DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of pants showing my new design.

FIG. 4 is a right view thereof.

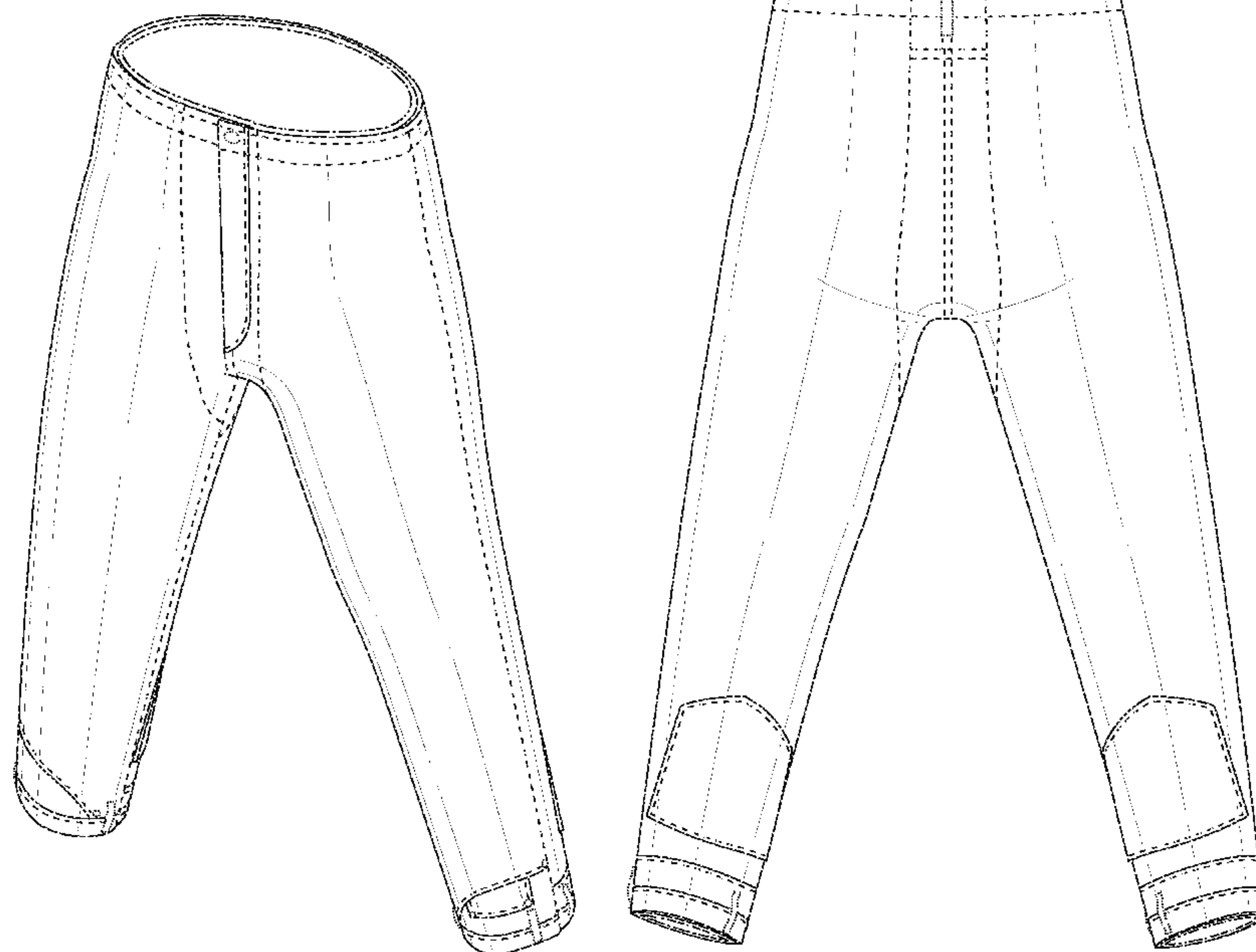
FIG. 5 is a left view thereof.

The shade lines shown represent surface shading and not surface ornamentation, color, or material type. The dot-dashed boundary lines shown do not form part of the claimed design. The bounds of the claimed design are defined with dot-dashed boundary lines when the boundary does not exist in reality in the article embodying the design. The illustrated designs extend to the boundary but do not include the boundary.

