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(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for an adjustable holder for one or more items, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of an adjustable holder showing the new design as assembled.

FIG. 2 is an expanded perspective view of the adjustable holder.

FIG. 3 is a top perspective view of a binocular cradle of the adjustable holder.

FIG. 4 is a bottom perspective view of the binocular cradle.

FIG. 5 is a front view of the binocular cradle.

FIG. 6 is a side view of the binocular cradle, the other side view being a mirror image thereof.

FIG. 7 is a bottom view of the binocular cradle.

FIG. 8 is a perspective view of an adjustable holder having a strap and a nodule for use with the binocular cradle.

FIG. 9 is a perspective view of the strap.

FIG. 10 is a cross-sectional view taken along line 10-10 in FIG. 8 of the nodule on the binocular cradle.

FIG. 11 is a perspective view of a rail of the adjustable holder.

FIG. 12 is a top view of the rail.

FIG. 13 is a bottom view of the rail.

FIG. 14 is a side view of the rail, the other side view being identical.

FIG. 15 is a front view of the rail, the back view being identical.

FIG. 16 is a top perspective view of a cup insert of the adjustable holder.

FIG. 17 is a bottom perspective view of the cup insert.

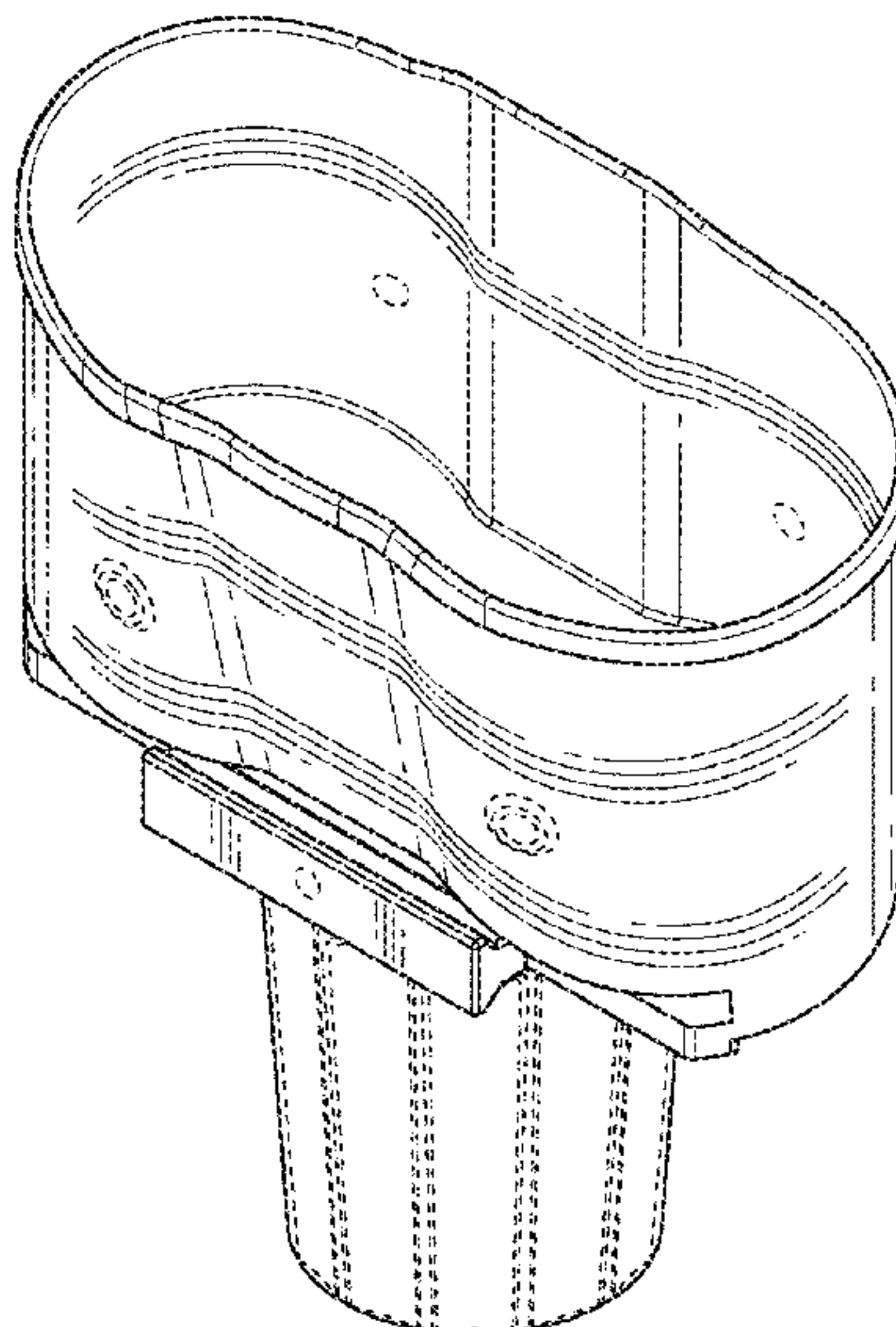
FIG. 18 is a front view of the cup insert, the back view being identical.

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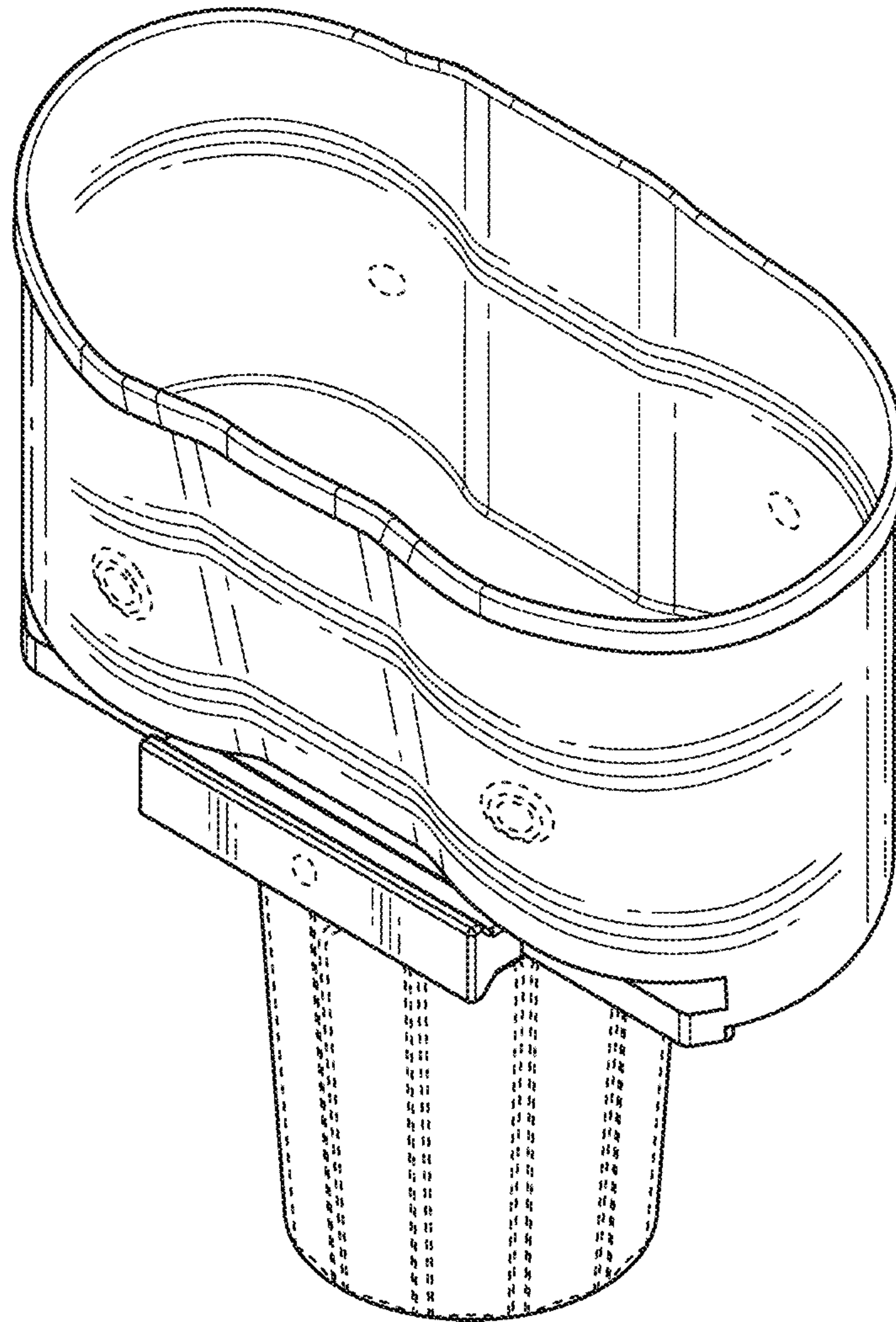

