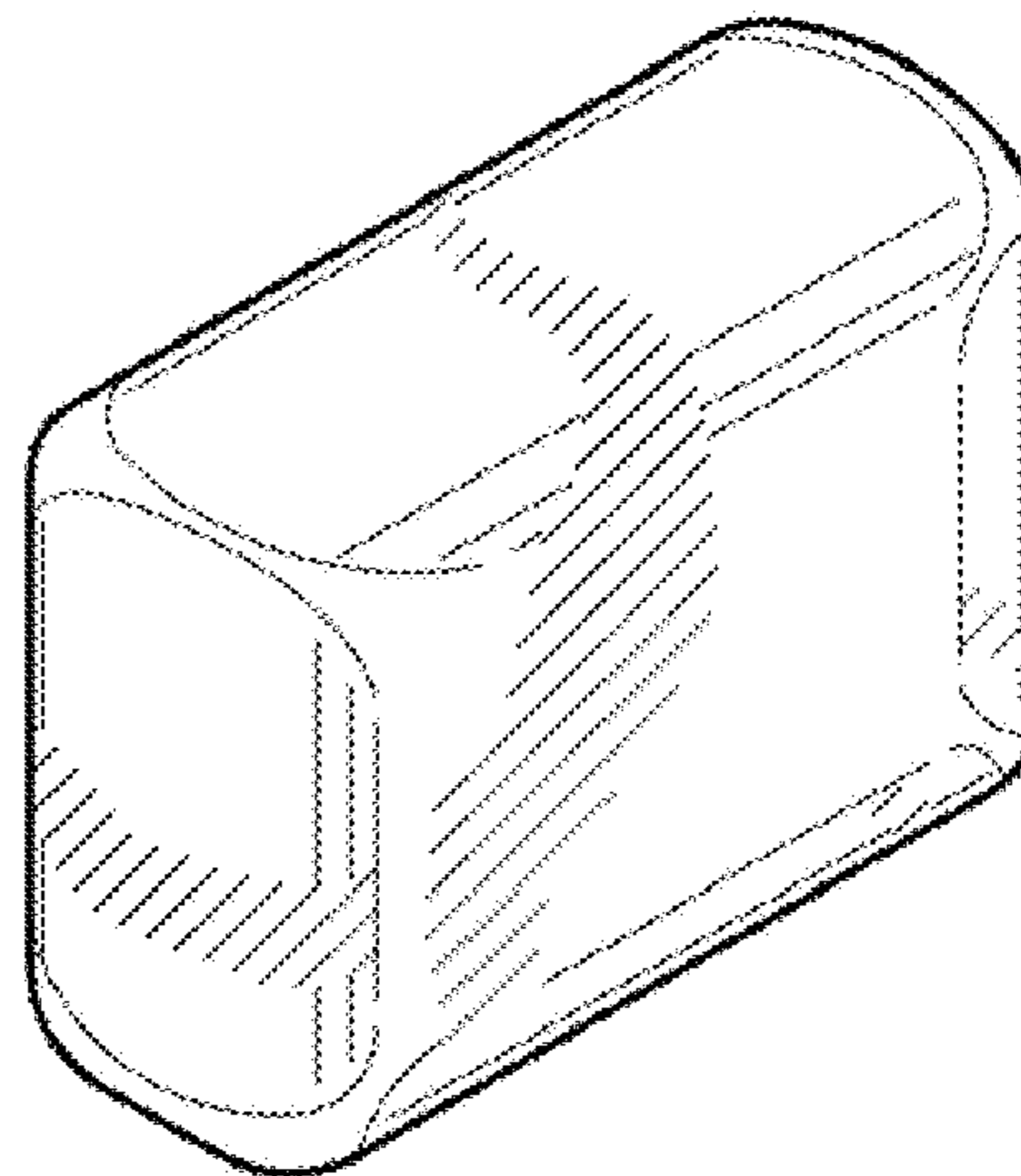
