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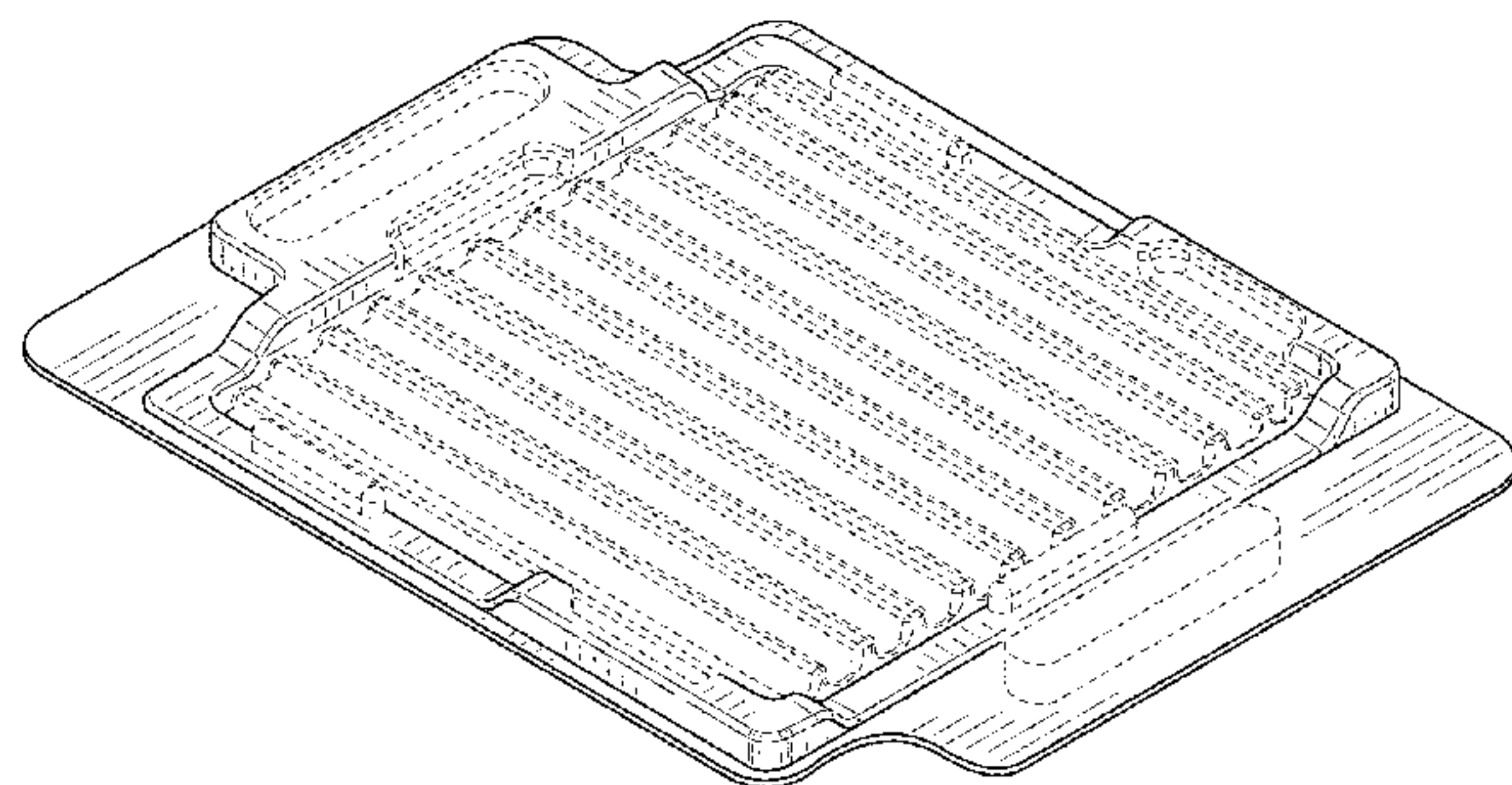
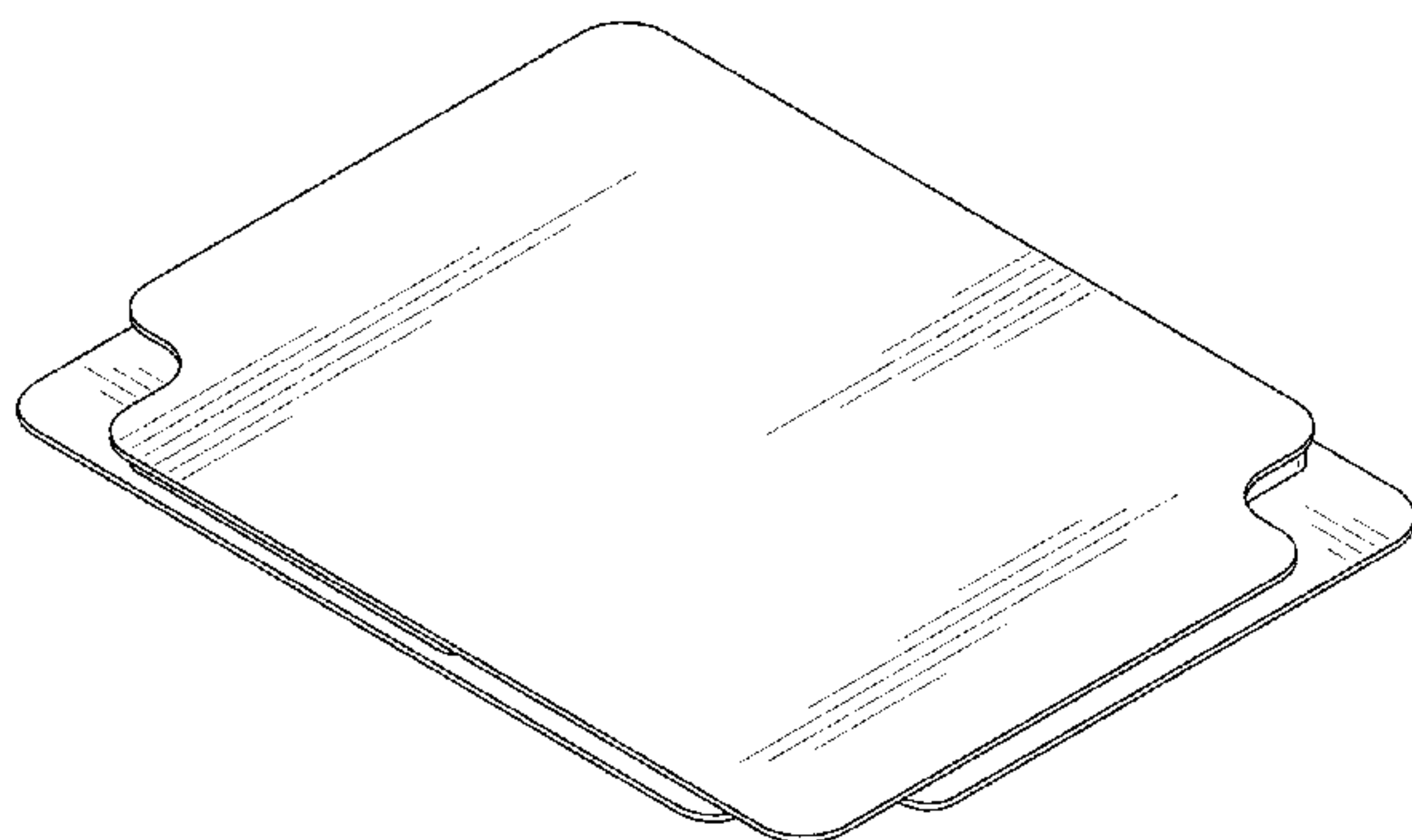
(57) **CLAIM**

