claimed design.

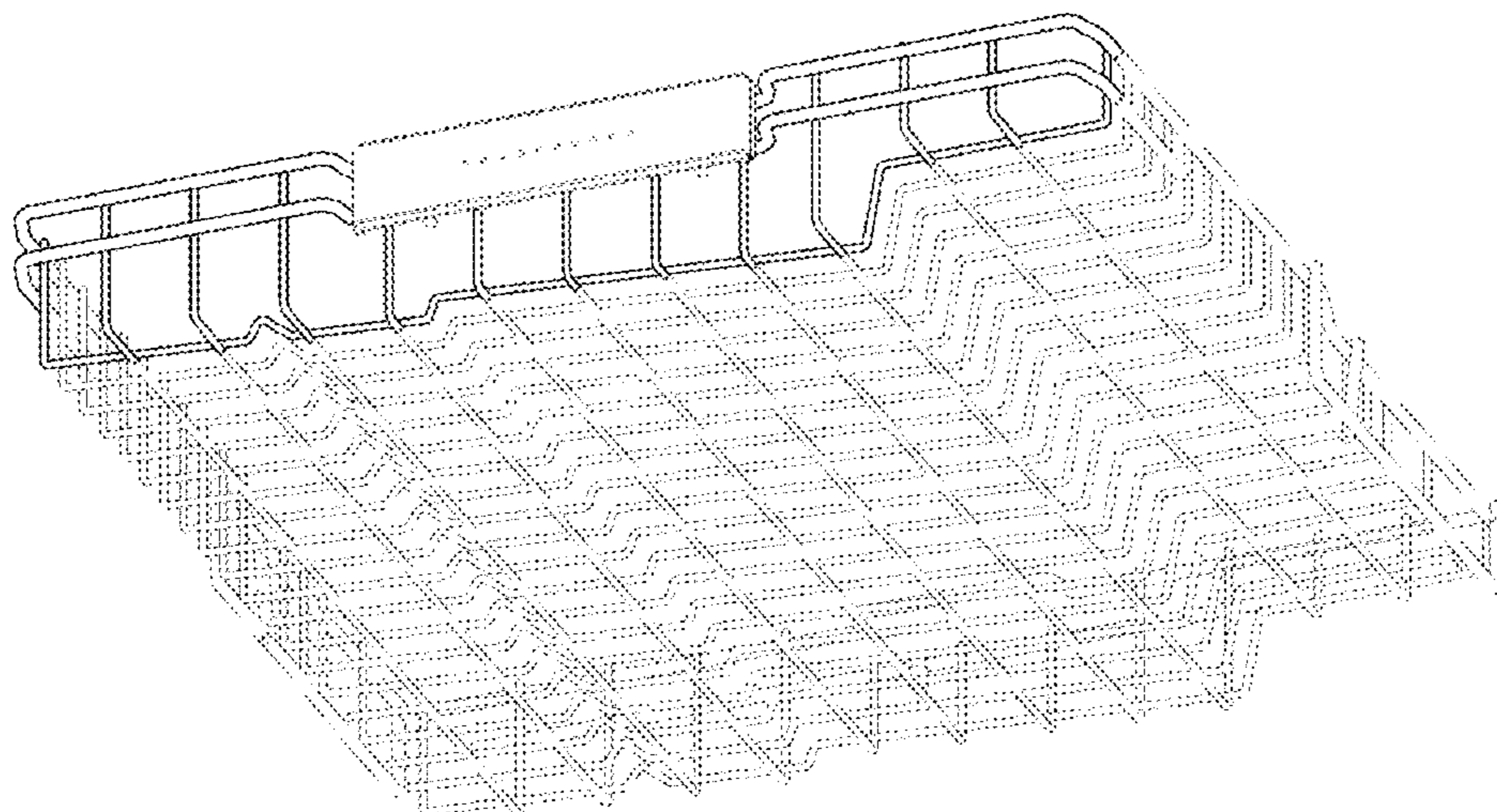

