DESCRIPTION

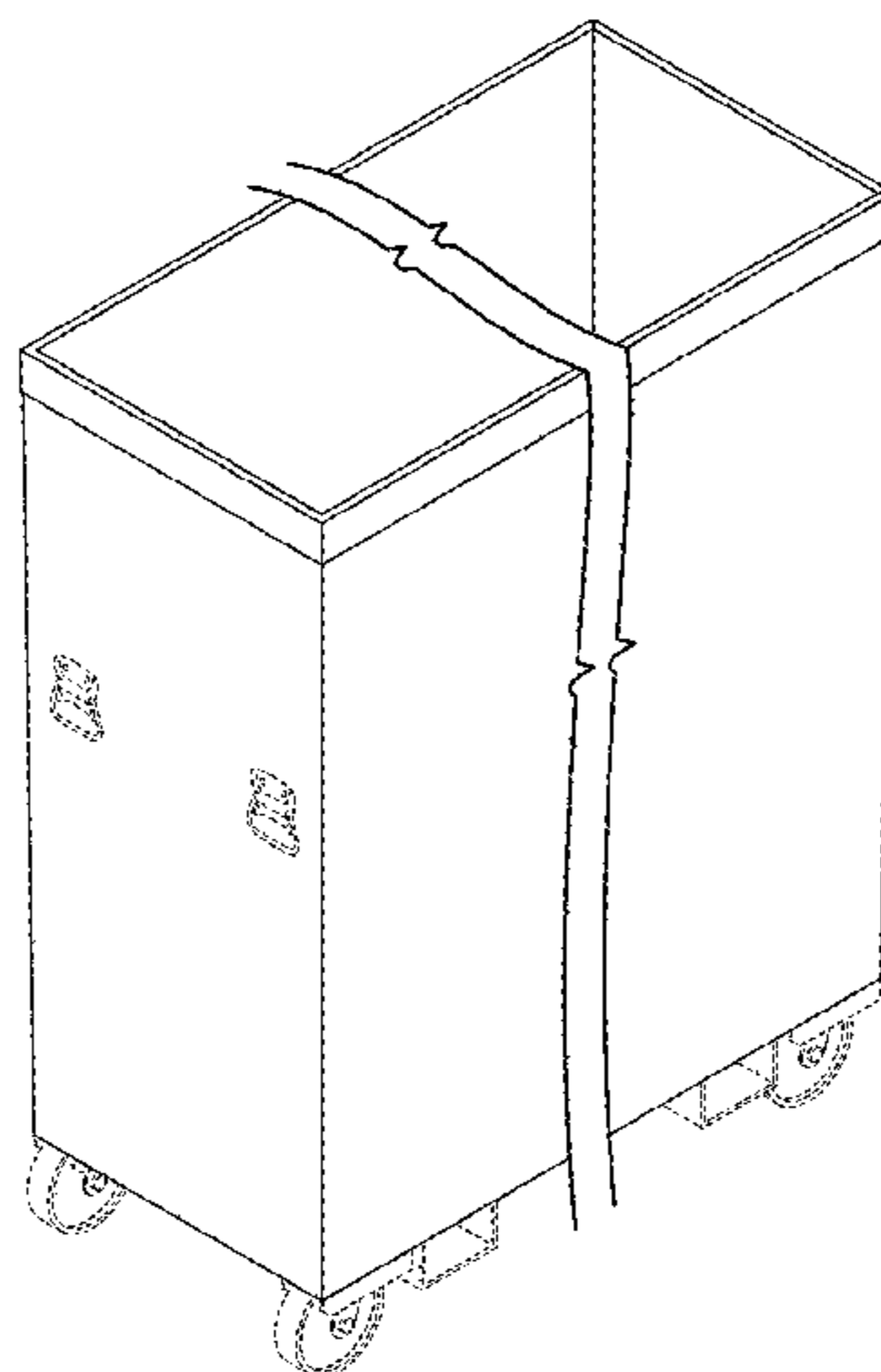
