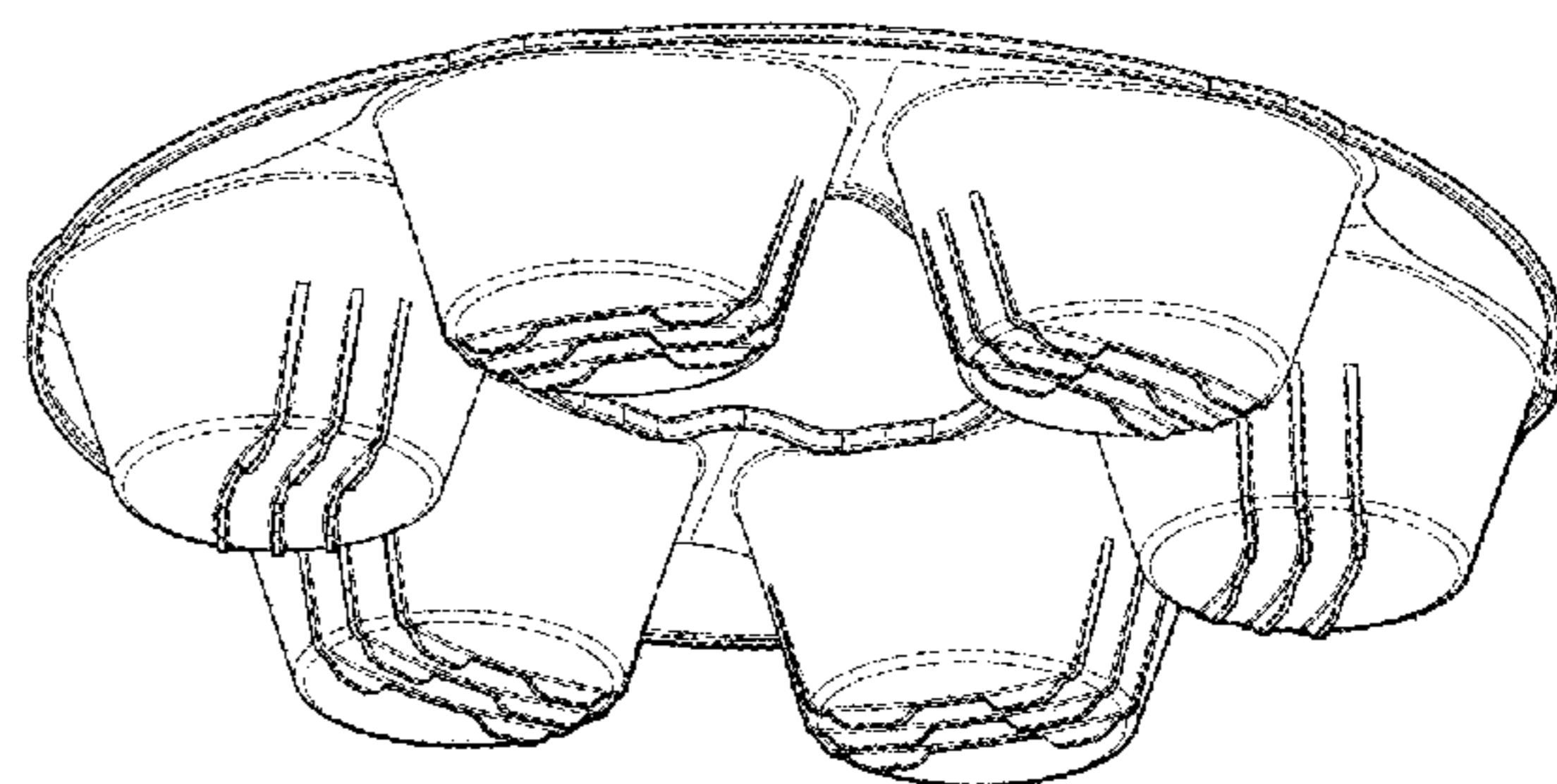
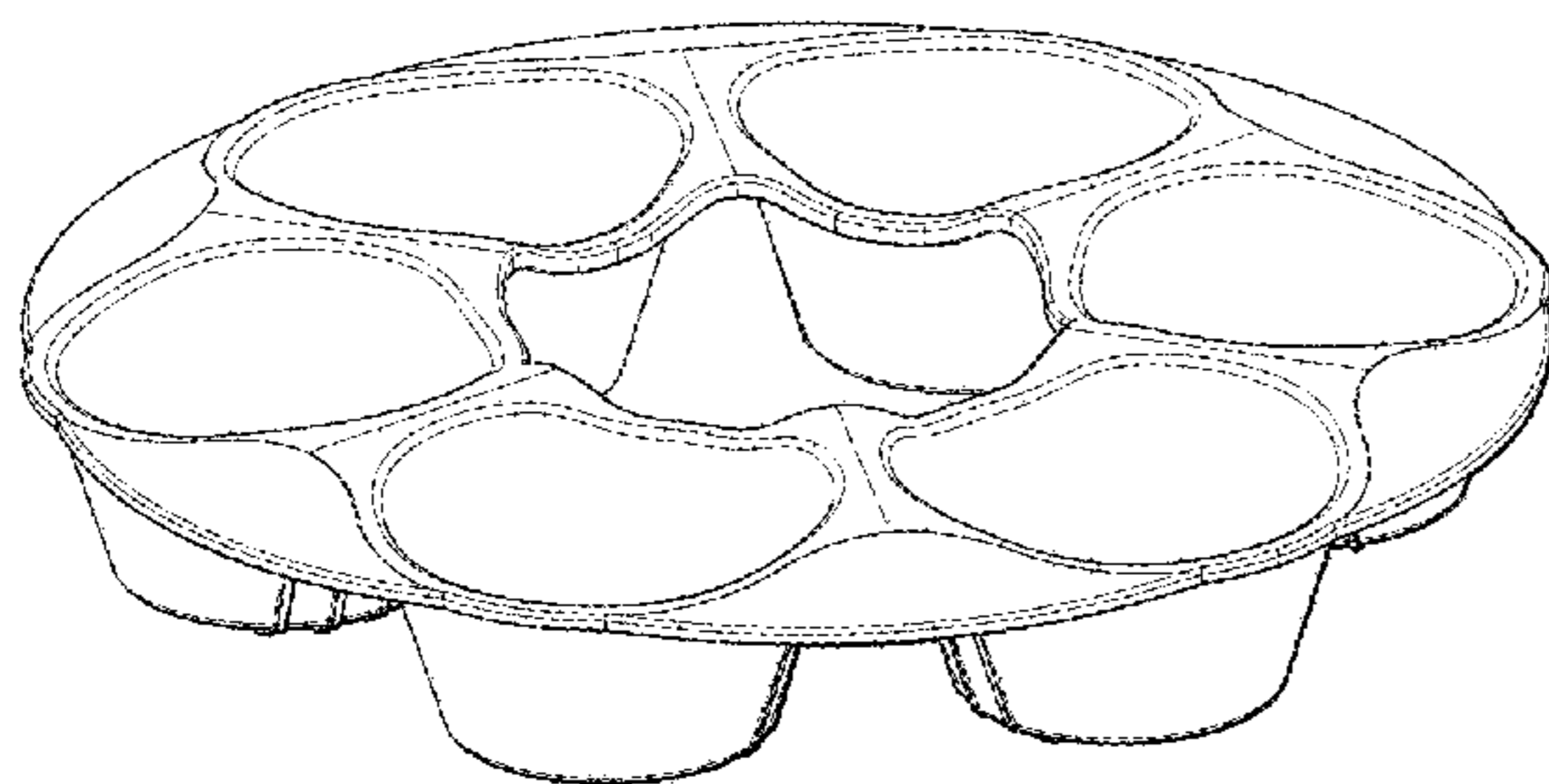
The ornamental design for