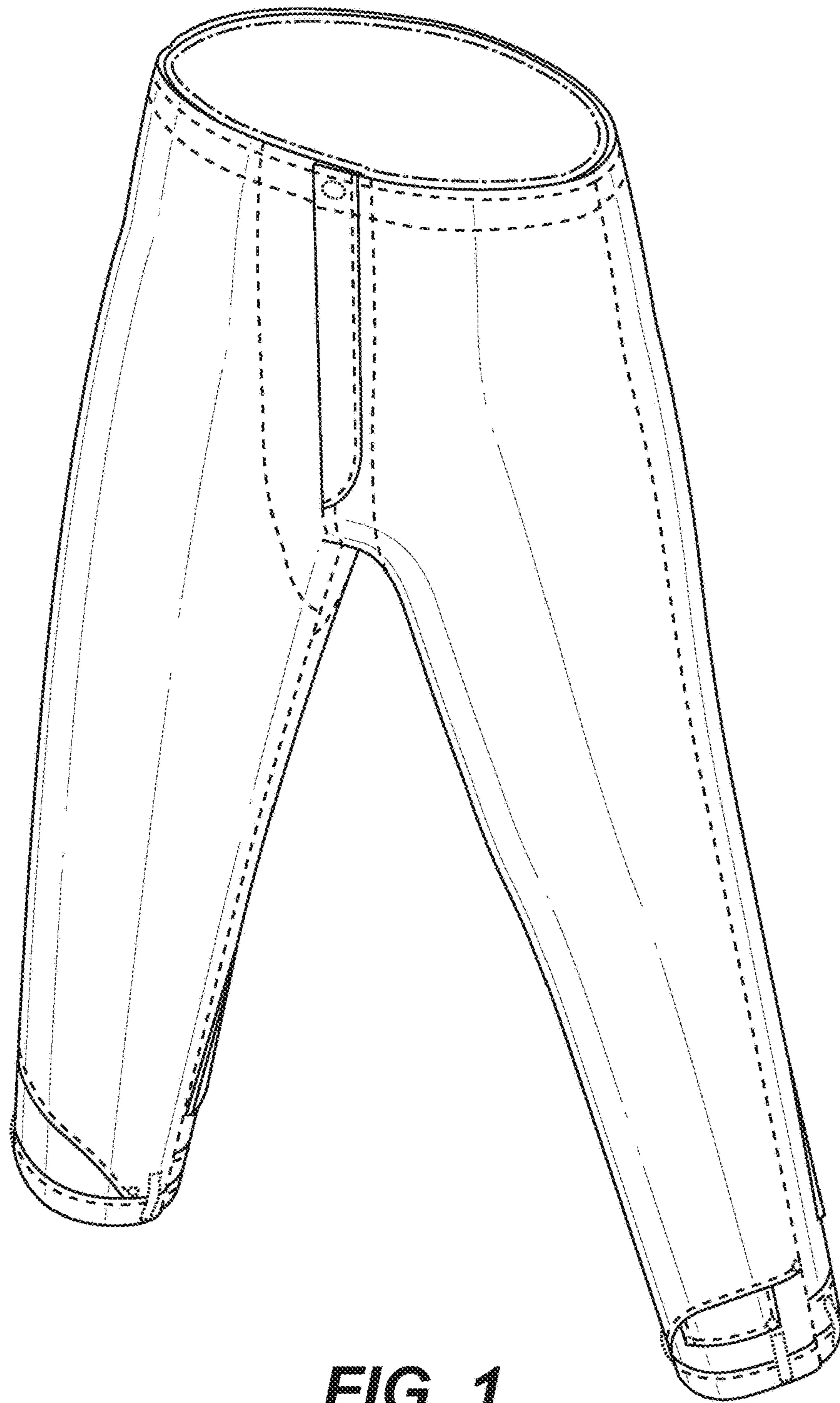