FIG. 1 is a top perspective view of a debris cart showing my new design;

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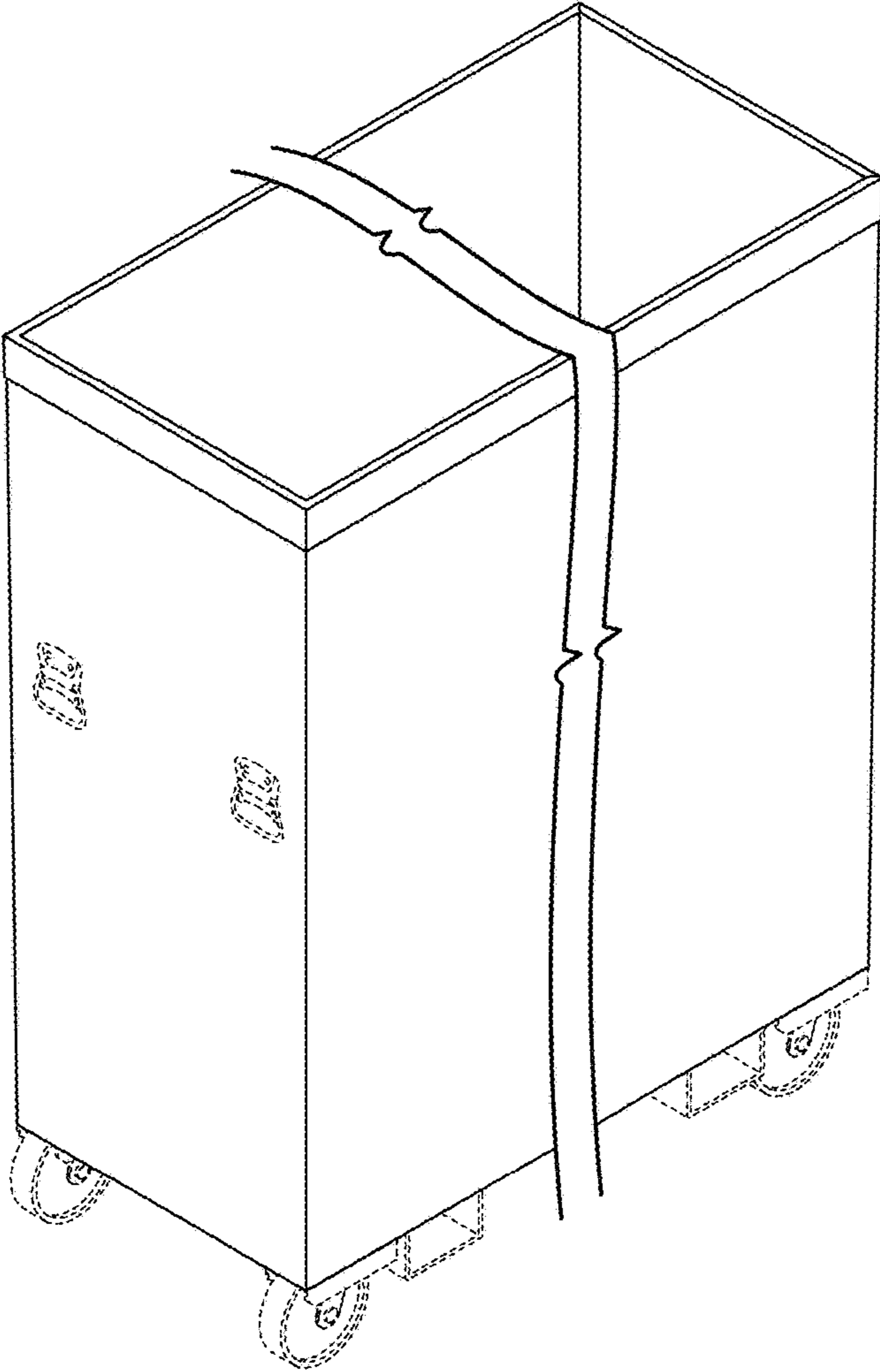

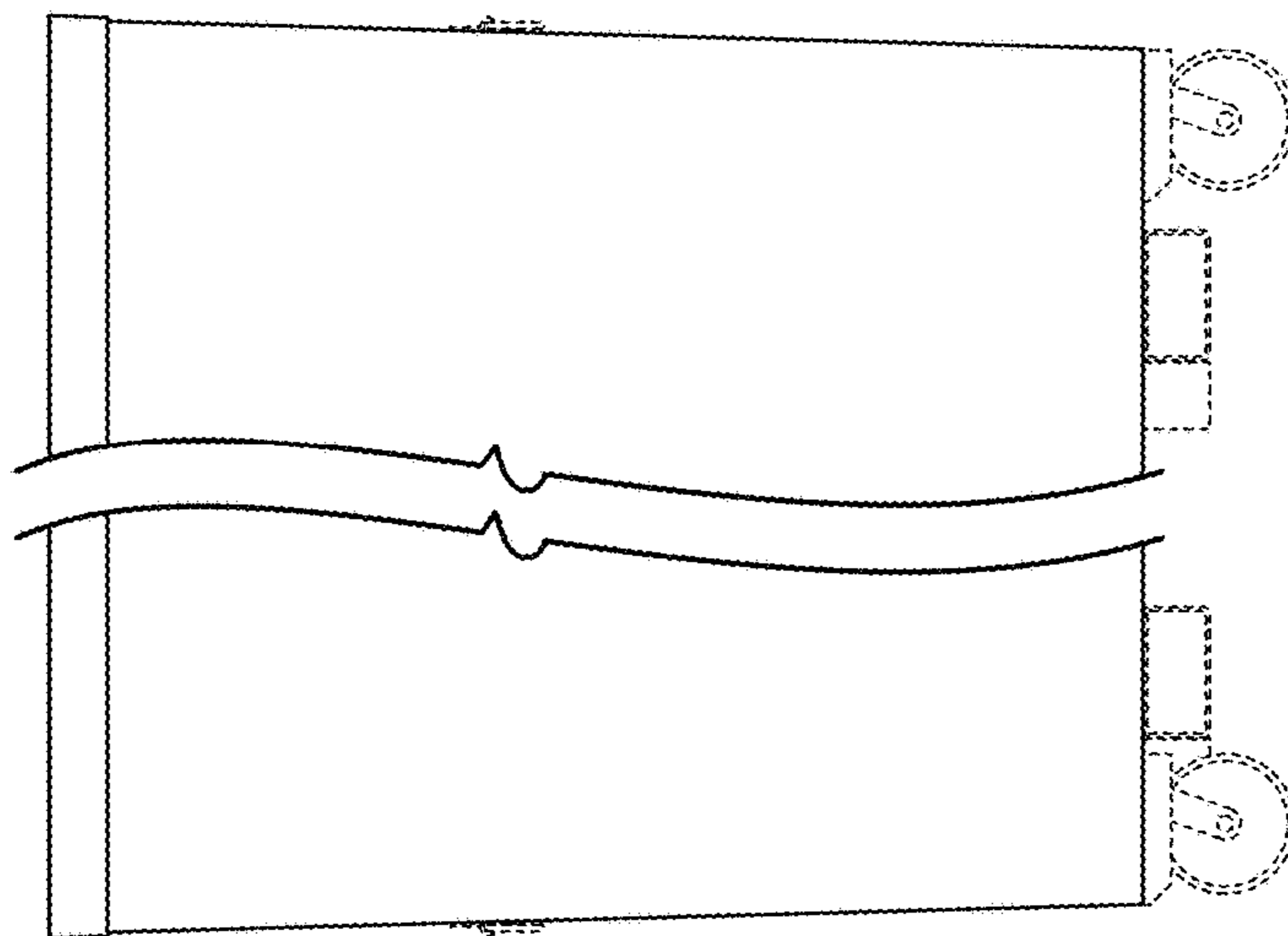