bakeware, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view from above of bakeware showing our new design;
FIG. 2 is a rear perspective view from below thereof;
FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a front elevational view thereof;
FIG. 6 is a rear elevational view thereof;
FIG. 7 is a left side elevational view thereof; and,

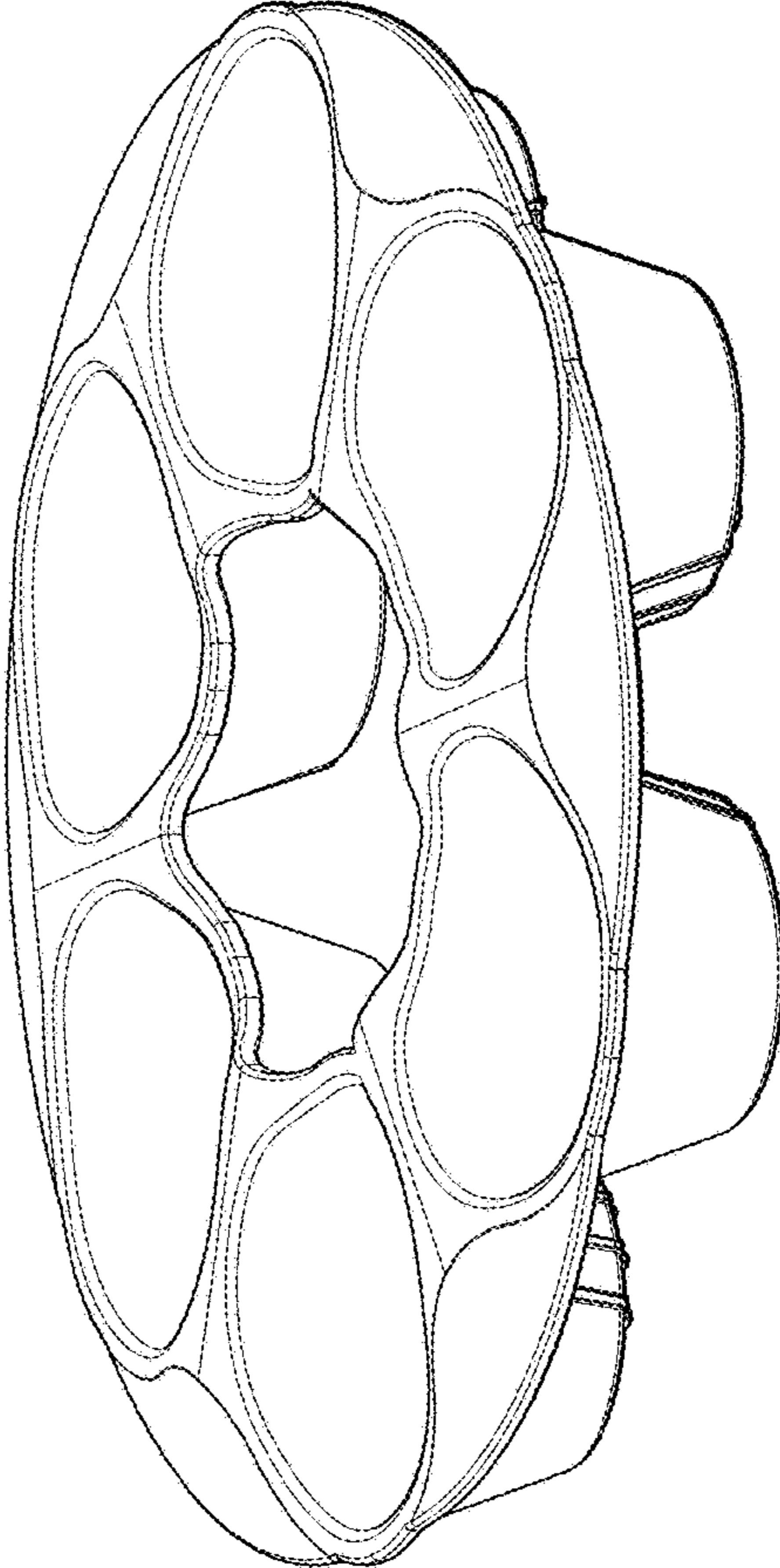

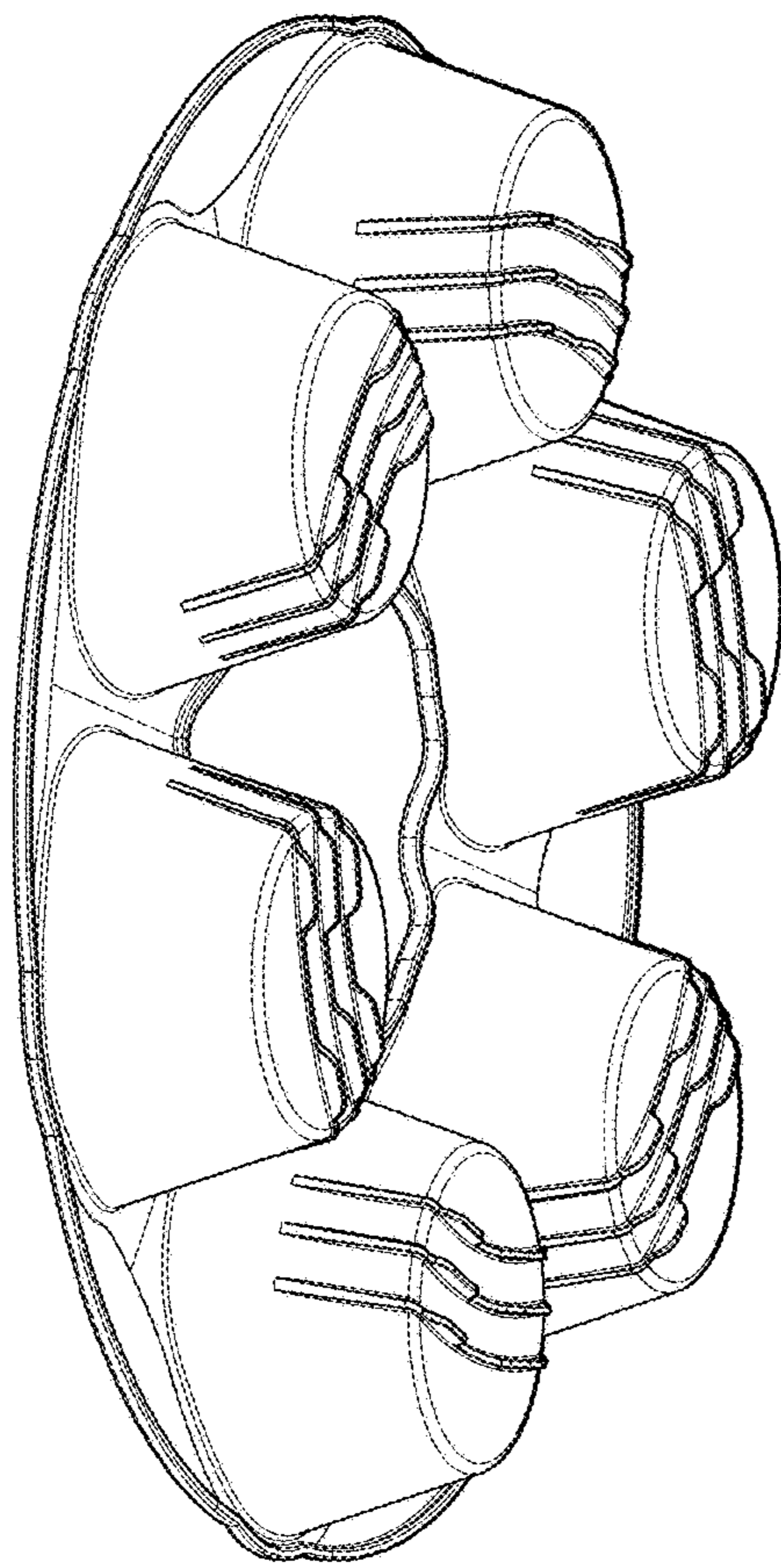

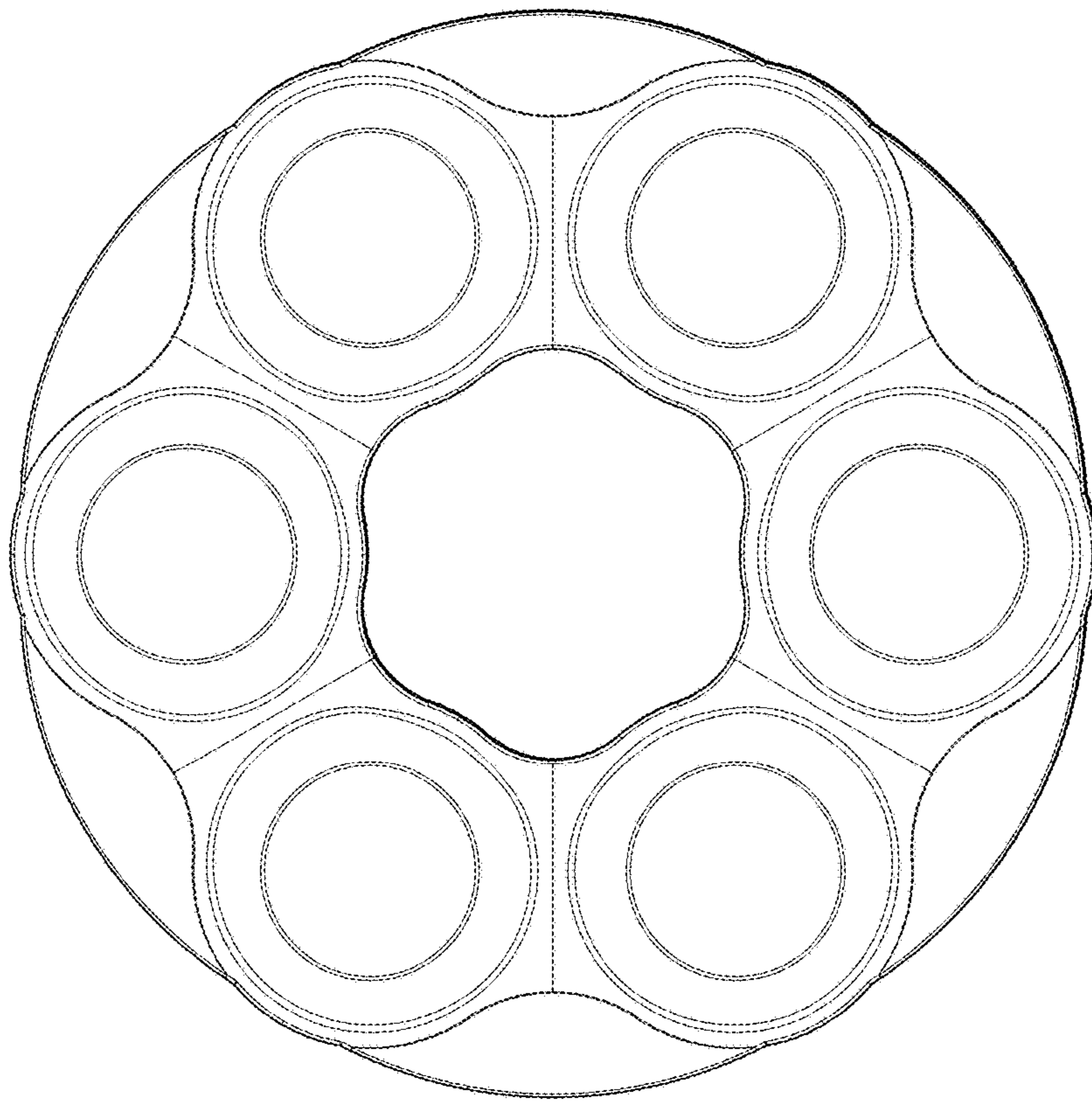

