DESCRIPTION

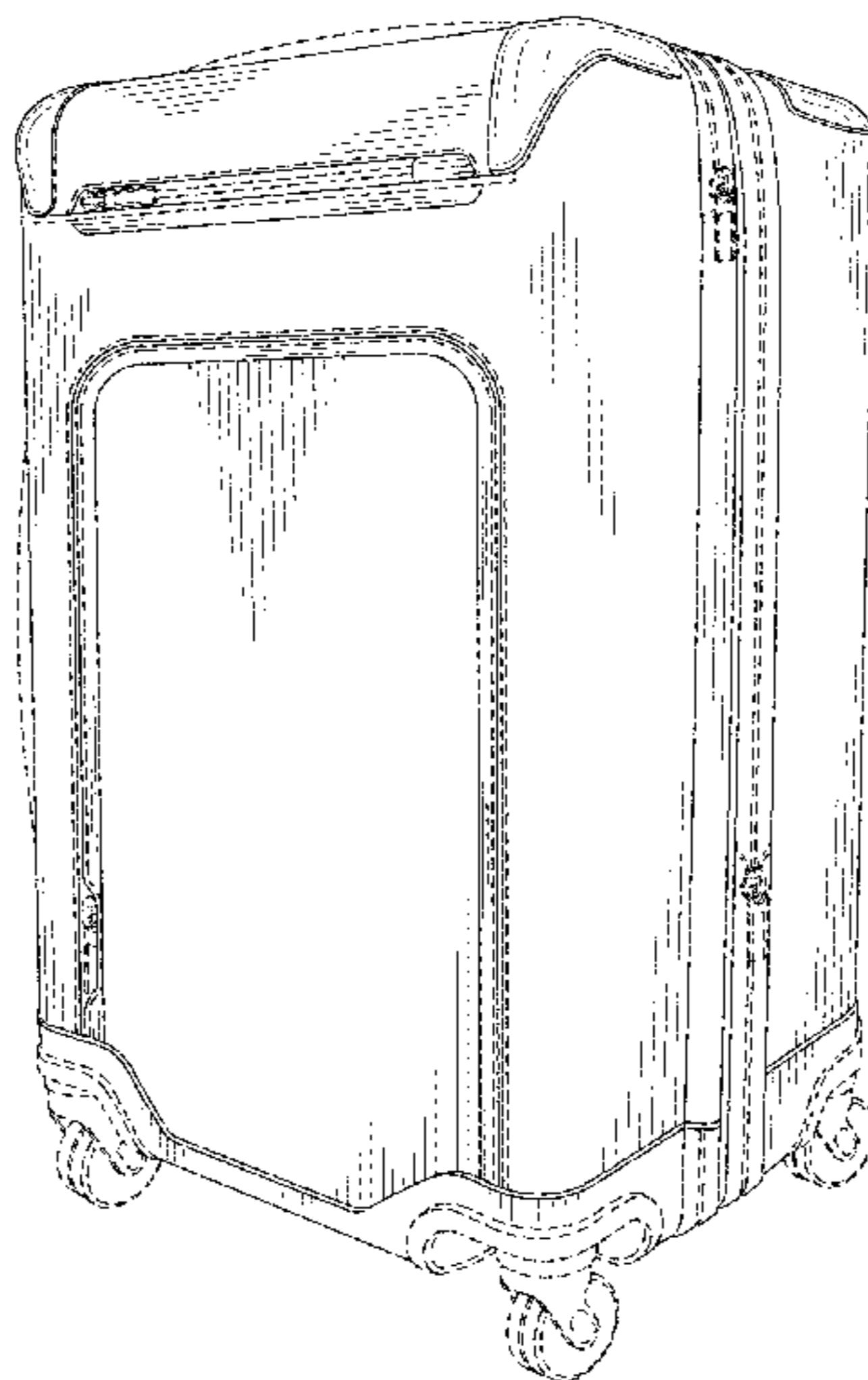
FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the suitcase;

FIG. 4 is a left side view of the suitcase;
FIG. 5 is a right side view of the suitcase;

FIG. 7 is a bottom view of the suitcase.