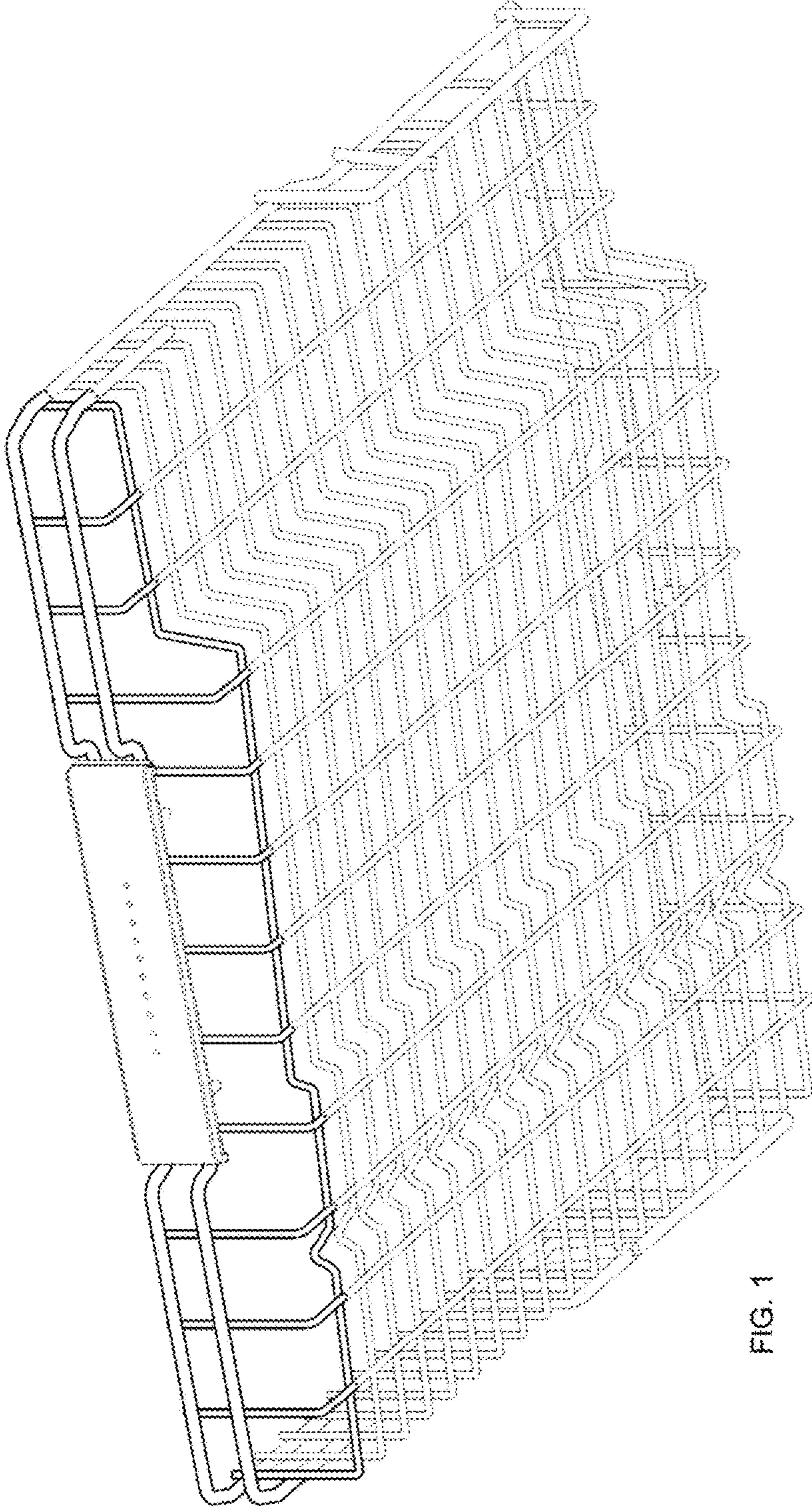

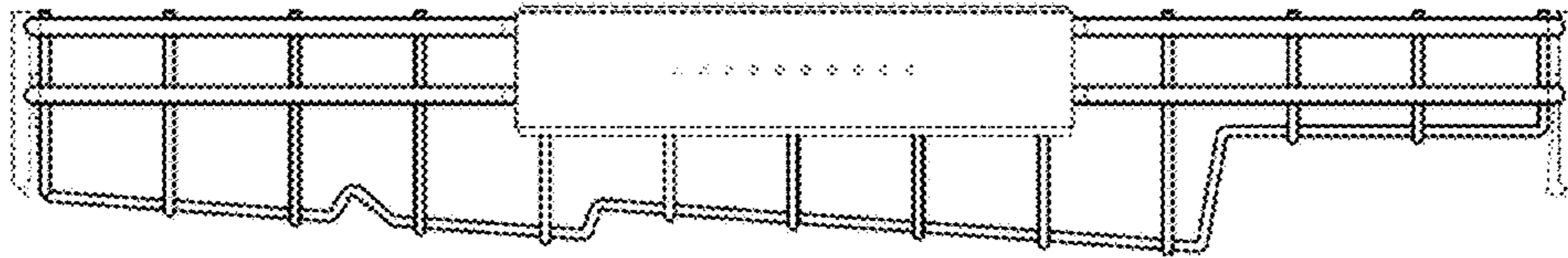