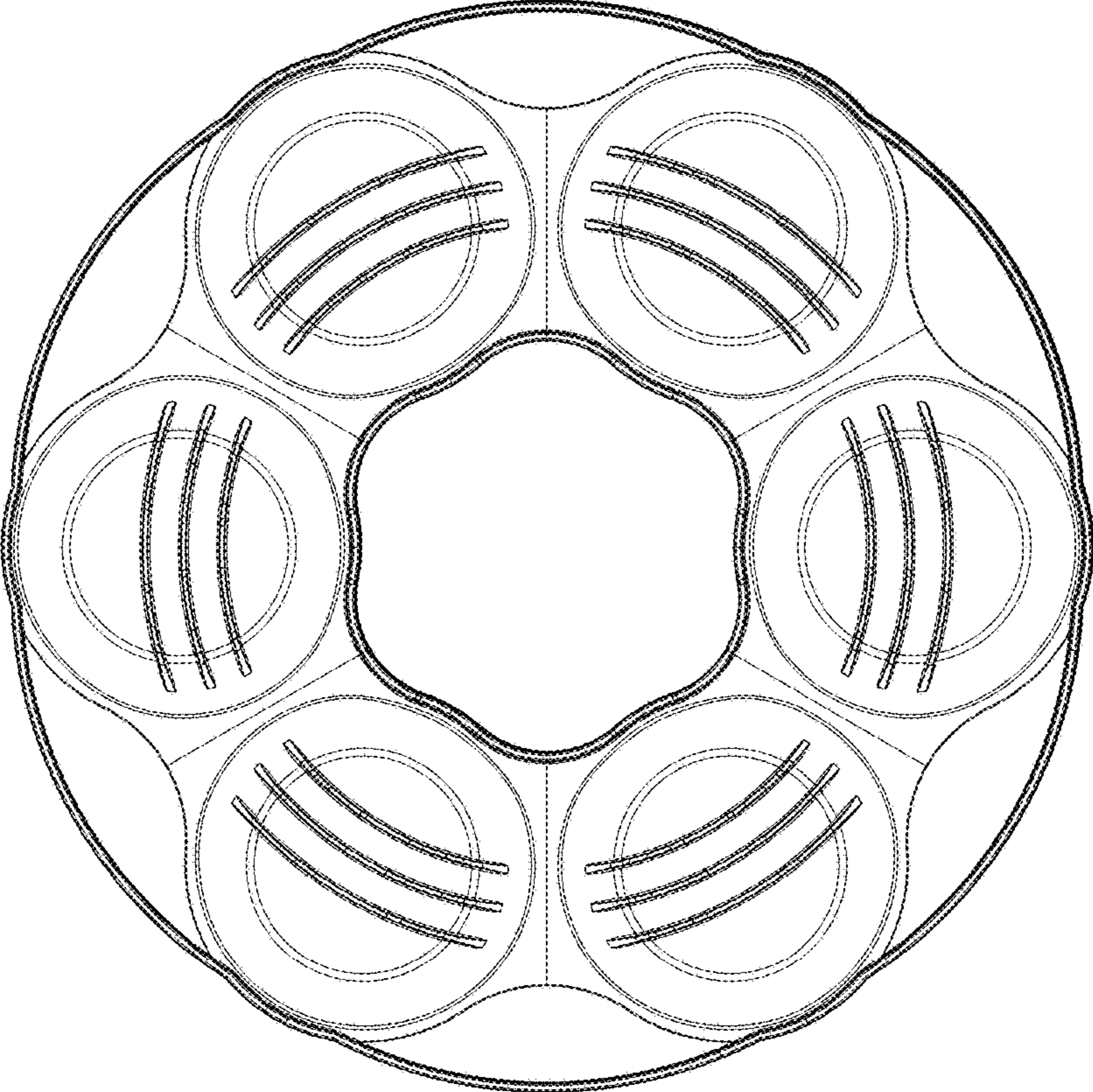

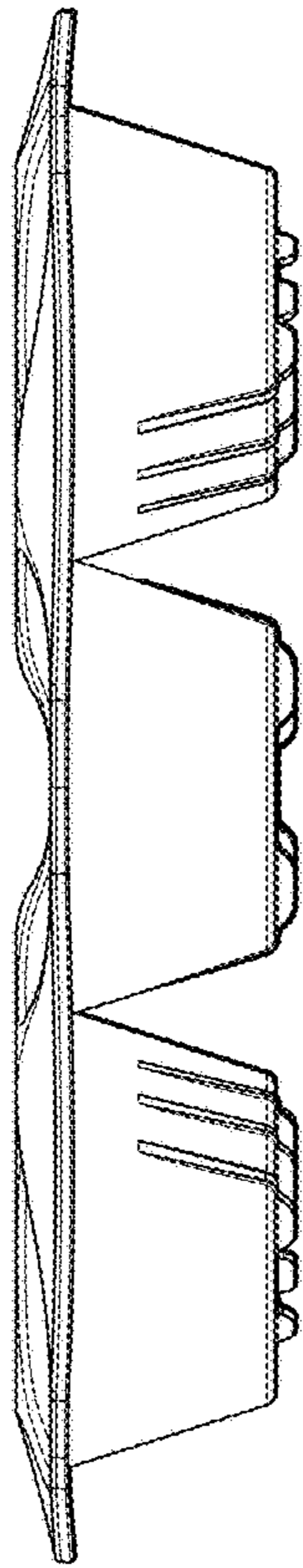

