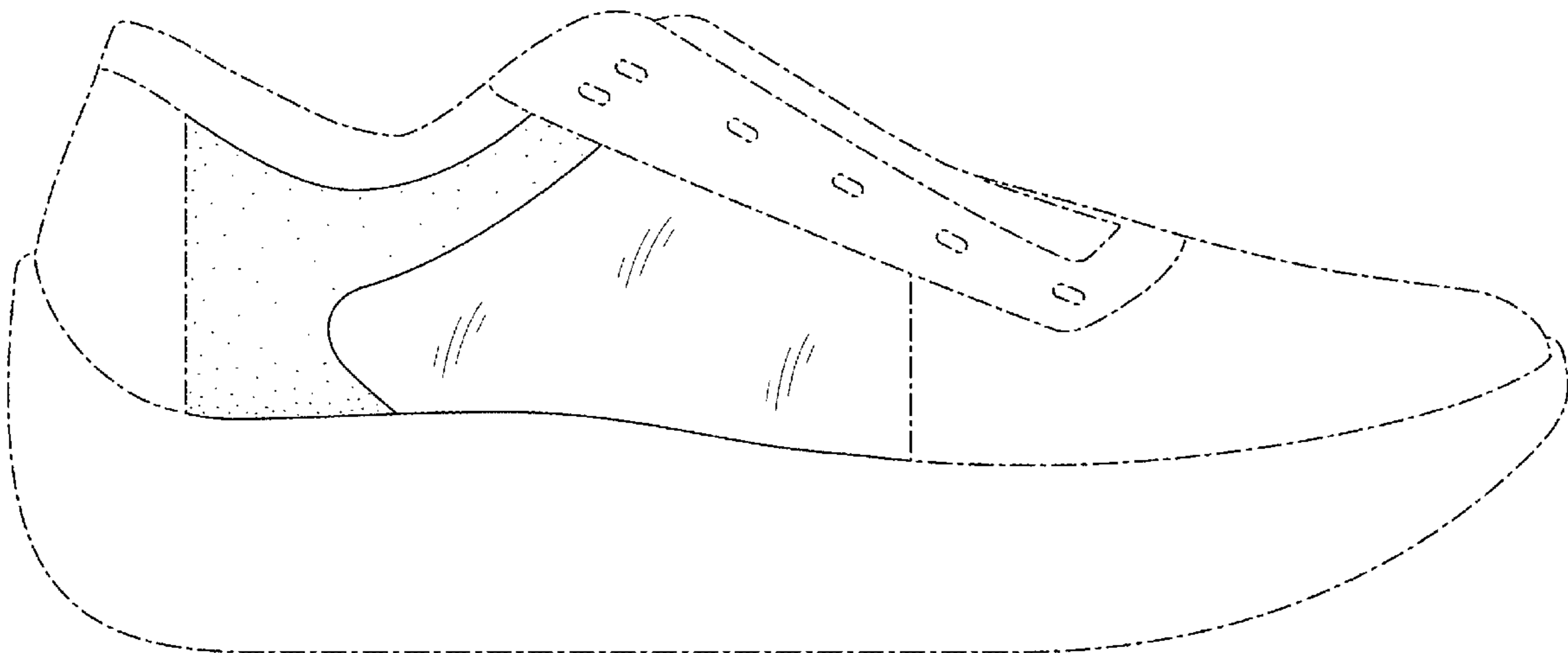
(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a shoe, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a shoe showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a side view thereof; and,
FIG. 3 is a rear perspective view thereof.
The broken lines immediately adjacent to the shaded areas define the bounds of the claimed design and form no part thereof. The oblique line shading represents a translucent or transparent appearance. The broken lines depicting the remainder of the shoe show features that form no part of the claimed design.

