FIG. 4 is a second side view thereof;

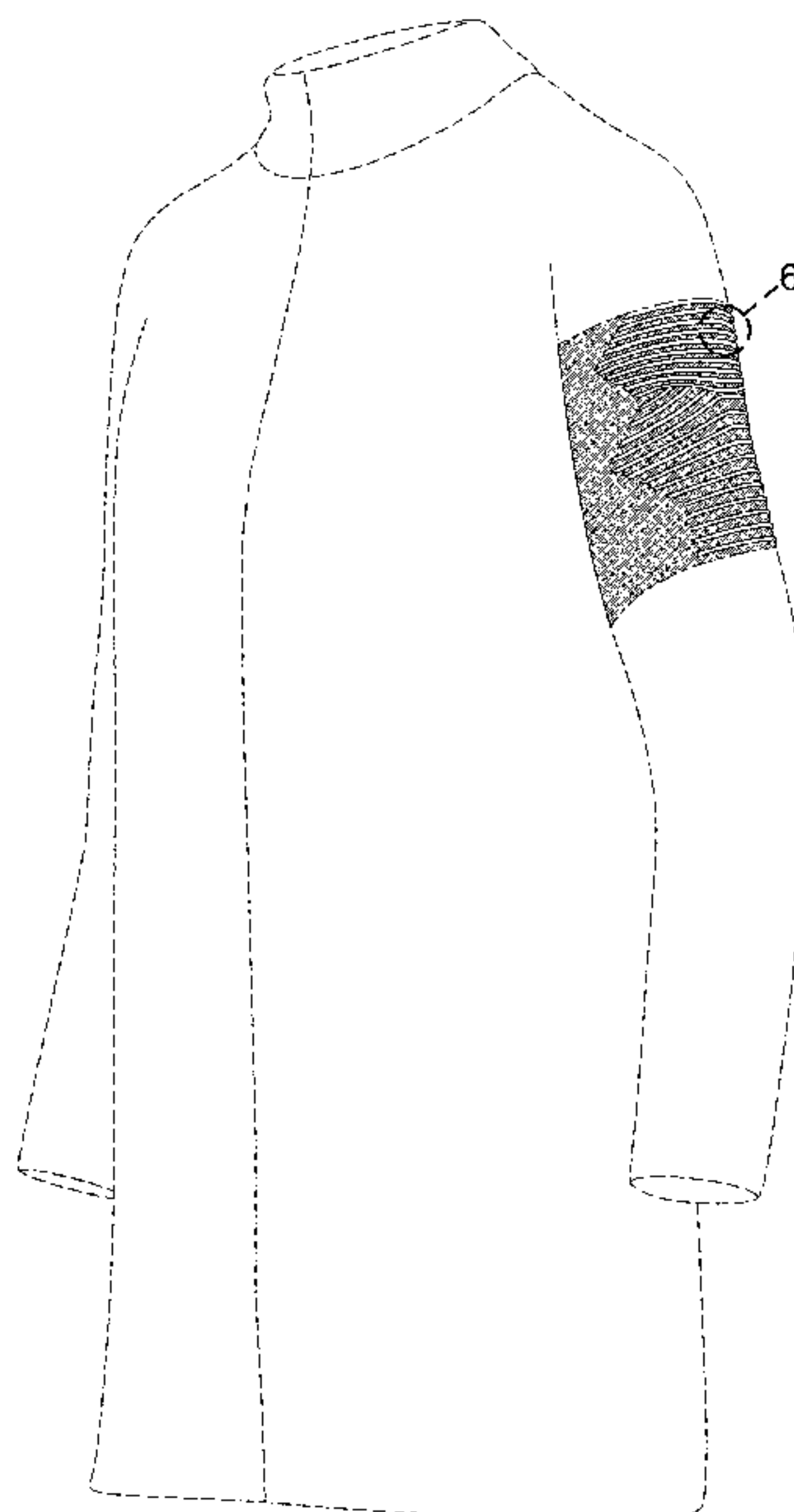
