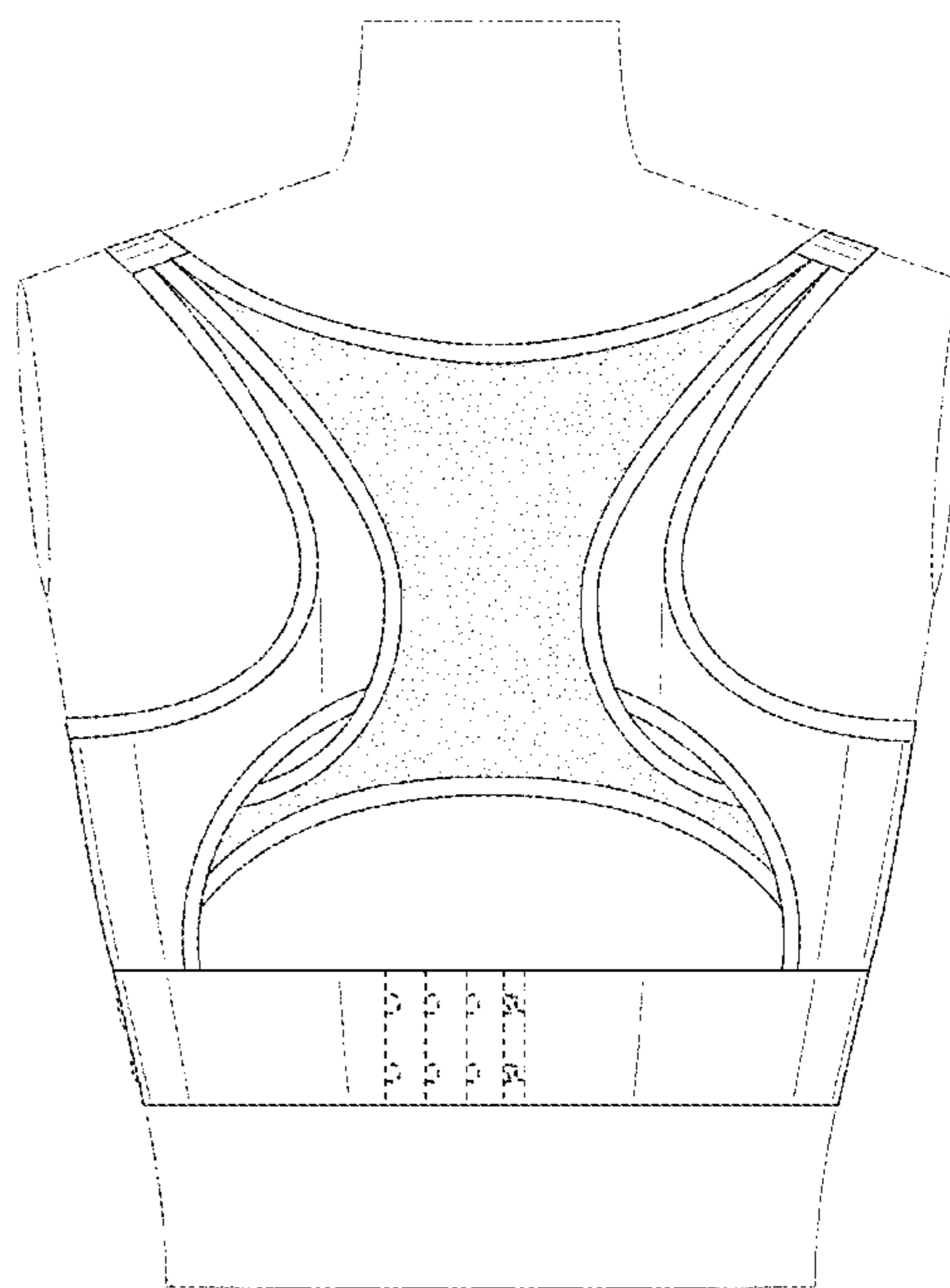
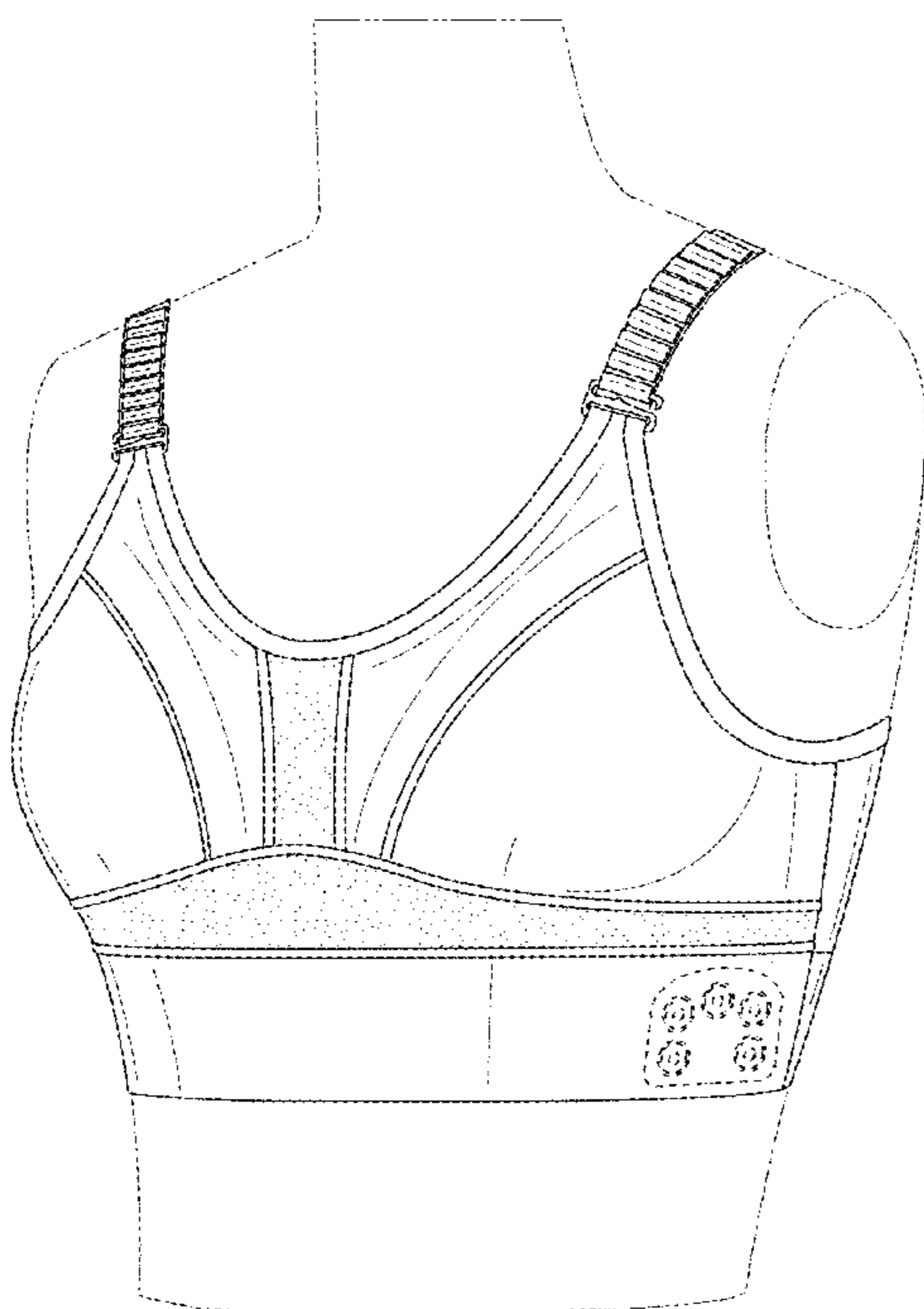
The ornamental design for a biosensing garment, as shown and described.