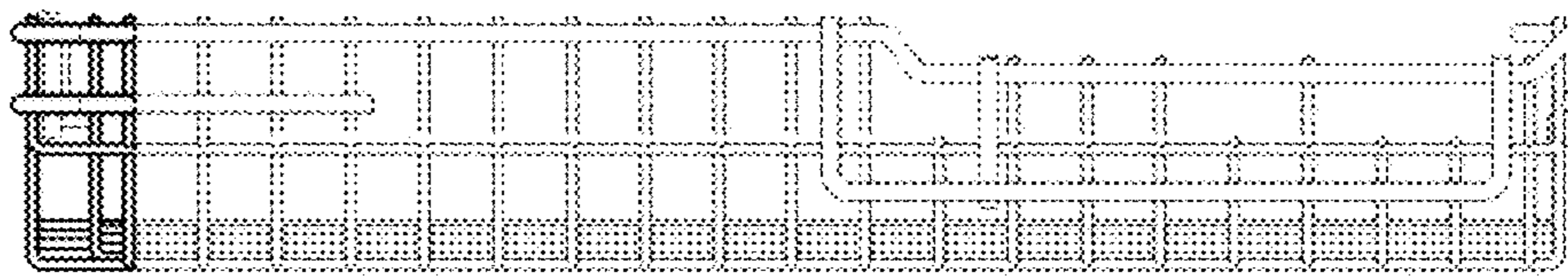

