The ornamental design for a motorcycle chaps with leopard pattern, as shown and described.

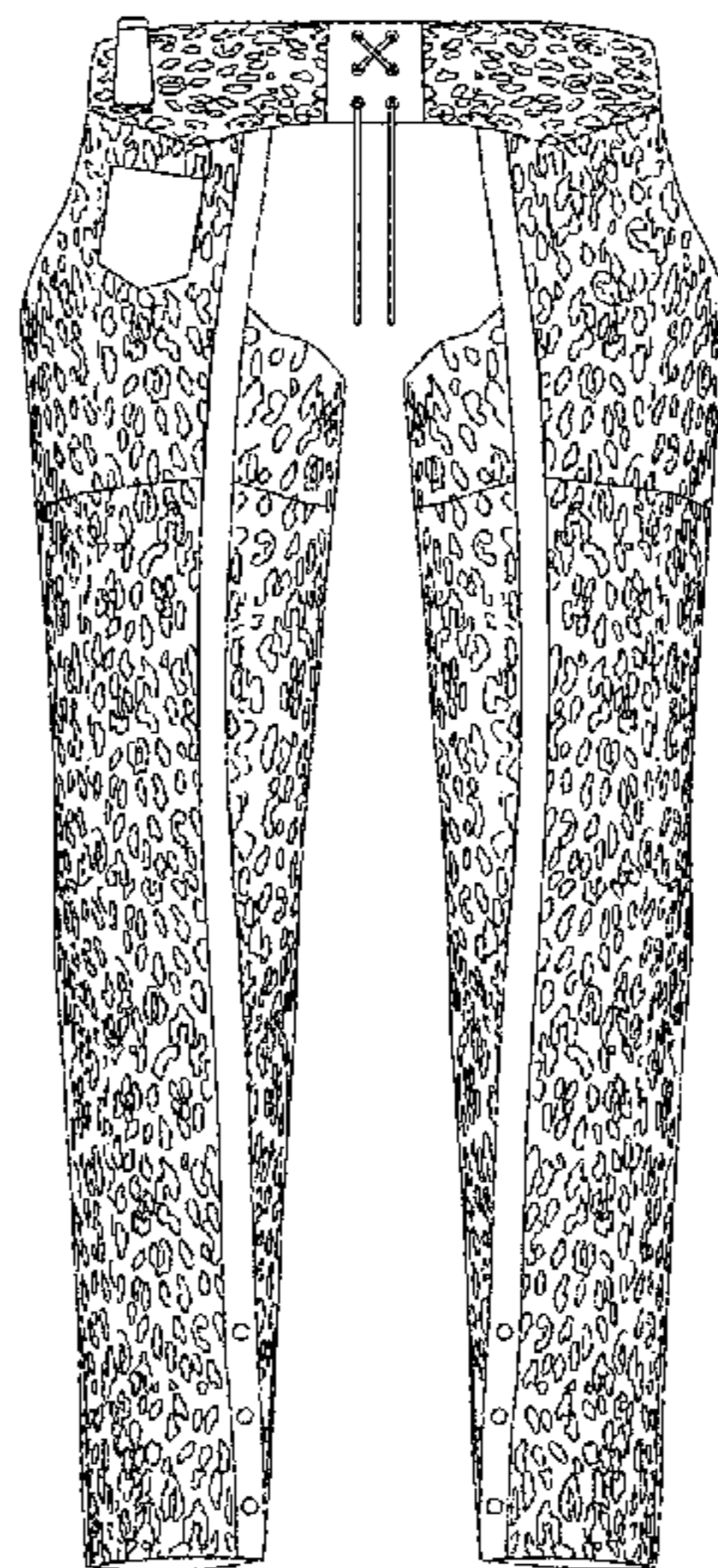
**DESCRIPTION**

