DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a beverage can showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a front elevation thereof;

FIG. 3 is a rear elevation thereof;

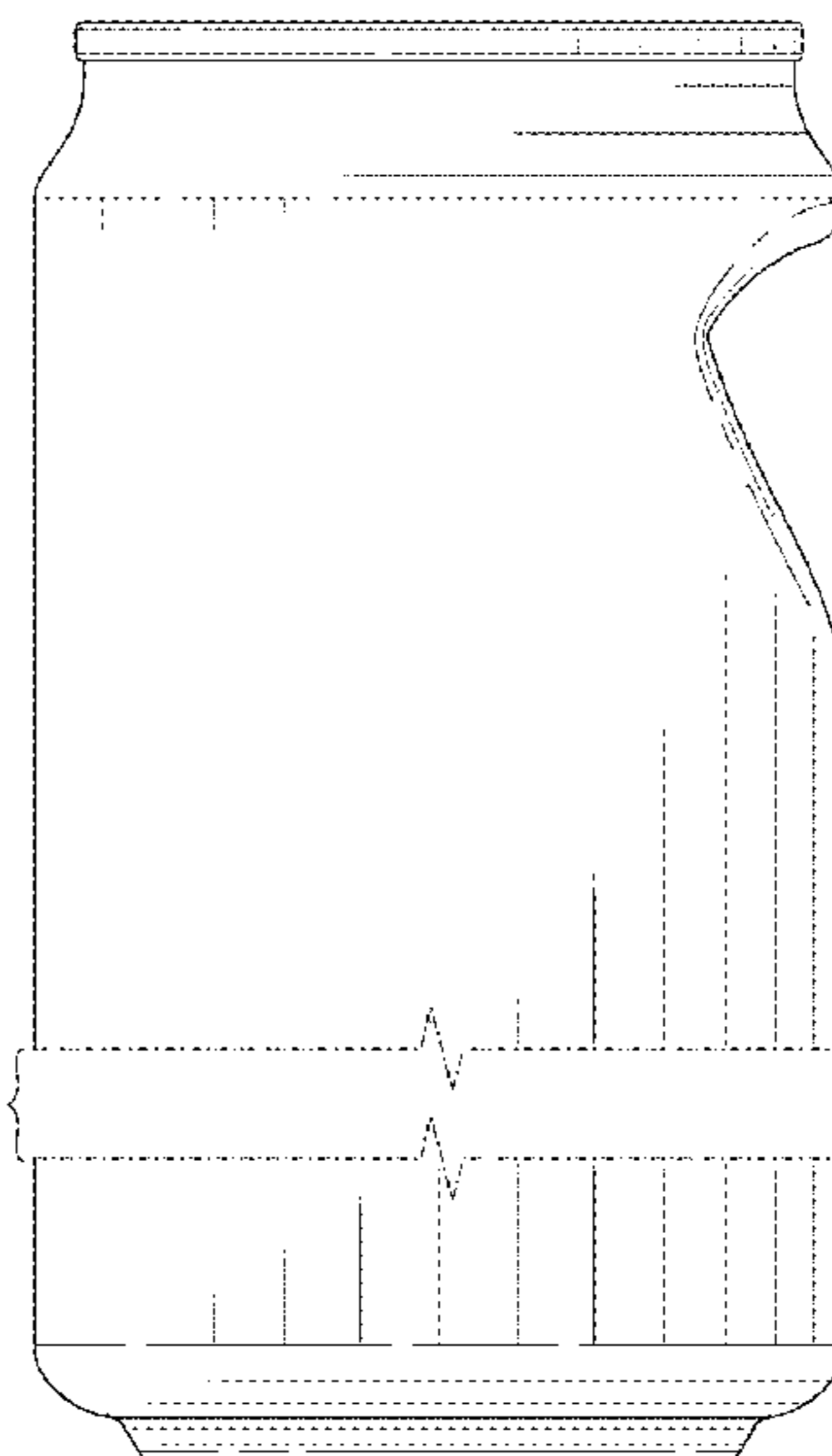
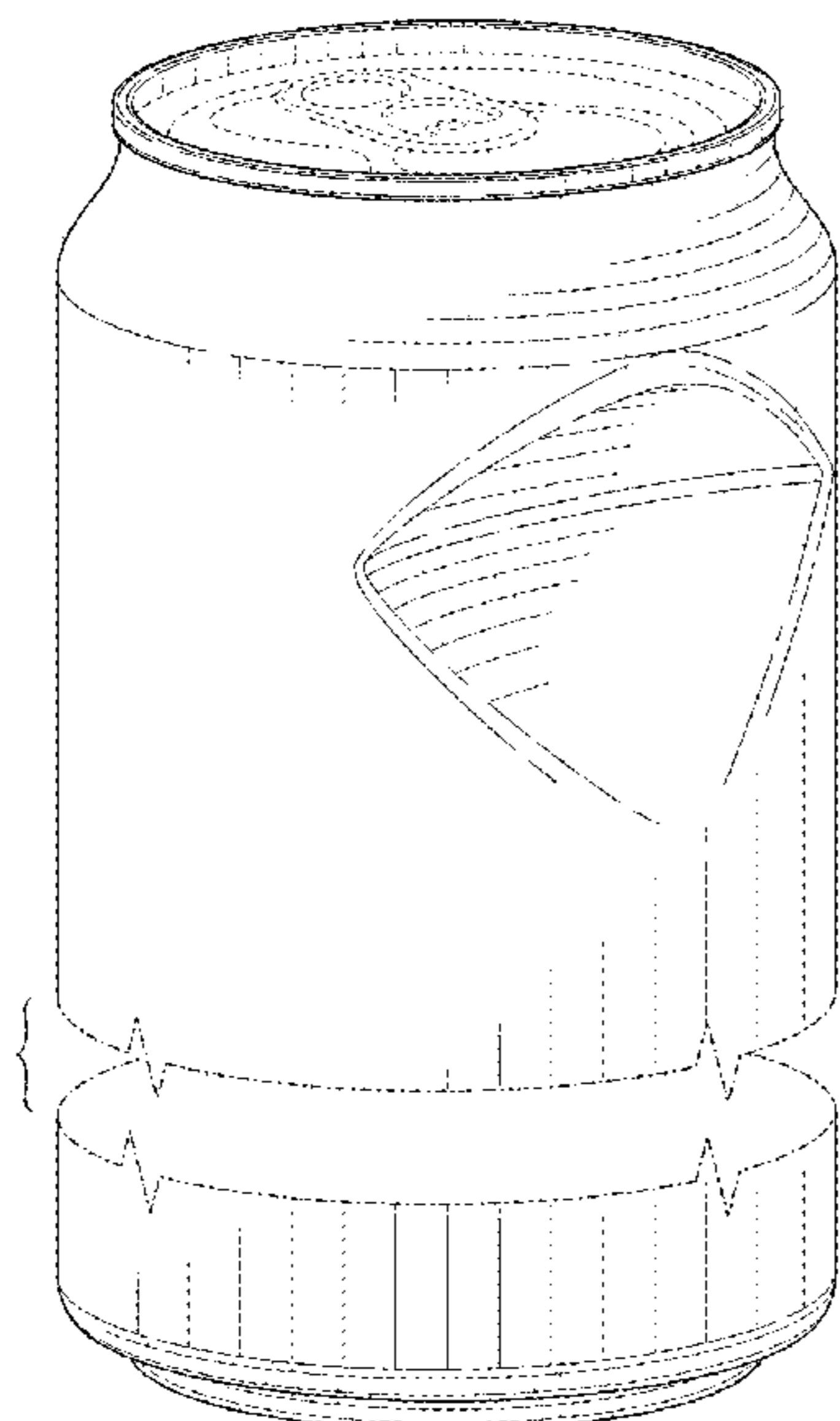
FIG. 4 is a left side elevation thereof;

The break lines and any portion of the article between the break lines forms no part of the claimed design.

