(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a display screen with a graphical user interface for controlling sound, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front view showing a first embodiment of a display screen with a graphical user interface for controlling sound; and,

FIG. 2 is a front view of a second embodiment thereof.

The peripheral dash-dot line showing of a display screen around FIGS. 1 and 2 is included for the purpose of showing a portion of the article which forms no part of the claimed design. Dotted lines are intended to show unclaimed portions of the design.

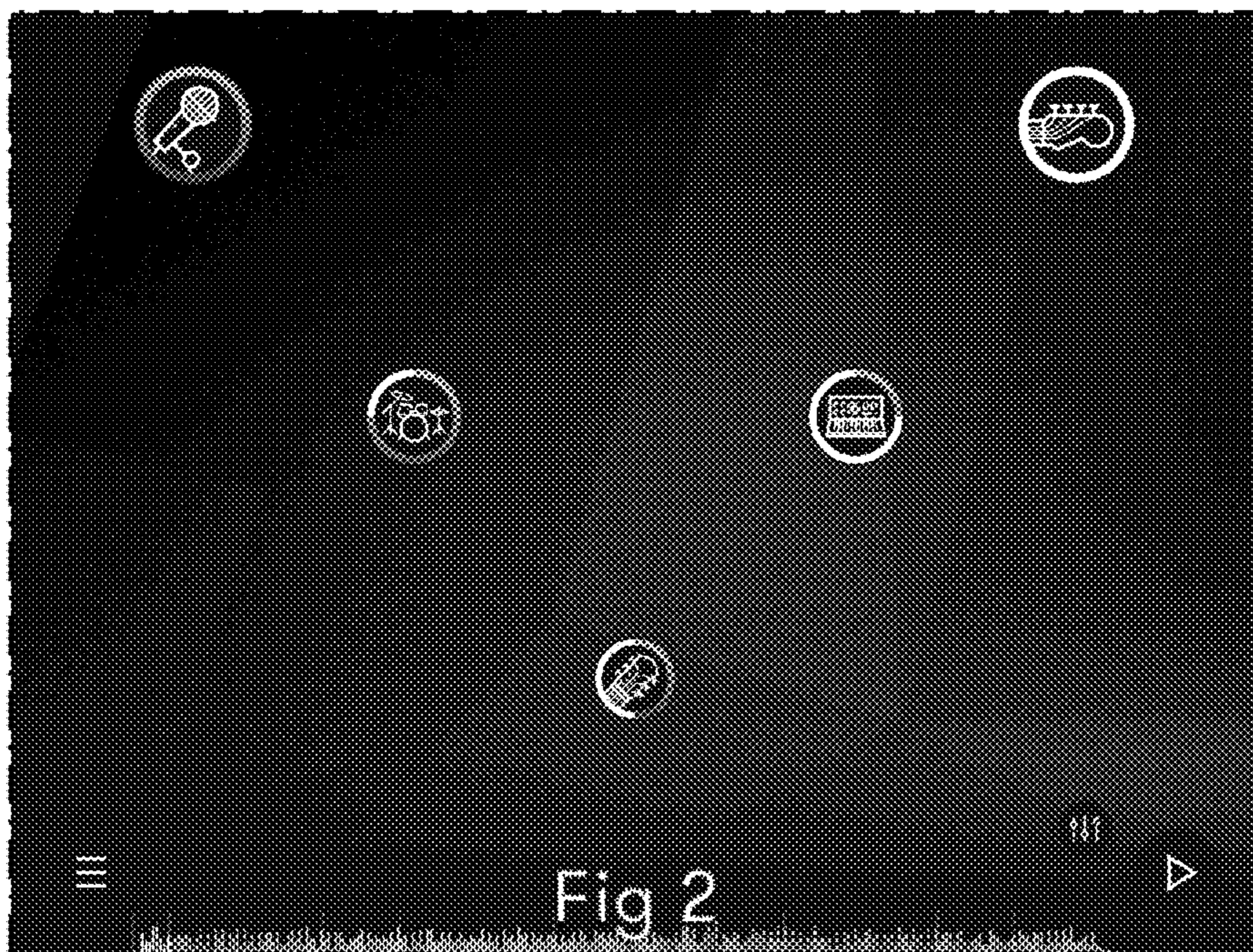
