FIG. 2 is a top, rear and side perspective view of the foot comforter for bed.

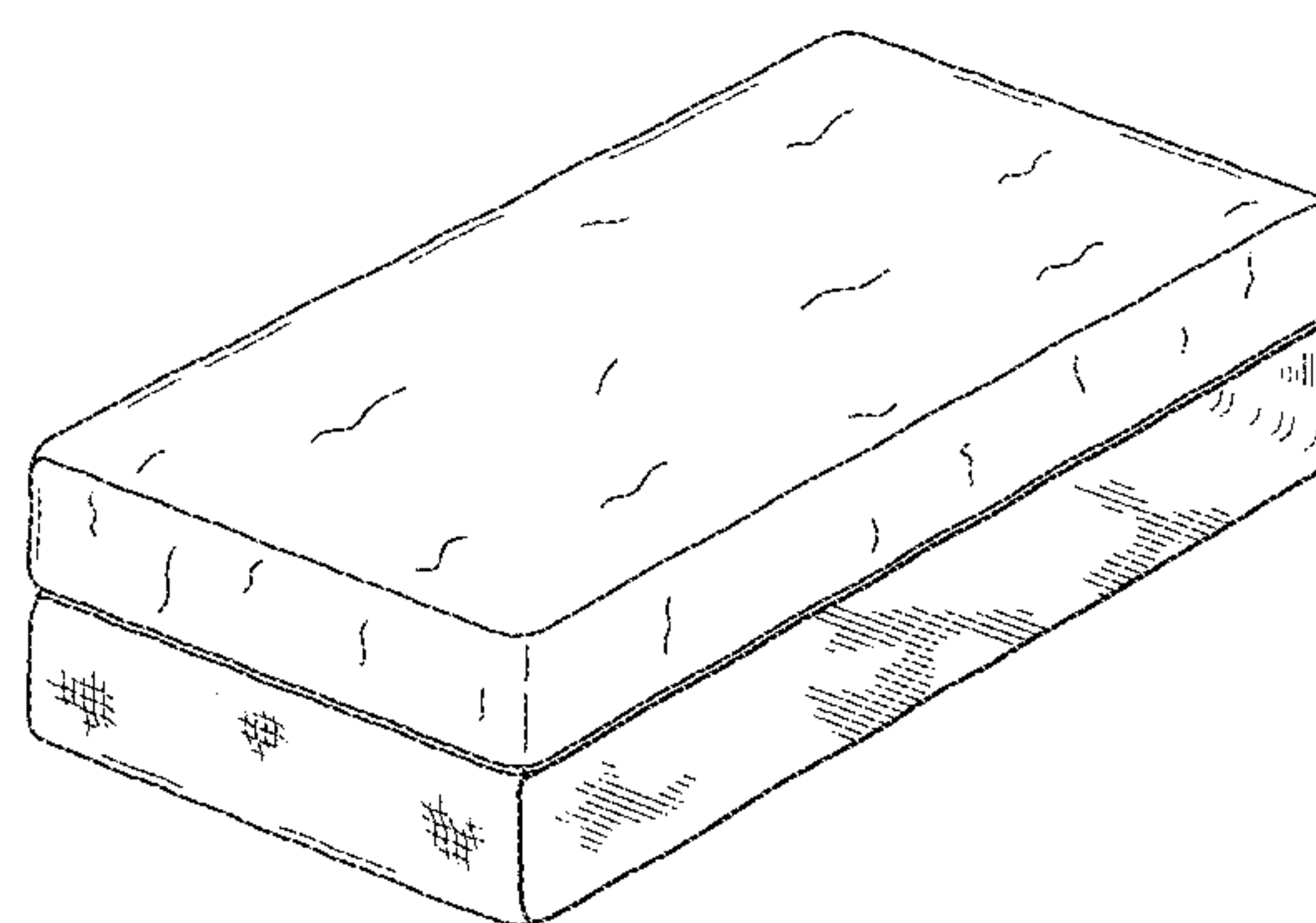
