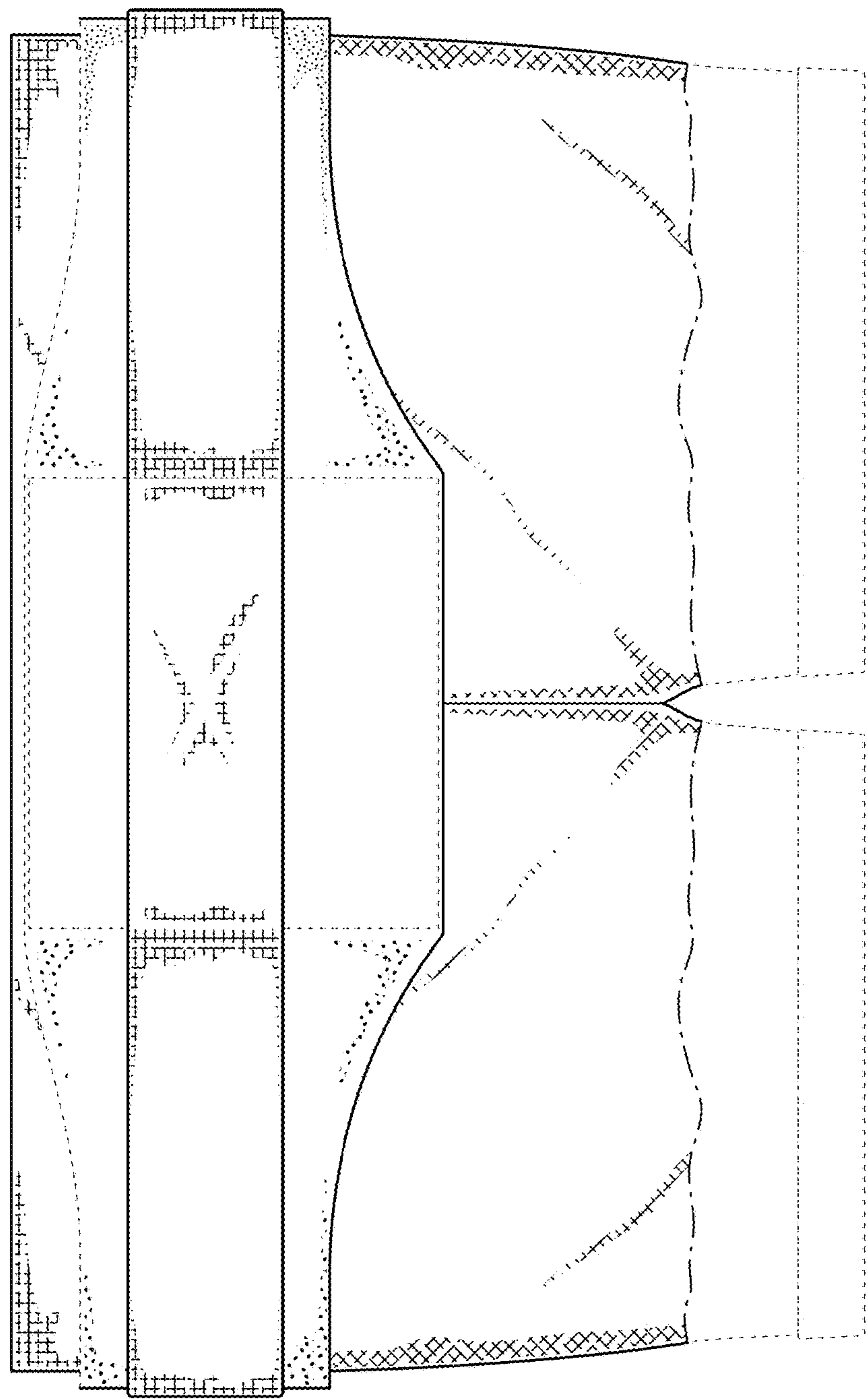

