**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 7 is a bottom view;

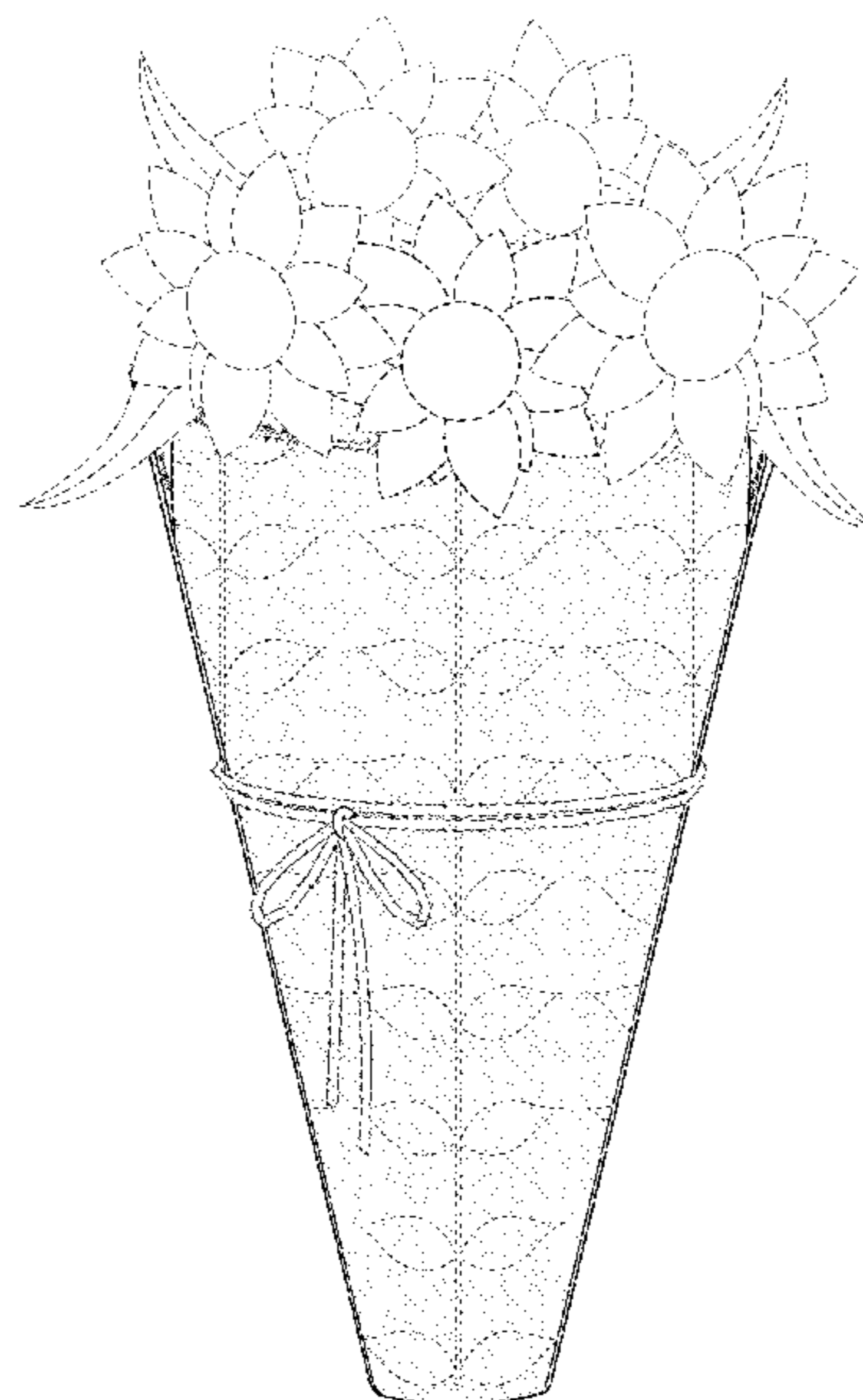
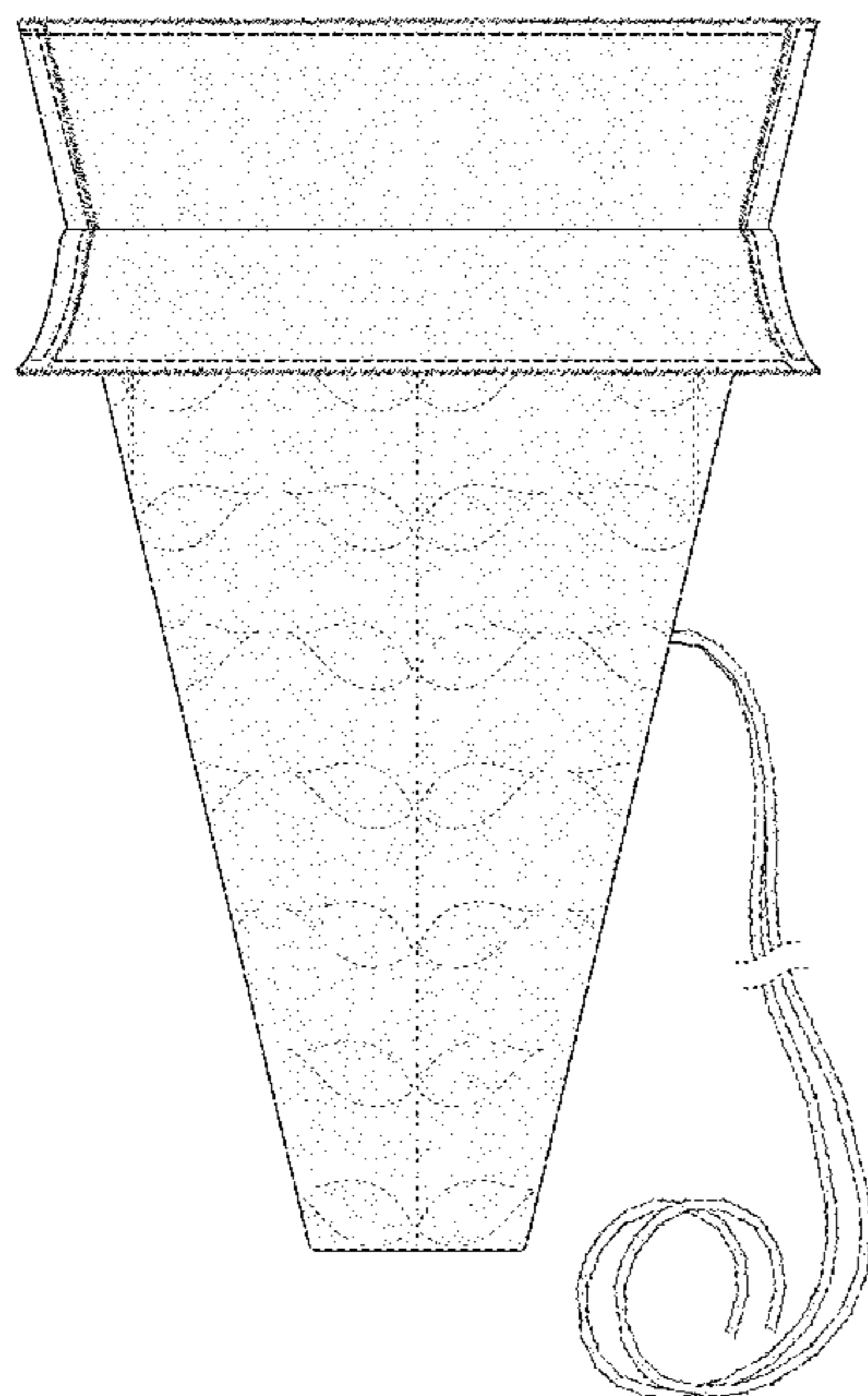
