FIG. 13 is a top plan view thereof;

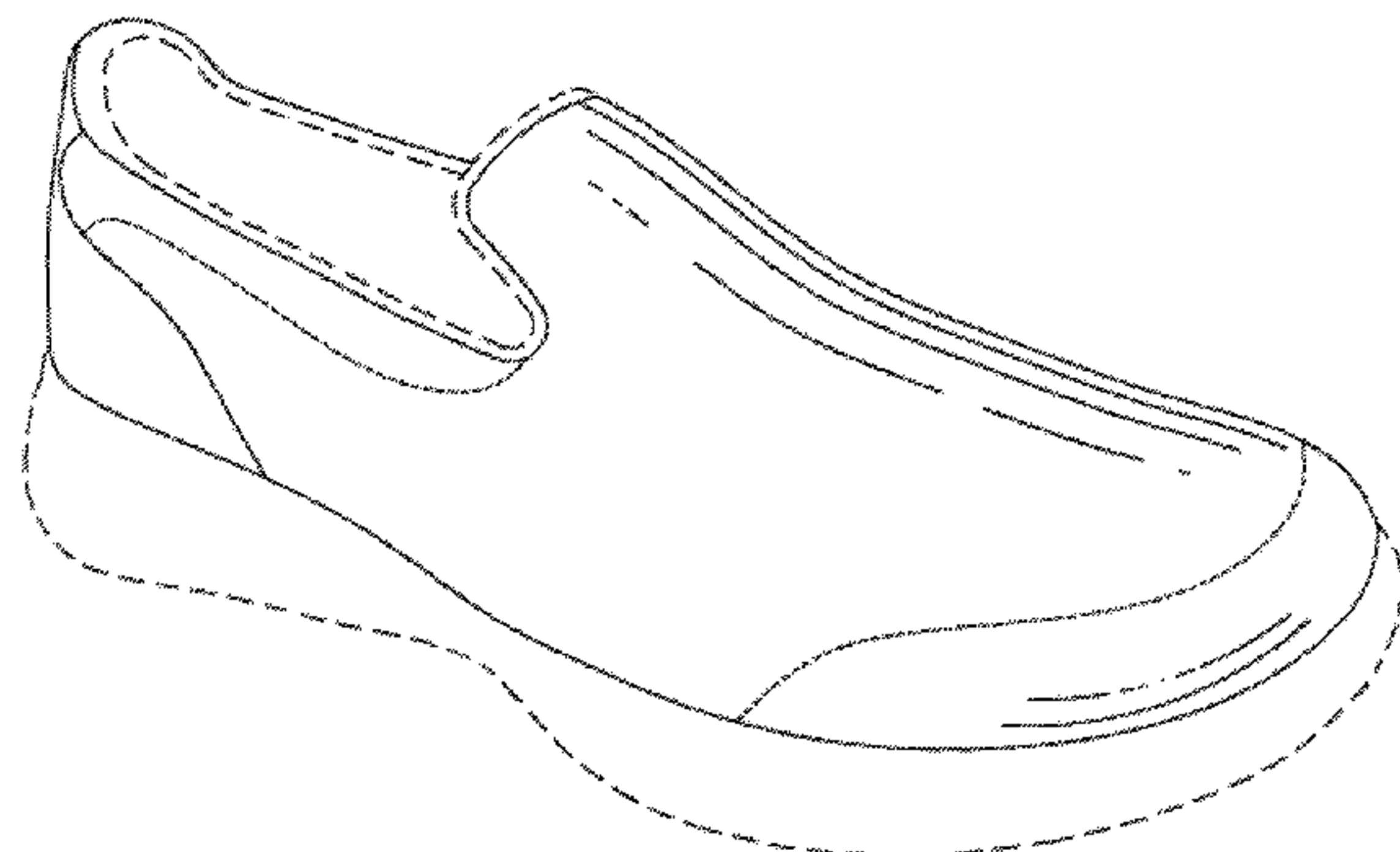
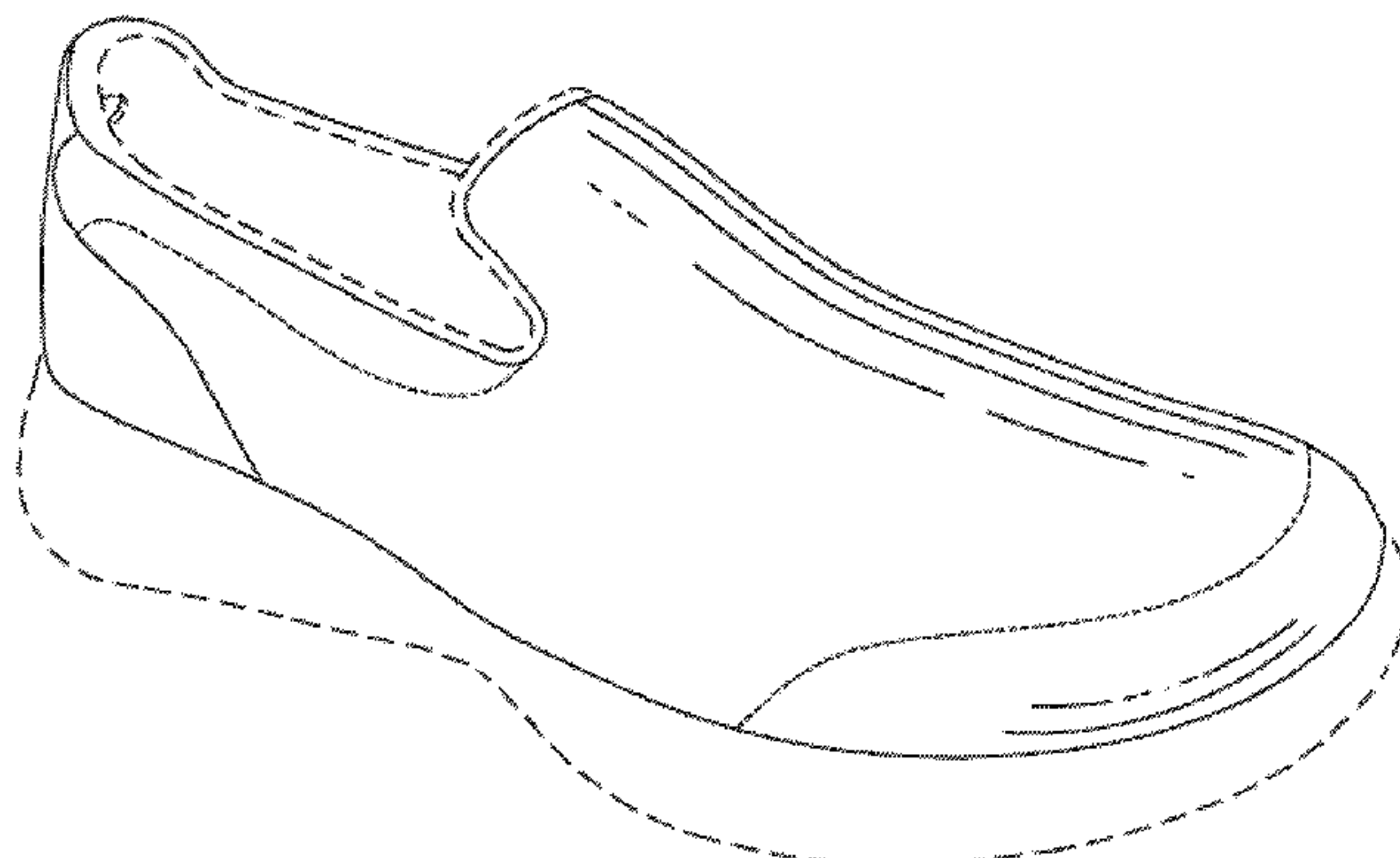