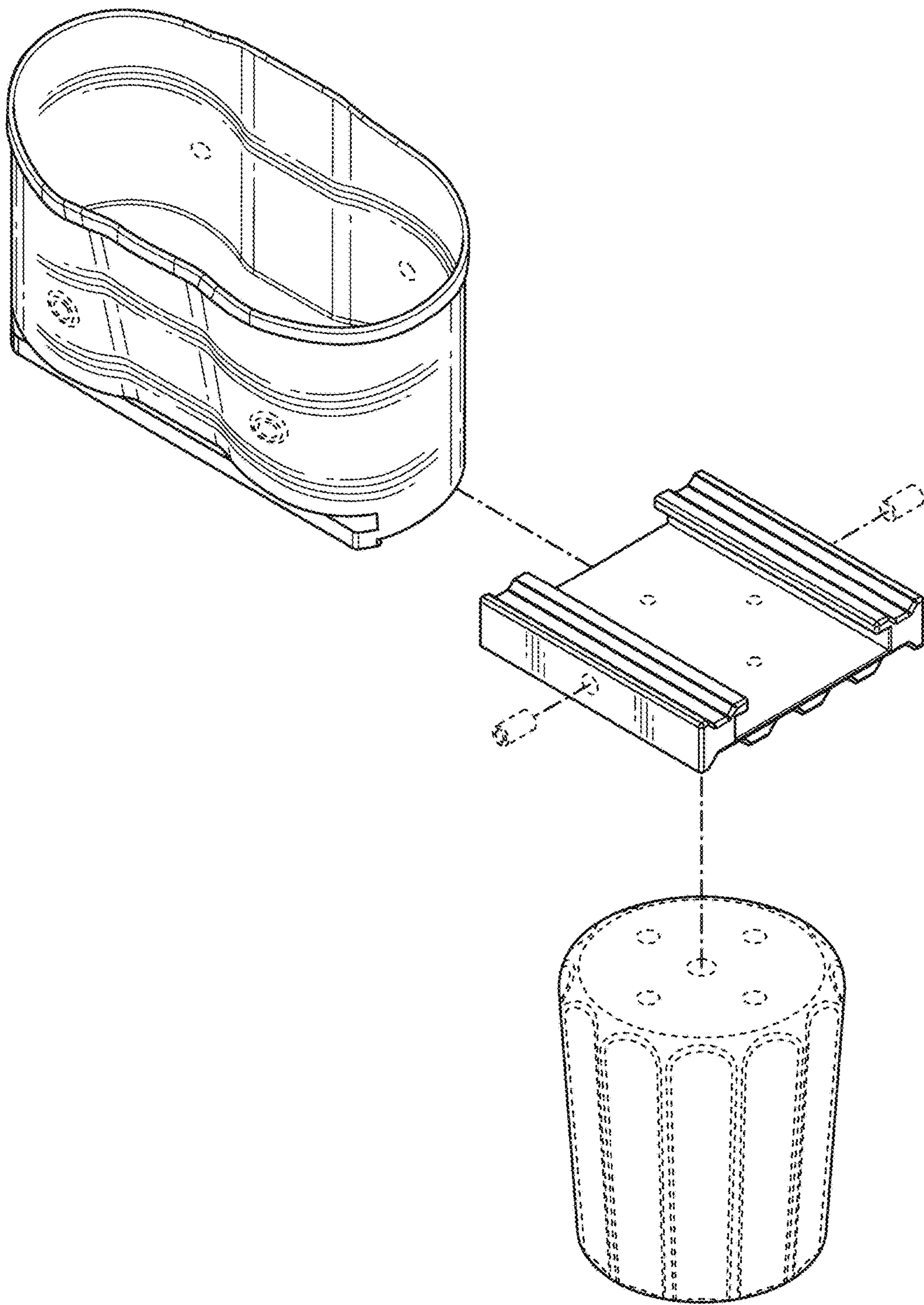

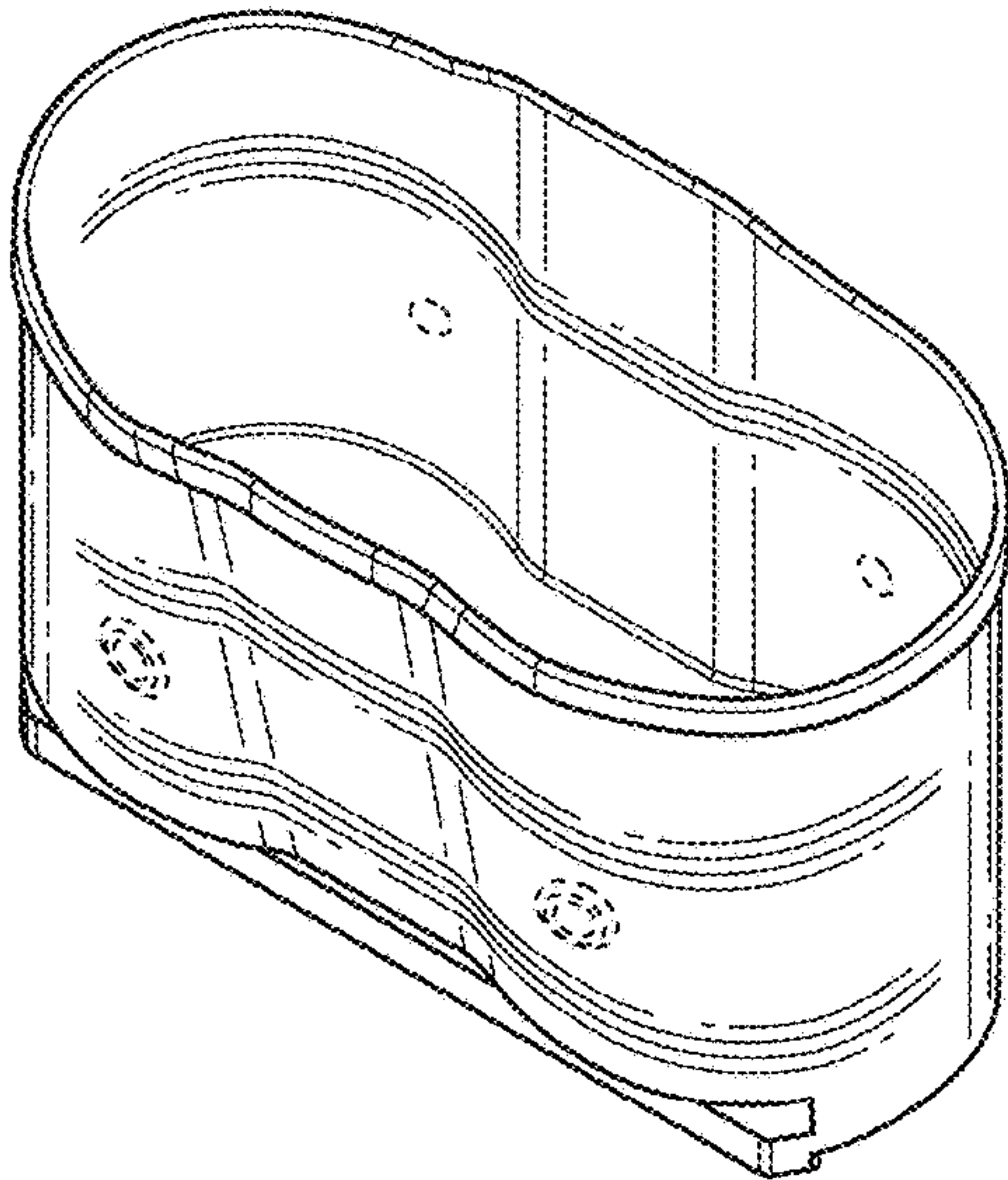

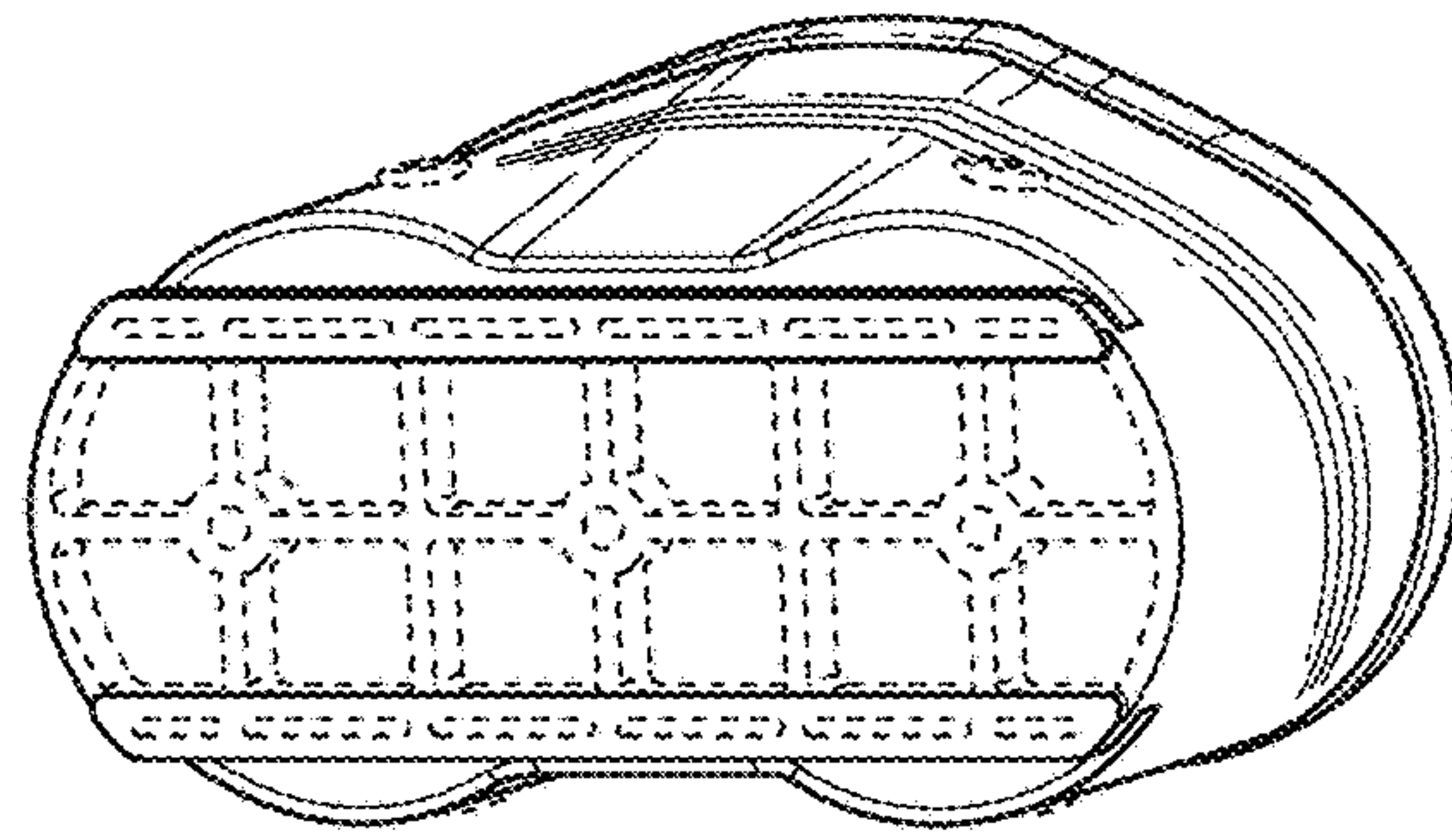