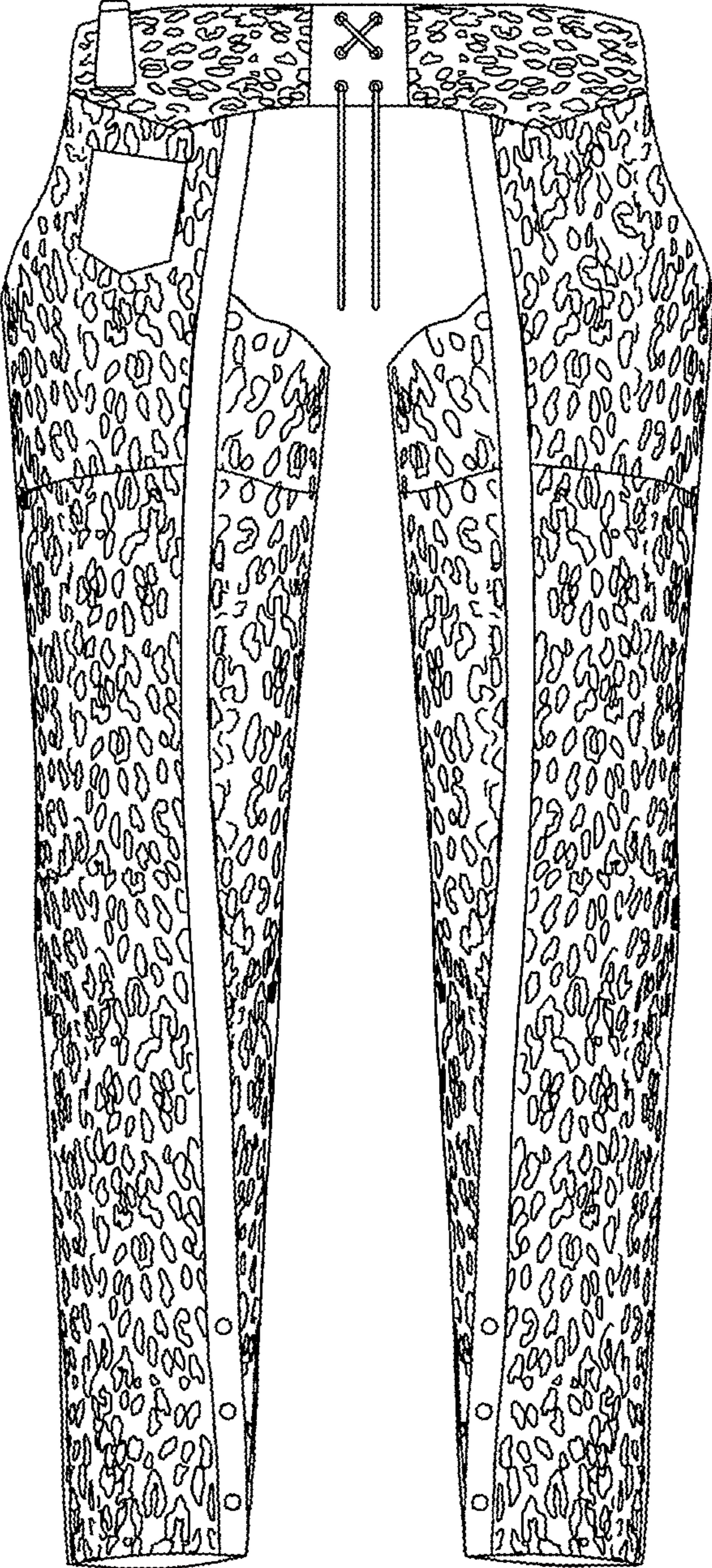

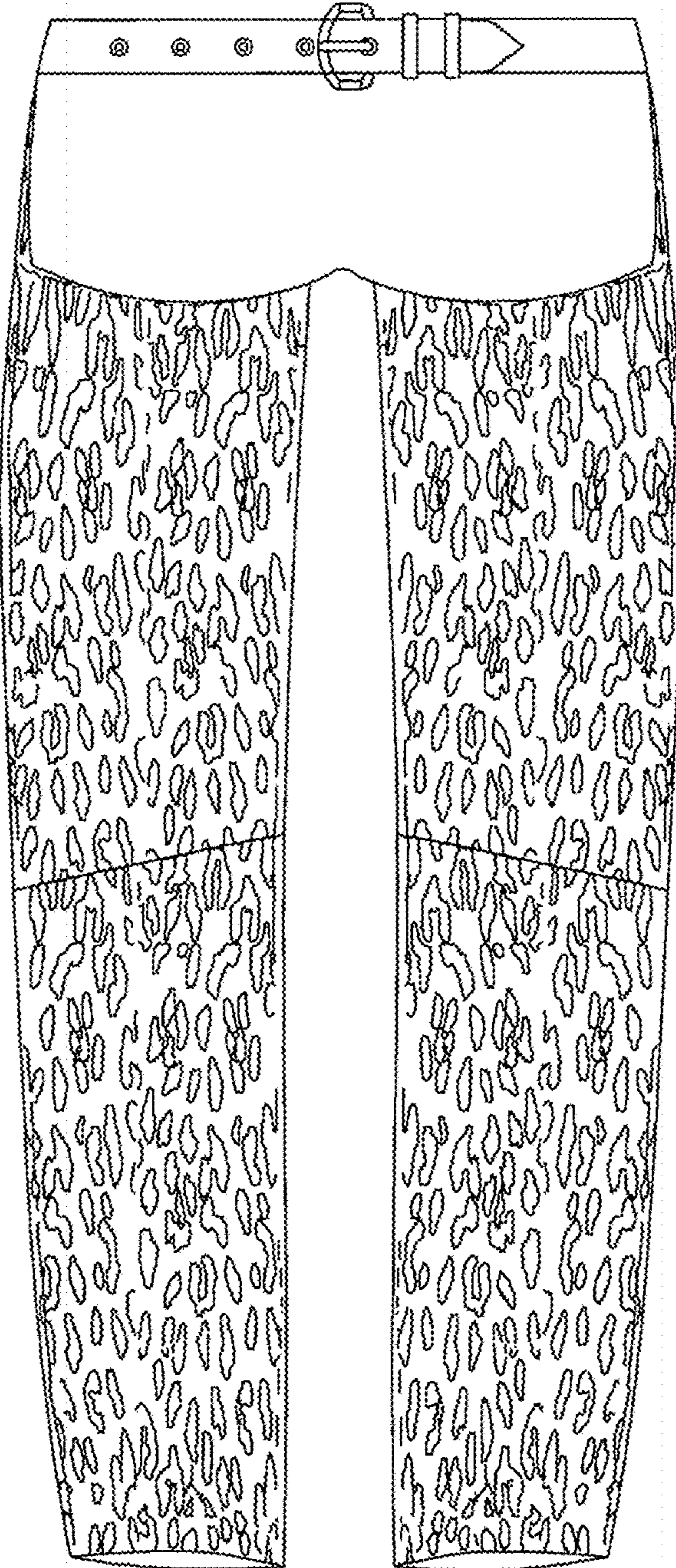