FIG. 5 is a rear view thereof; and,

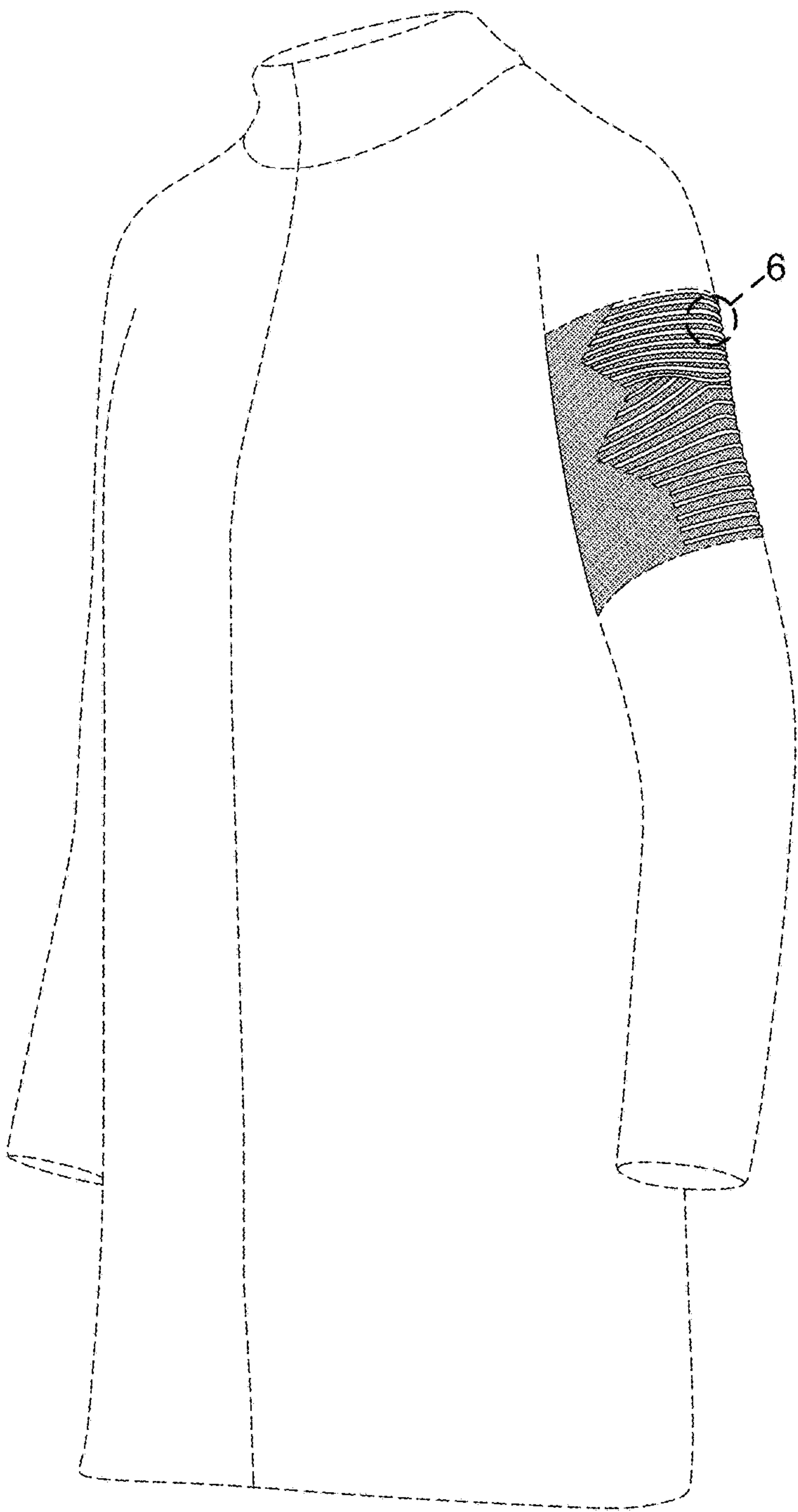

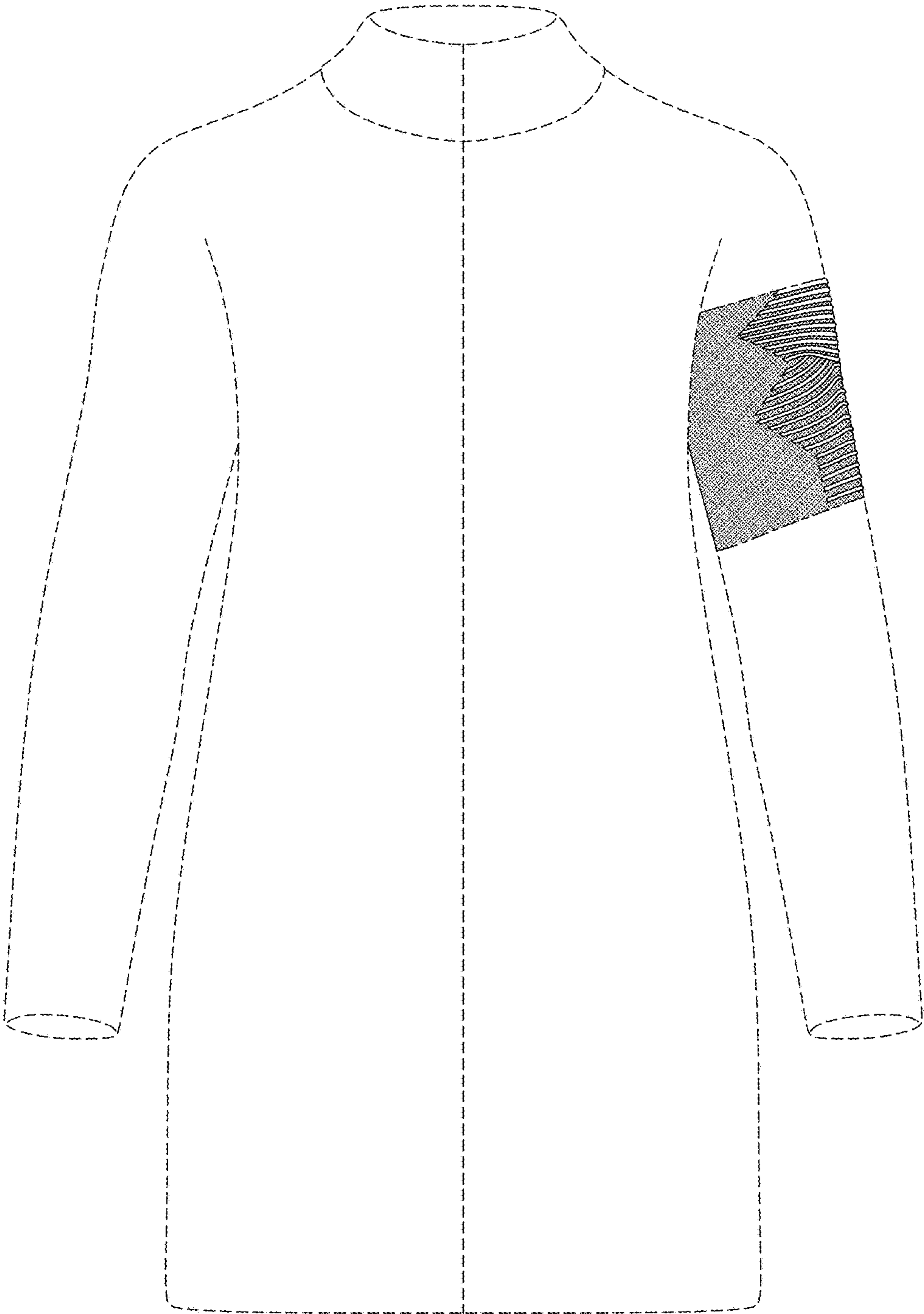