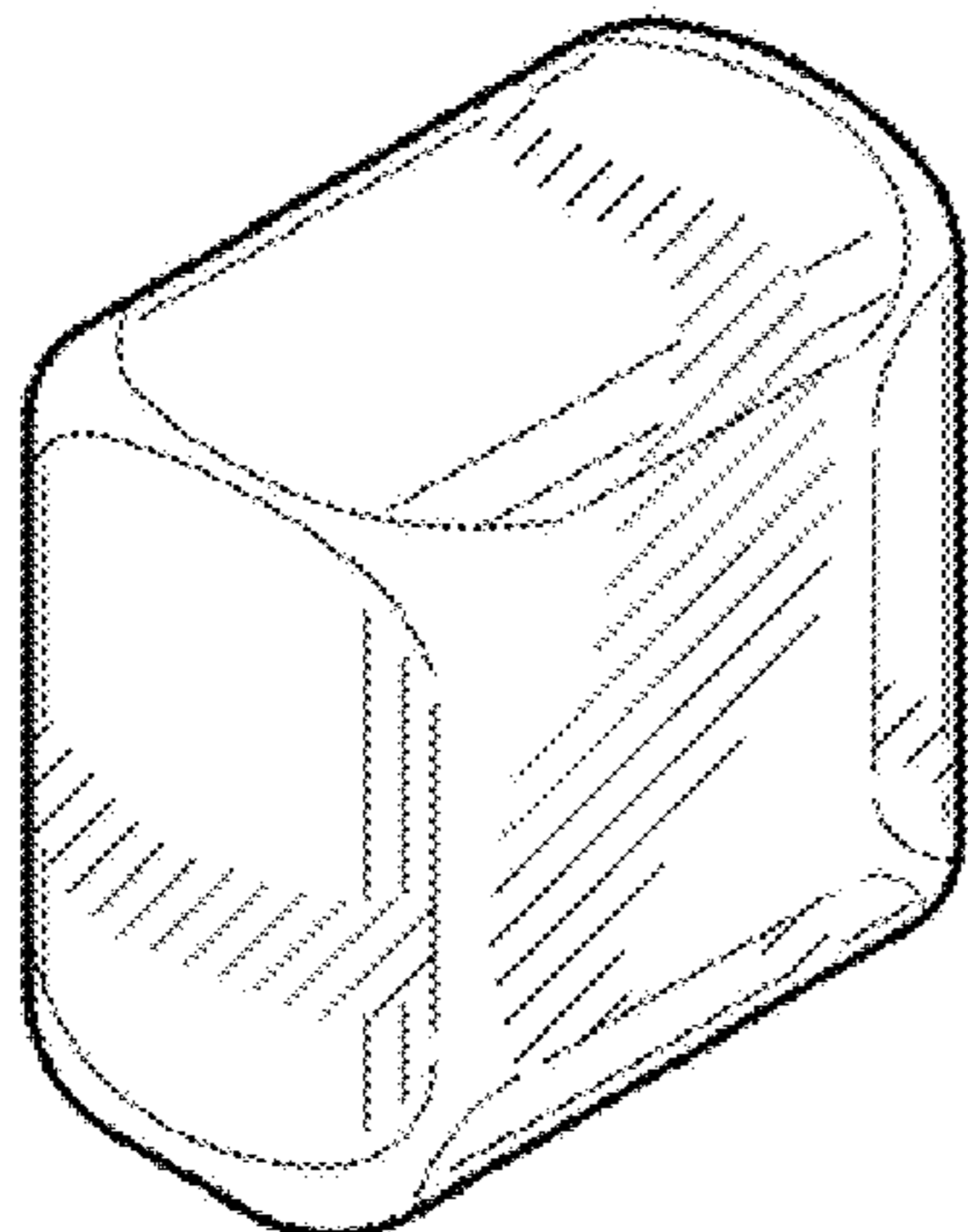

