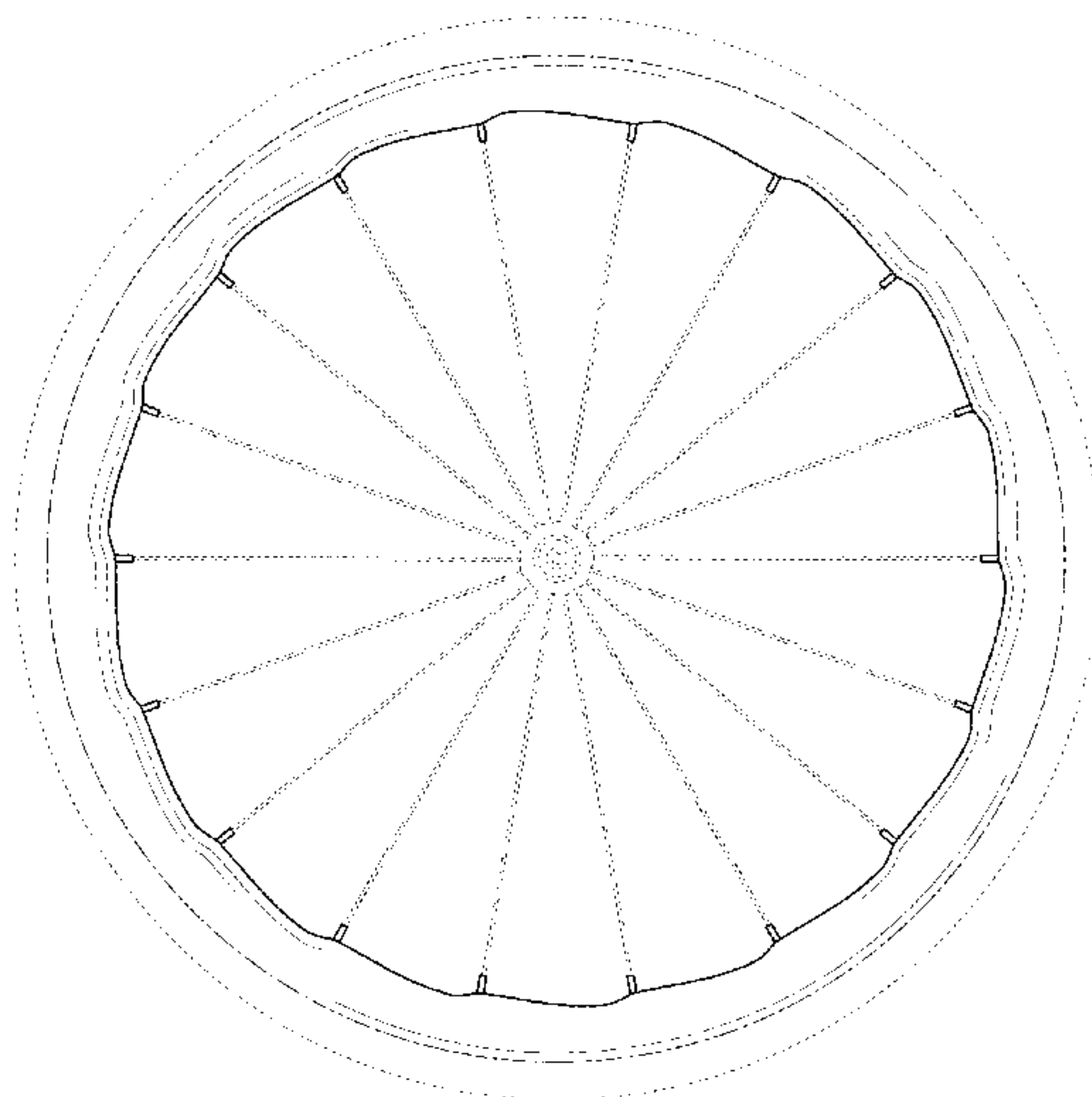
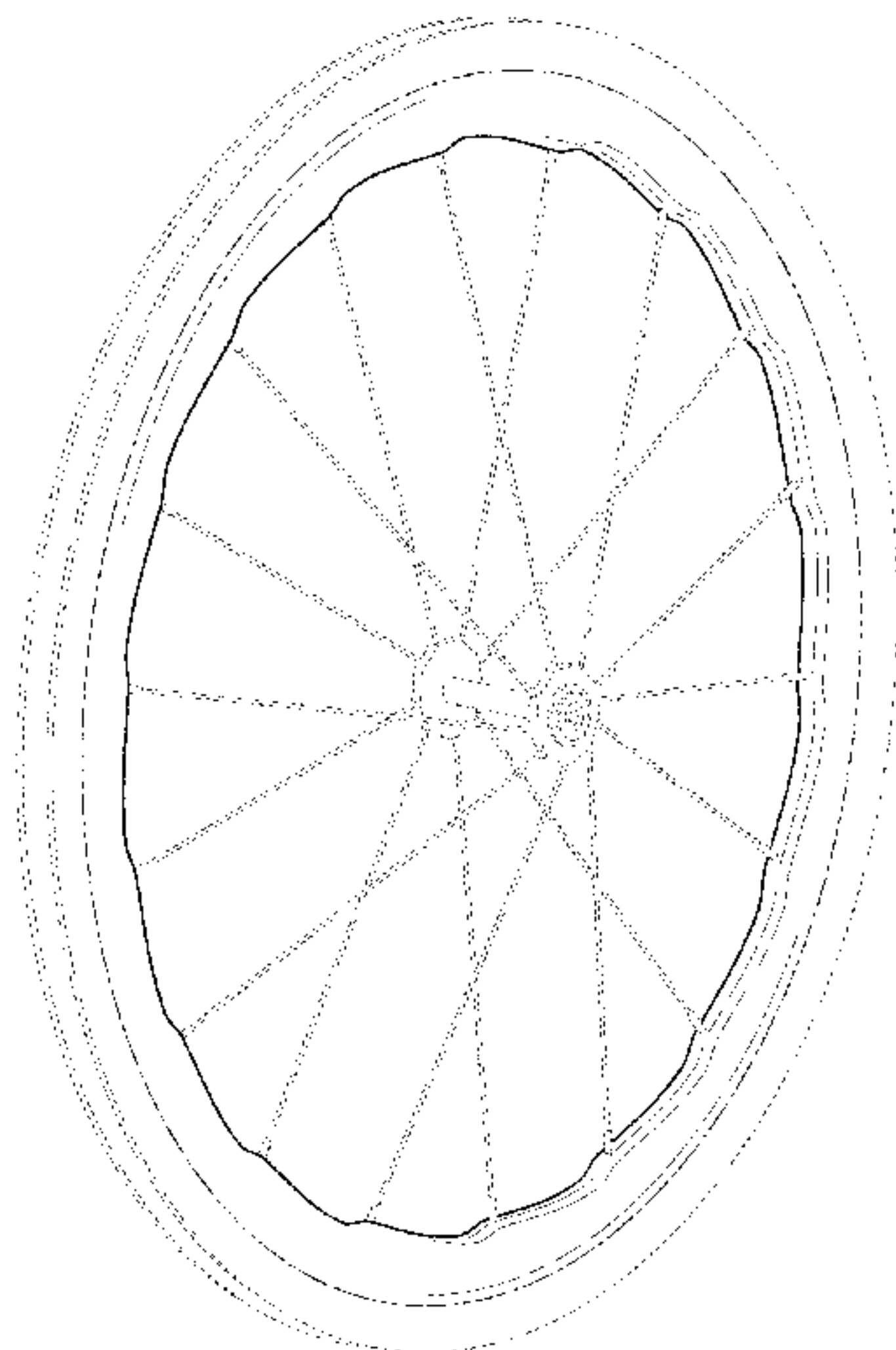
We claim the ornamental design for a