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(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a display screen or portion thereof with transitional graphical user interface, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front view of a first embodiment (with a rectangular feature) of a first display of a graphical user interface for a display screen or portion thereof showing our new design.

FIG. 2 is a front view of a first embodiment (with a rectangular feature) of a second display of a graphical user interface for a display screen or portion thereof showing our new design.

FIG. 3 is a front view of a first embodiment (with a rectangular feature) of a third display of a graphical user interface for a display screen or portion thereof showing our new design.

FIG. 4 is a front view of a second embodiment (with a square feature) of the first display of a graphical user interface for a display screen or portion thereof showing our new design. FIG. 5 is a front view of a second embodiment (with a square feature) of the second display of a graphical user interface for a display screen or portion thereof showing our new design.

FIG. 6 is a front view of a second embodiment (with a square feature) of the third display of a graphical user interface for a display screen or portion thereof showing our new design.

FIG. 7 is a front view of a third embodiment (with an oval feature) of the first display of a graphical user interface for a display screen or portion thereof showing our new design.

FIG. 8 is a front view of a third embodiment (with an oval feature) of the second display of a graphical user interface for a display screen or portion thereof showing our new design.

FIG. 9 is a front view of a third embodiment (with an oval feature) of the third display of a graphical user interface for a display screen or portion thereof showing our new design.

FIG. 10 is a front view of a fourth embodiment (with a triangular feature) of the first display of a graphical user interface for a display screen or portion thereof showing our new design.

FIG. 11 is a front view of a fourth embodiment (with a triangular feature) of the second display of a graphical user interface for a display screen or portion thereof showing our new design.

FIG. 12 is a front view of a fourth embodiment (with a triangular feature) of the third display of a graphical user interface for a display screen or portion thereof showing our new design.

FIG. 13 is a front view of a fifth embodiment (with a diamond feature) of the first display of a graphical user interface for a display screen or portion thereof showing our new design.

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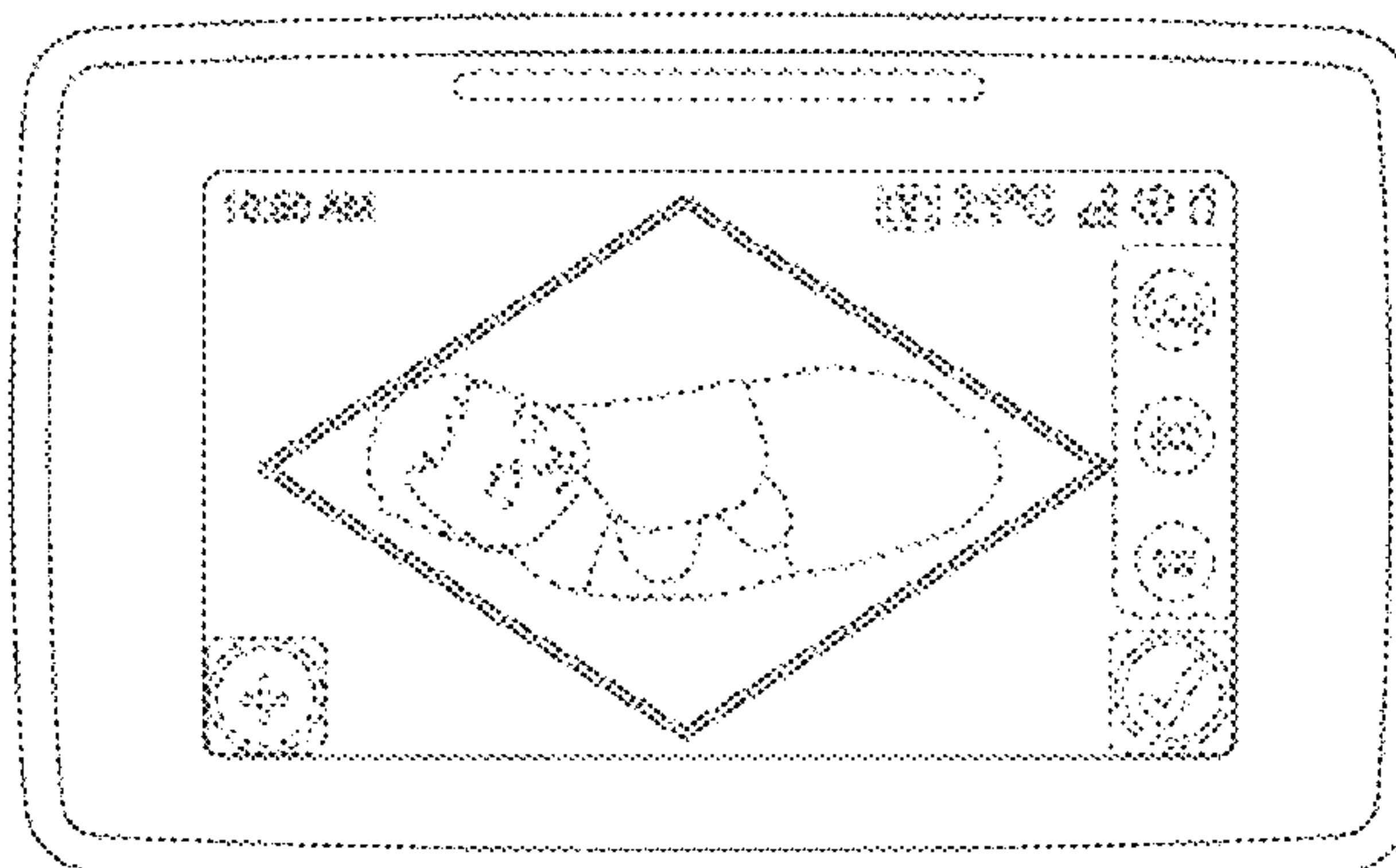
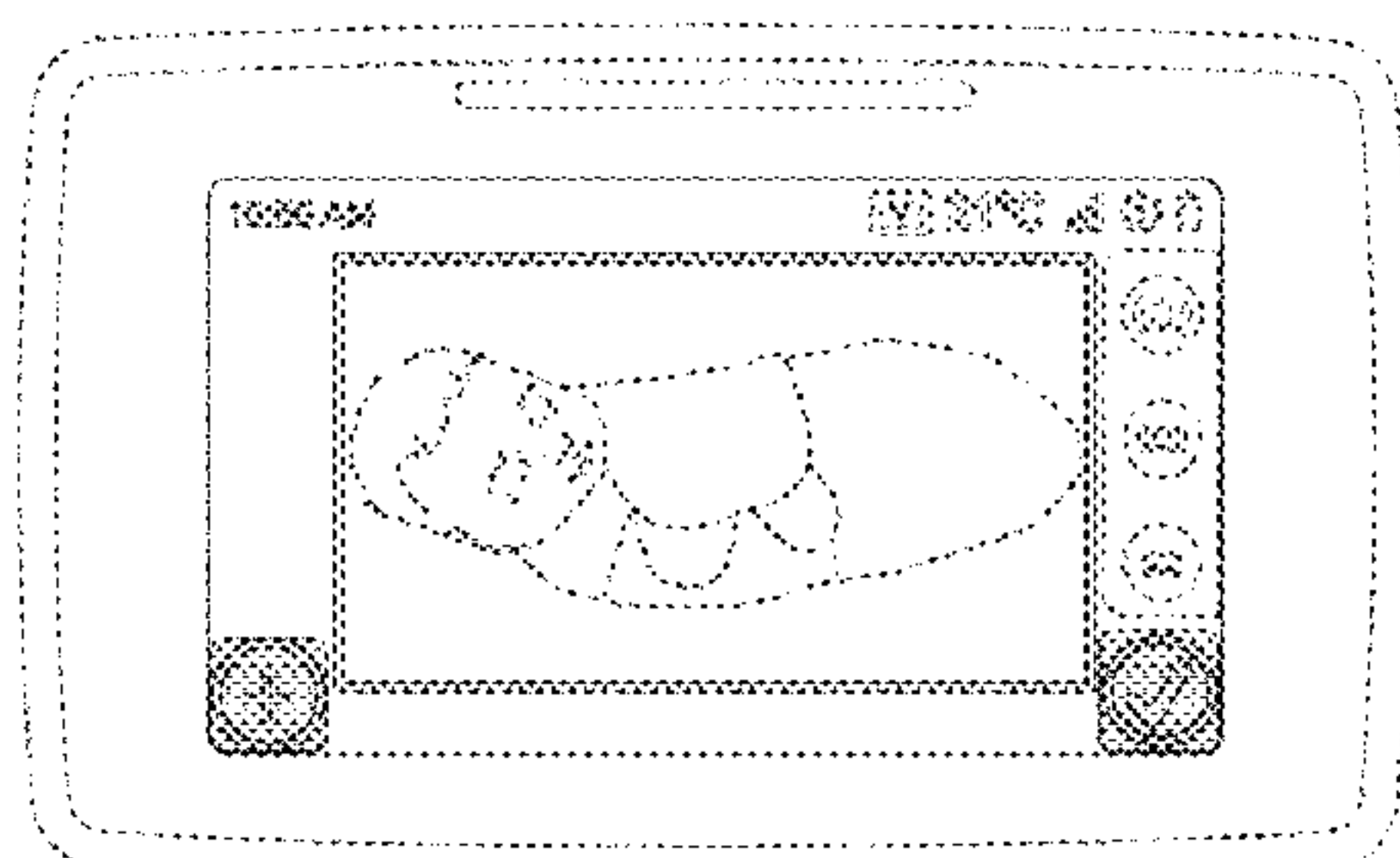