(57) **CLAIM**

We claim the ornamental design for a textured confectionary, as substantially shown and described.

FIG. 1 is a front elevation view of a first embodiment of a textured confectionary in accordance with the present design, the rear elevation view being identical thereto;
 FIG. 2 is a left side elevation view thereof, the right side elevation view, top plan view and bottom plan view being identical thereto;
 FIG. 3 is a perspective view thereof;
 FIG. 4 is a front elevational view of a second embodiment of a textured confectionary, the rear elevation view being identical thereto;
 FIG. 5 is a left side elevation view thereof, the right side elevation view being identical thereto;
 FIG. 6 is a top plan view thereof, the bottom plan view being identical thereto;
 FIG. 7 is a perspective view thereof;
 FIG. 8 is a front elevation view of a third embodiment of a textured confectionary, the rear elevation view being identical thereto;
 FIG. 9 is a left side elevation view thereof, the right side elevation being identical thereto;
 FIG. 10 is a top plan view thereof, the bottom plan view being identical thereto;
 FIG. 11 is a perspective view thereof;
 FIG. 12 is a front elevation view of a fourth embodiment of a textured confectionary, the rear elevation view being identical thereto;
 FIG. 13 is a left side elevation view thereof, the right side elevation view being identical thereto;
 FIG. 14 is a top view thereof, the bottom plan view being identical thereto;
 FIG. 15 is a perspective view thereof;
 FIG. 16 is a front elevation view of a fifth embodiment of a textured confectionary, the rear side being identical thereto;
 FIG. 17 is a left side elevation view thereof, the right side elevational view being identical thereto;
 FIG. 18 is a top plan view thereof, the bottom plan view being identical thereto; and,
 FIG. 19 is a perspective view thereof.
 The shading in the Figures indicates that the surfaces have a glossy surface texture.

