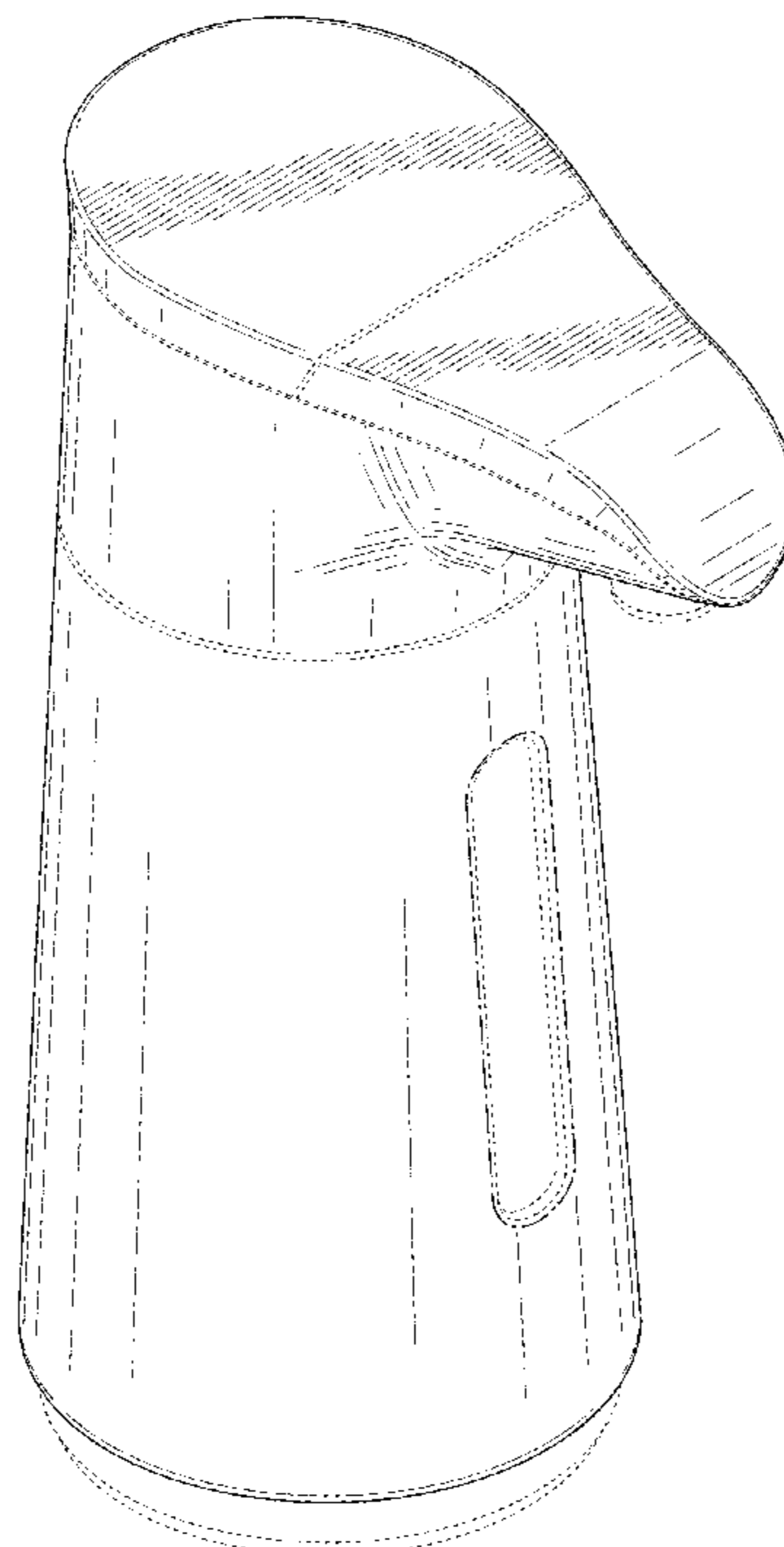
The ornamental design for a