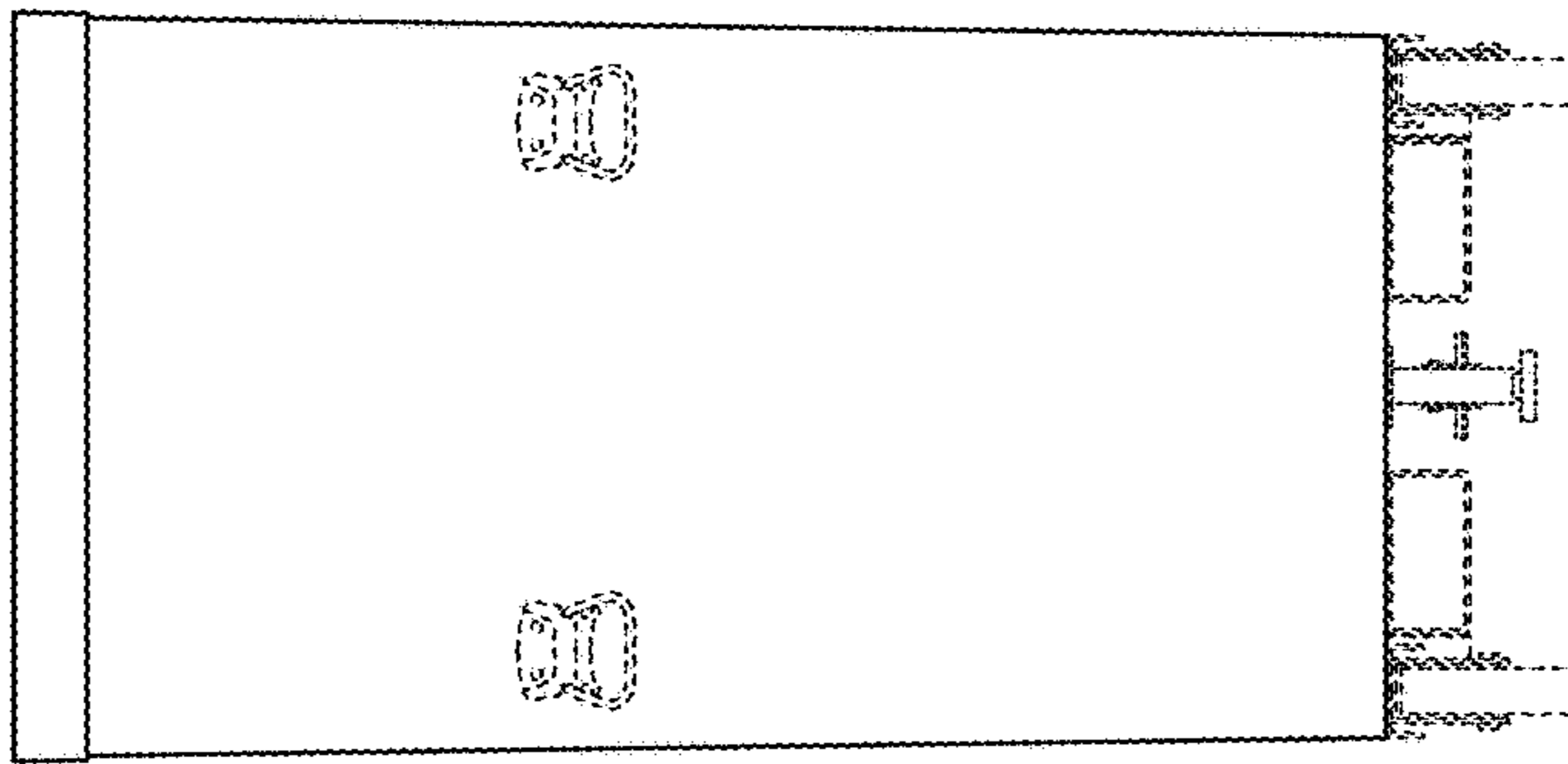