FIG. 14 is a bottom plan view thereof;

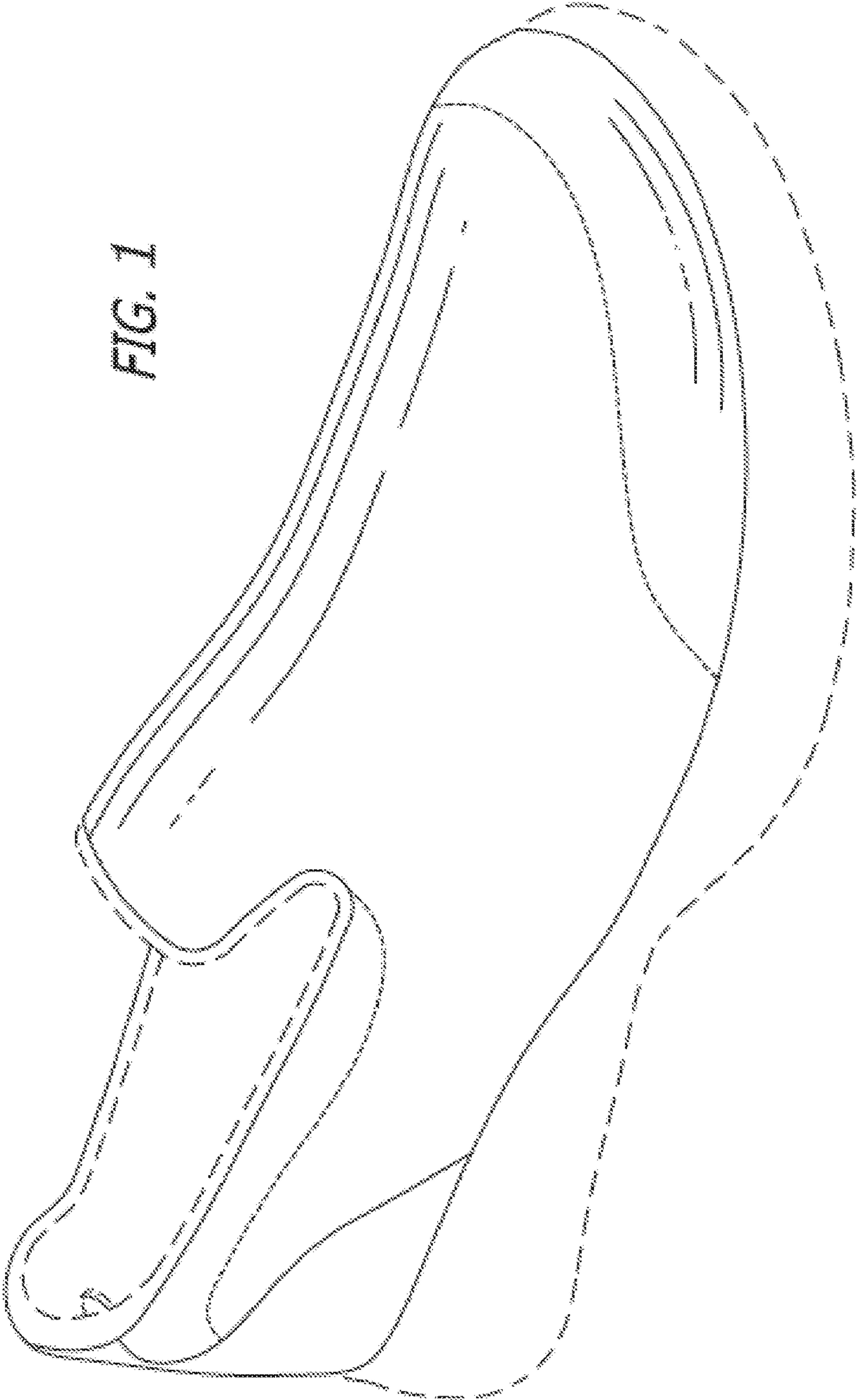