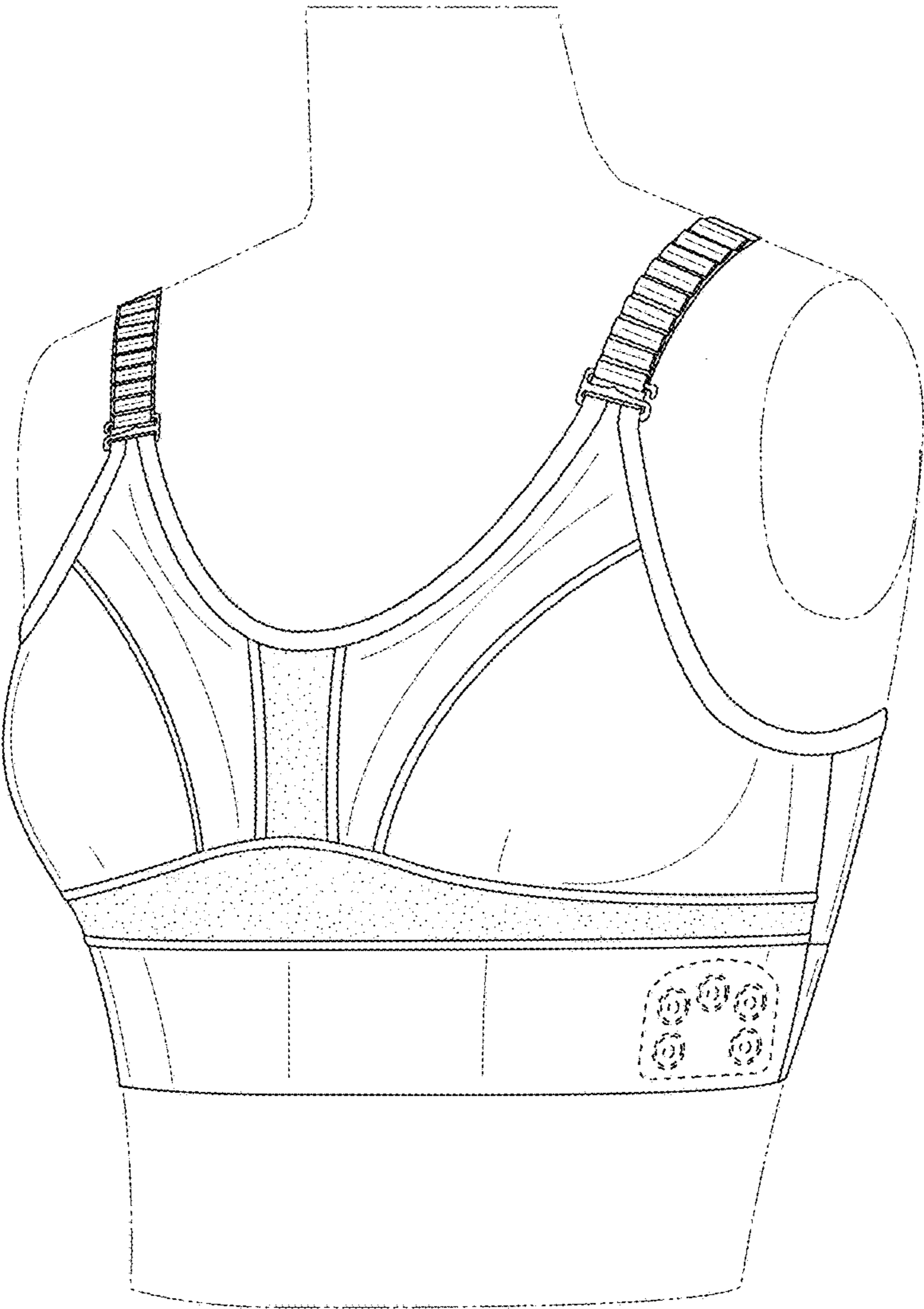