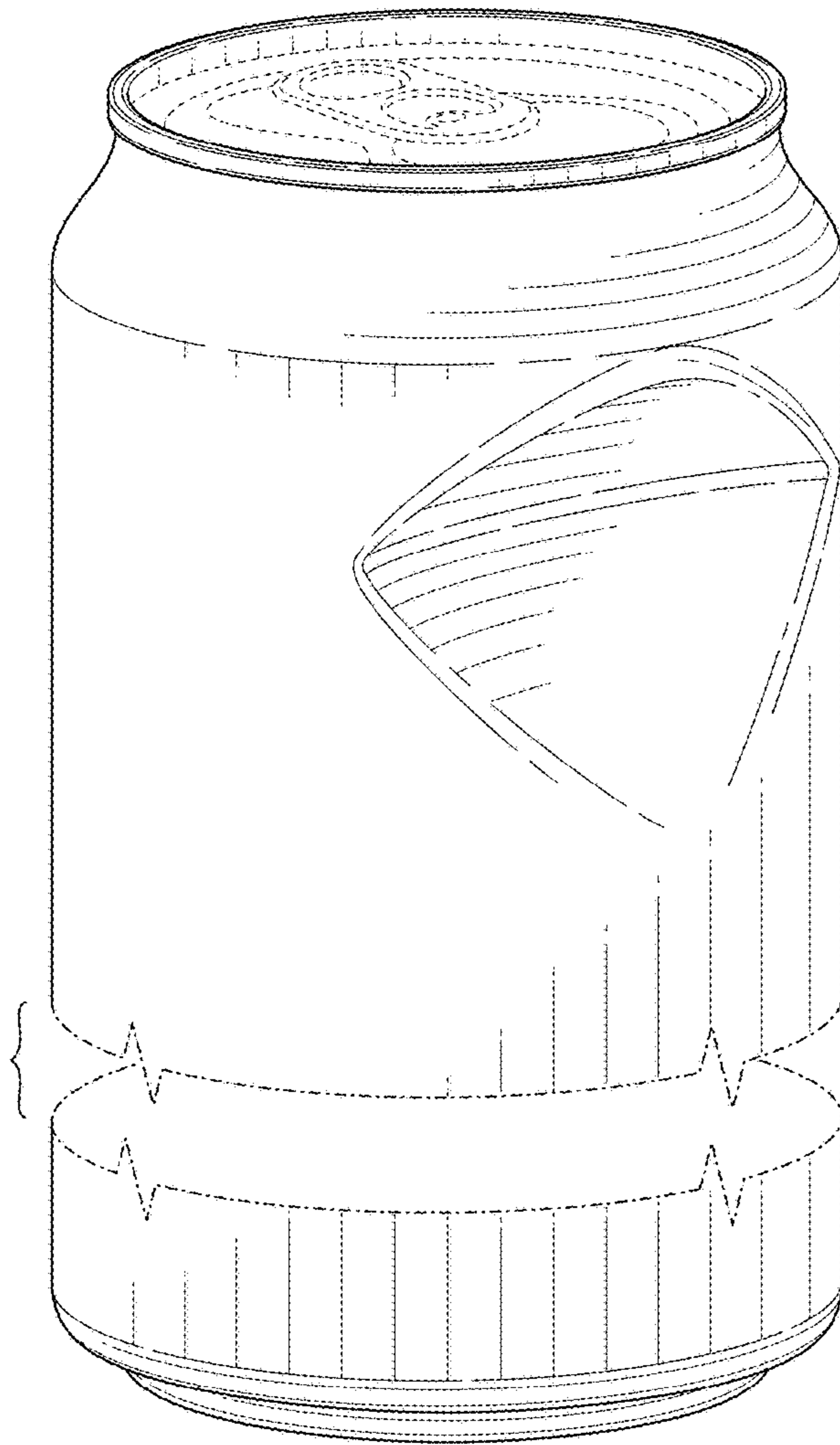