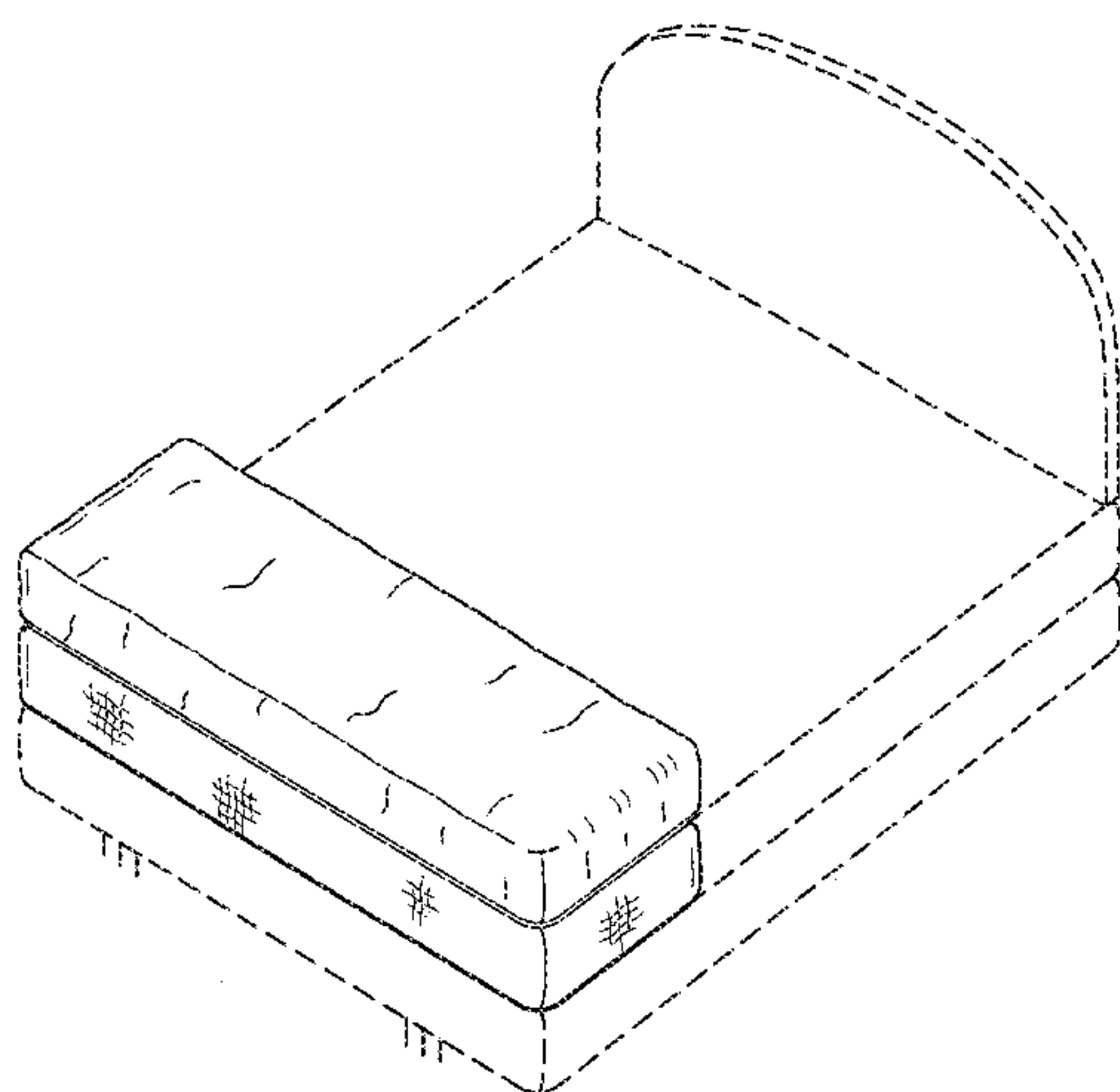
FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof.