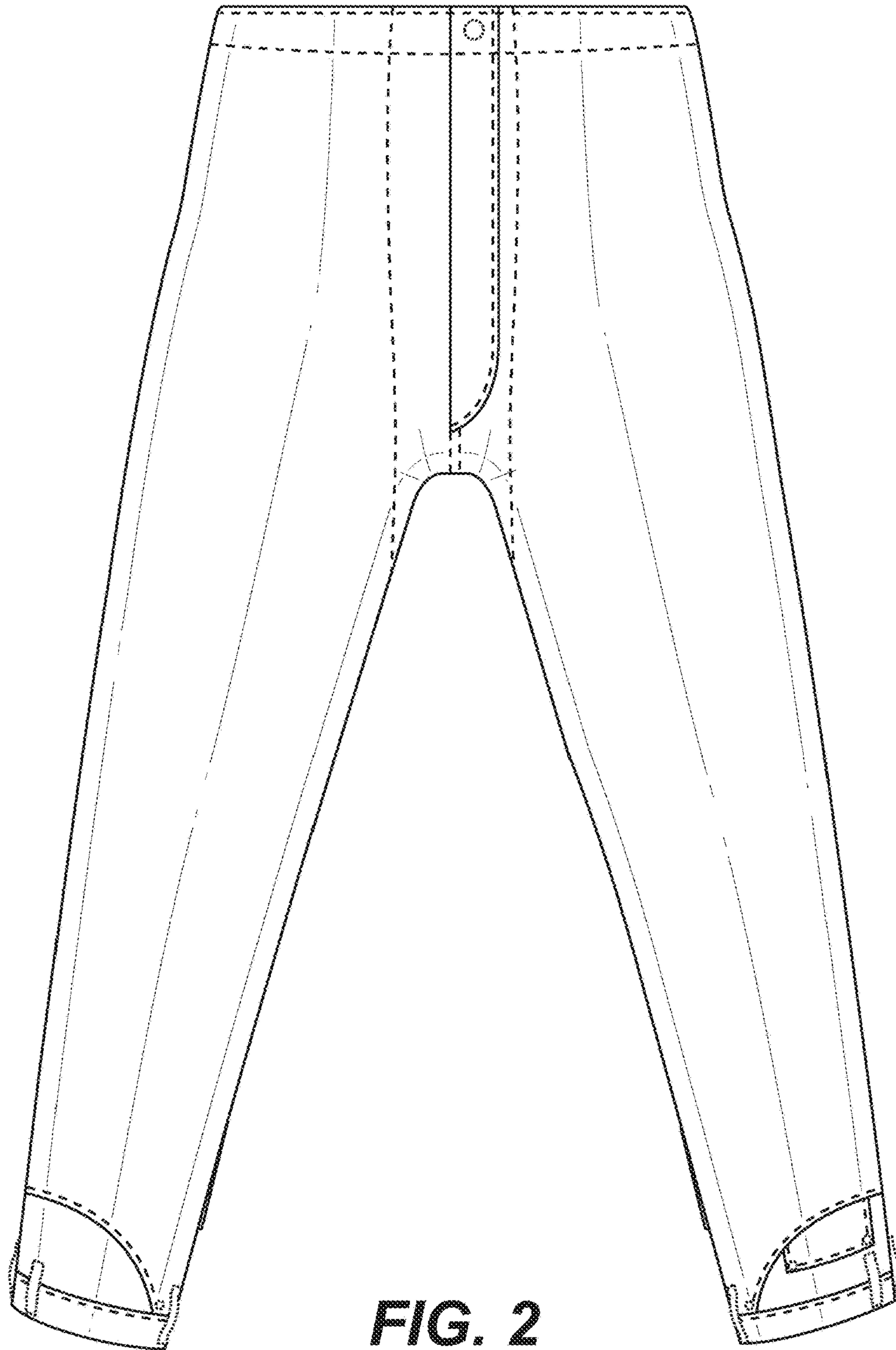

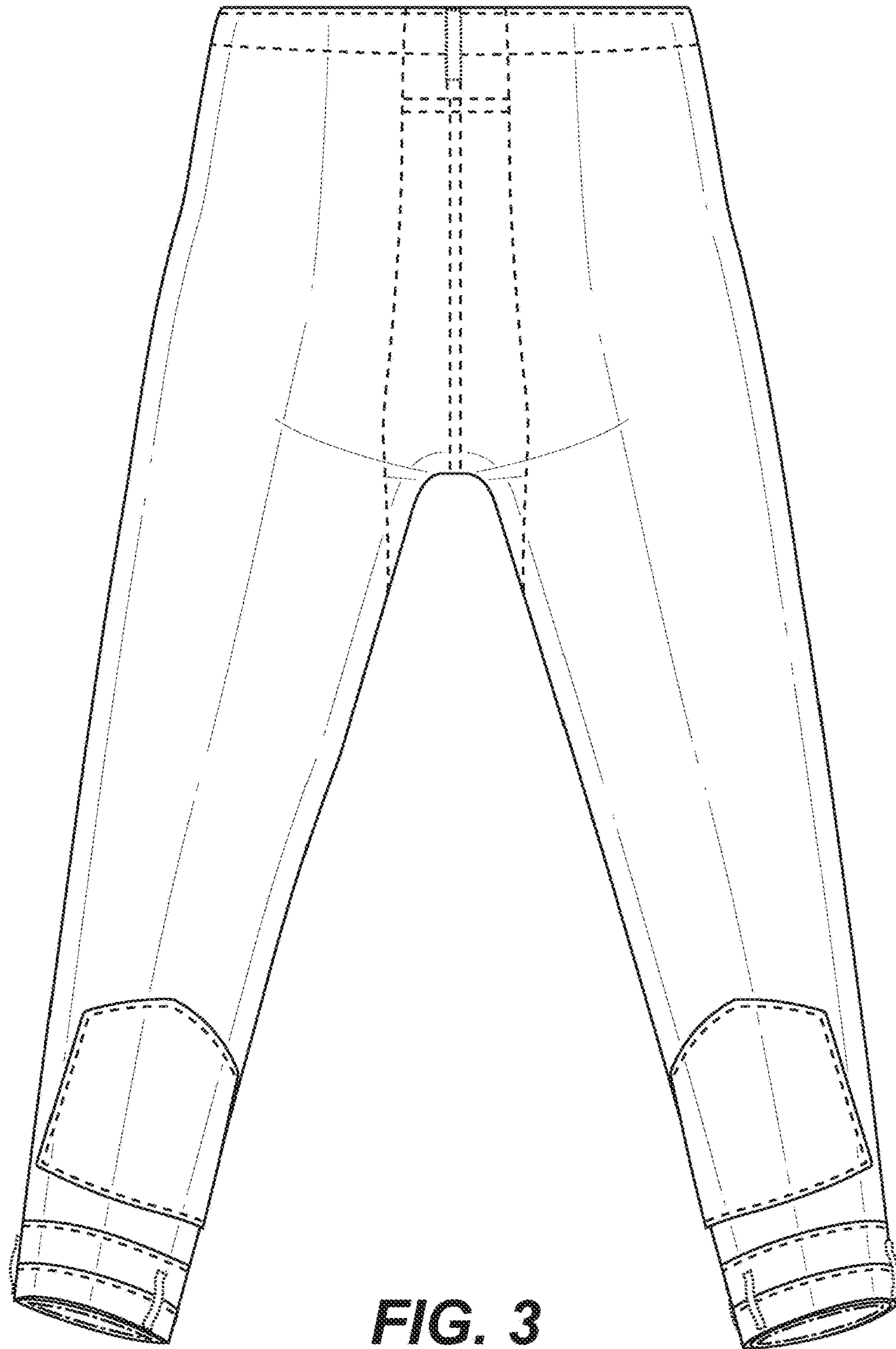

