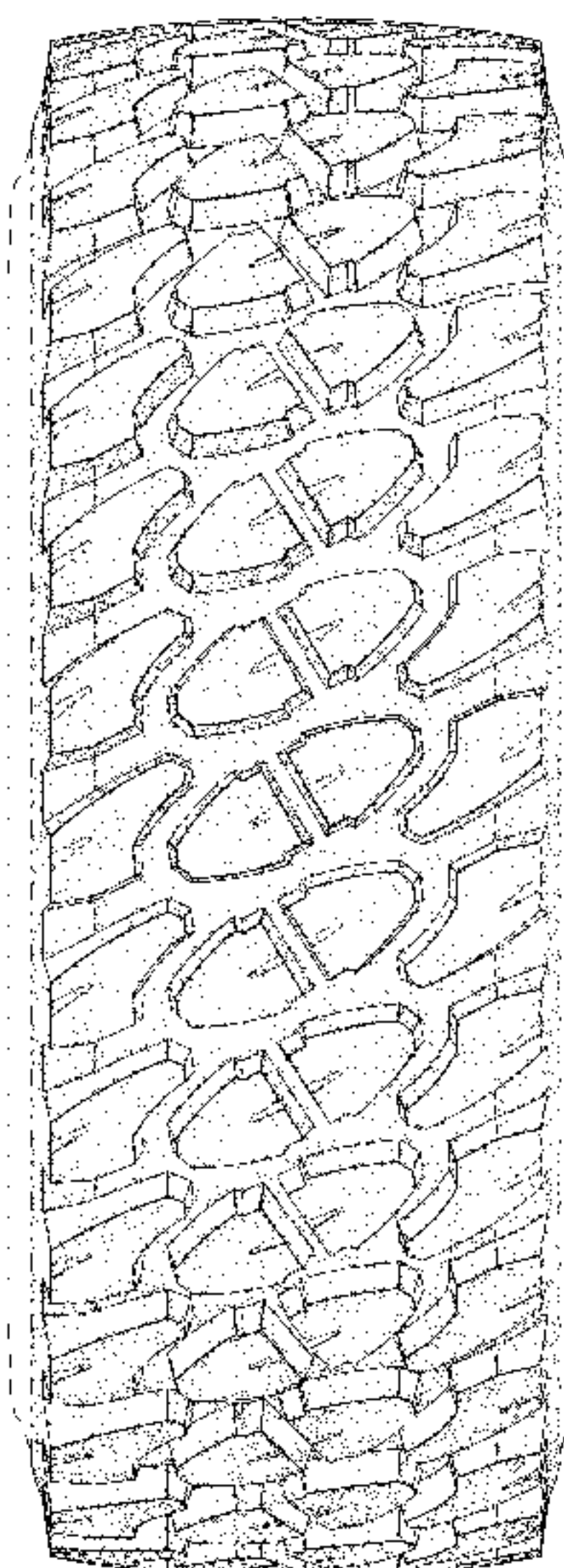
The ornamental design for a tire tread, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the tire tread of our design; FIG. 2 is a front elevation view of the tire tread of our design; FIG. 3 is a side elevation view of the tire tread of our design; FIG. 4 is a side elevation view of the tire tread of our design, taken from the opposite side of that shown in FIG. 3; and, FIG. 5 is an enlarged, partial view of the tire tread of FIG. 1, as indicated by the break lines.

