FIG. 3 is a front elevation view.

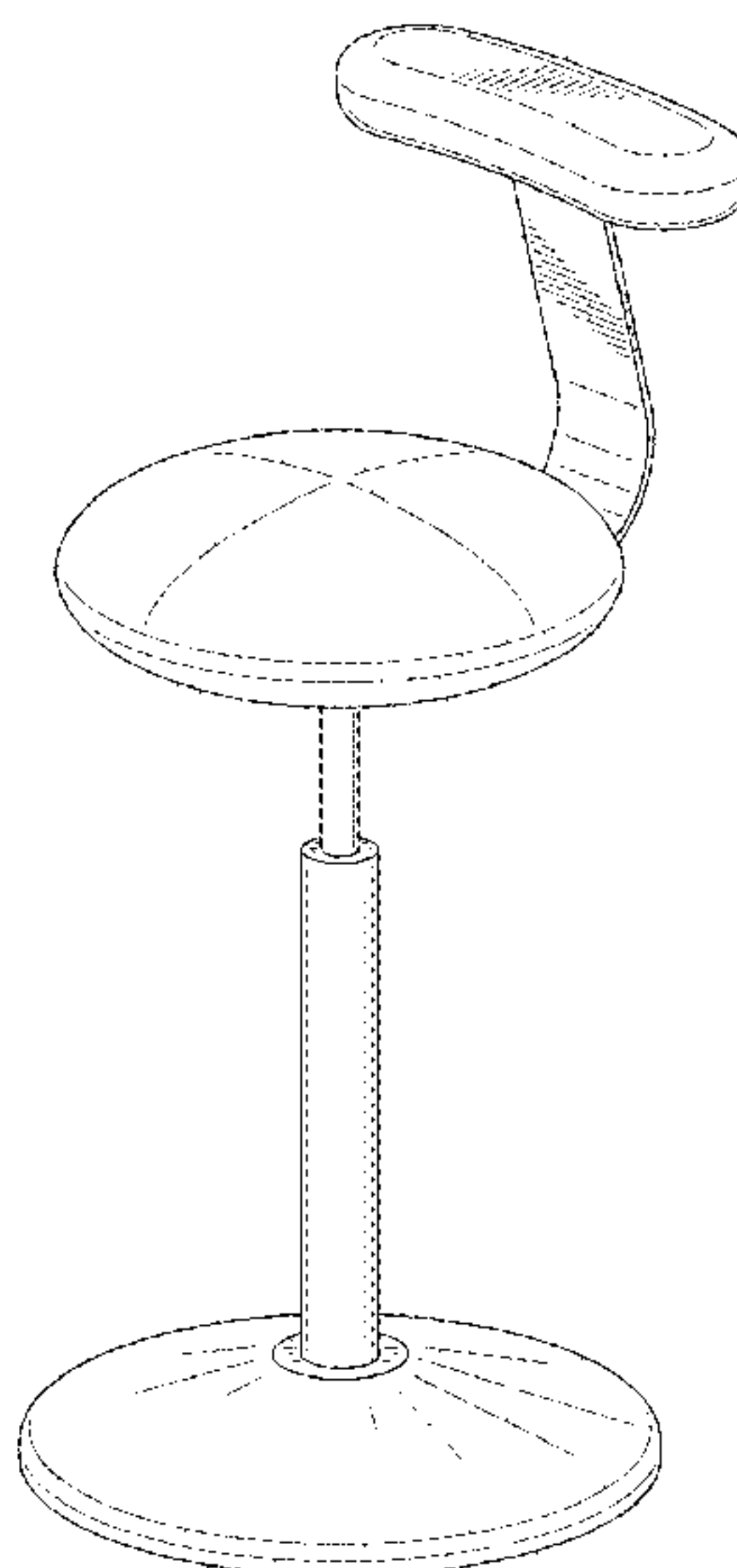
FIG. 4 is a back elevation view.