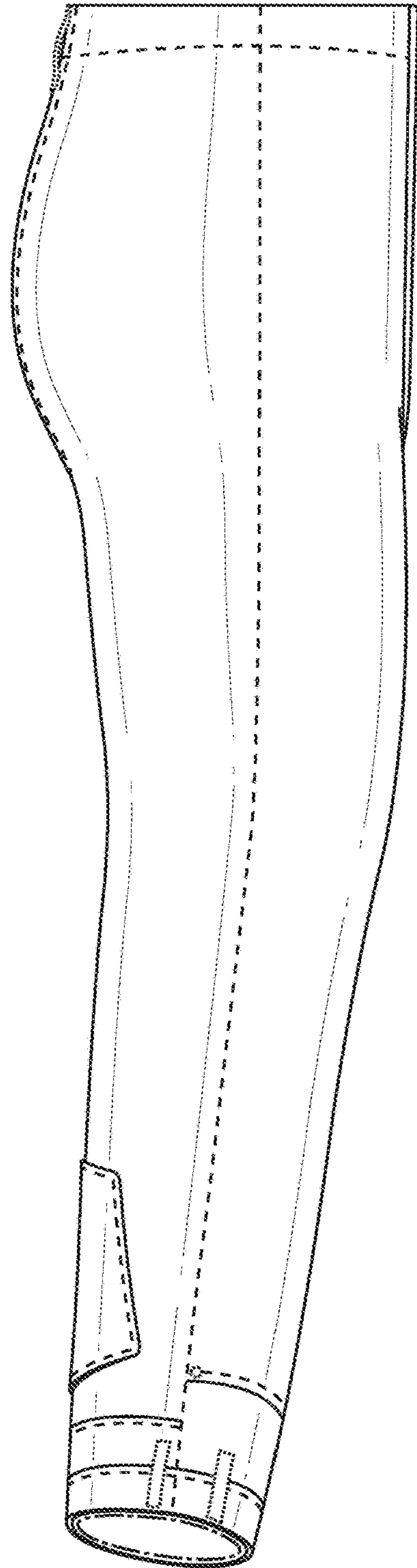