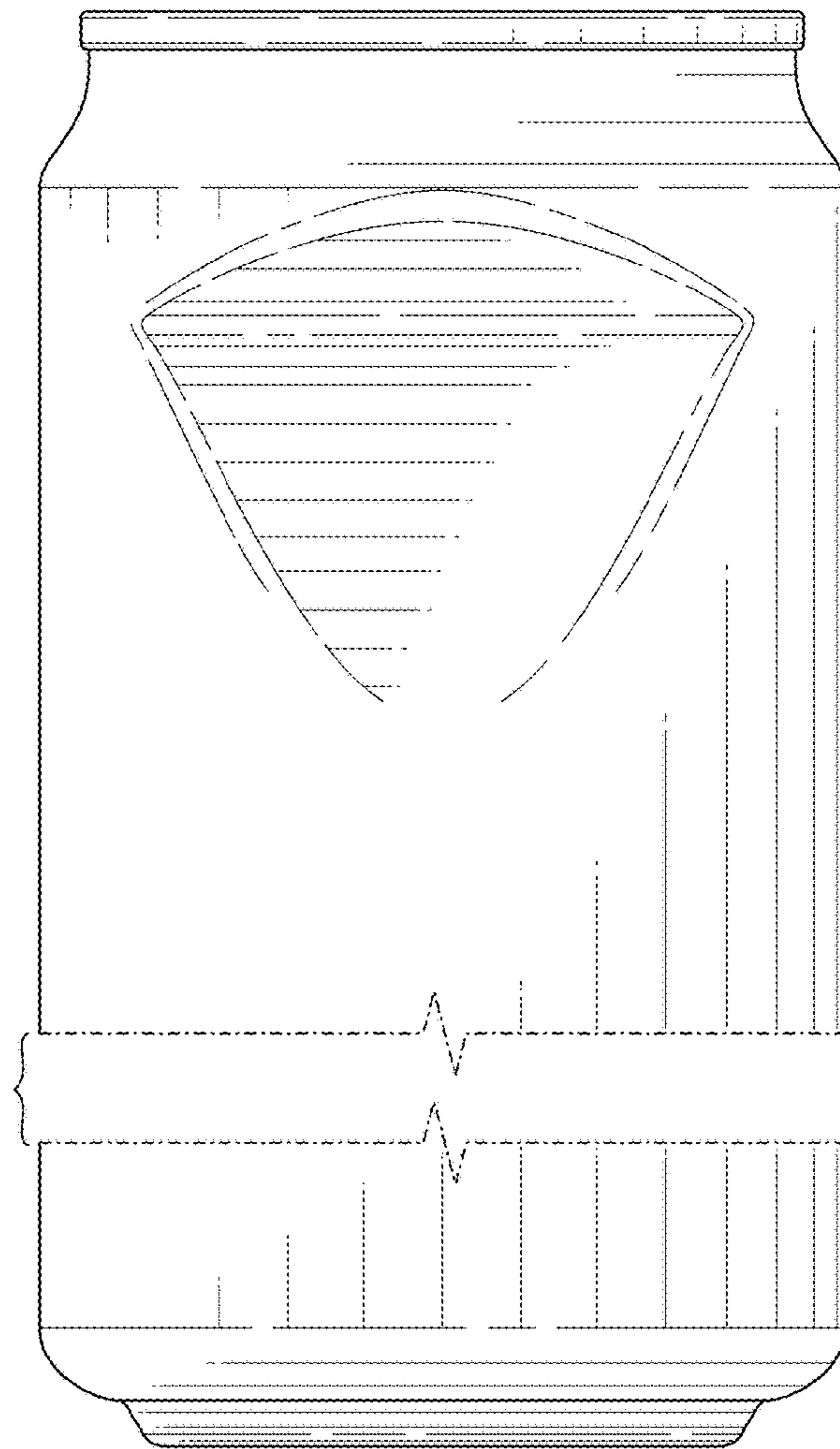

