DESCRIPTION

FIG. 3 is a rear view thereof;

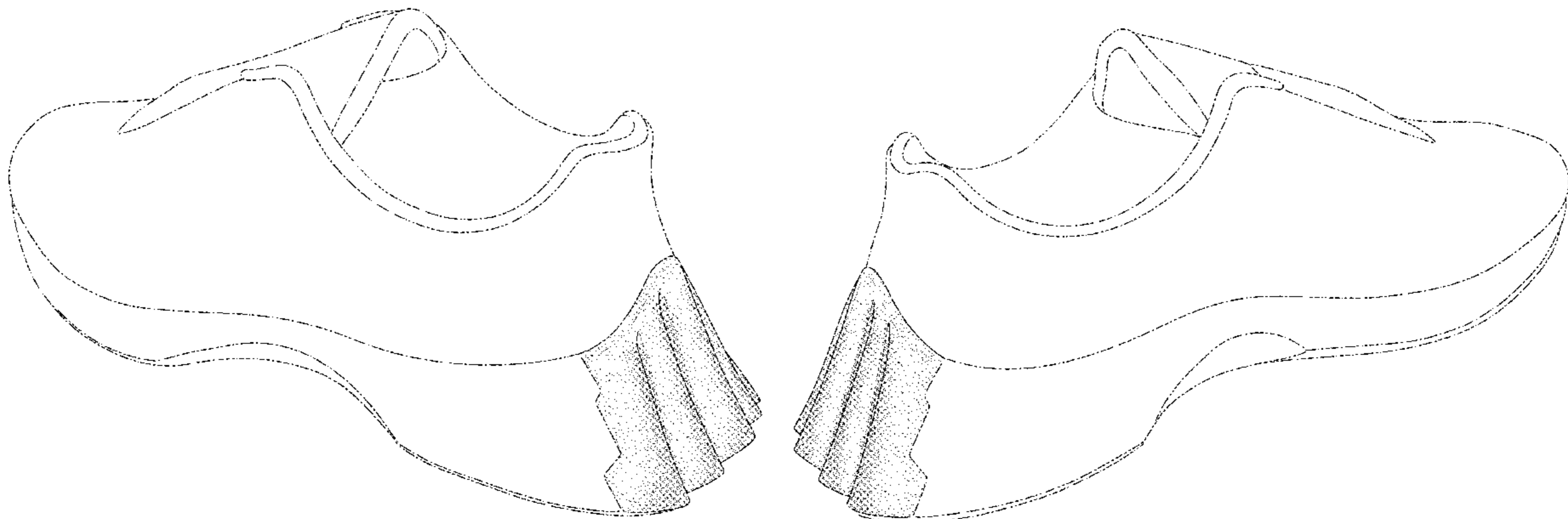
FIG. 4 is a side view thereof;