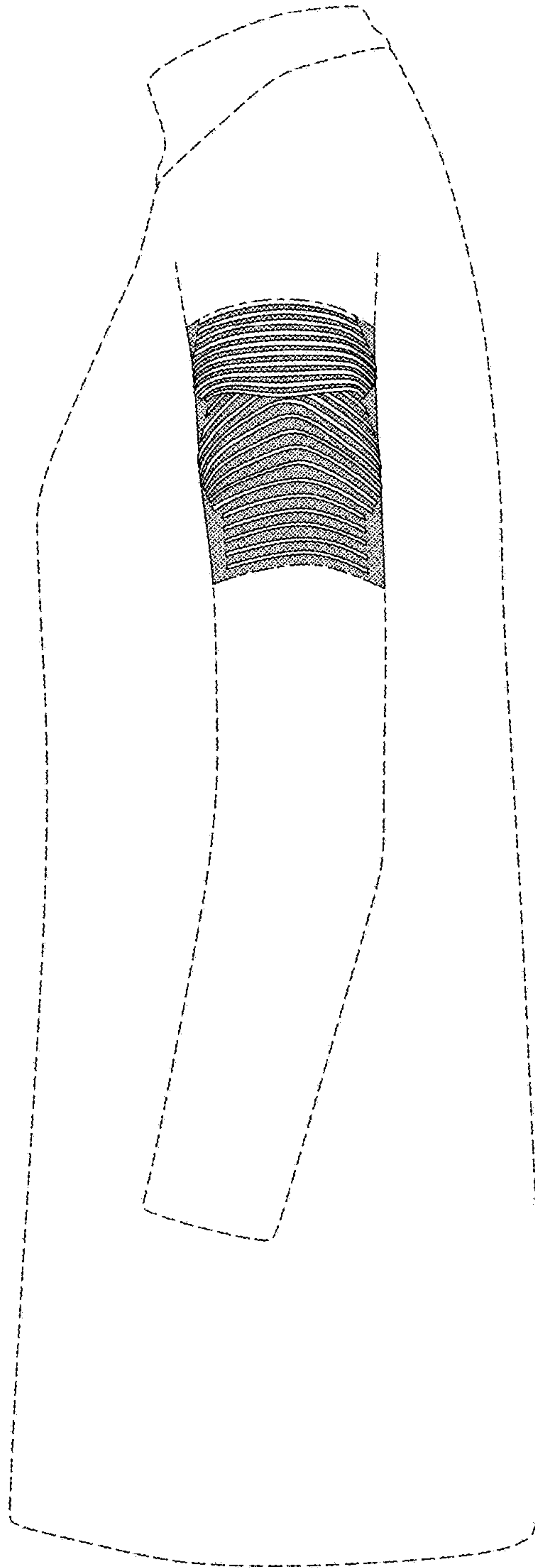