The broken lines illustrate portions of the suitcase and form no part of the claimed design. The two broken lines immediately adjacent the largest enclosed zipper track on the front face represent stitching, and form no part of the claimed design.

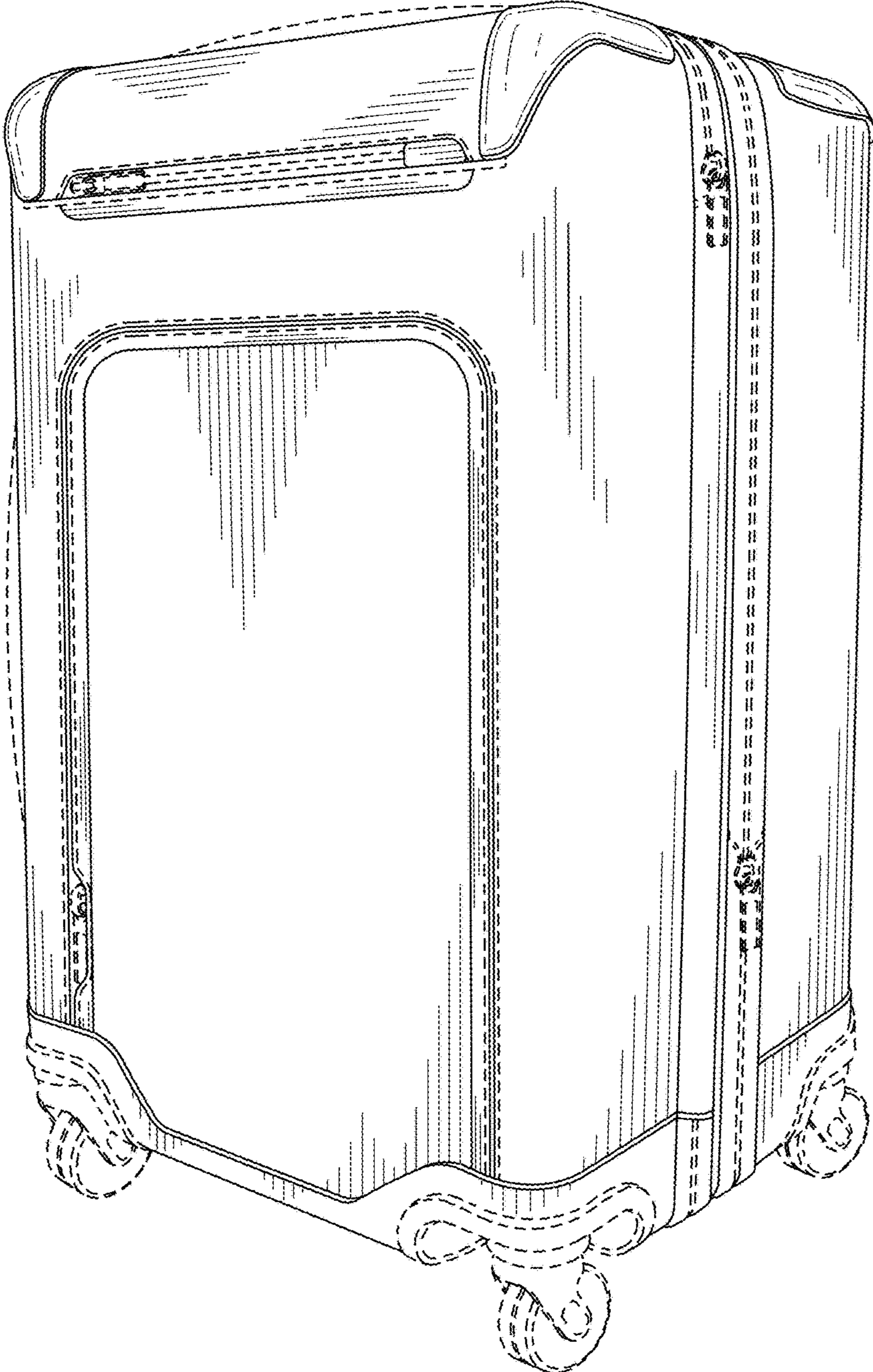