bicycle wheel rim, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a bicycle wheel rim showing our new design;
FIG. 2 is a side view of the bicycle wheel rim shown in FIG. 1;
FIG. 3 is a front view of the bicycle wheel rim shown in FIG. 1;
FIG. 4 is a front perspective view of a second embodiment of a bicycle wheel rim showing our new design;

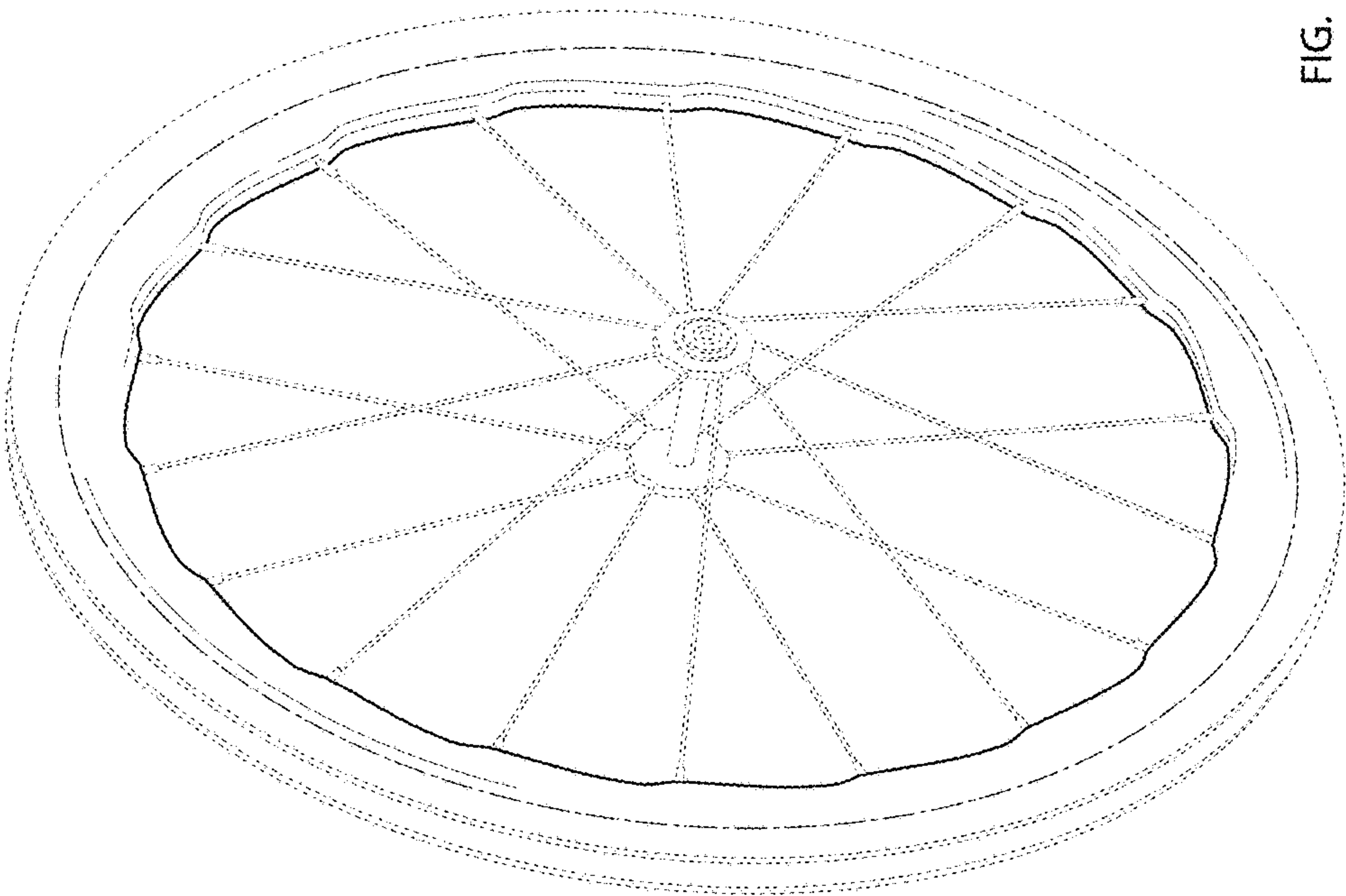

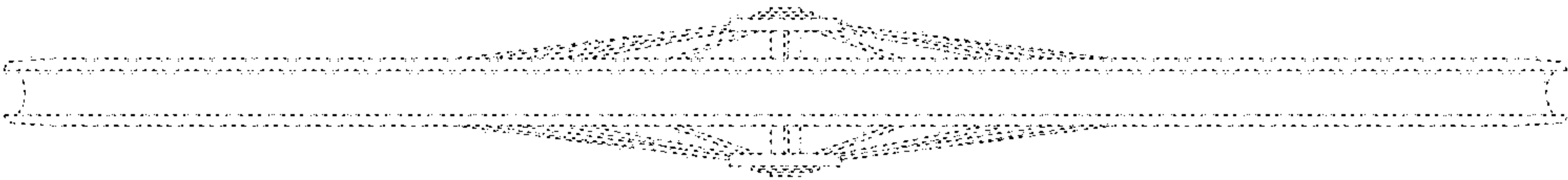

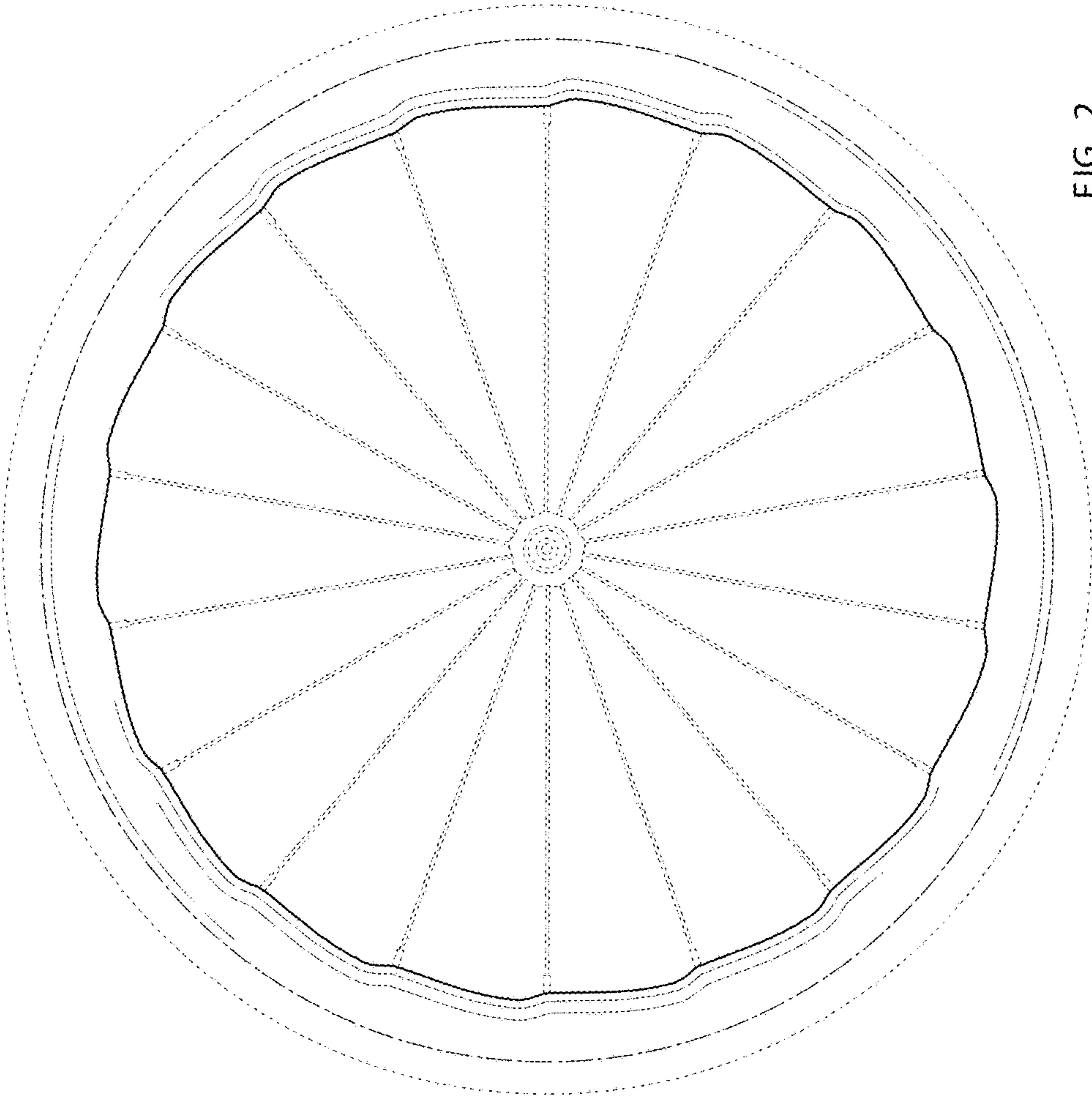