FIG. 14 is a front view of a fifth embodiment (with a diamond feature) of the second display of a graphical user interface for a display screen or portion thereof showing our new design.

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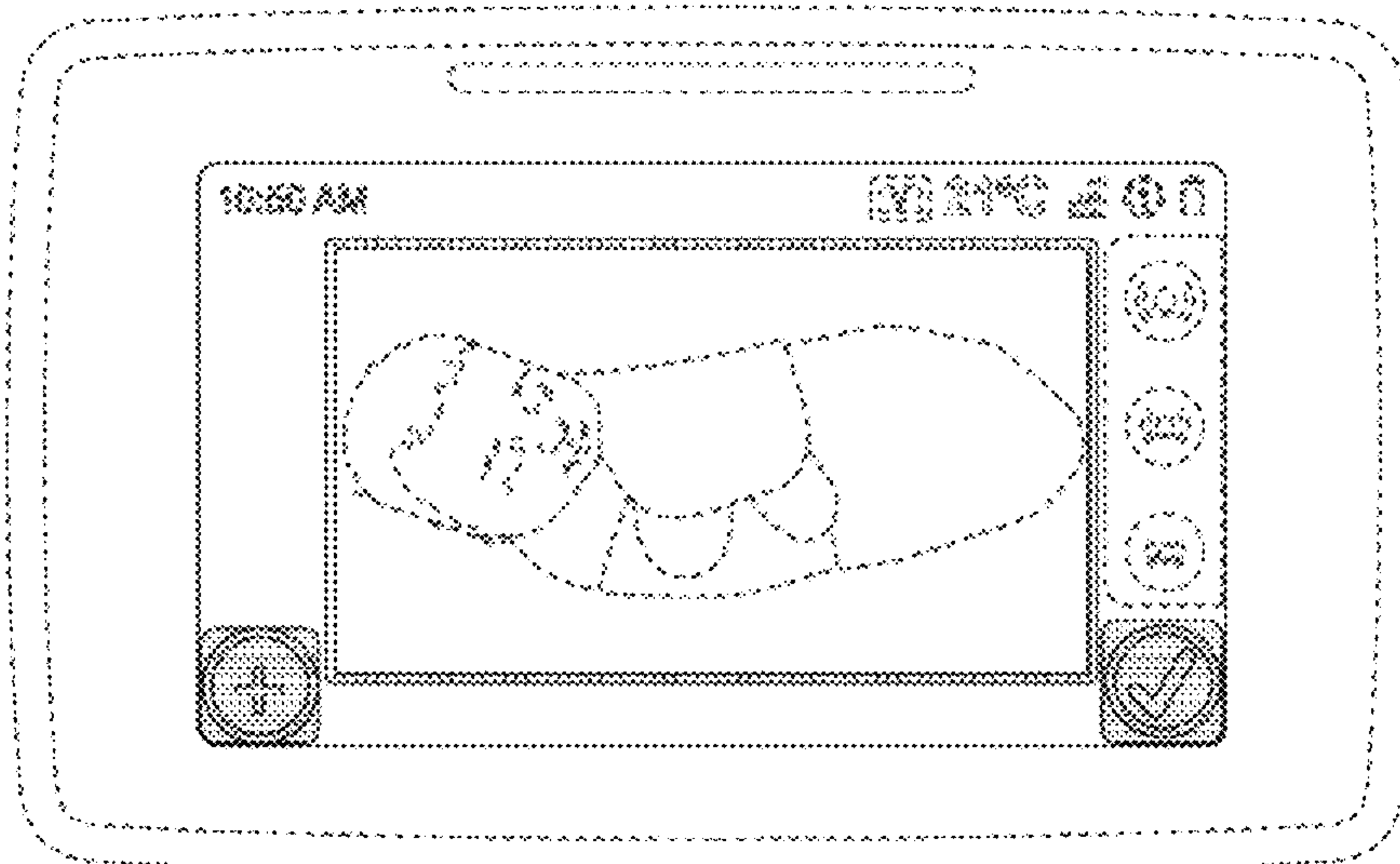

