The dash-dot lines forming a circle in FIGS. 1, 2, 8, 9, and 10 form no part of the claimed design.

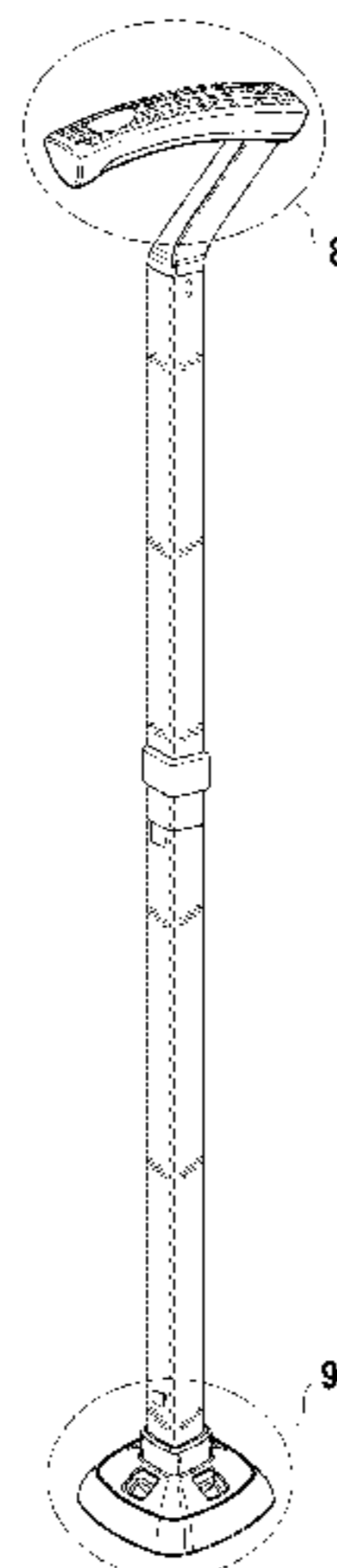

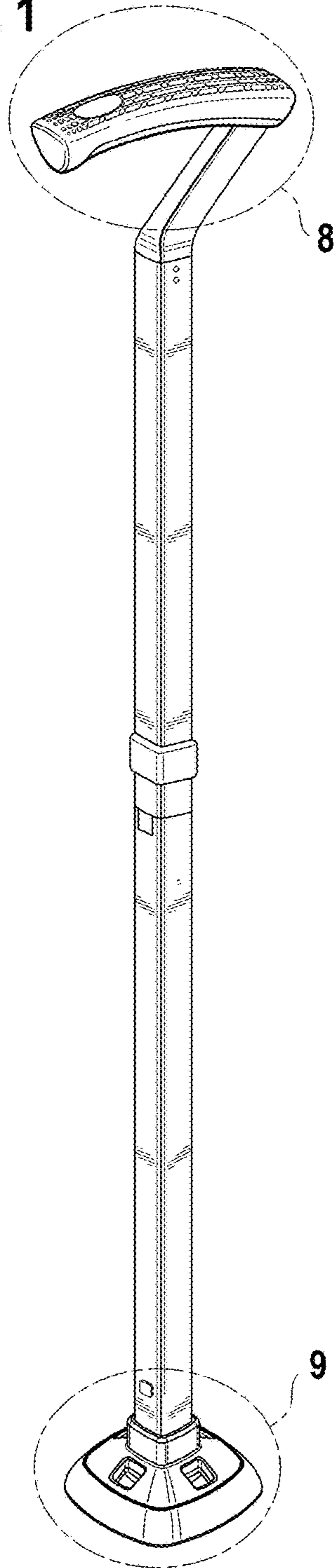

