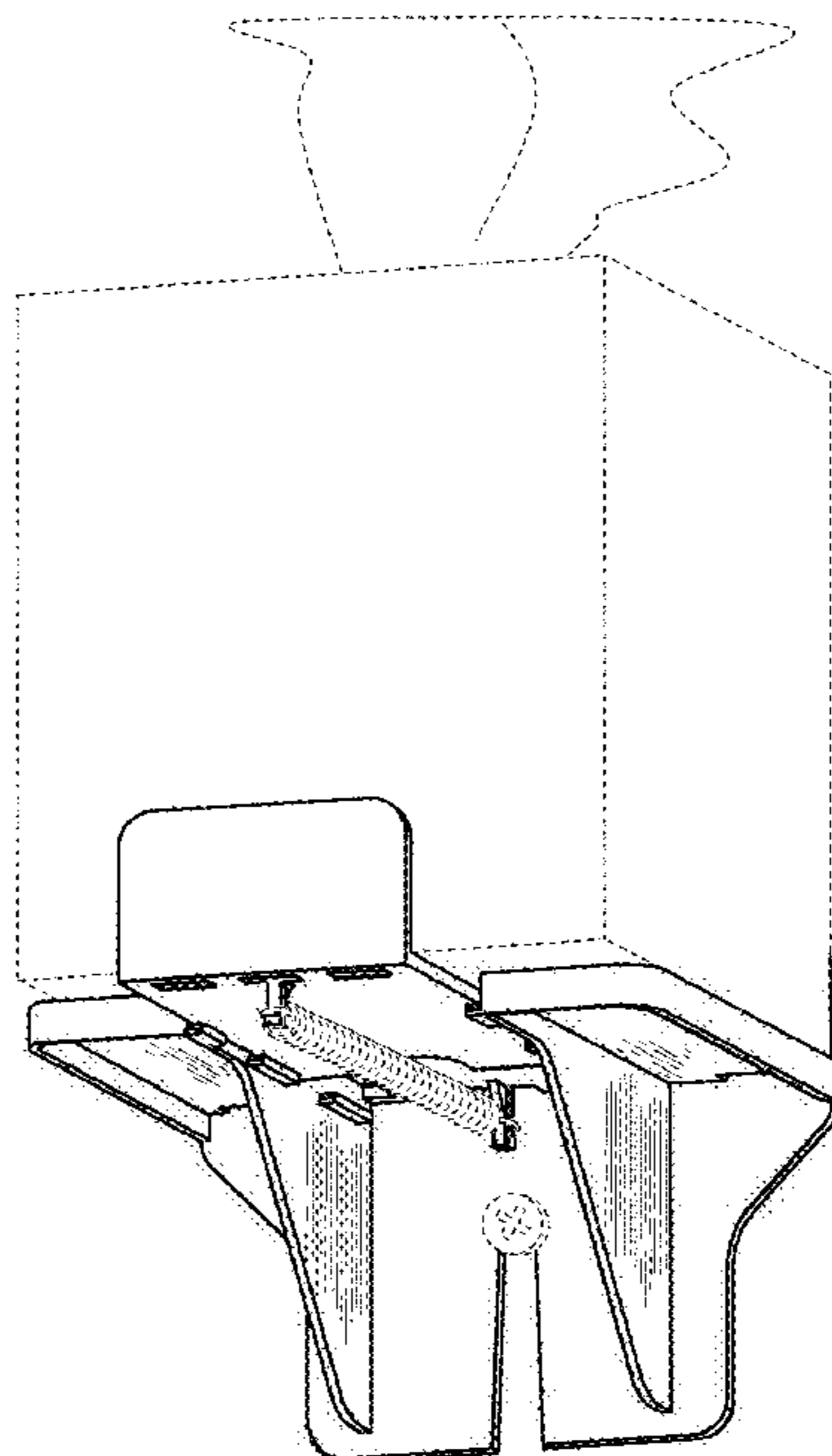
(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a holder for tissue box, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a bottom perspective view of a holder for tissue box, showing my new design in an environment of use; FIG. 2 is an exploded view top plan view thereof; FIG. 3 is an exploded bottom view thereof; FIG. 4 is a front elevation view thereof; FIG. 5 is a rear elevation view thereof; FIG. 6 is an exploded left side elevation view, the exploded right-side elevation view being a mirror image thereof; and, FIG. 7 is a top perspective view.