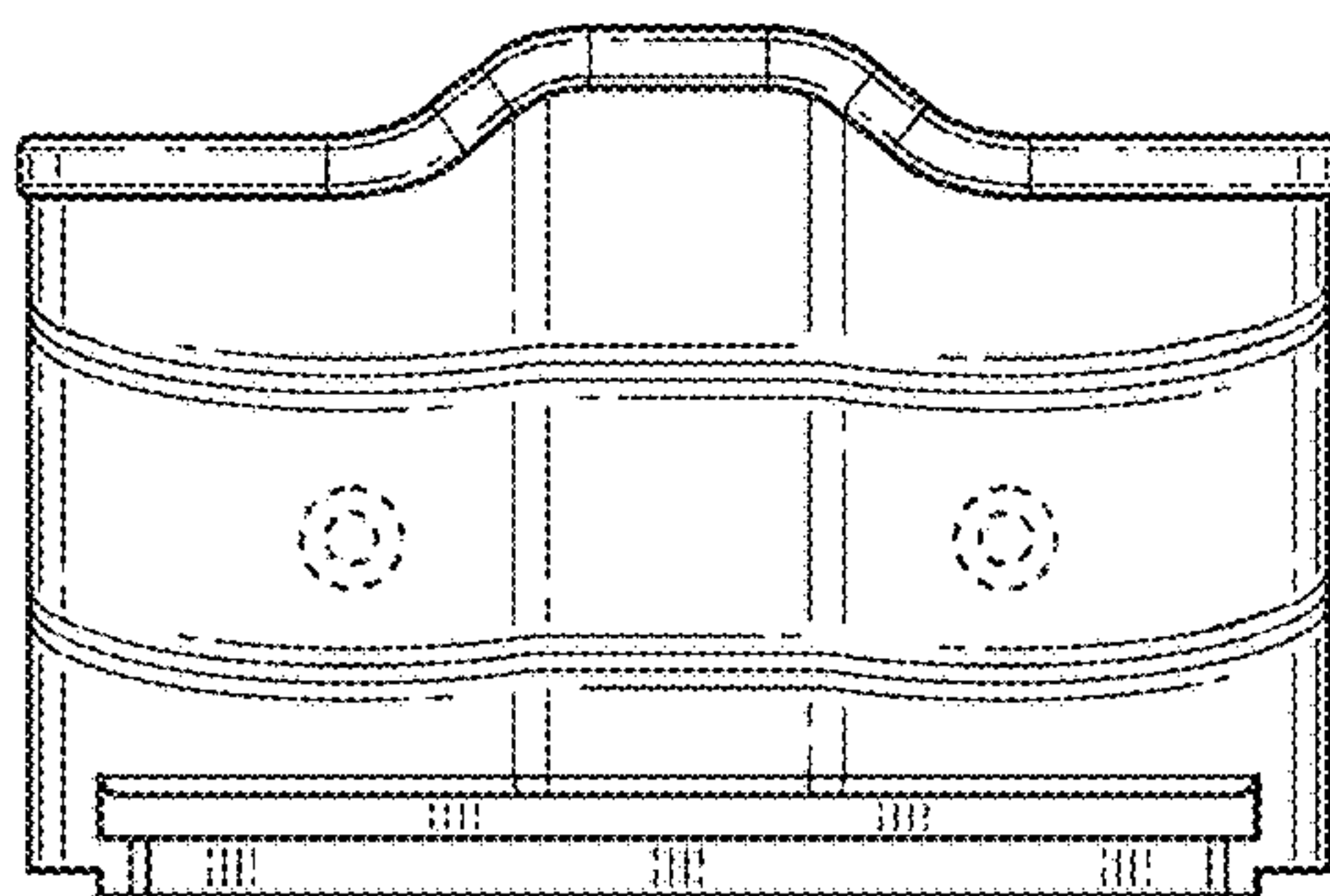

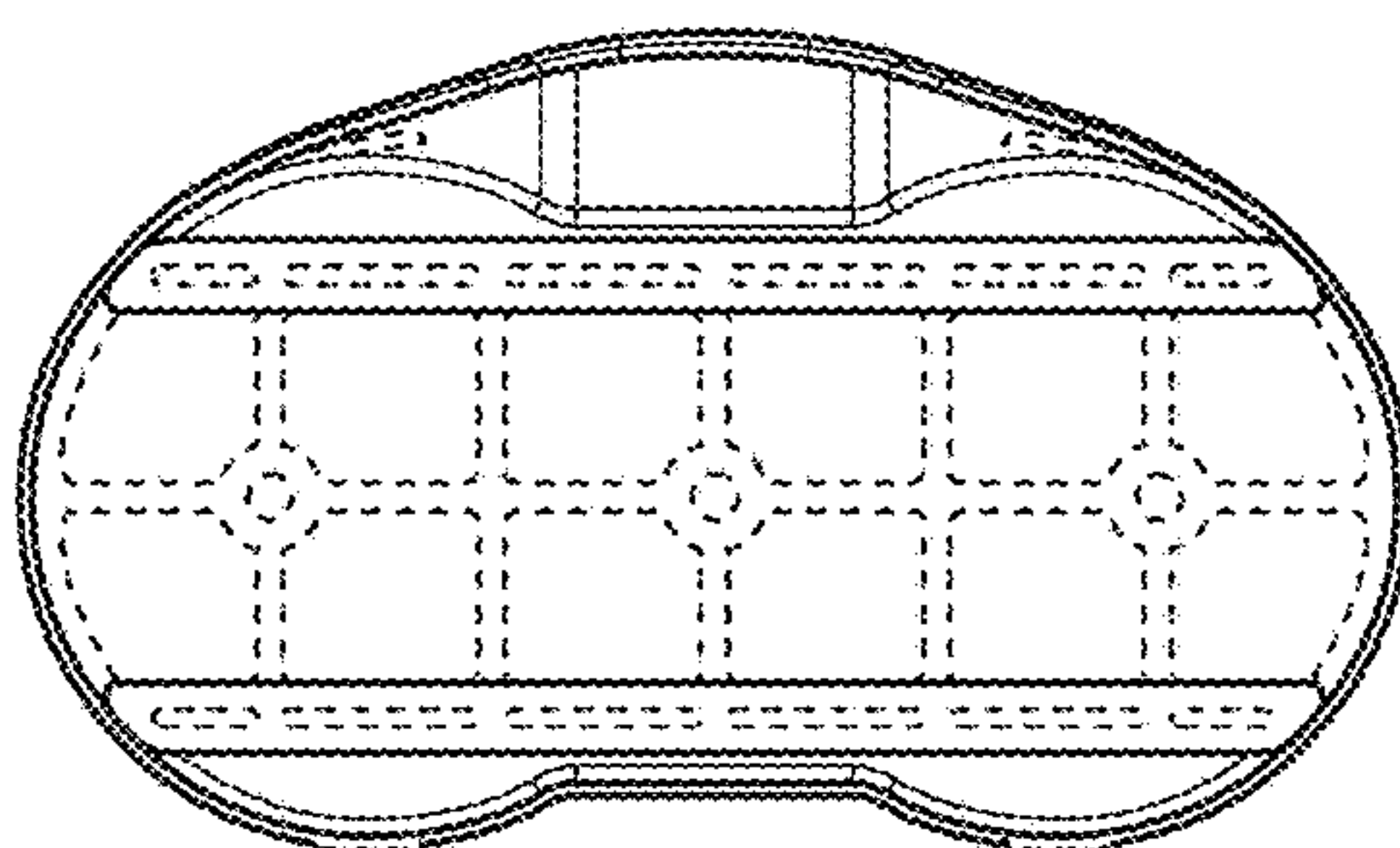