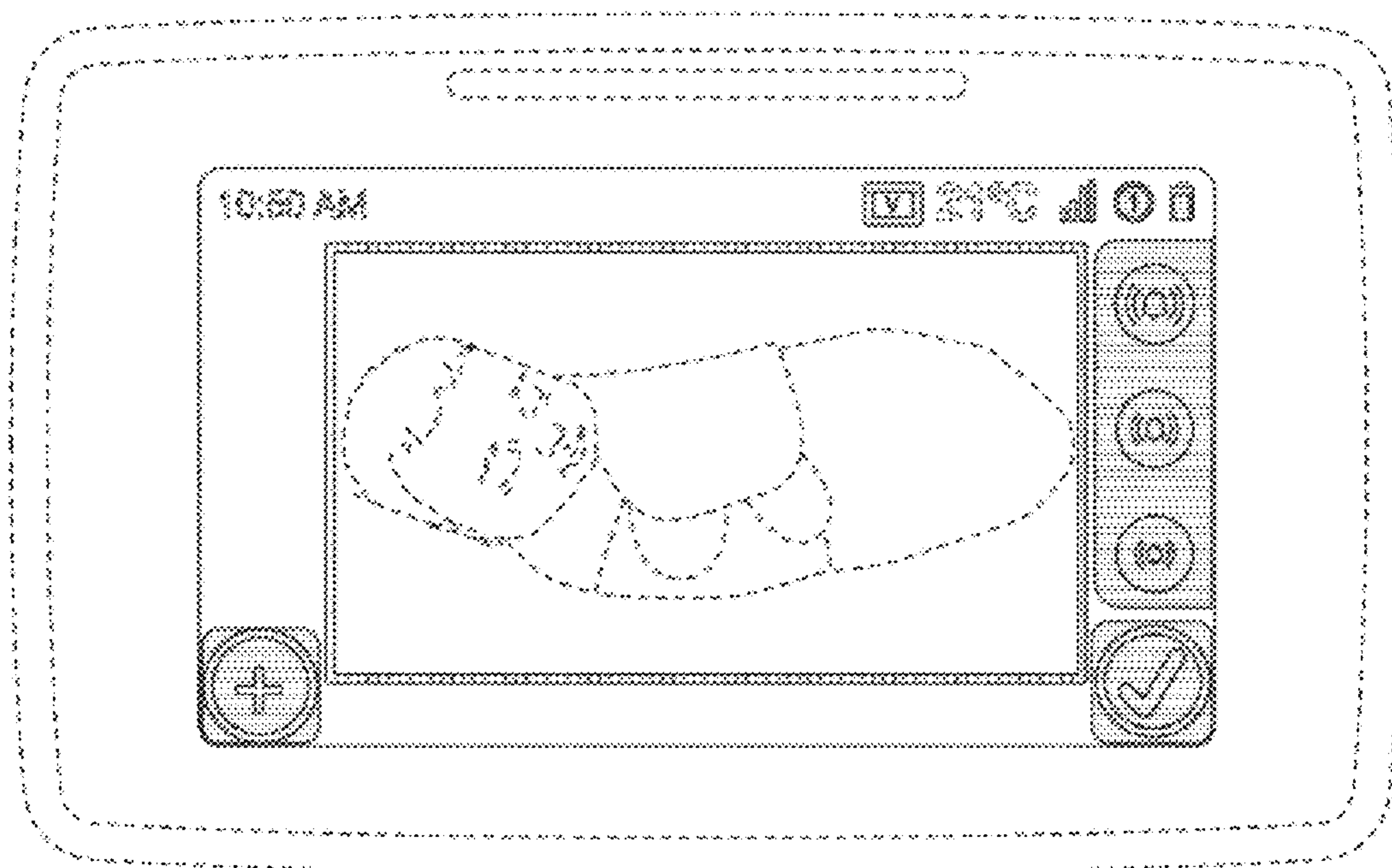

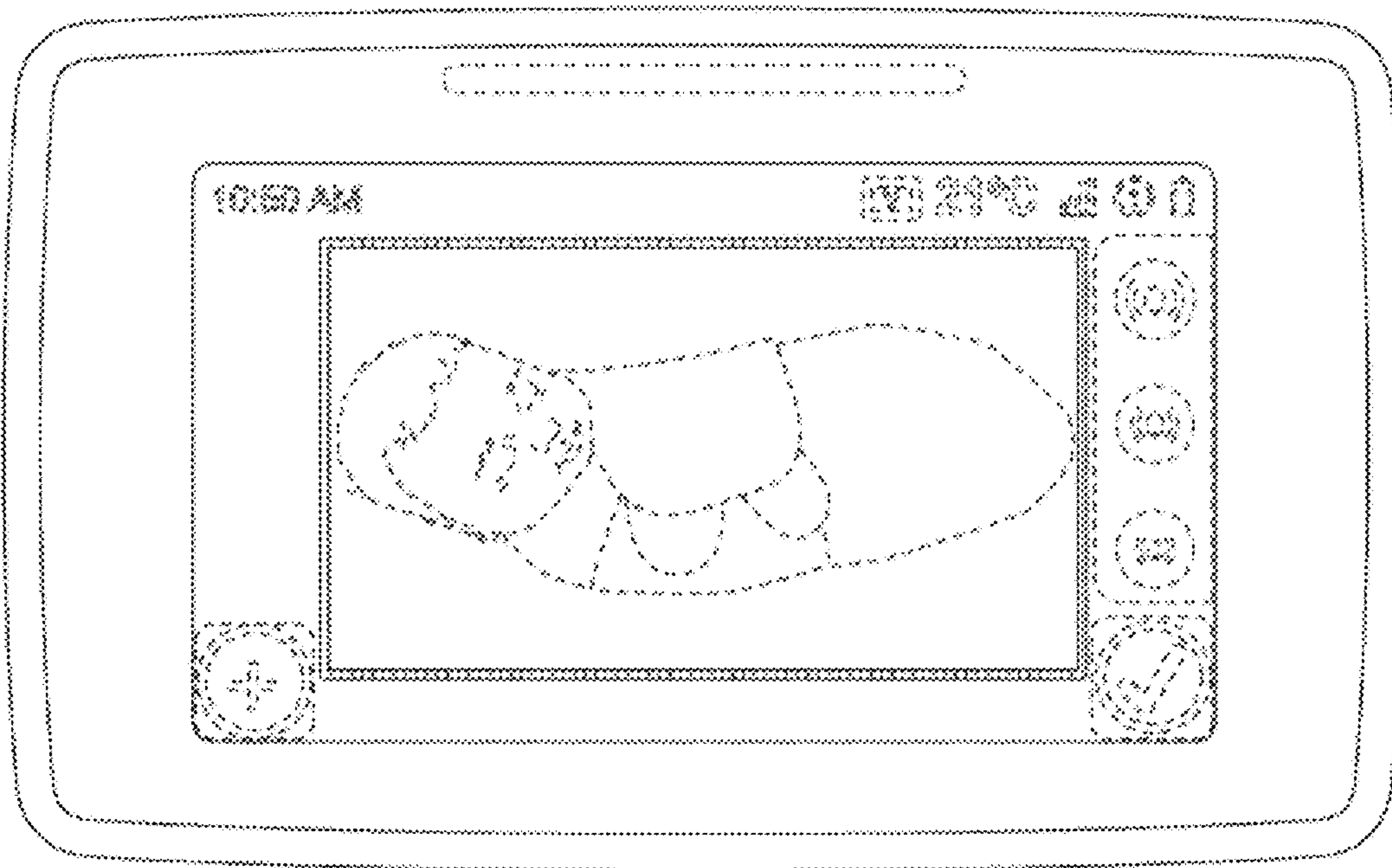

