FIG. 6 is a right view thereof;

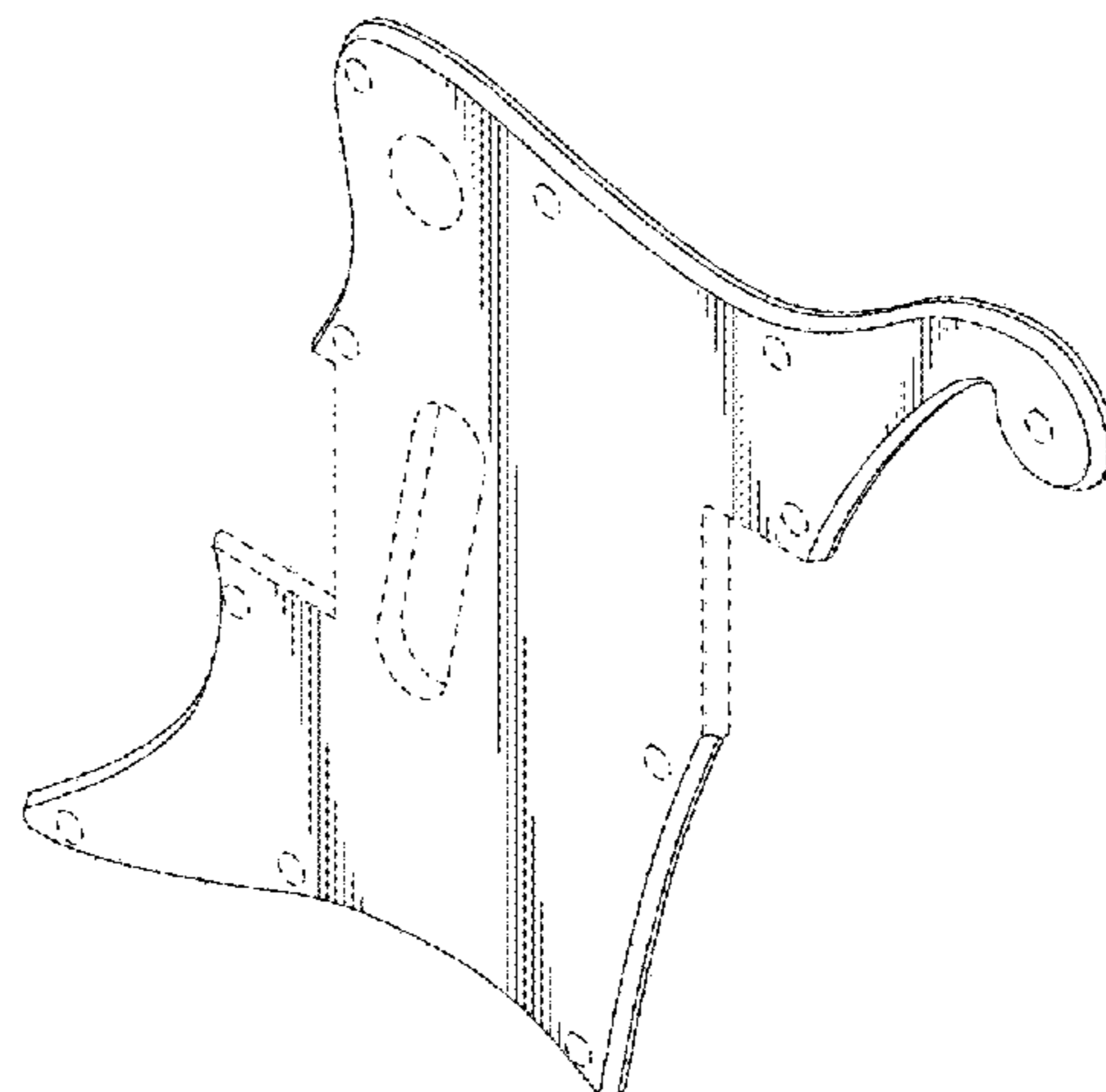
FIG. 7 is a left view thereof;