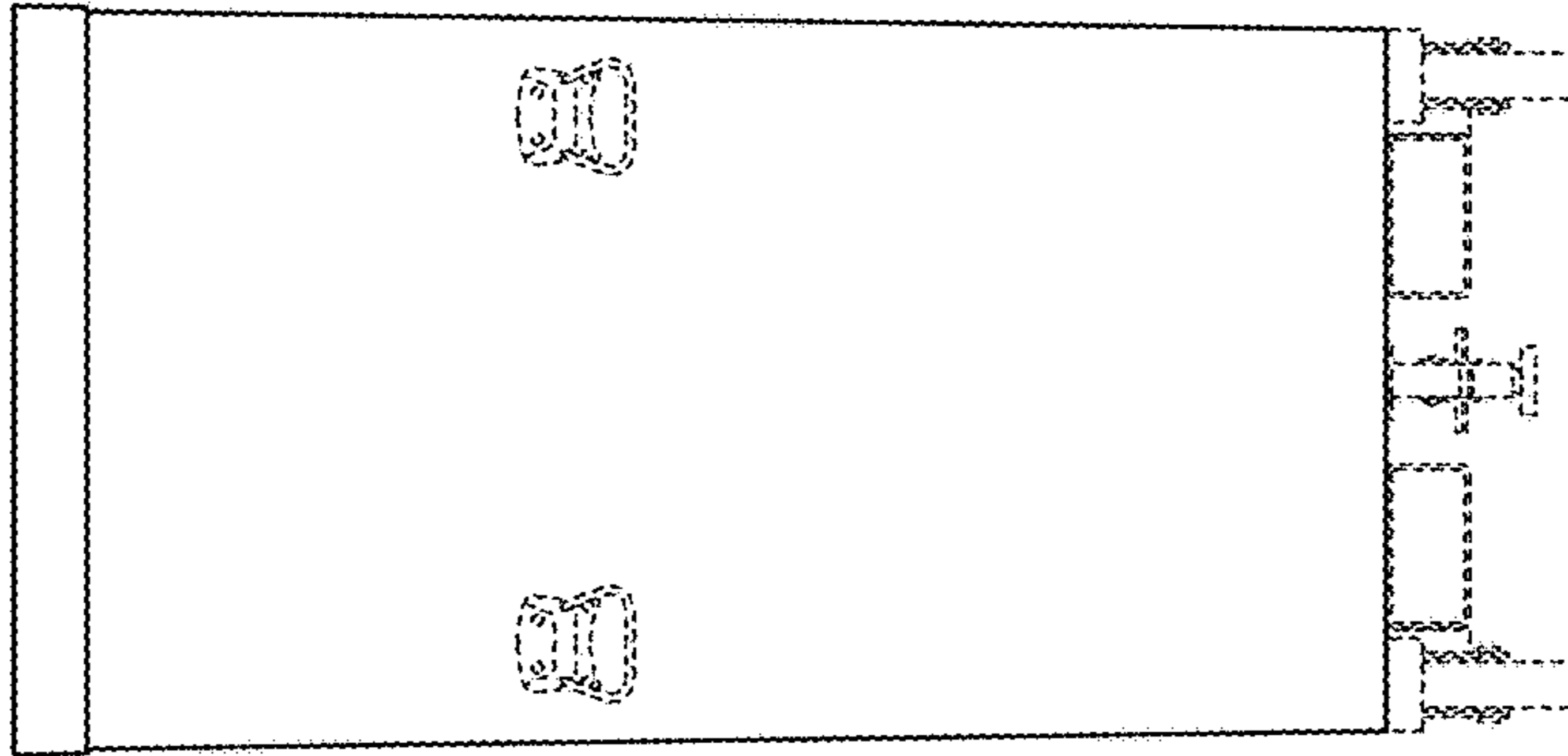

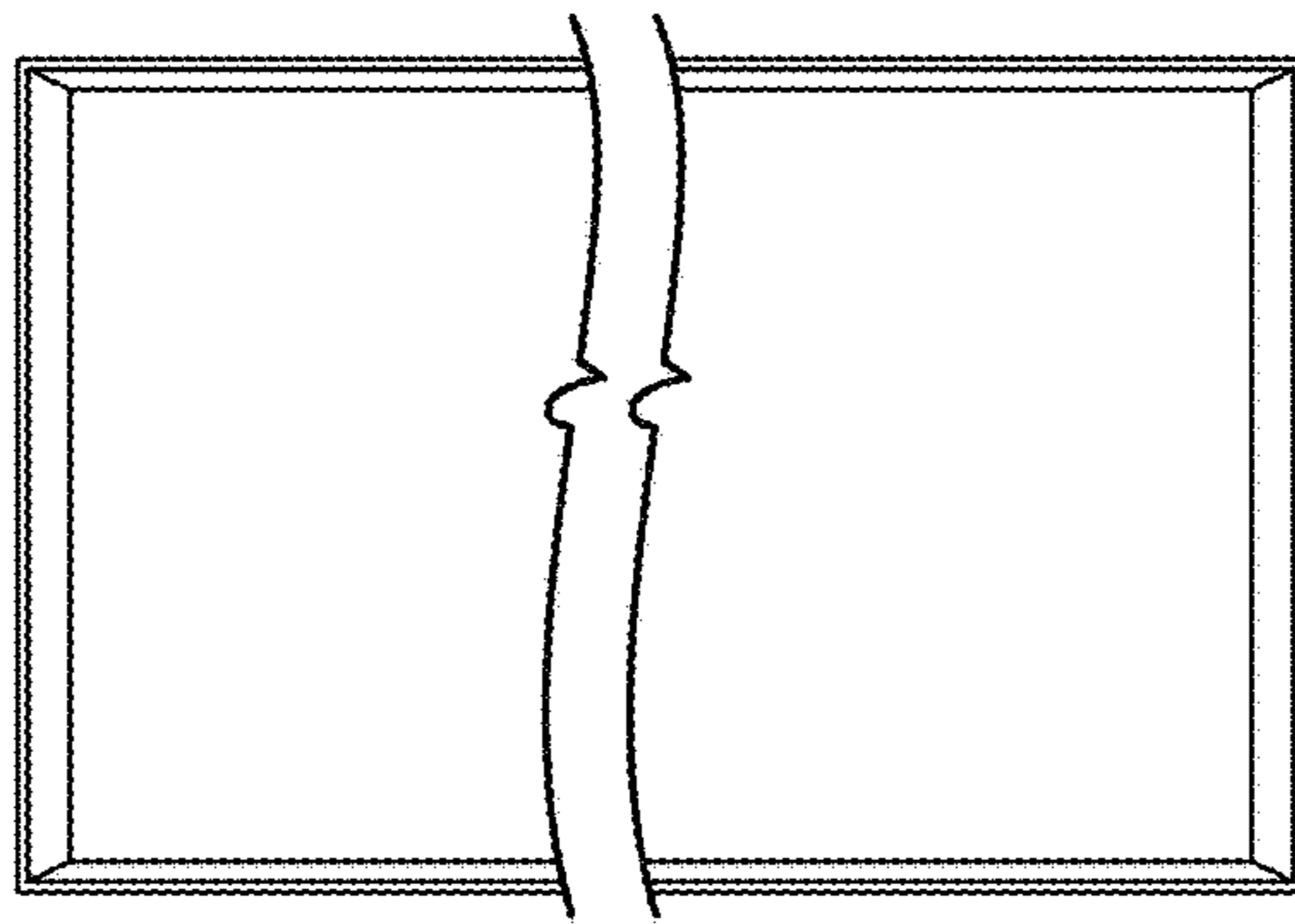