dispenser, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of an embodiment of the claimed design;
FIG. 2 is a front view of the embodiment of FIG. 1;

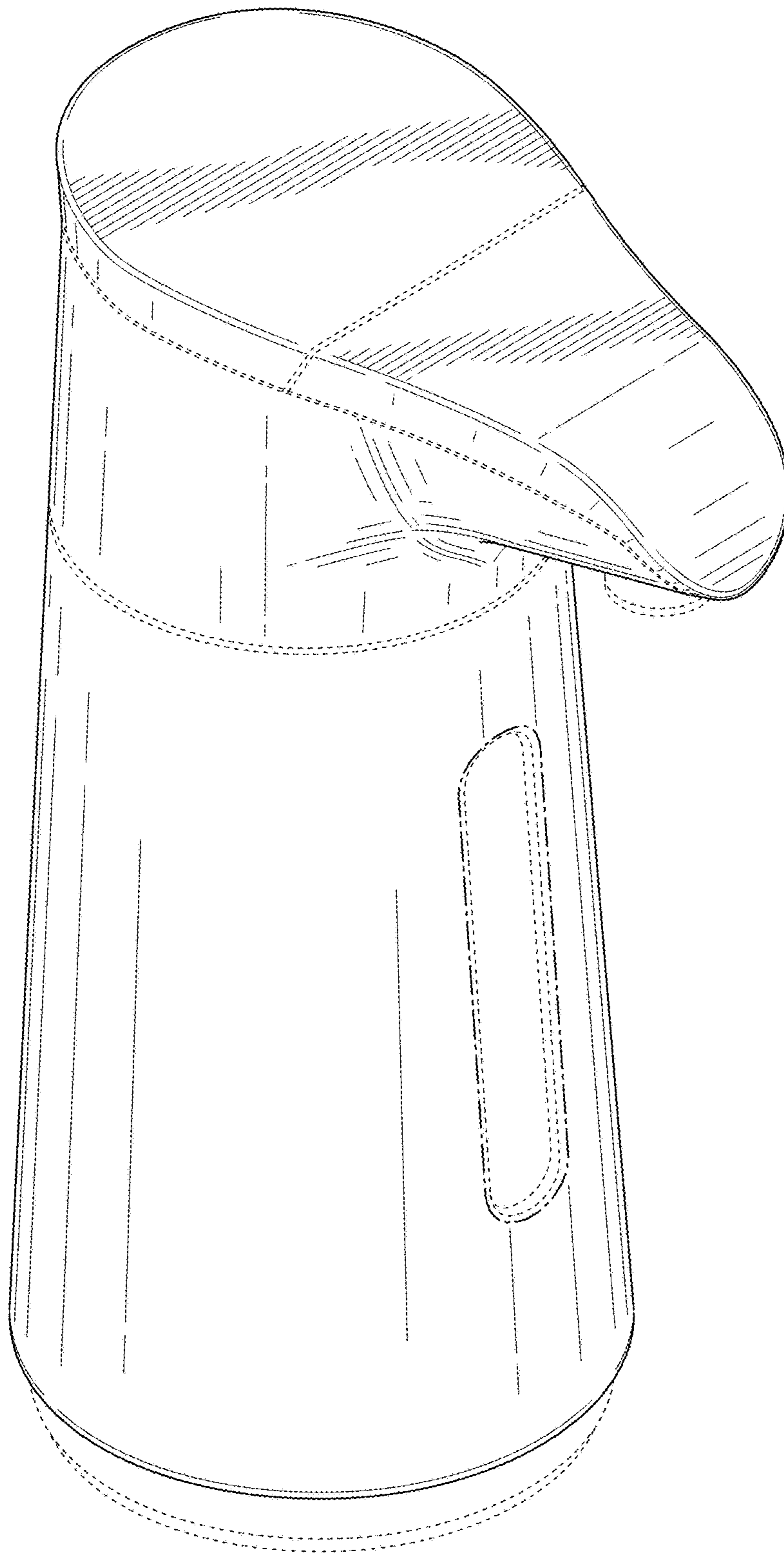

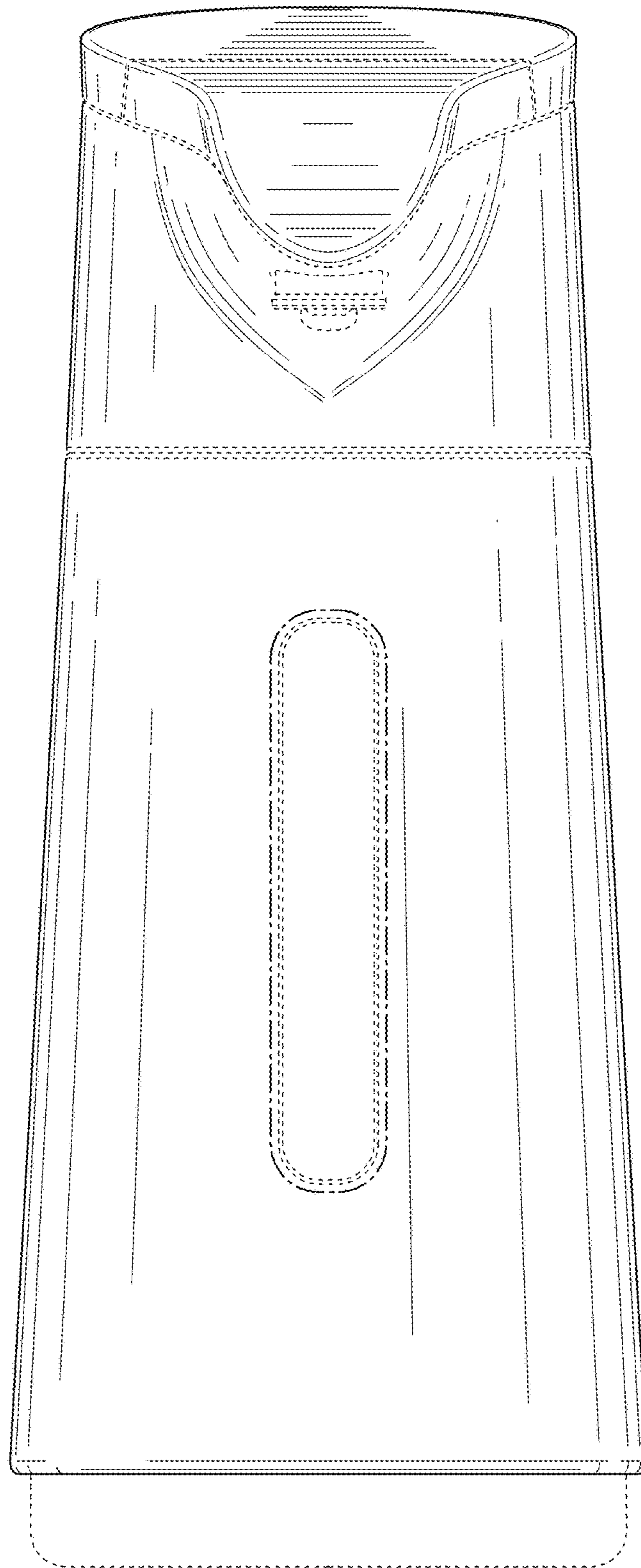