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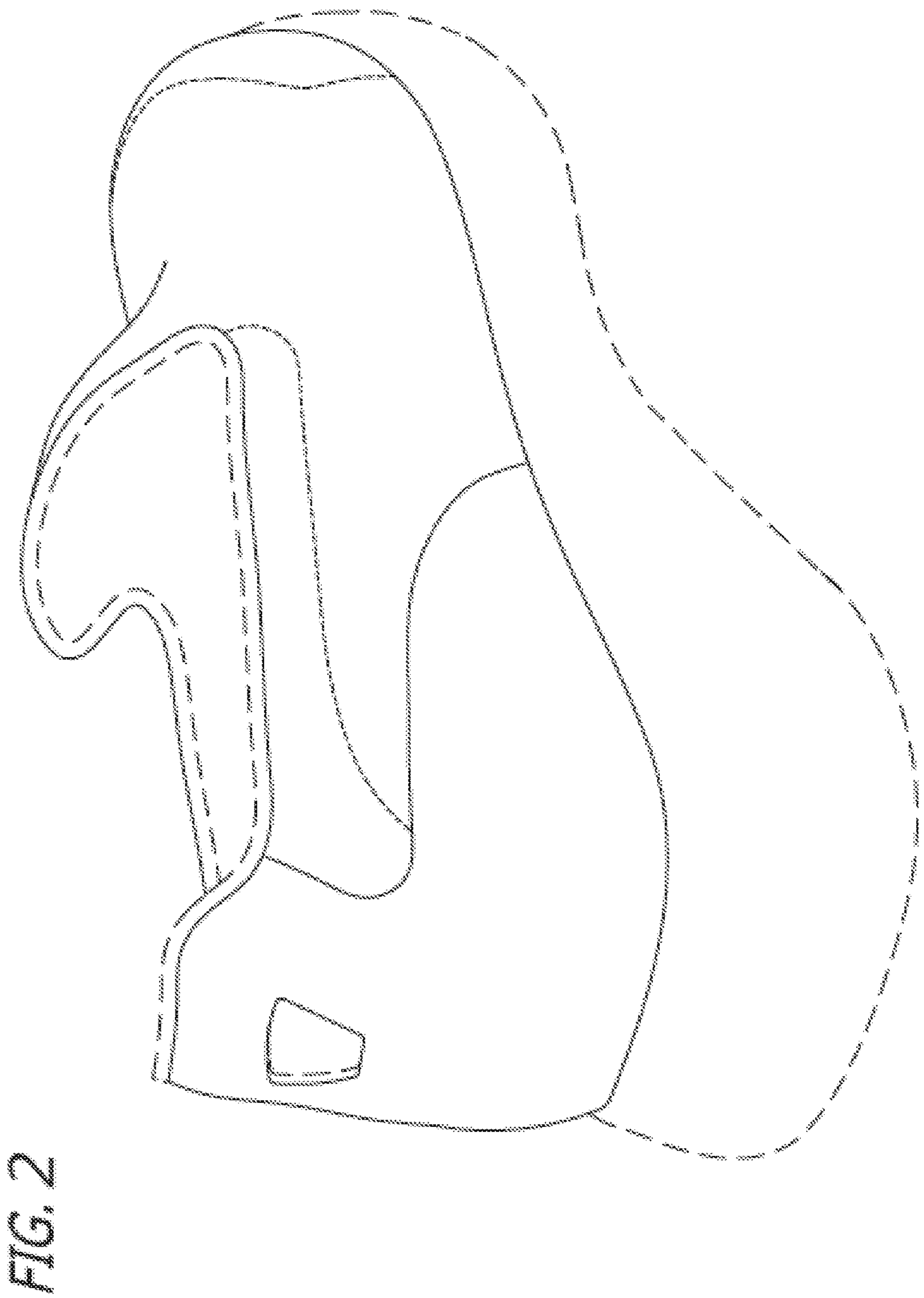

