FIG. 4 is a side view thereof;

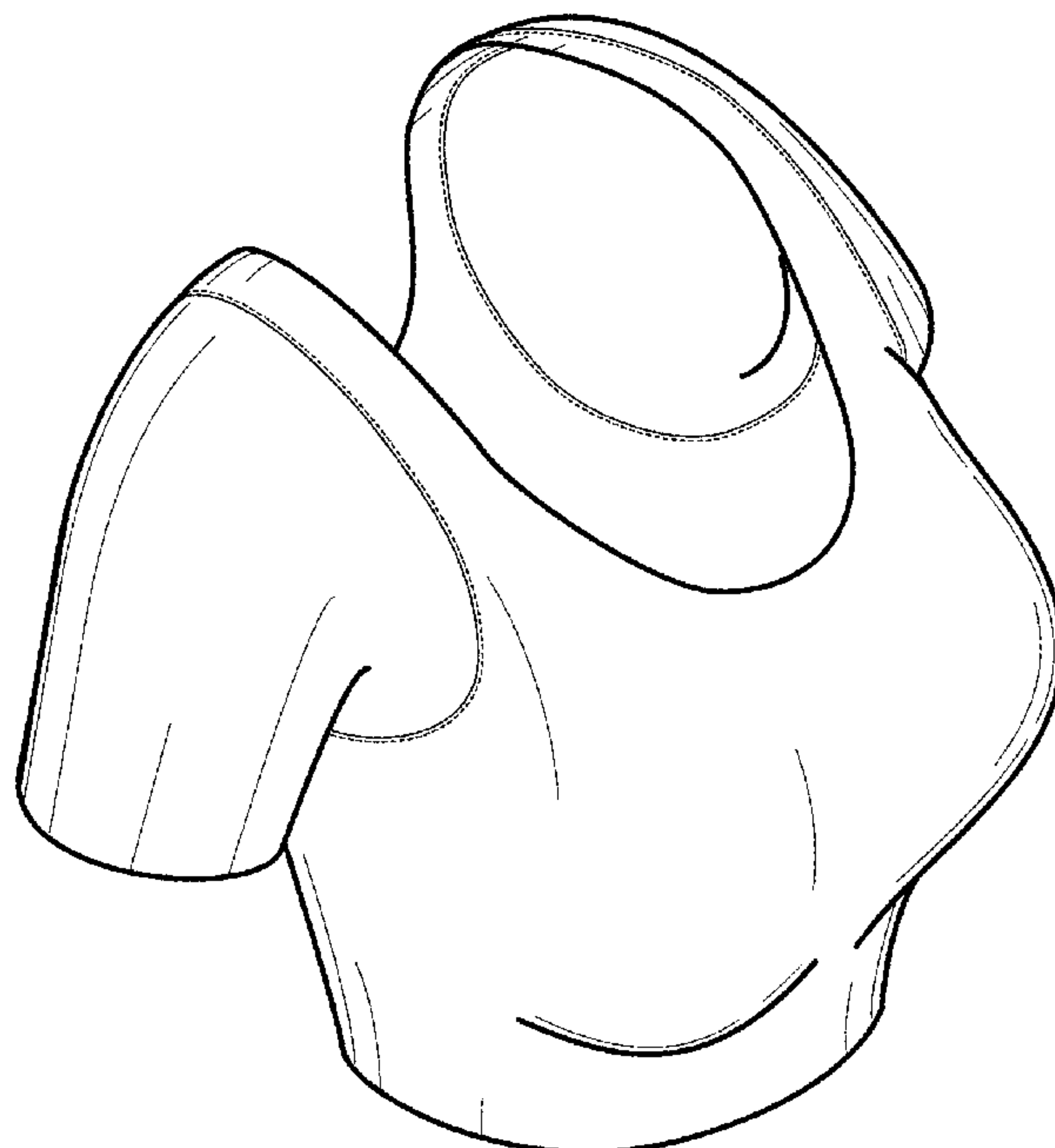
FIG. 5 is a another side view