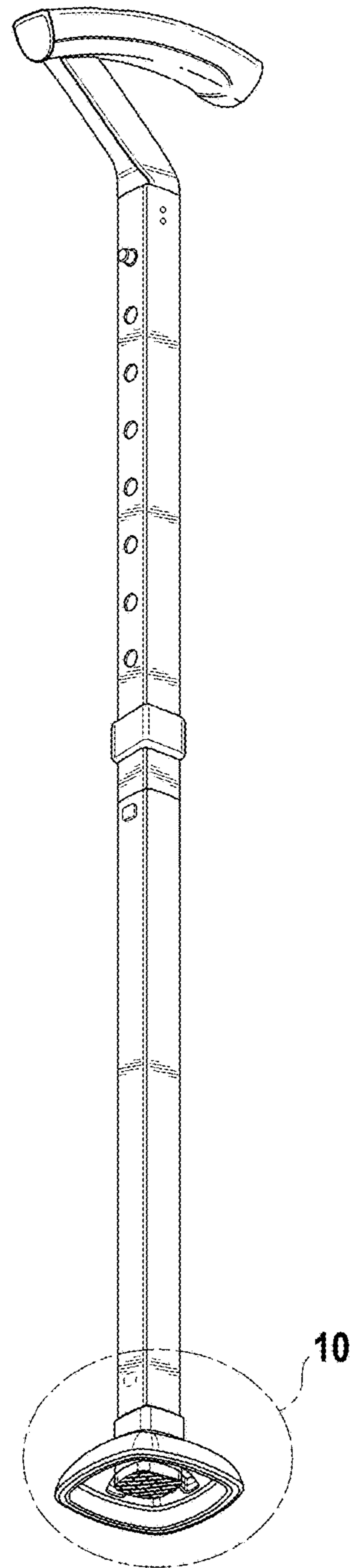

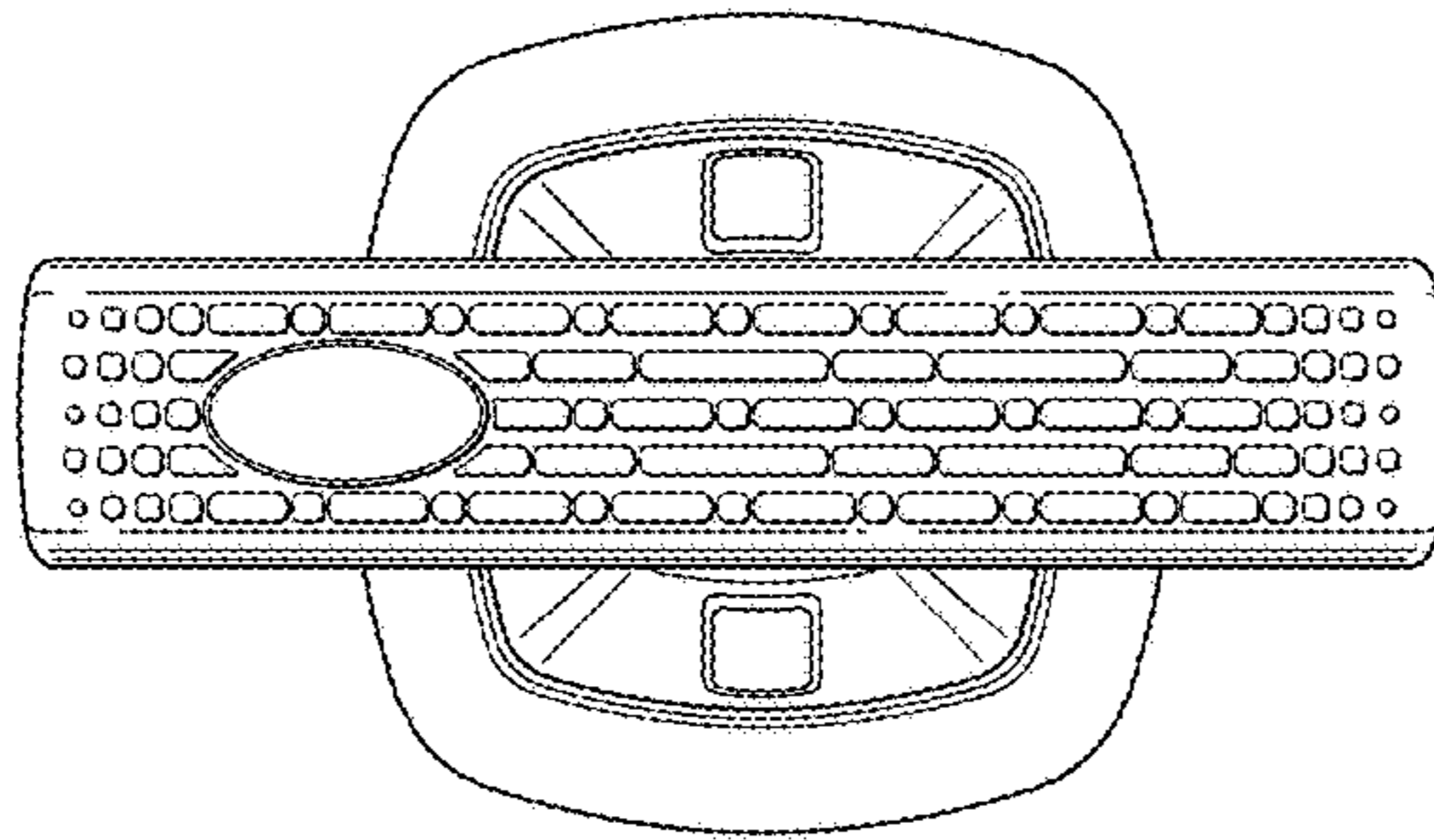