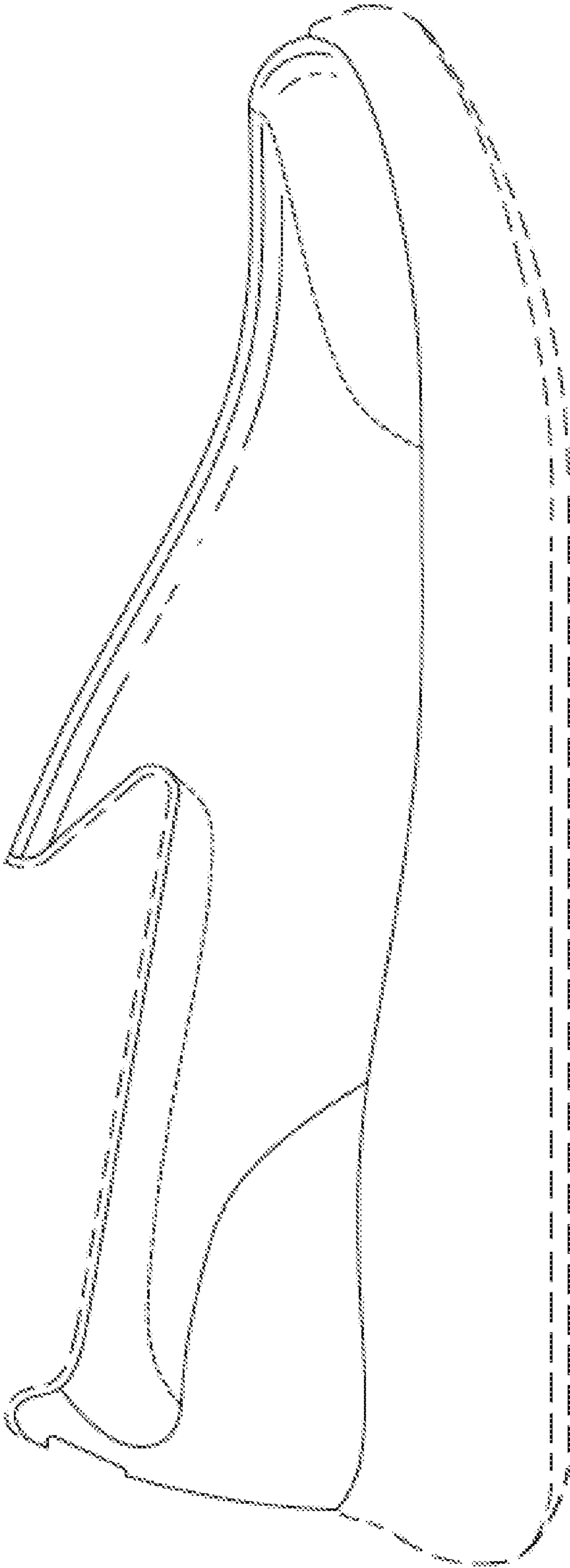

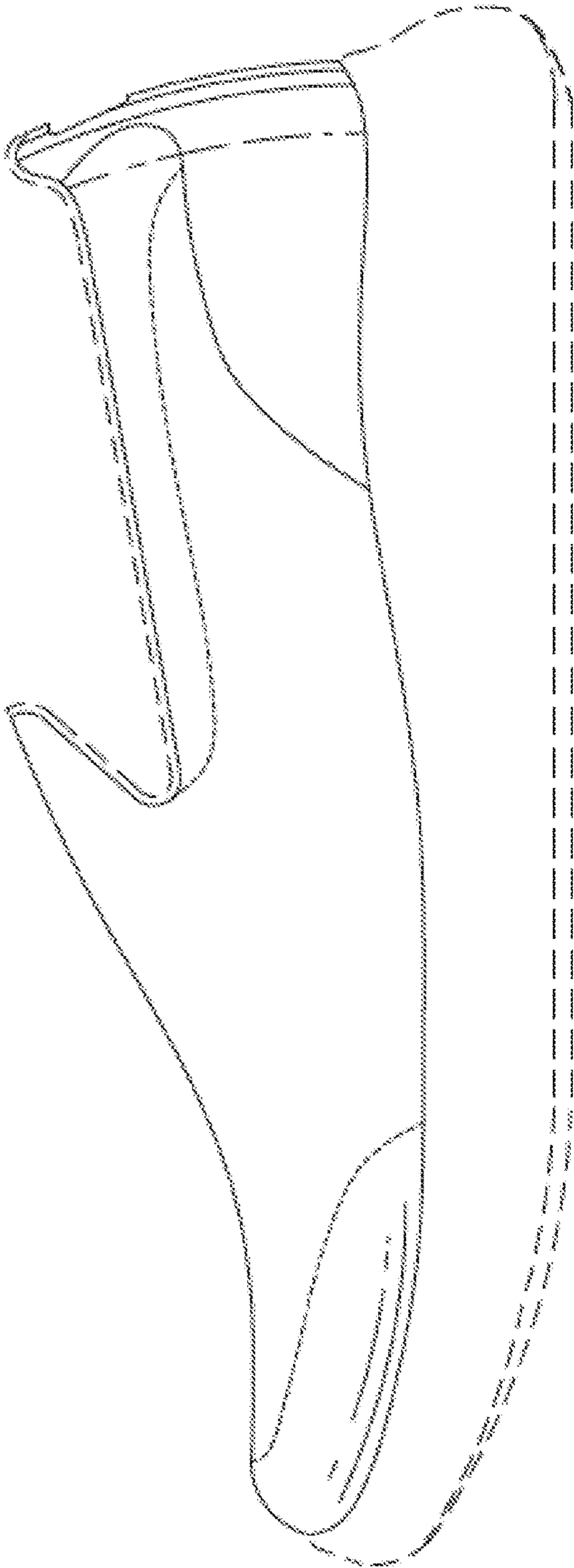

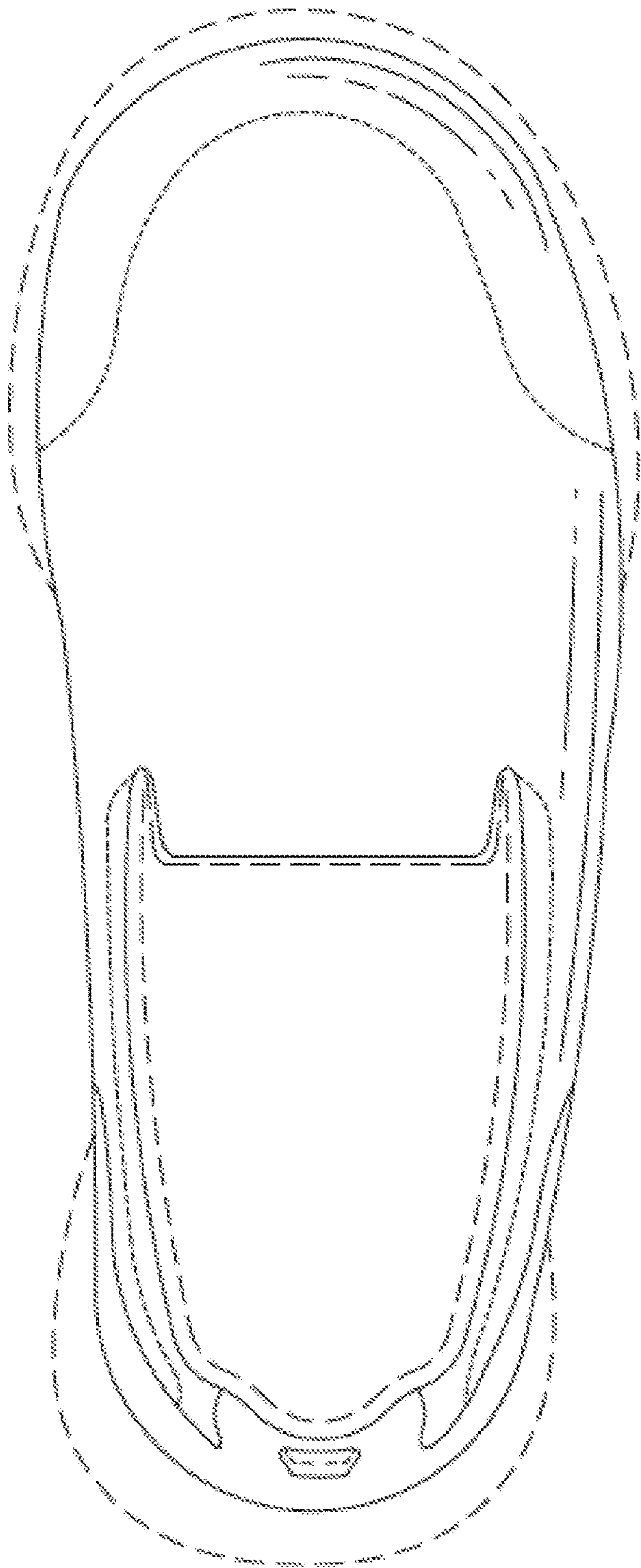