and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top perspective view of a tissue graft retainer
showing our new design having a first part and a second part
which is identical to and assembled with the first part;
FIG. 2 is a left side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 3 is right side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a front elevational view thereof;
FIG. 6 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view thereof;
FIG. 8 is a top perspective view of the first part of the tissue
graft retainer of FIG. 1, with the second part removed to
show an interior face of the first part which is identical to an
interior face of the second part;

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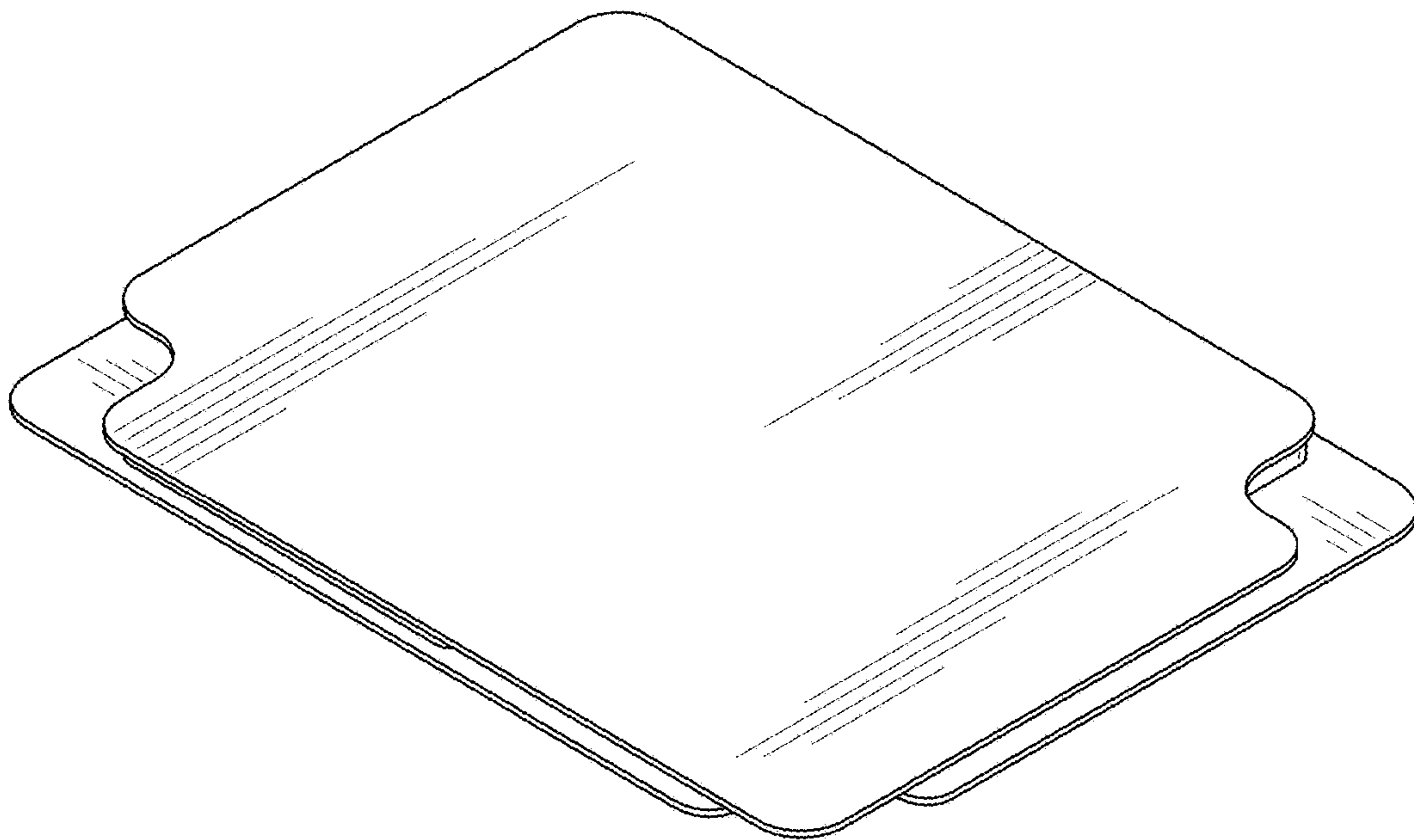

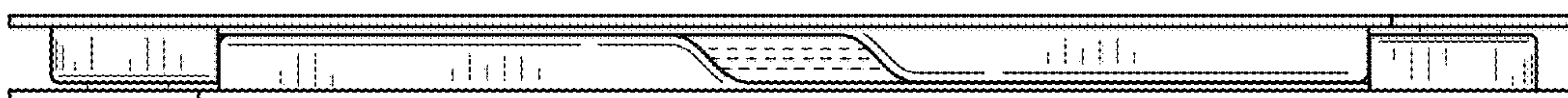