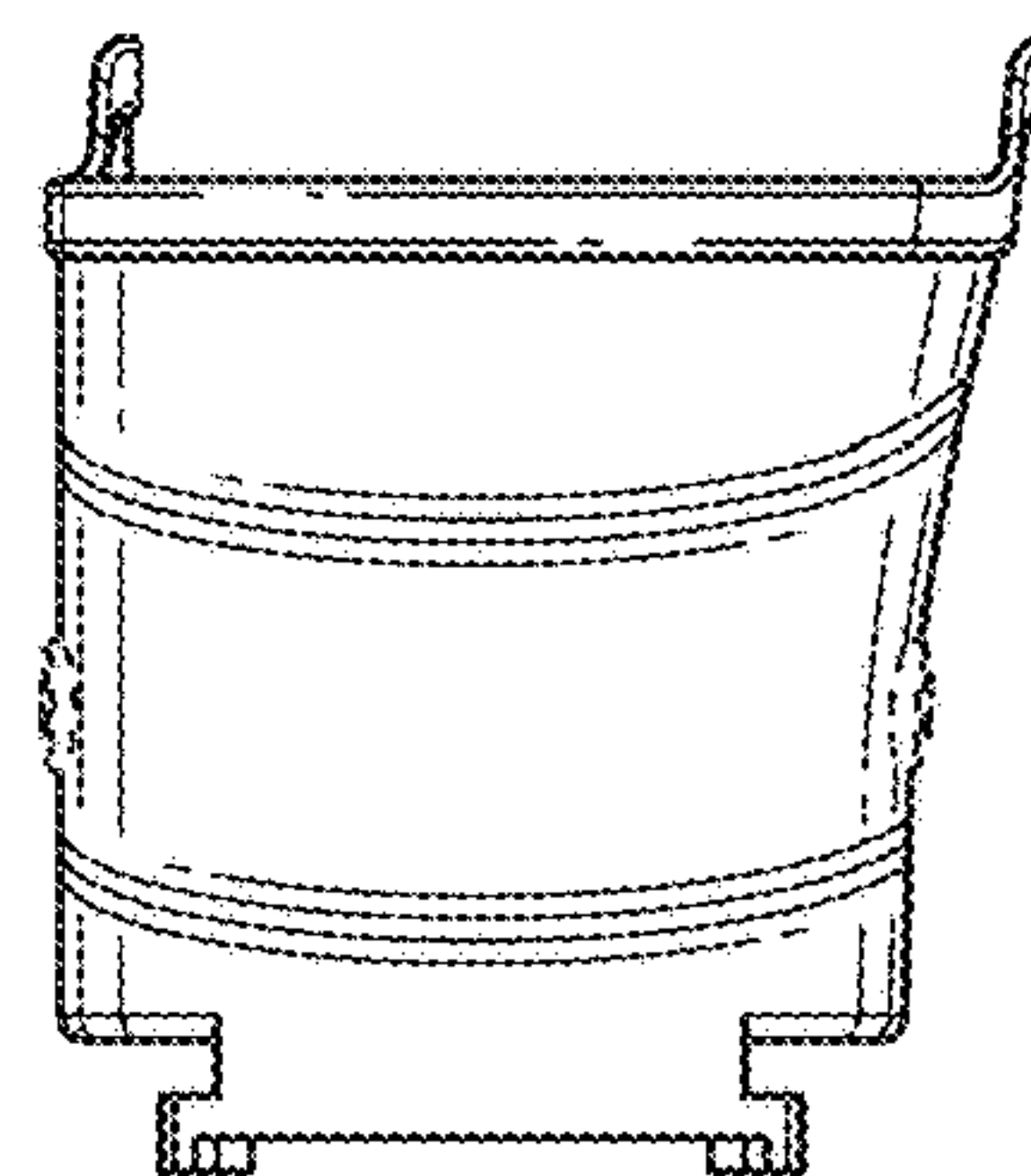

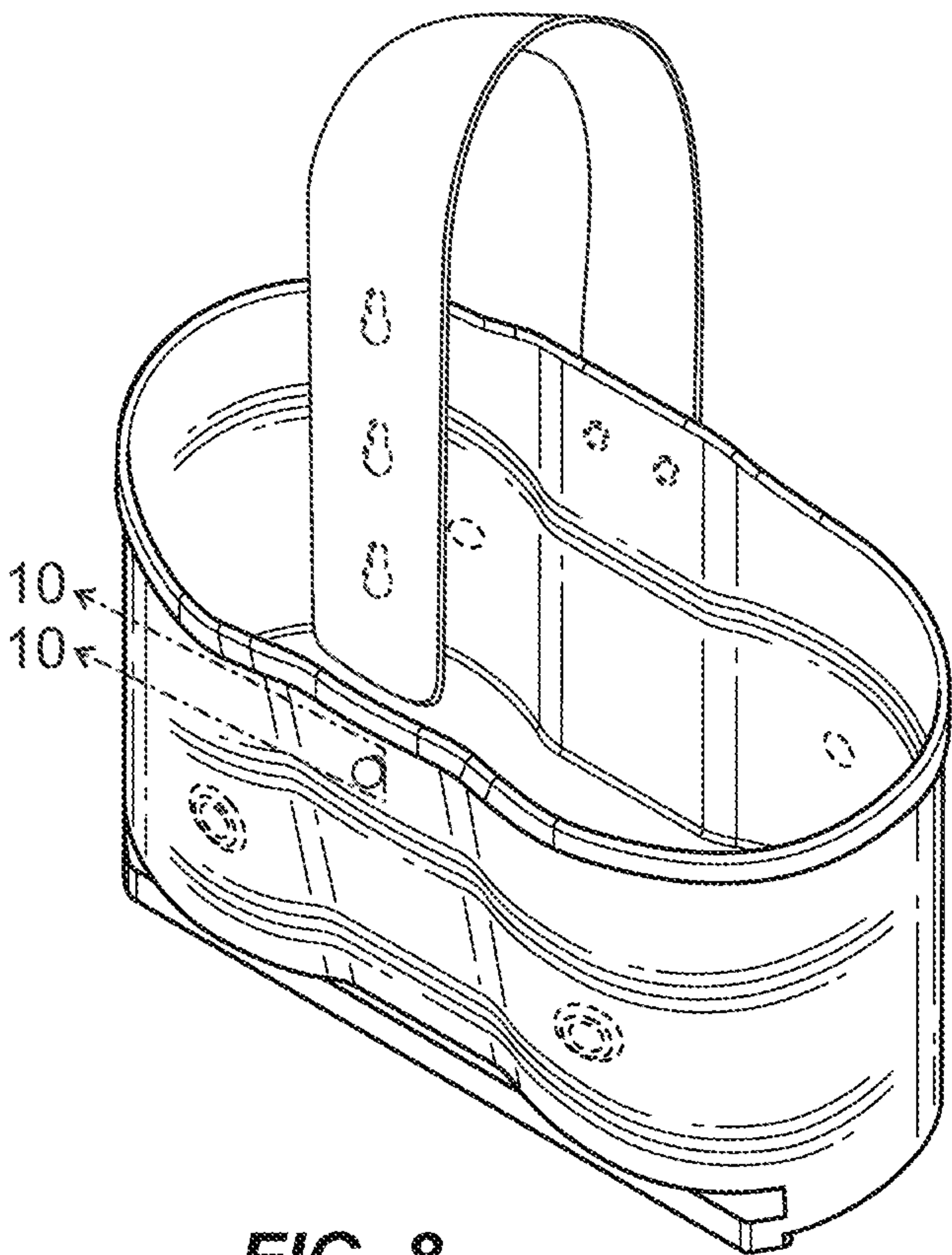

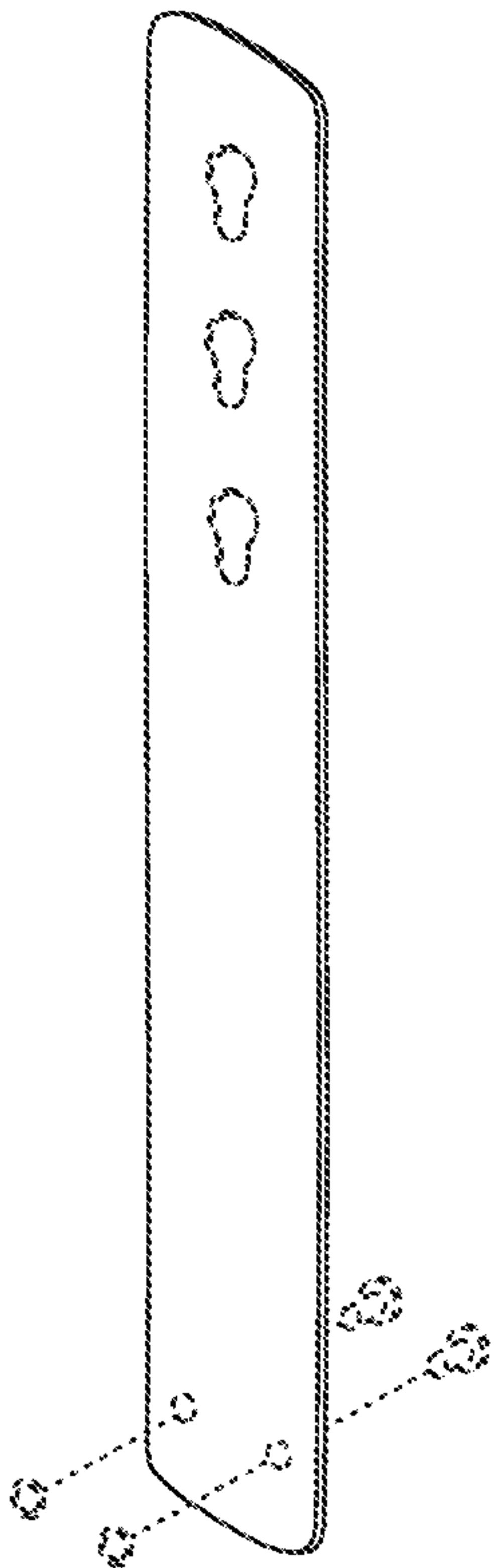