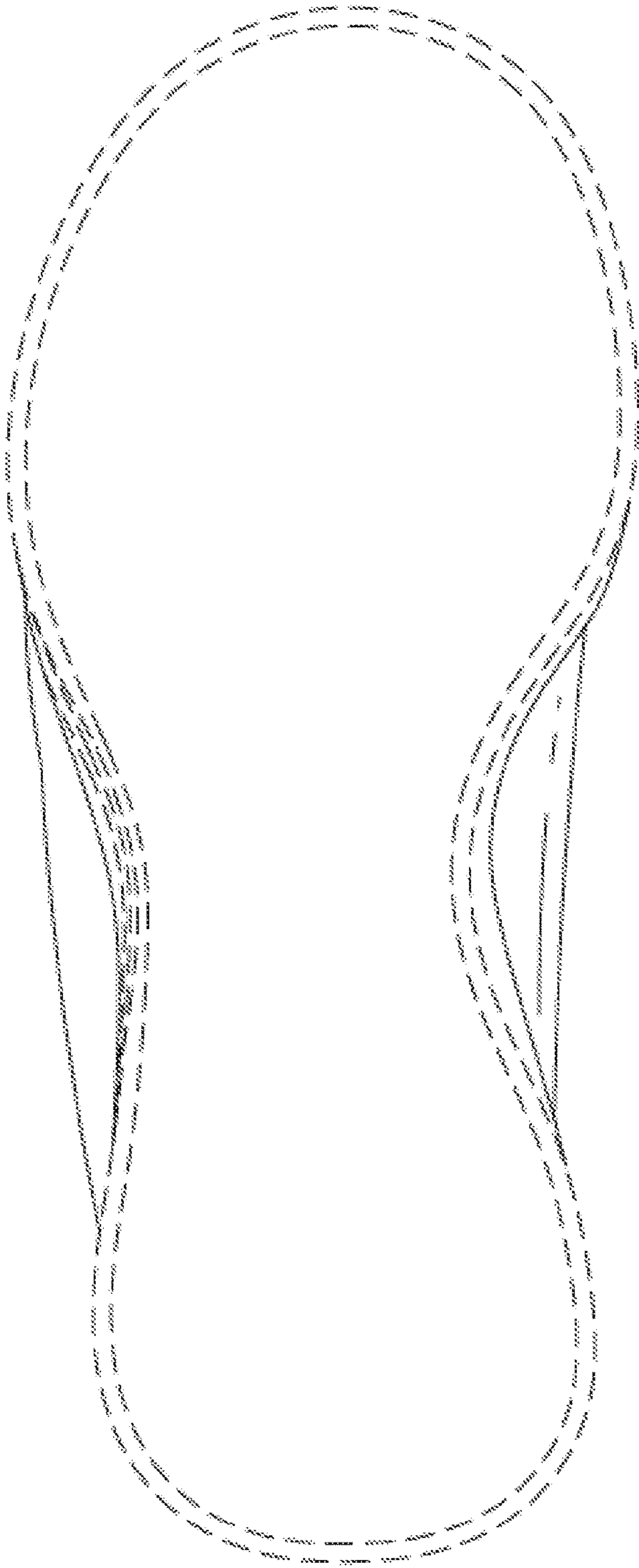

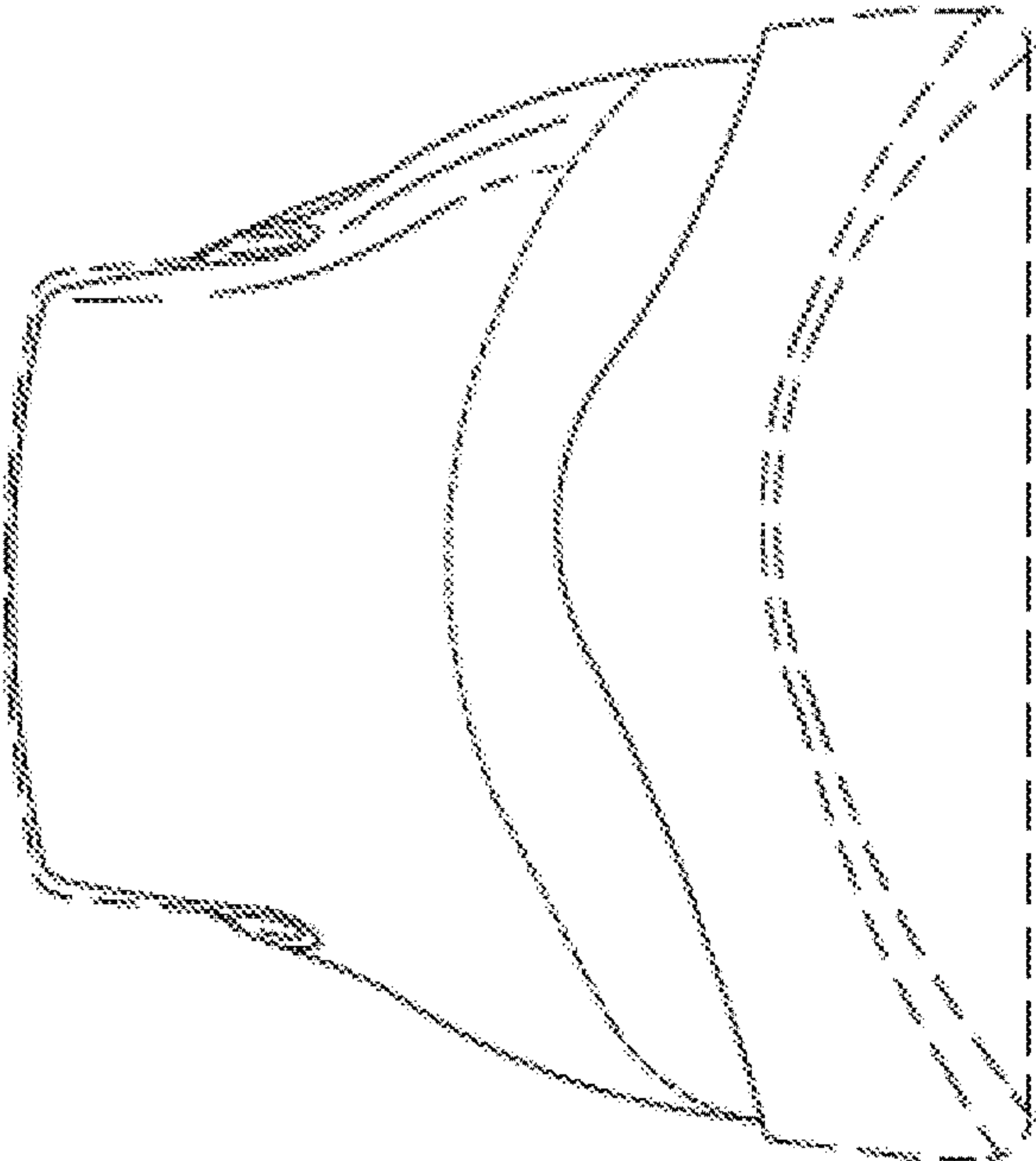