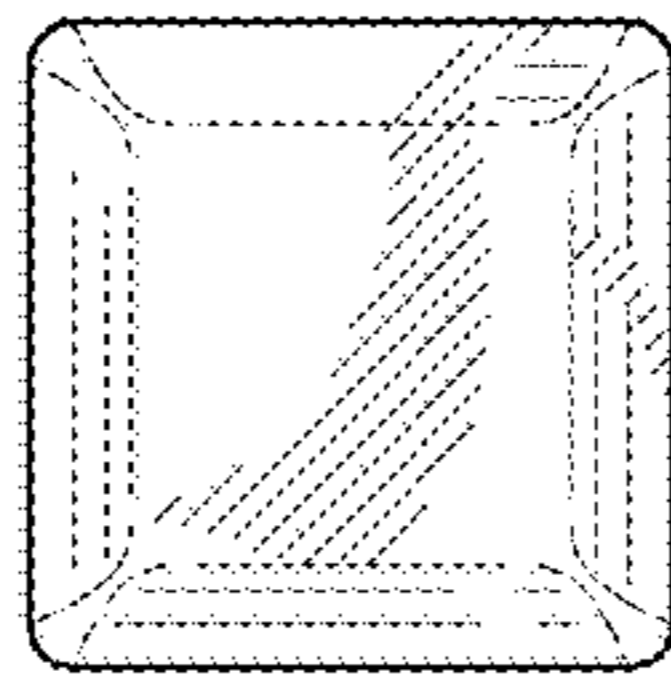

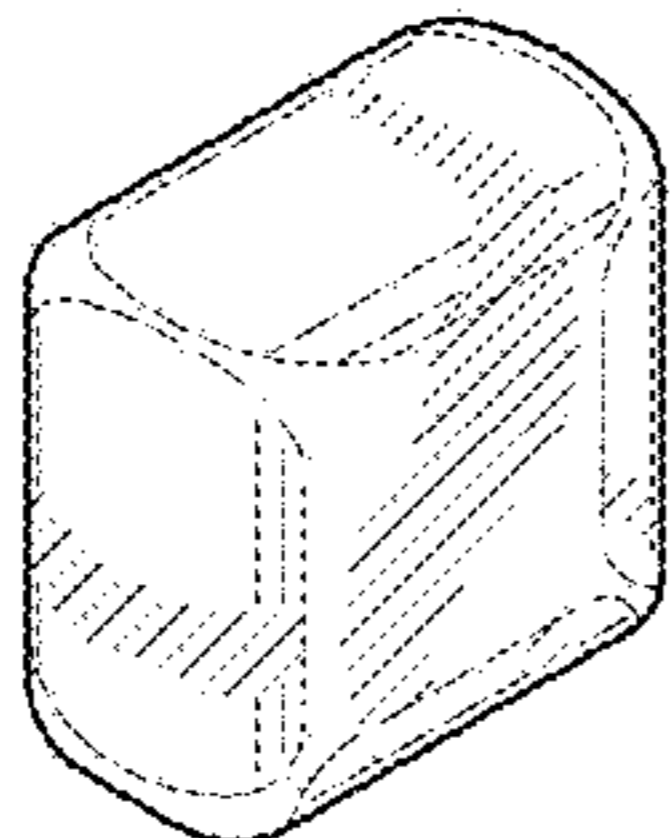

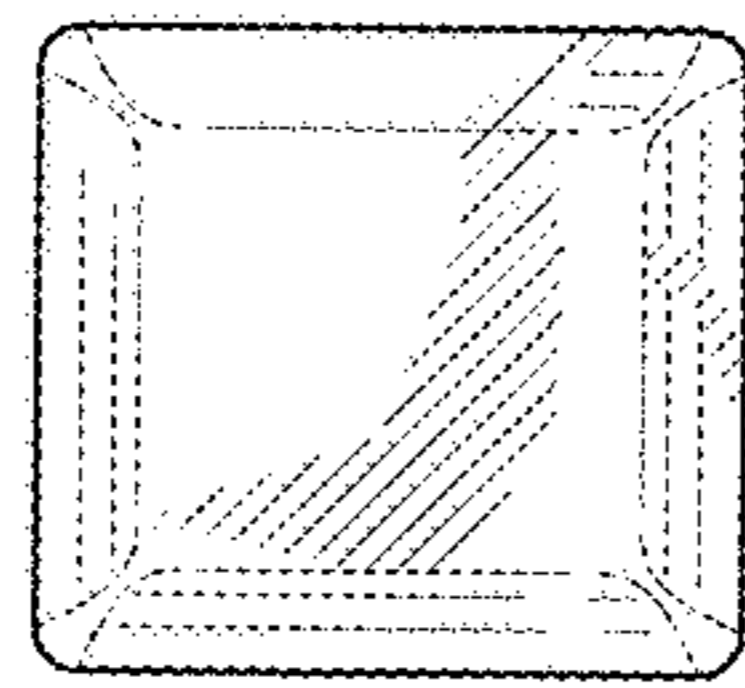