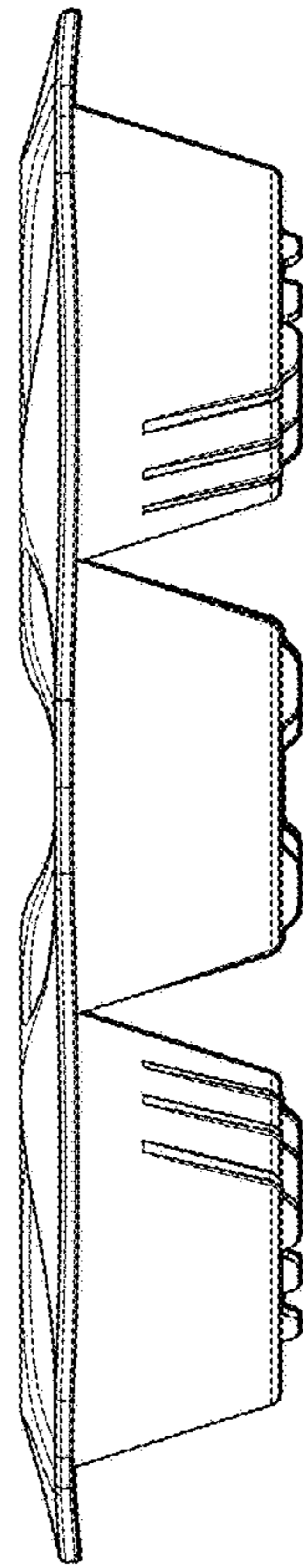

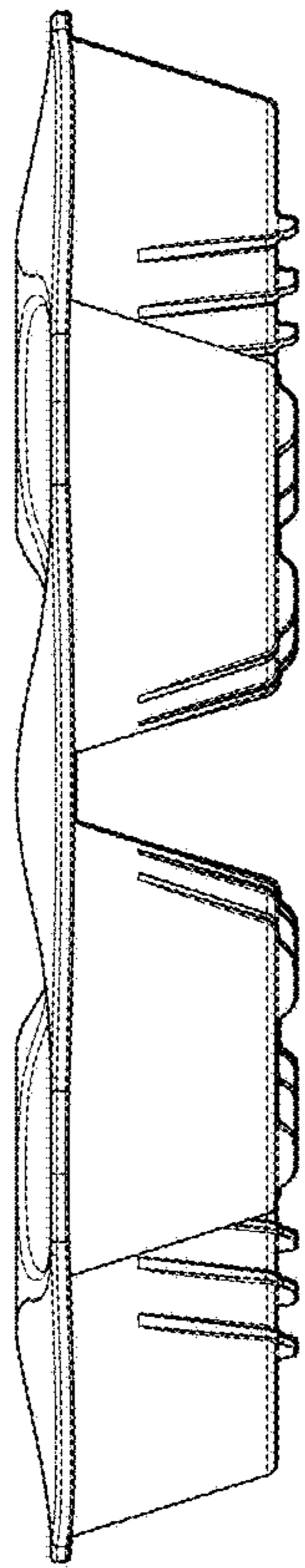

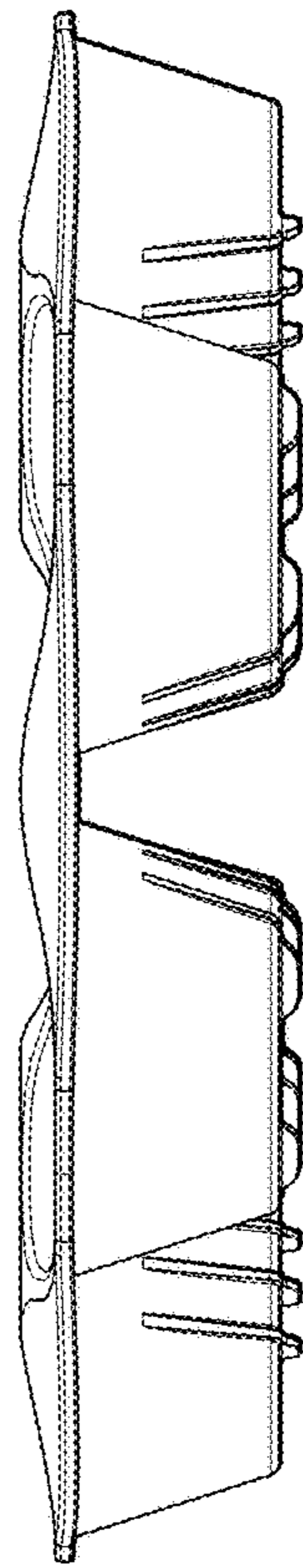