FIG. 8 is a front view showing the flower bouquet bag in an open configuration;

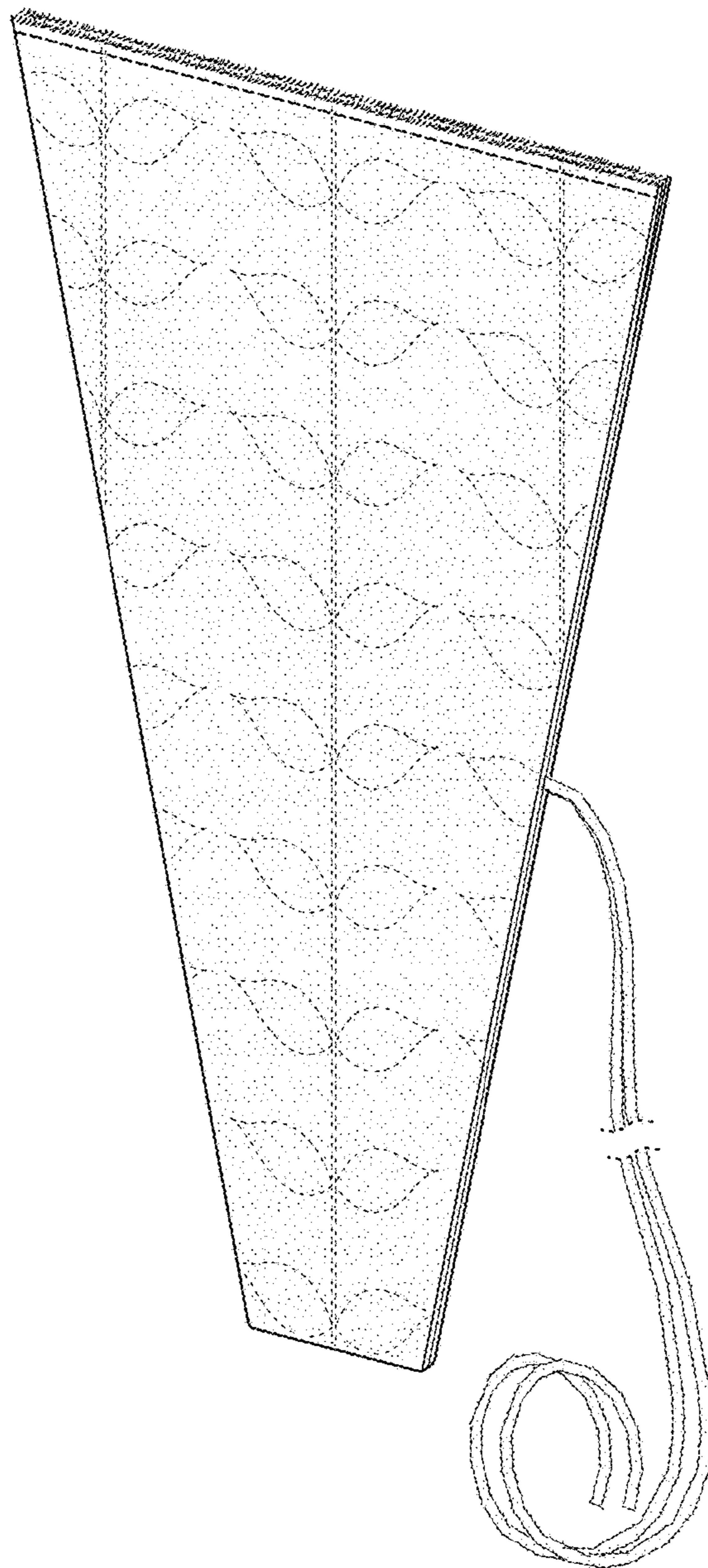

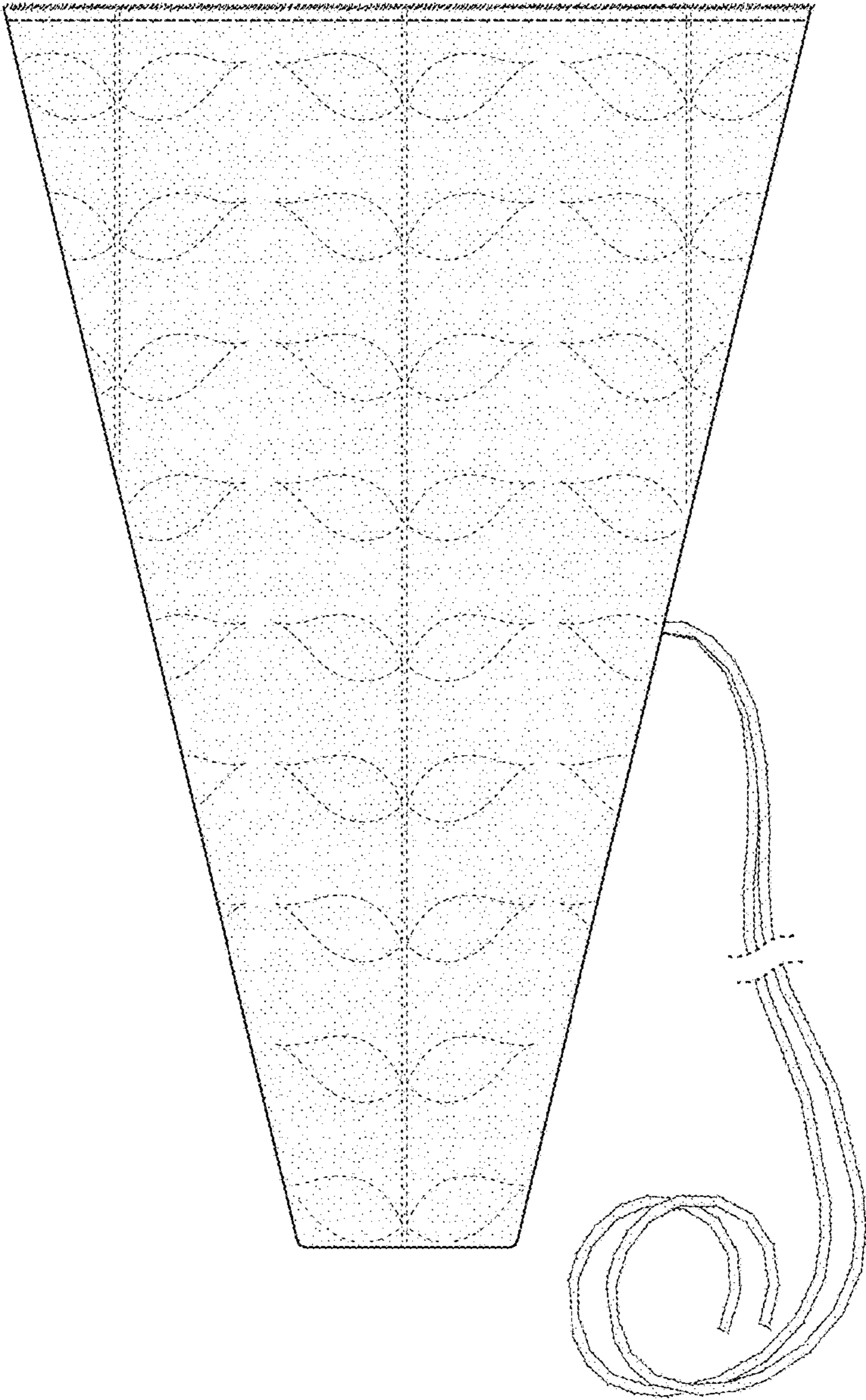