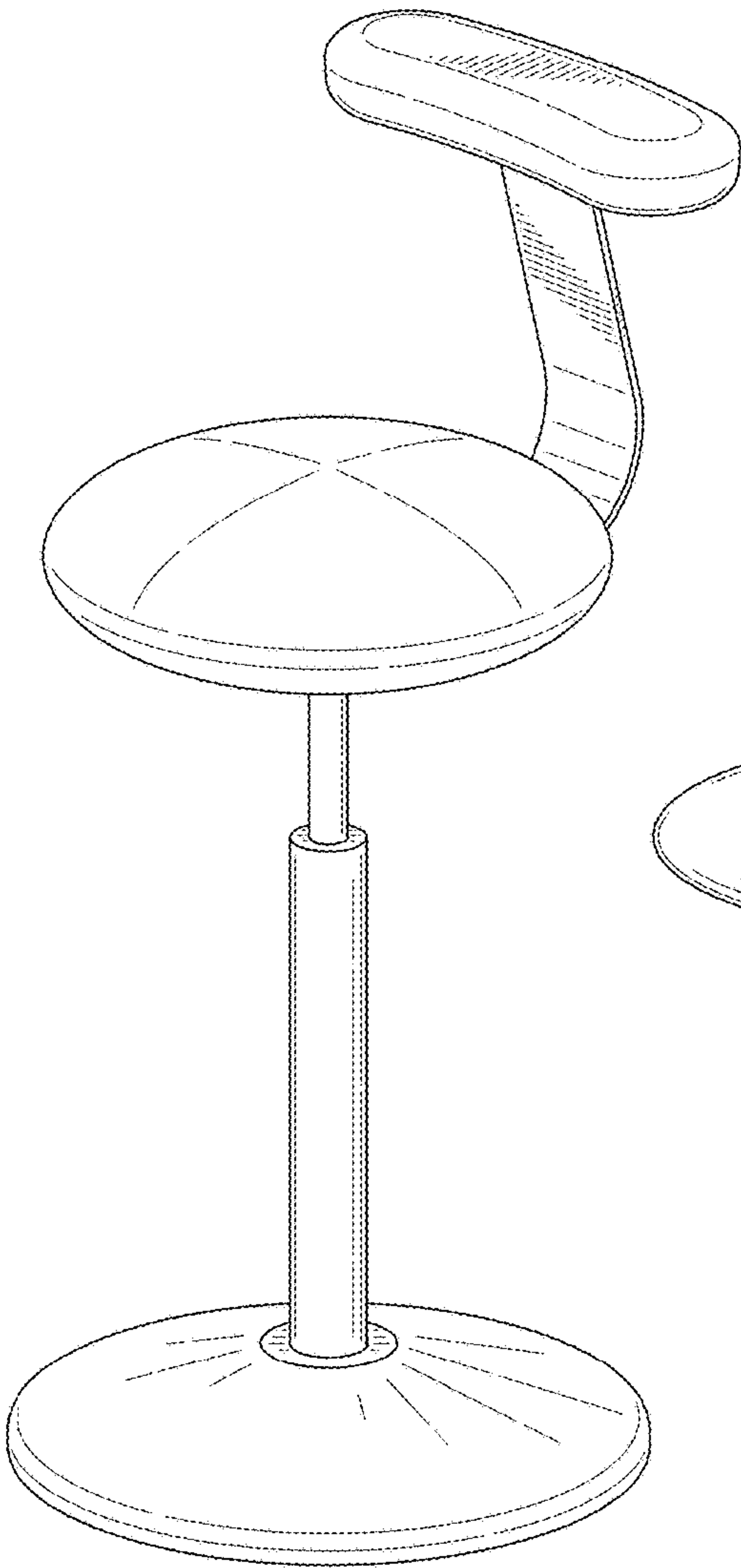