The broken lines in FIG. 1 depict environmental subject matter of tissue box, spring and fastener for the invention and form no part of the claimed design.

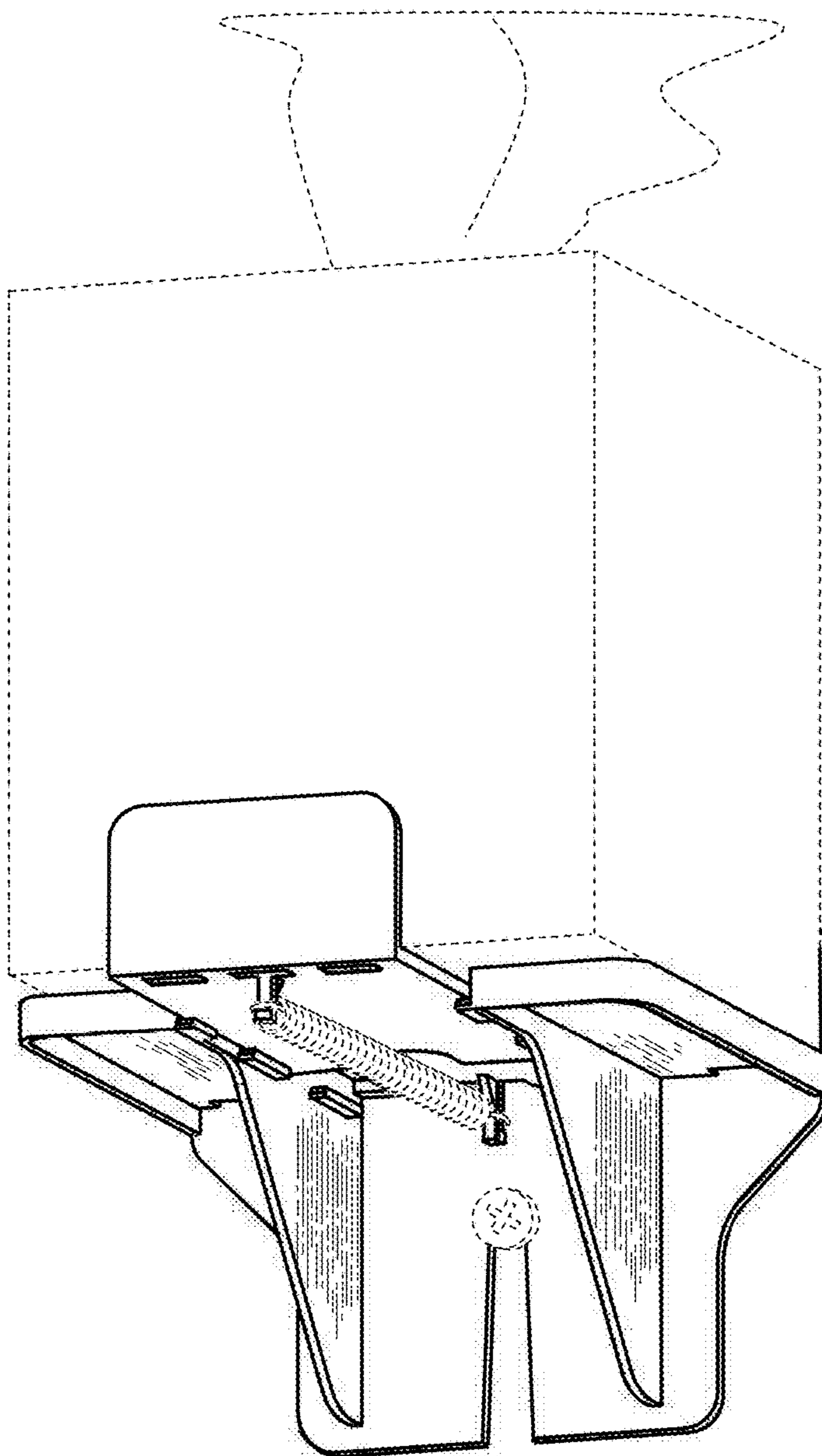

