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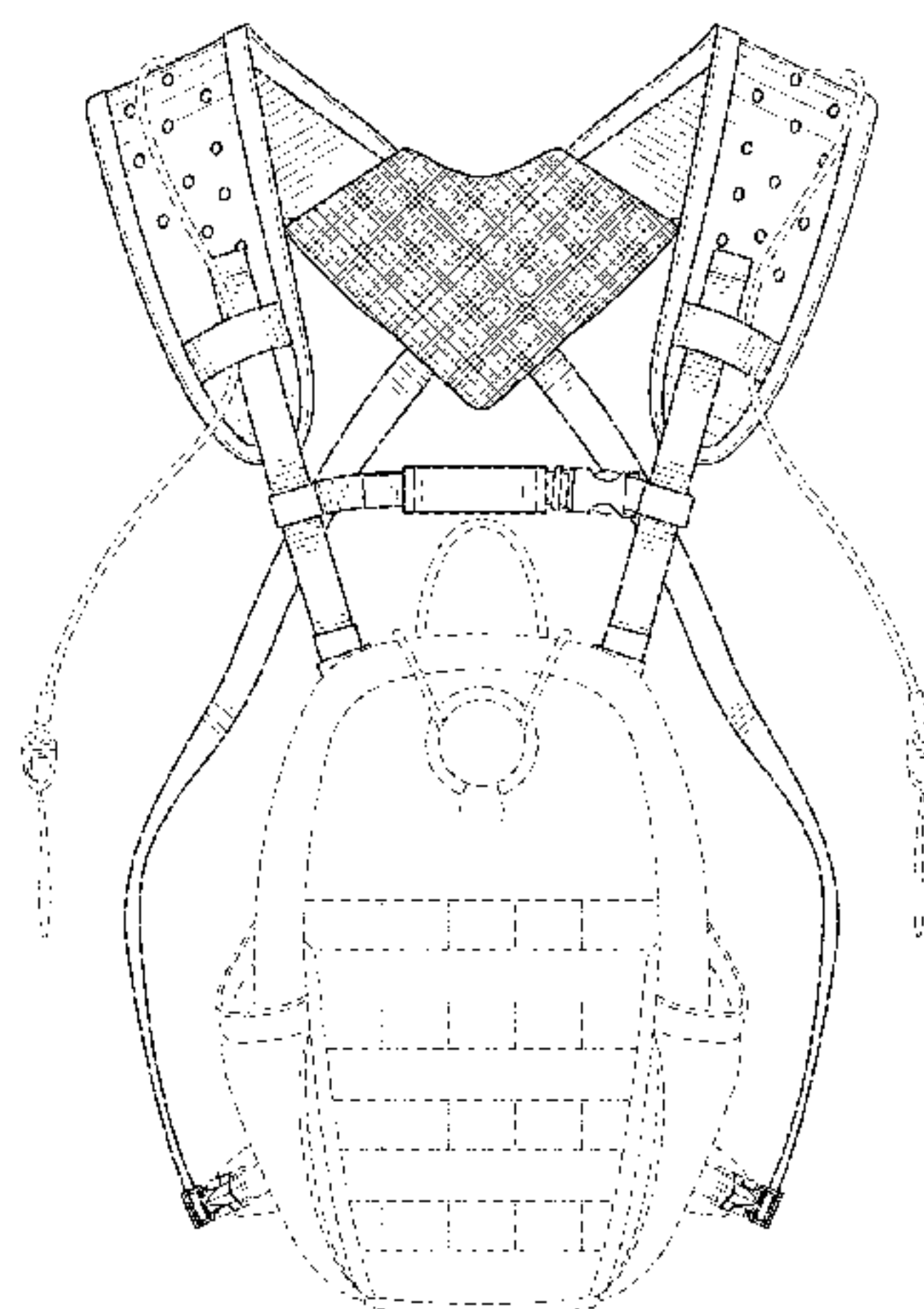
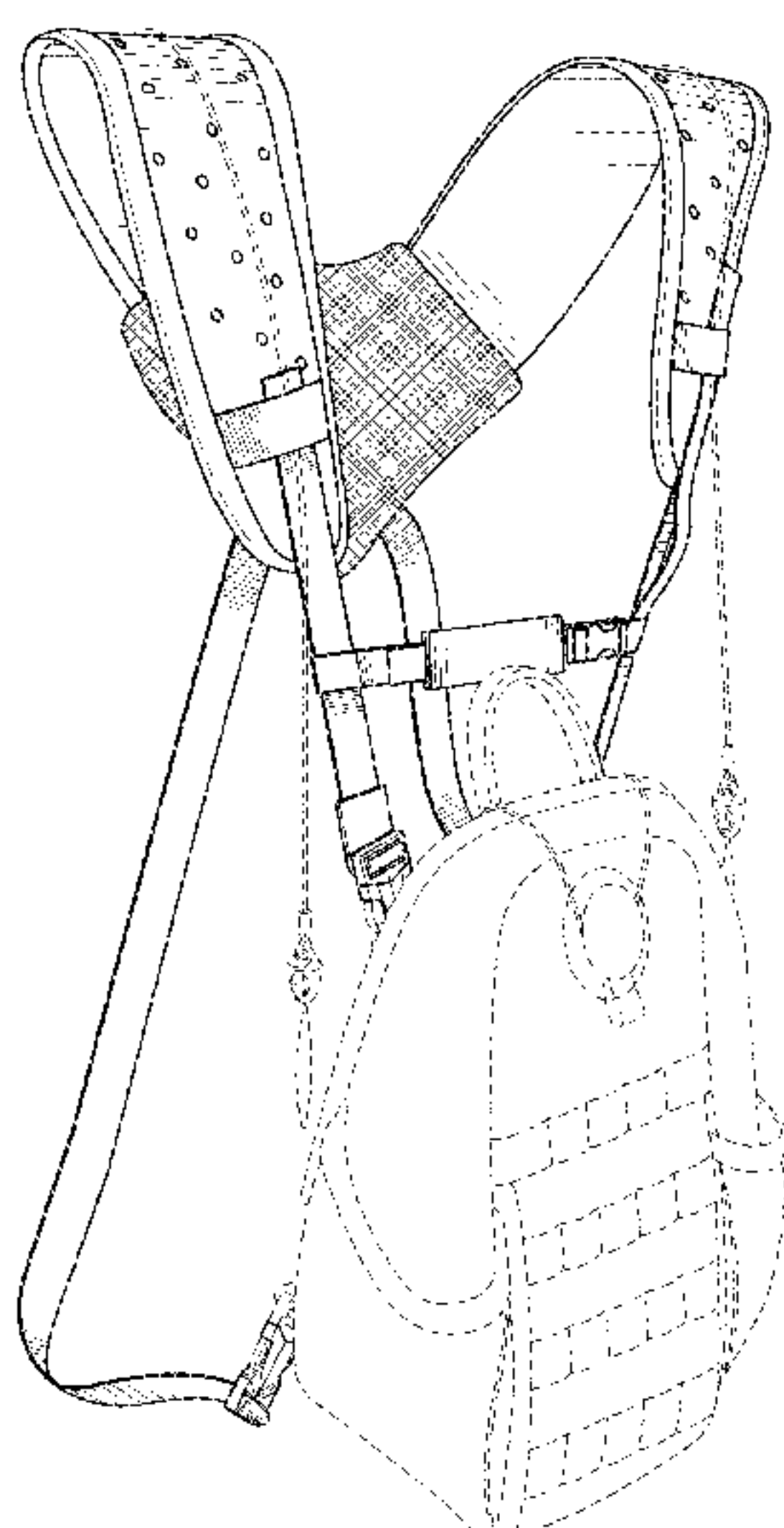