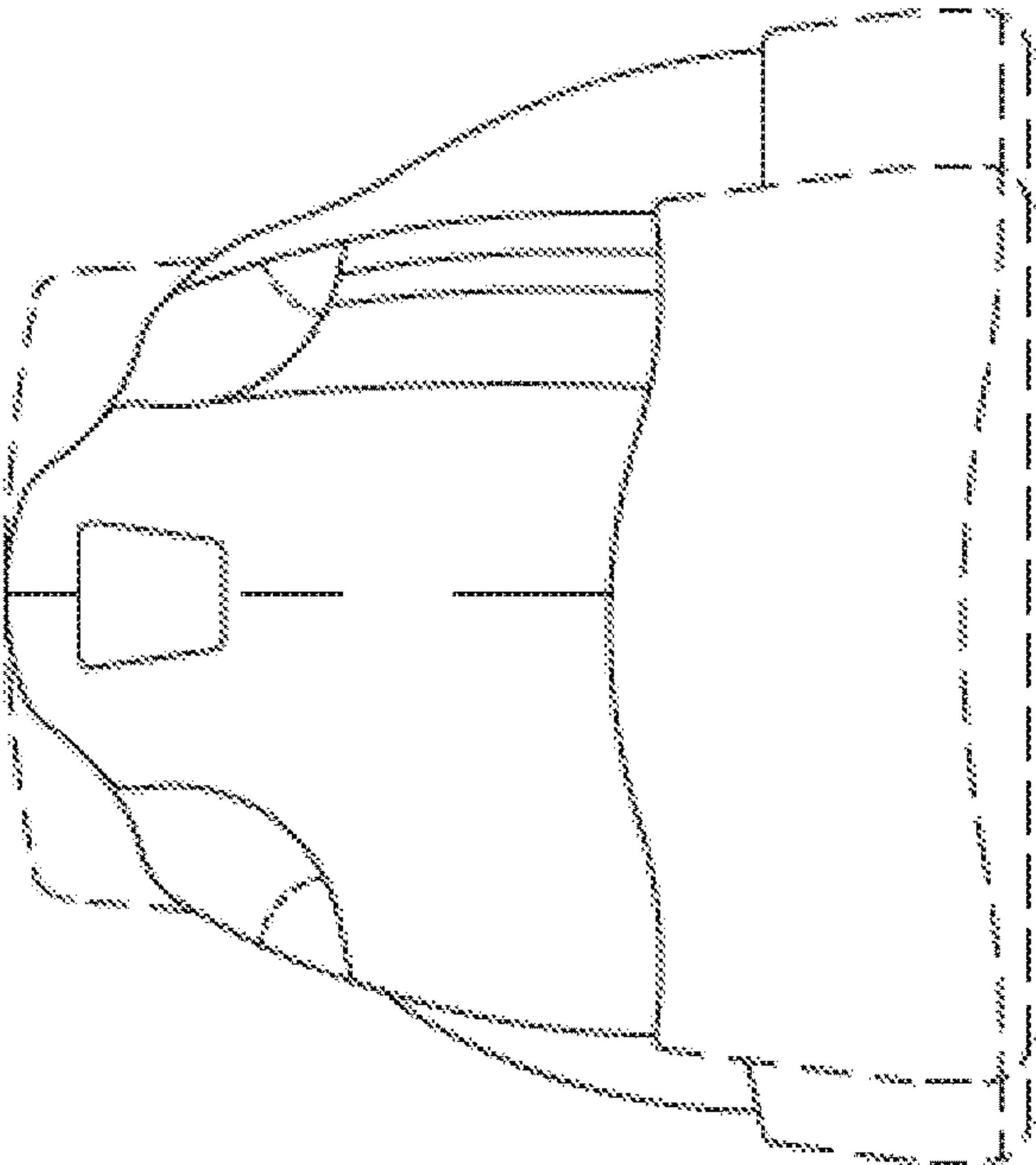
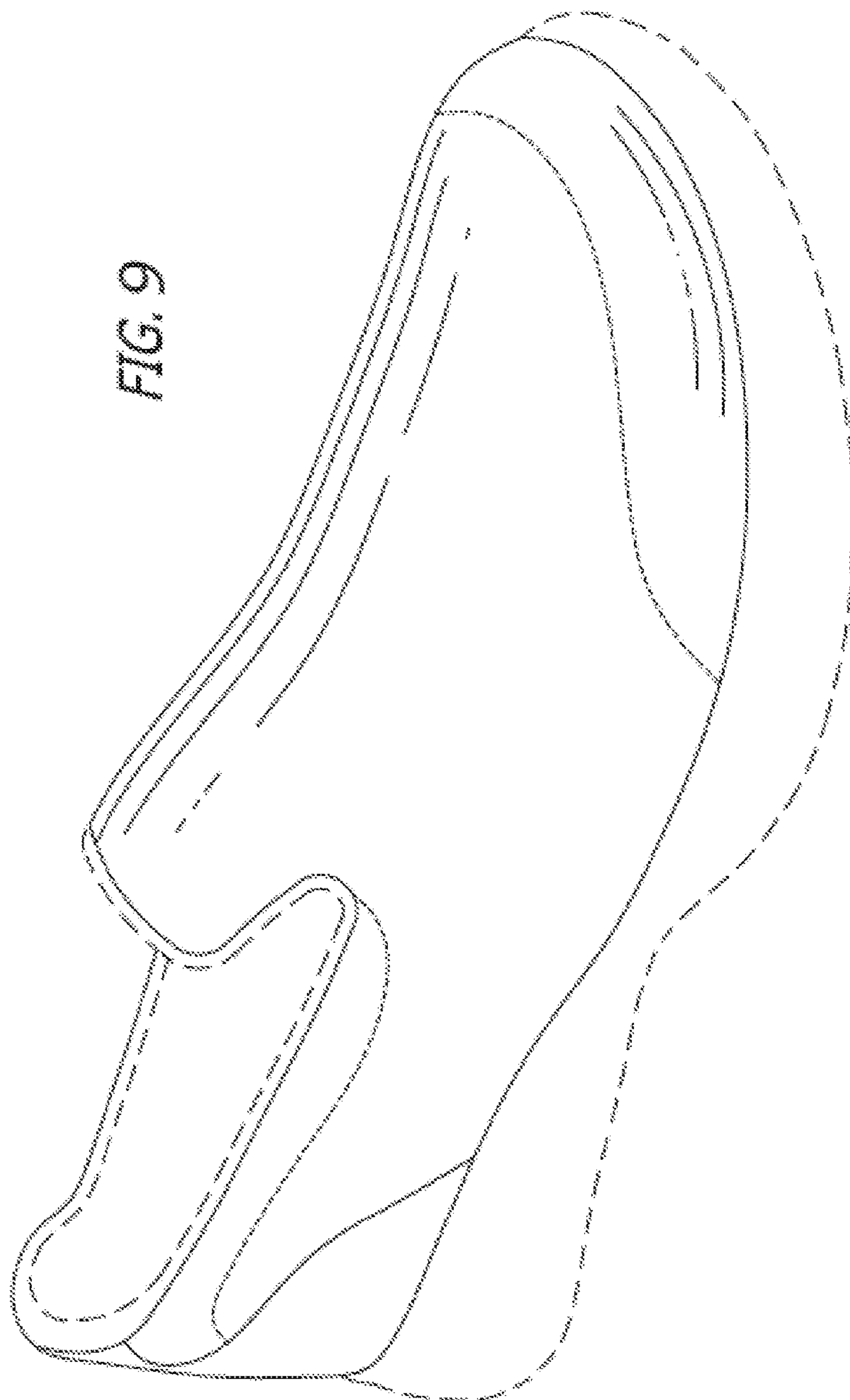

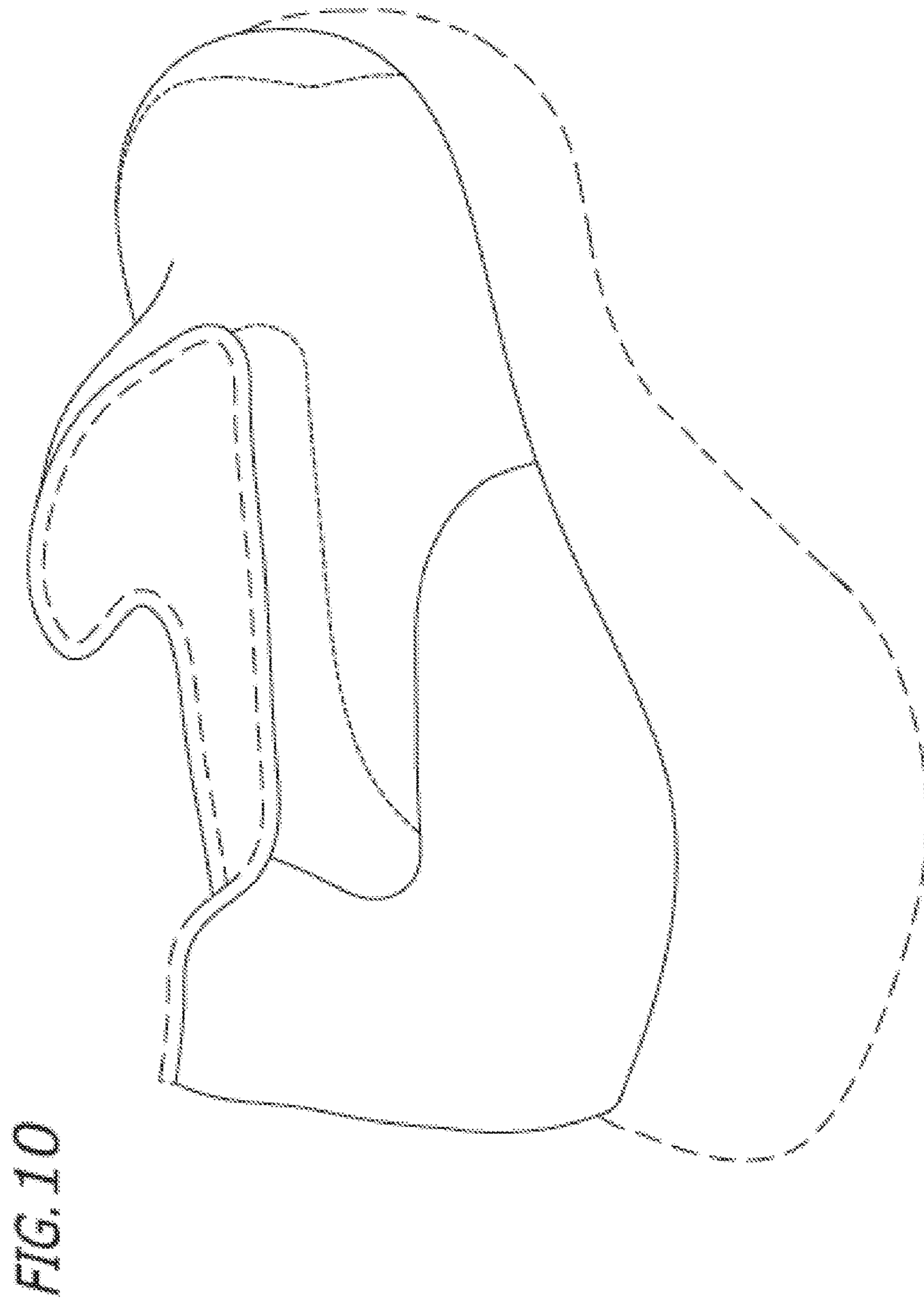