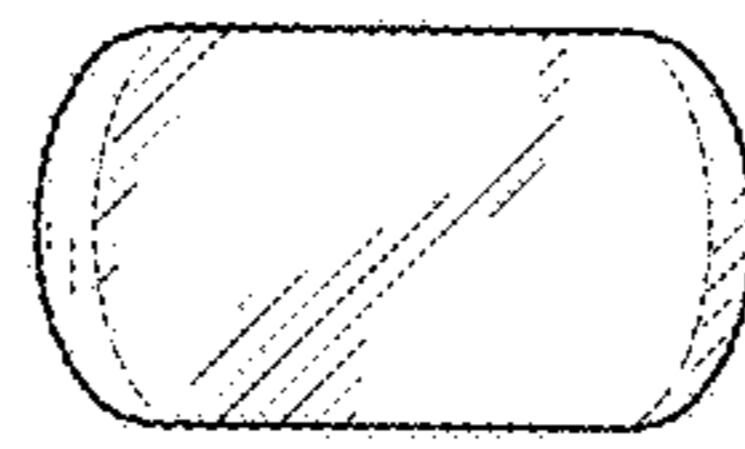

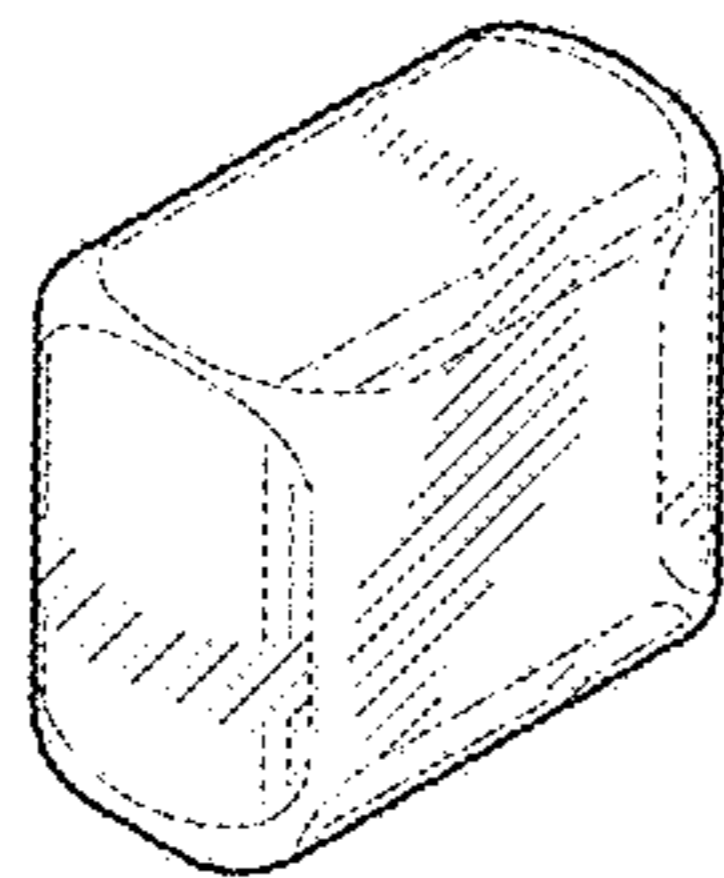

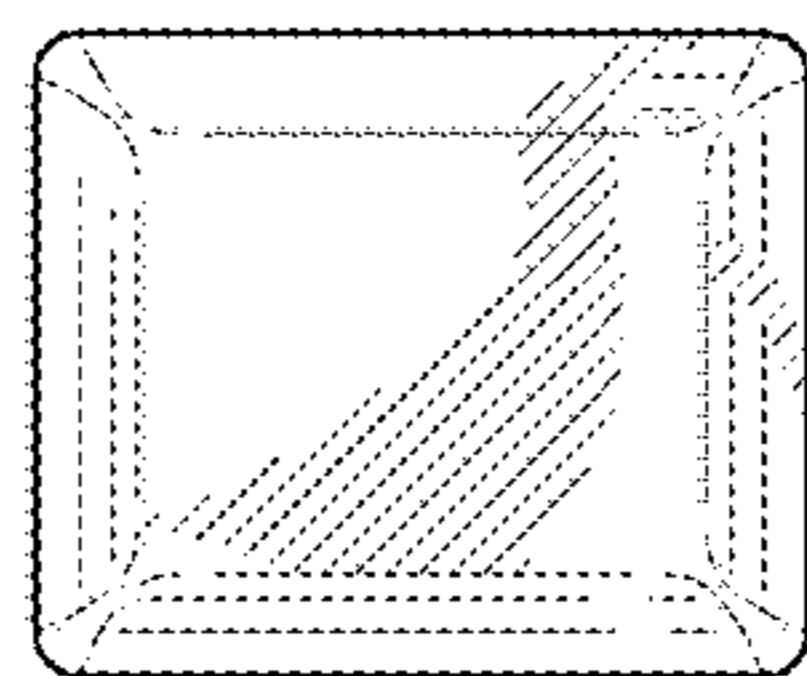