(57) **CLAIM**

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front, top, left-side perspective view of the binocular case;
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a right-side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a left-side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 6 is a rear elevational view thereof;
FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view thereof;

FIG. 9 is a rear elevational view thereof in a state of being worn with an auxiliary pouch deployed.

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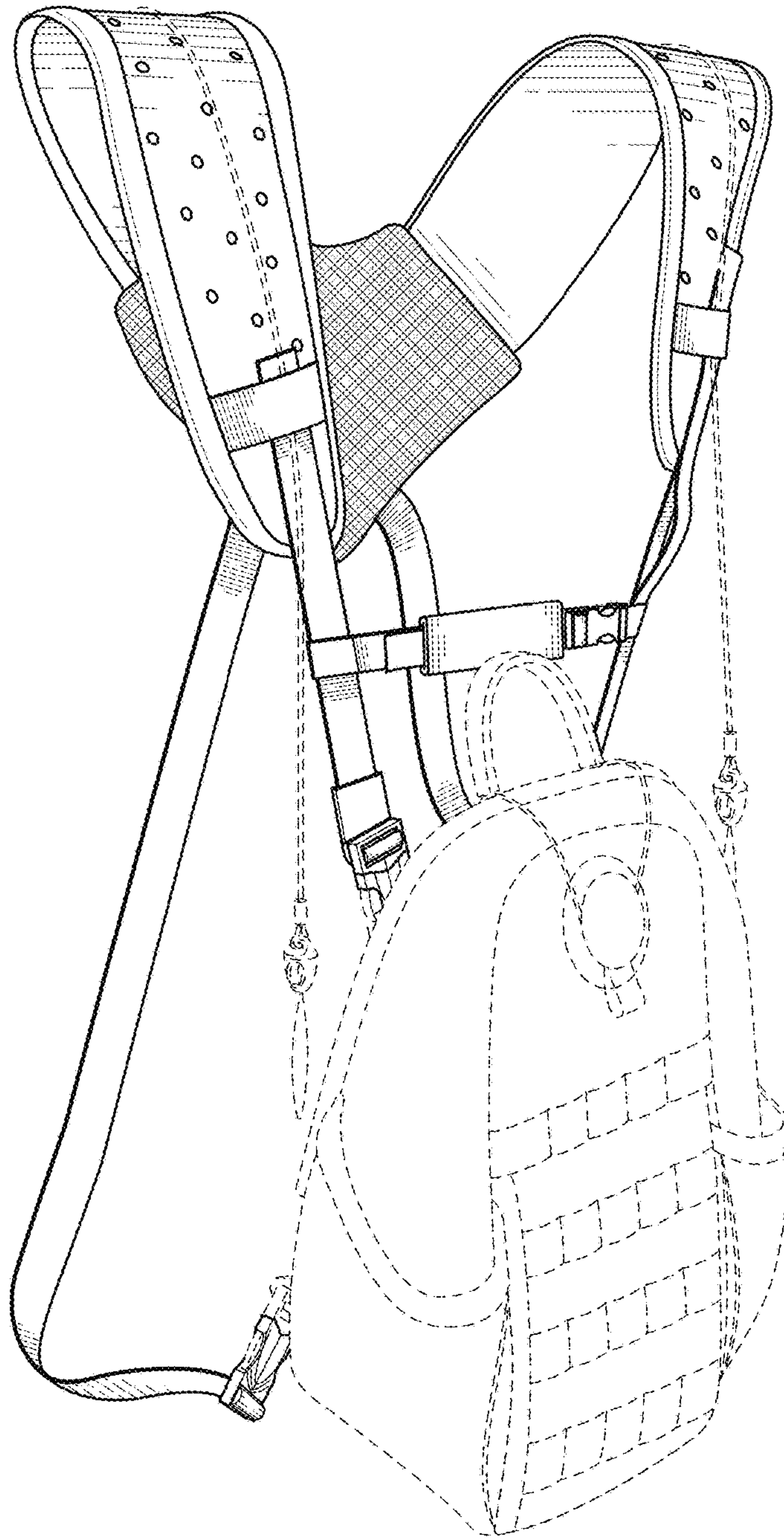

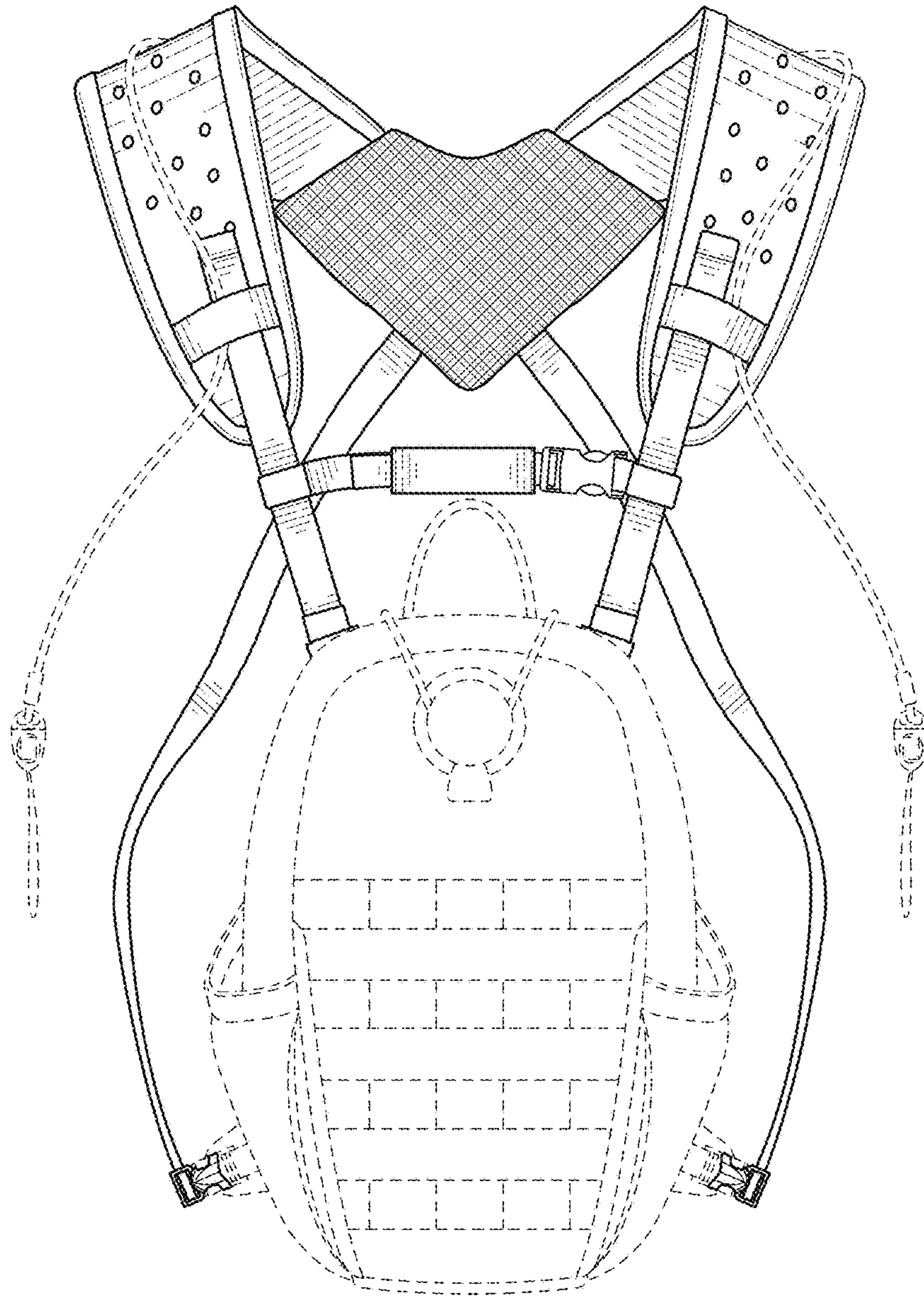

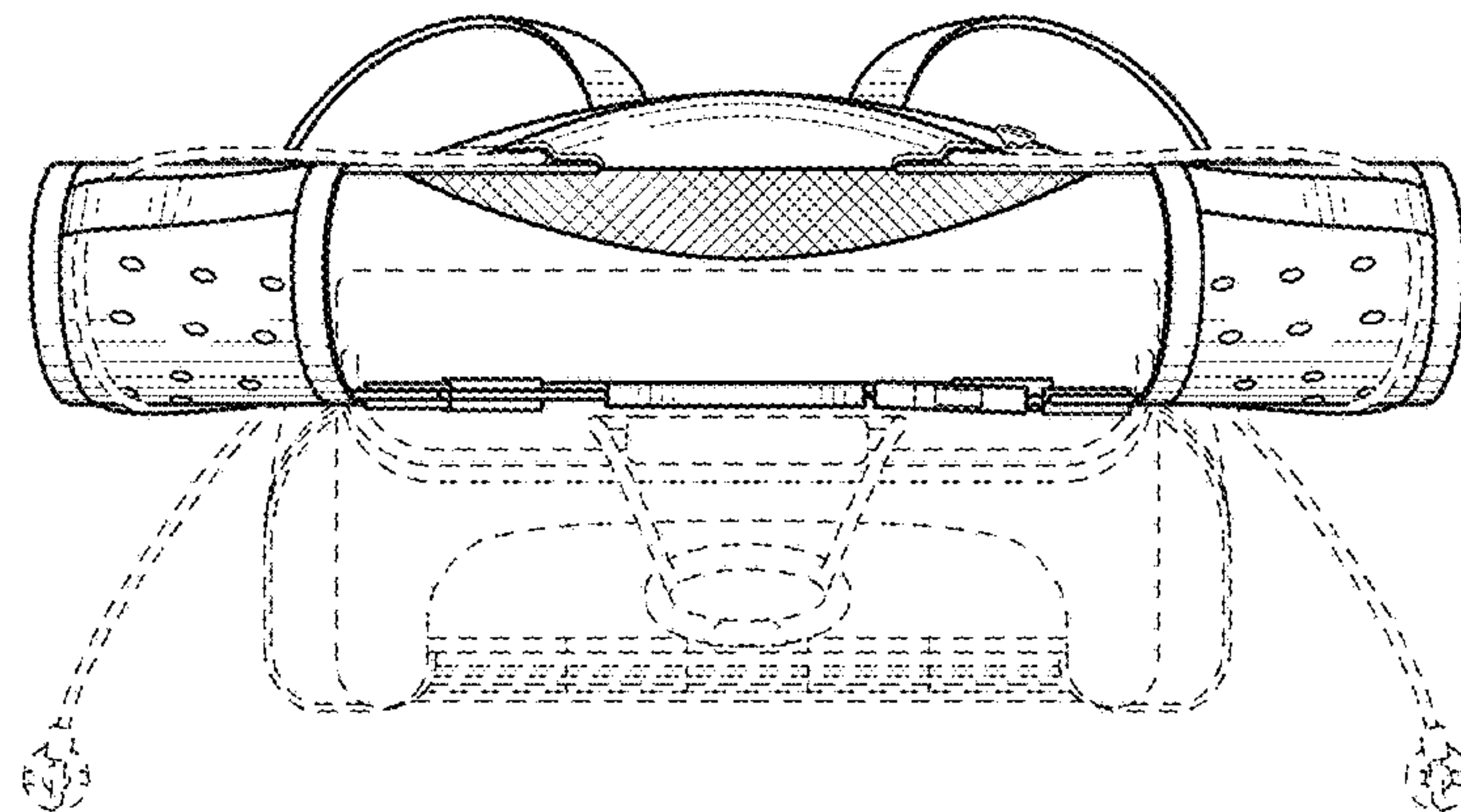