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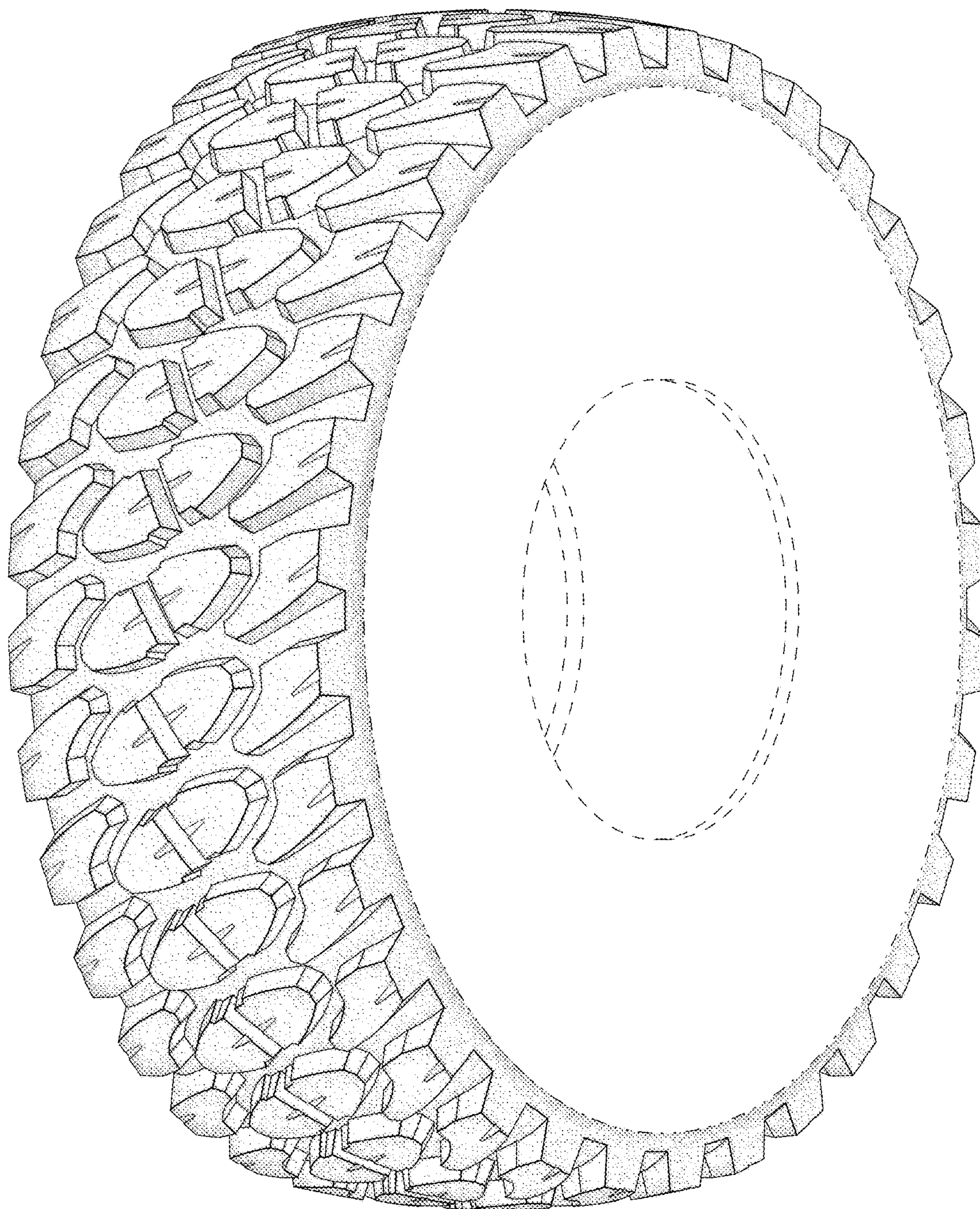

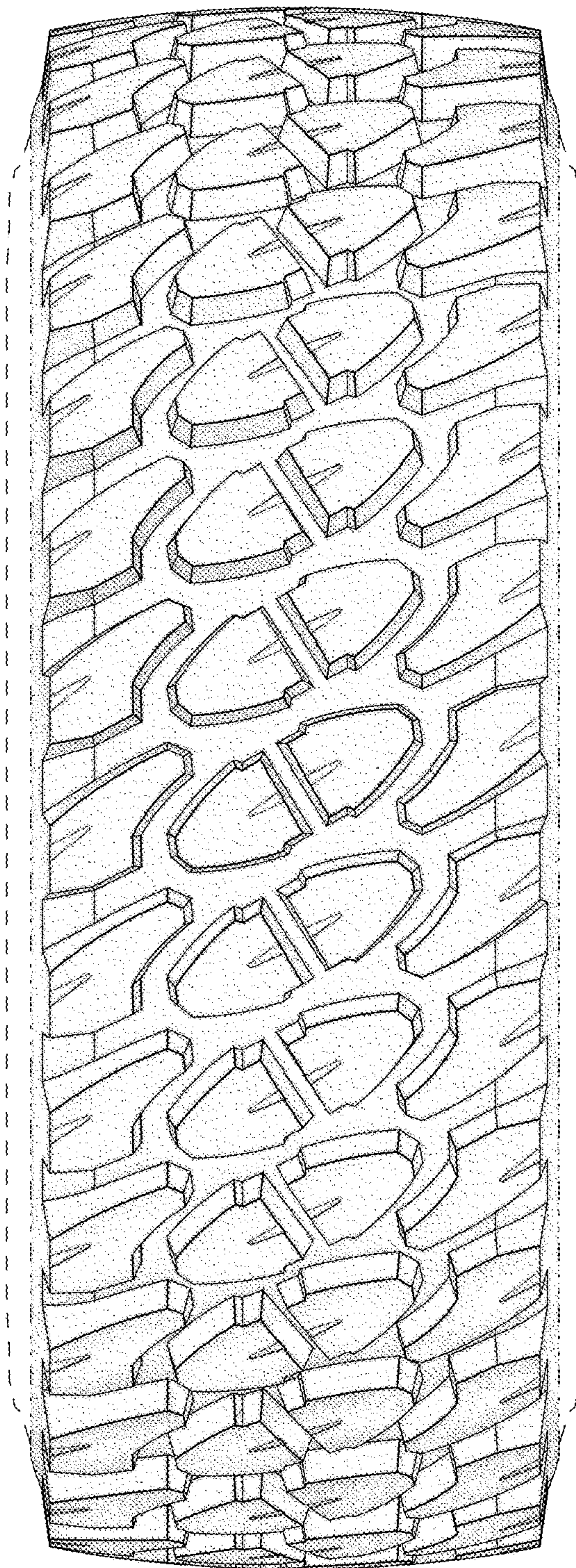