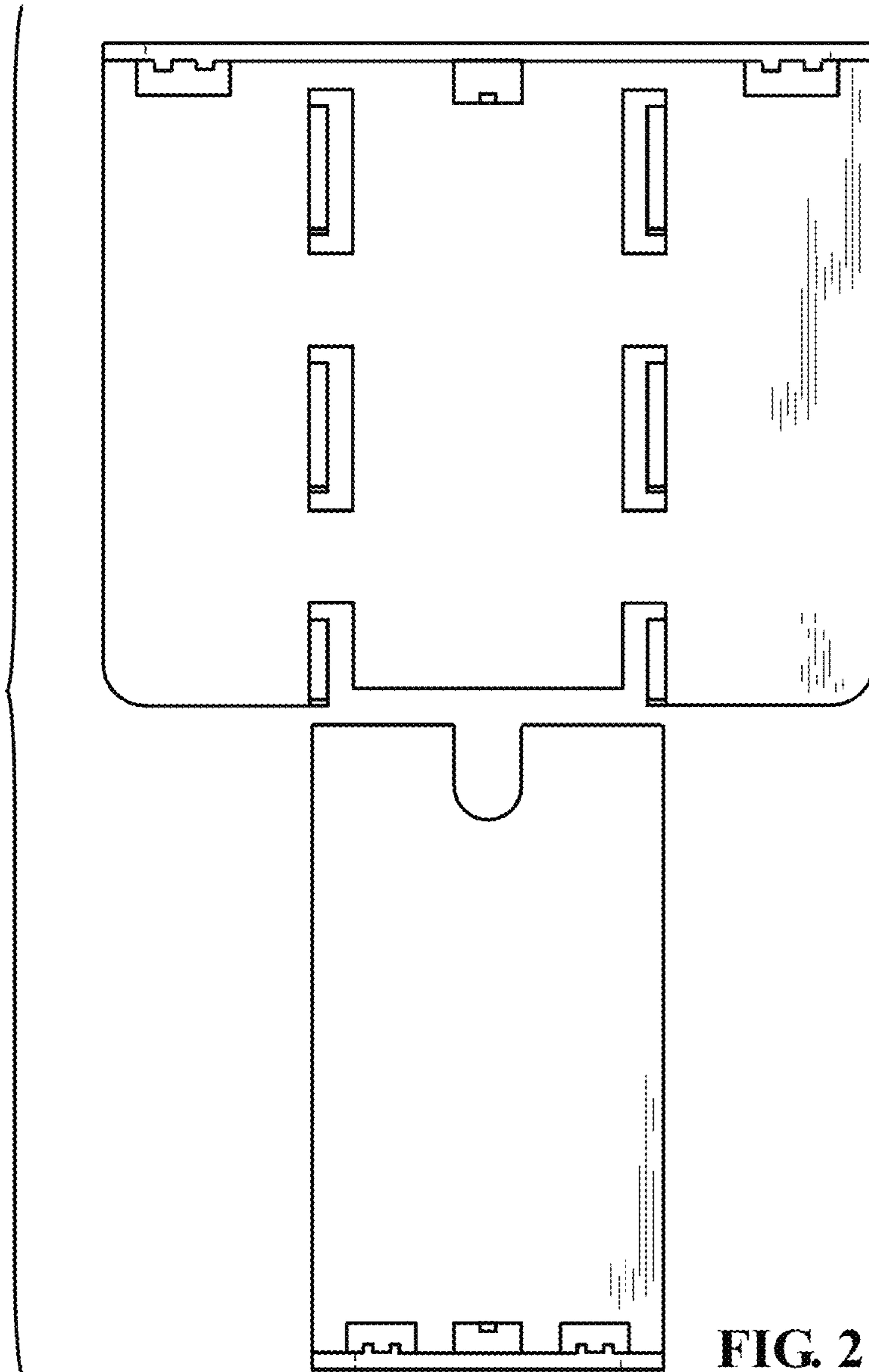