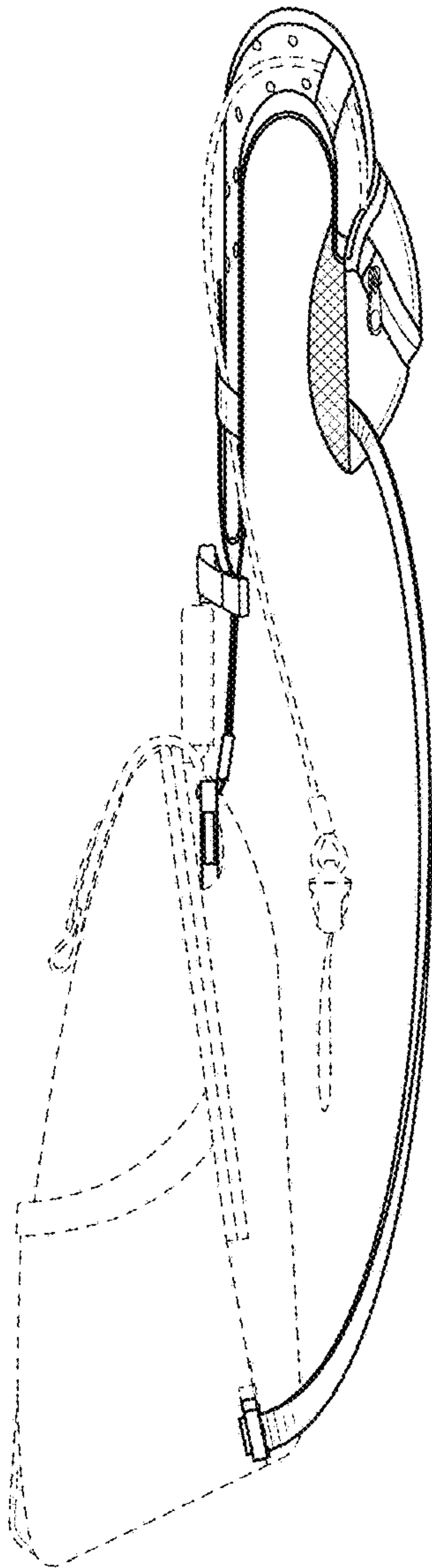

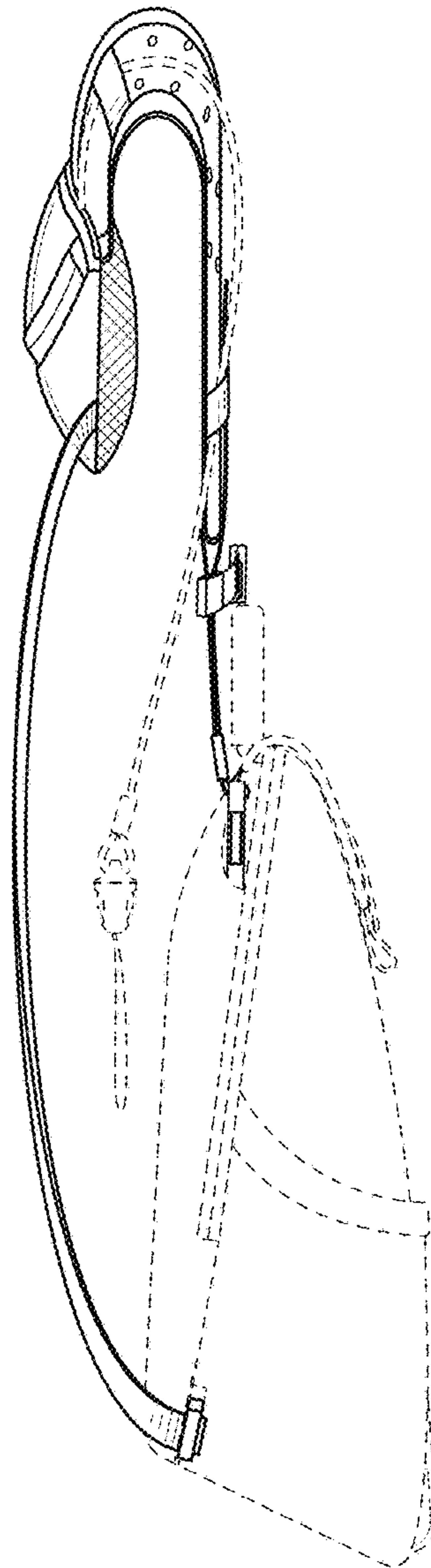

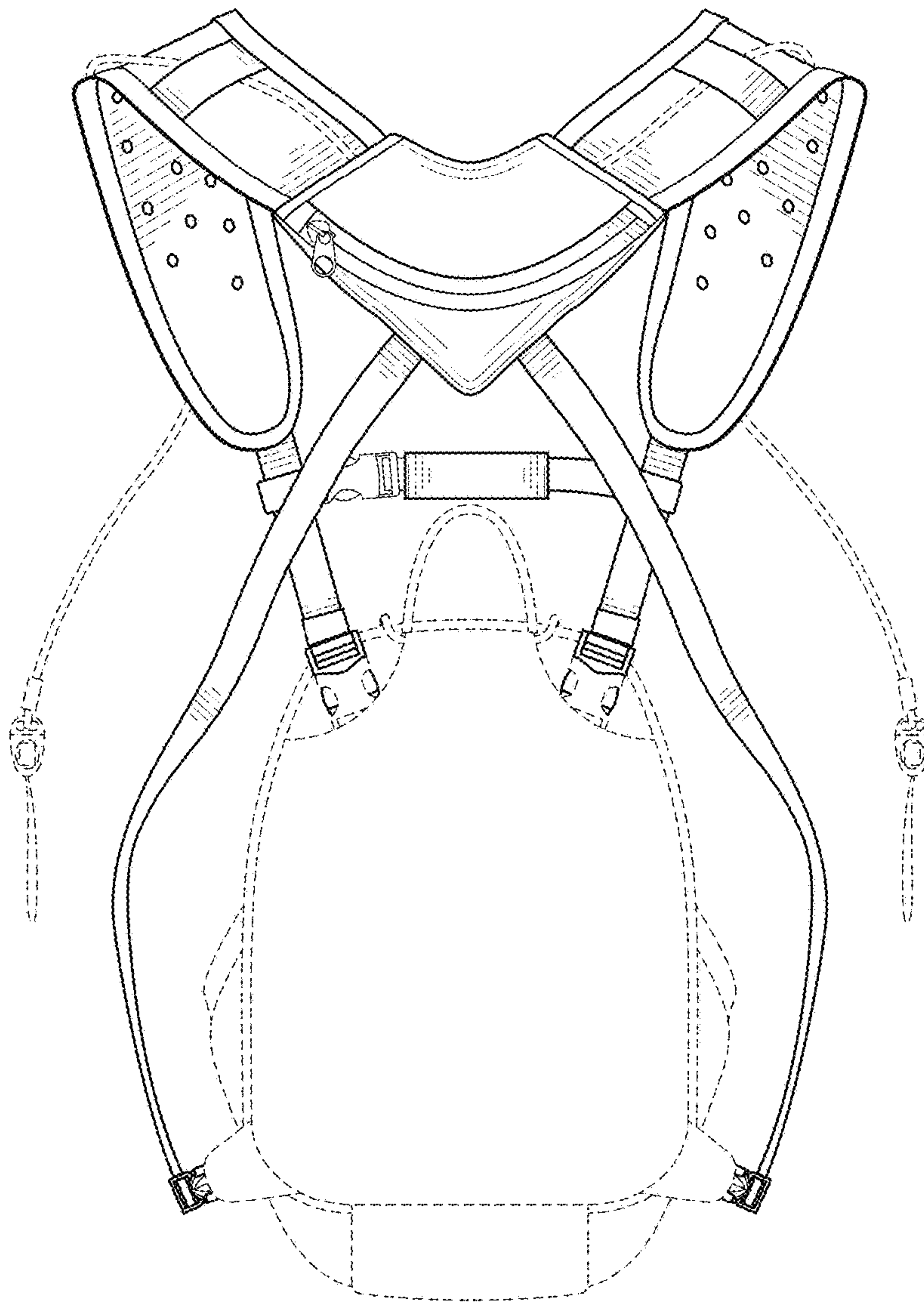