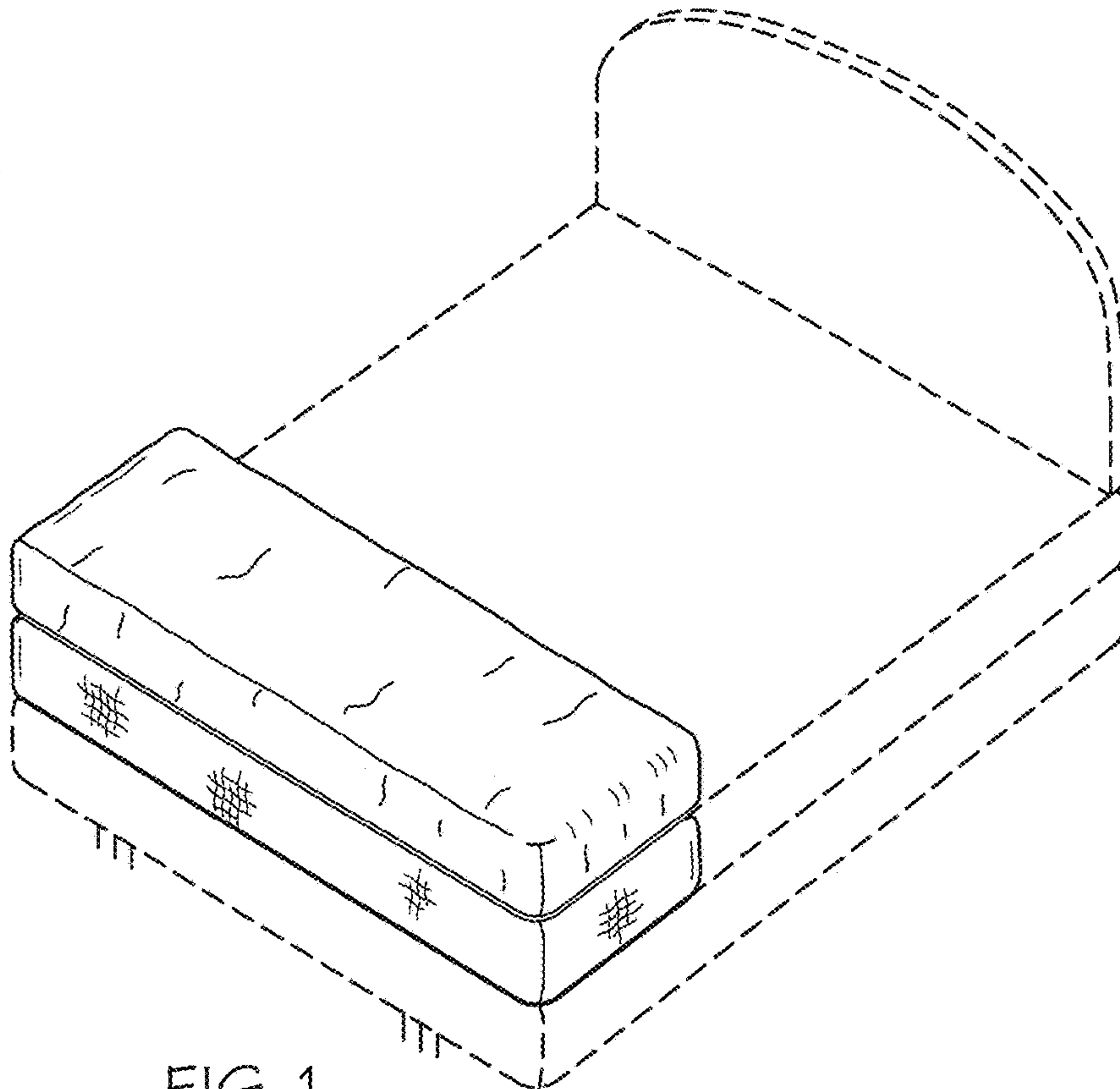