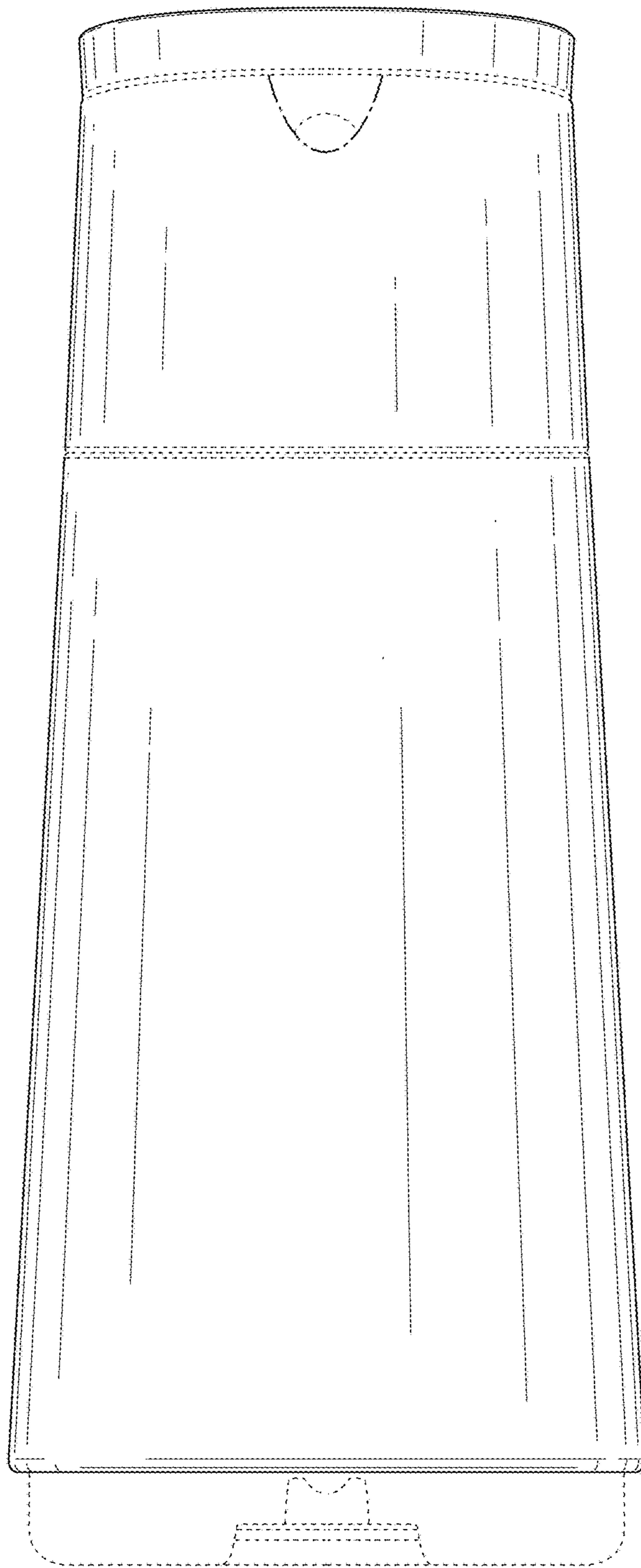