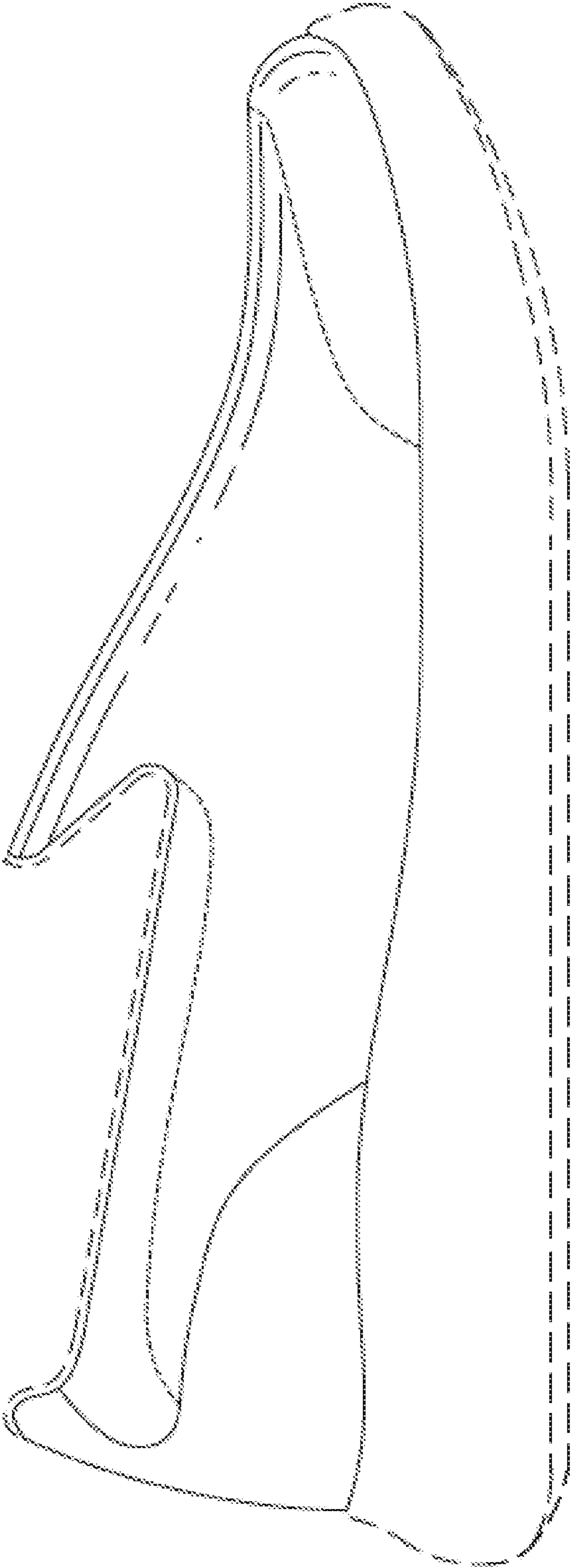

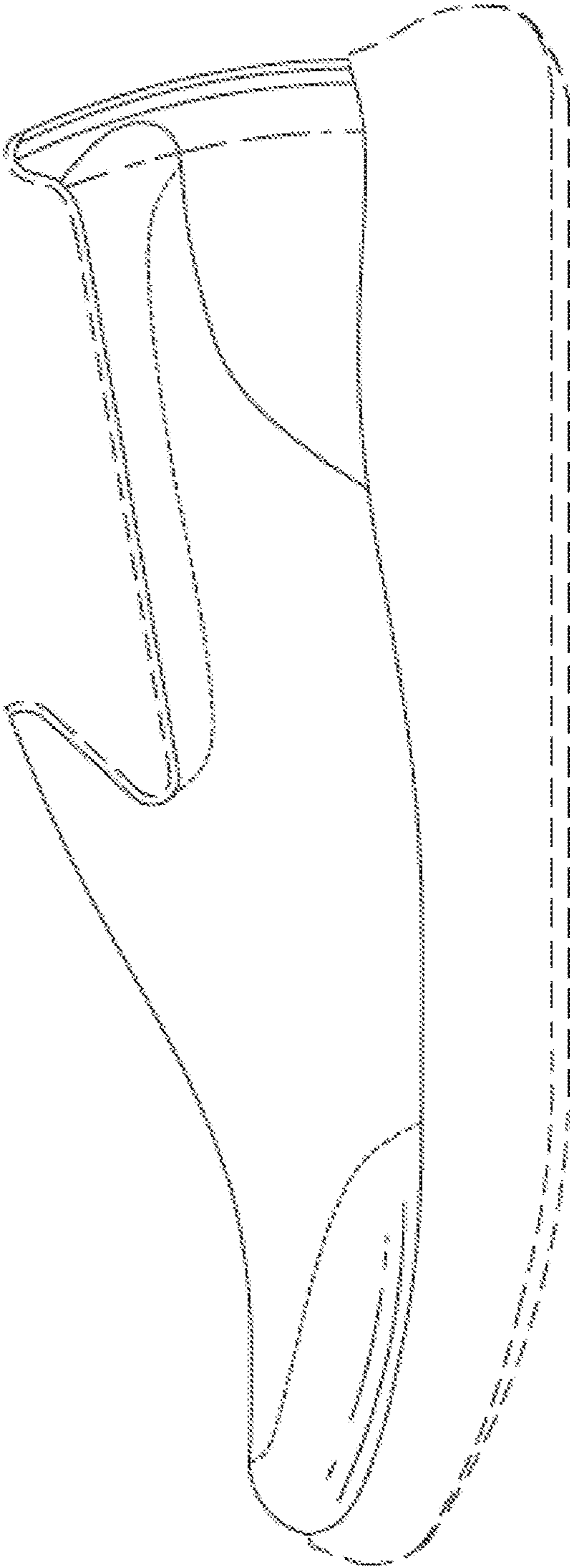