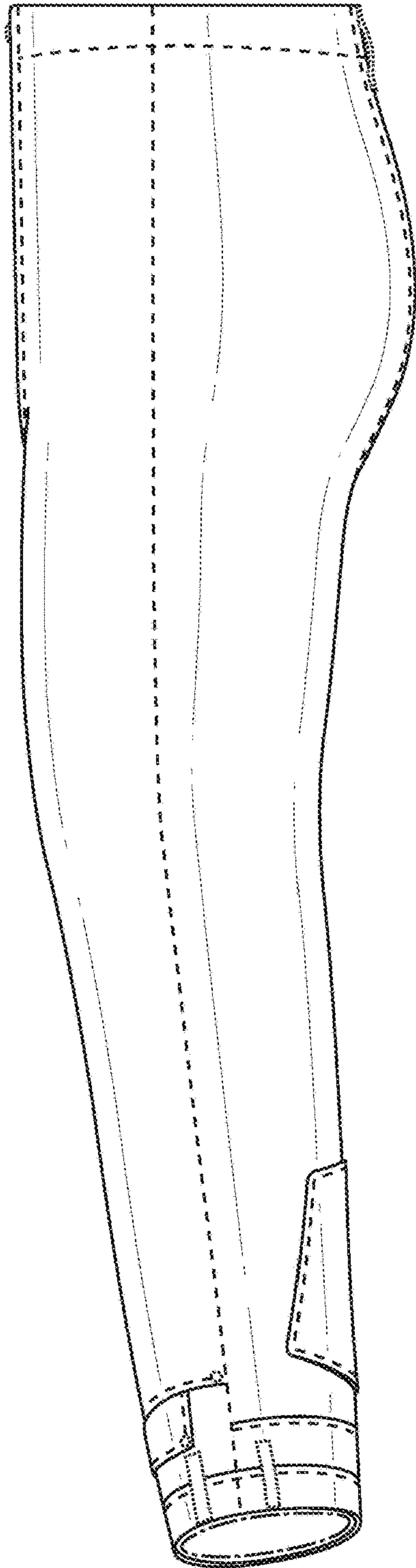

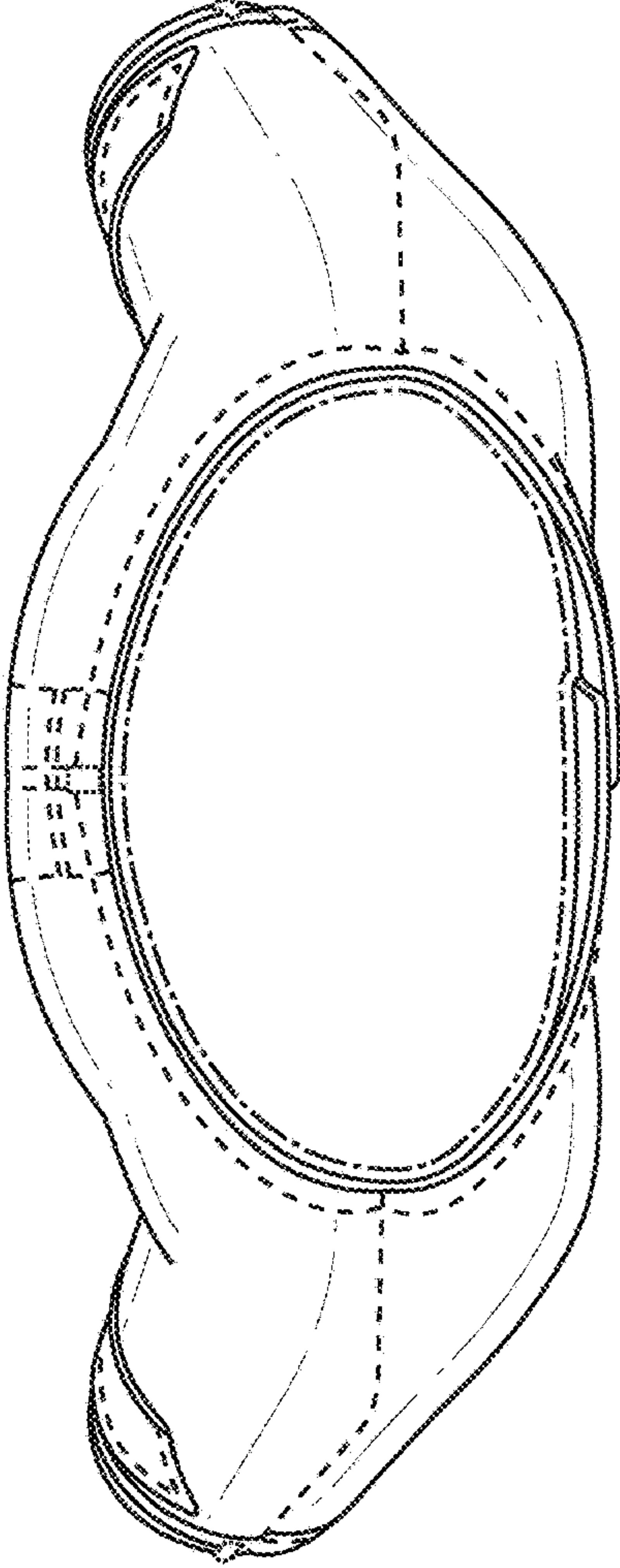