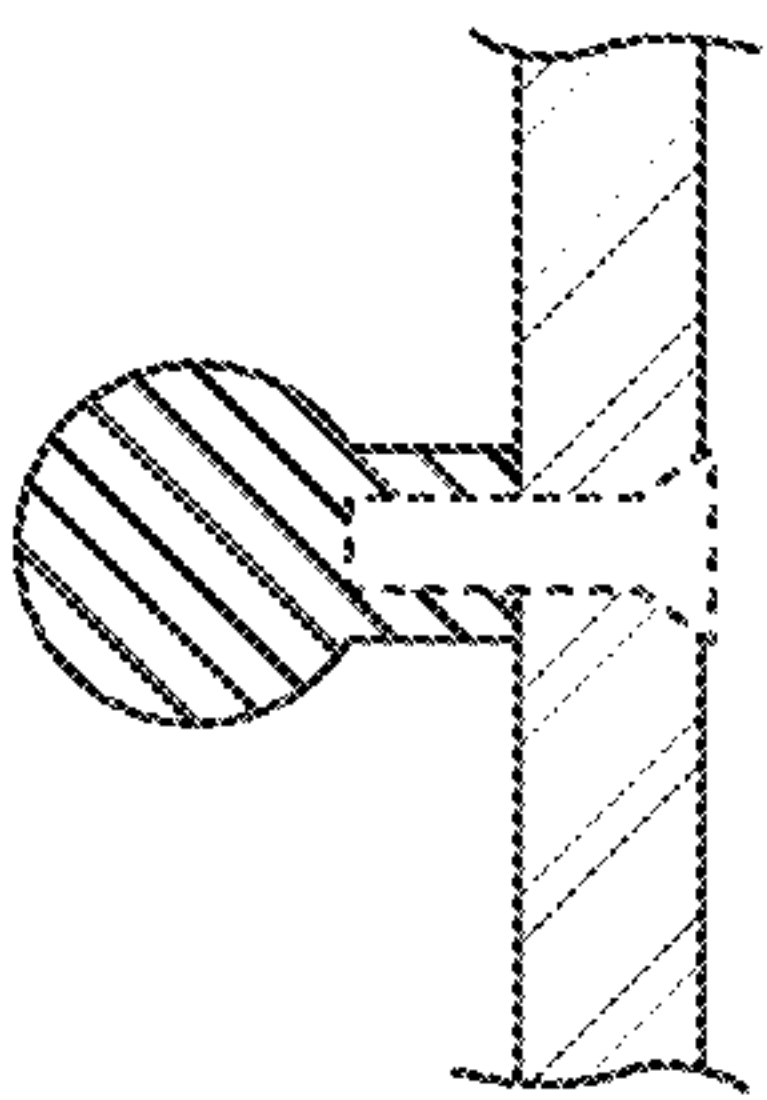

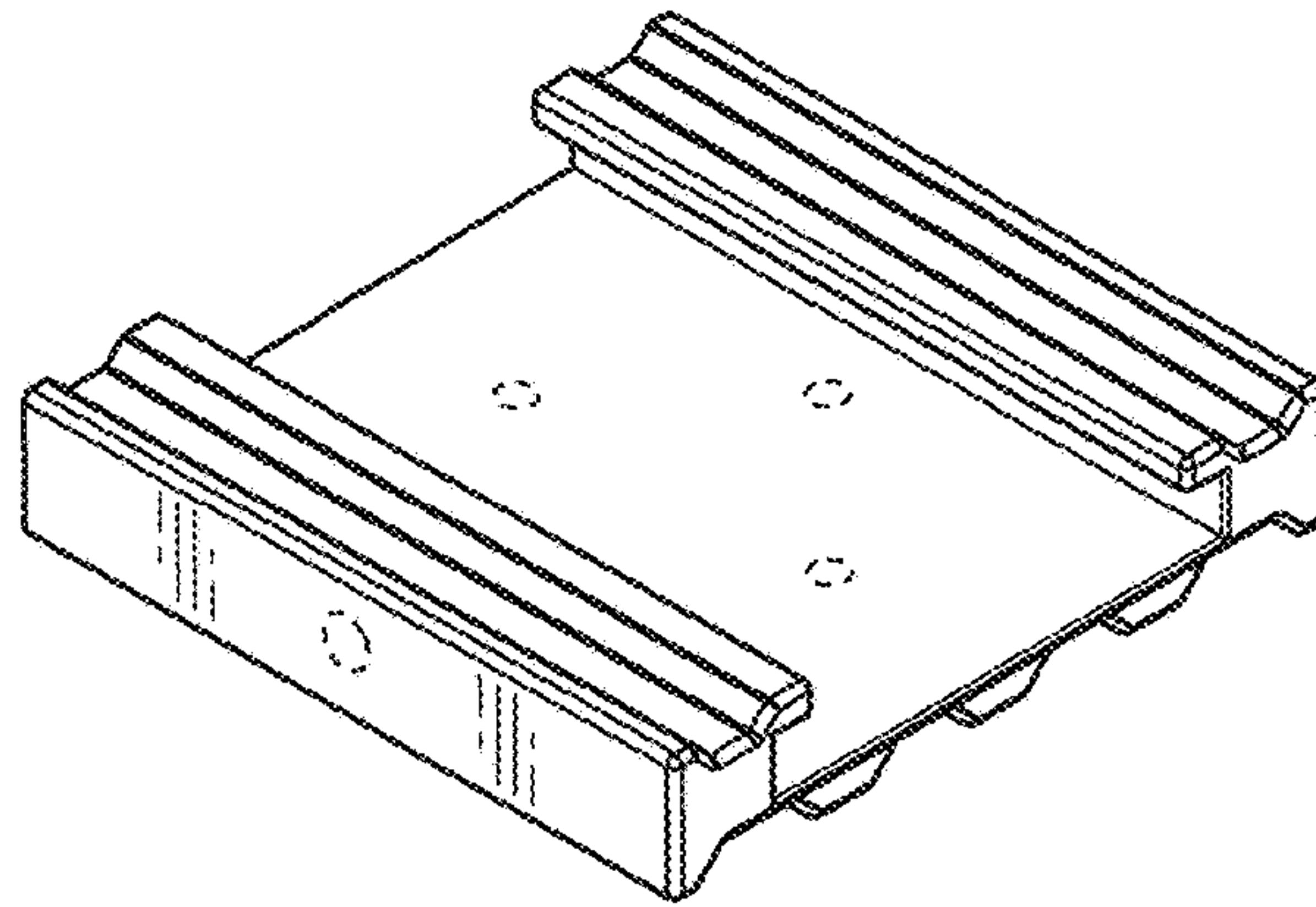