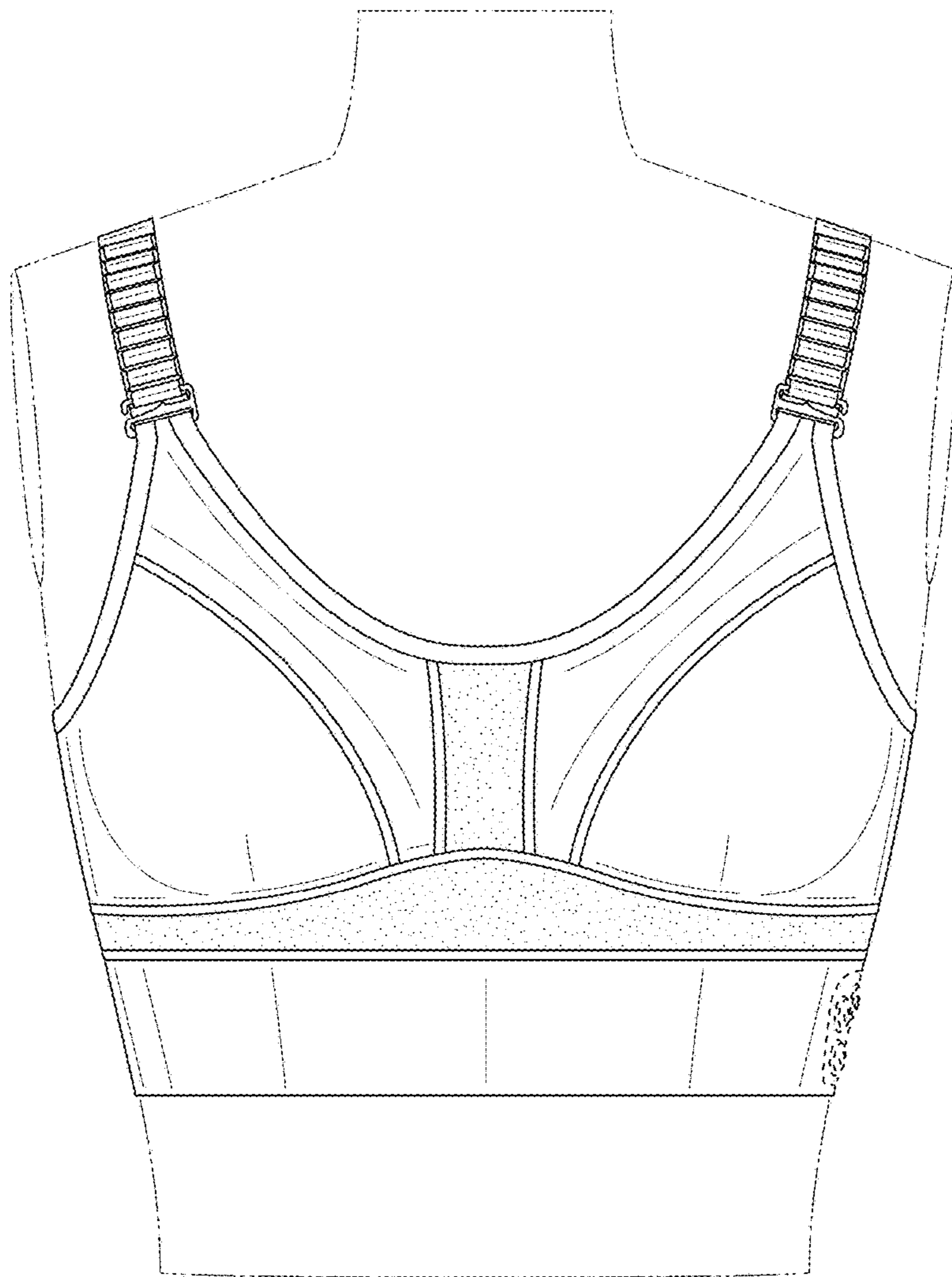