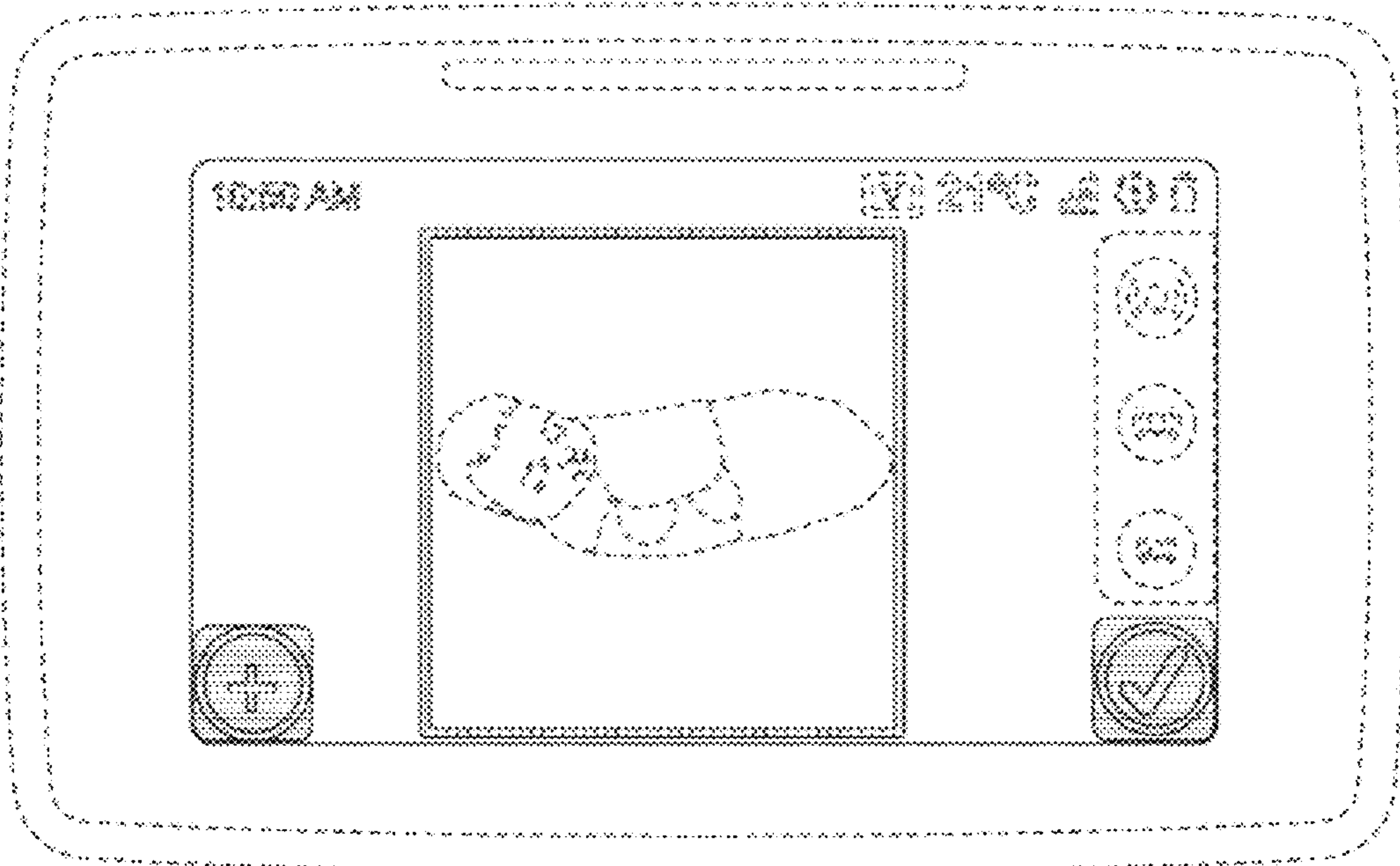

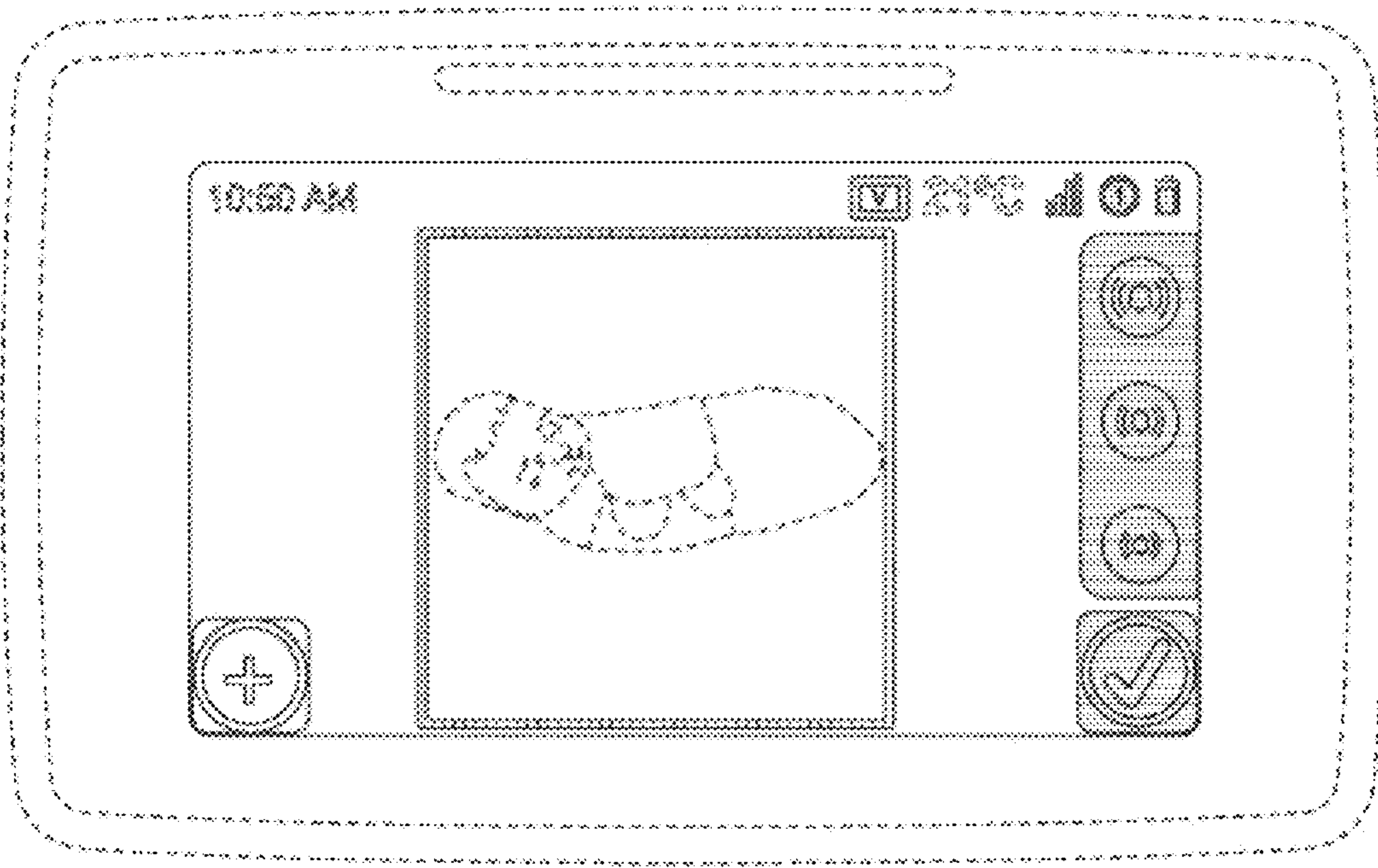

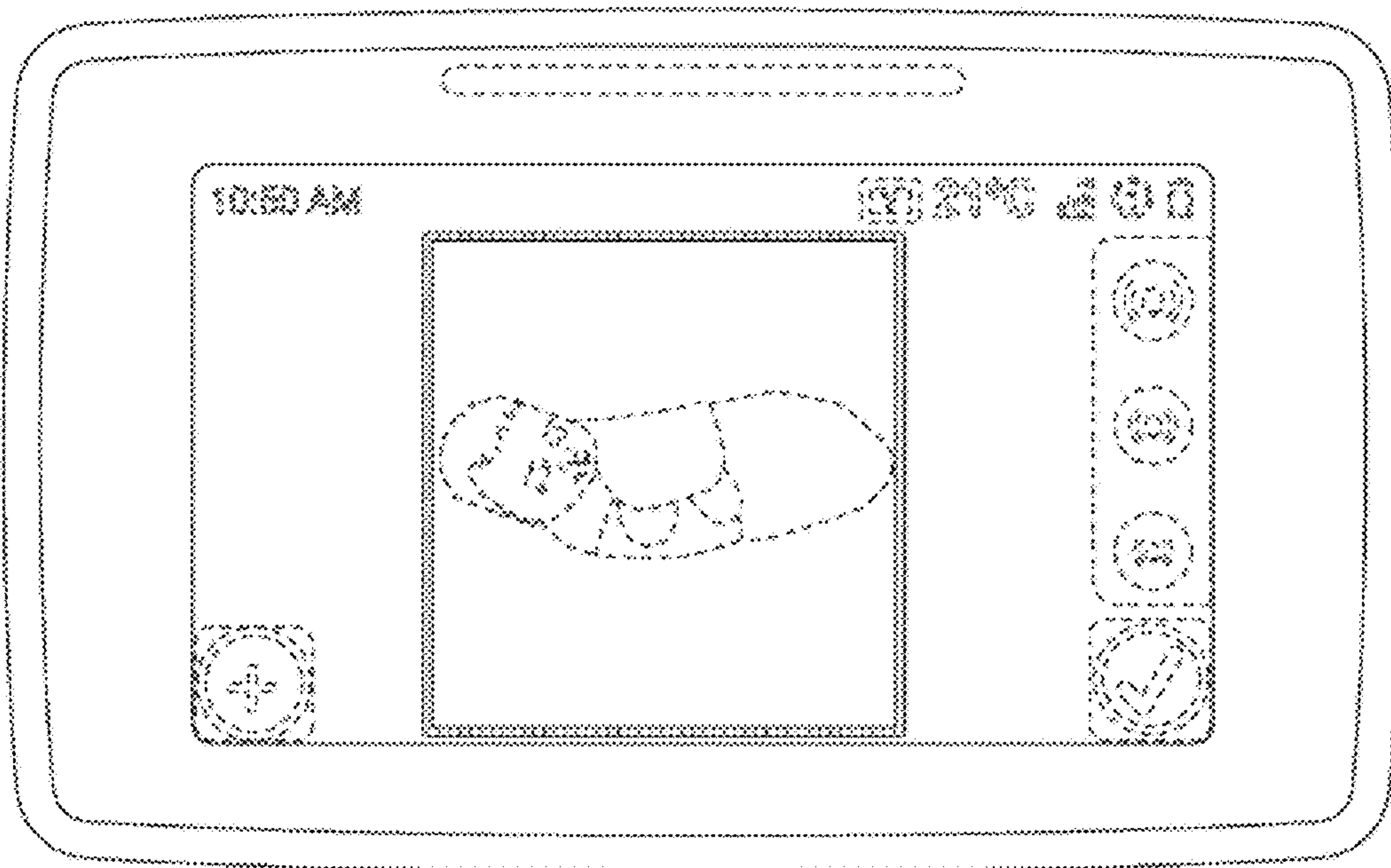