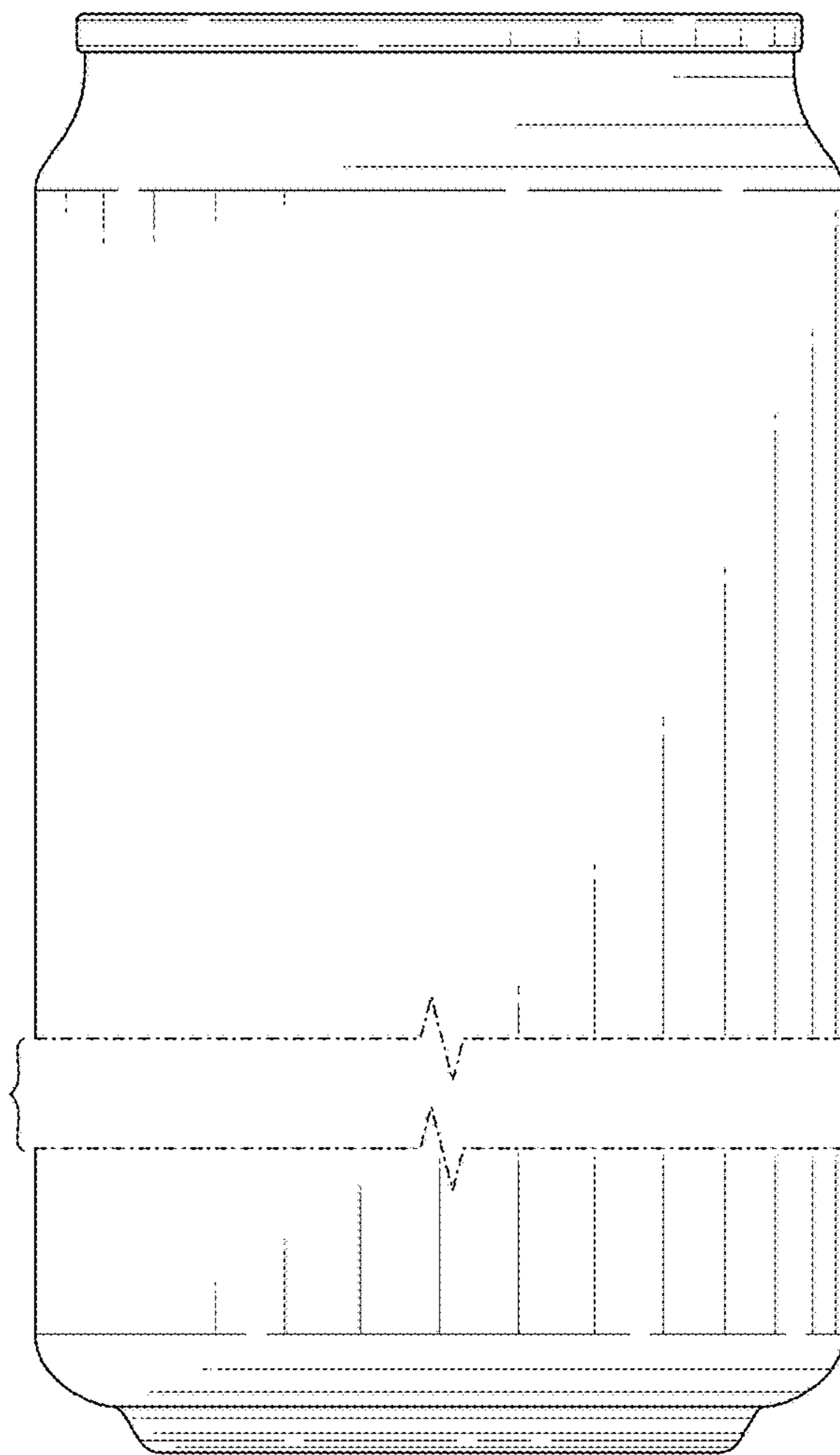