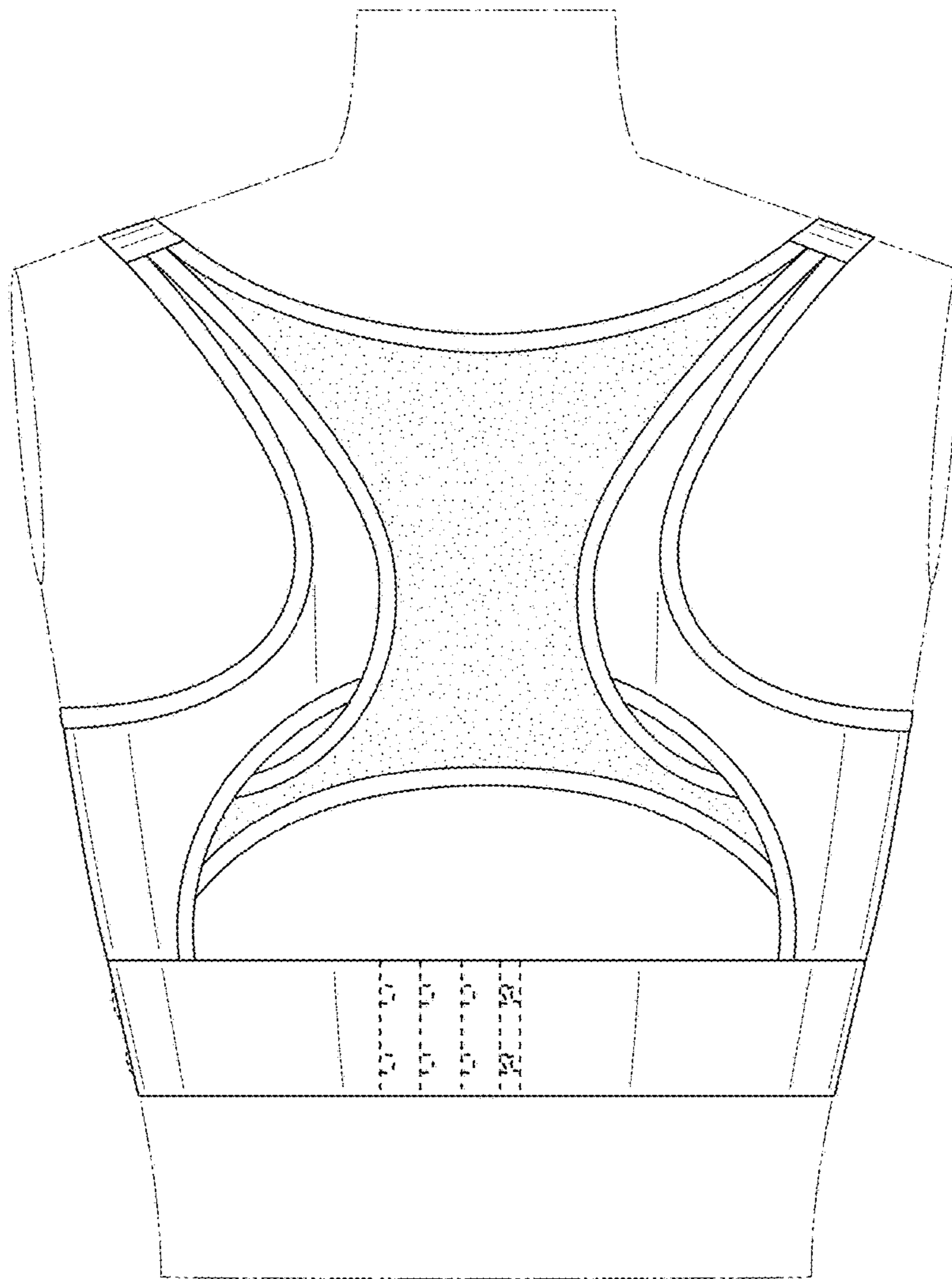