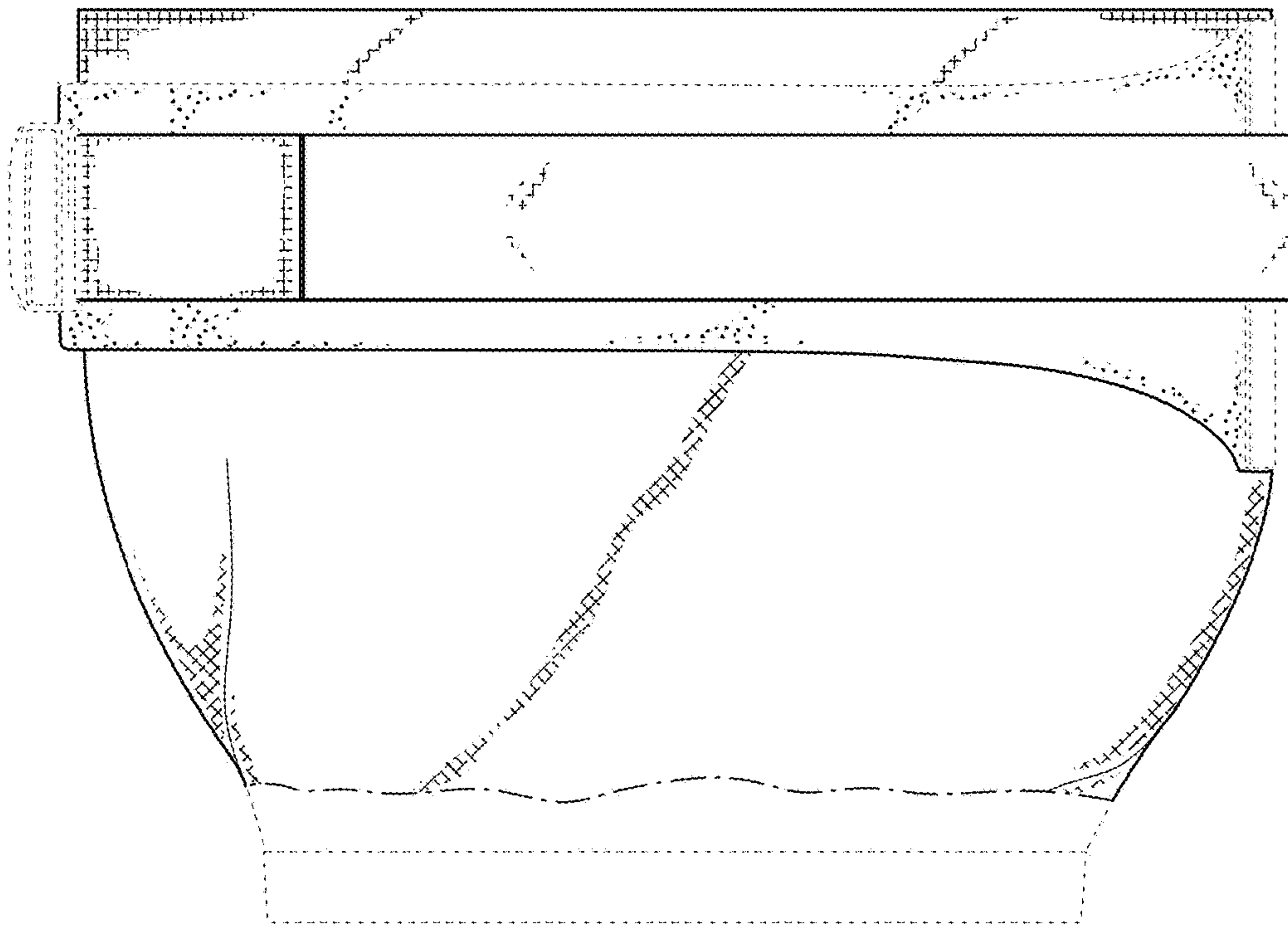