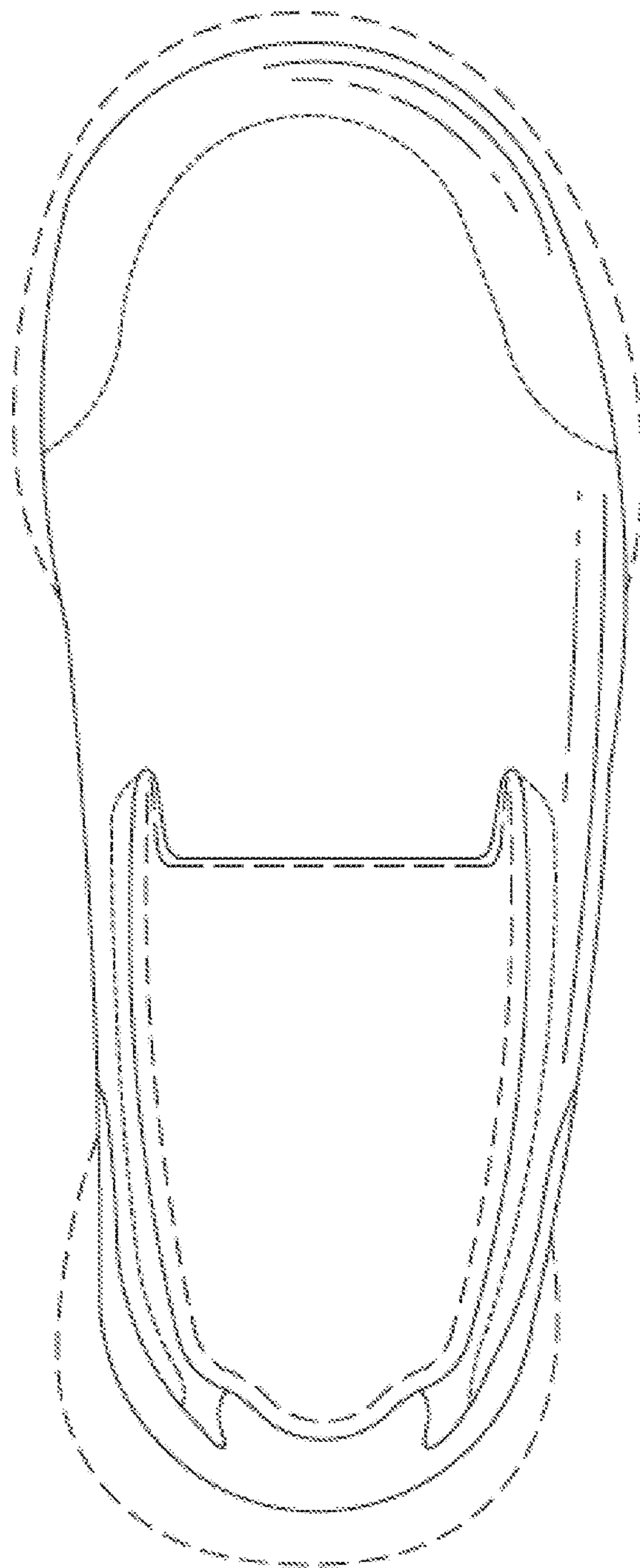

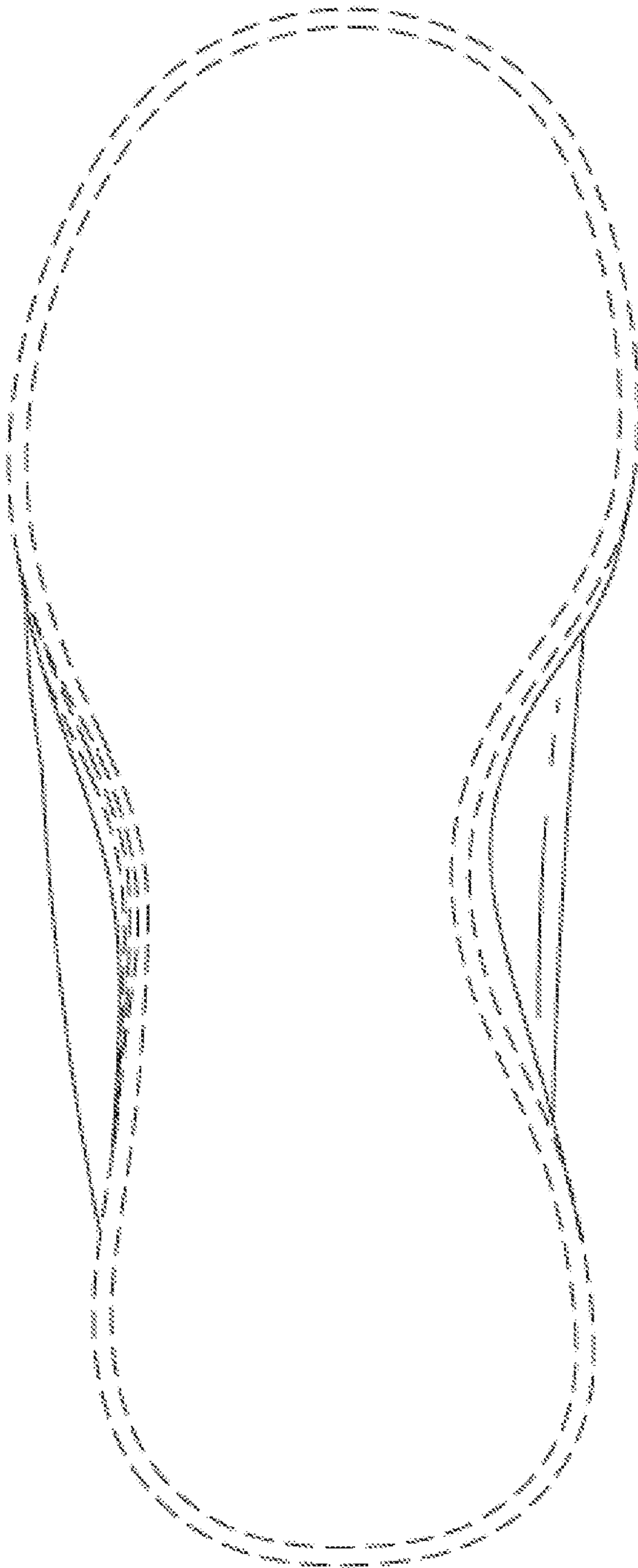

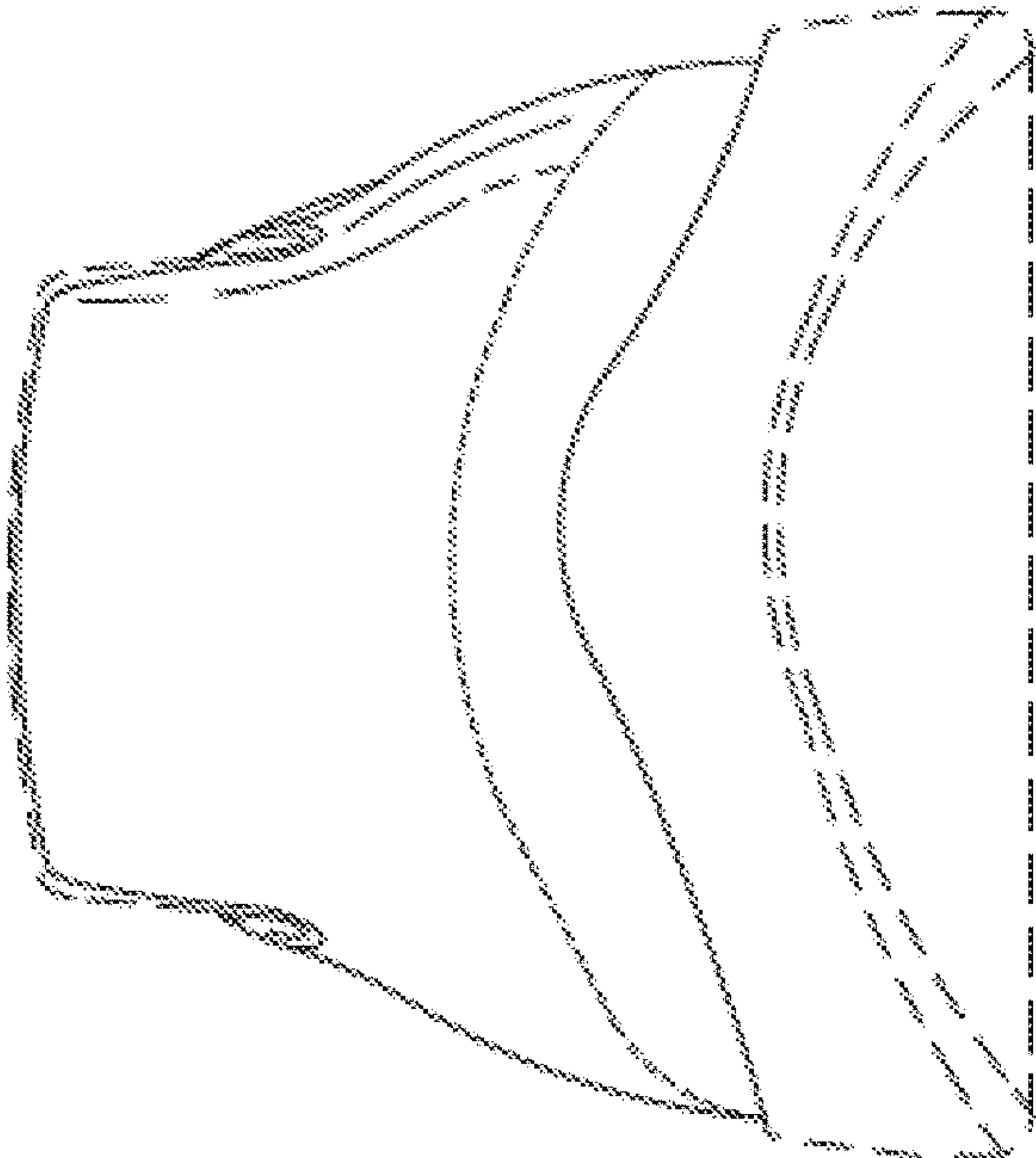