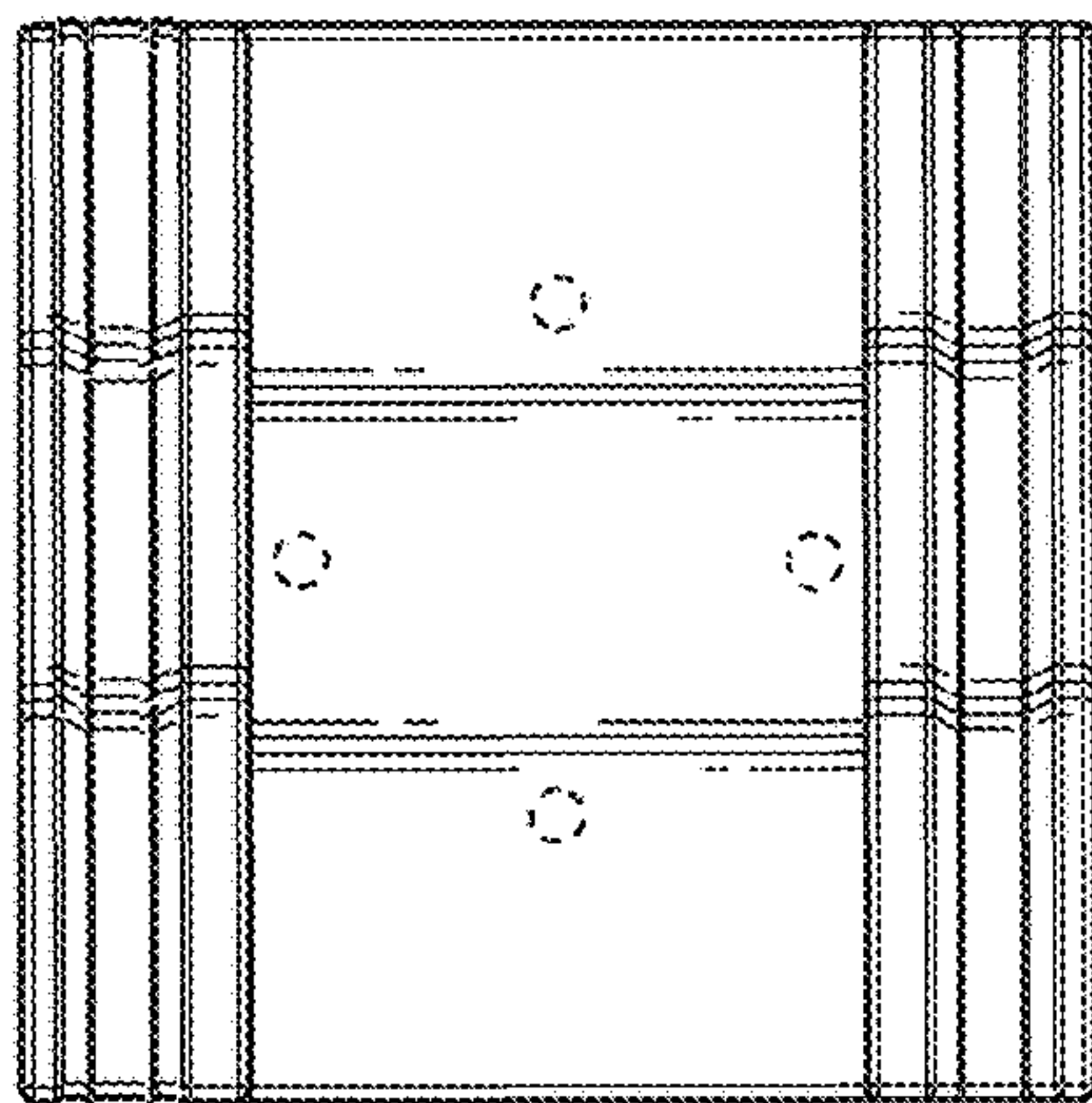

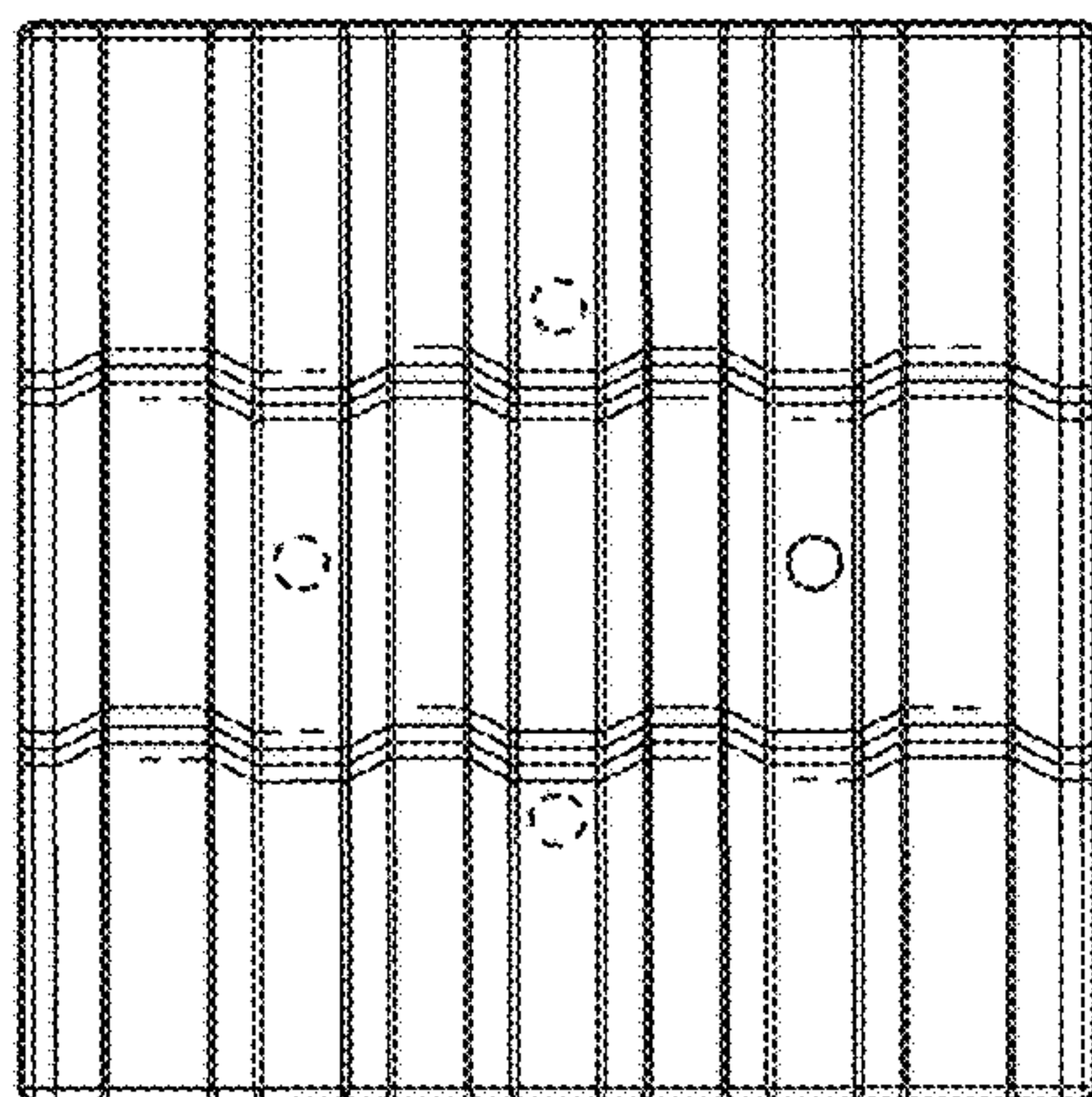

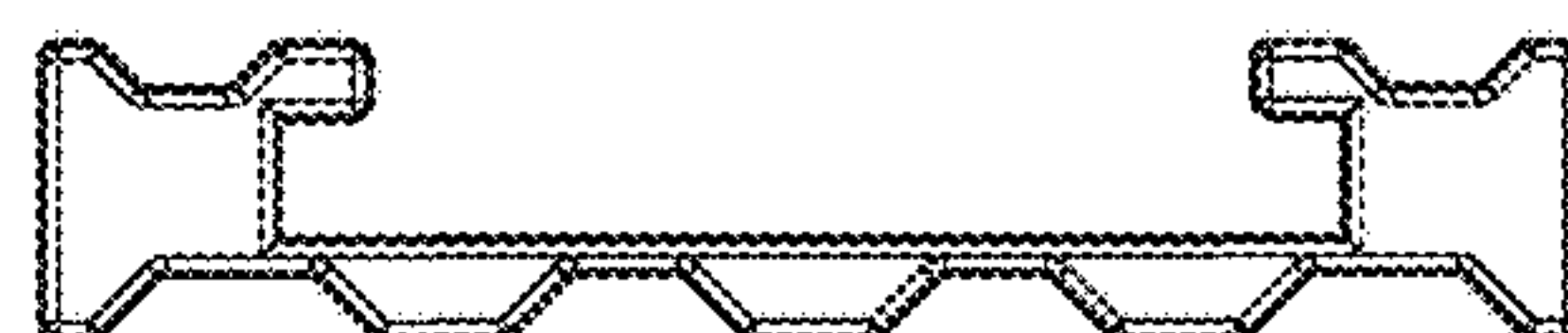