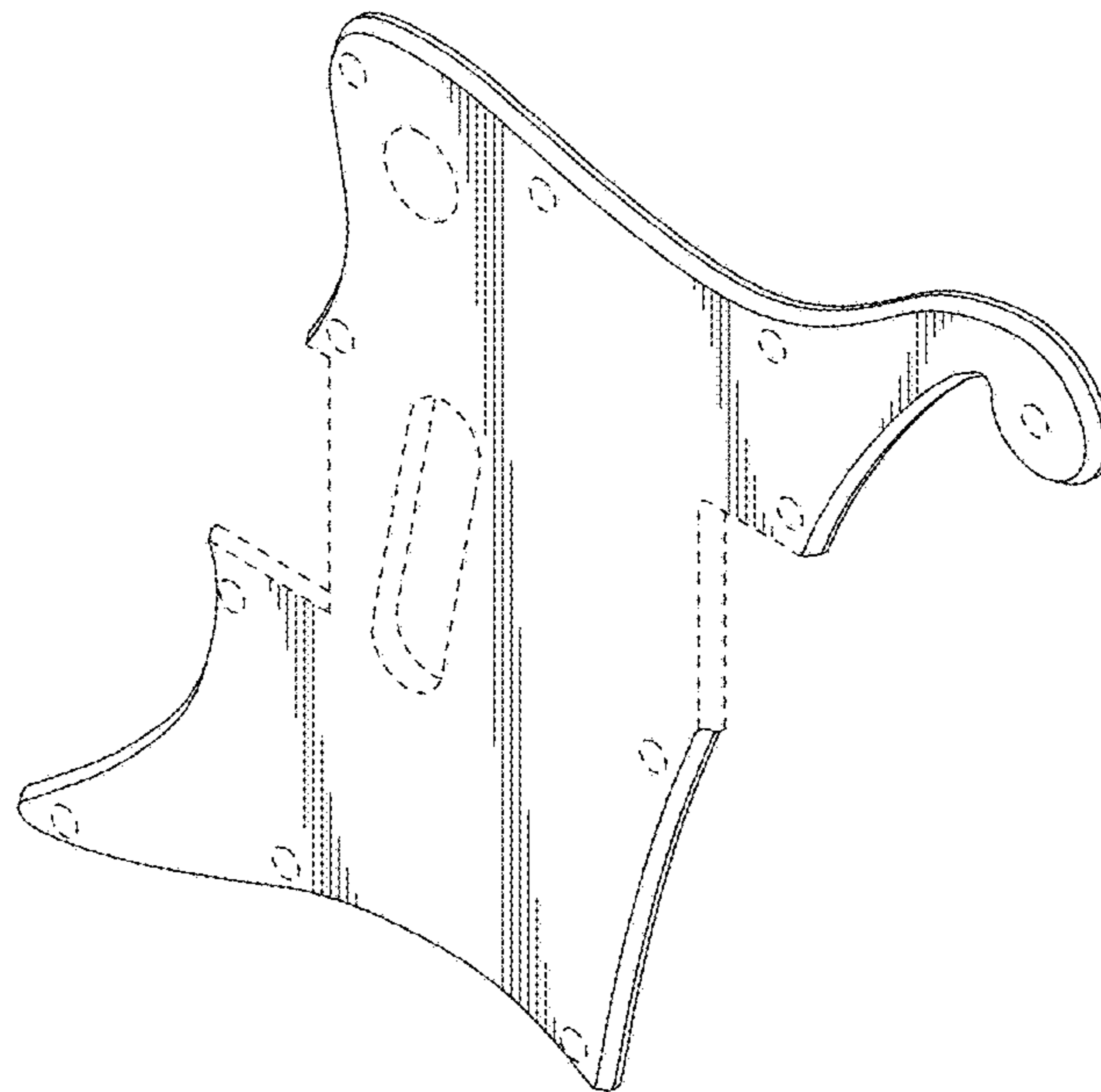

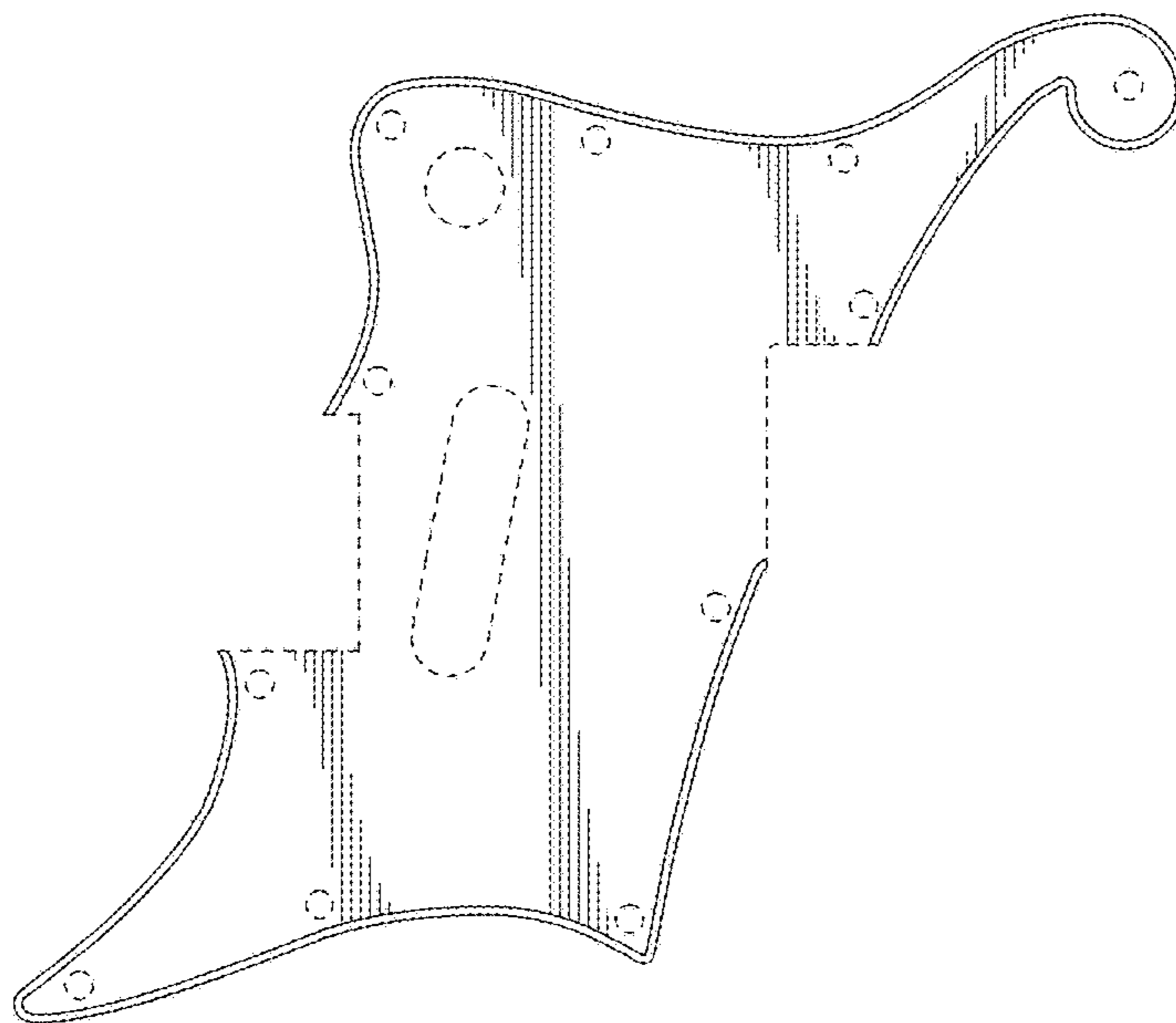