thereof;

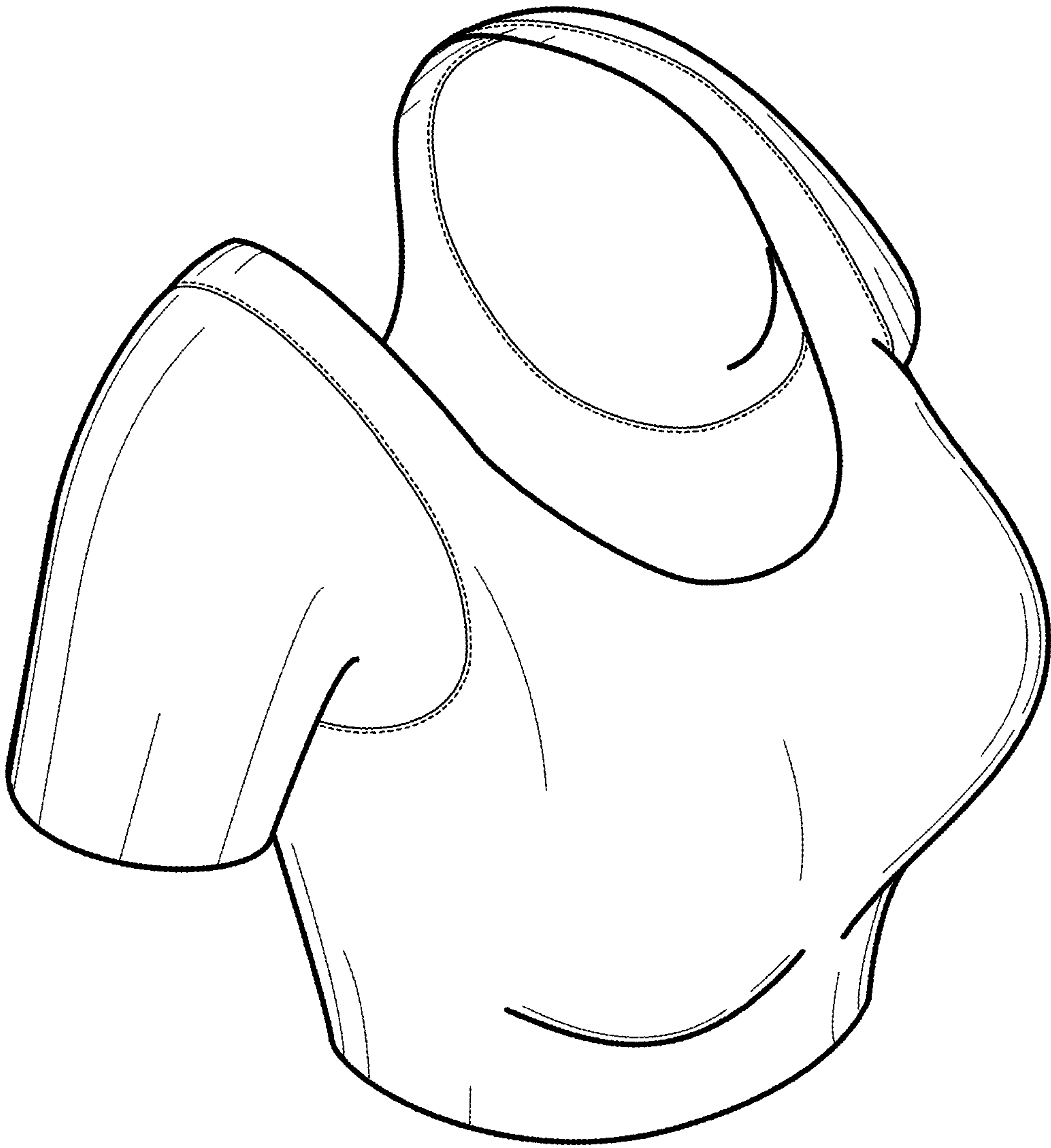