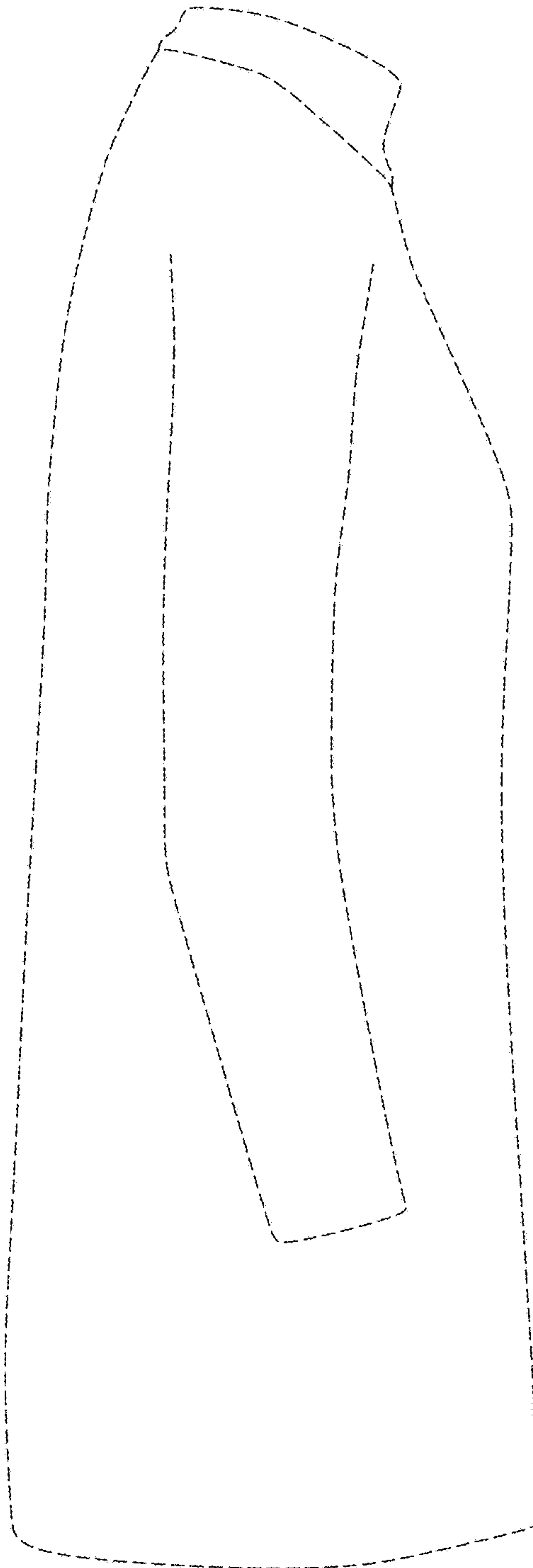

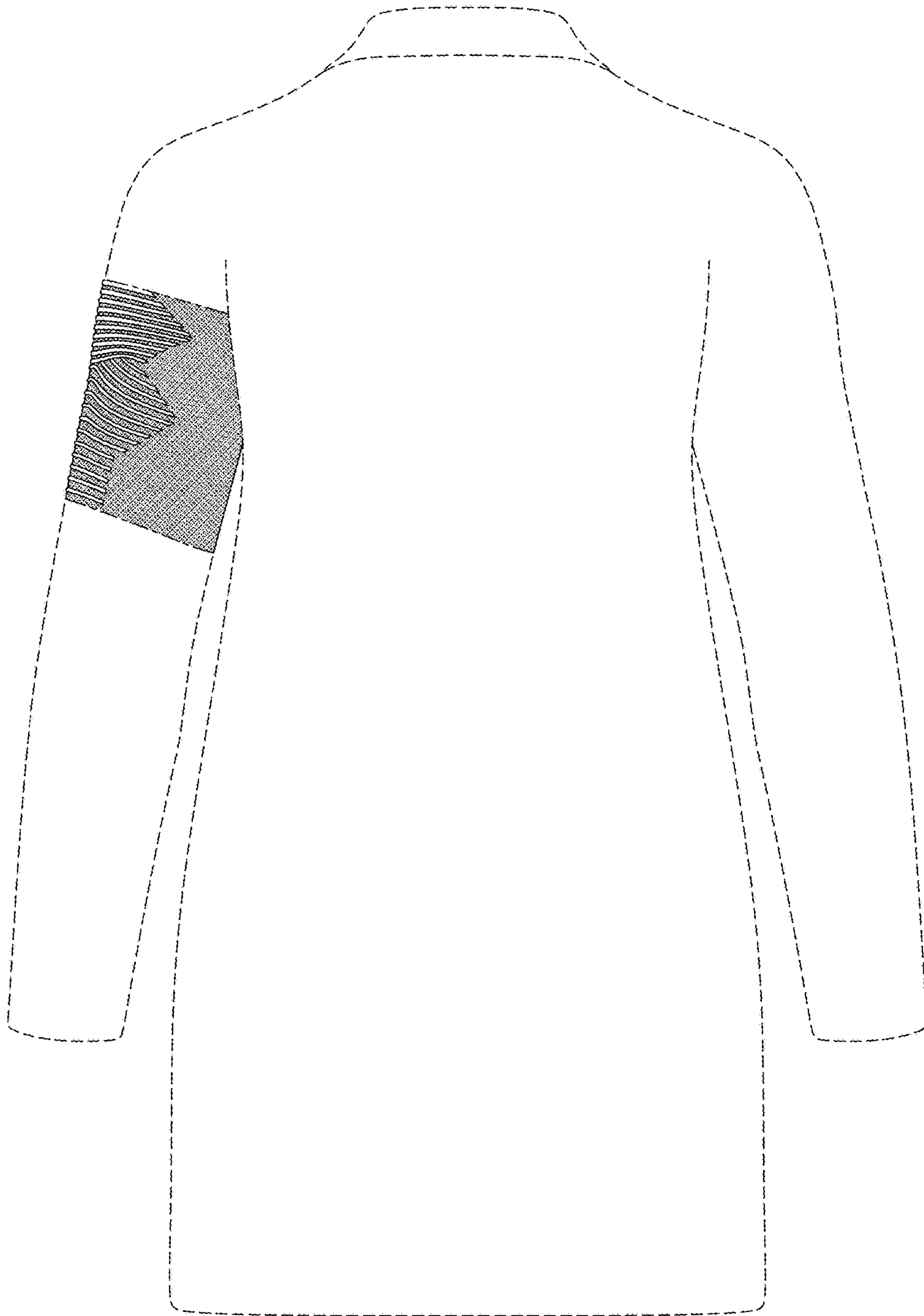