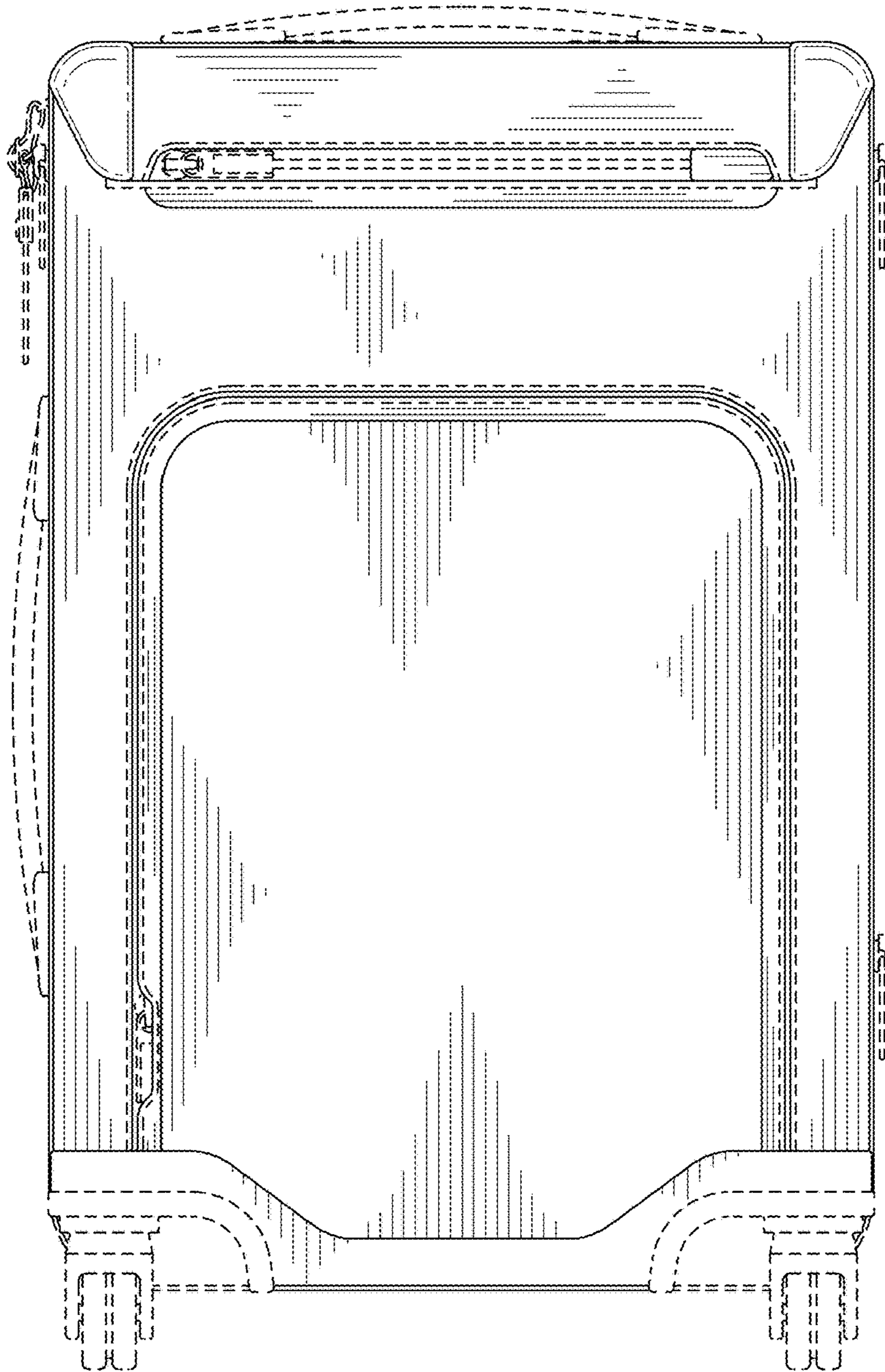

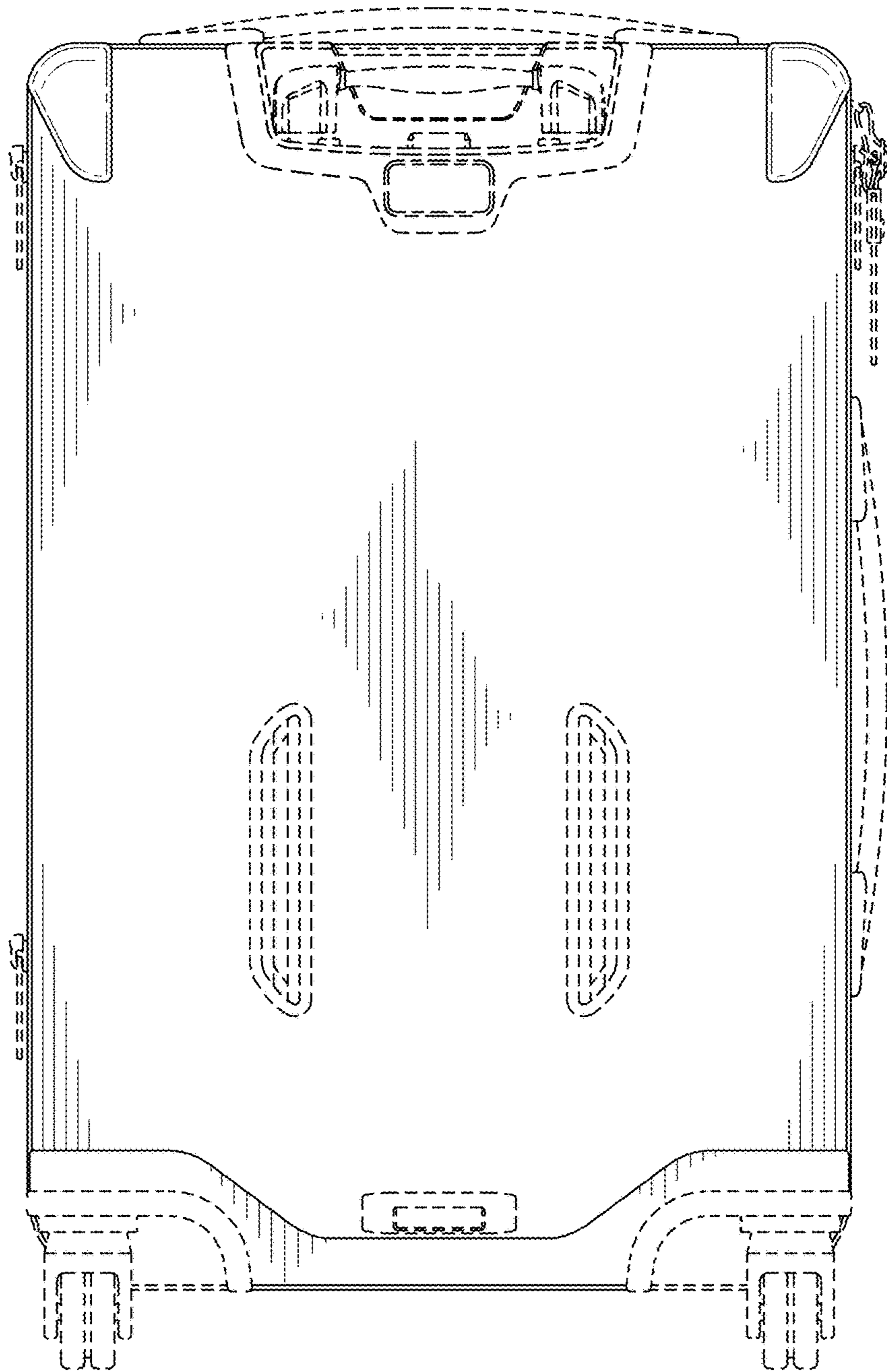