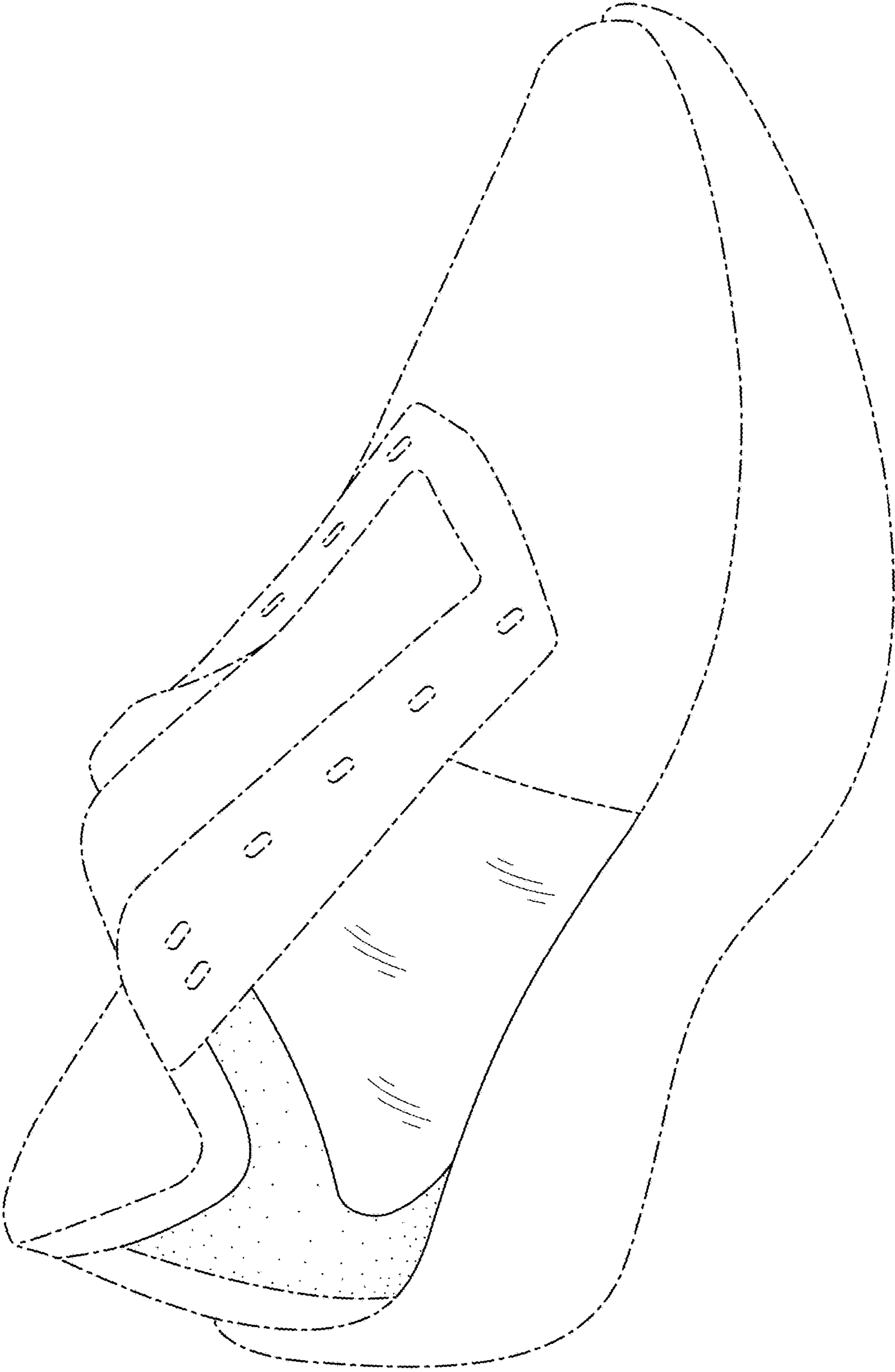