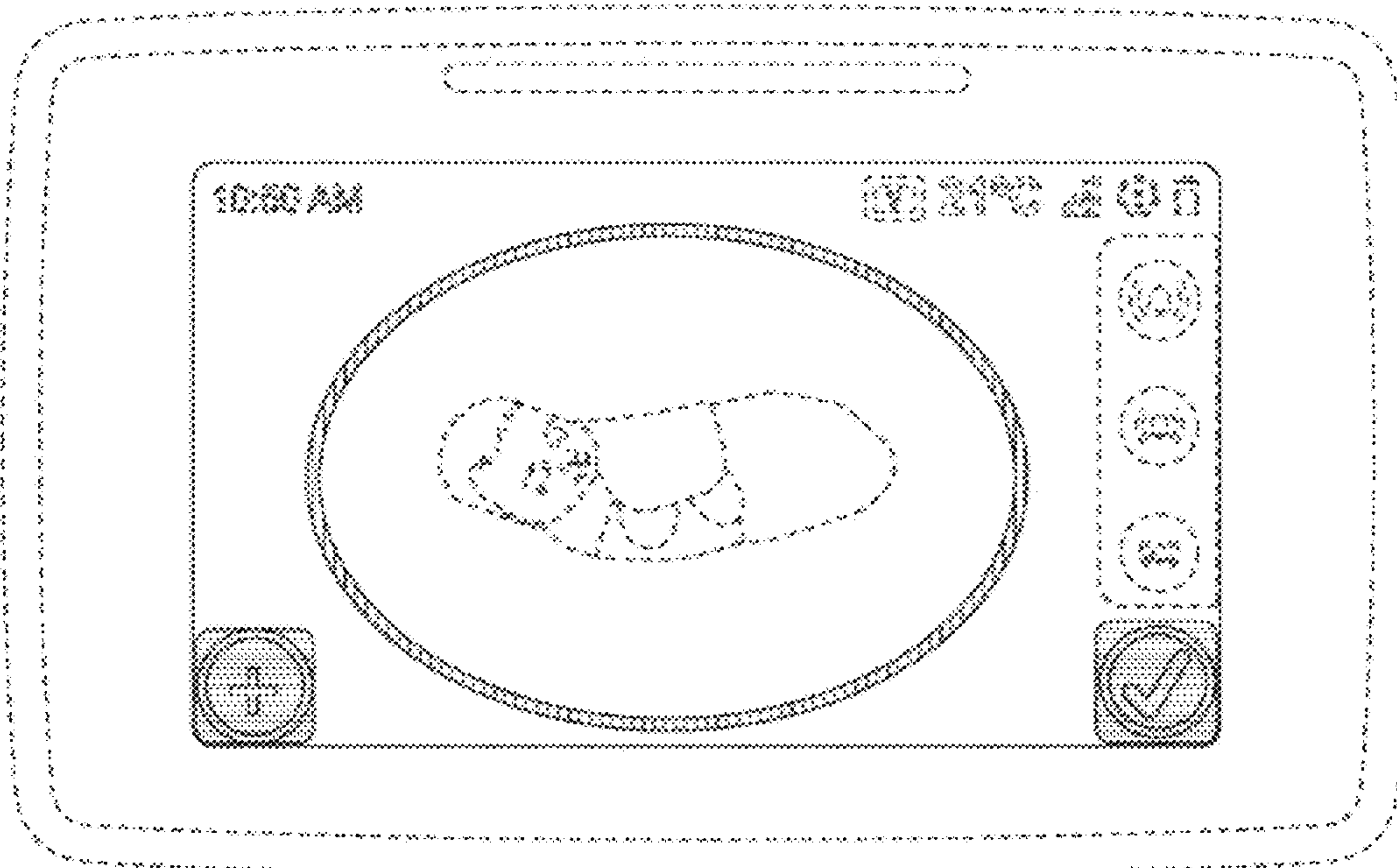

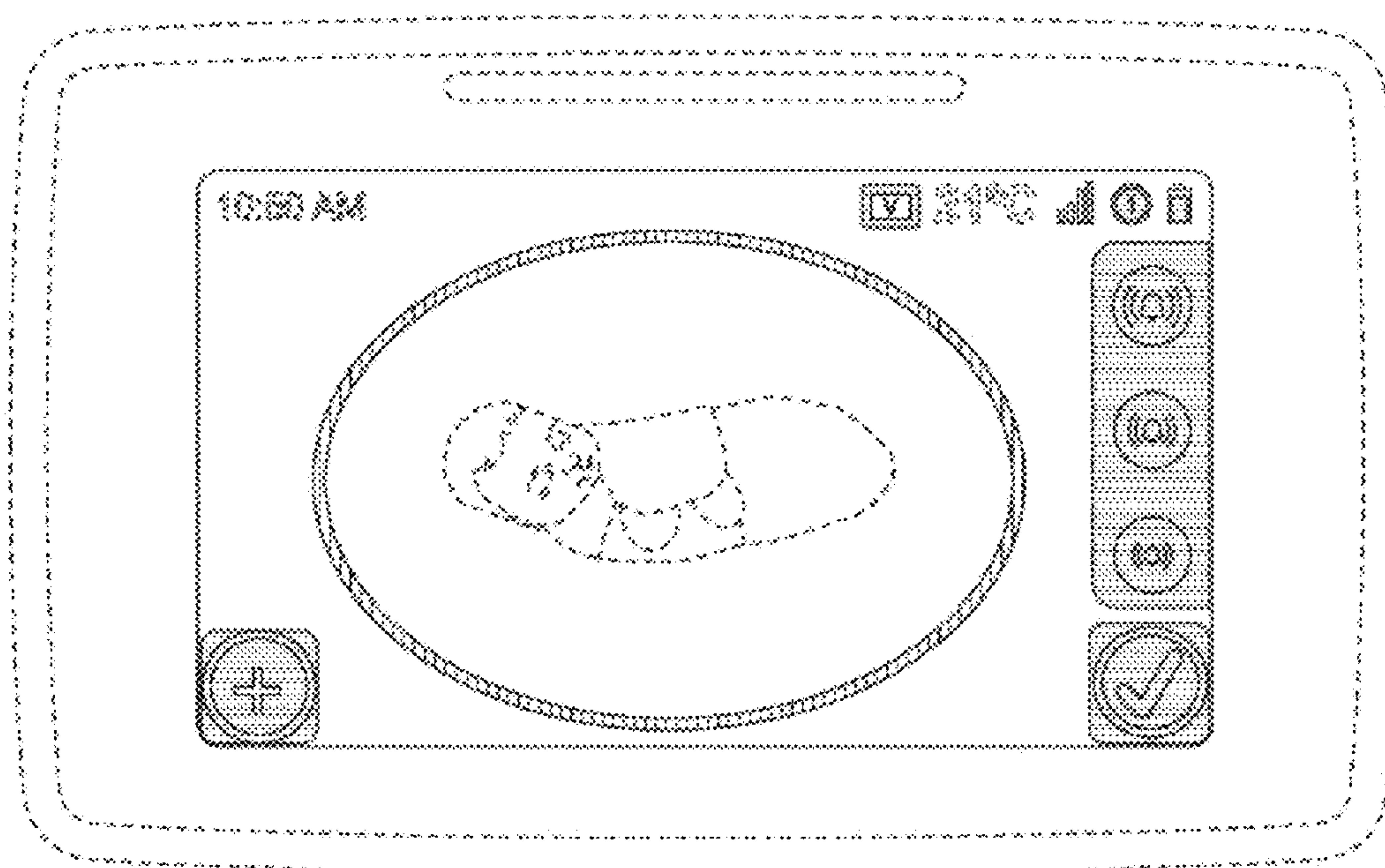