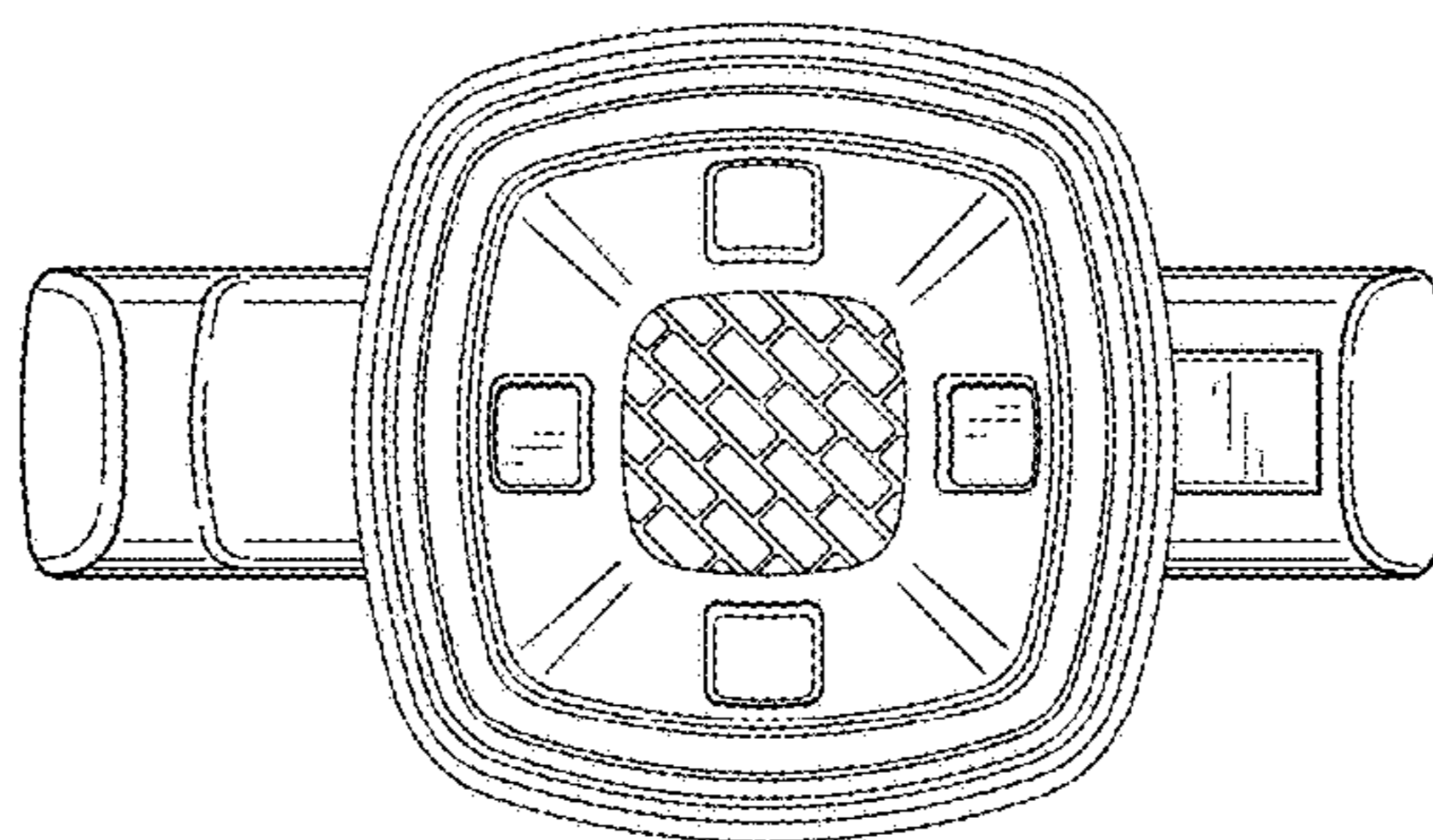

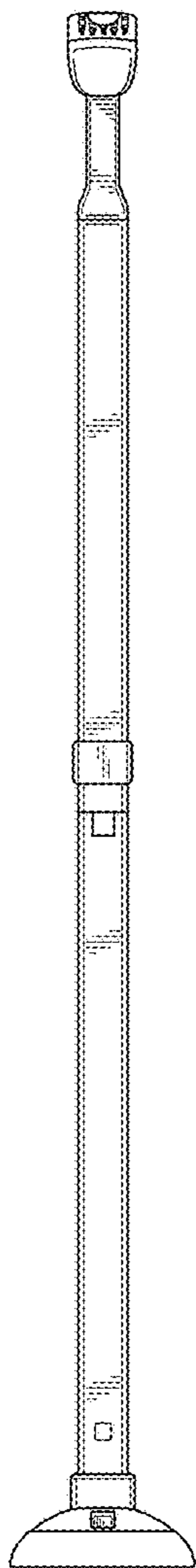