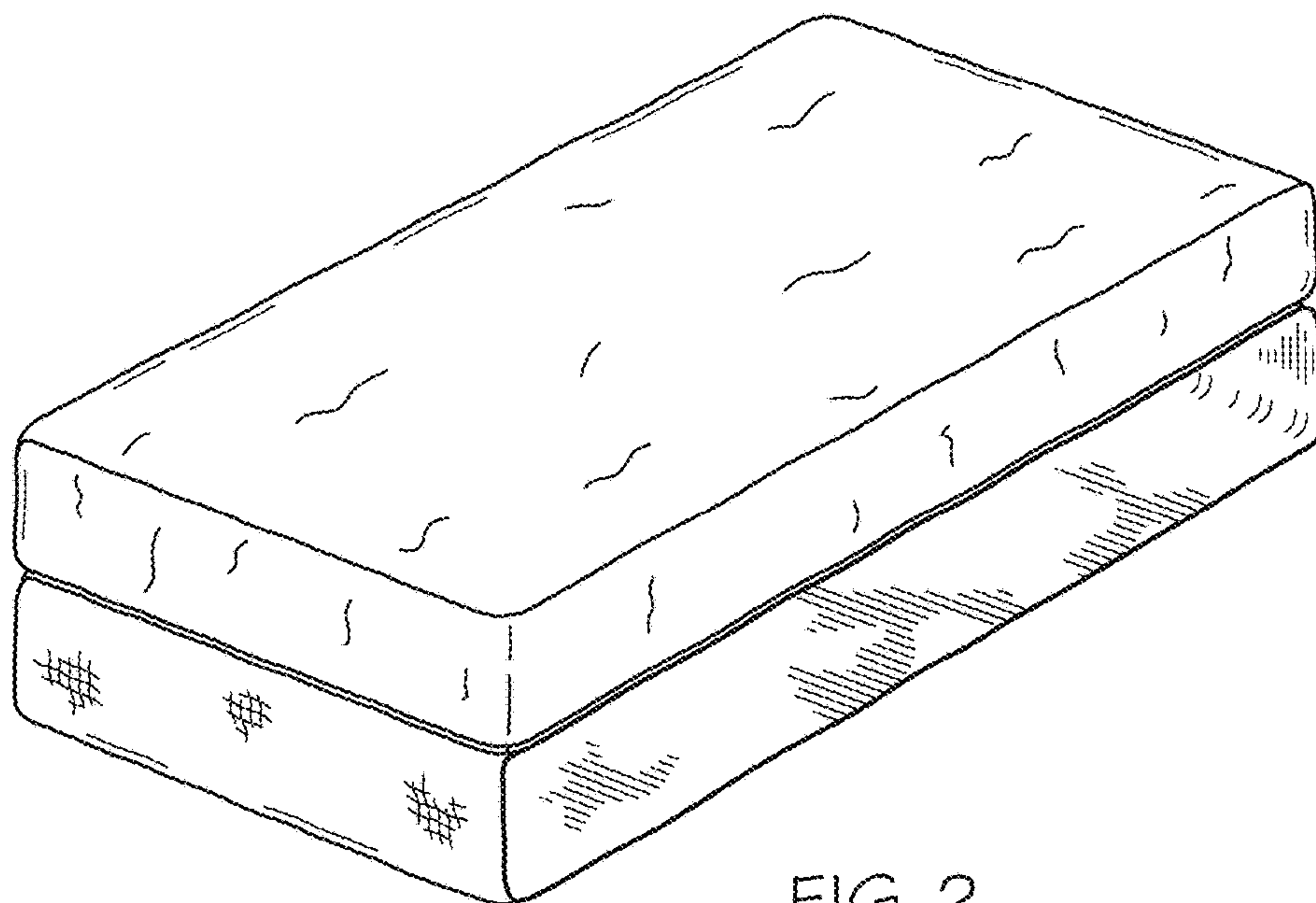