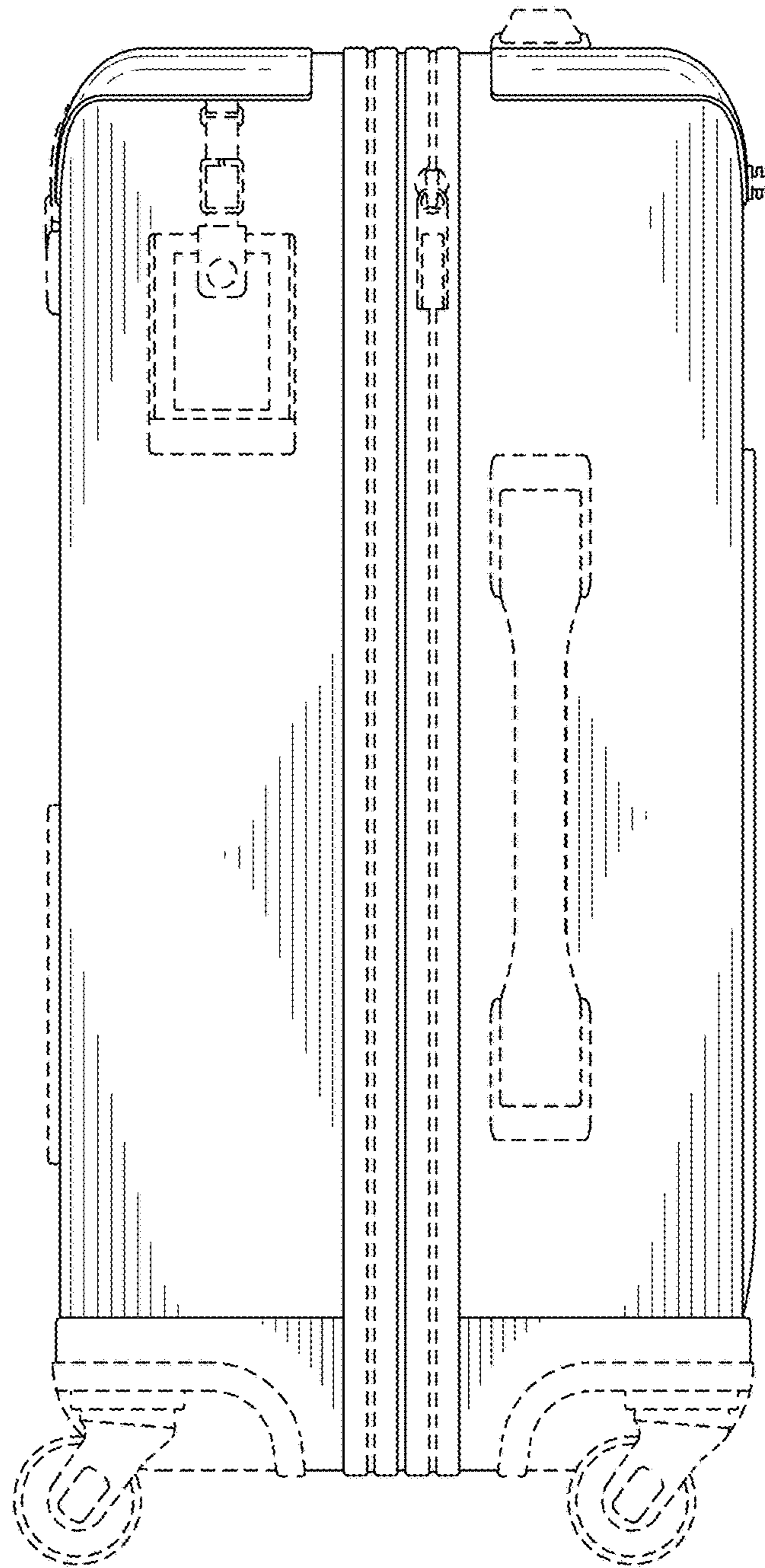

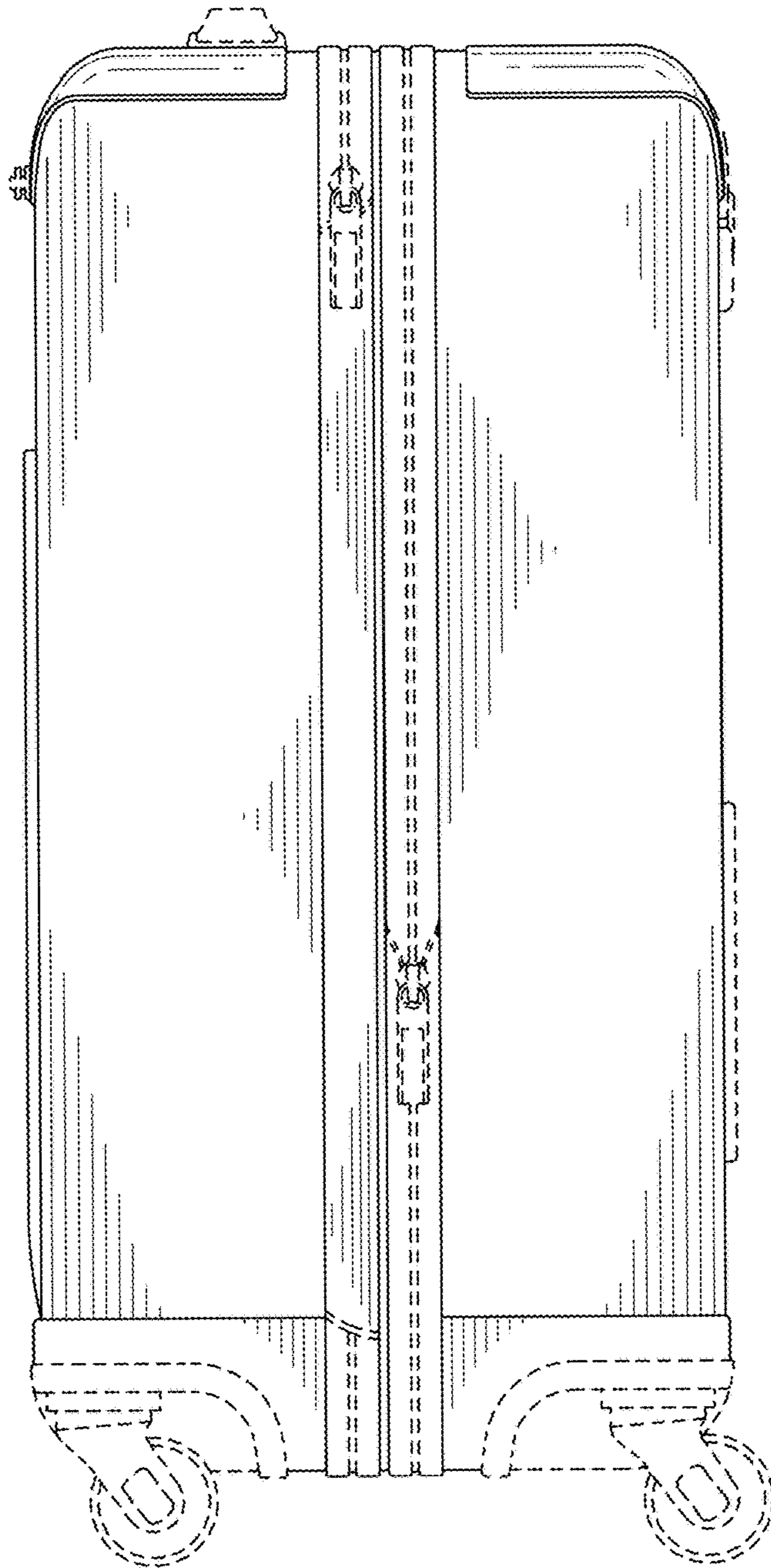