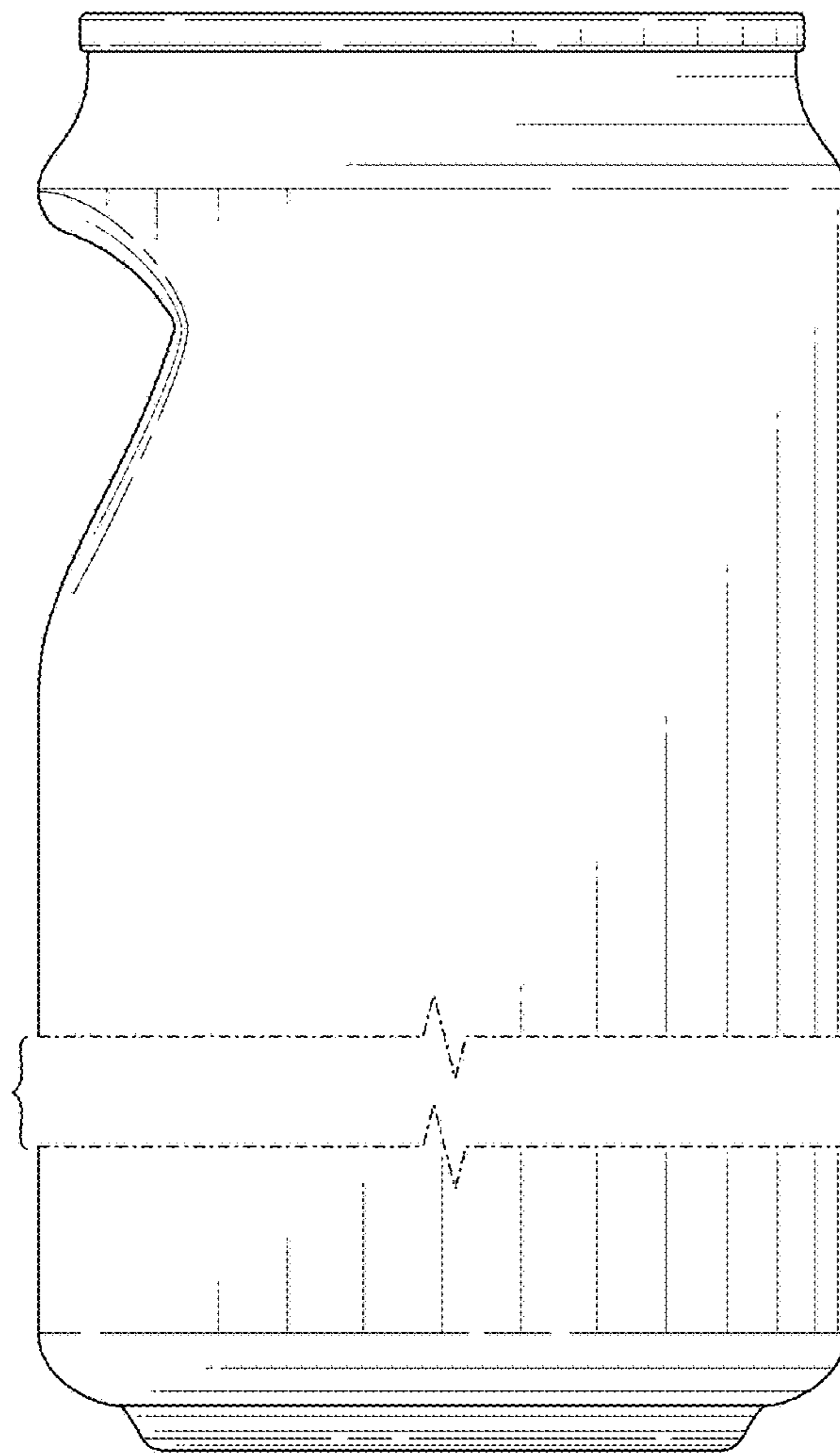