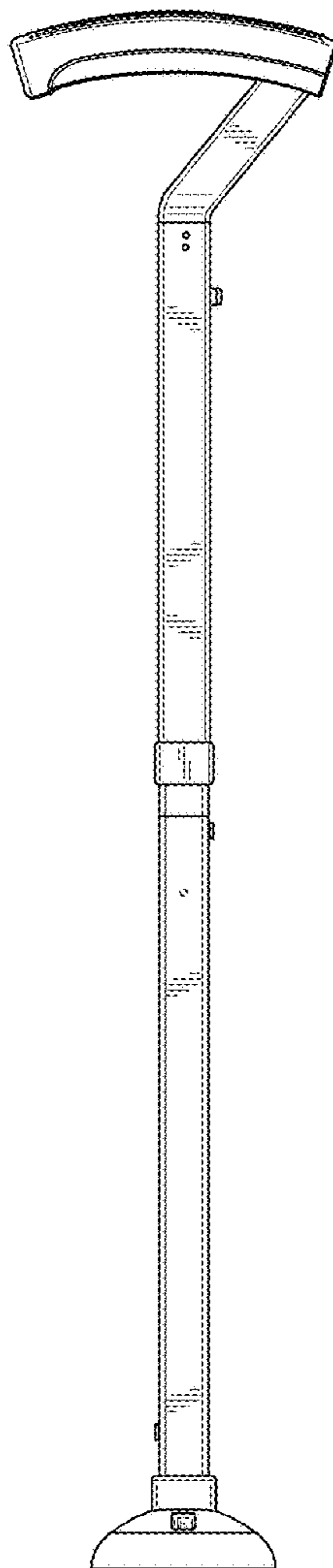

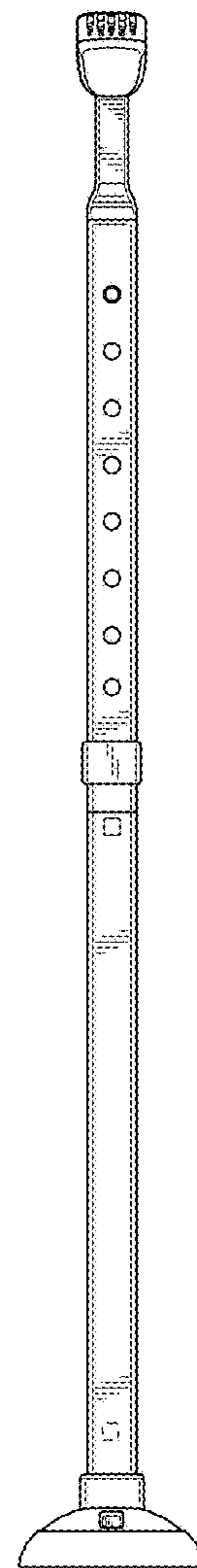