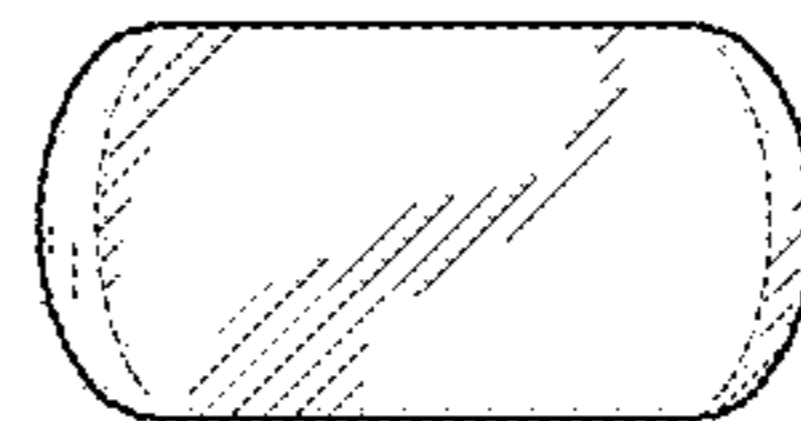

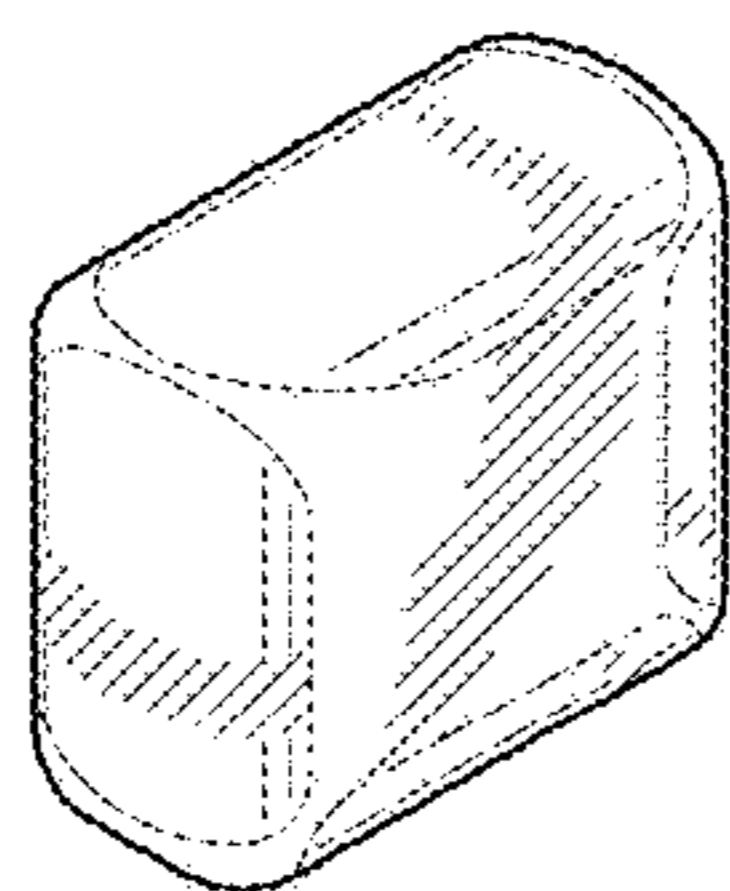