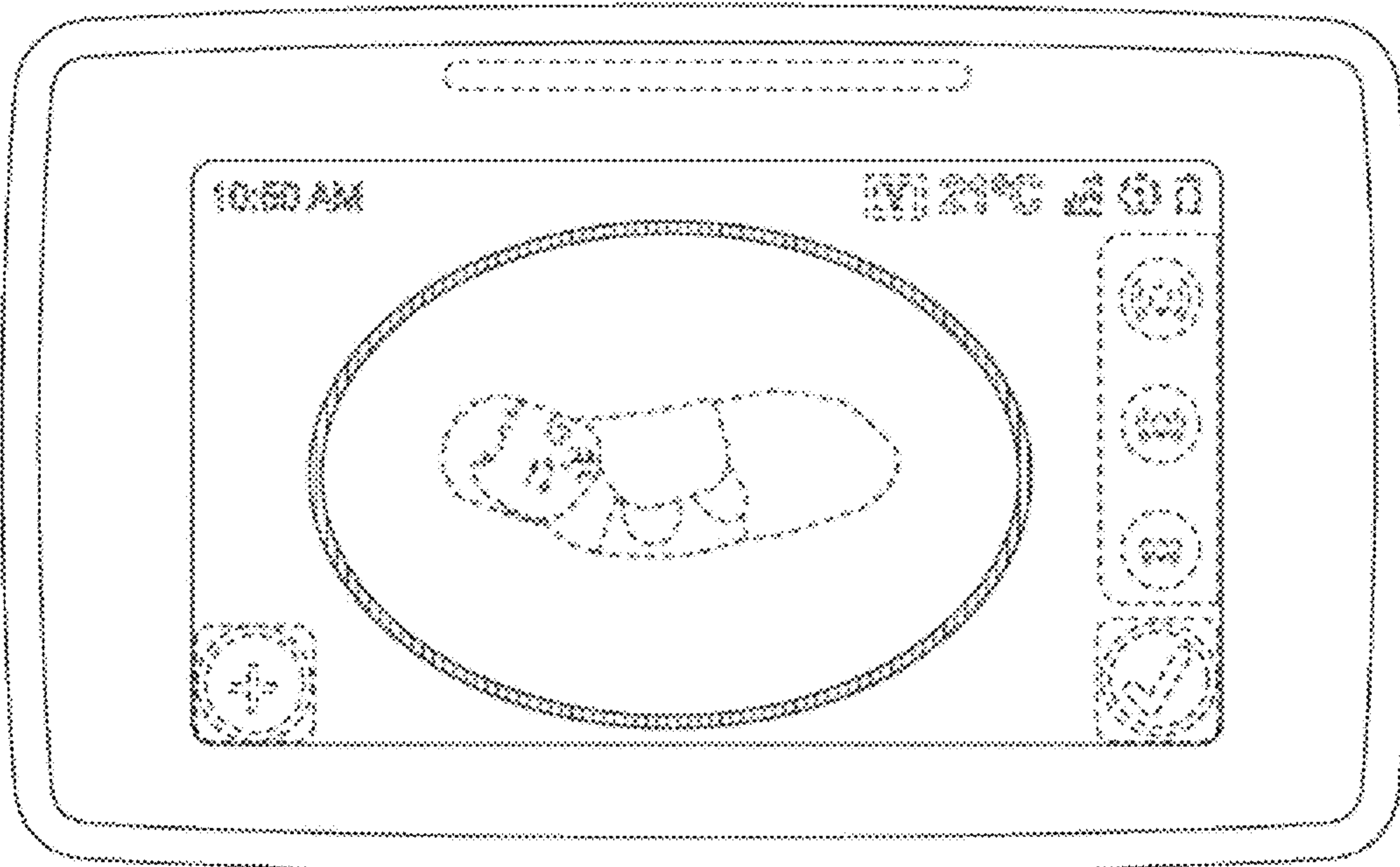

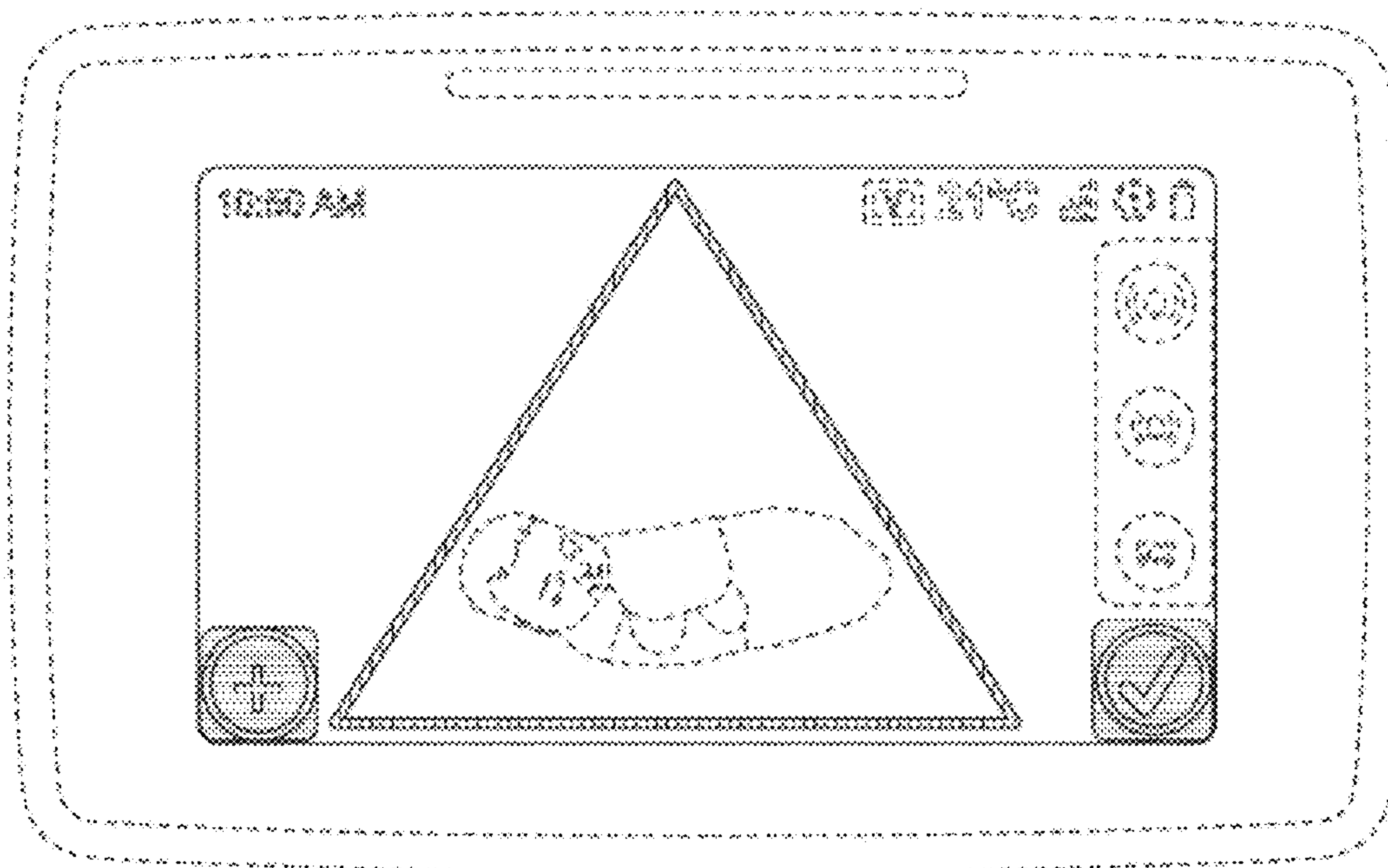