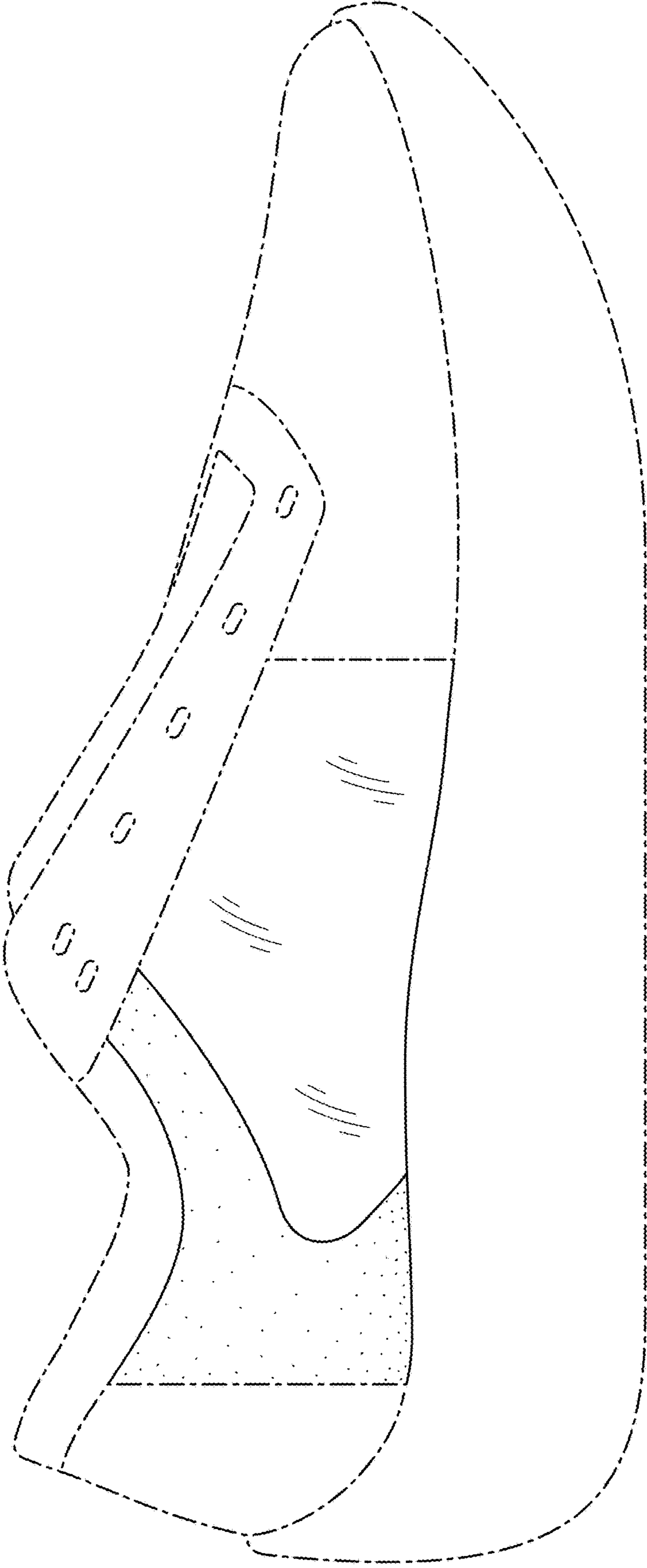

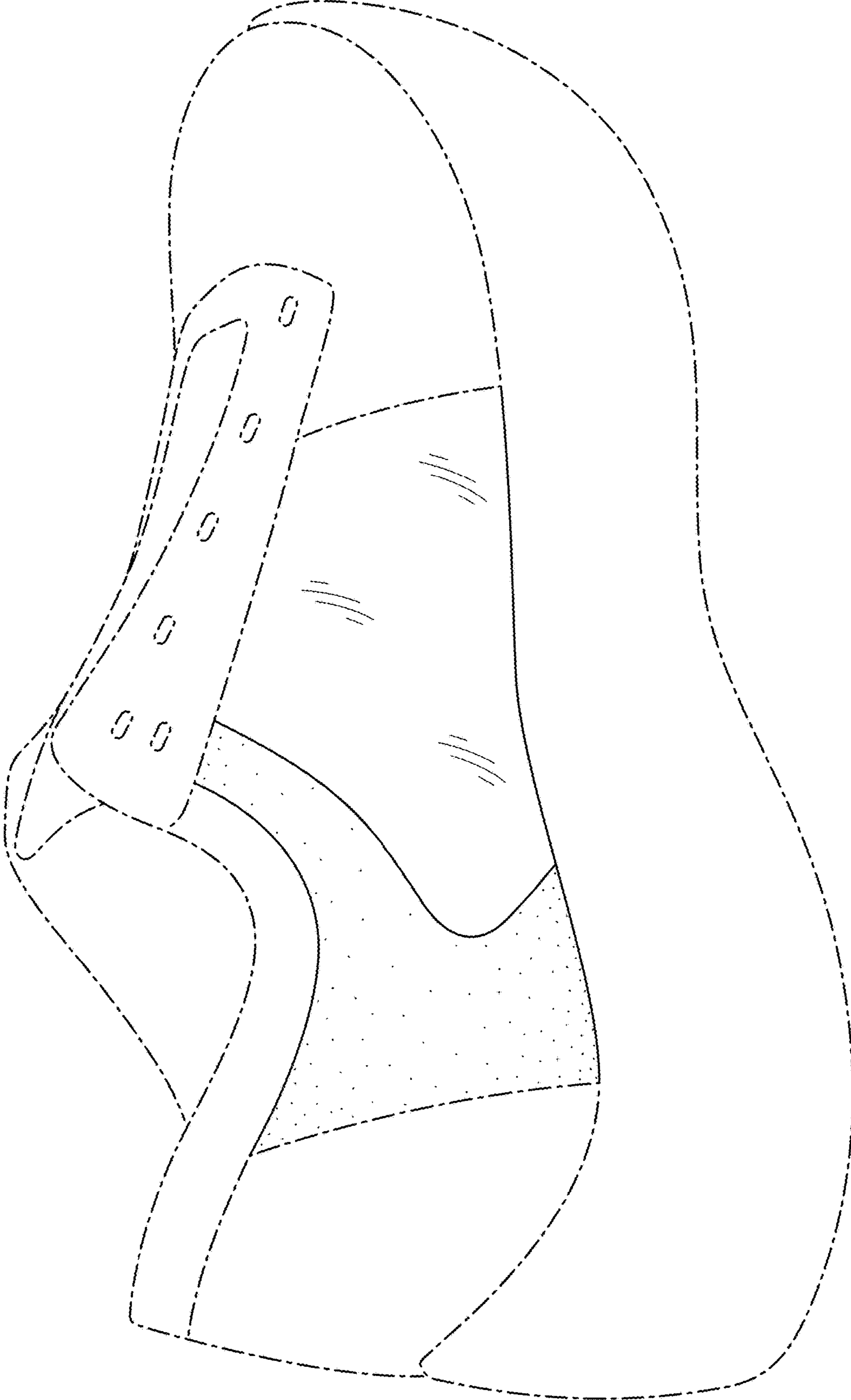