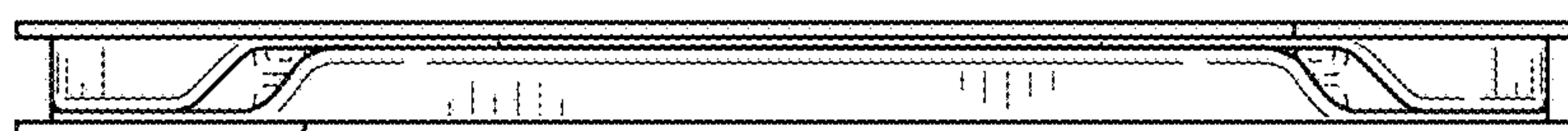

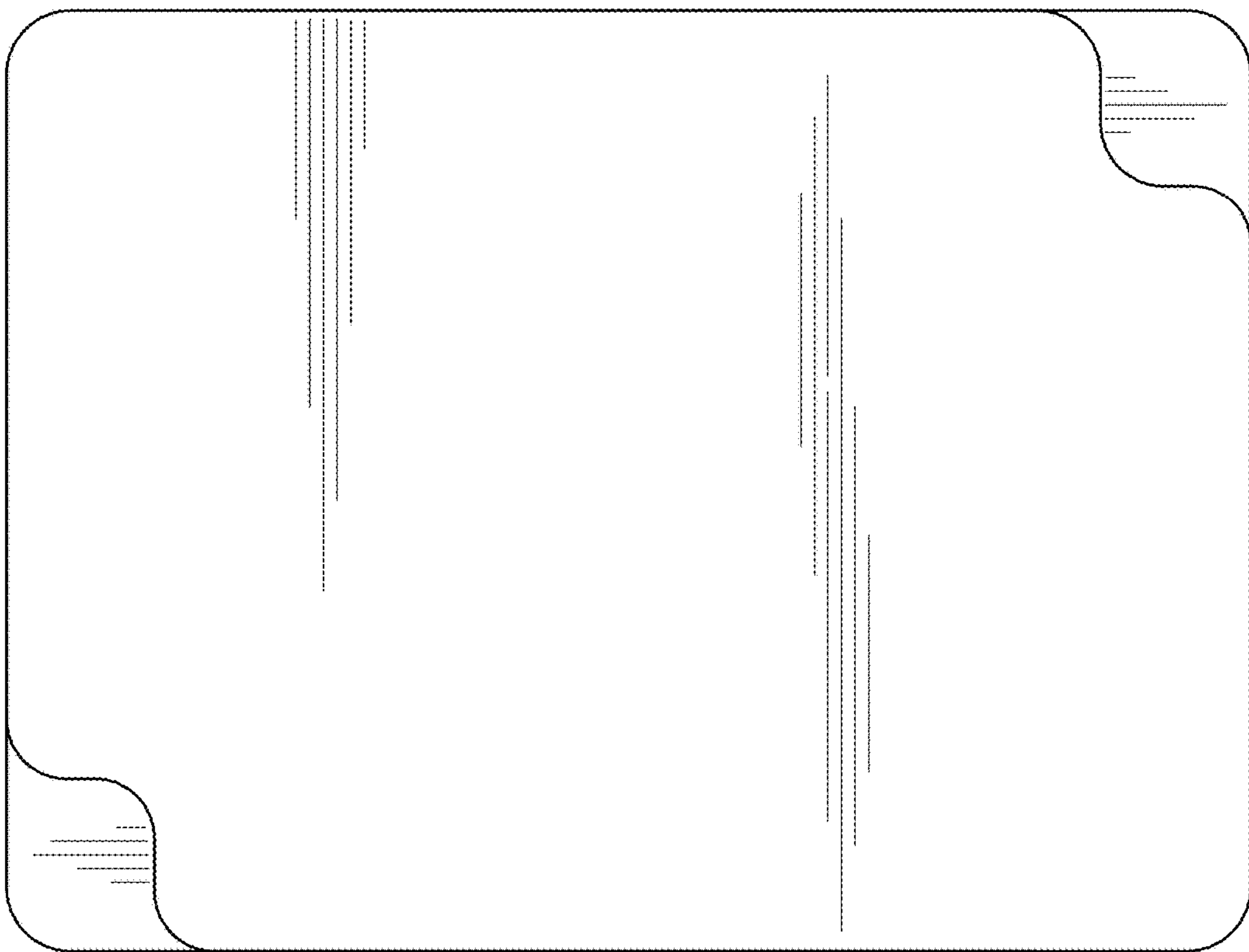

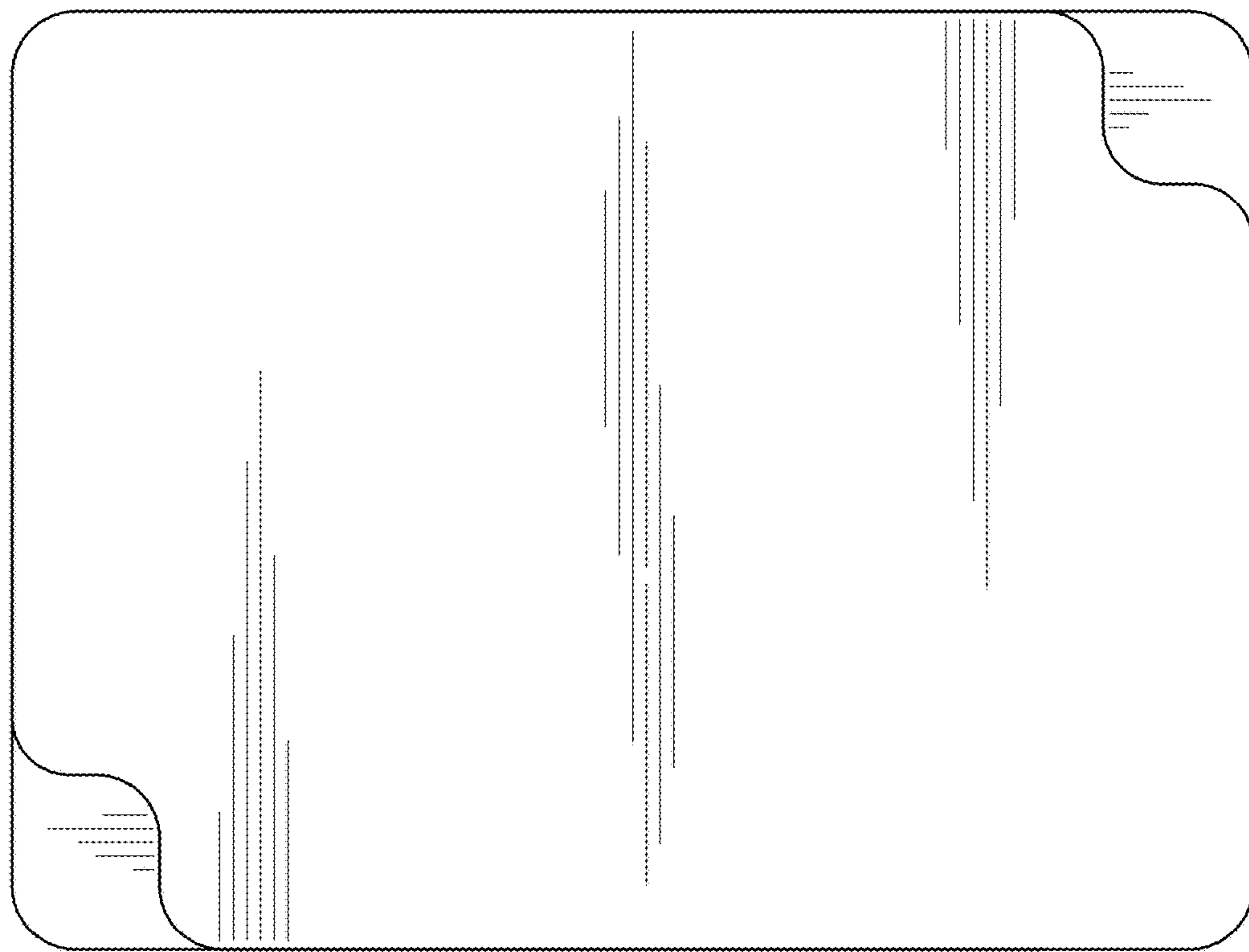

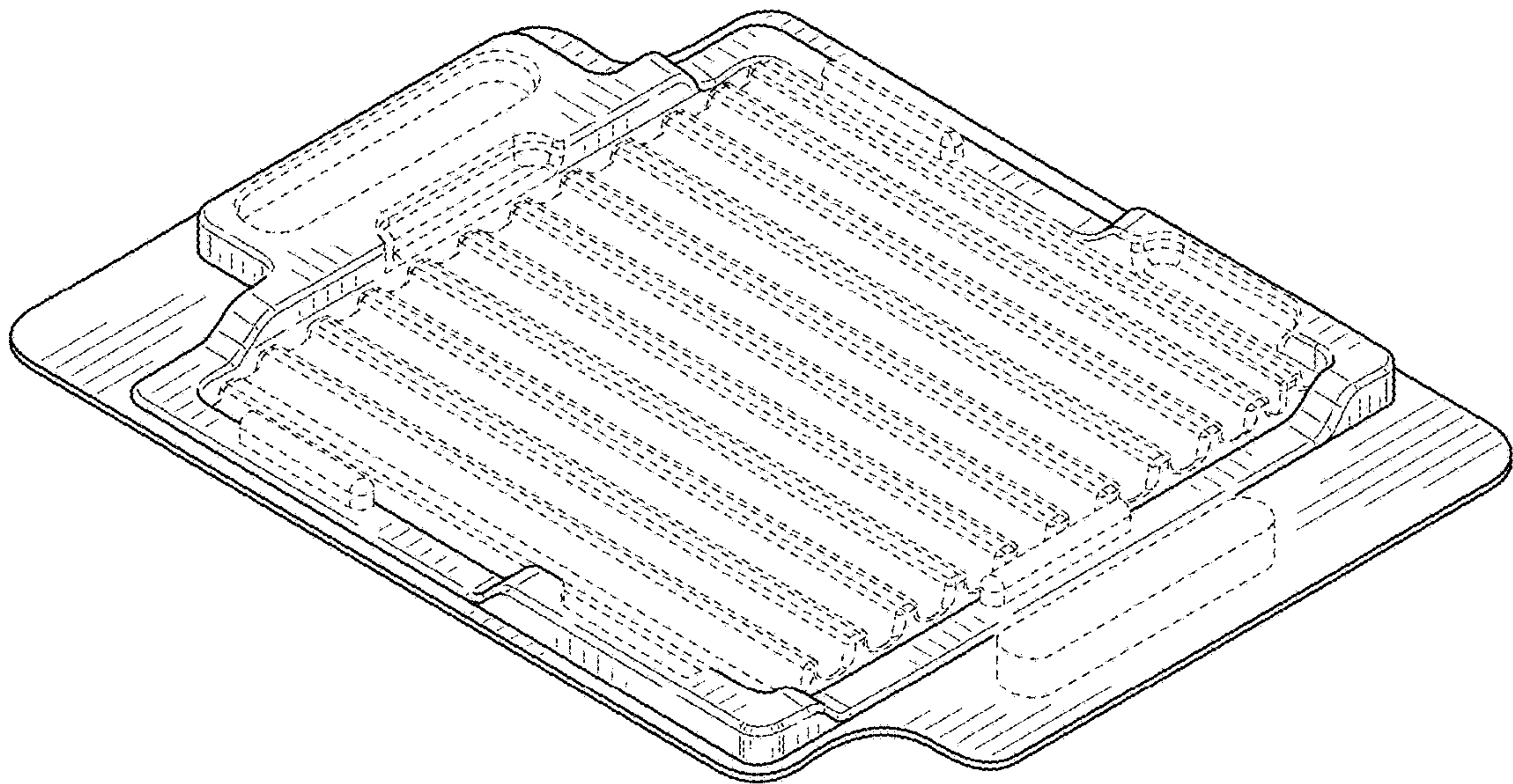