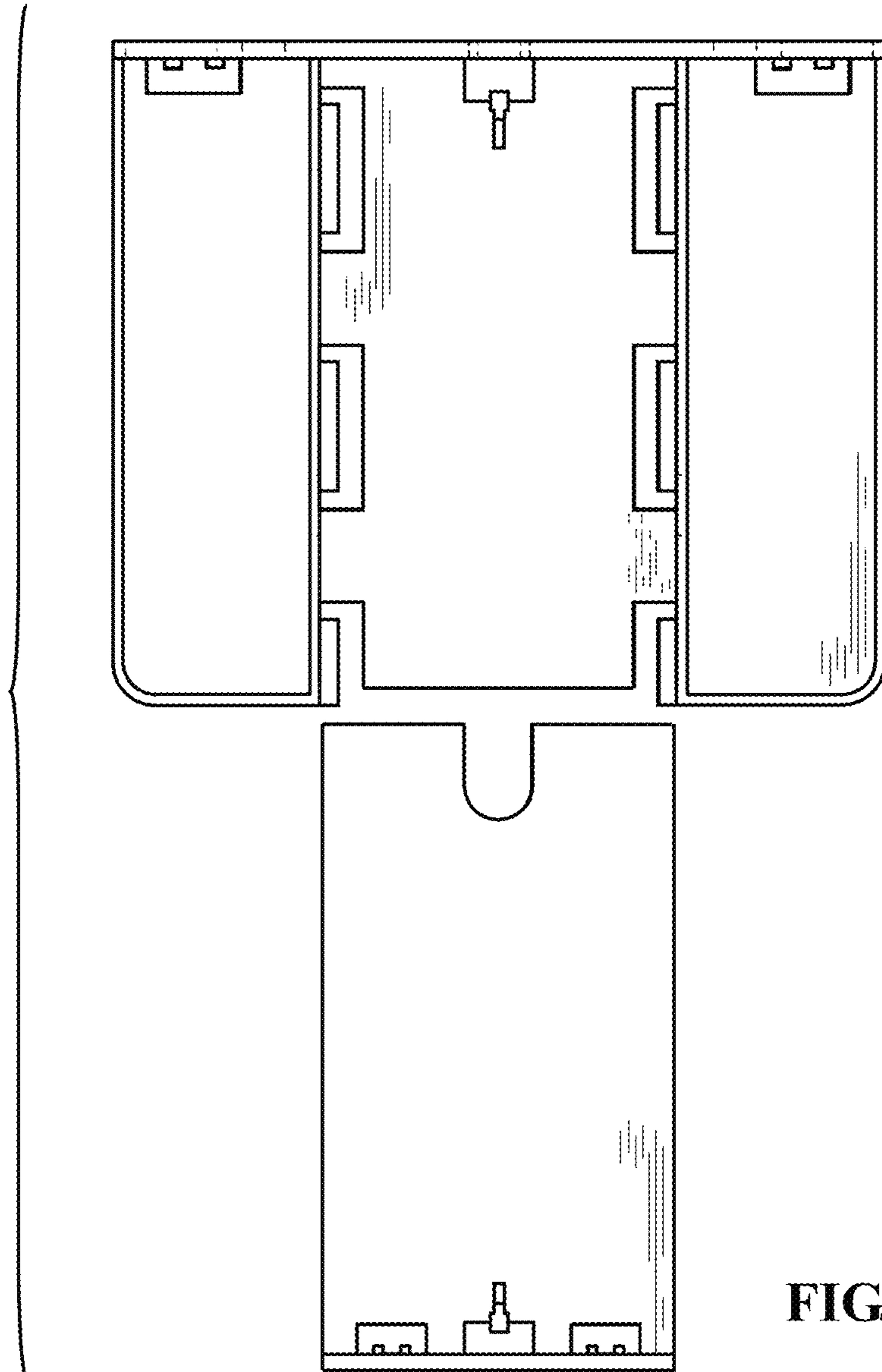

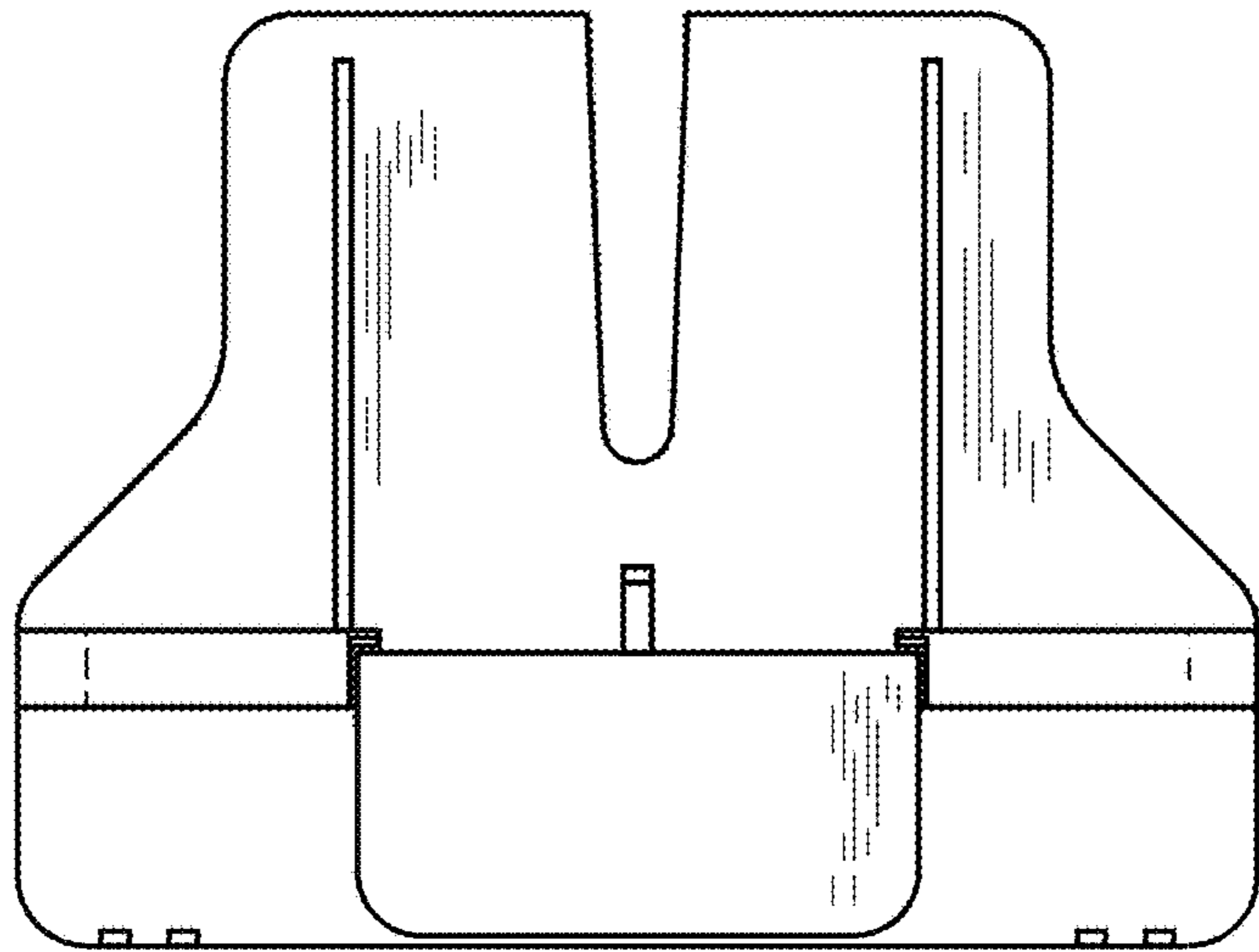