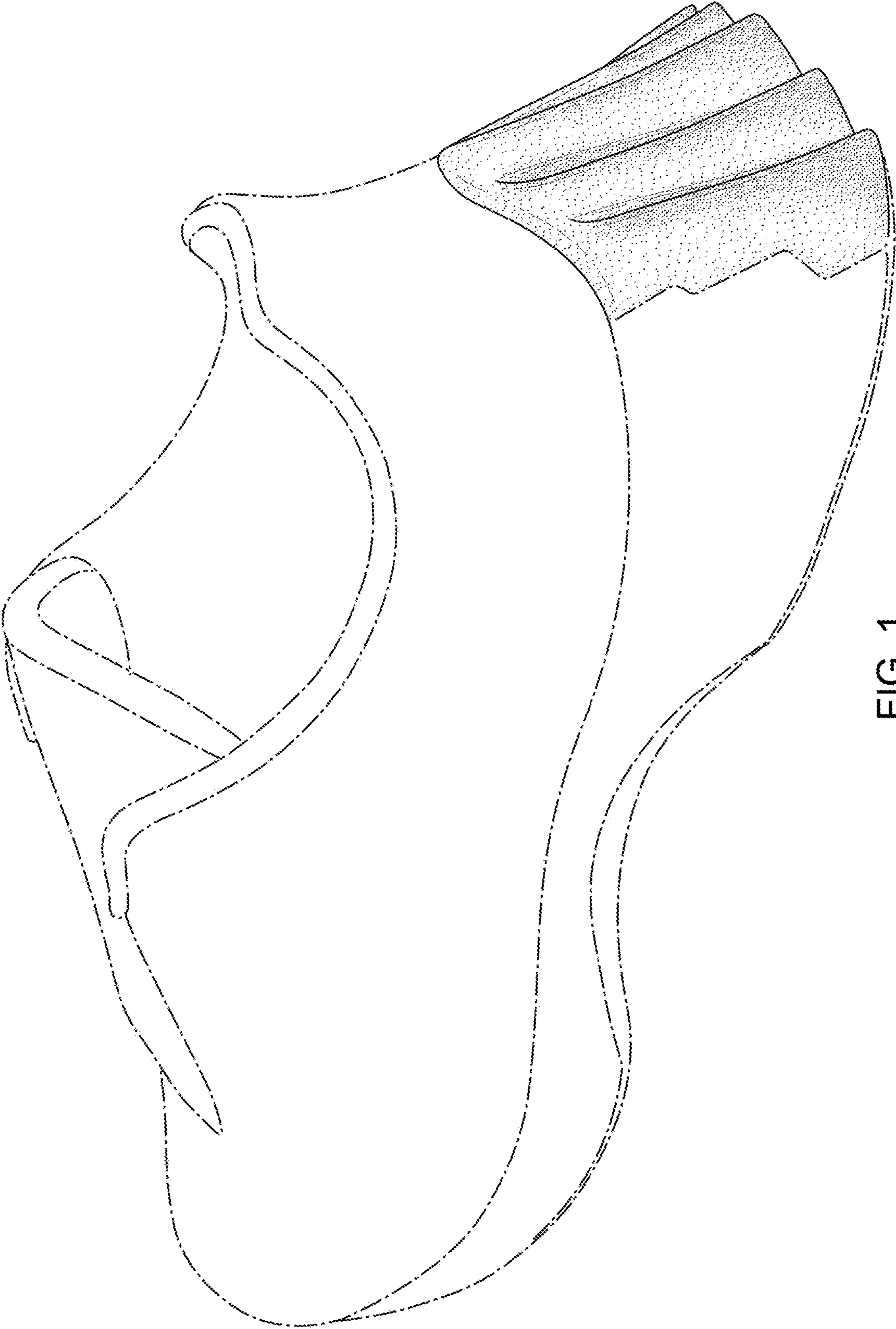

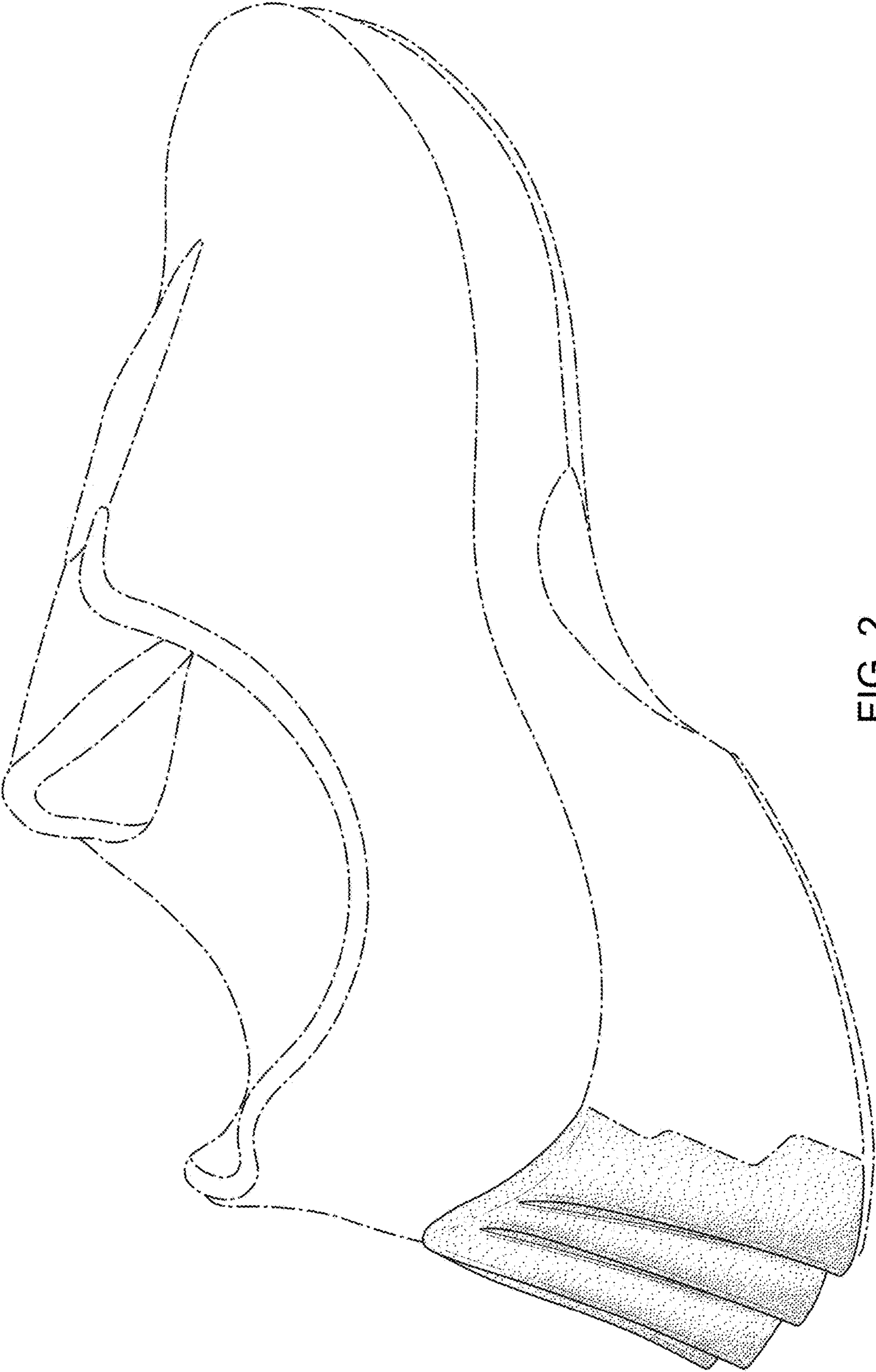