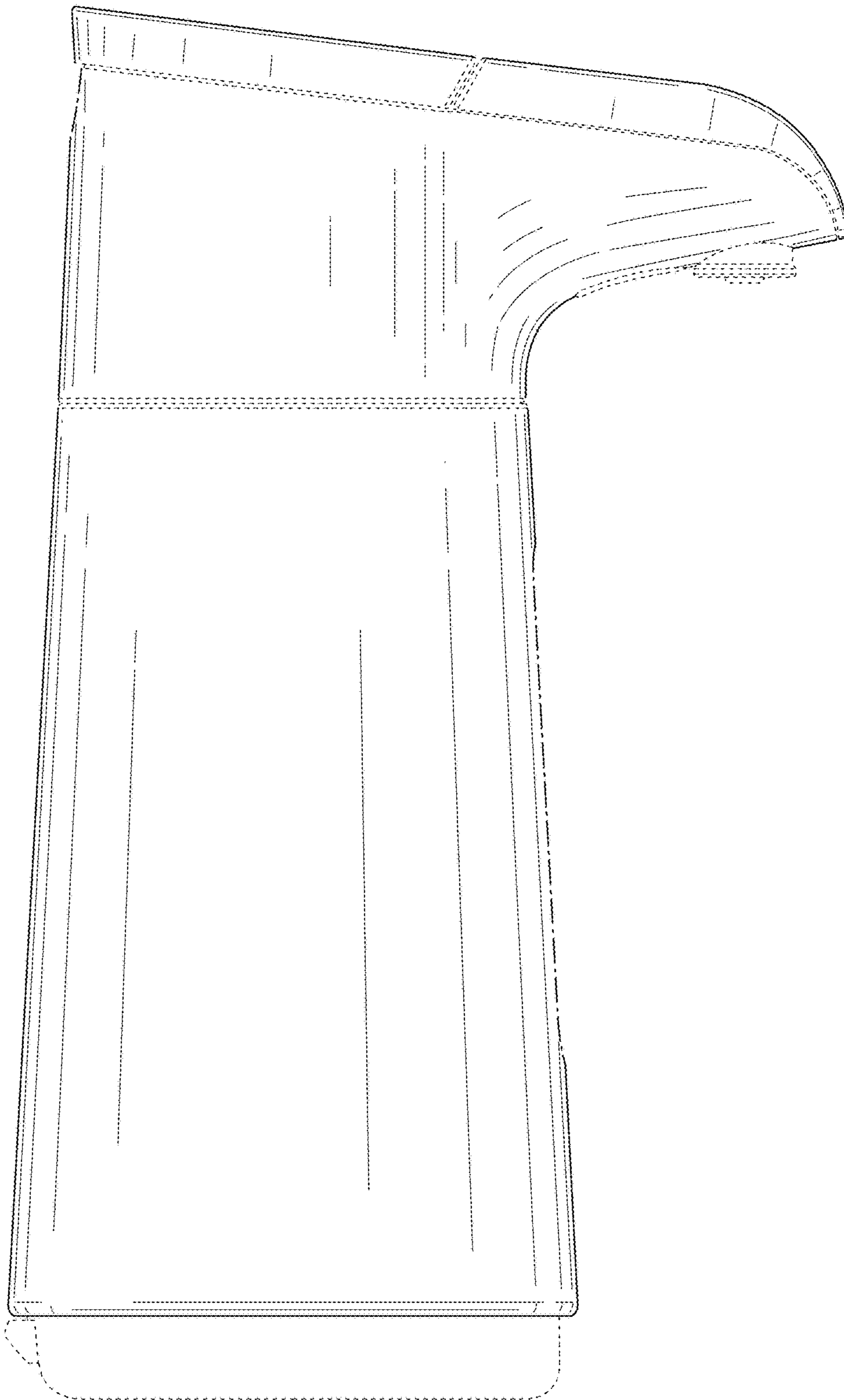

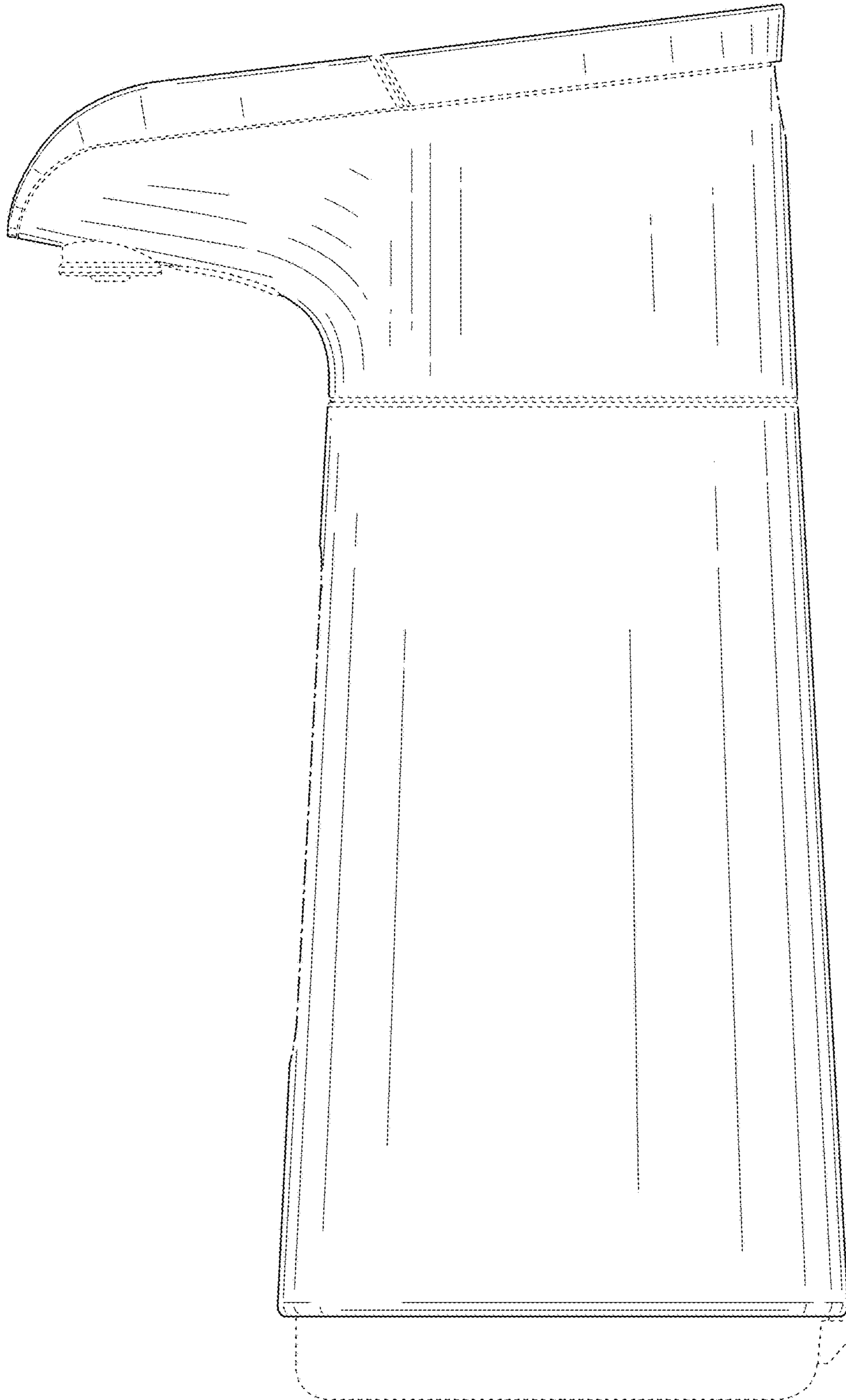