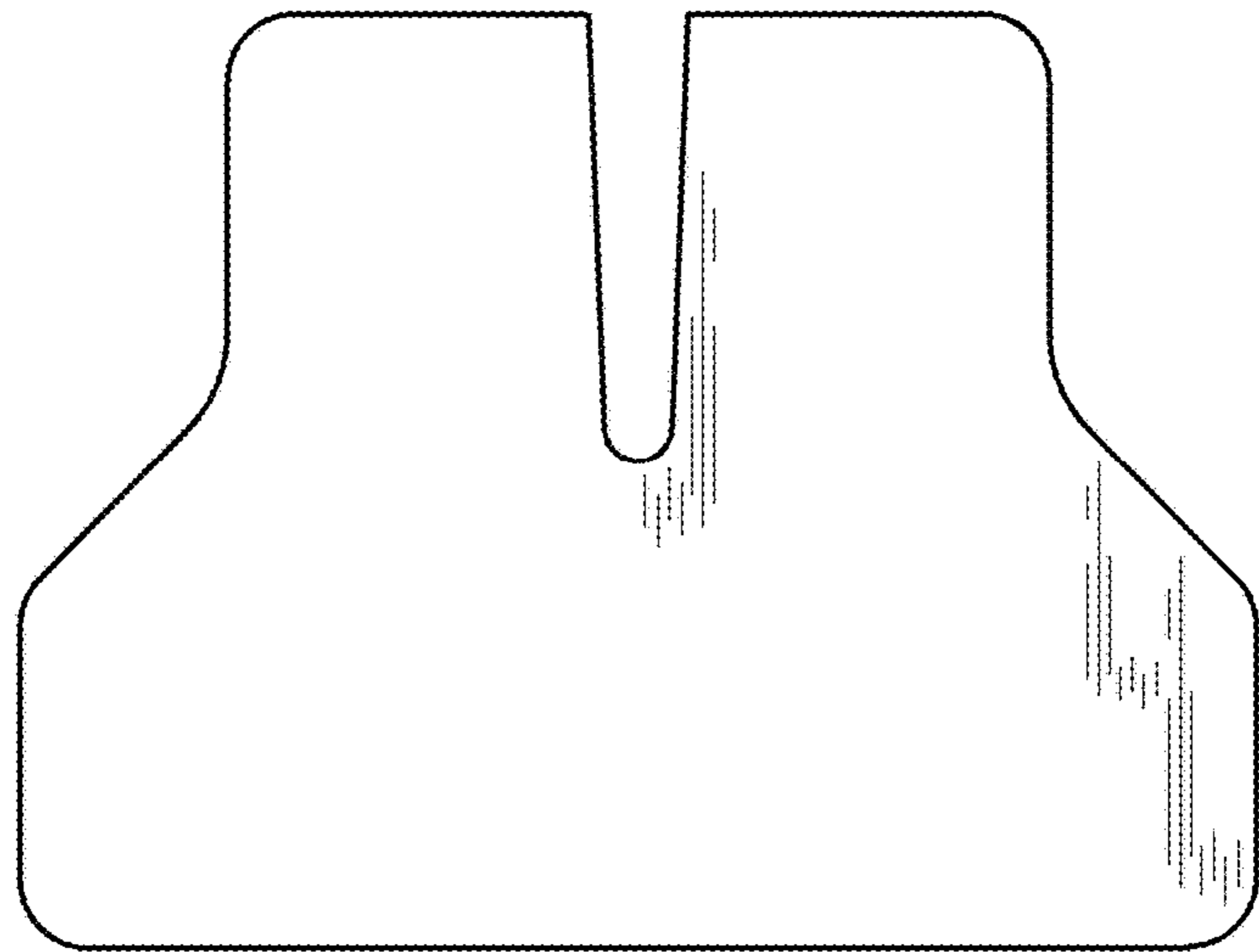