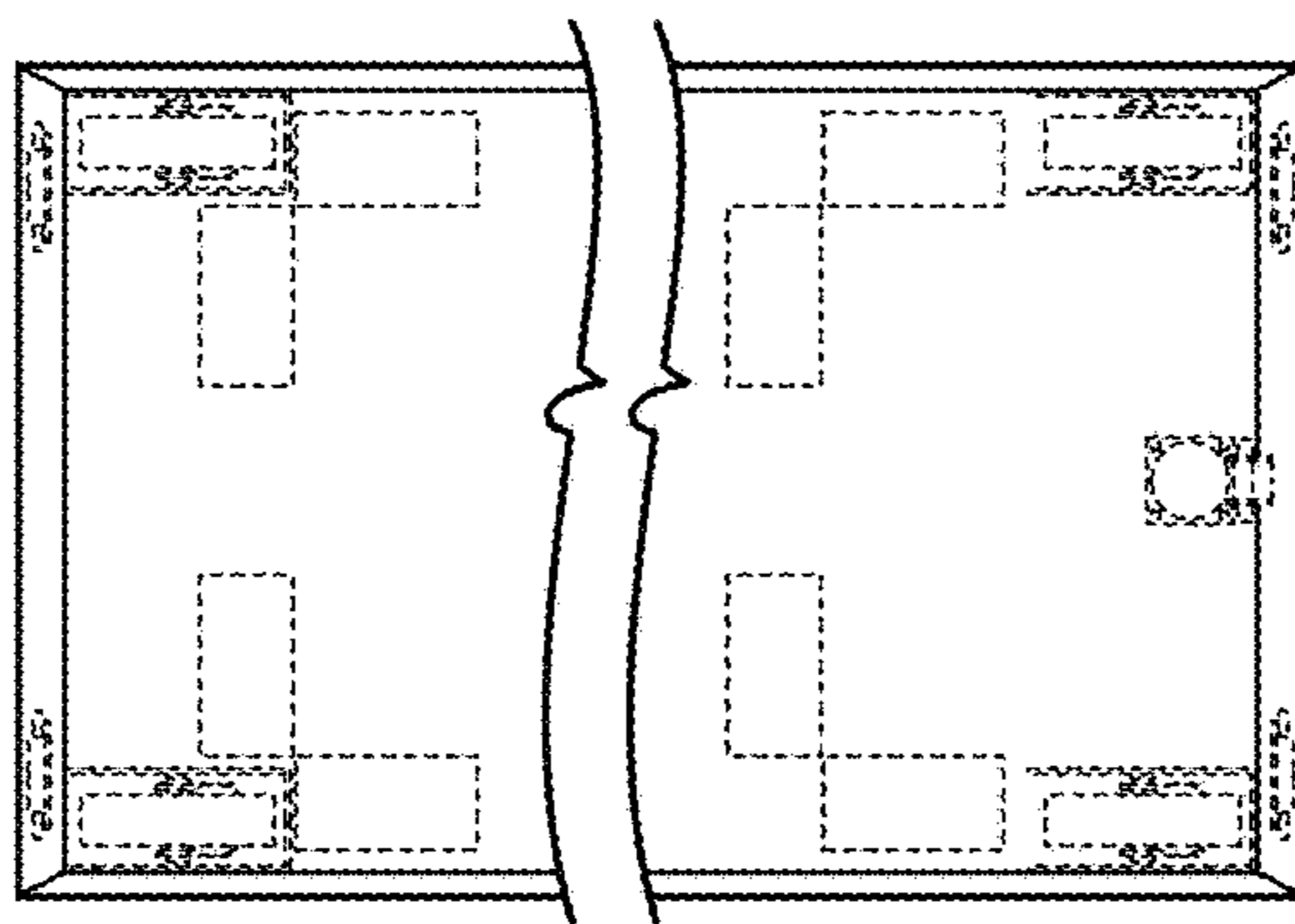