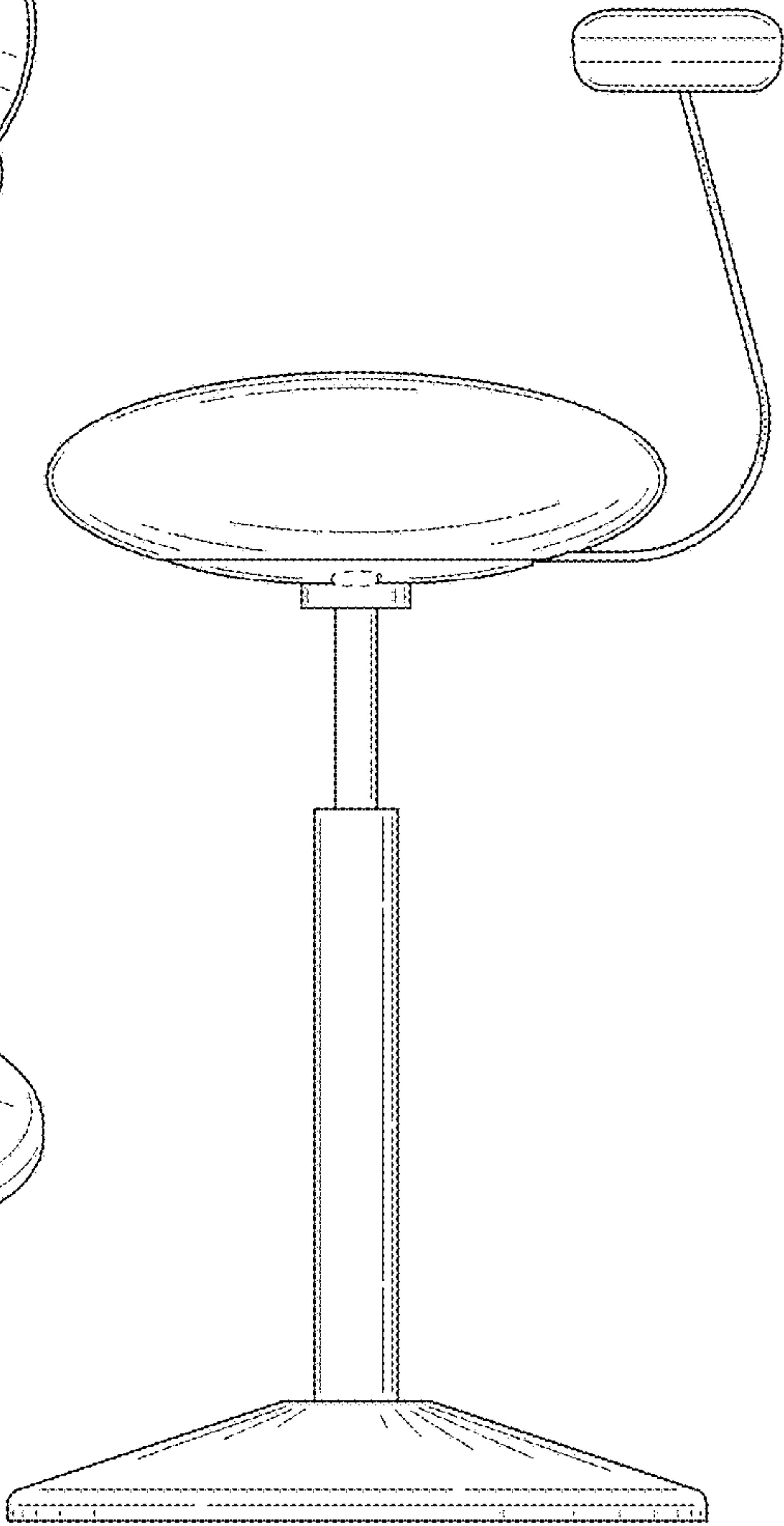