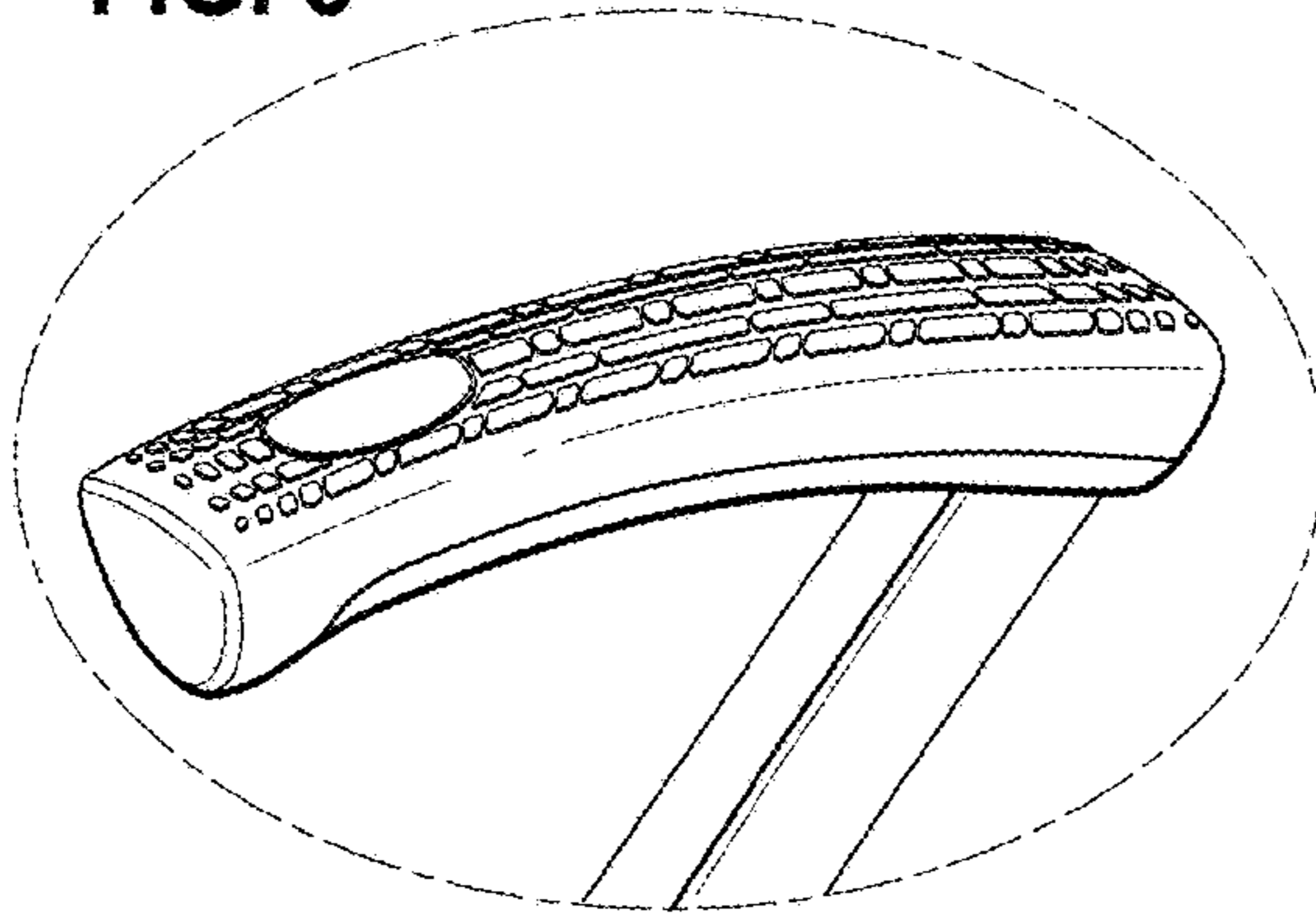

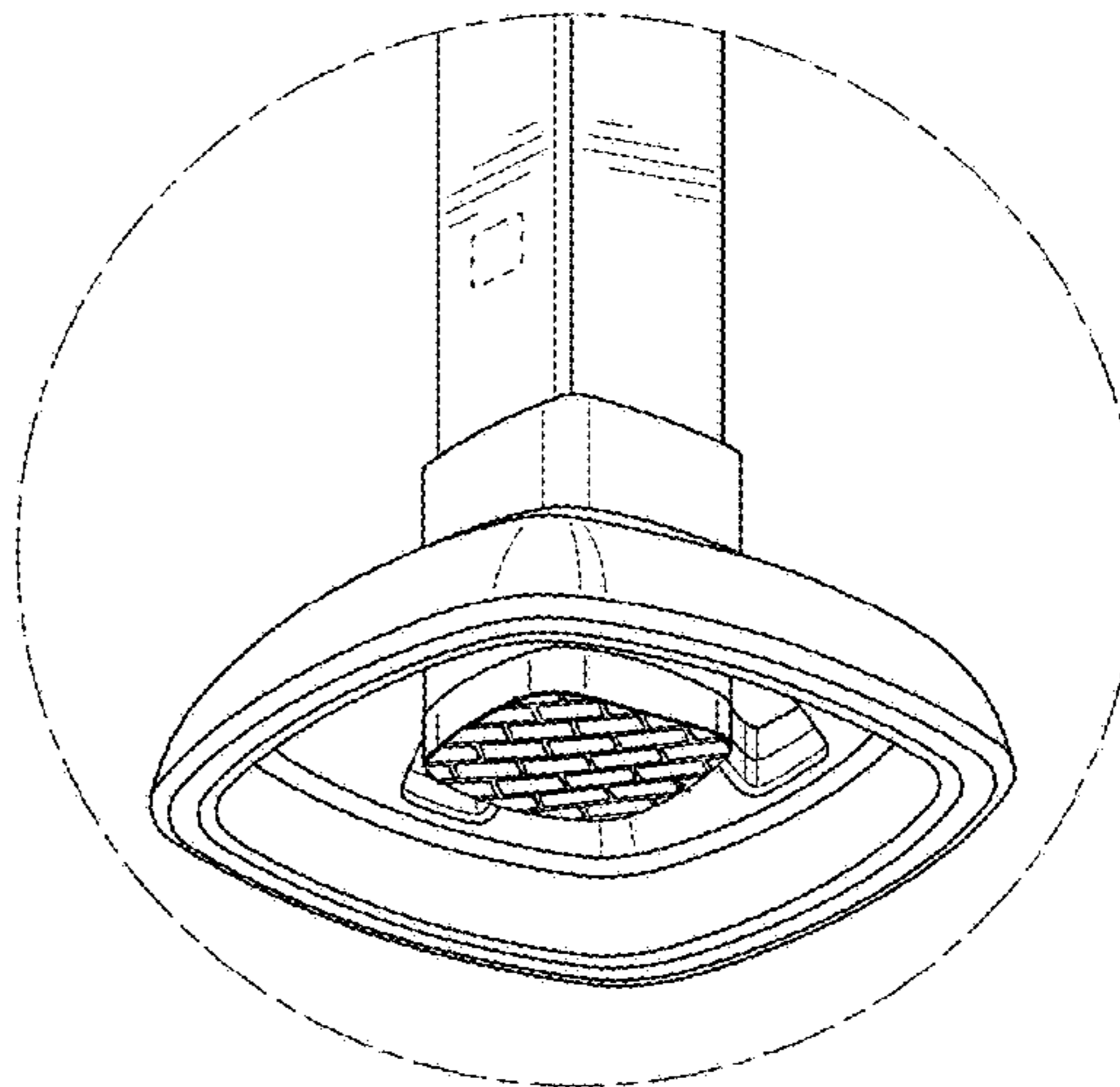