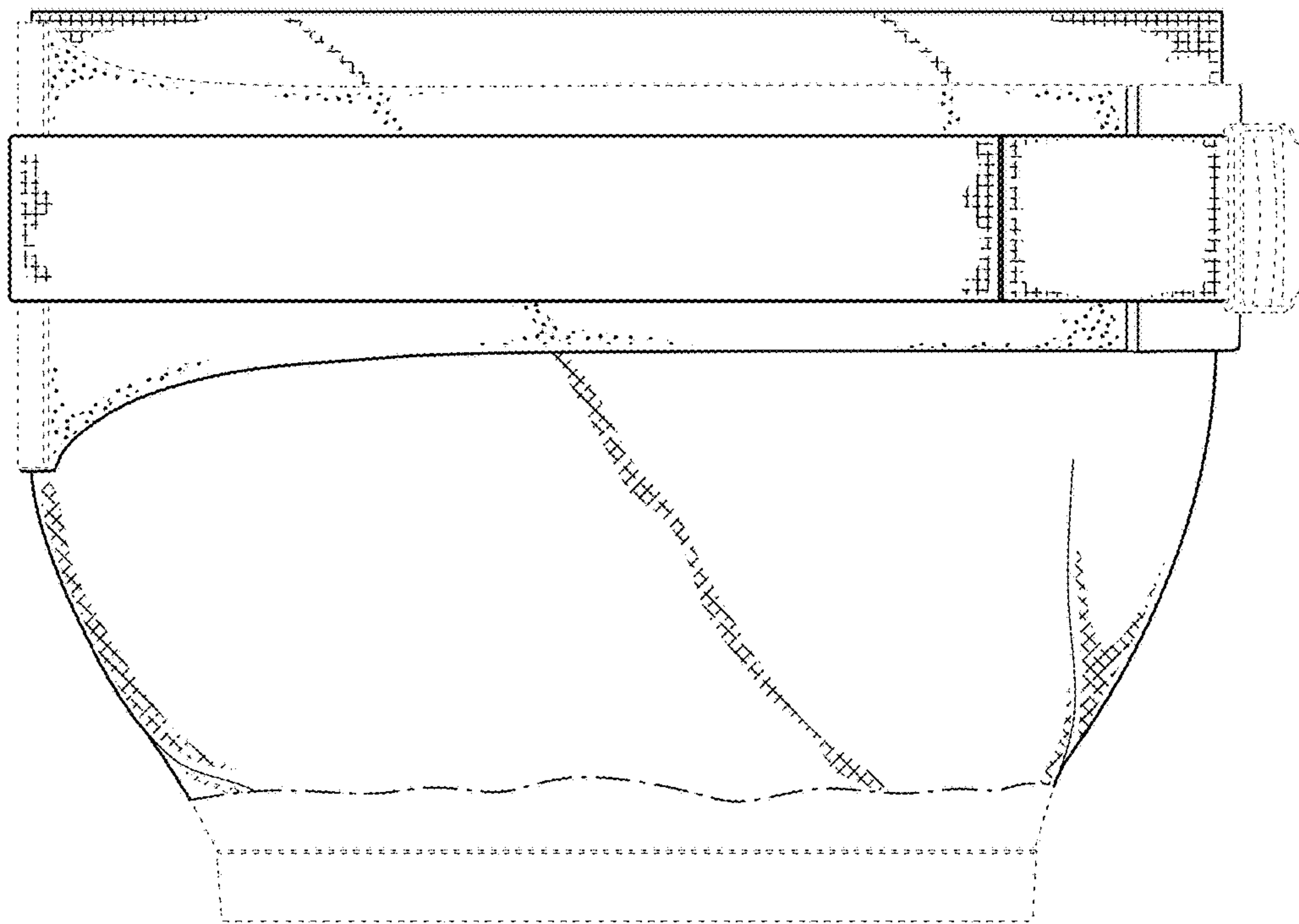