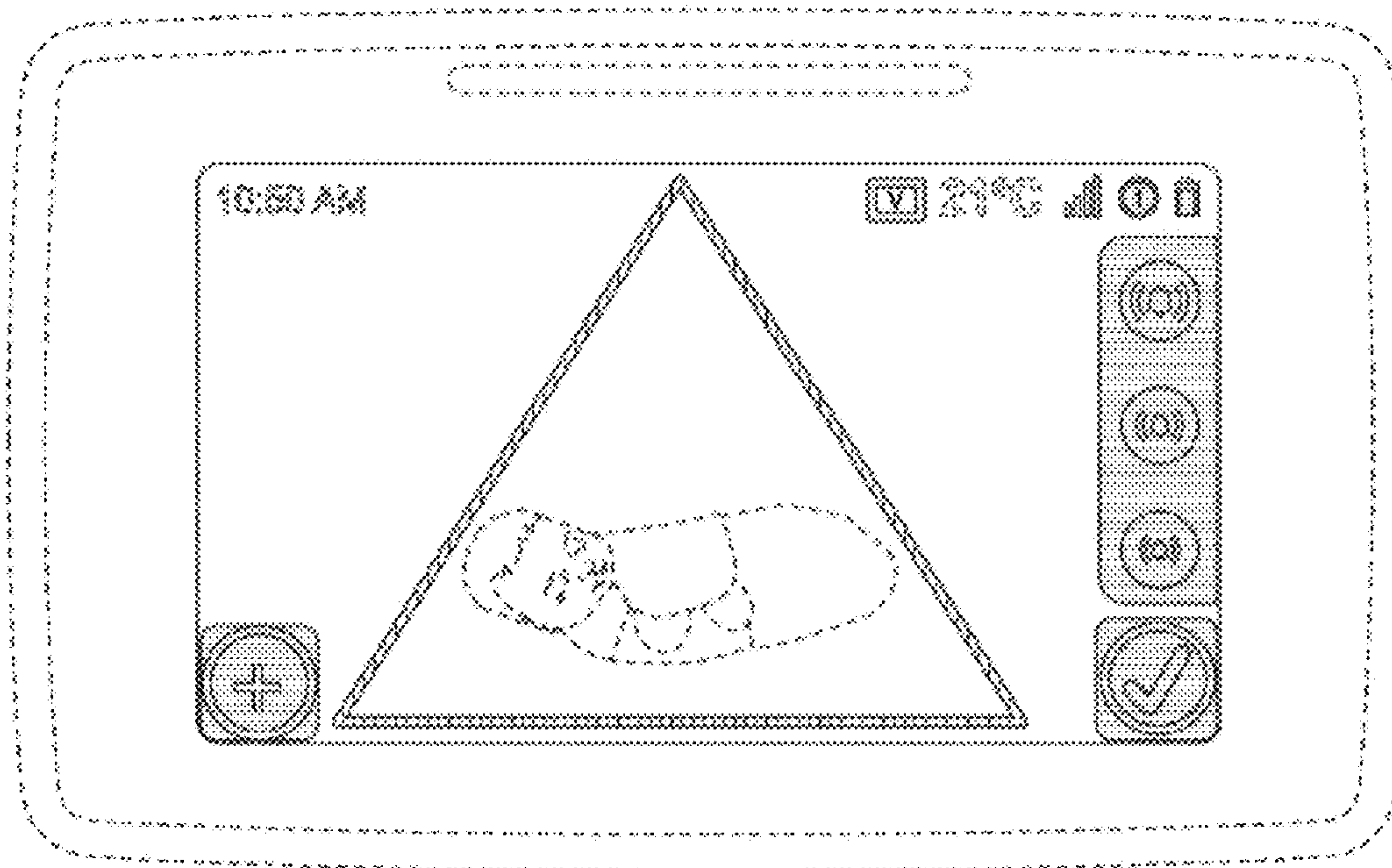

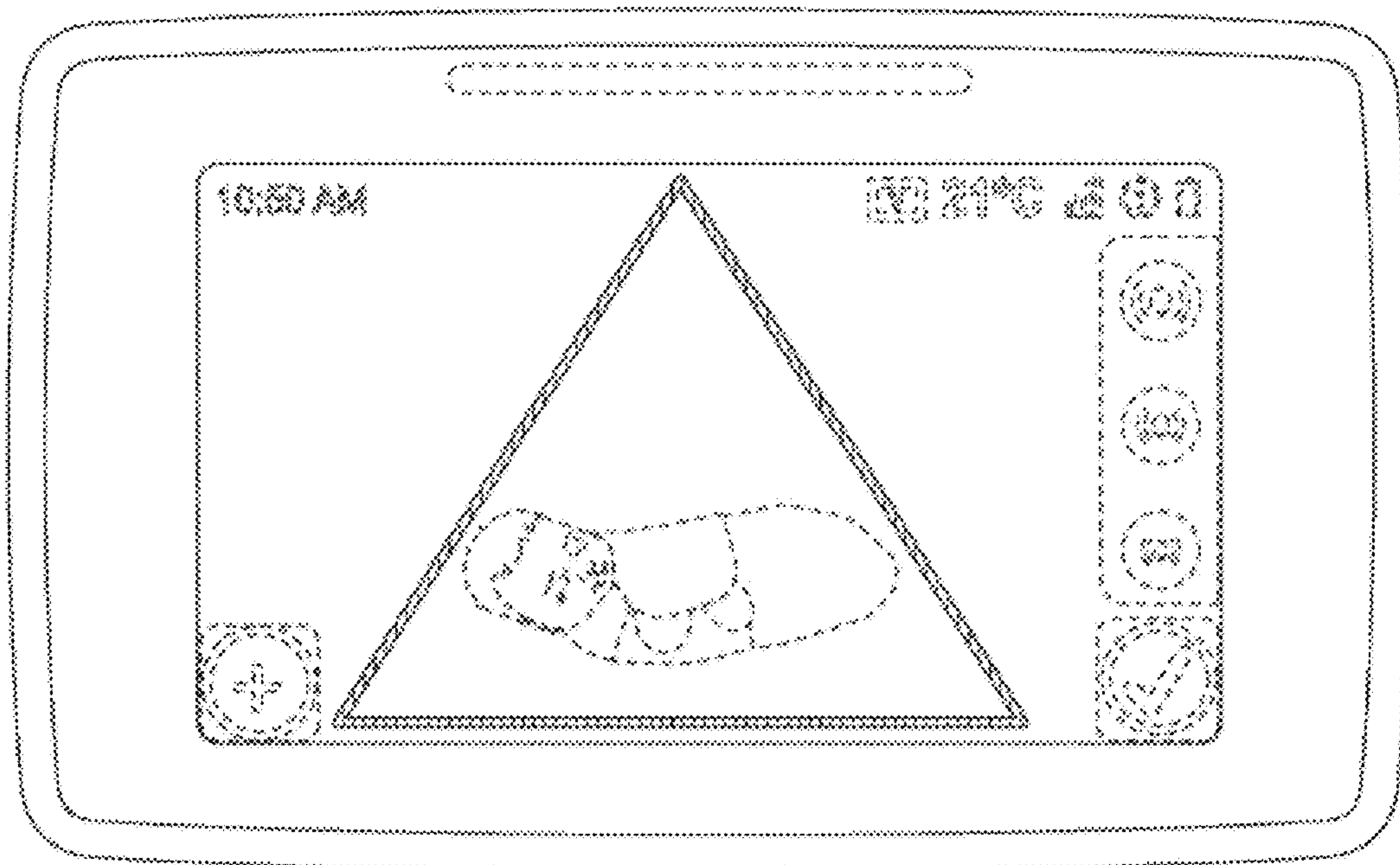

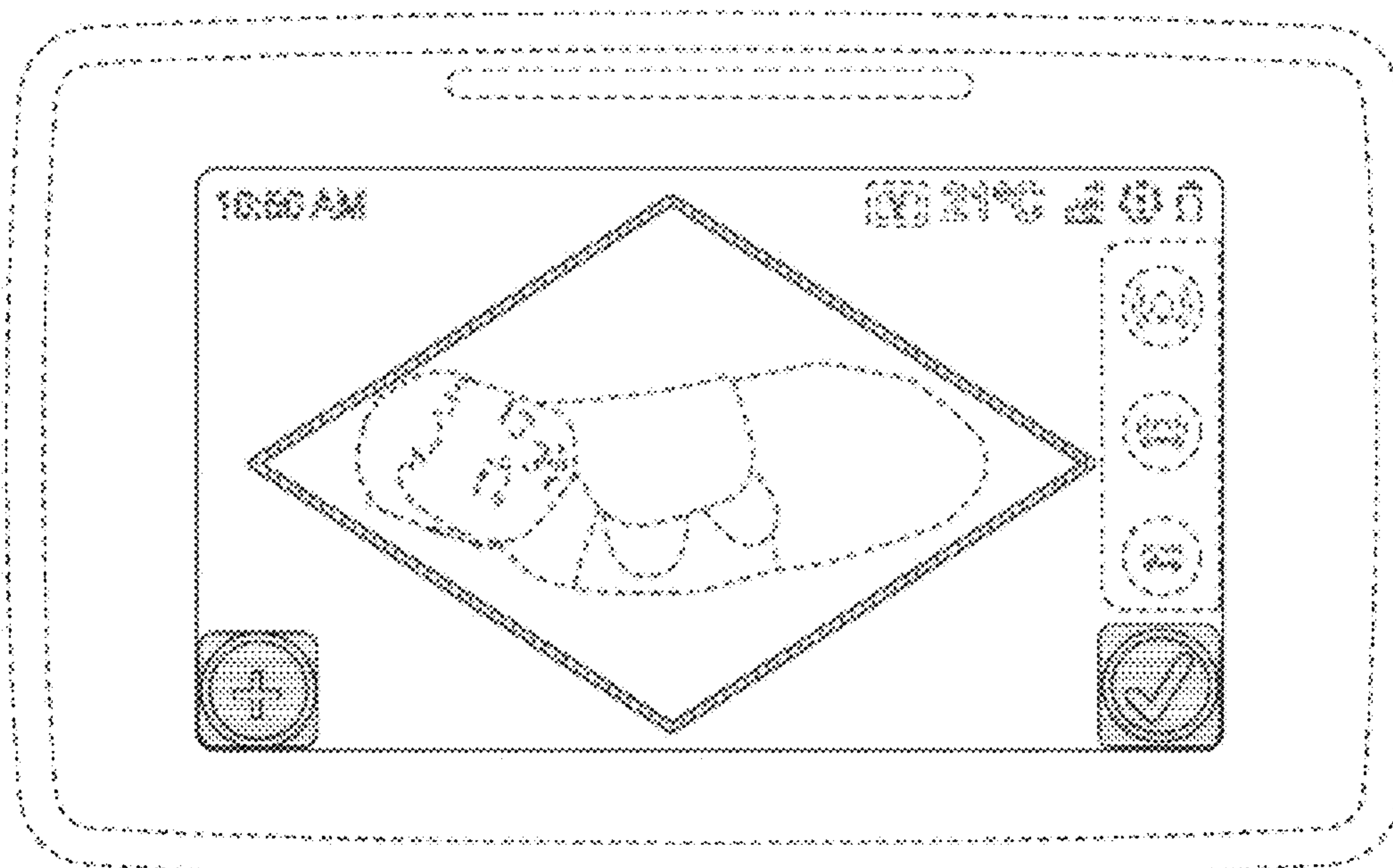