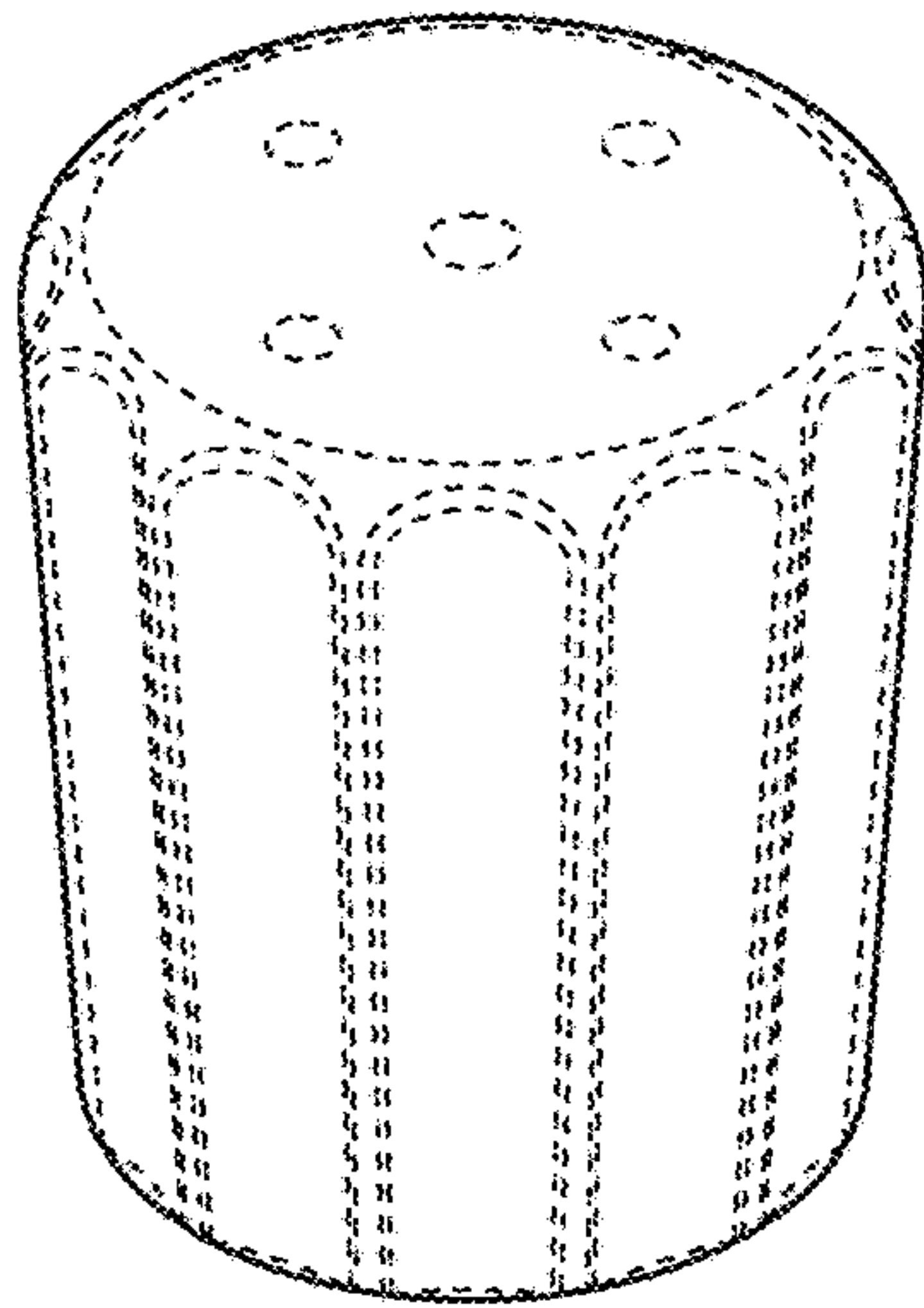

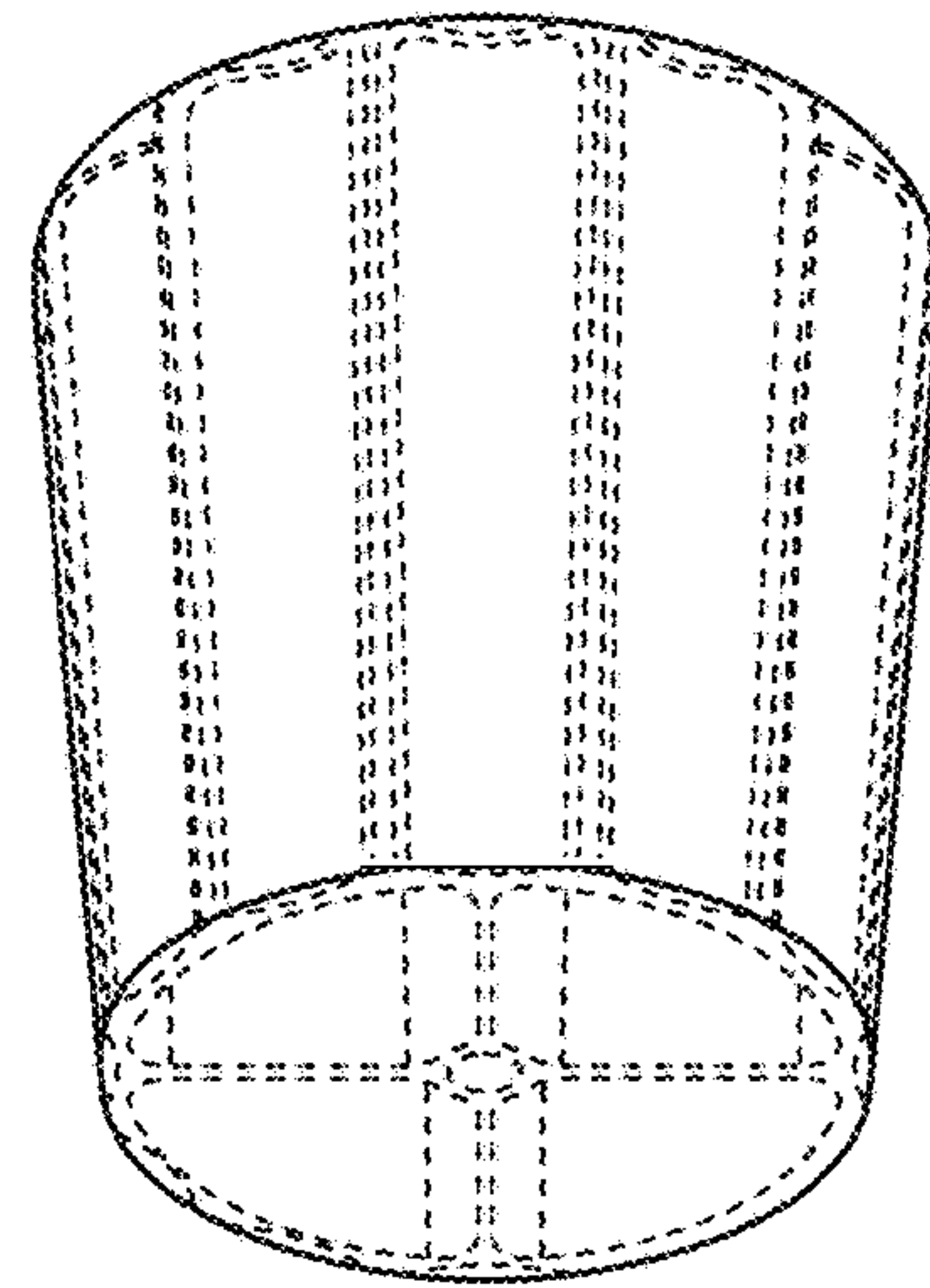