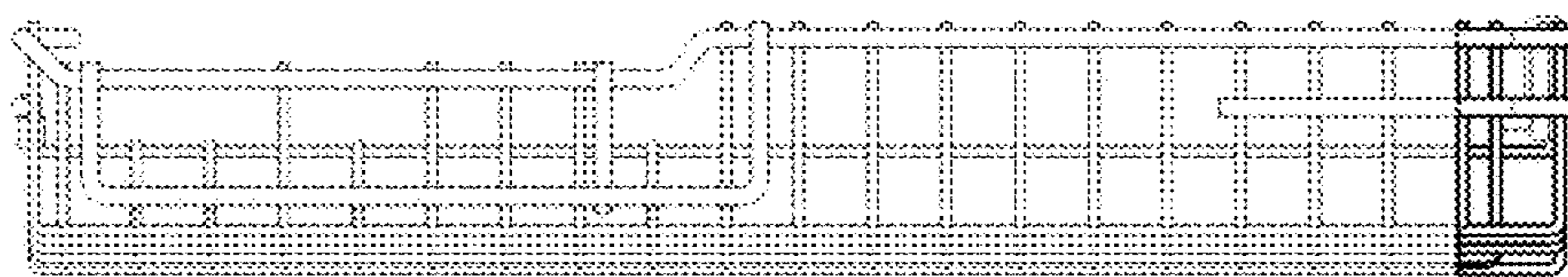

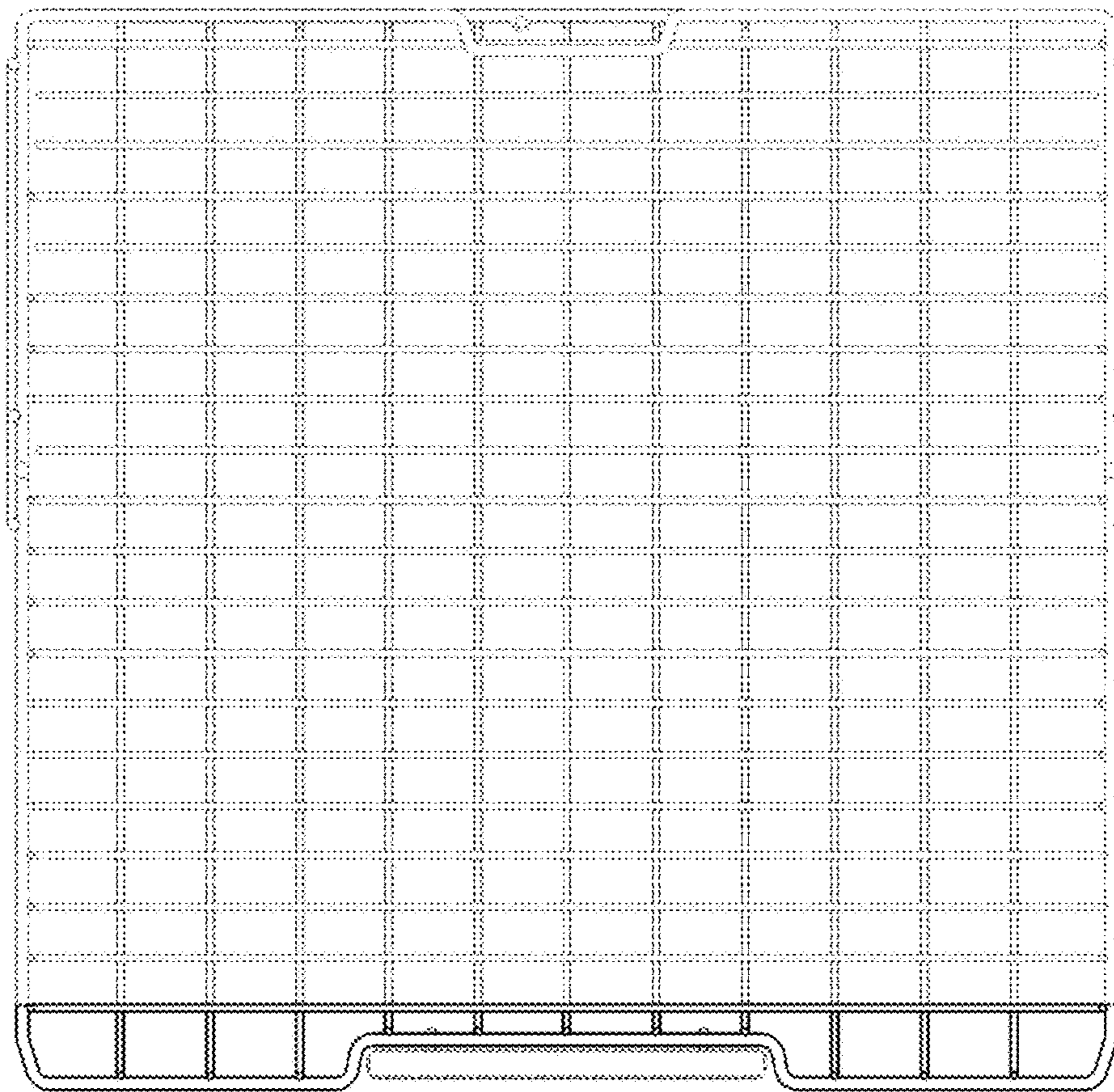