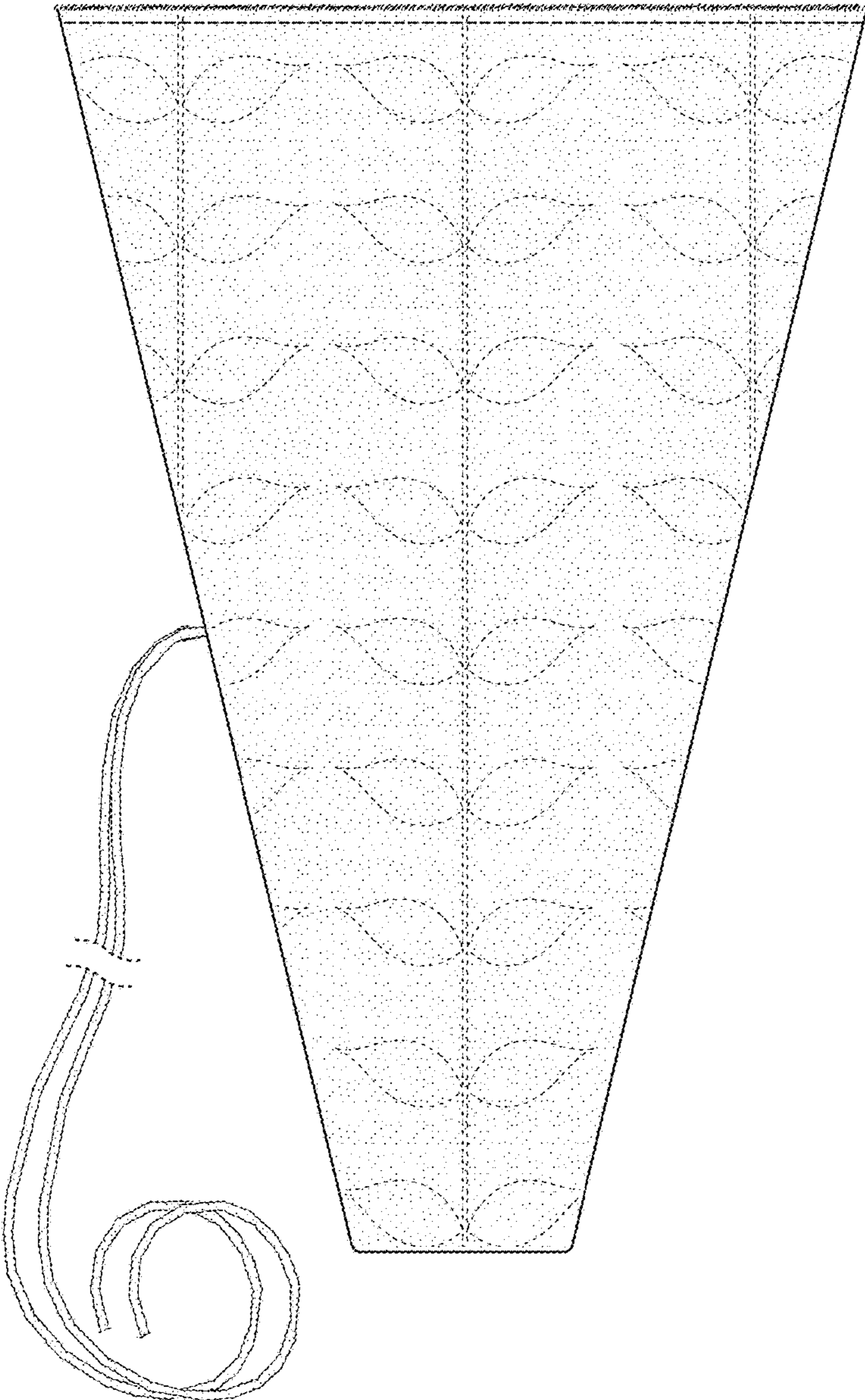

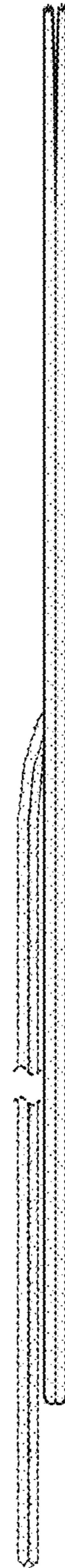