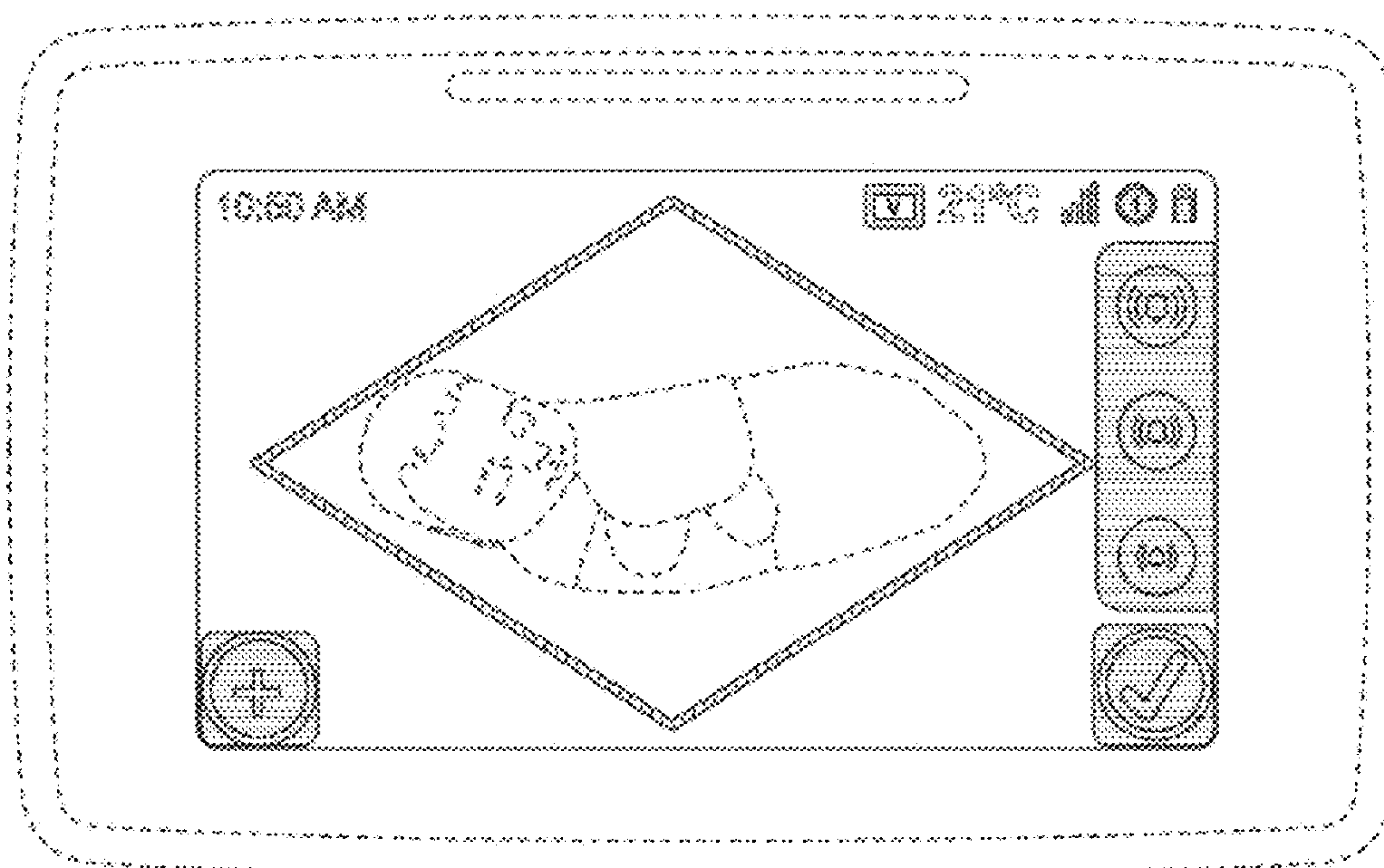

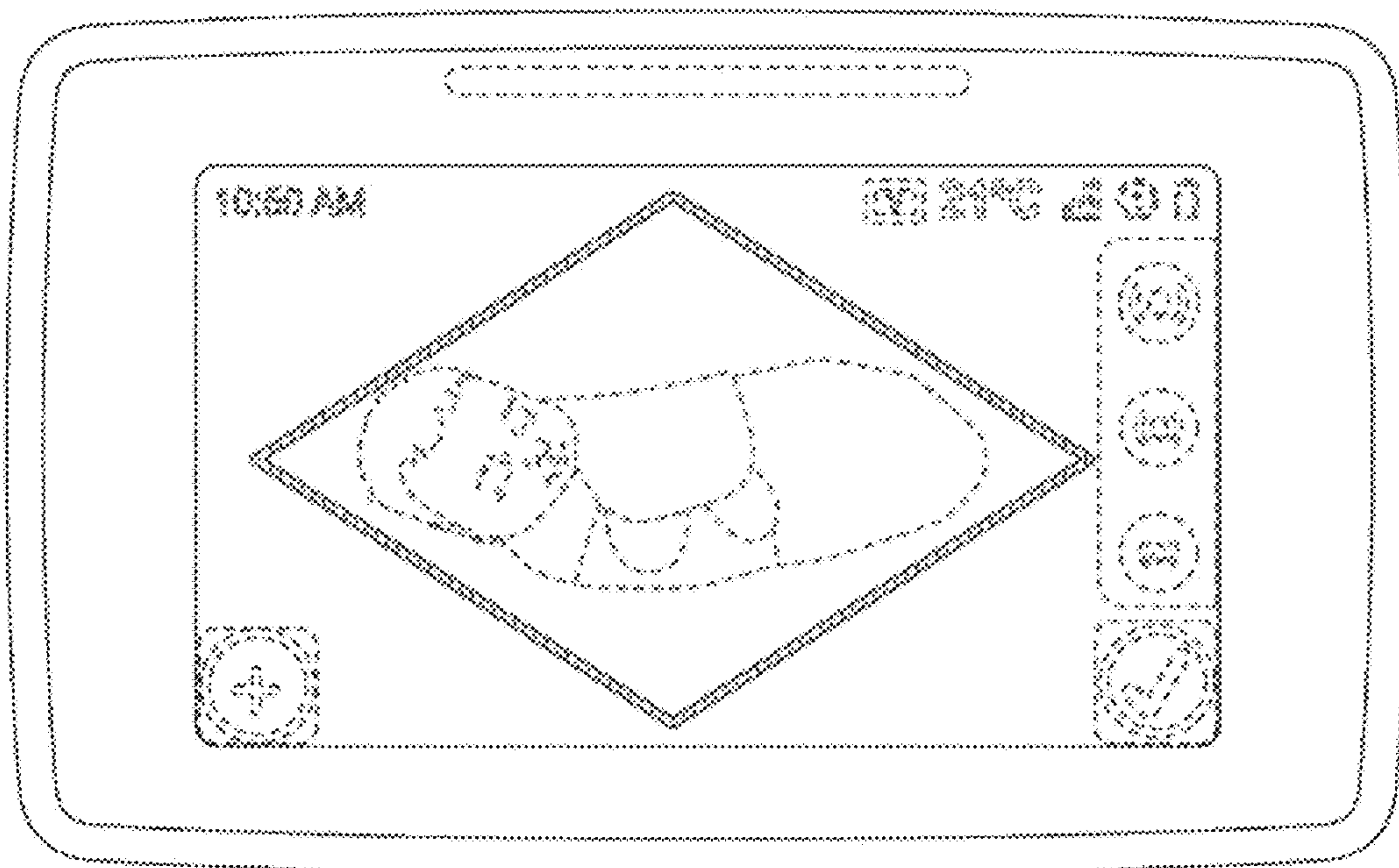