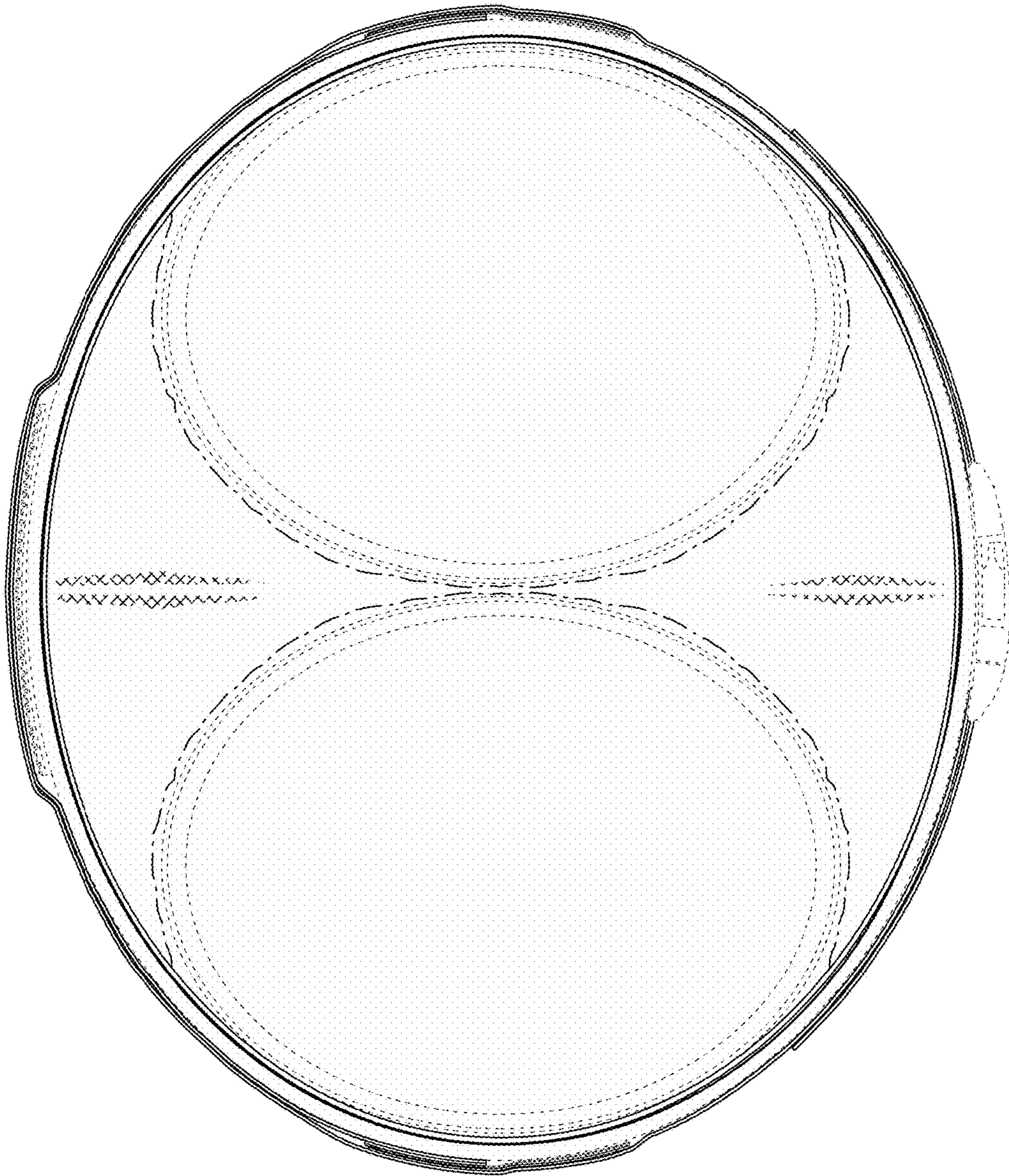