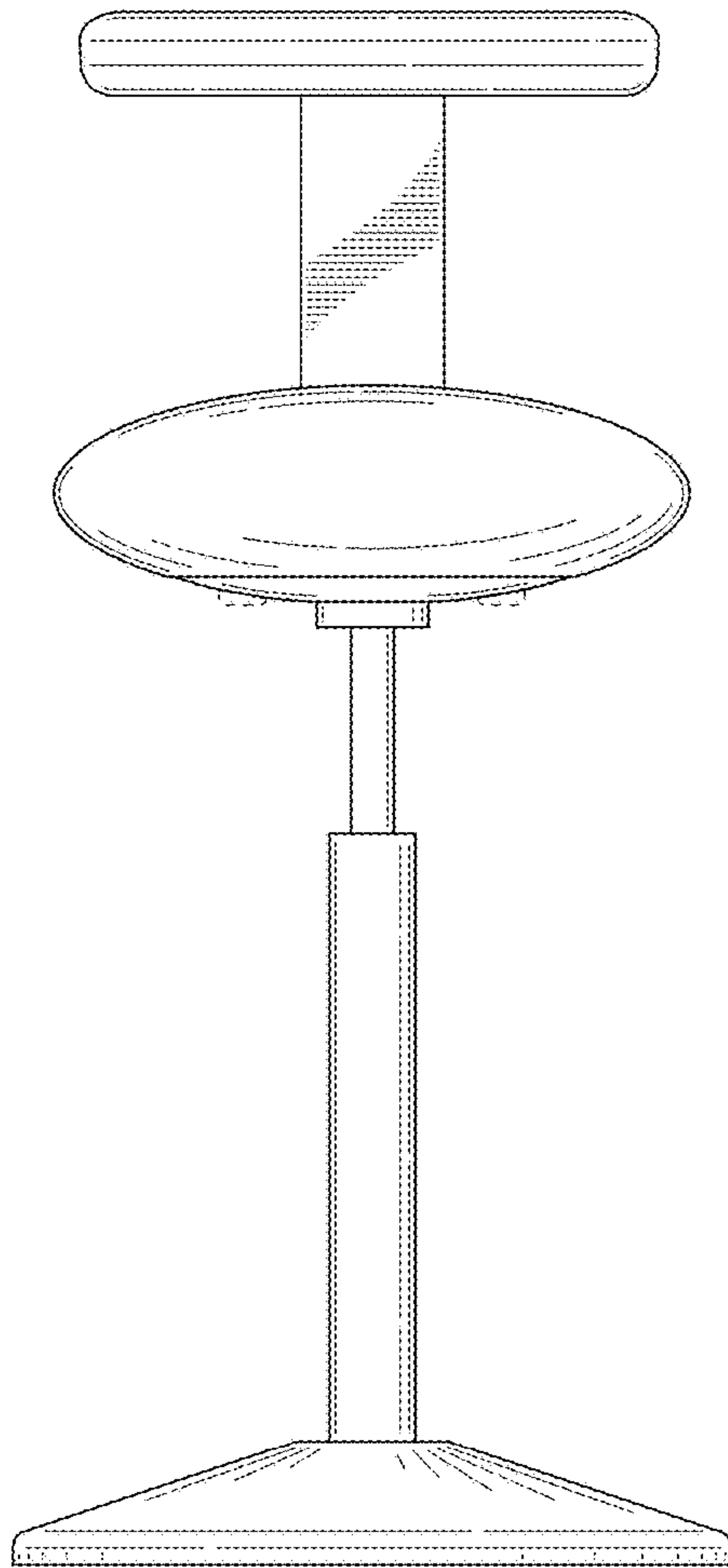

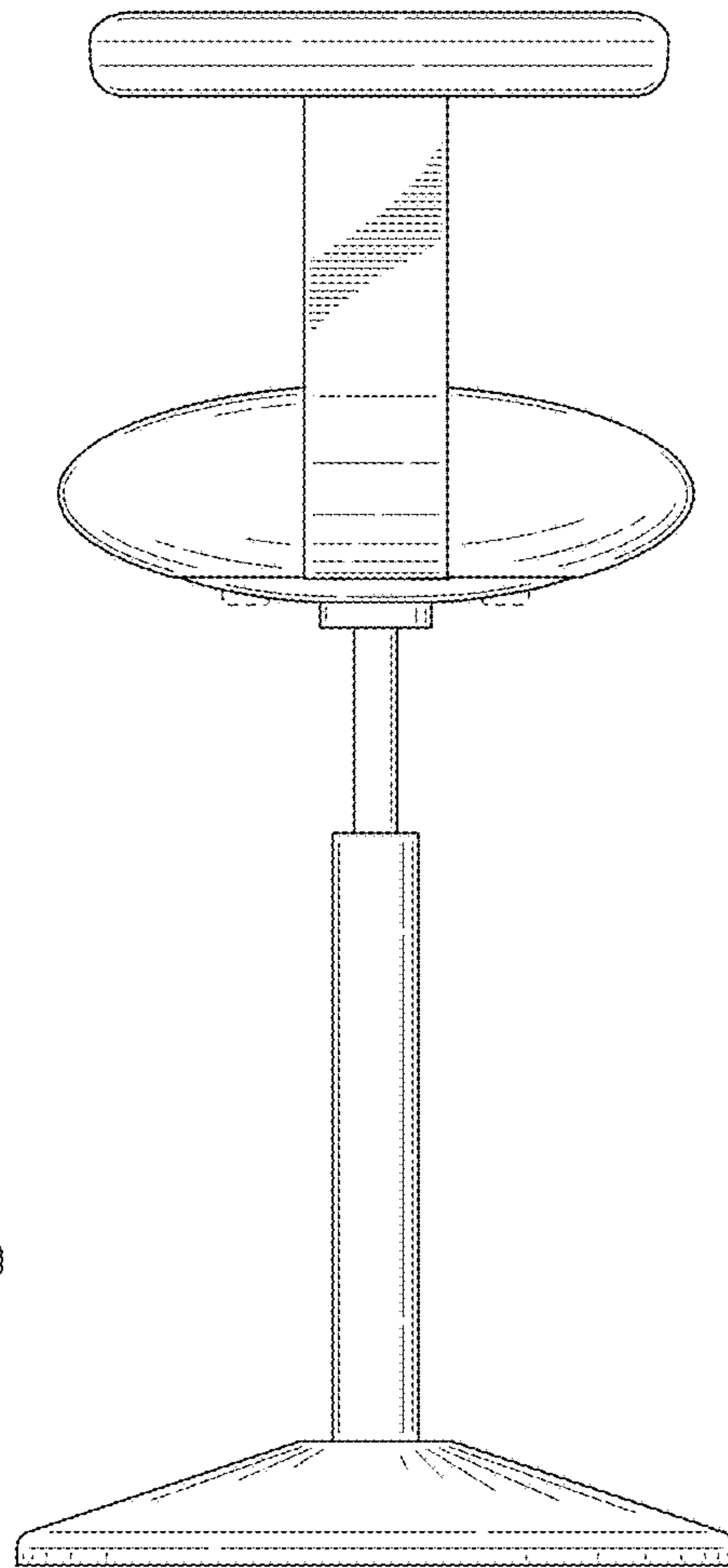