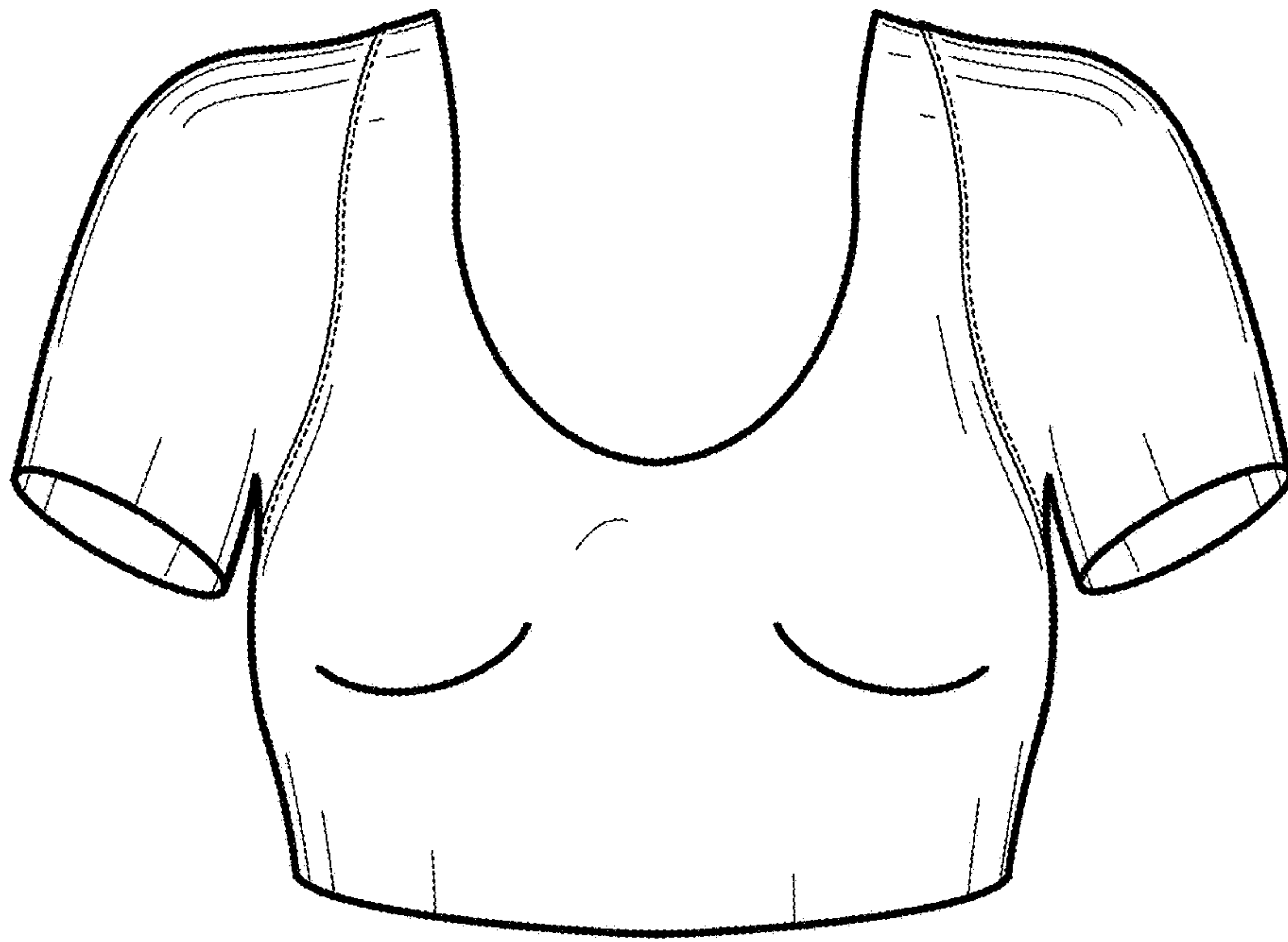