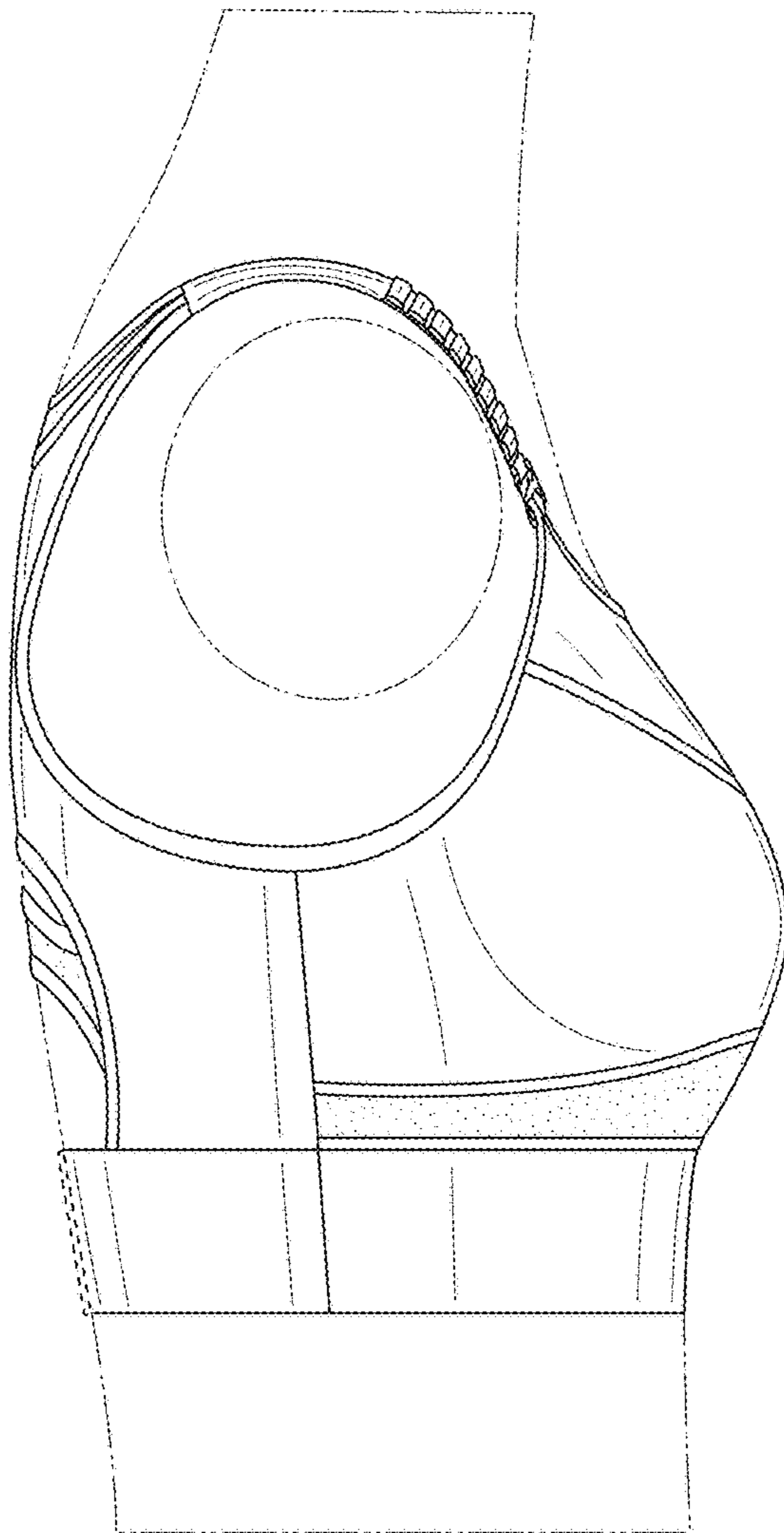