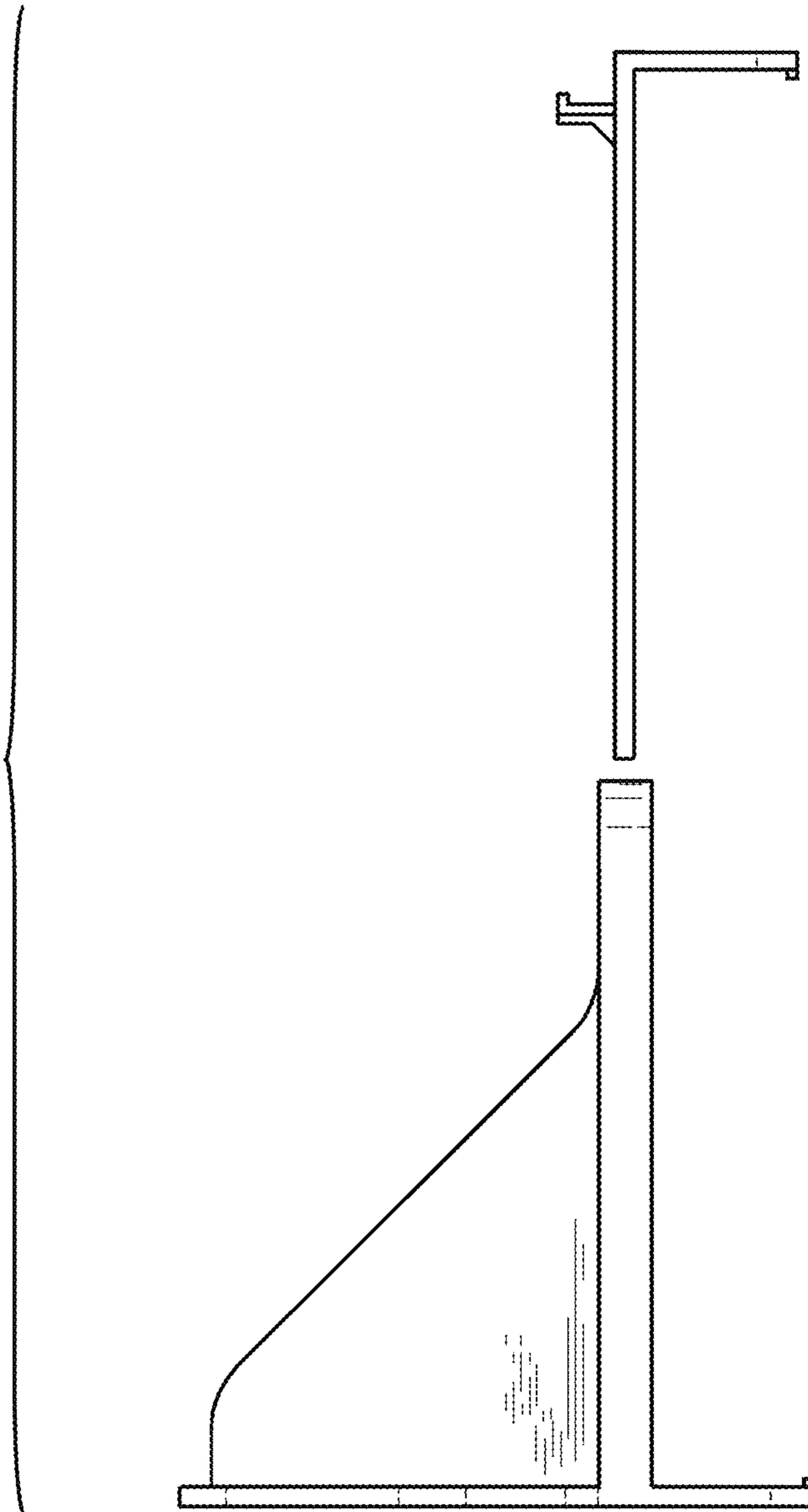

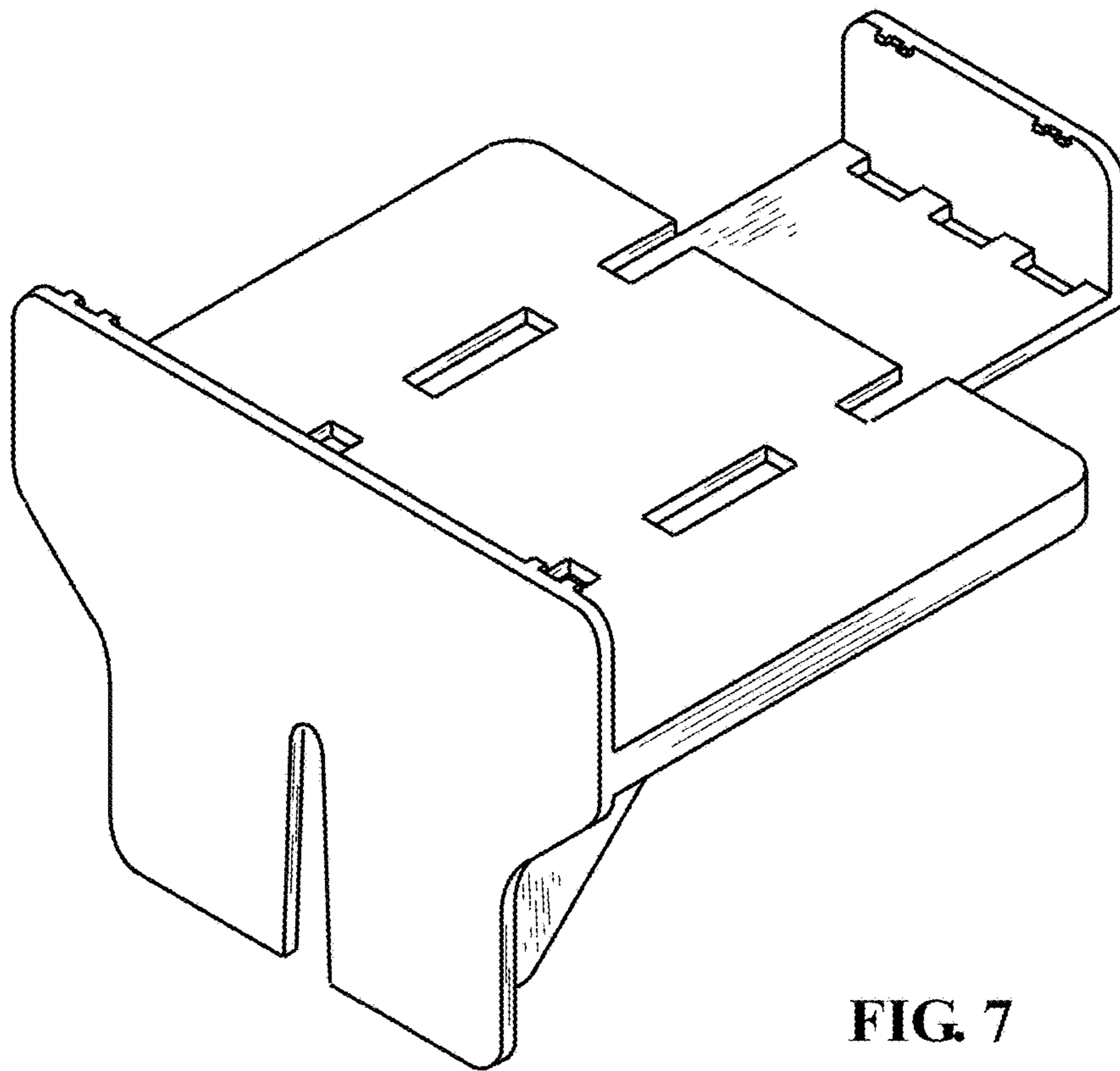