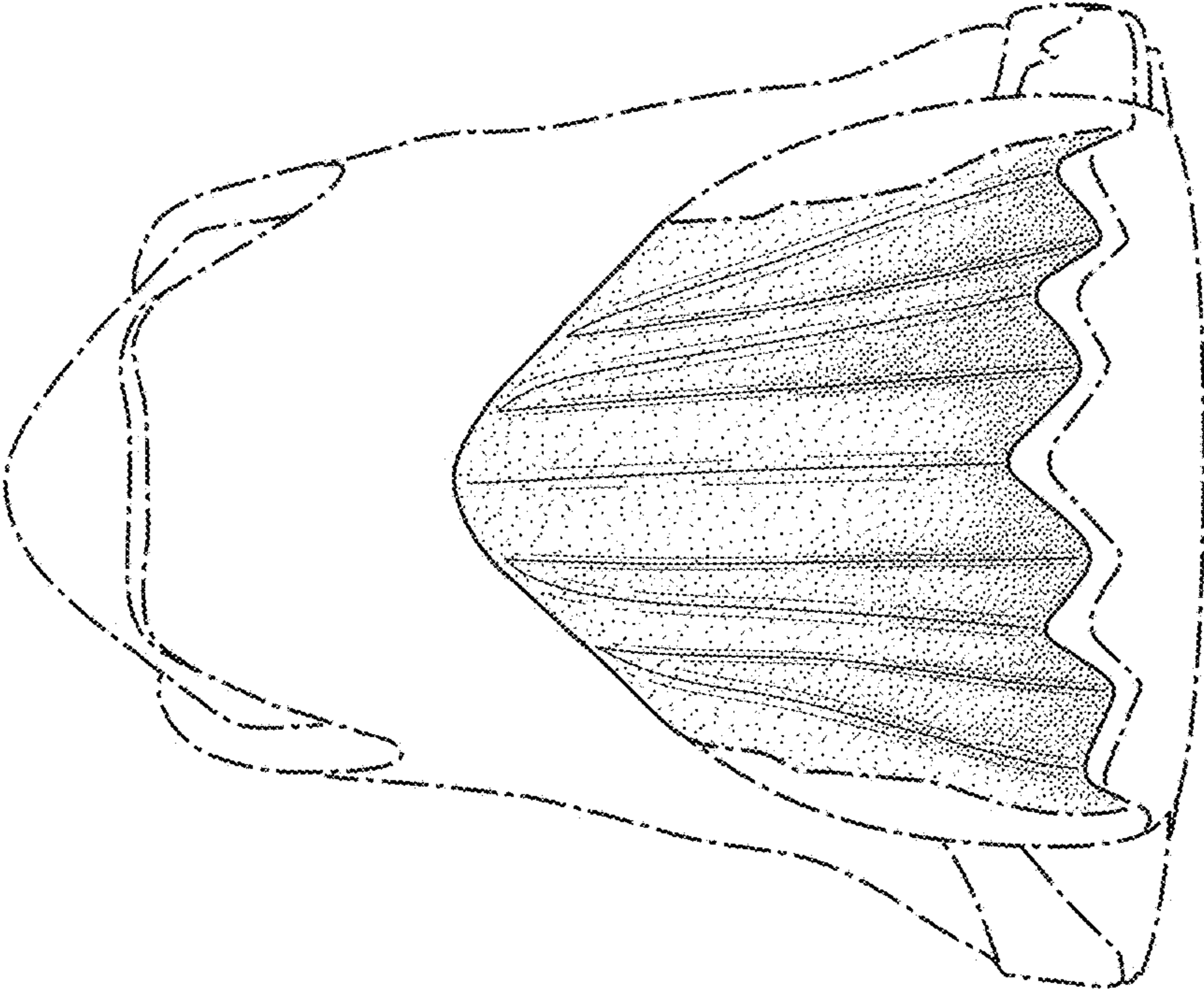