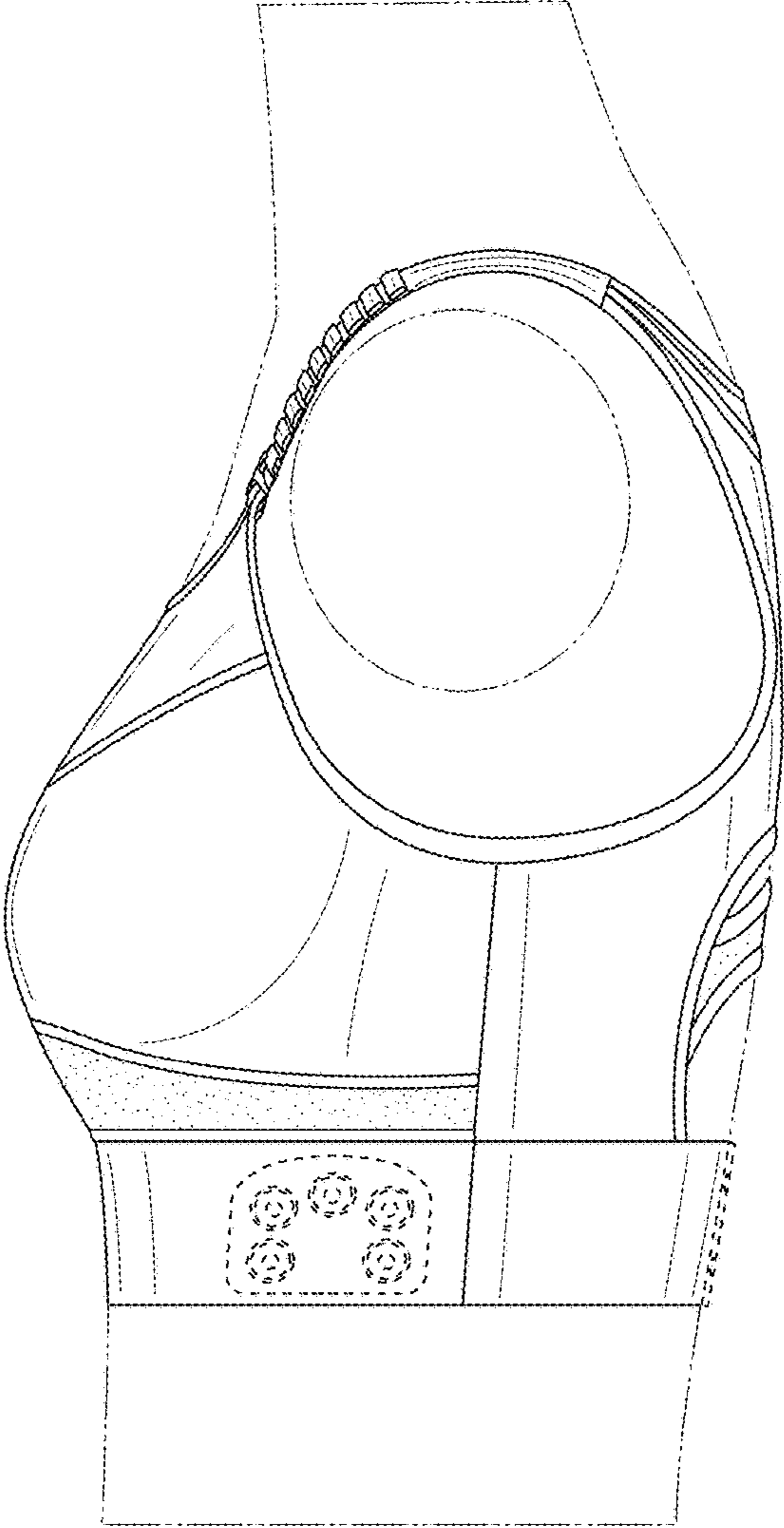