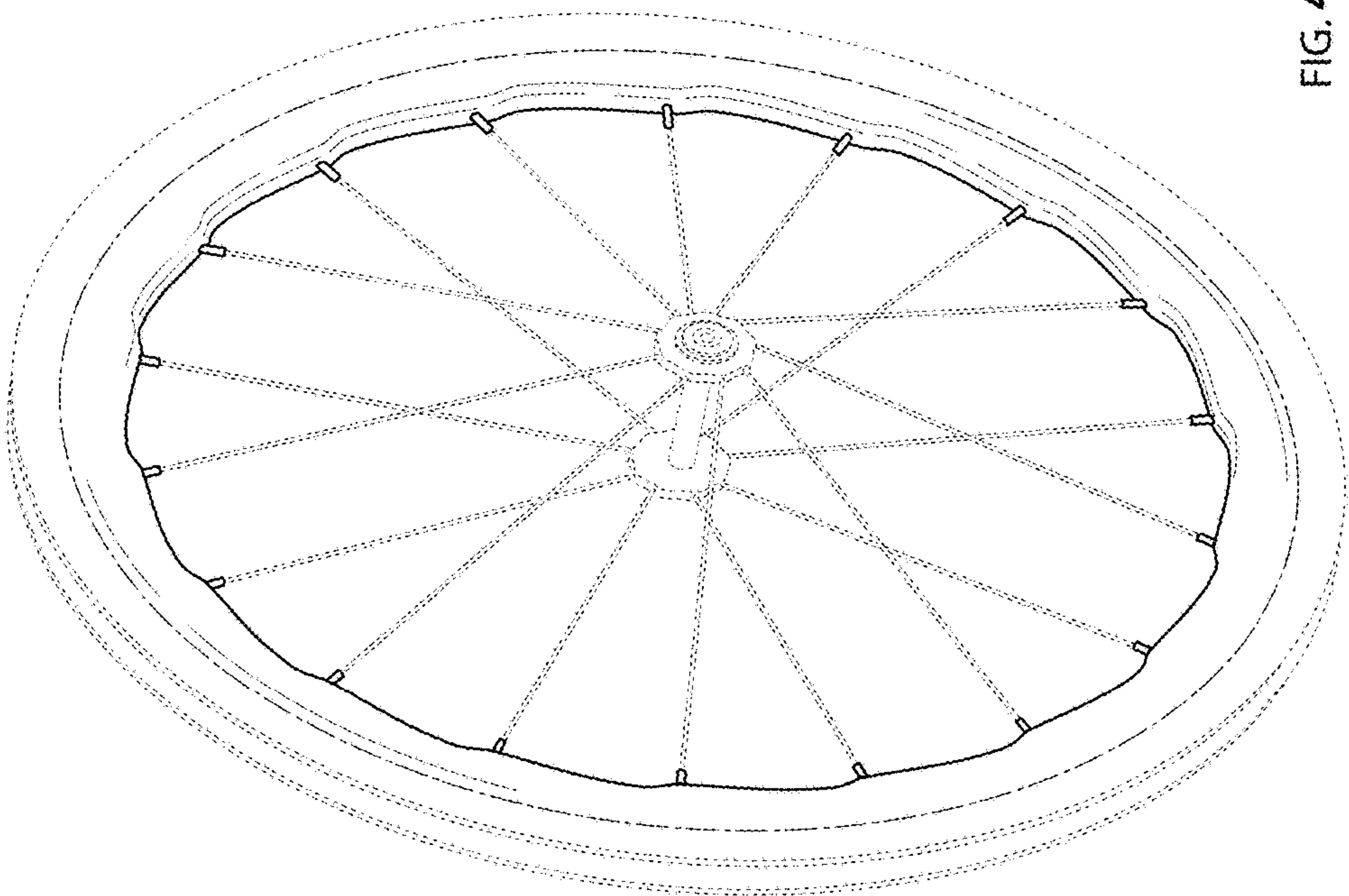

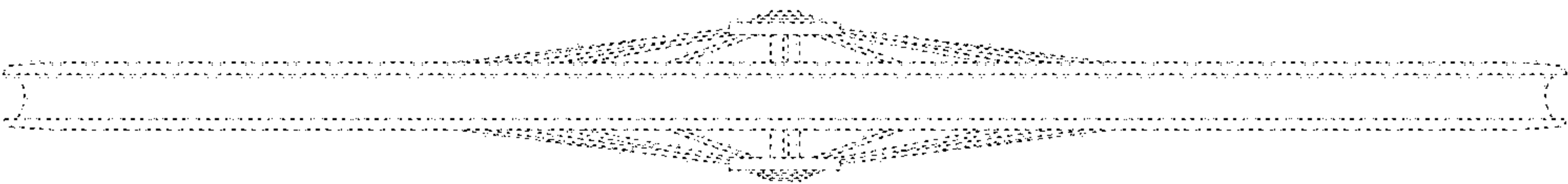

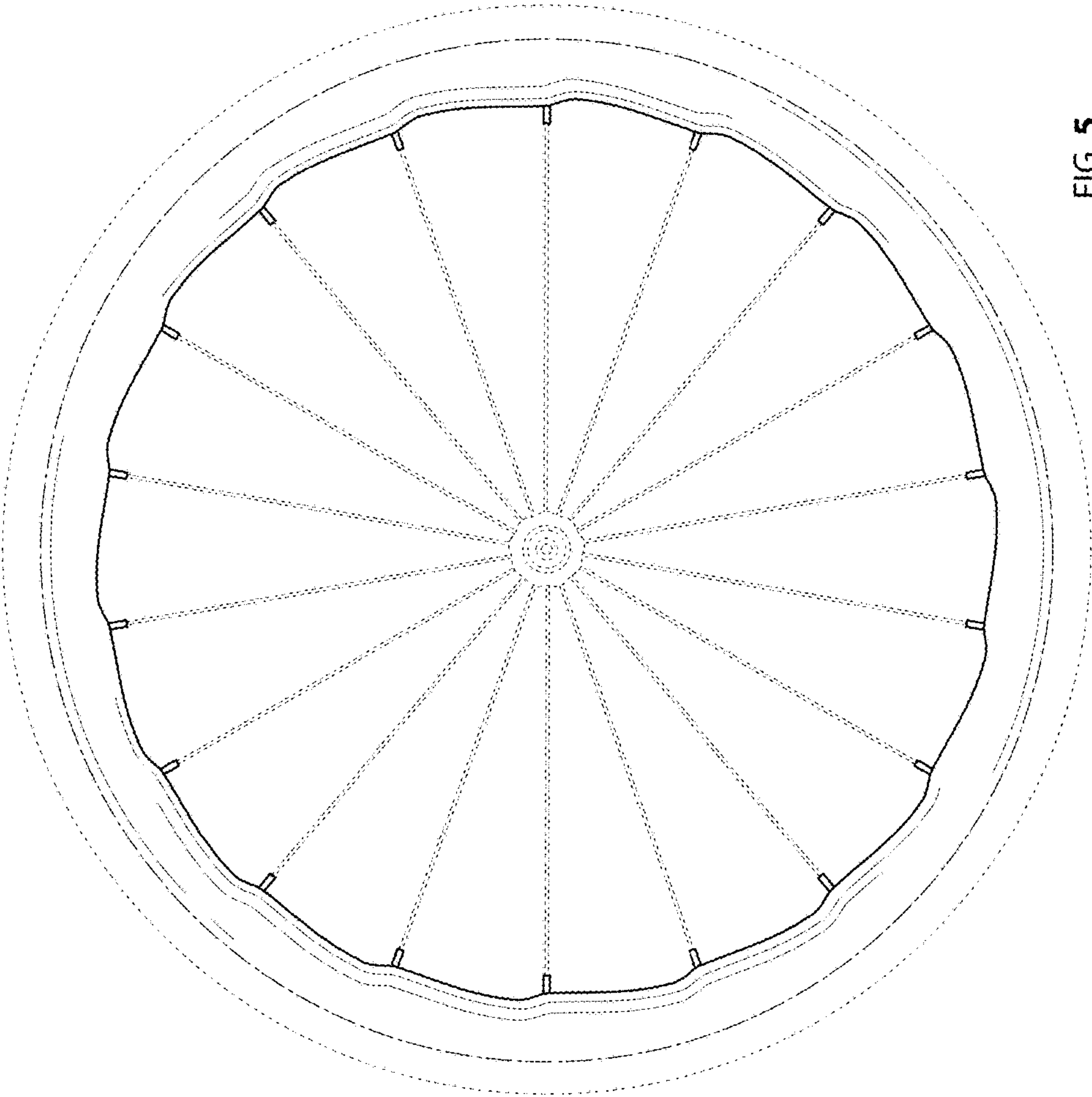