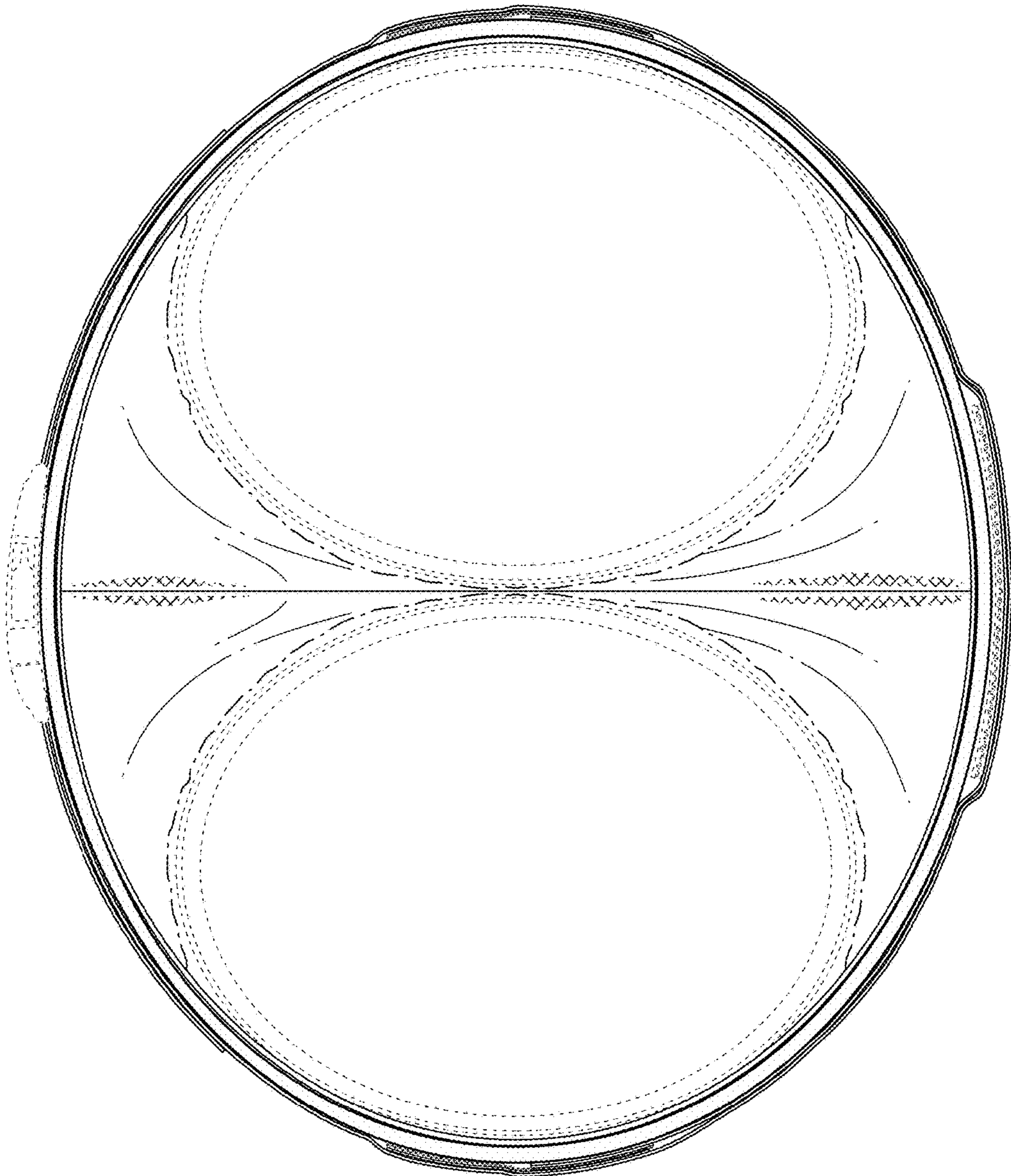