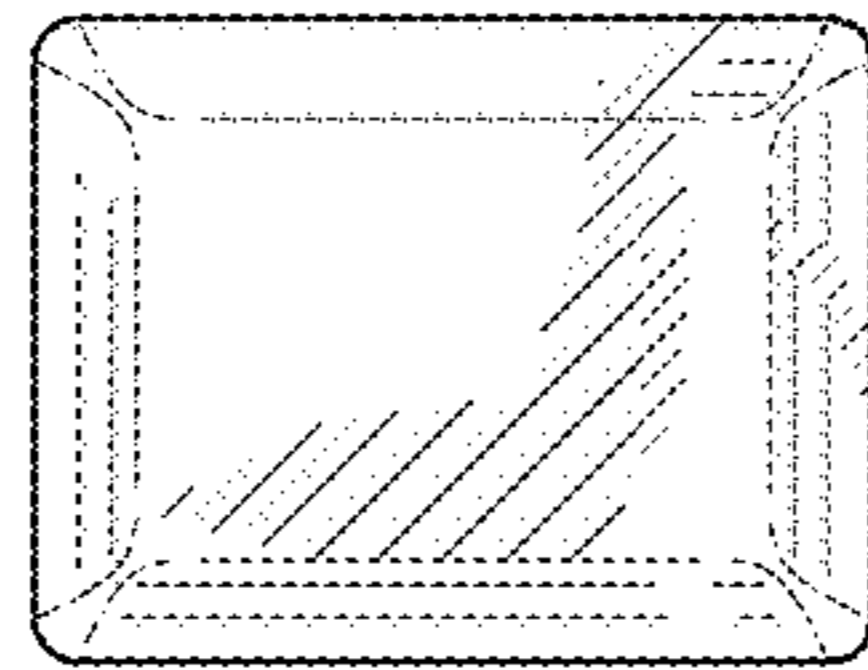

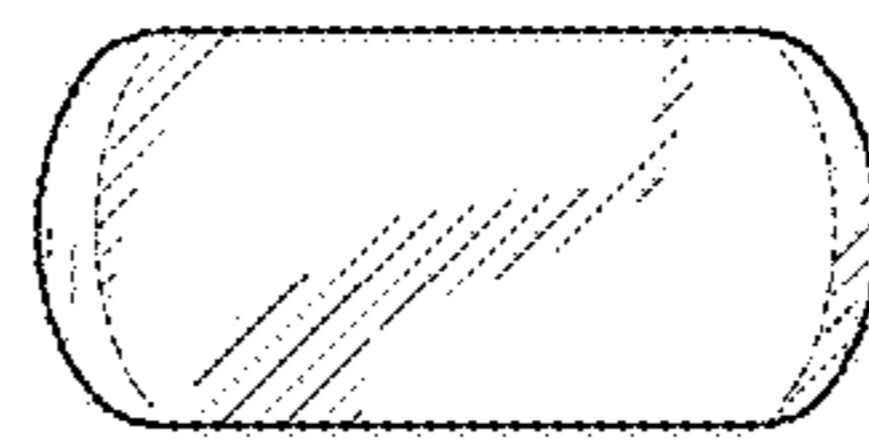

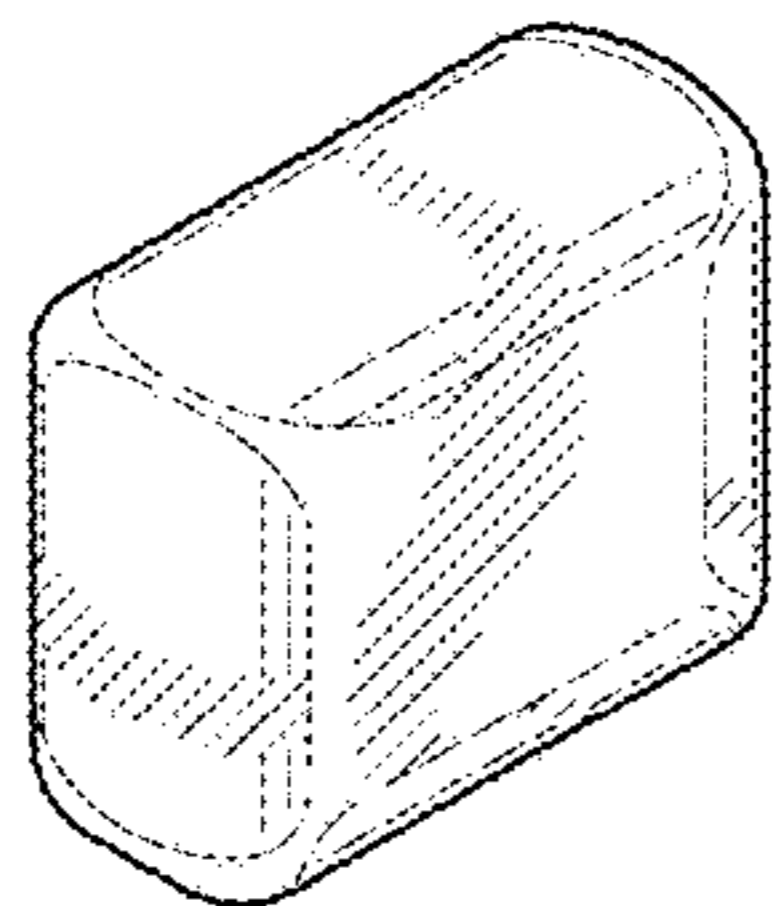