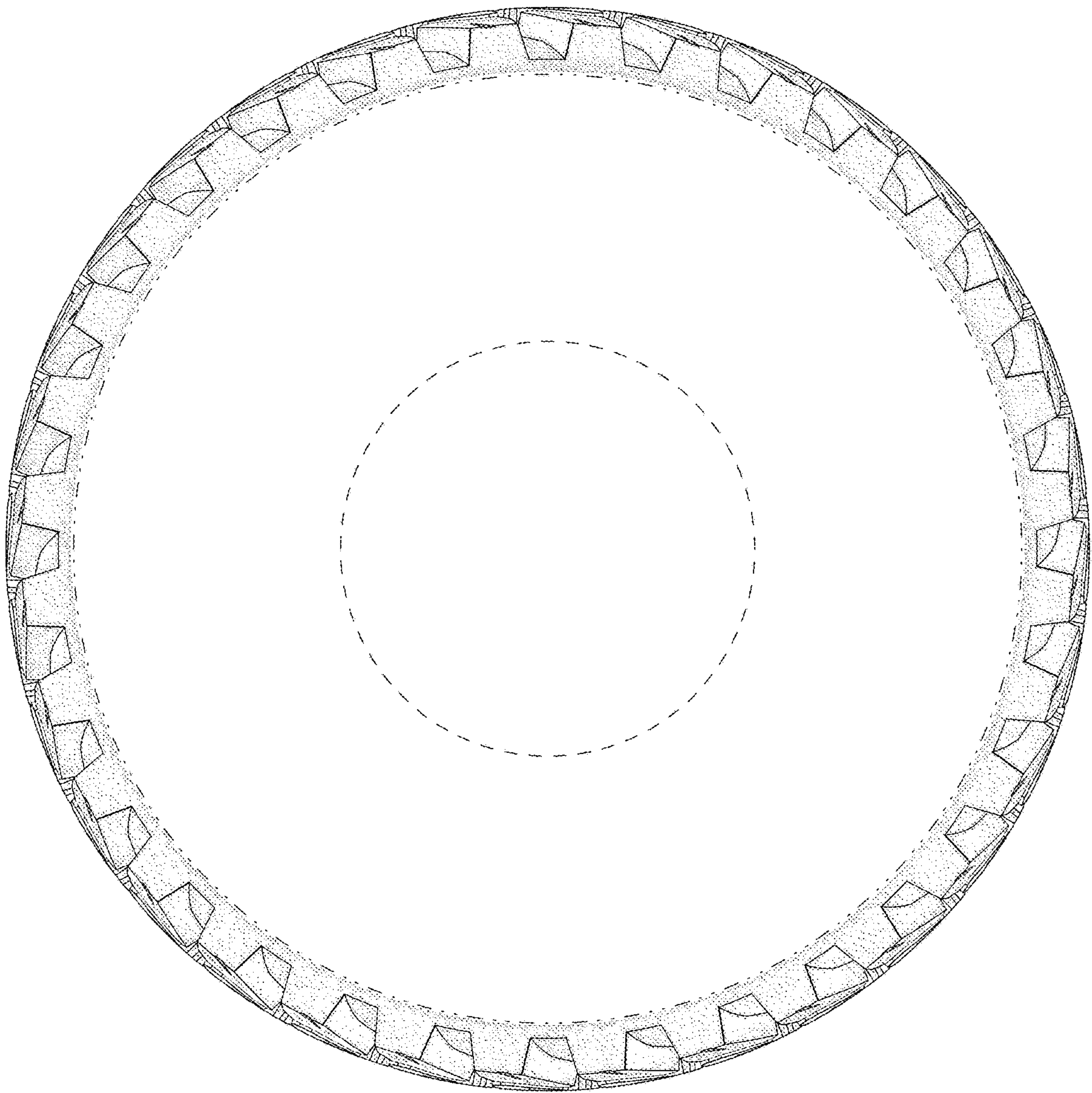