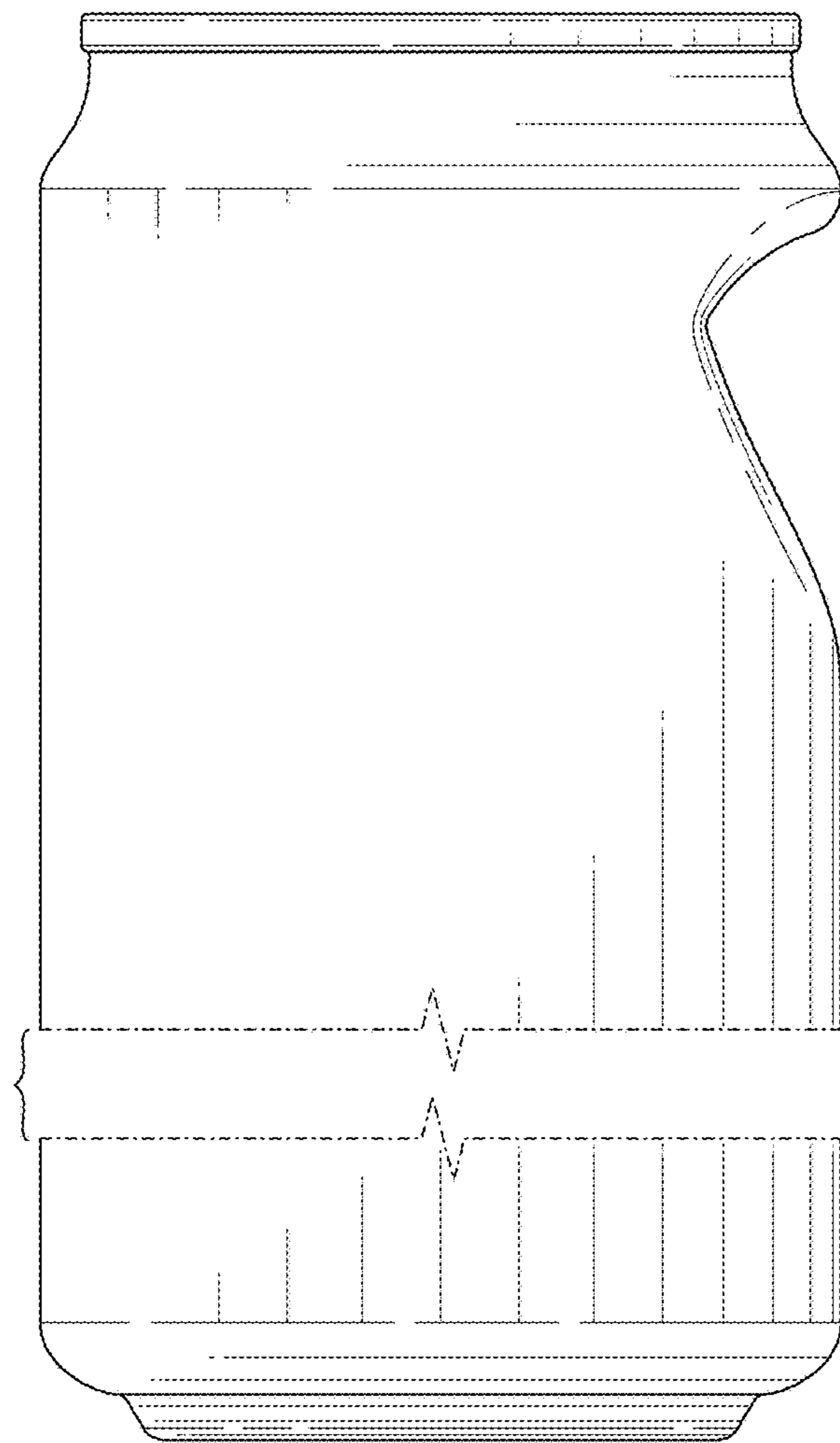