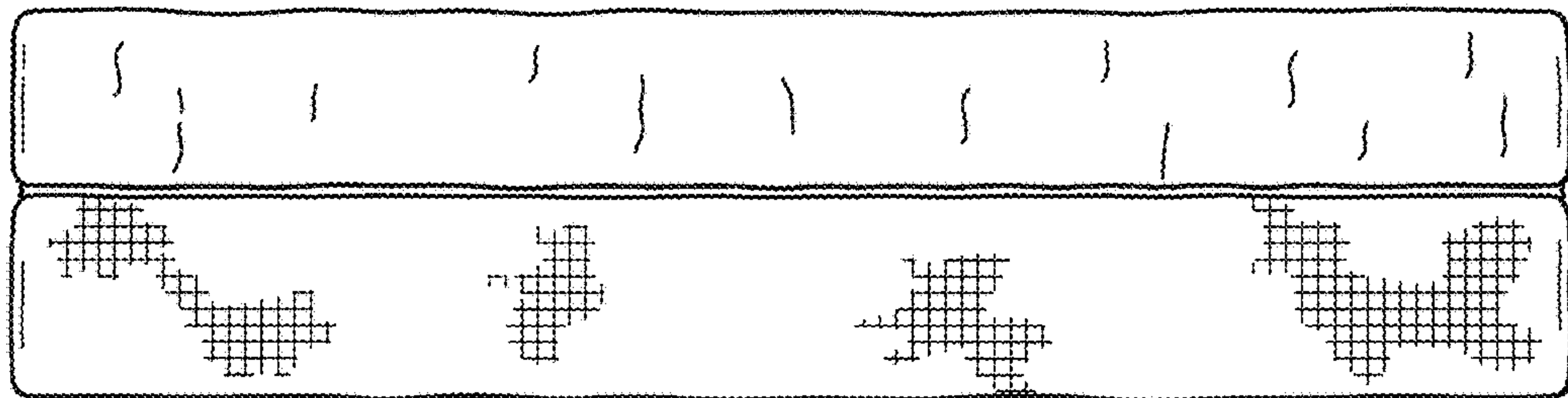

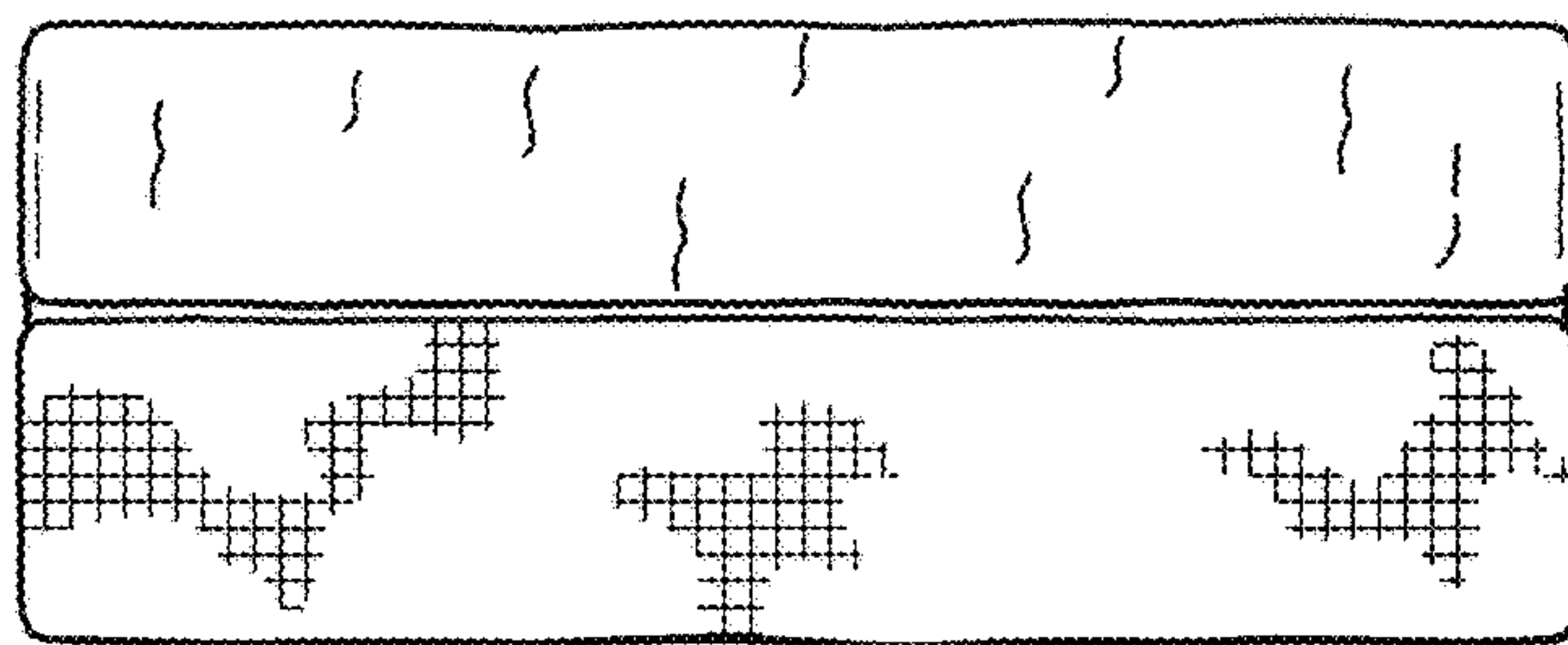