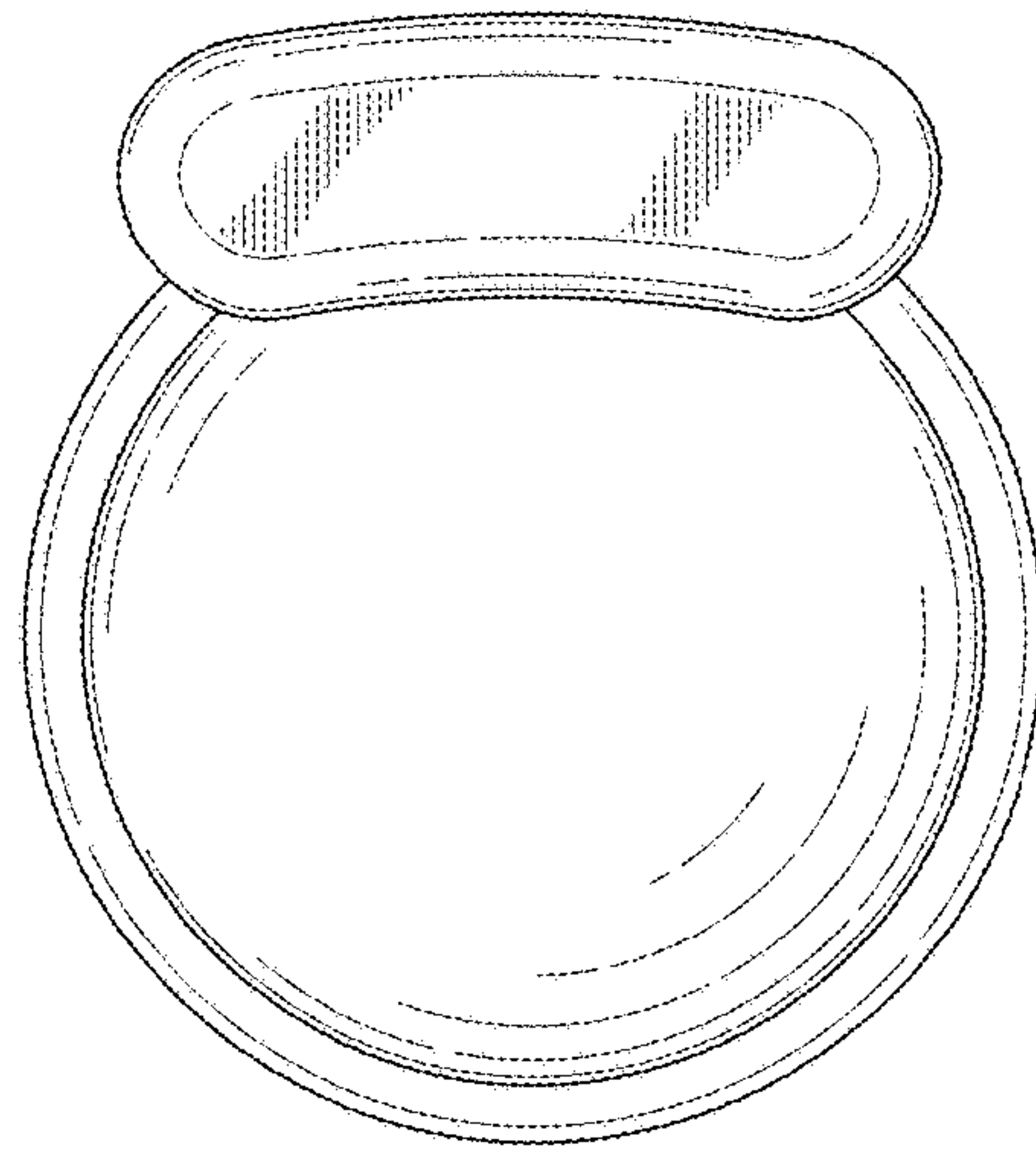