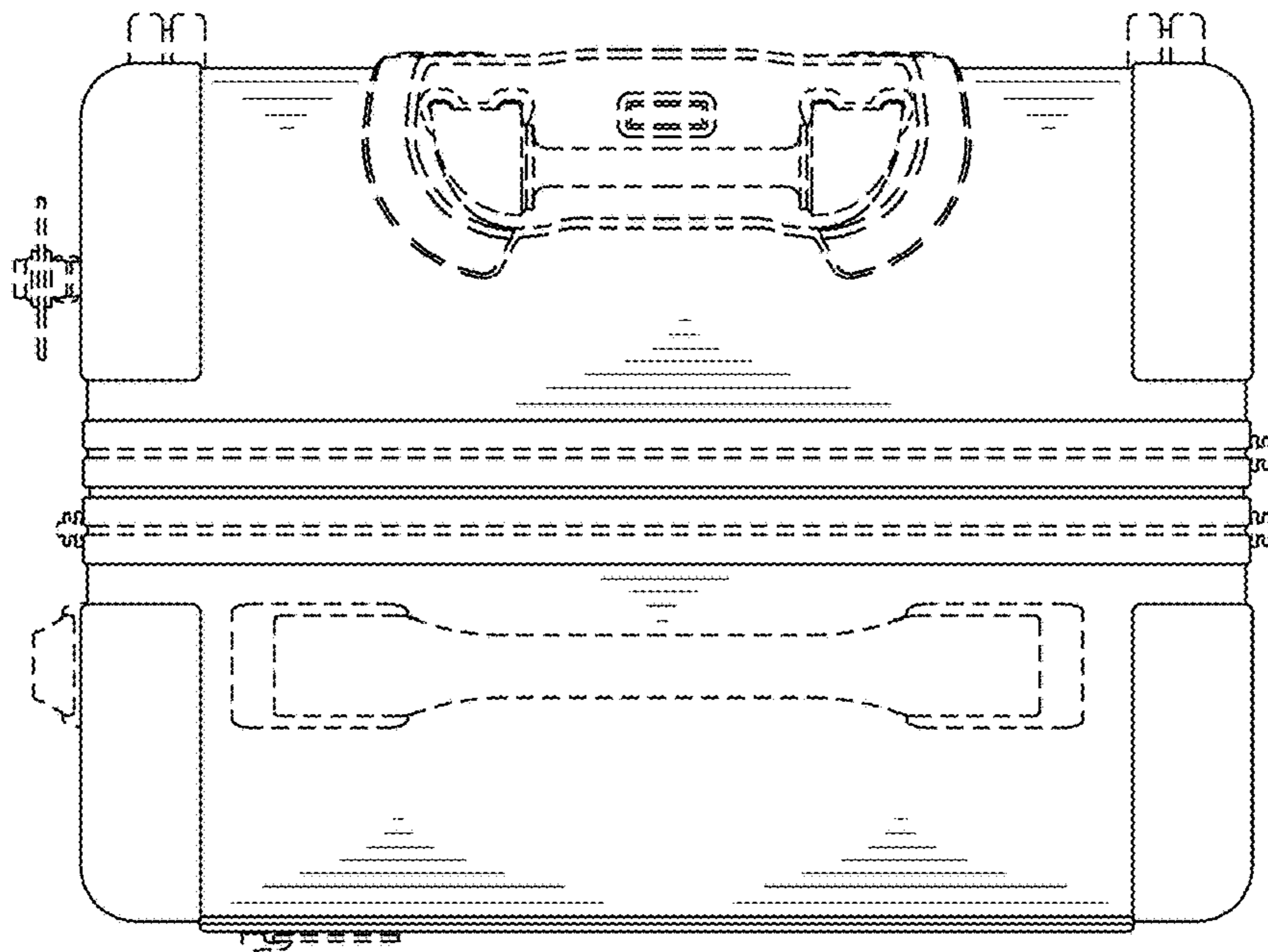

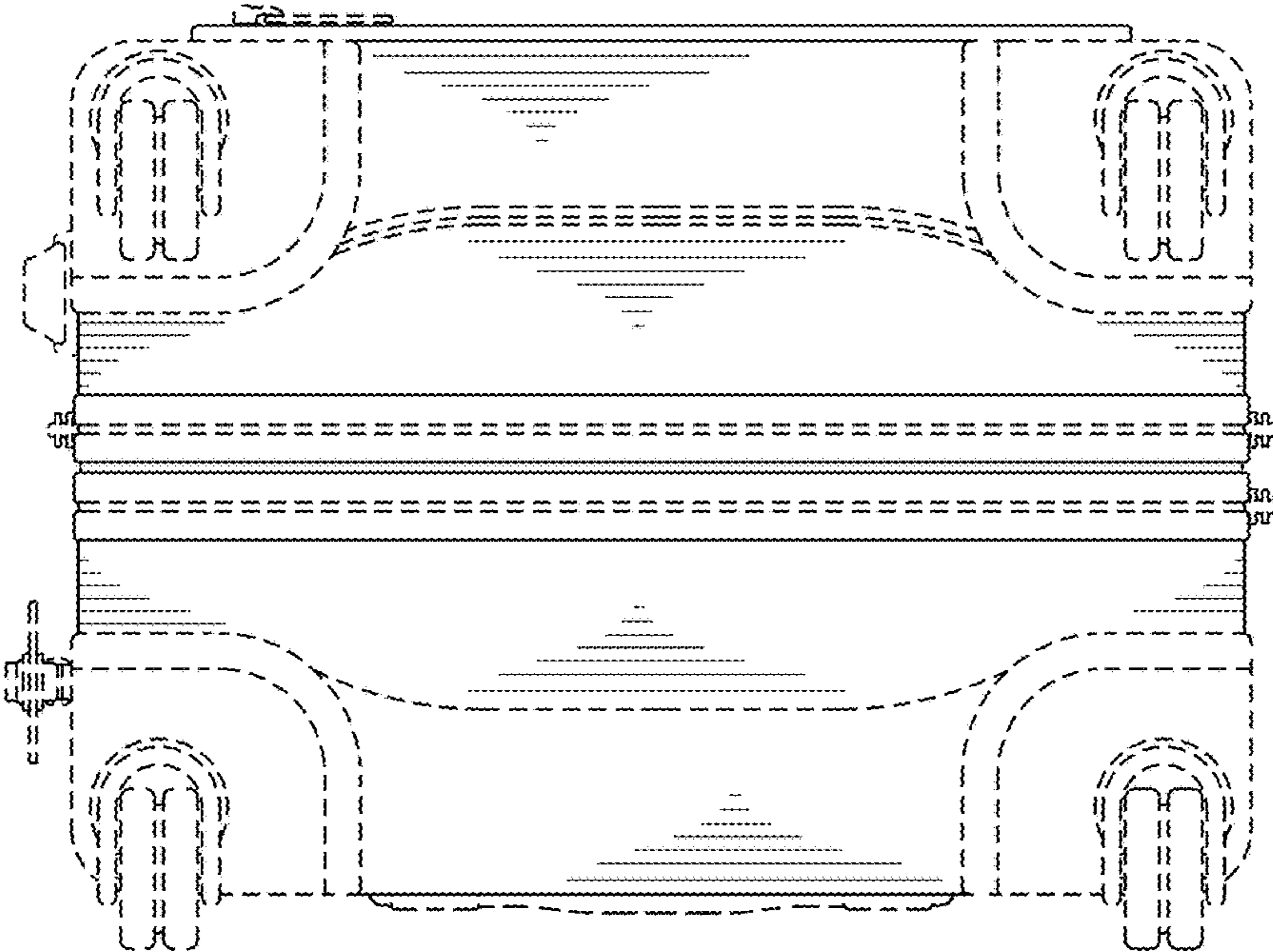