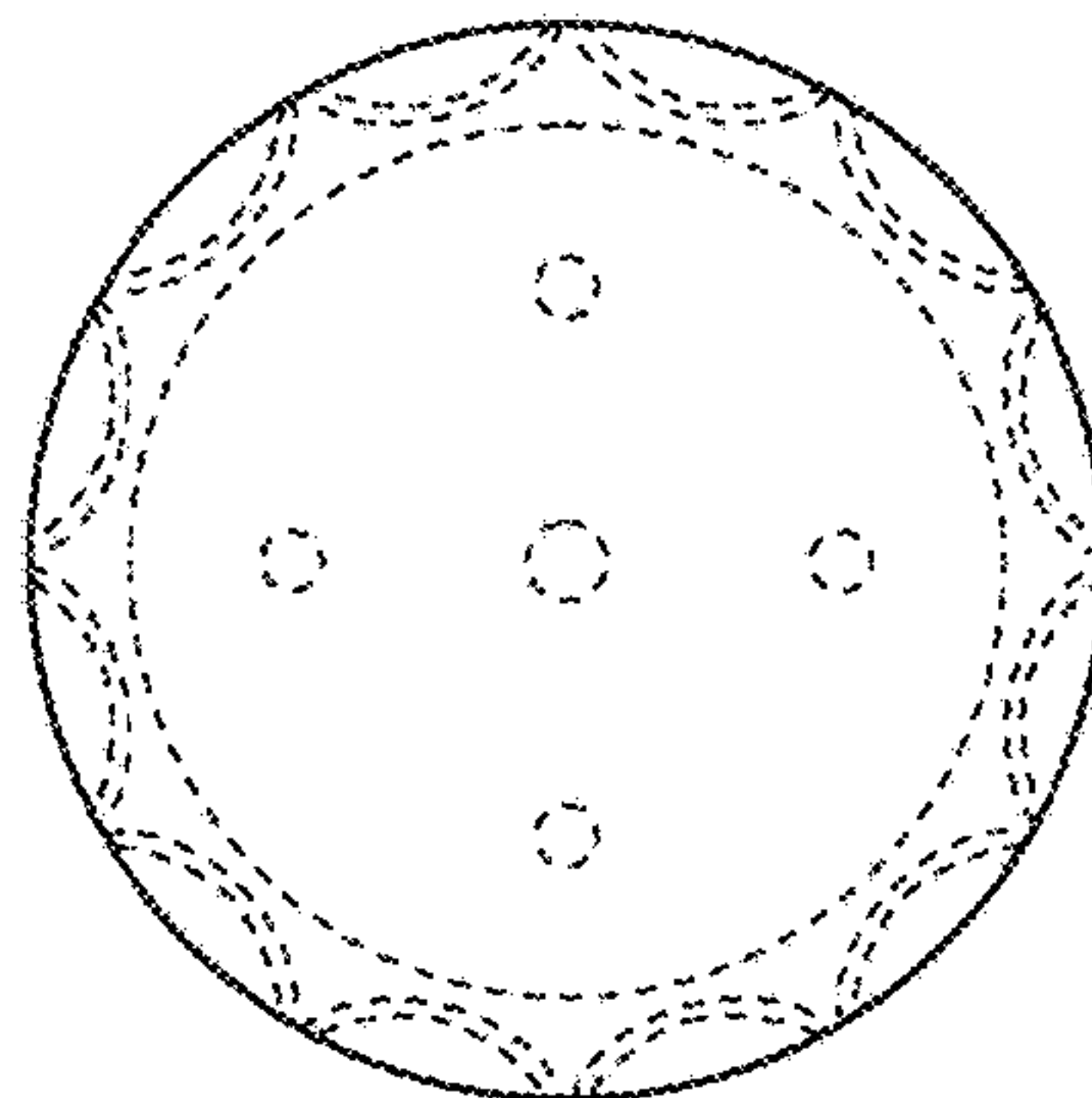

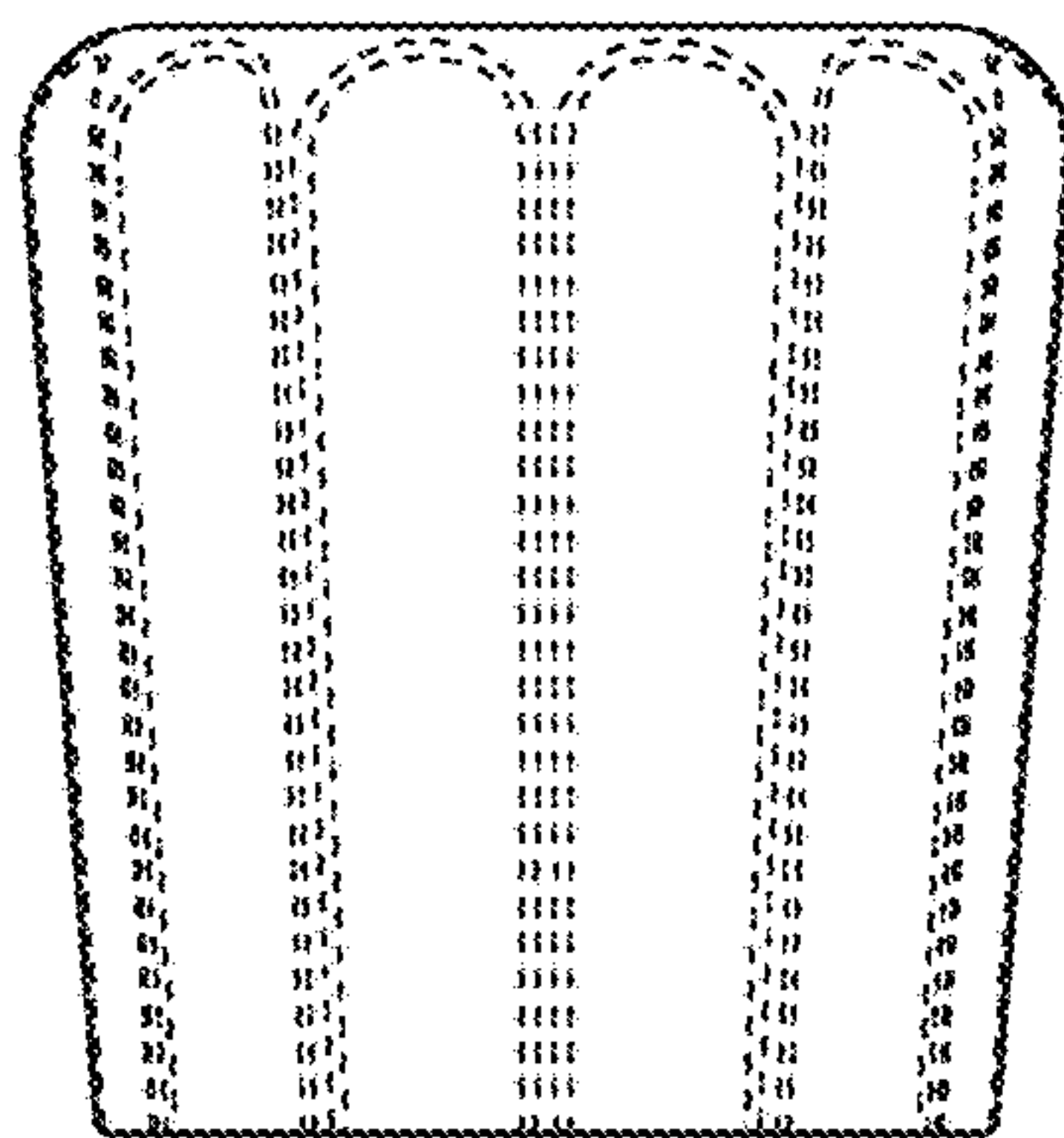

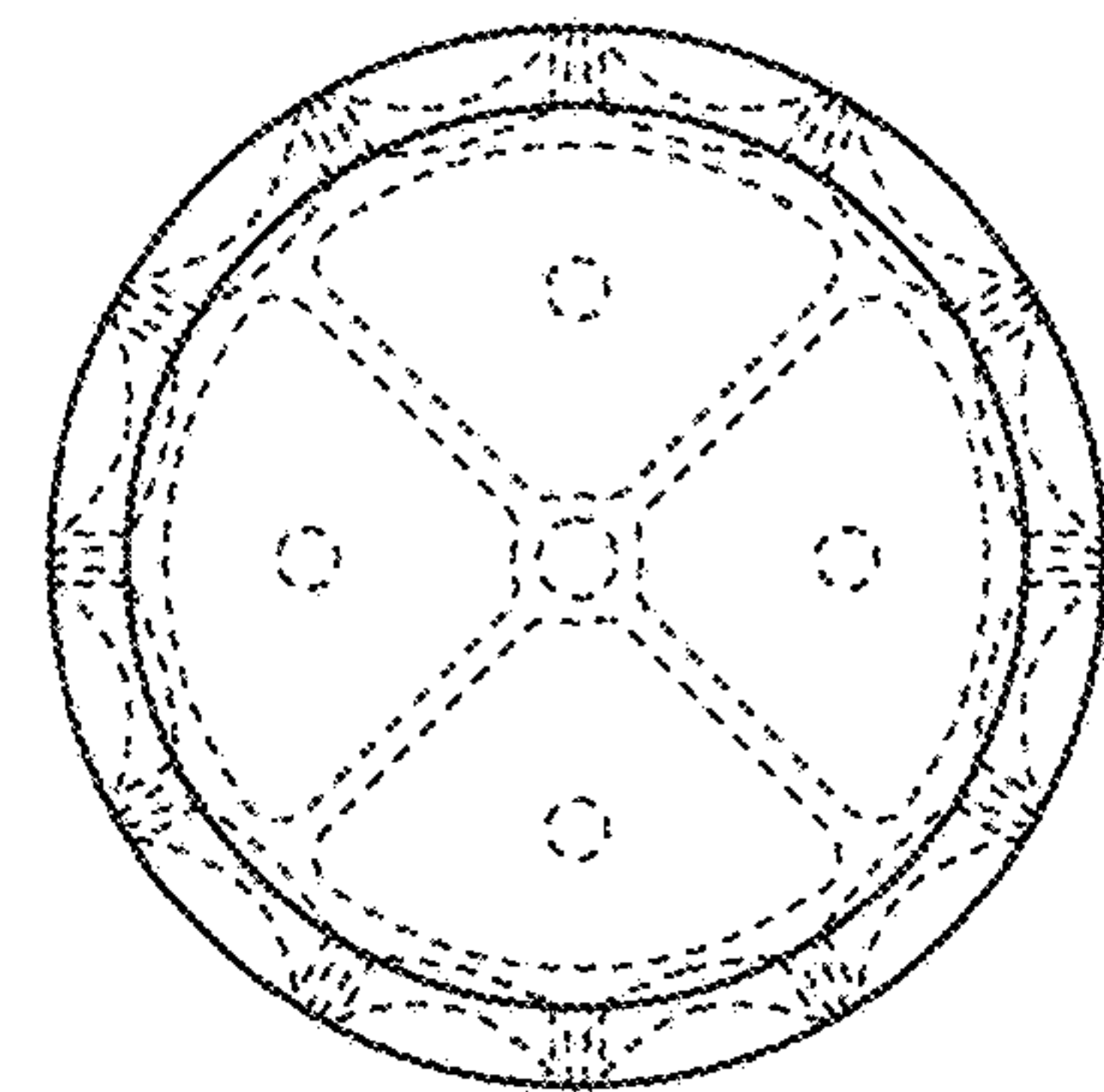