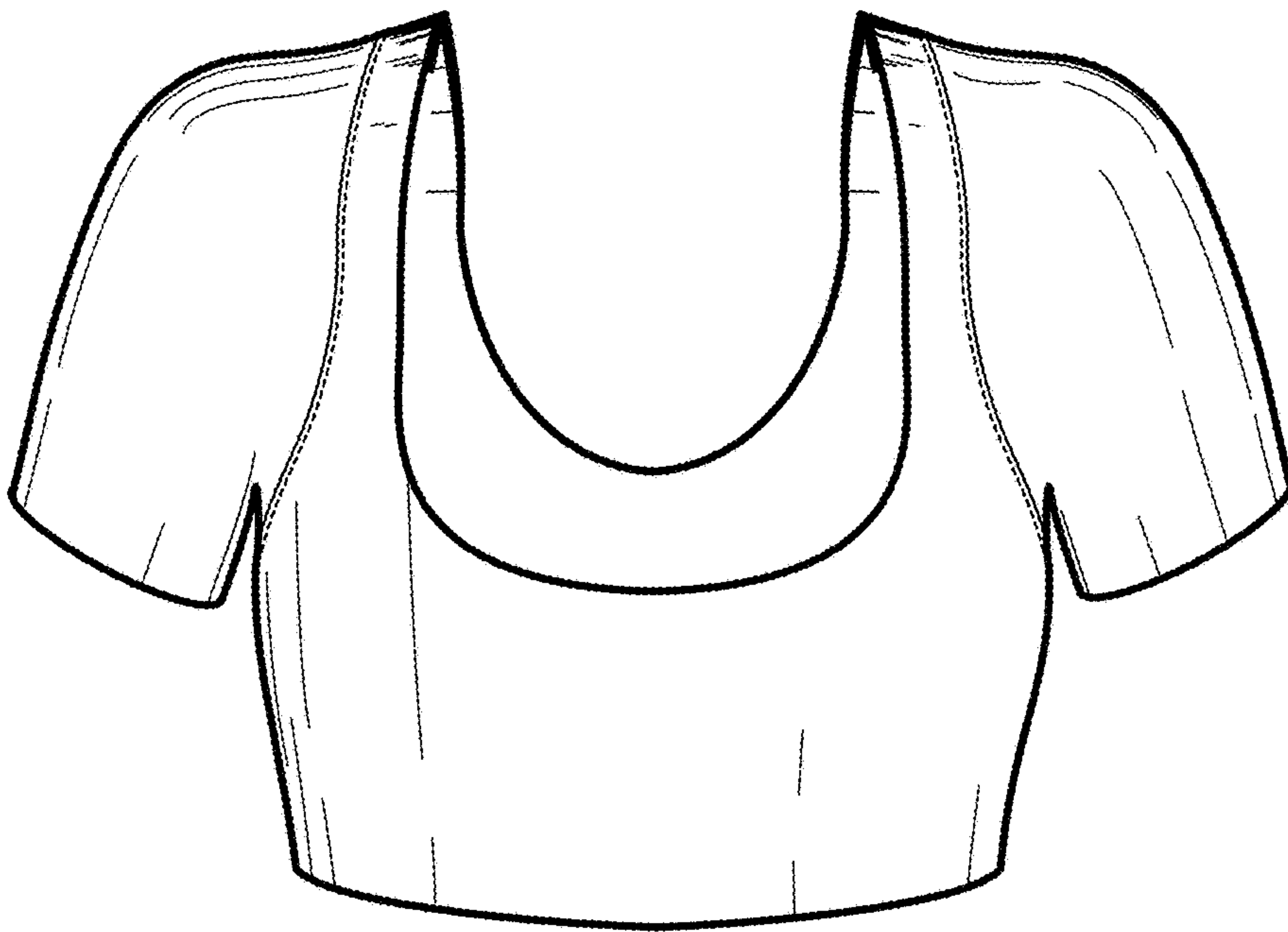