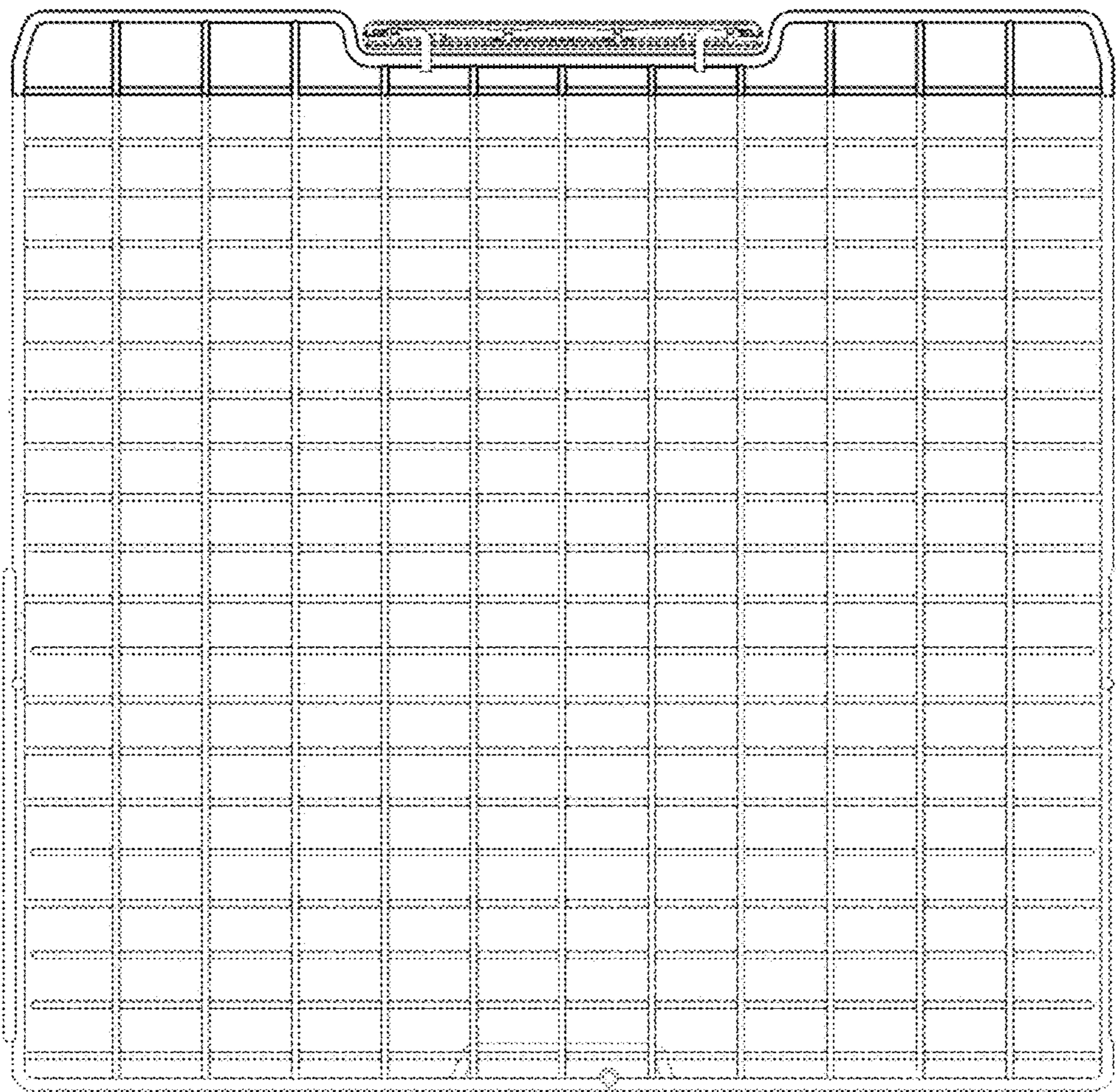