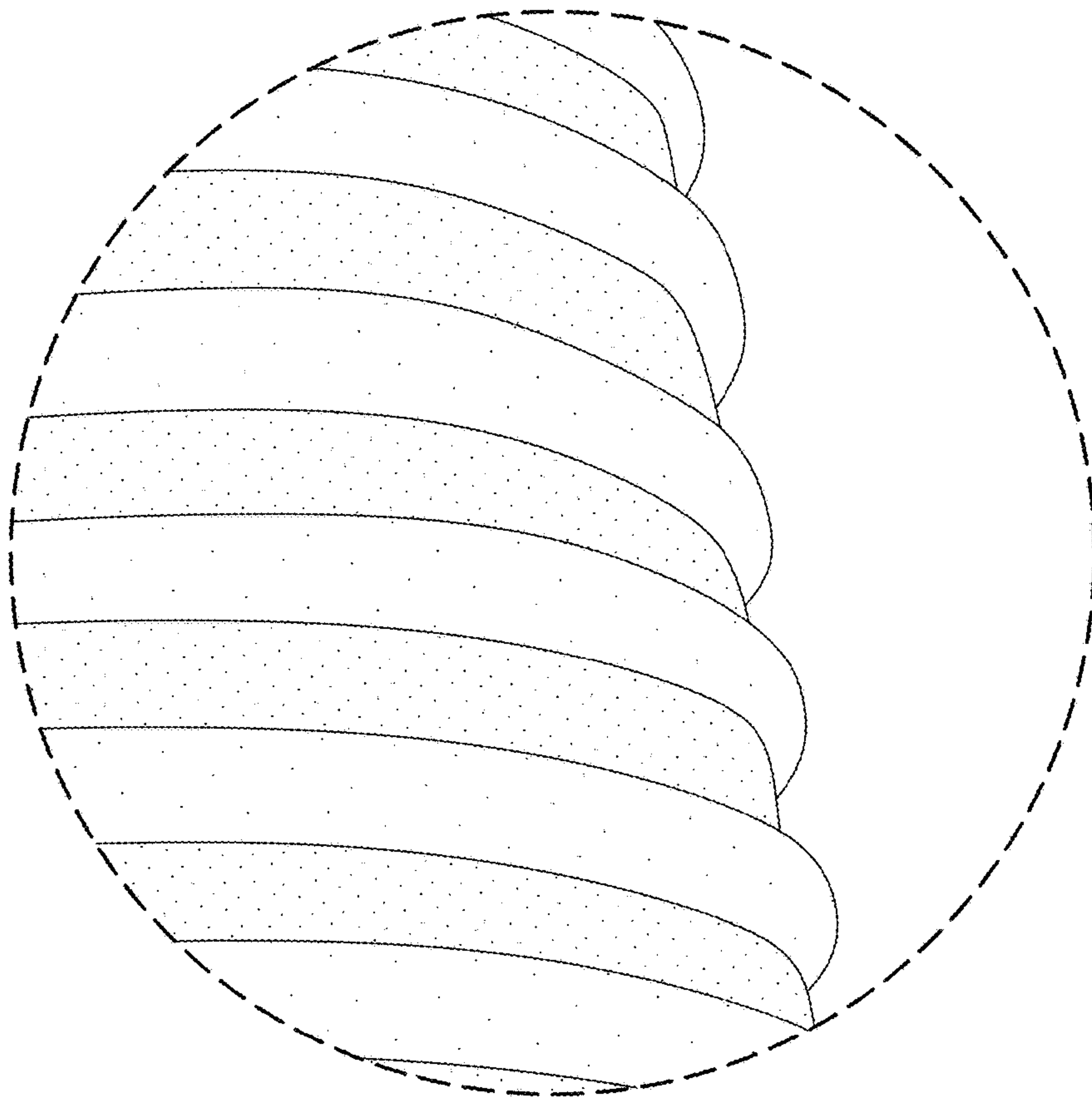