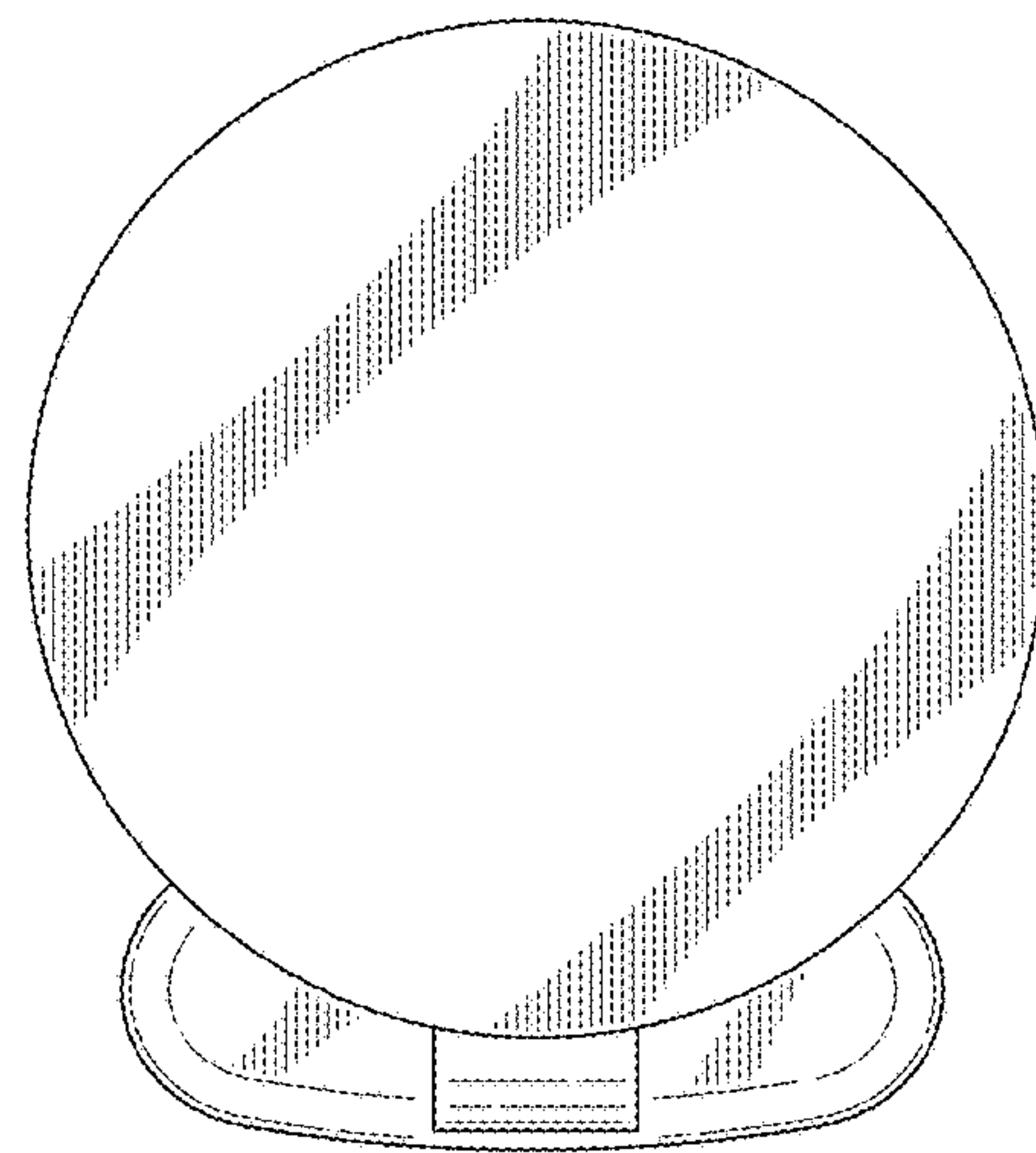