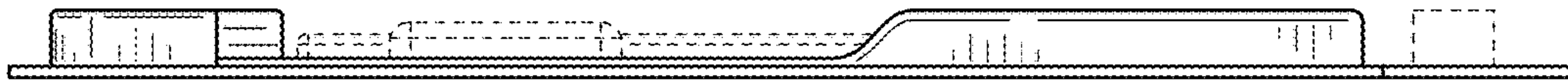

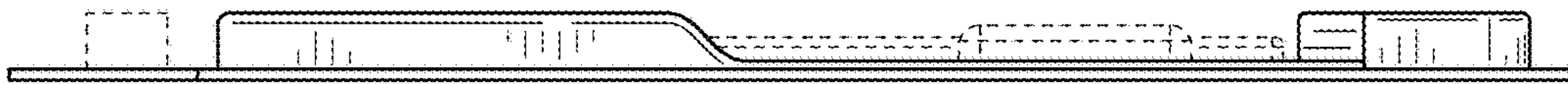

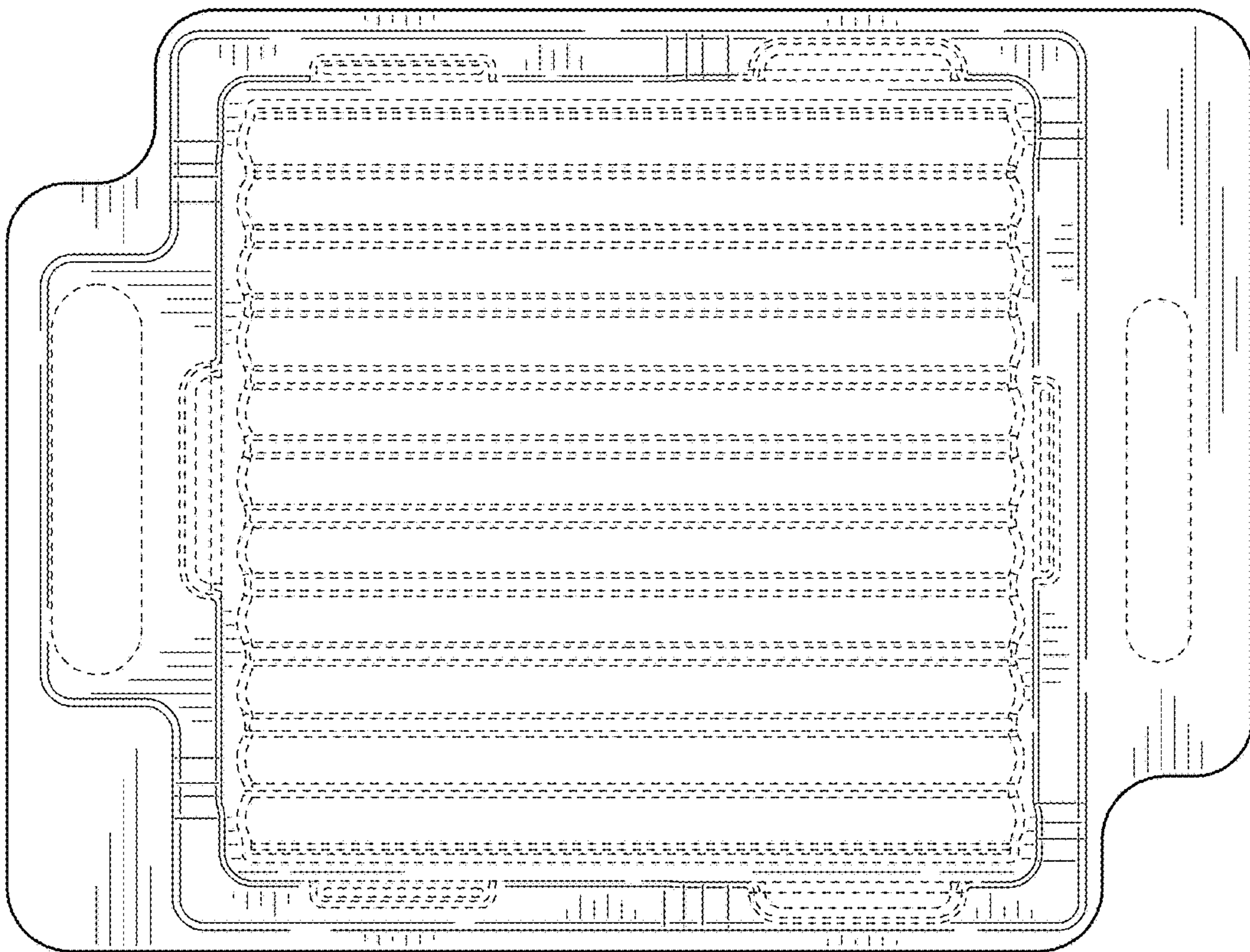

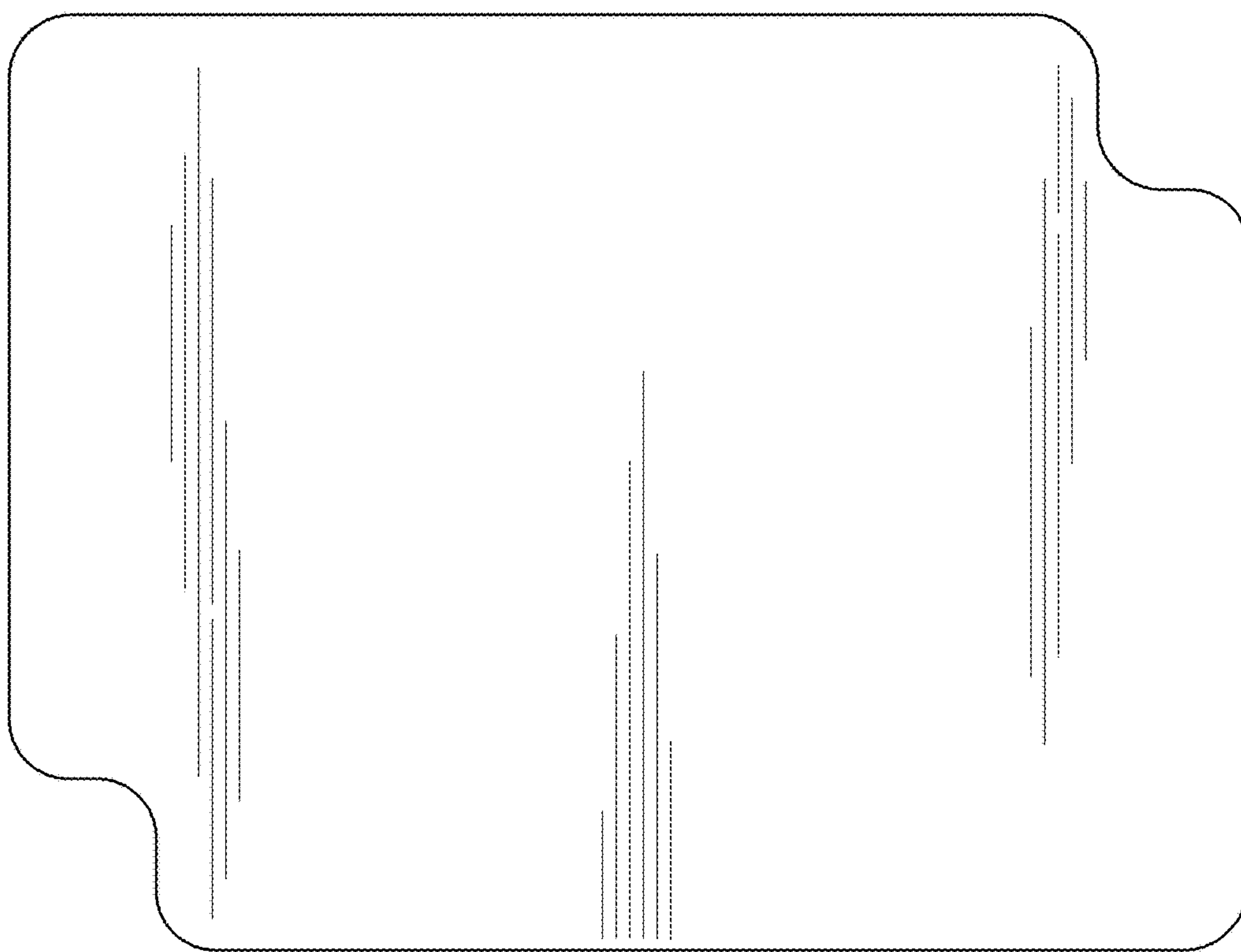