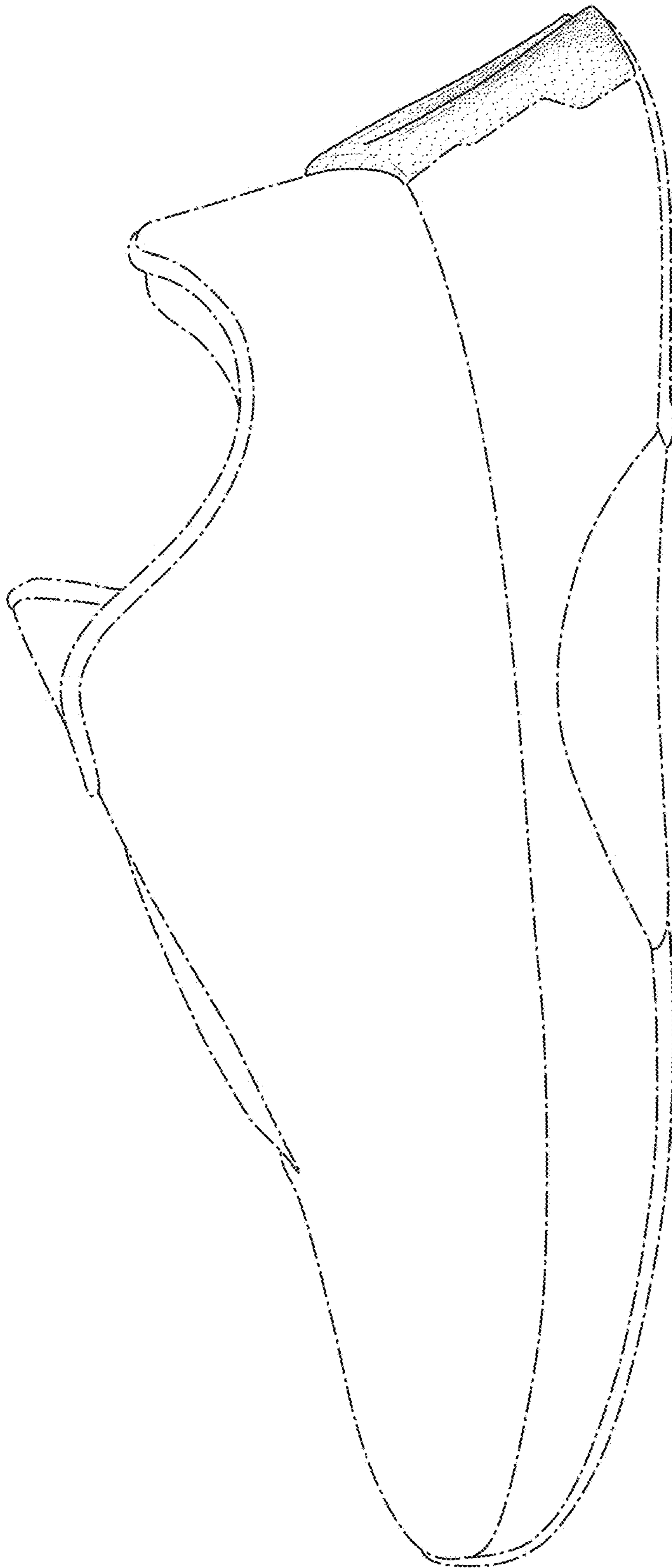

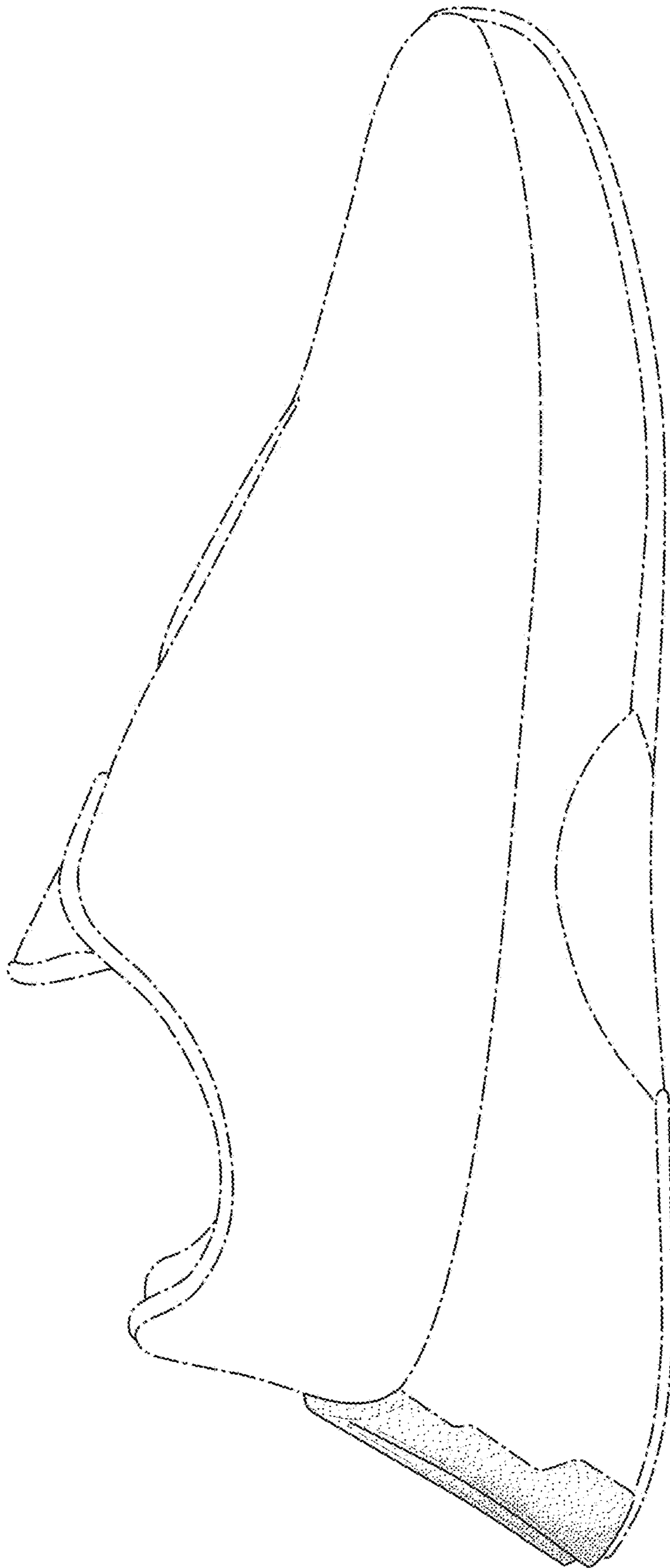