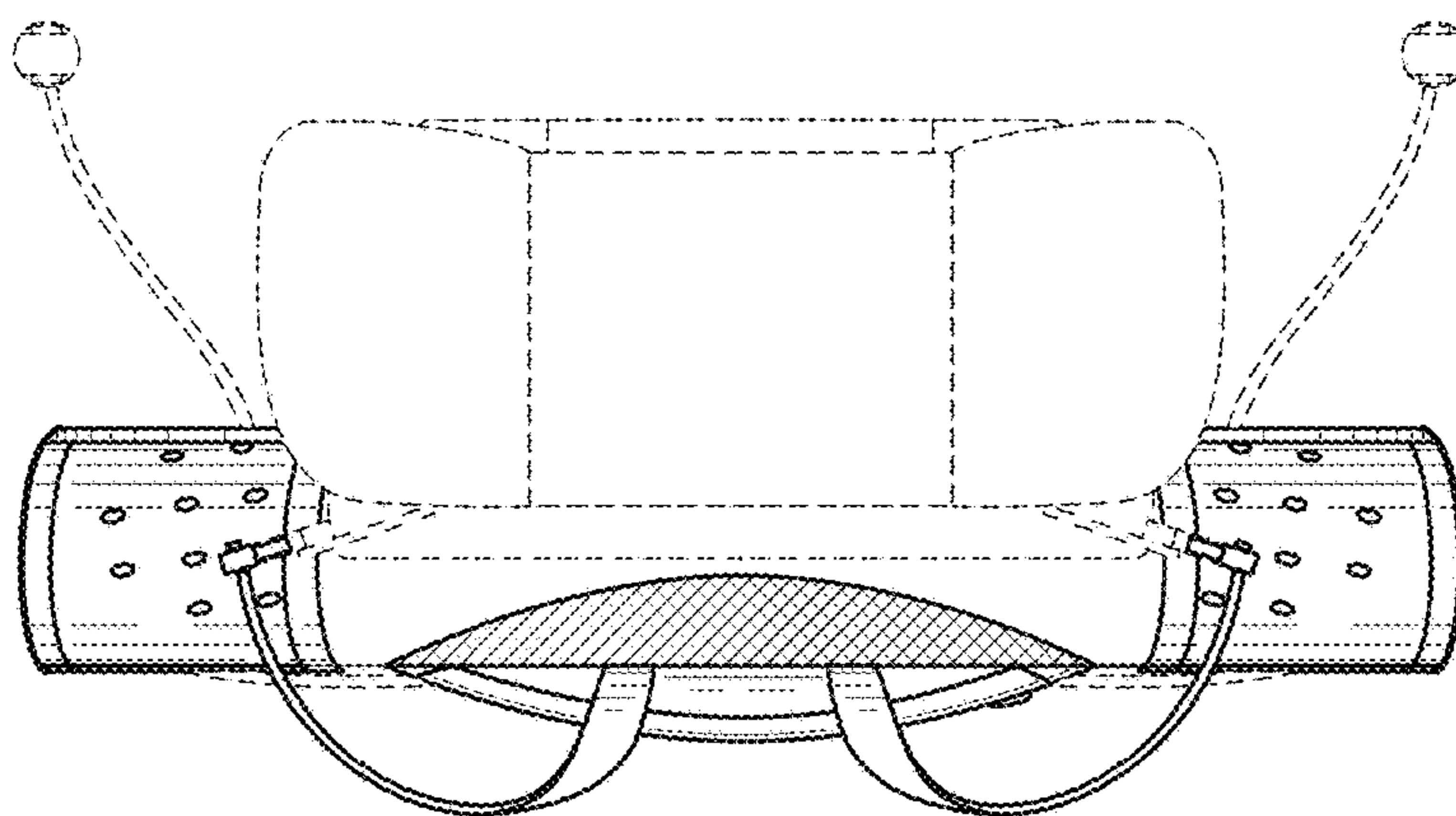

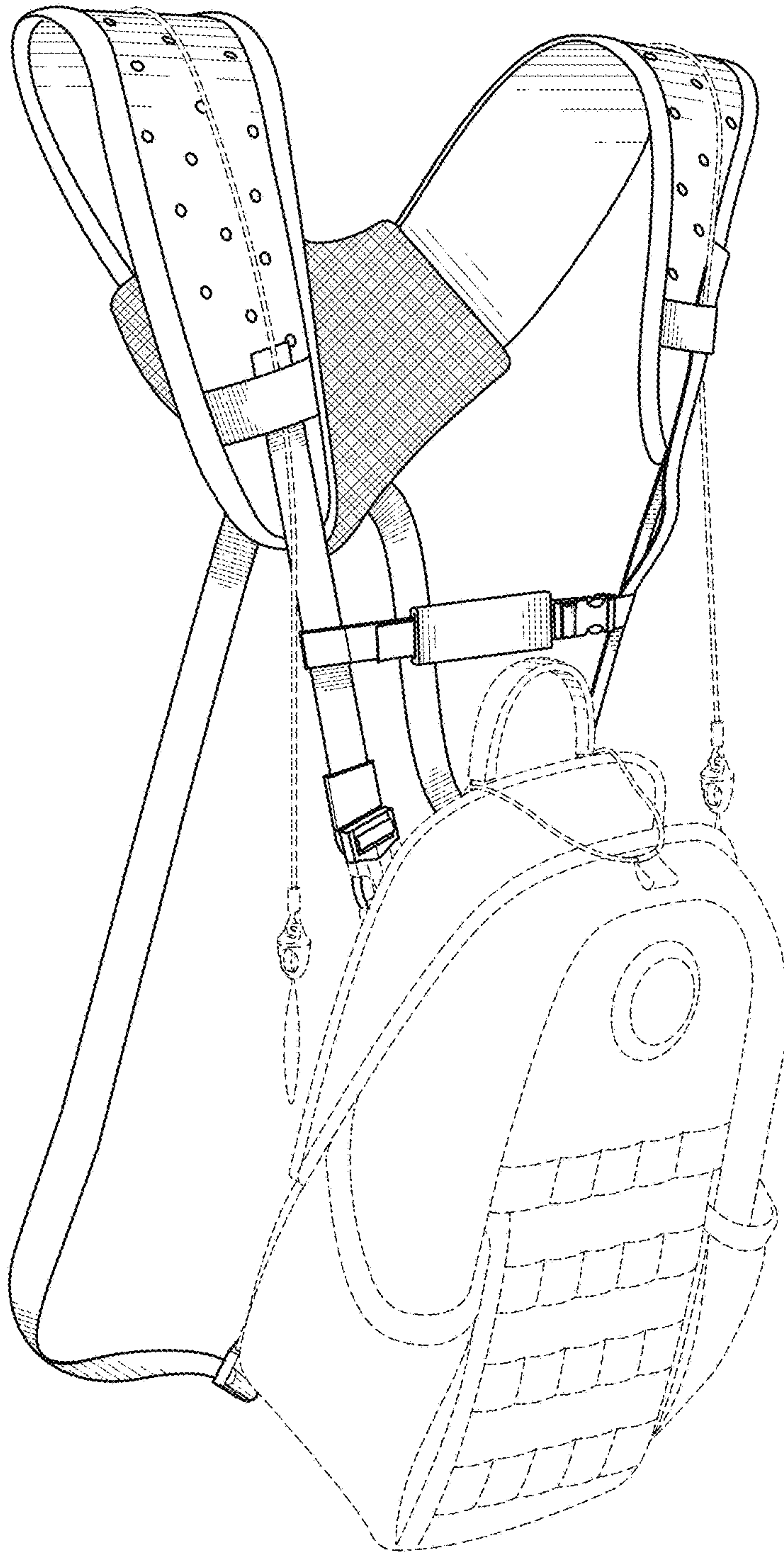

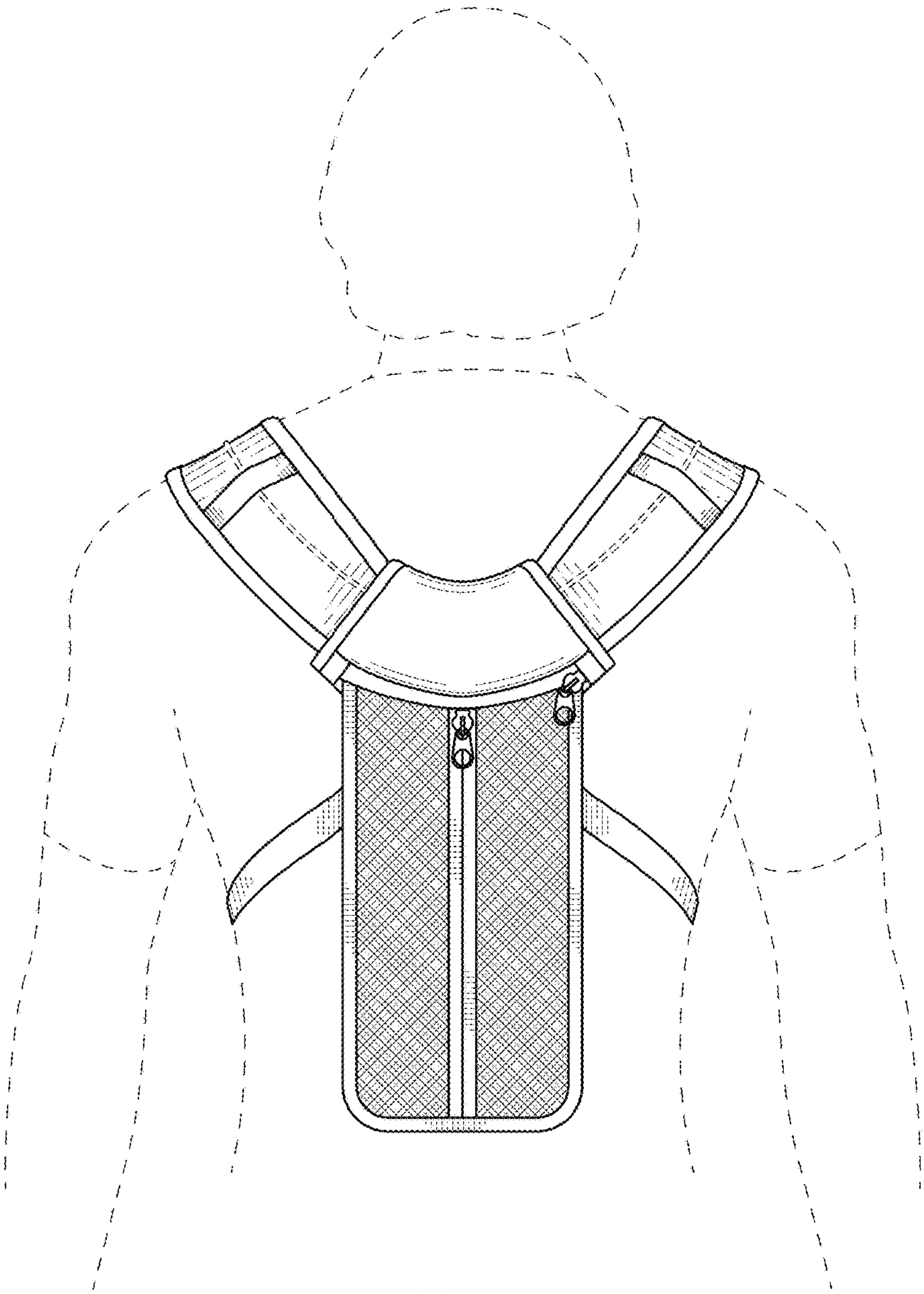