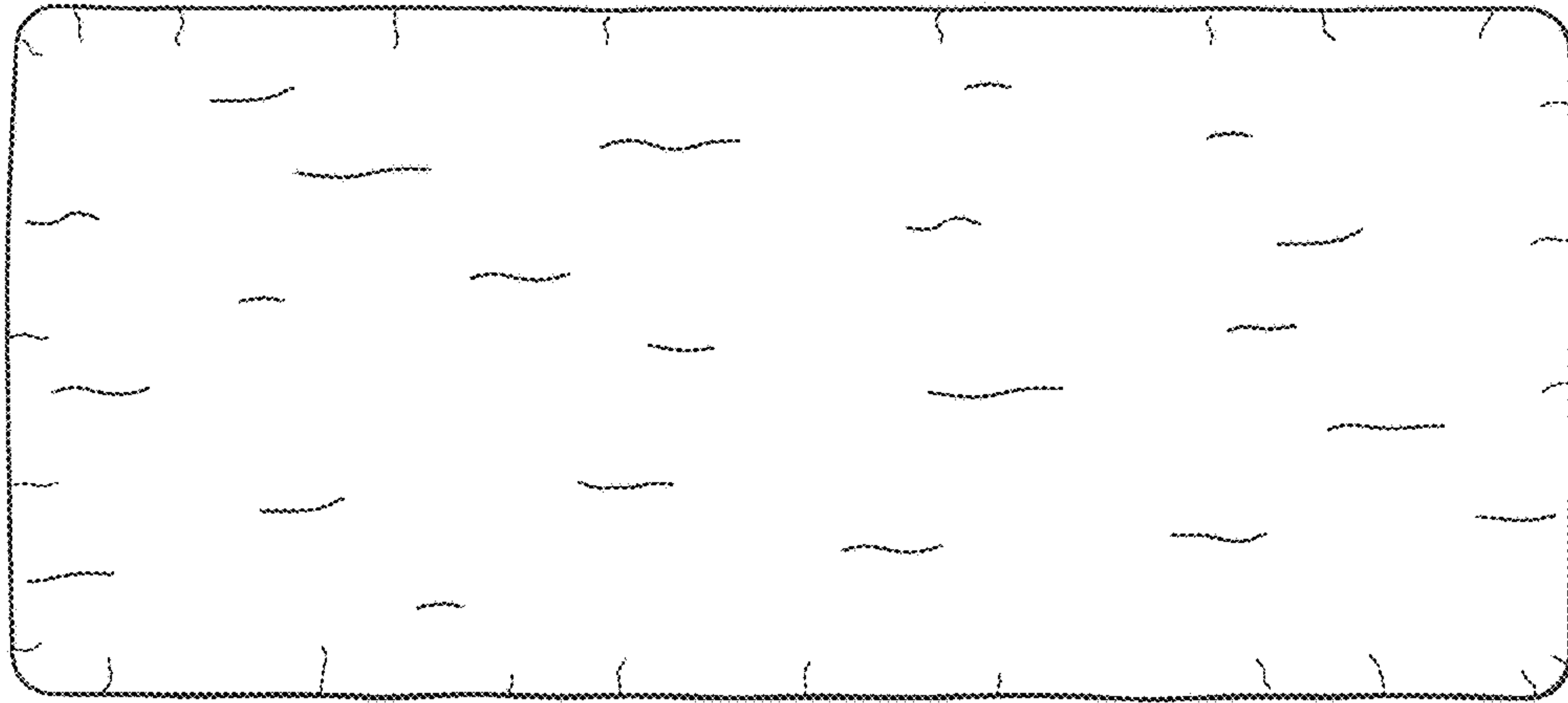