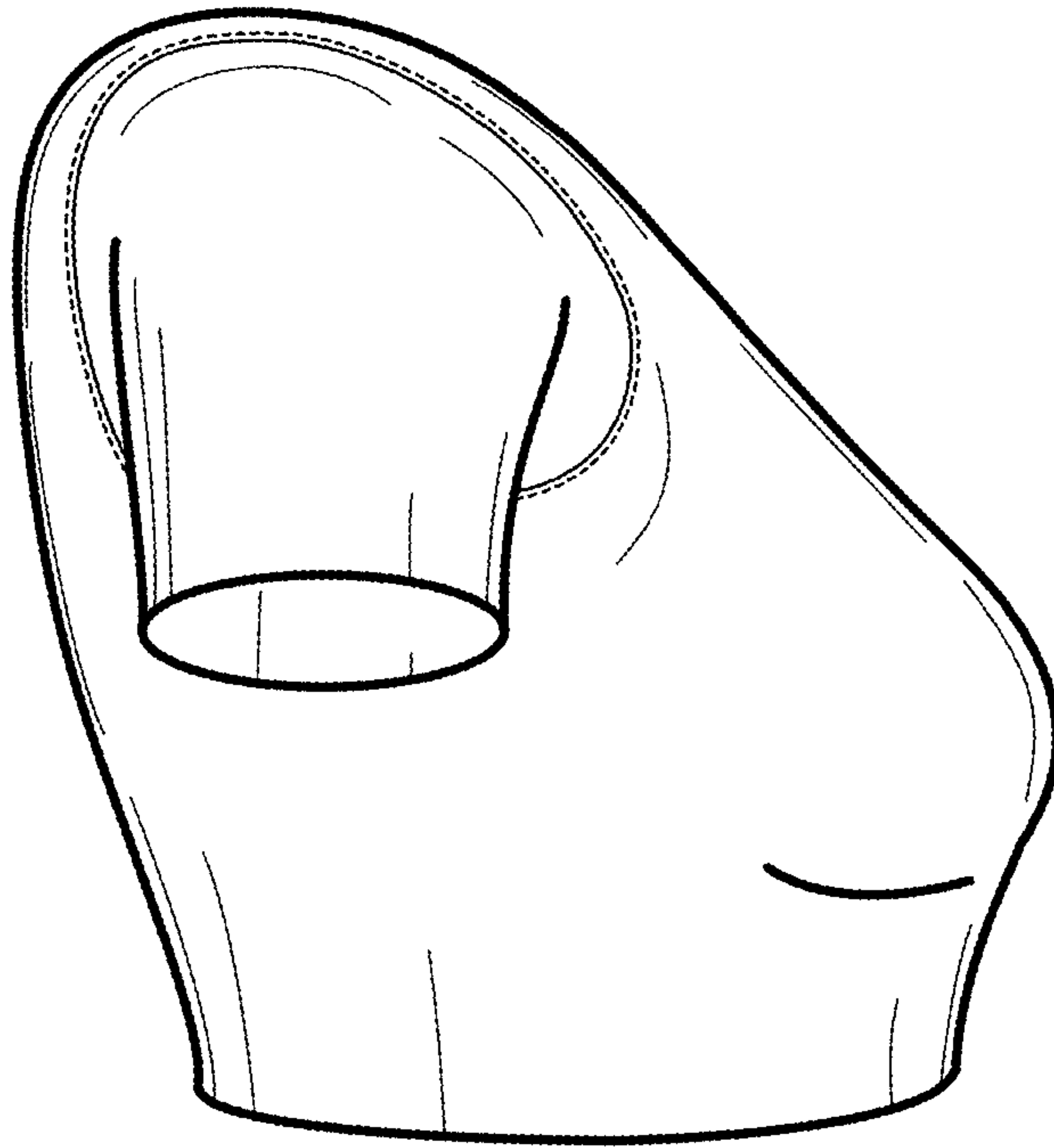

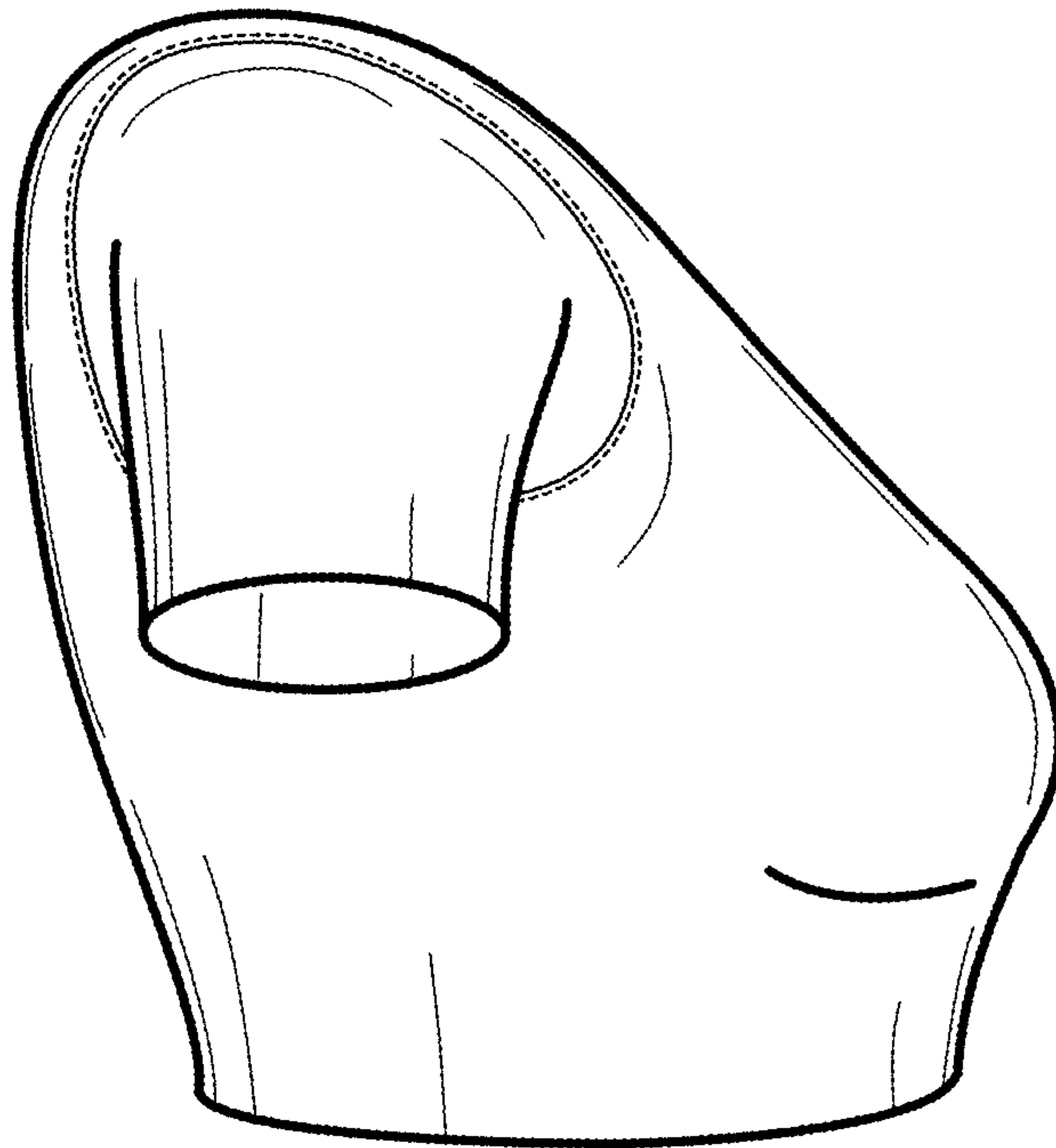