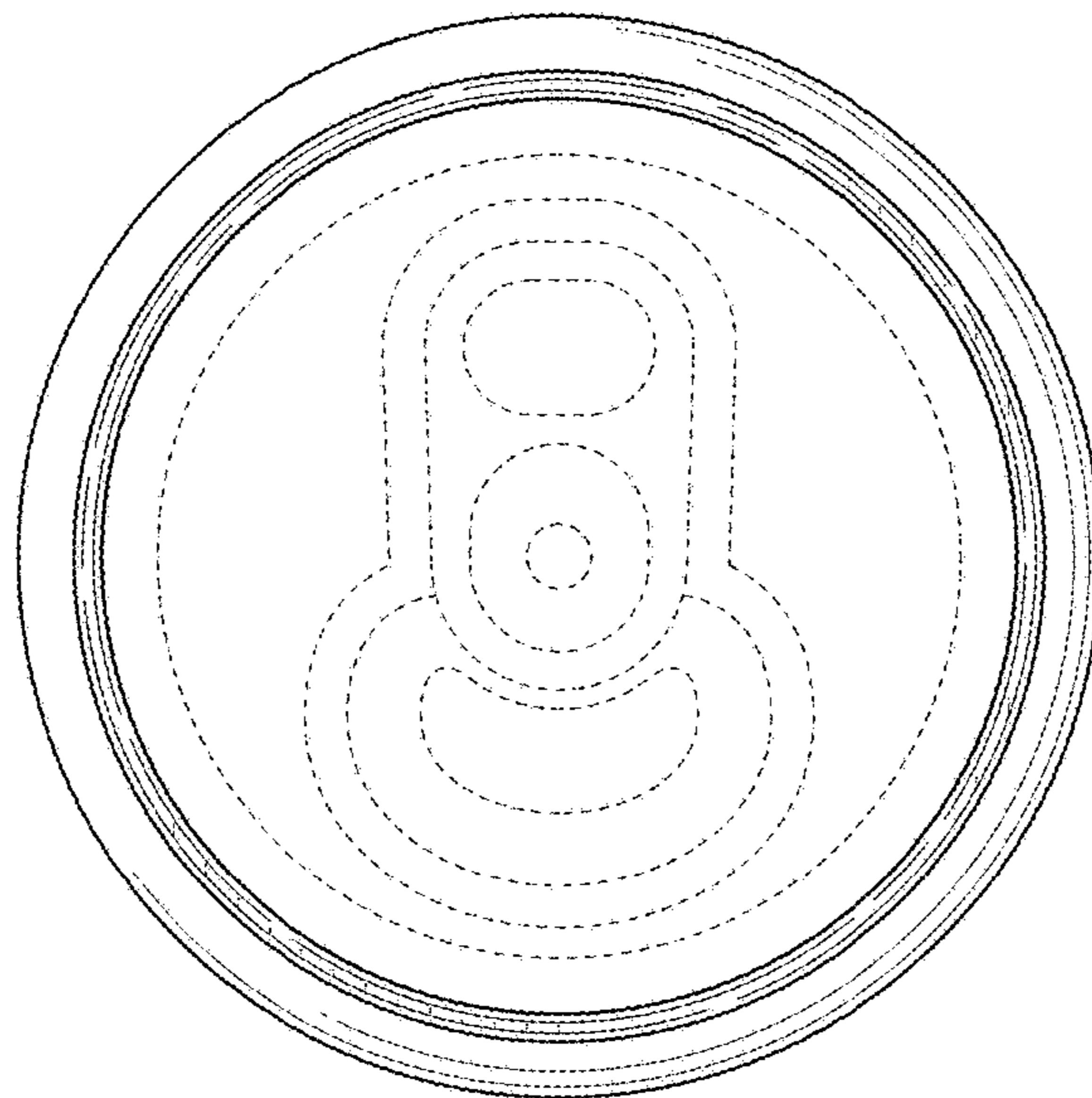