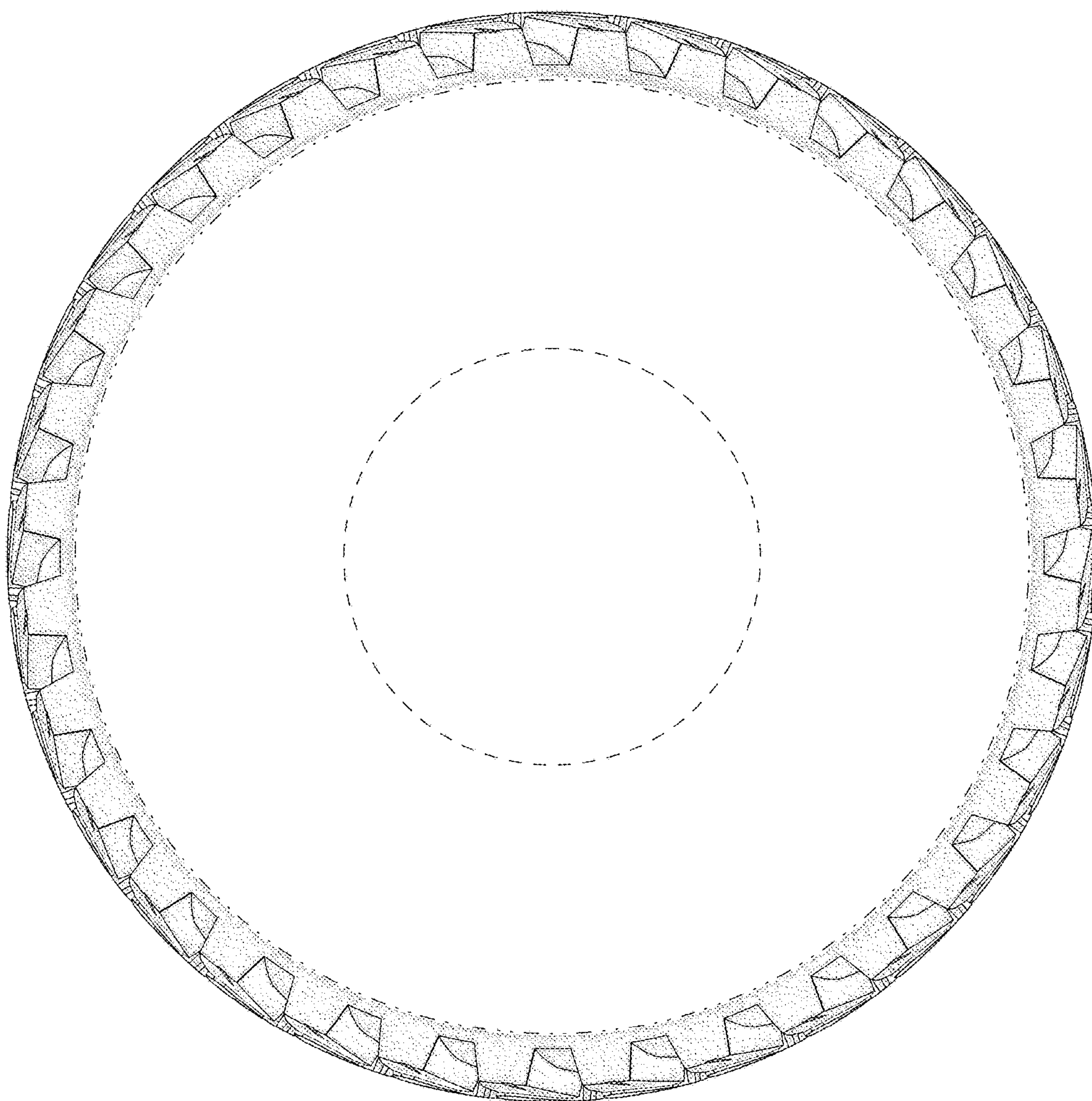

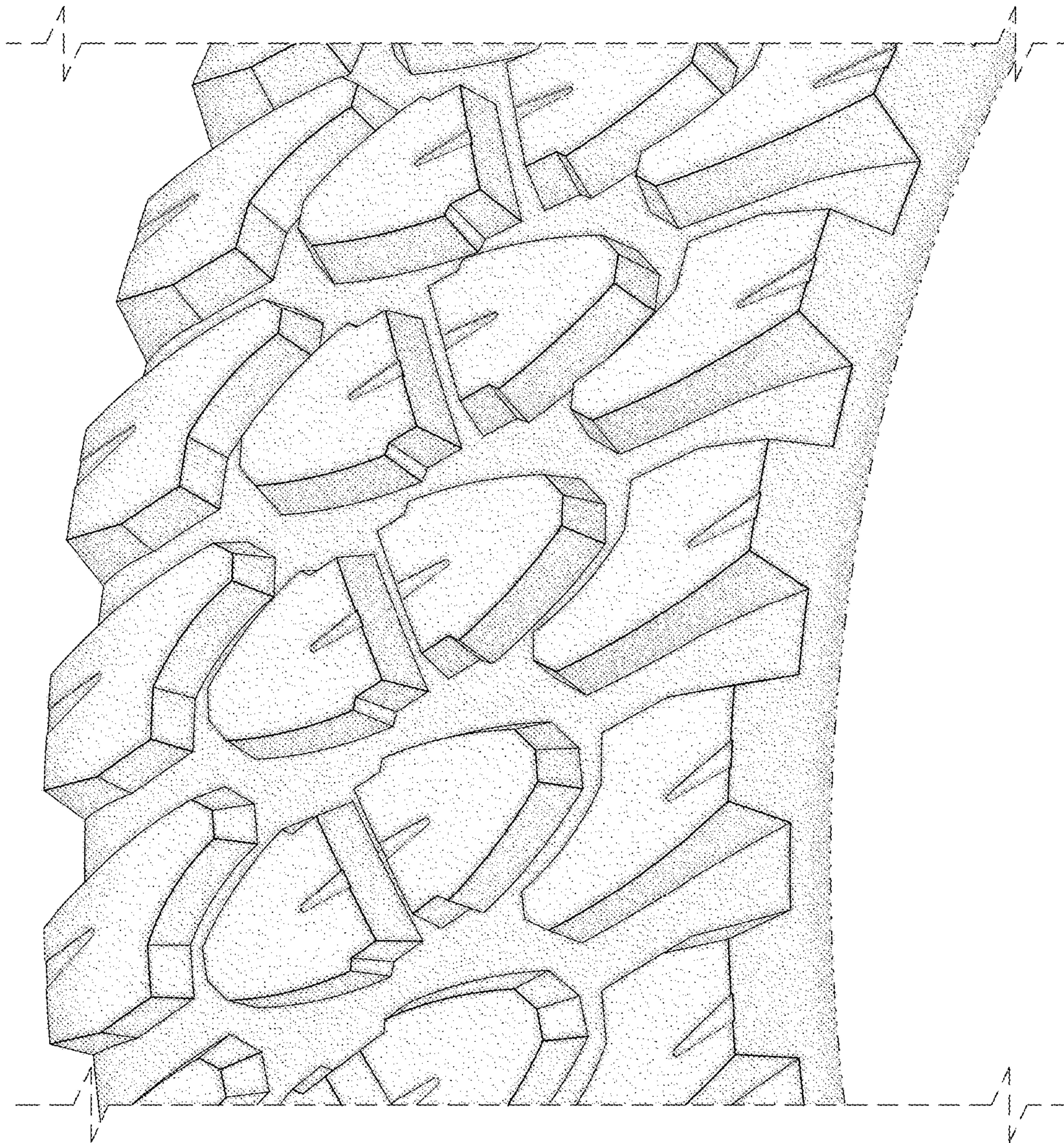