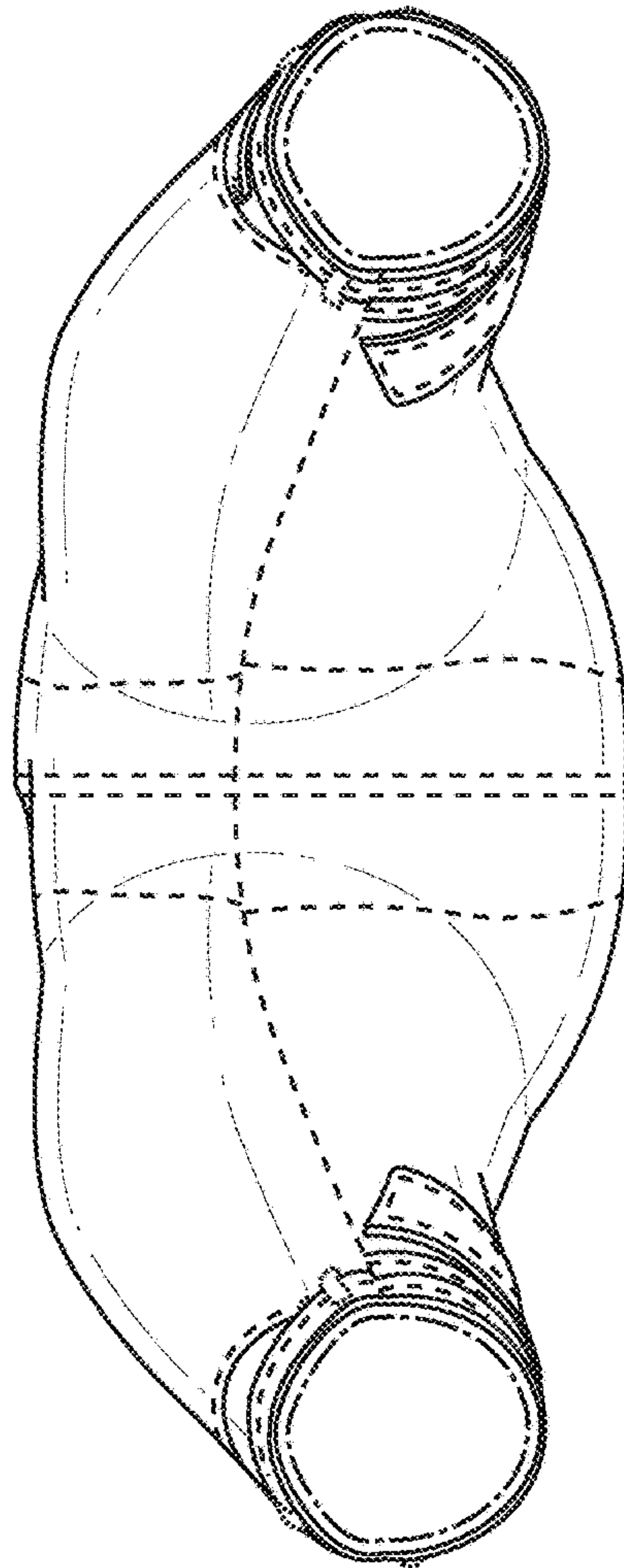