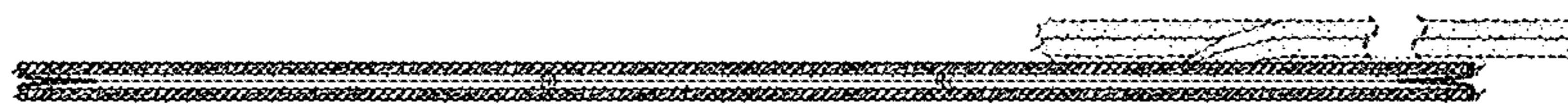

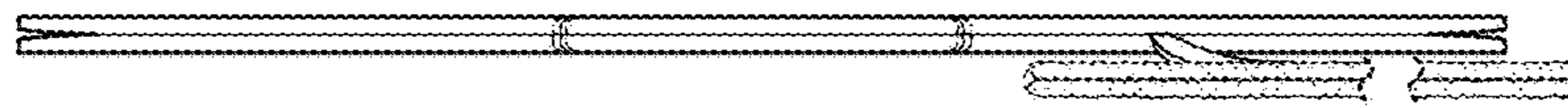

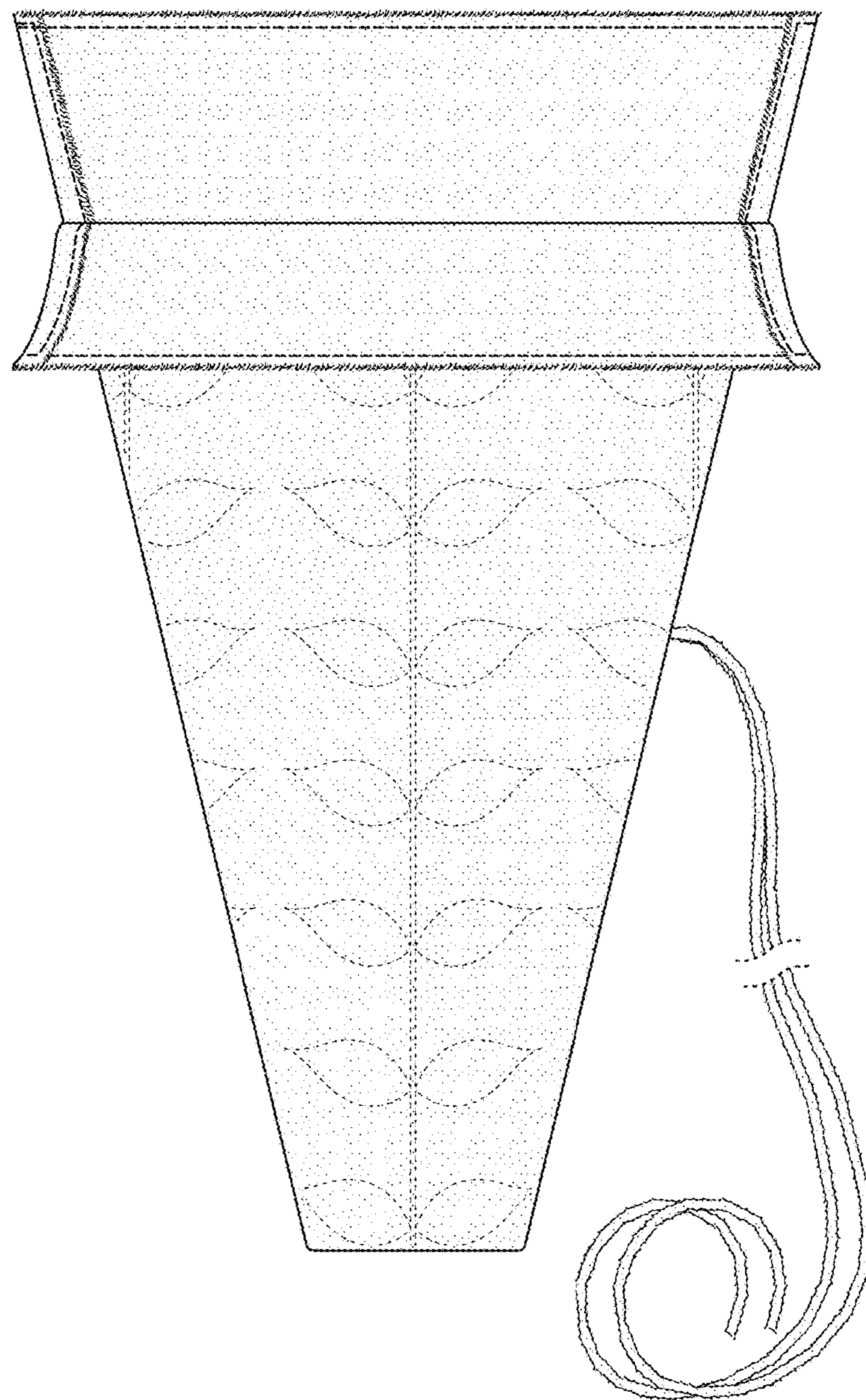

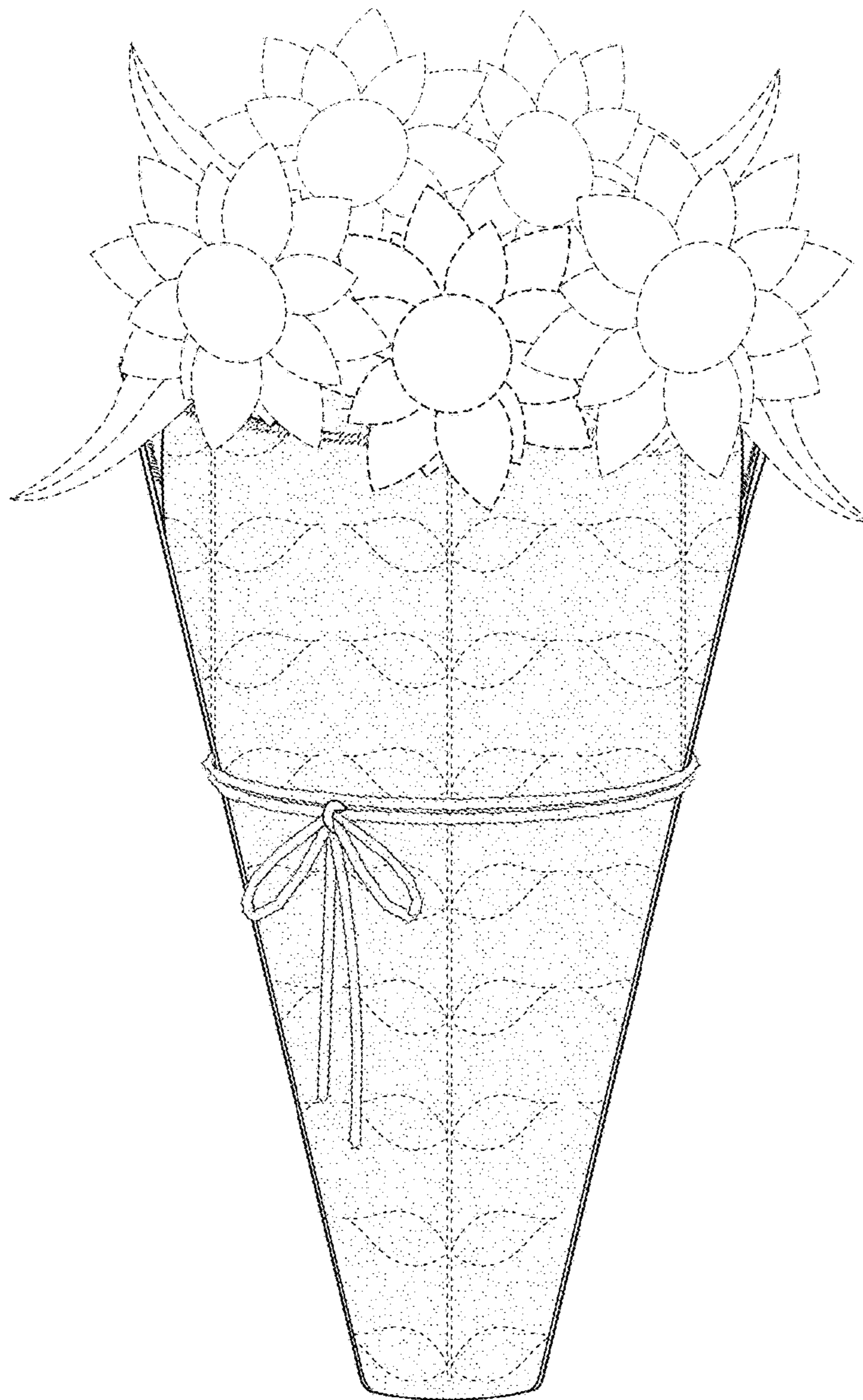