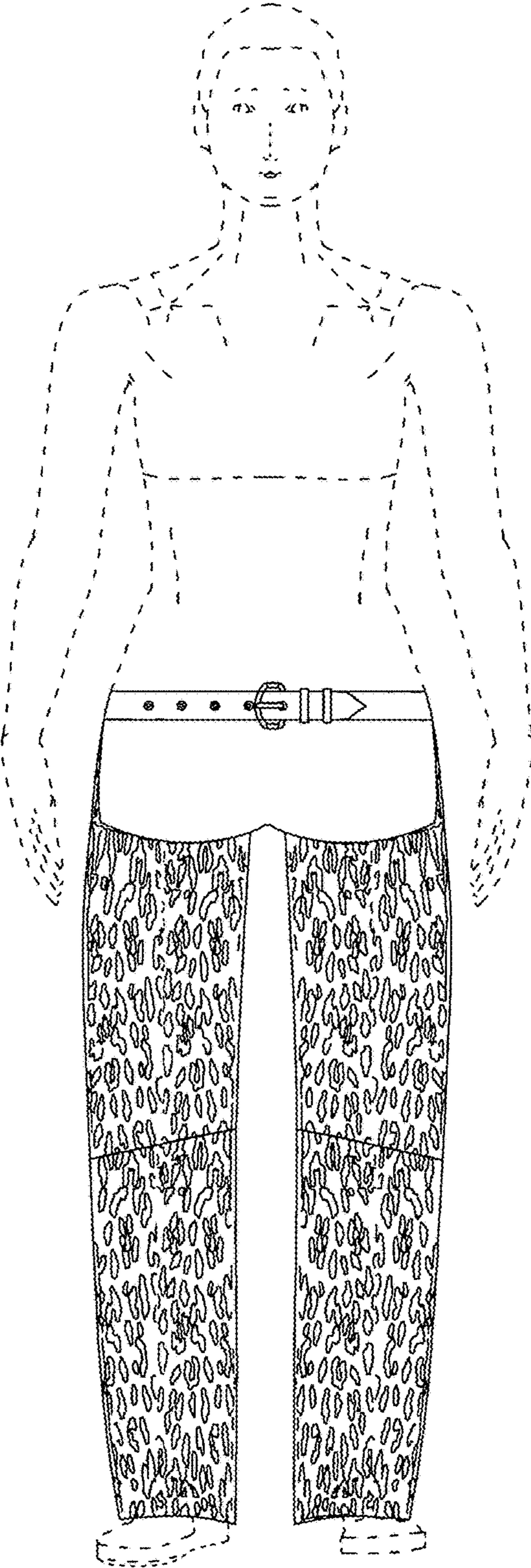

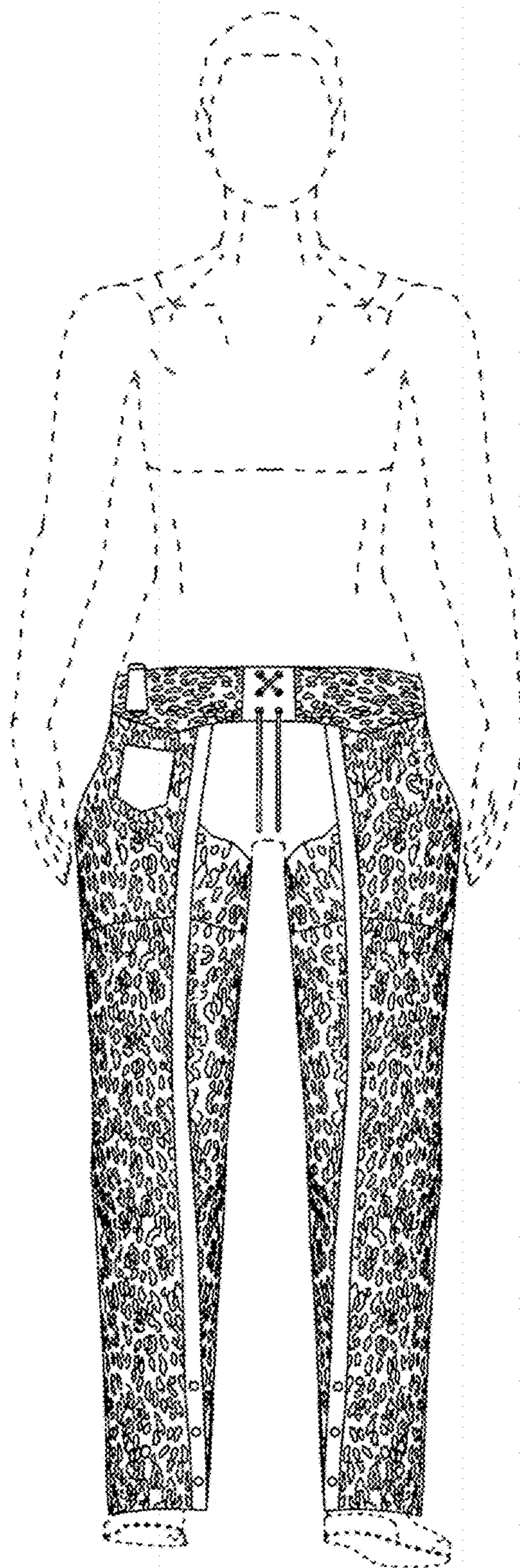