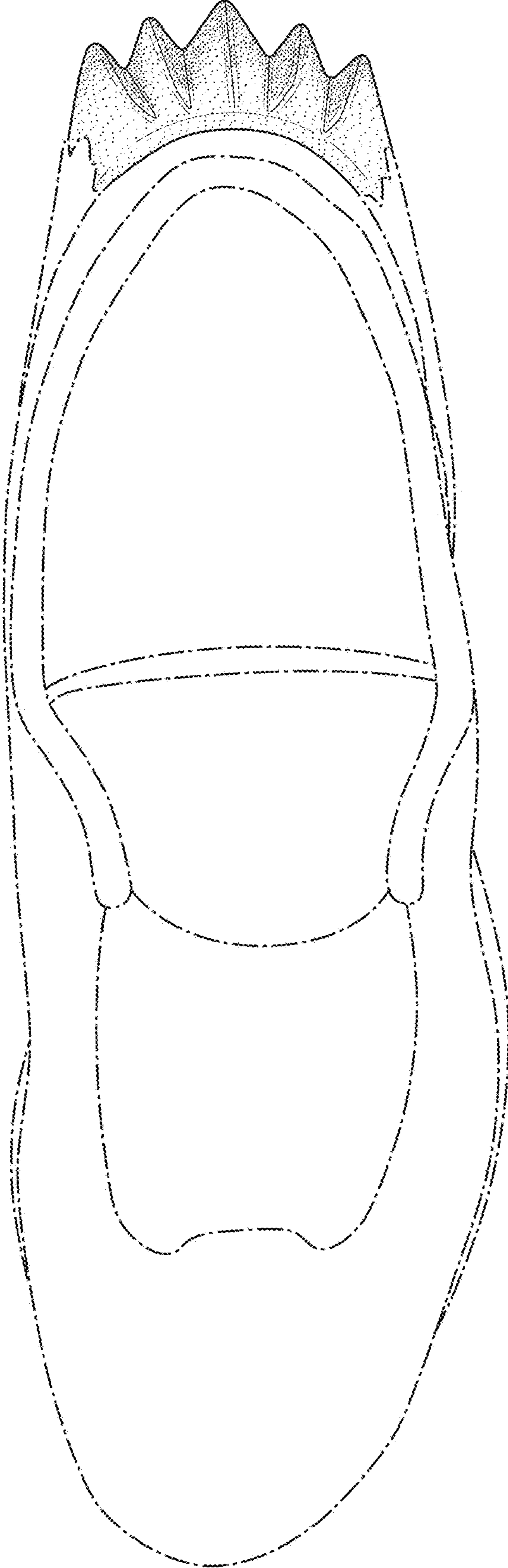