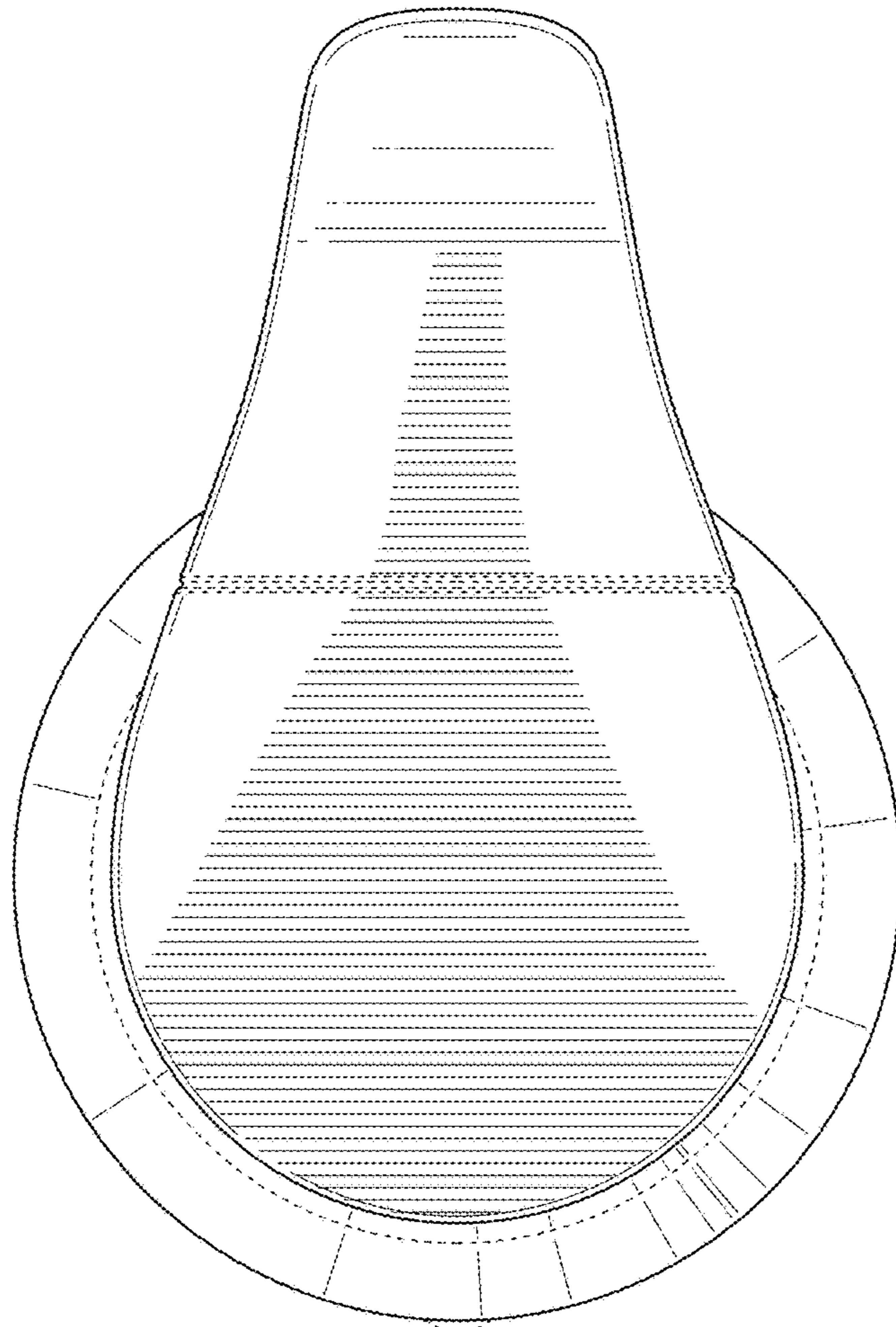

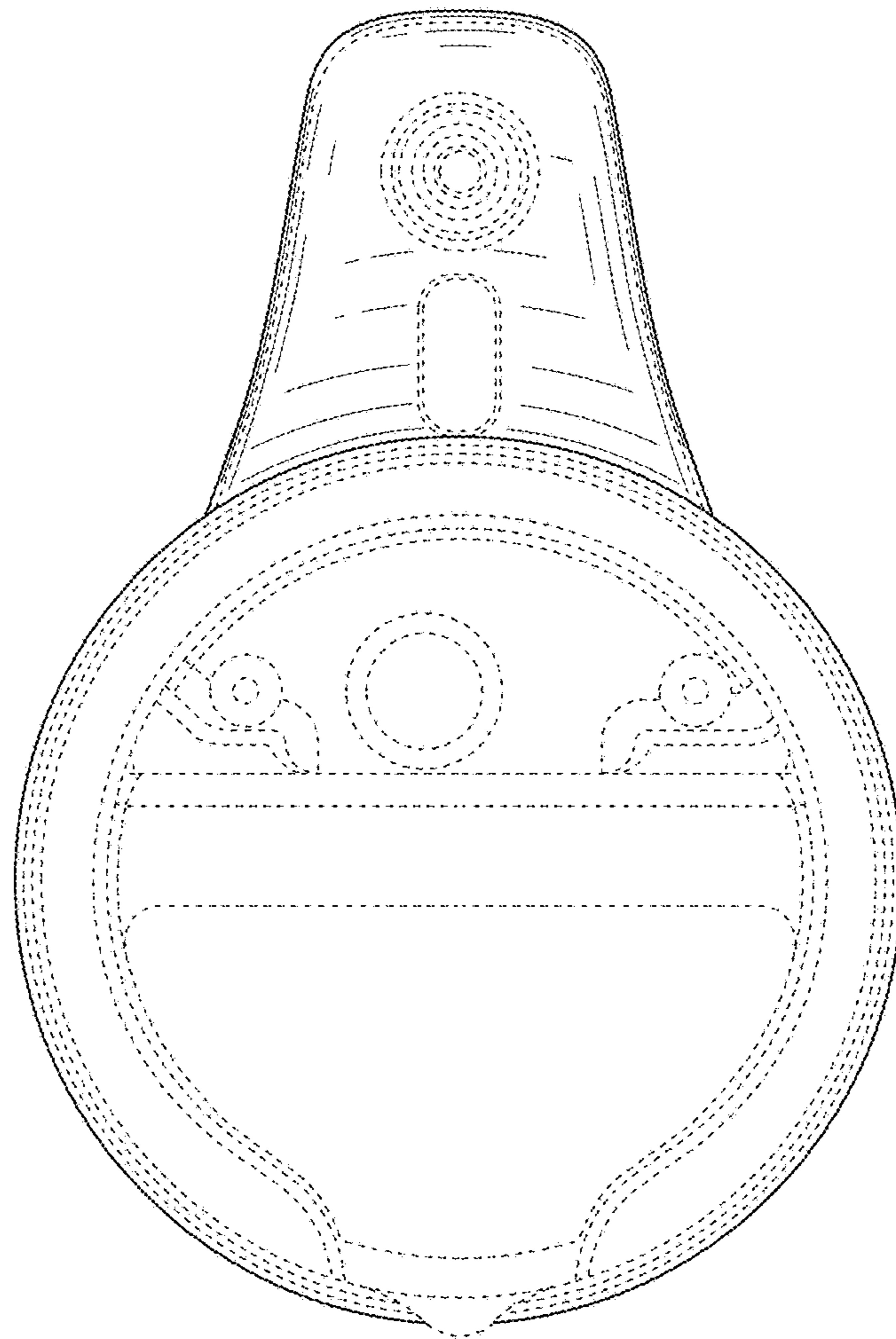