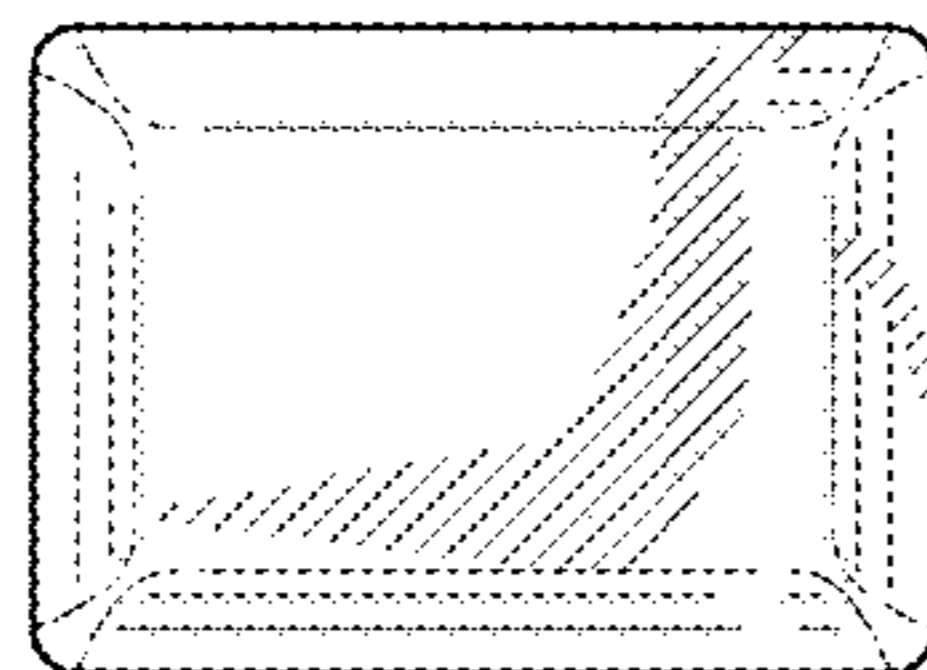

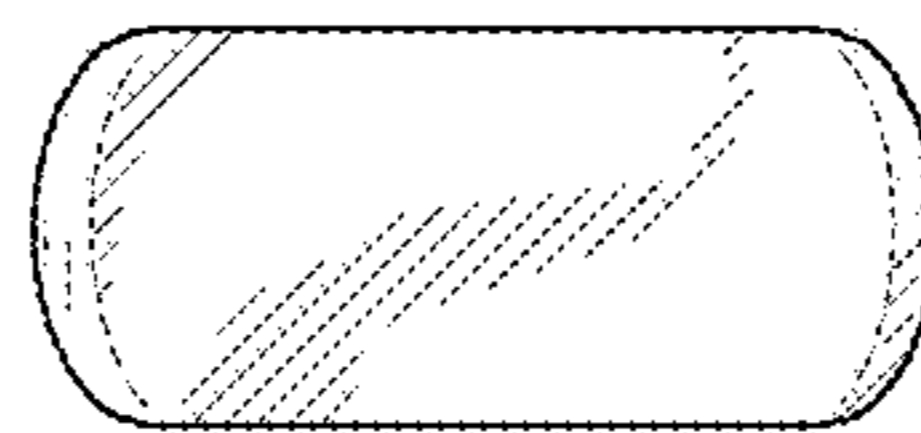

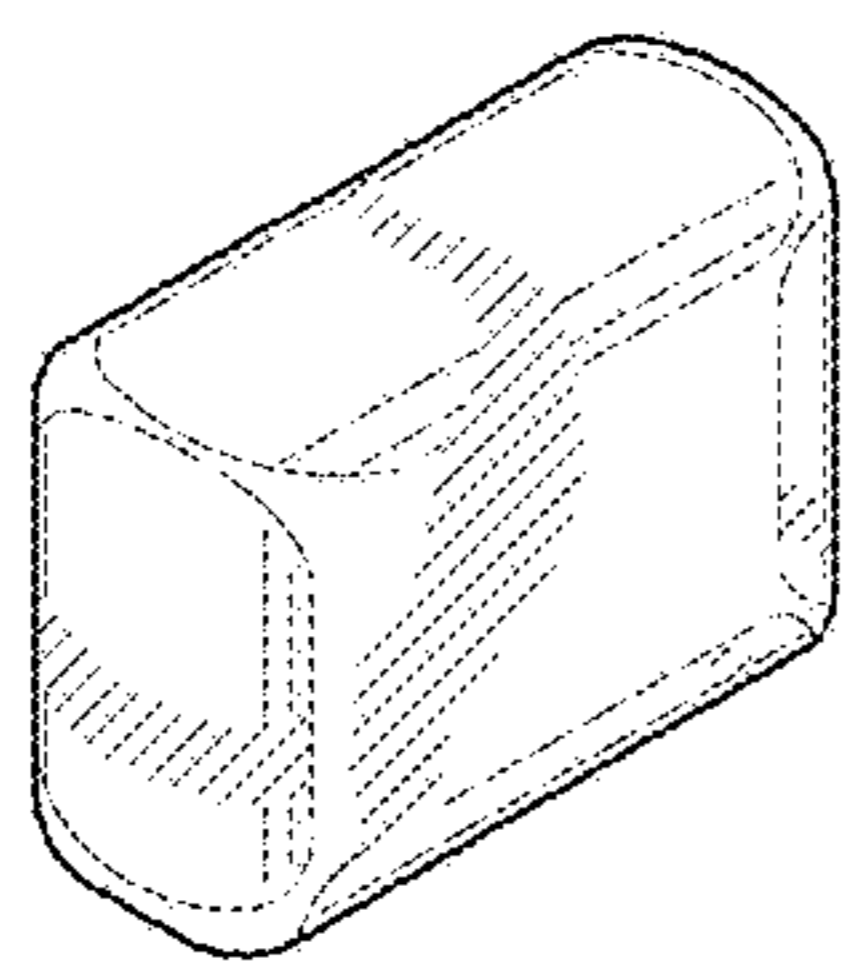