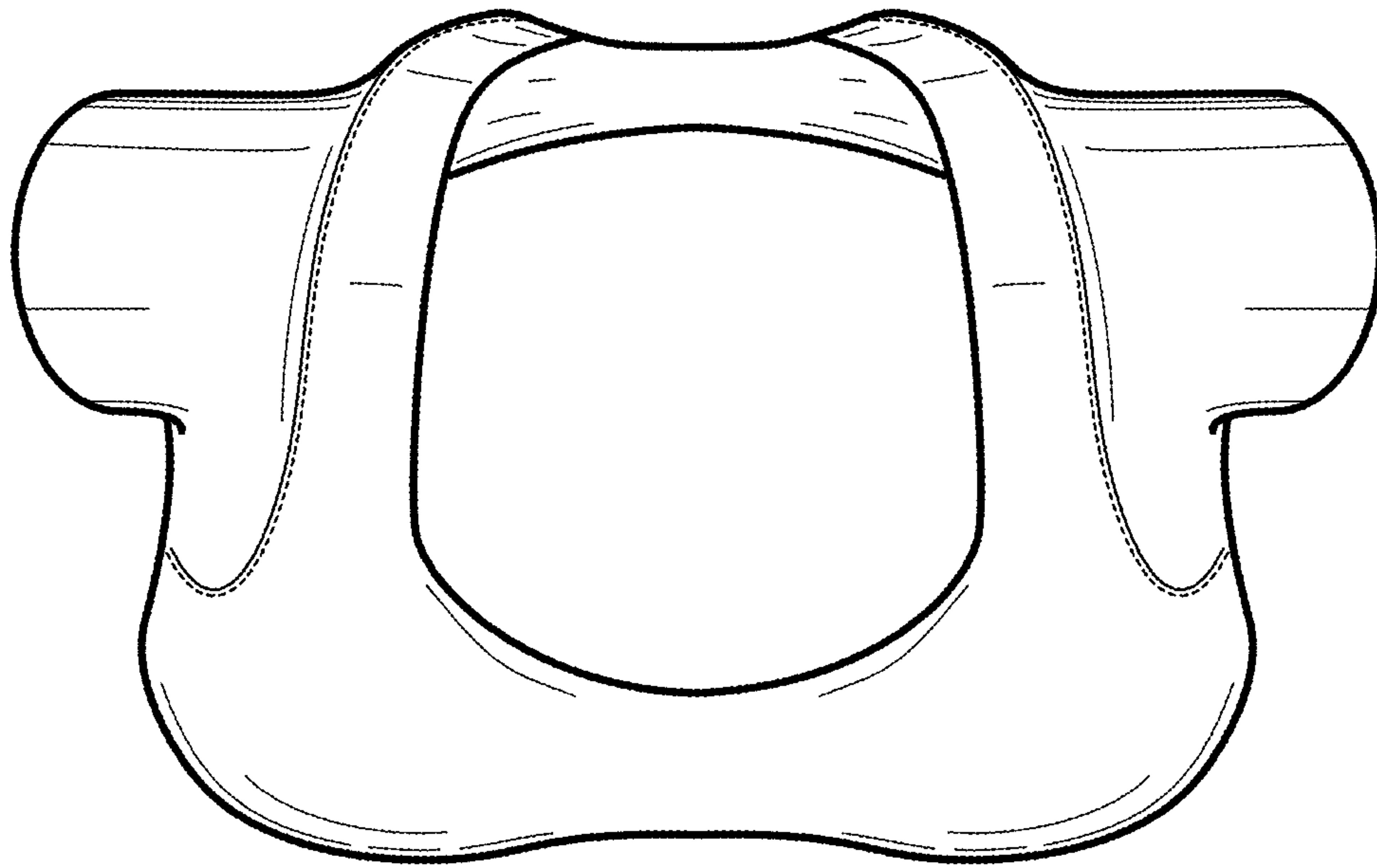