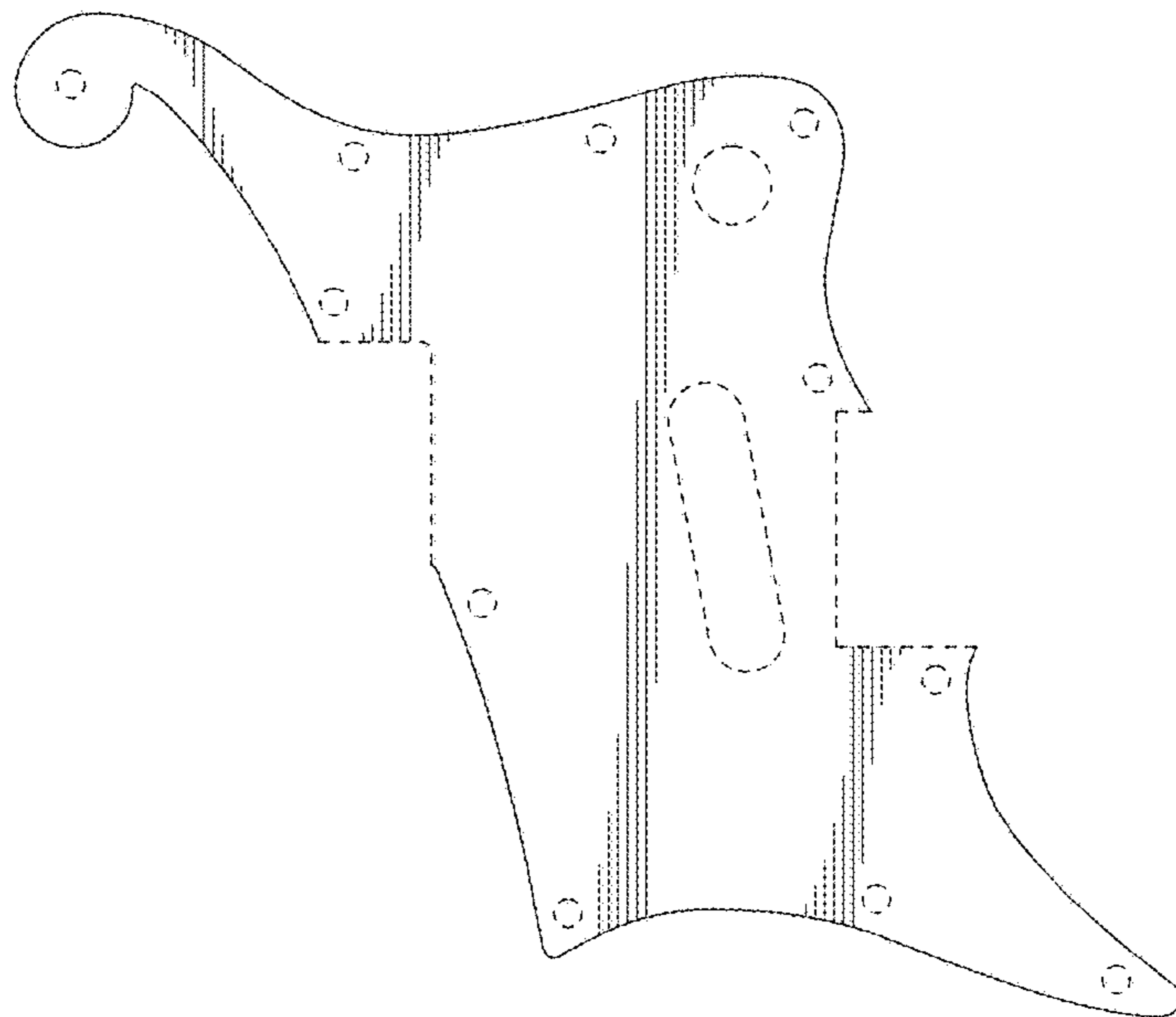

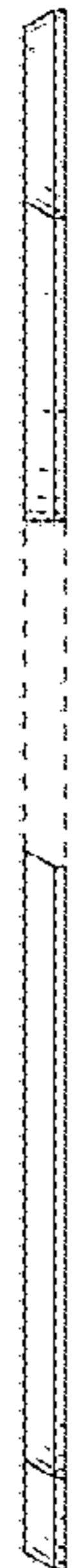