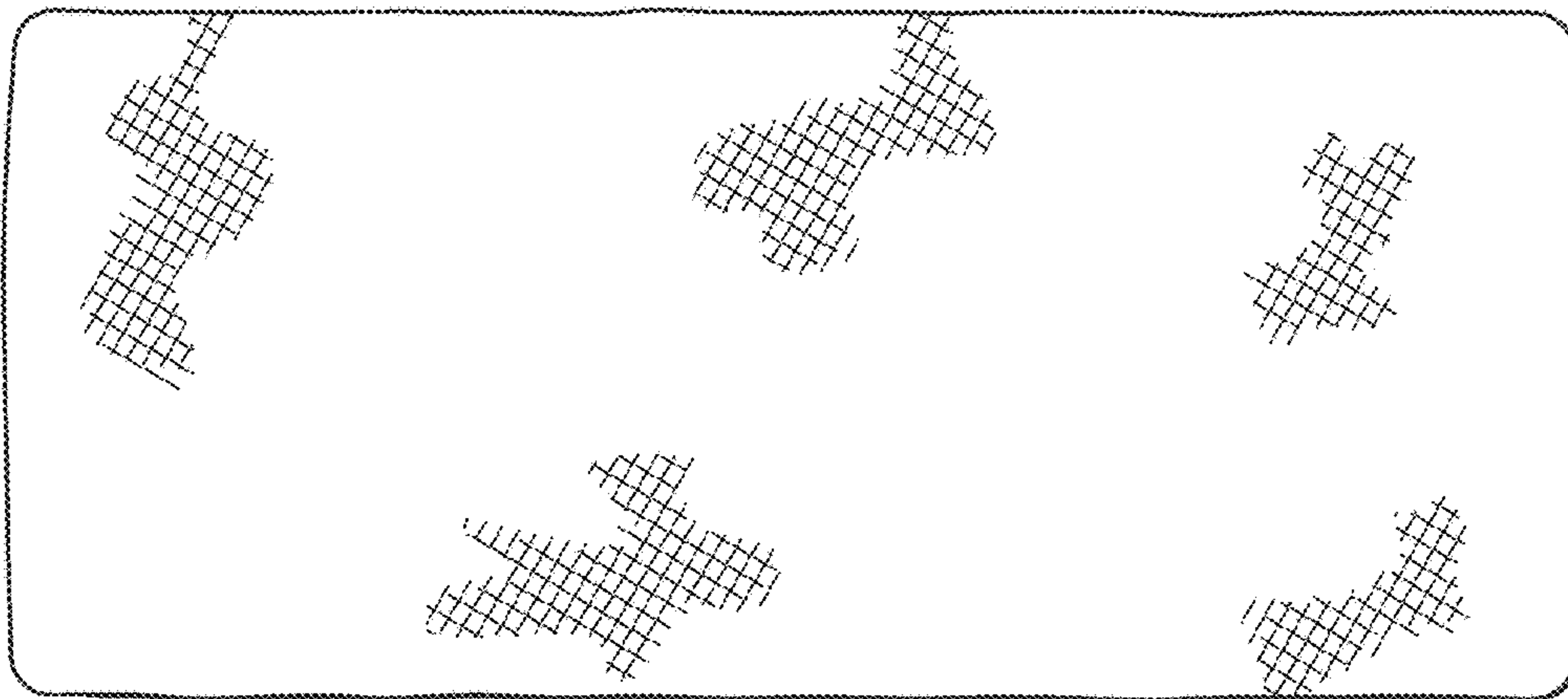