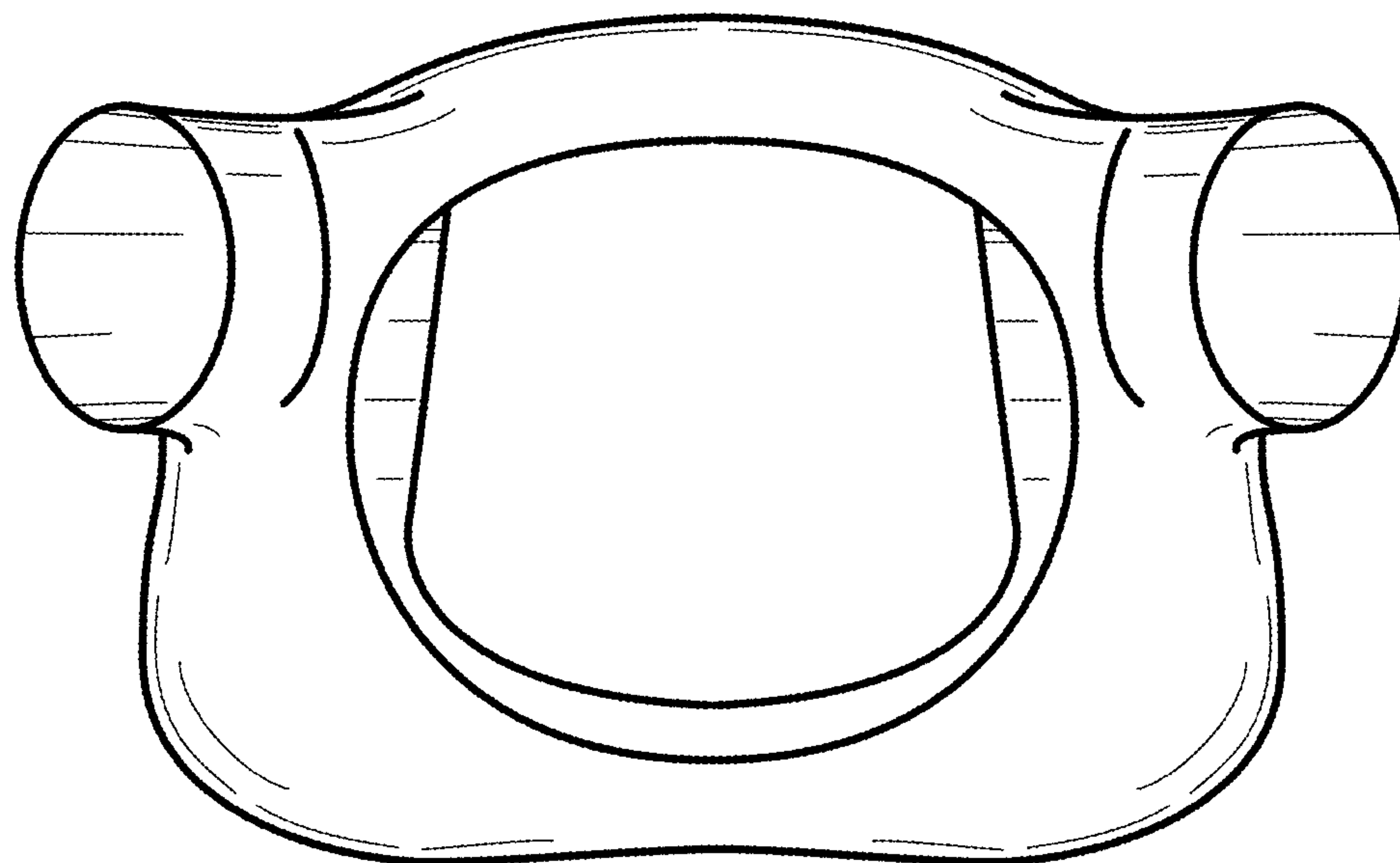