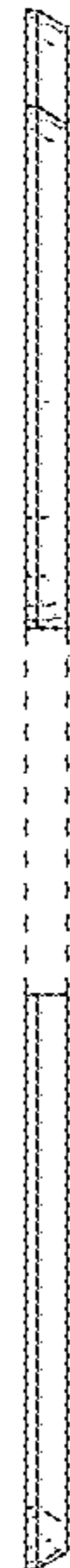

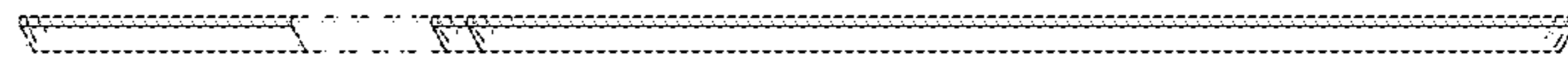

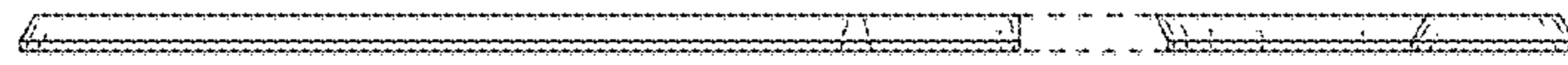

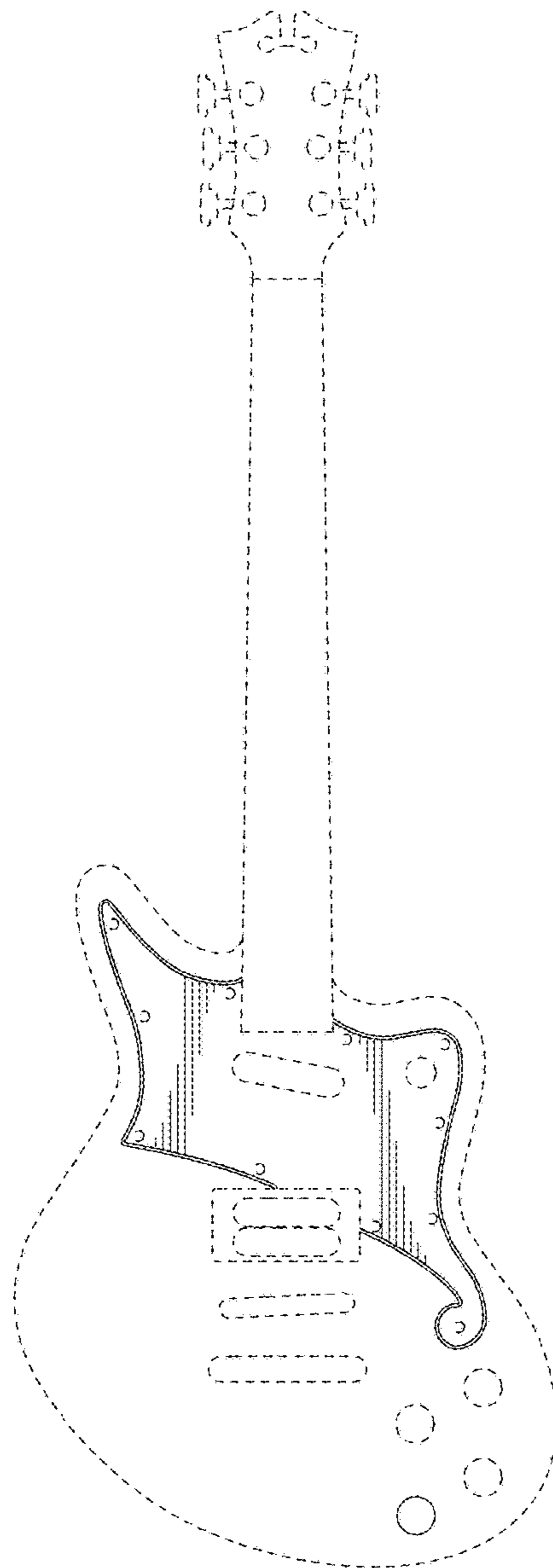
